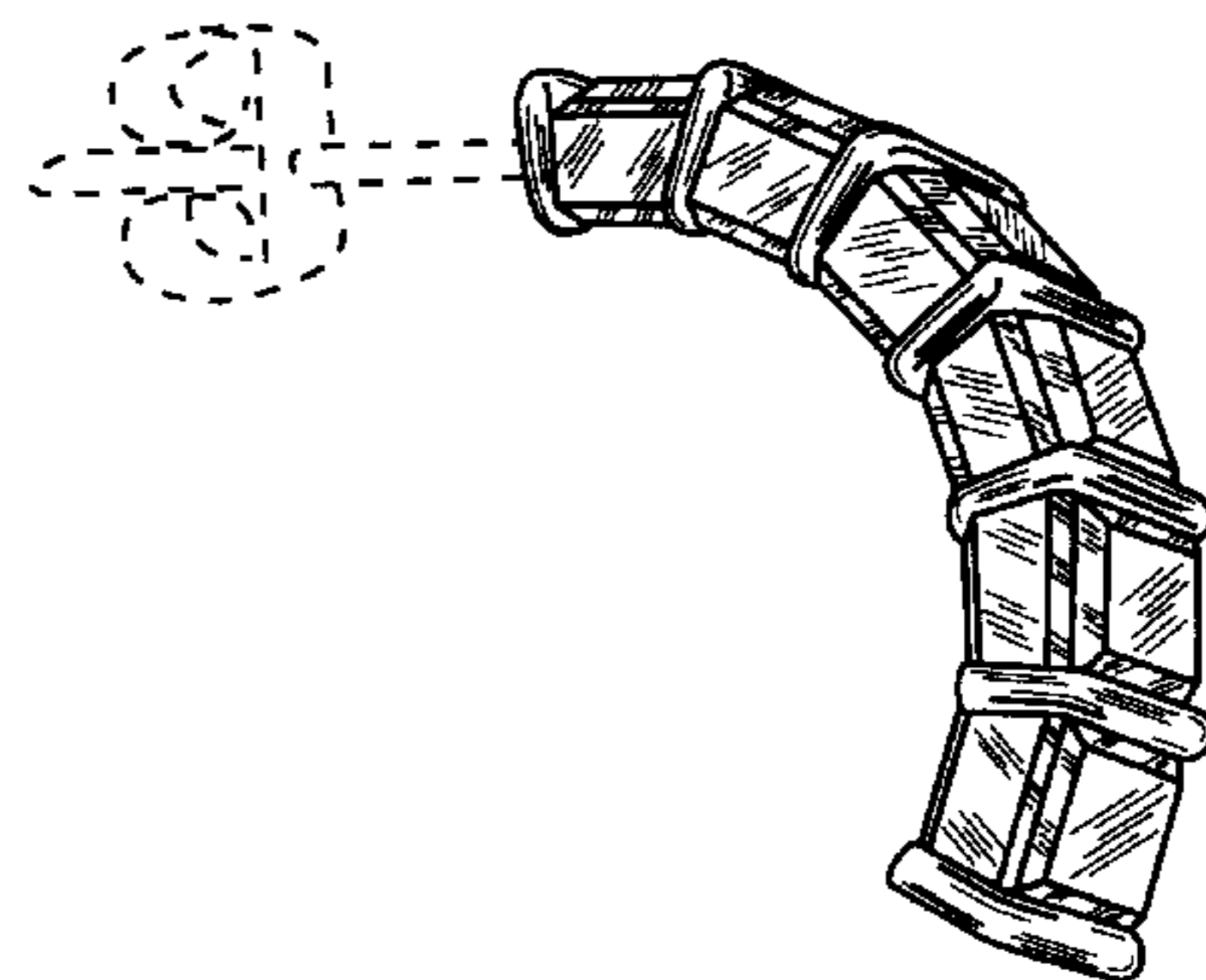
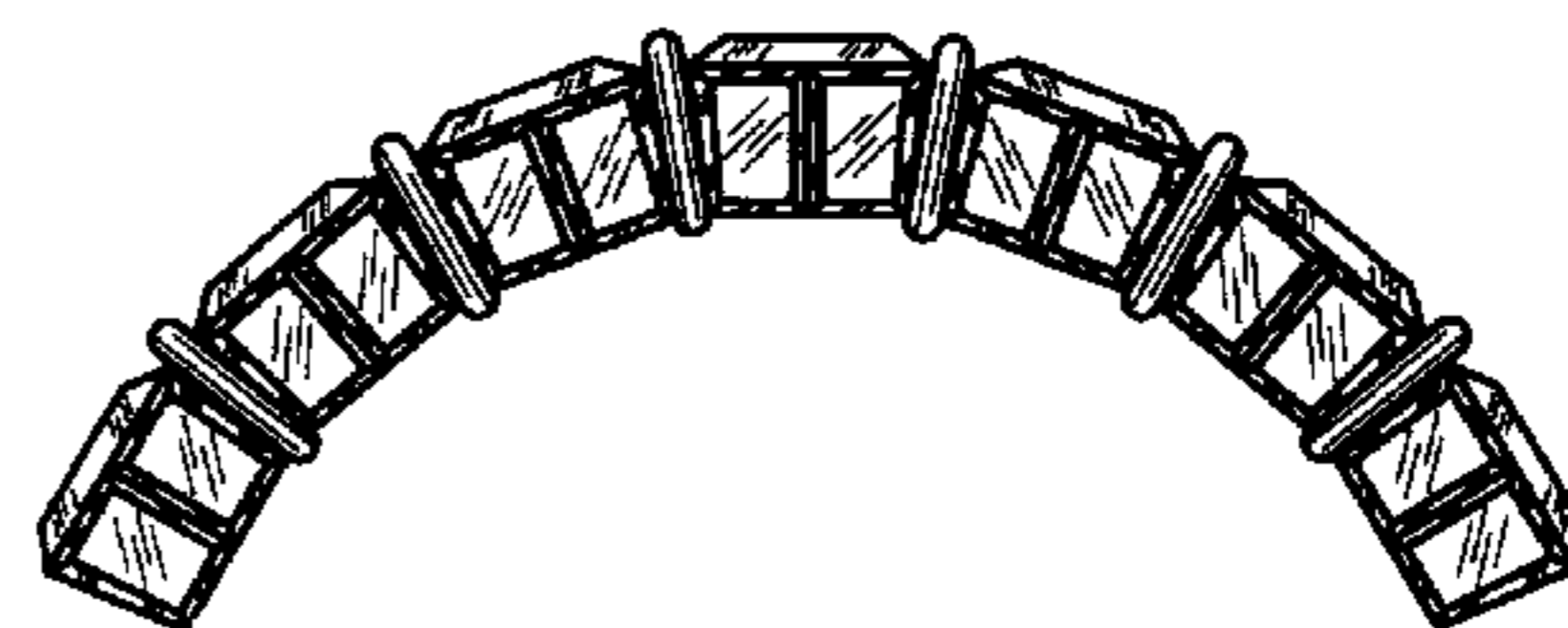
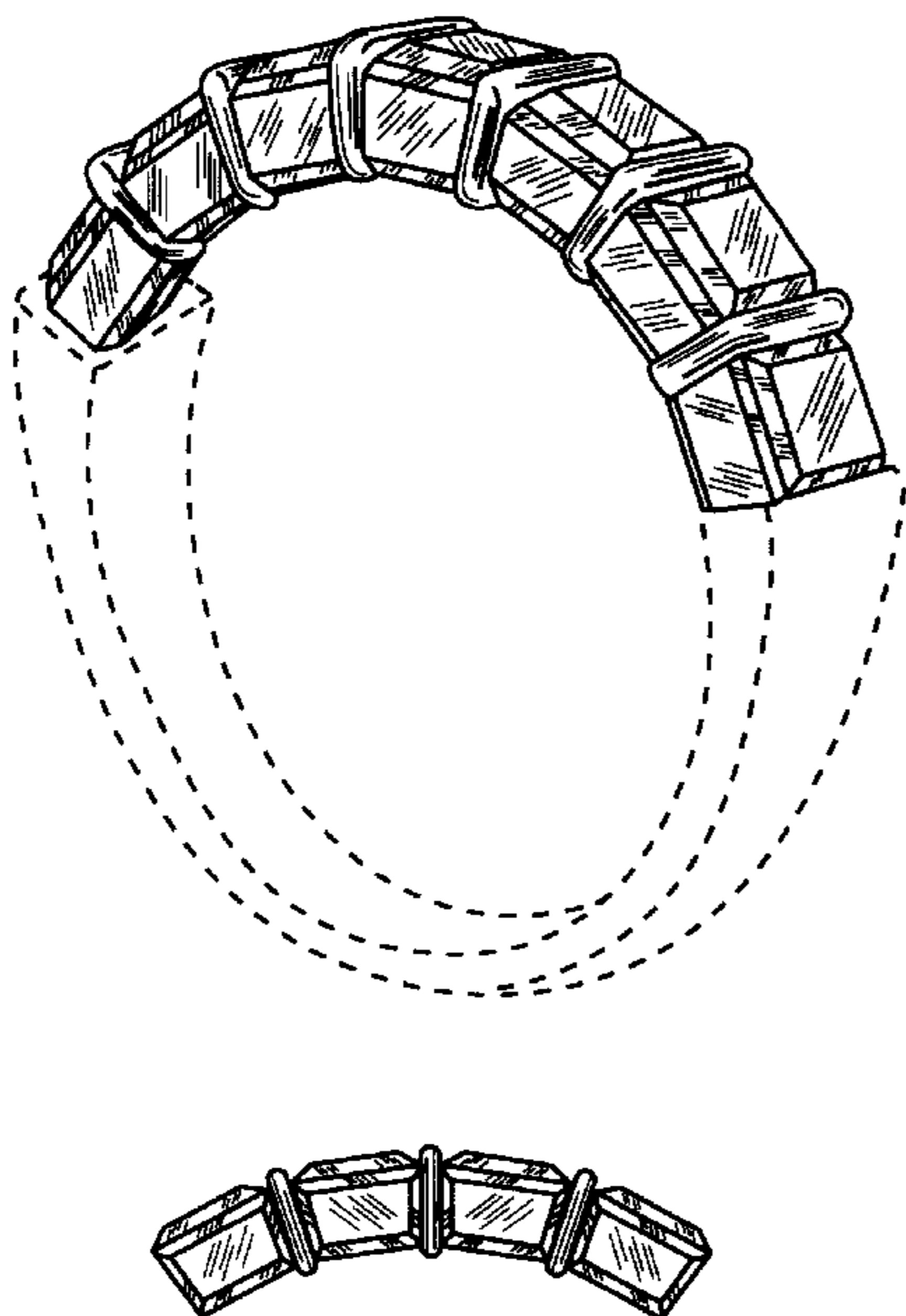
