(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sucking nozzle for medical and dental use, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof with the left side being substantially the same;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view of a sucking nozzle for medical and dental use
 FIG. 7 is a side perspective view of an alternative embodiment of a sucking nozzle for medical and dental use;
 FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a top perspective view thereof; and,
 FIG. 11 is a bottom perspective view of a alternative embodiment of a sucking nozzle for medical and dental use.

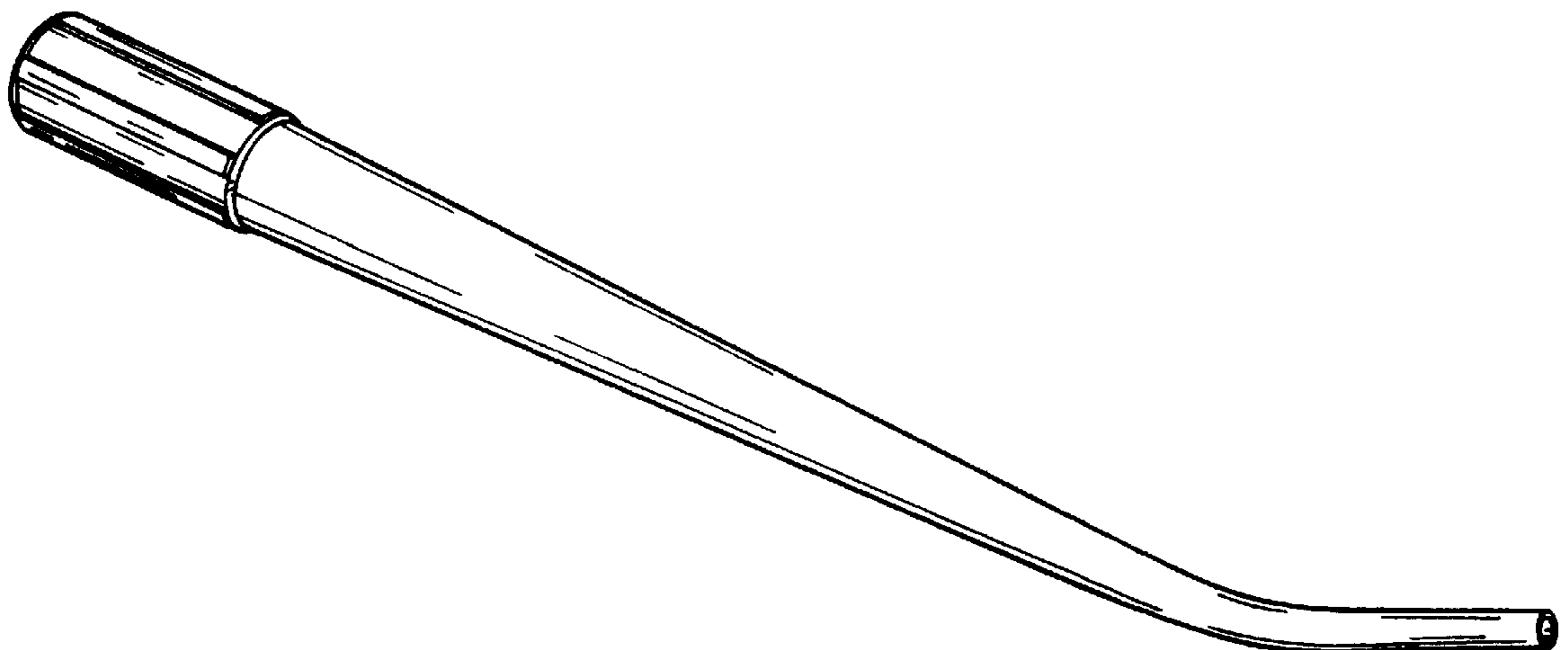
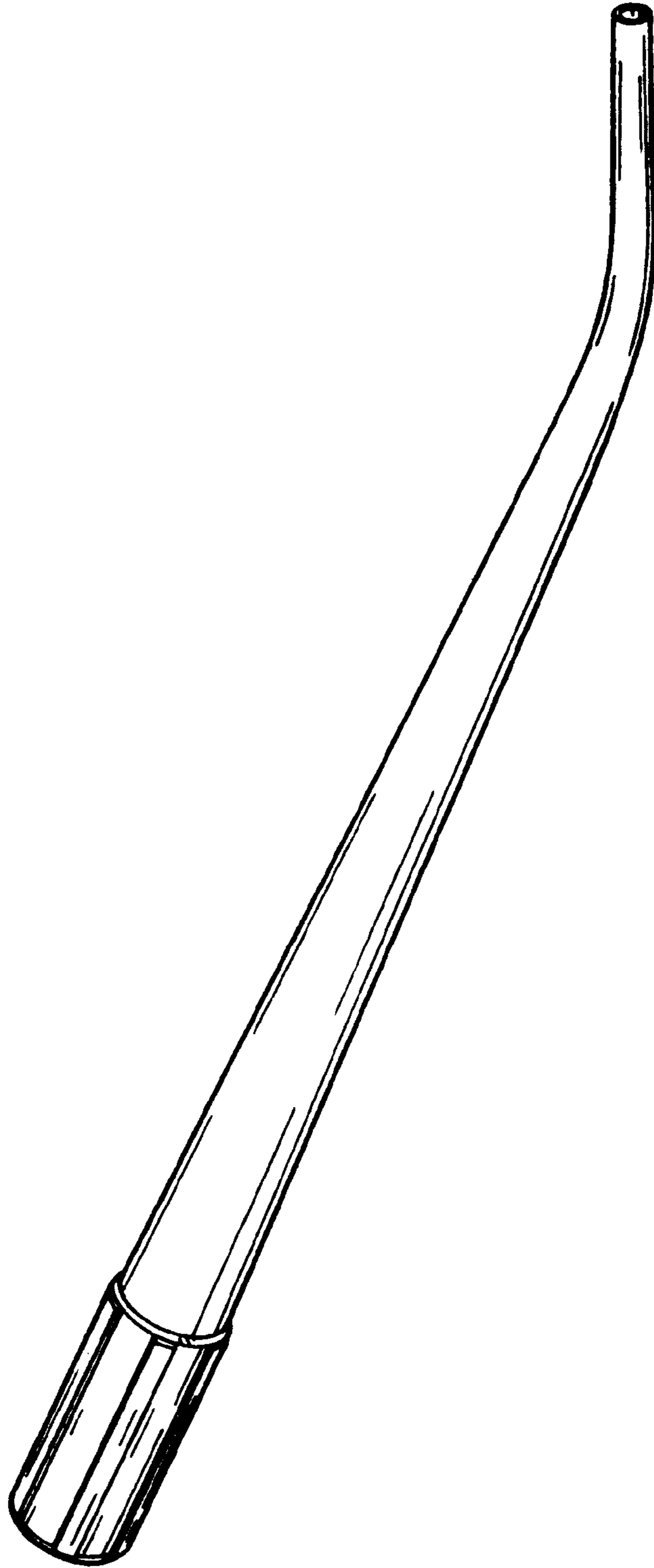