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ring or earring, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my new jewelry design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of my new design; FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment of my new design; FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a sixth embodiment of my new design; and, FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a seventh embodiment of my new design. The broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 9 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

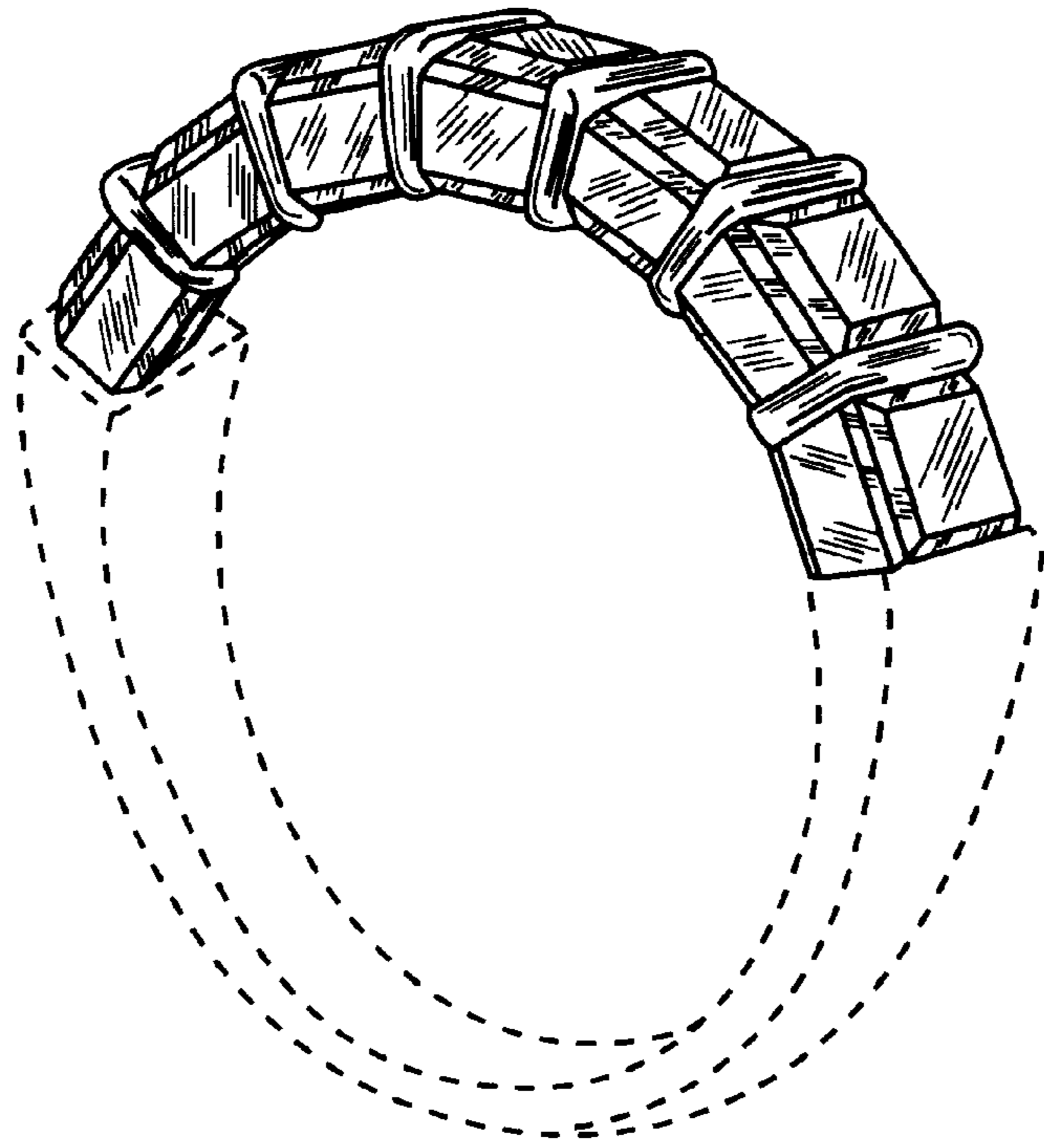

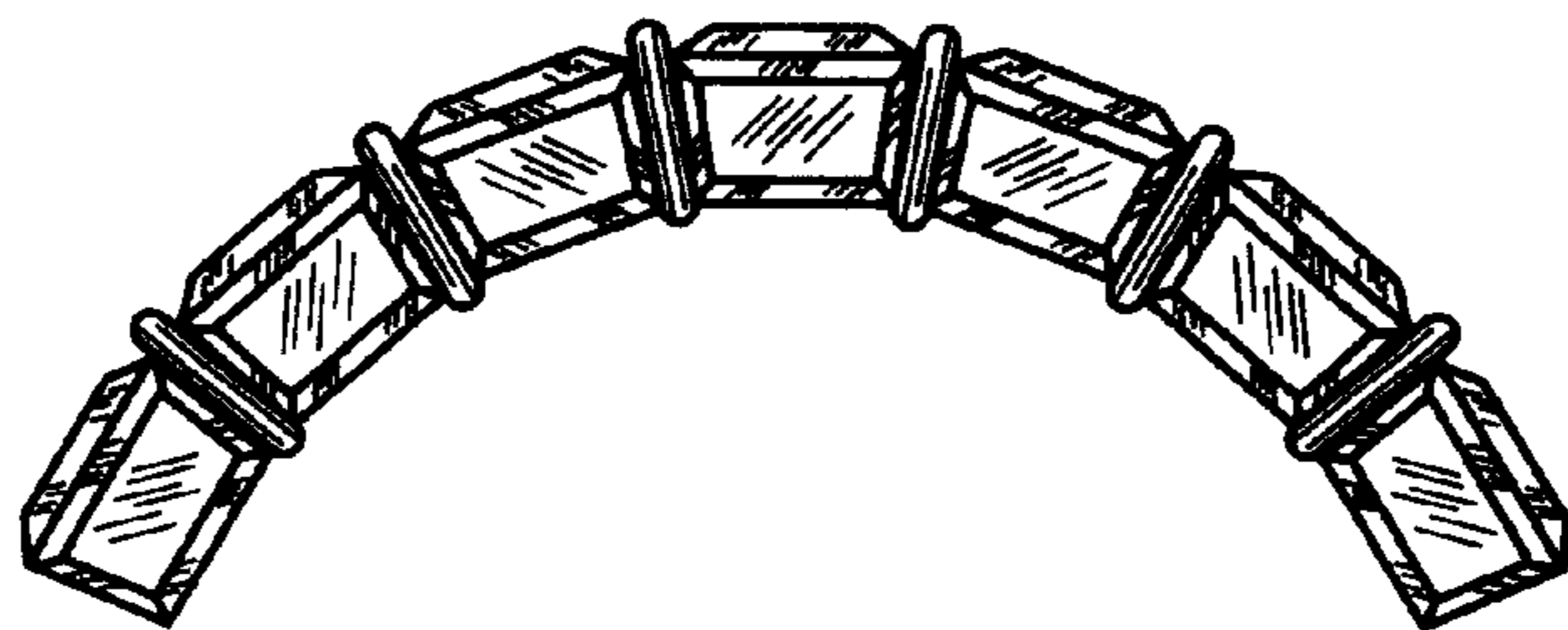