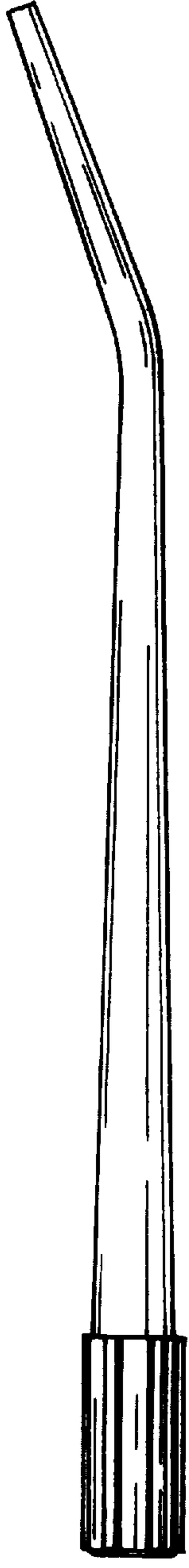

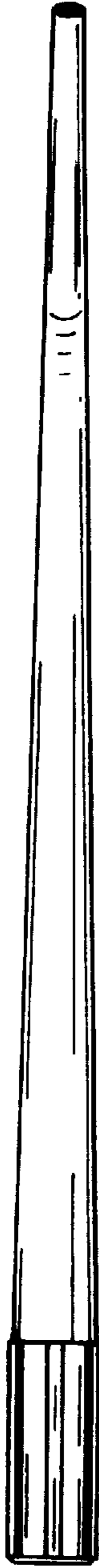

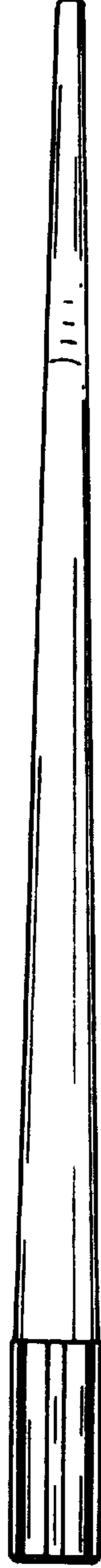