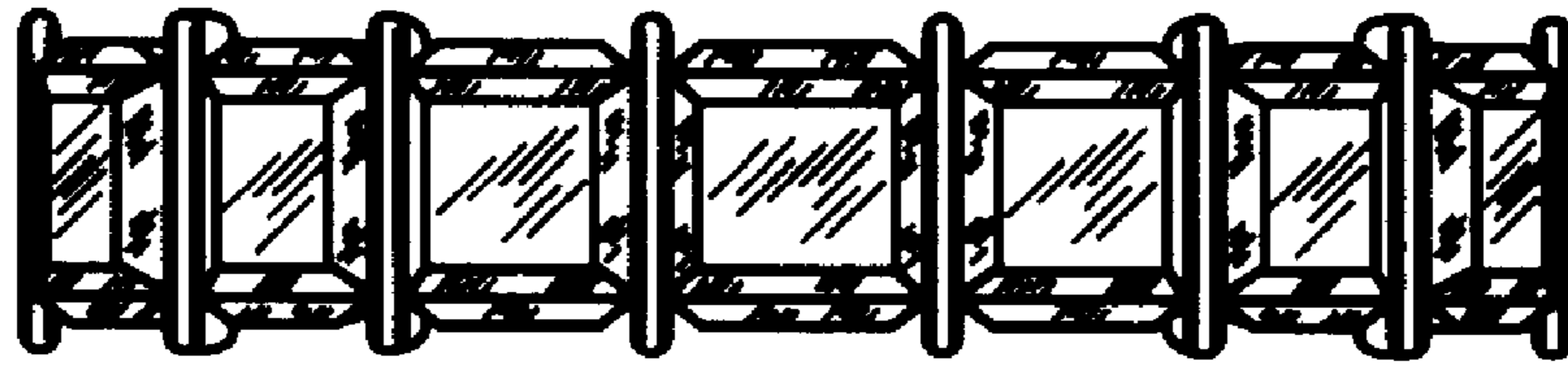

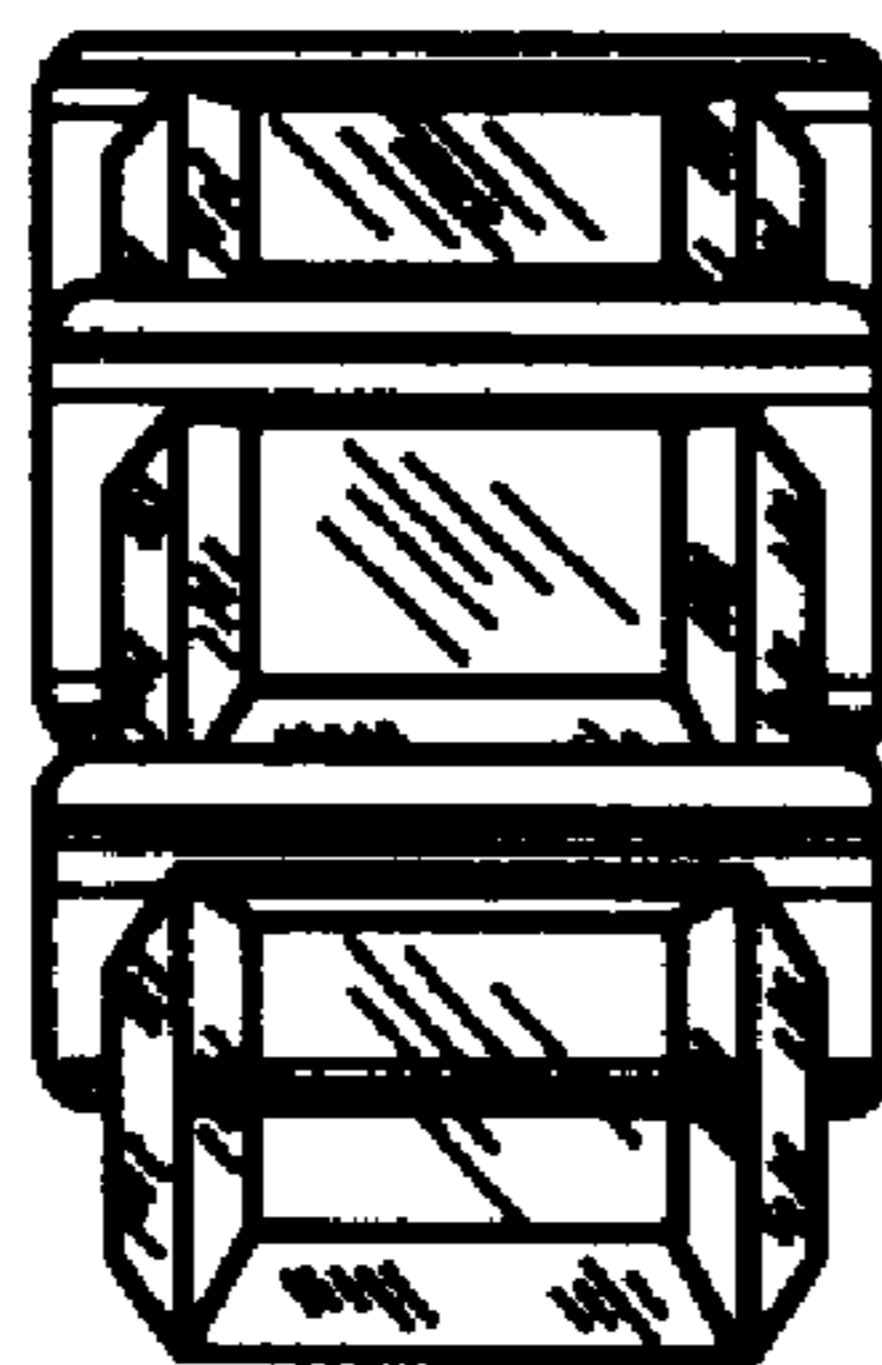

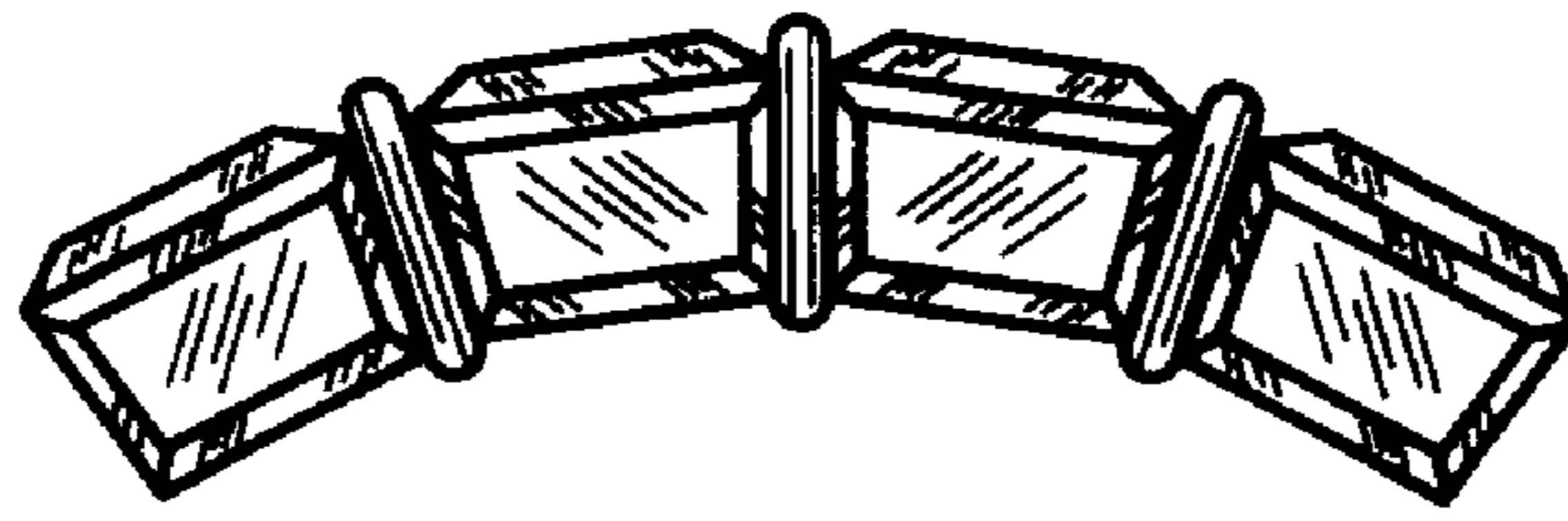

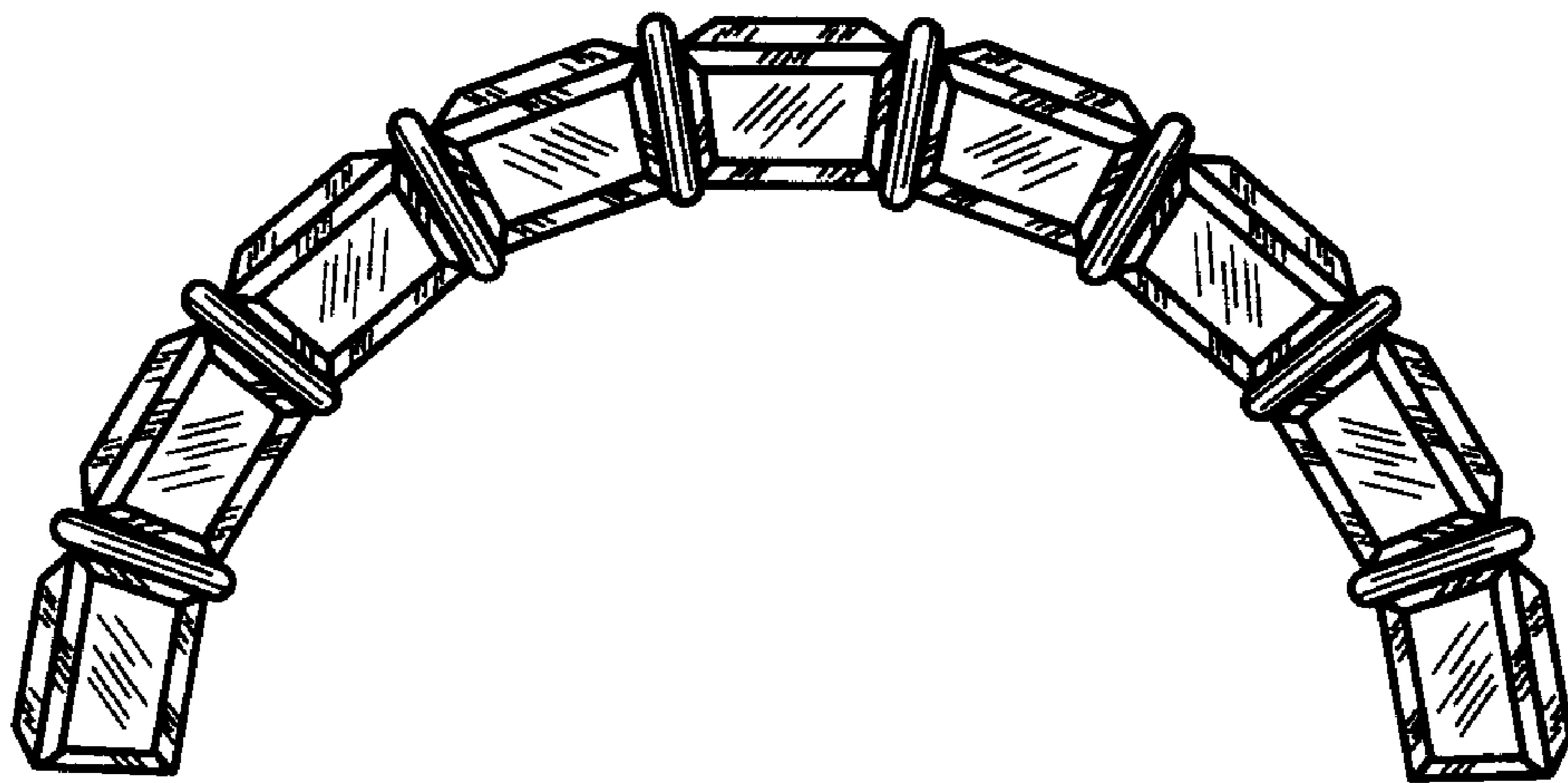

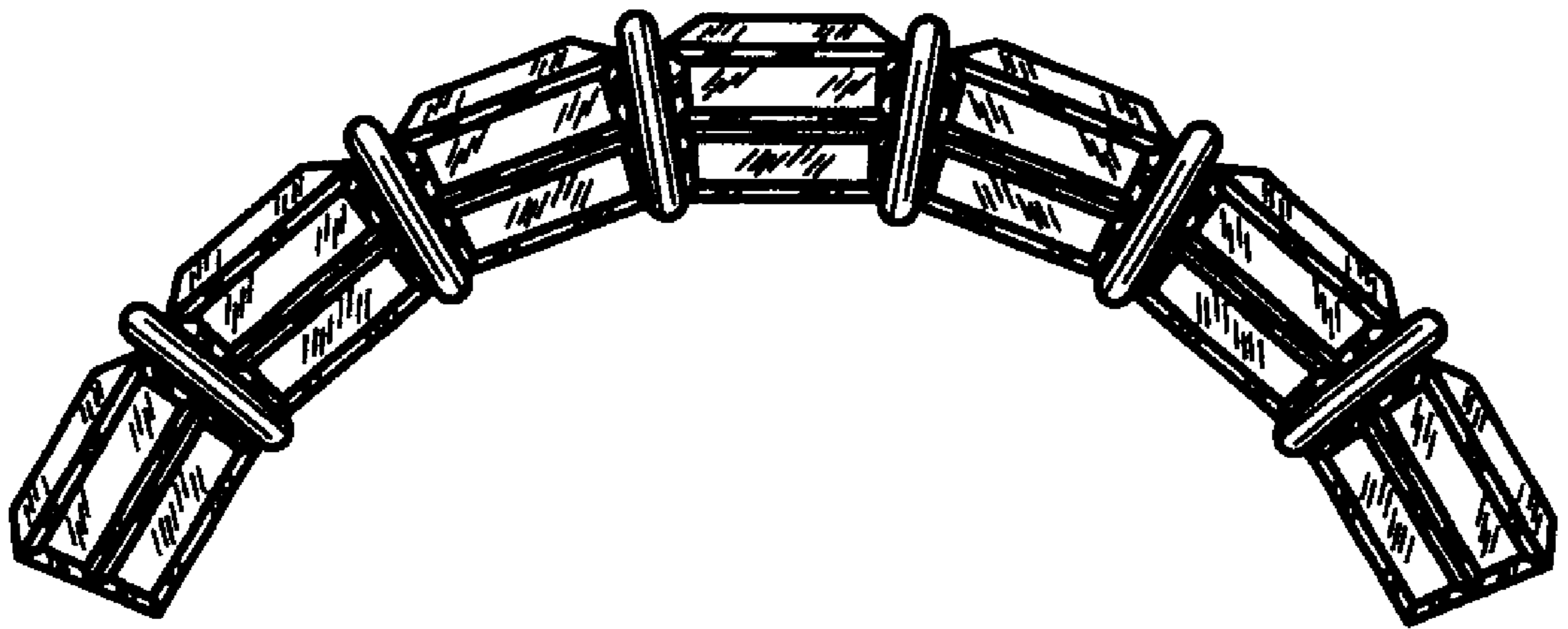

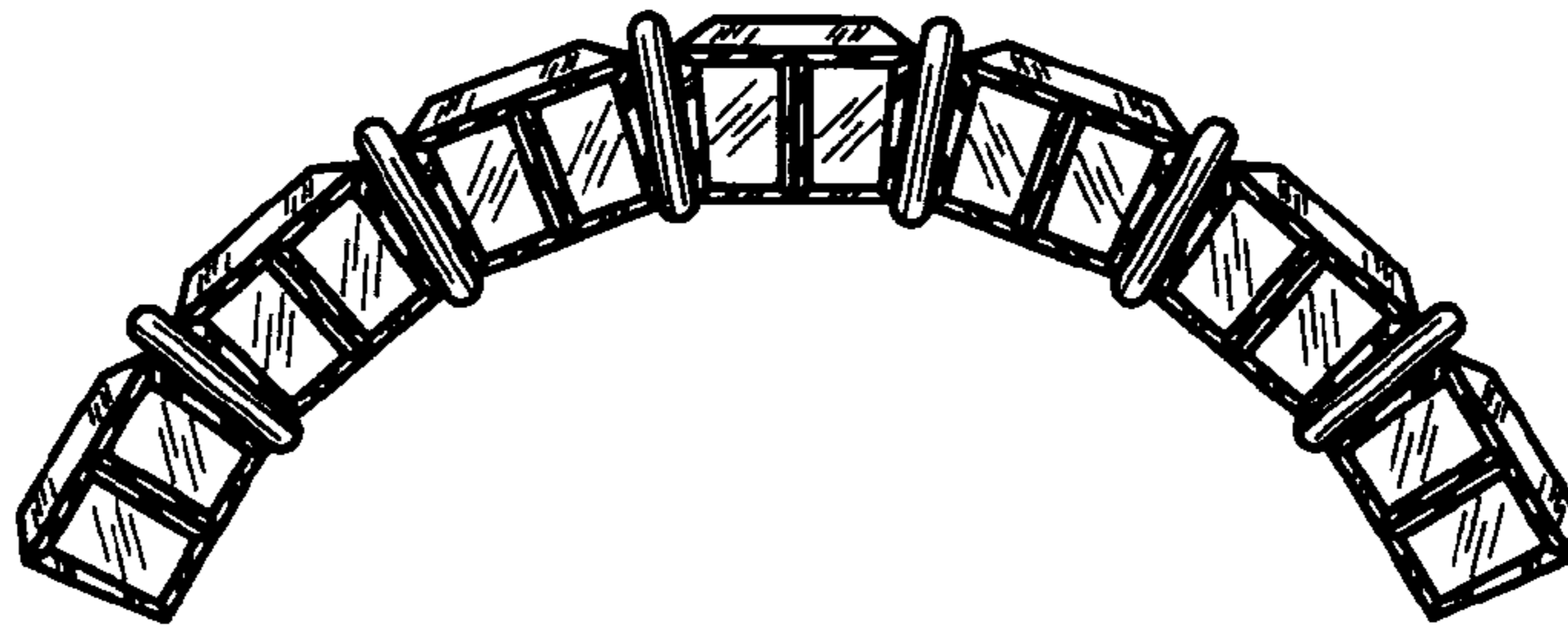

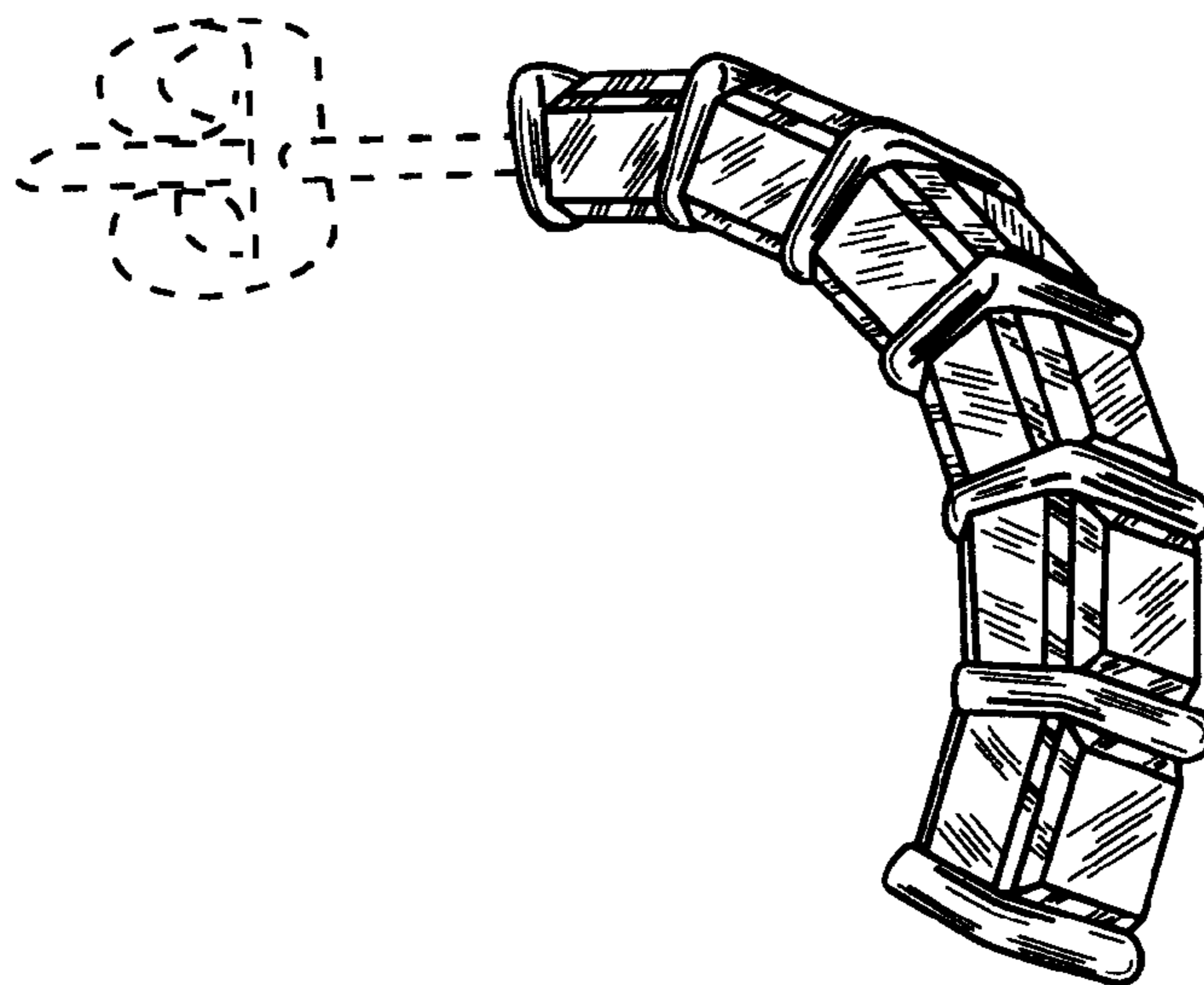