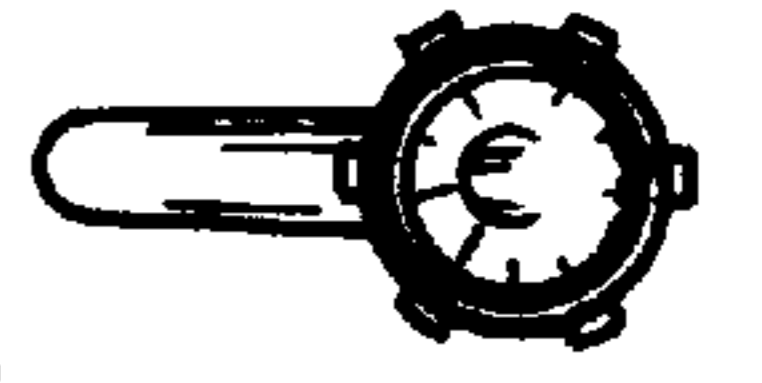

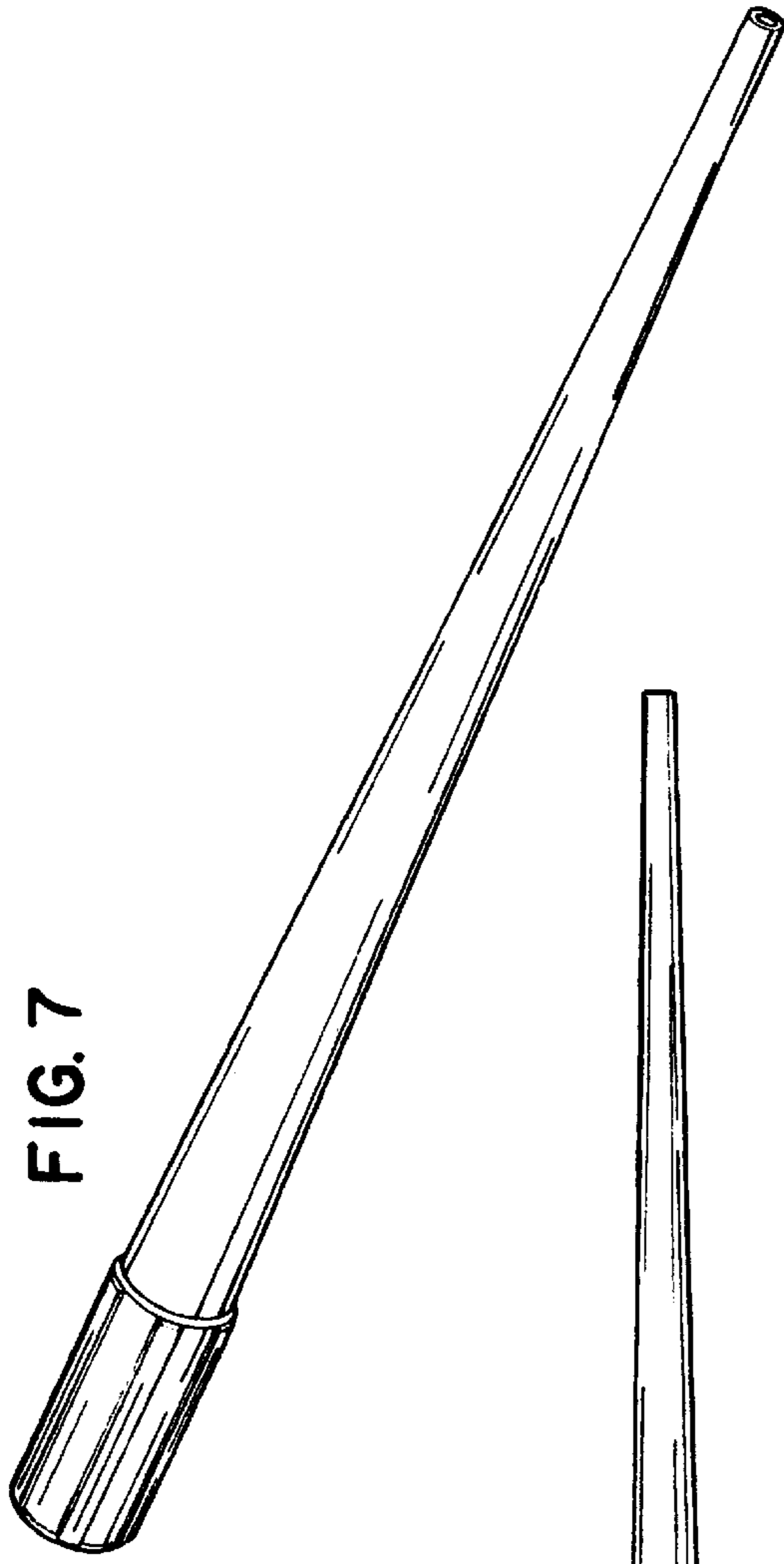

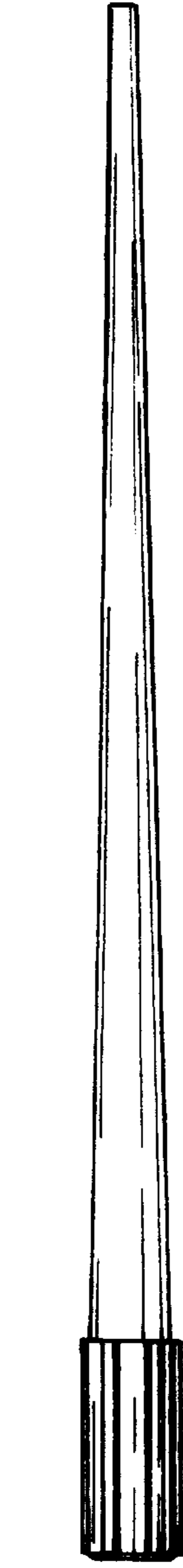

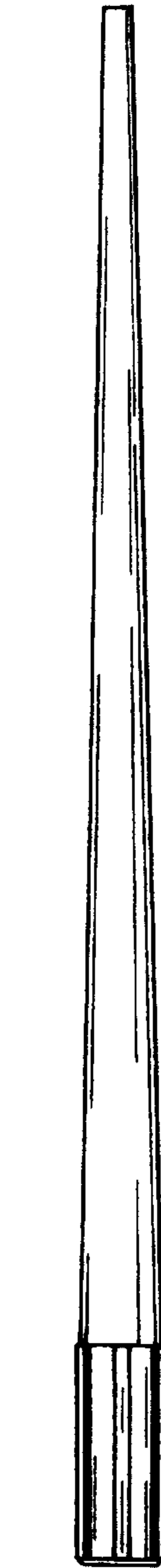
