(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a novelty skeleton figure, as
shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a first embodiment of a novelty
skeleton figure manifesting aspects of the new and orna-
mental design.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation of the novelty skeleton
illustrated in FIG. 1.

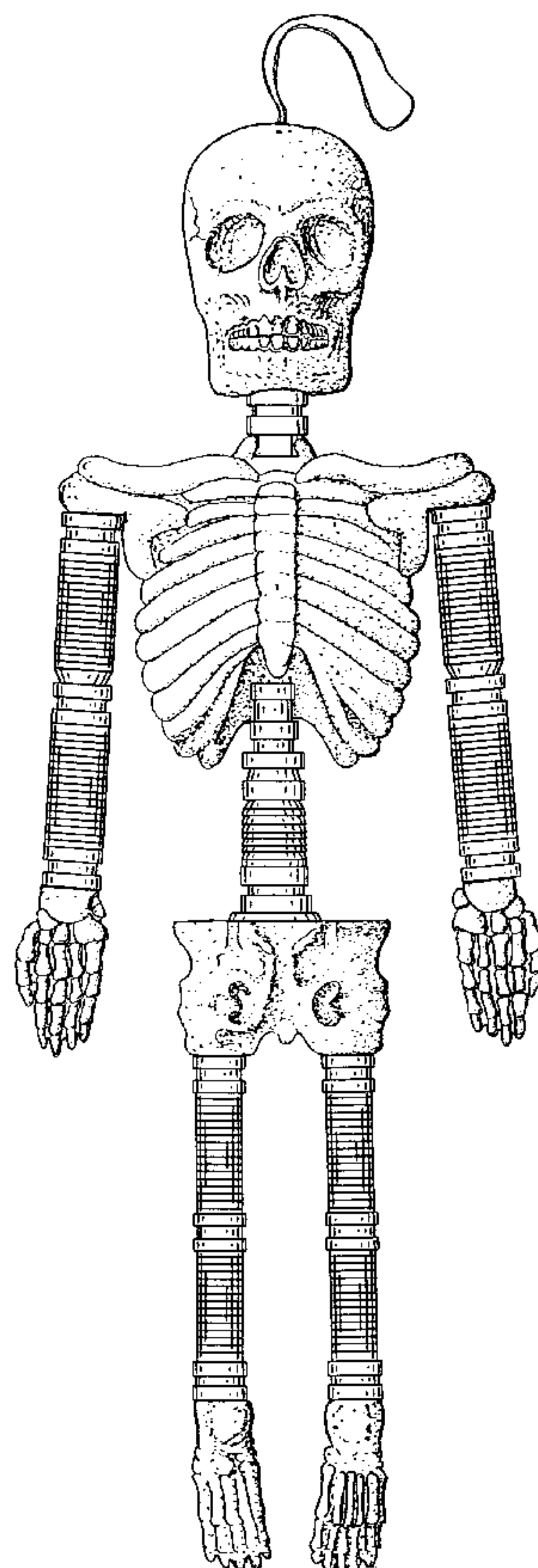
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation of the novelty skeleton figure
illustrated in FIGS. 1 and 2.

FIG. 4 is a top view of the novelty skeleton figure illustrated
in FIGS. 1, 2 and 3; and,

illustrated in FIGS. 1, 2, 3 and 4.

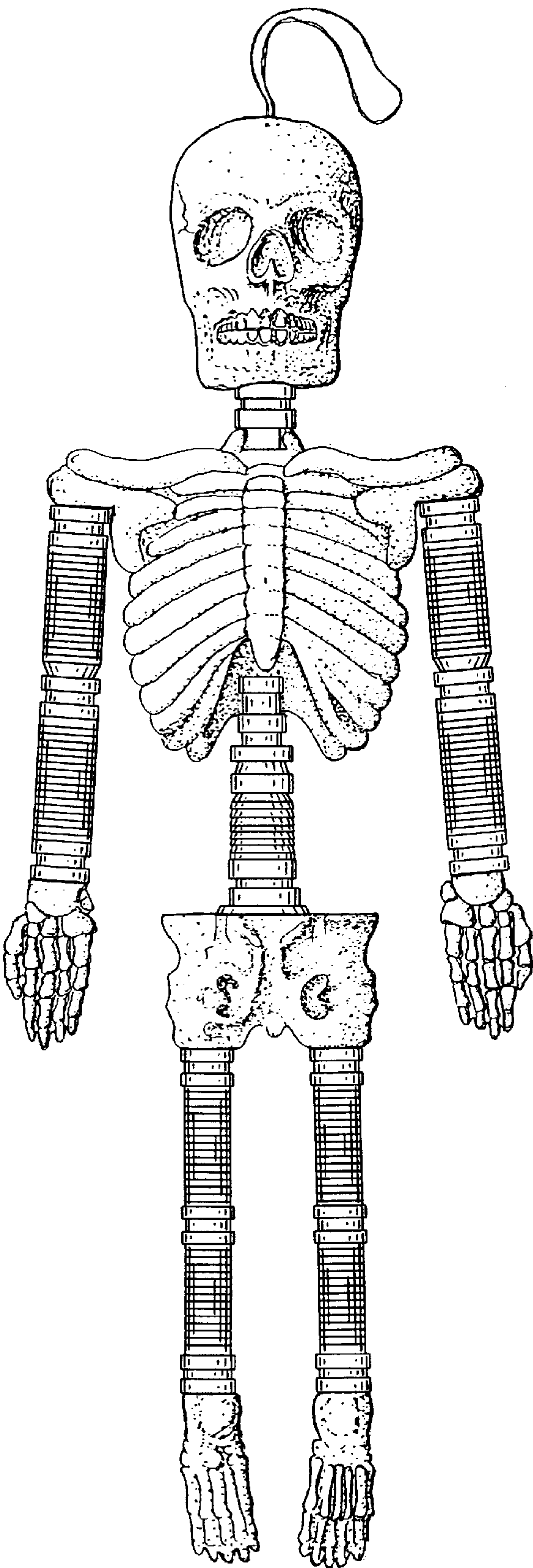

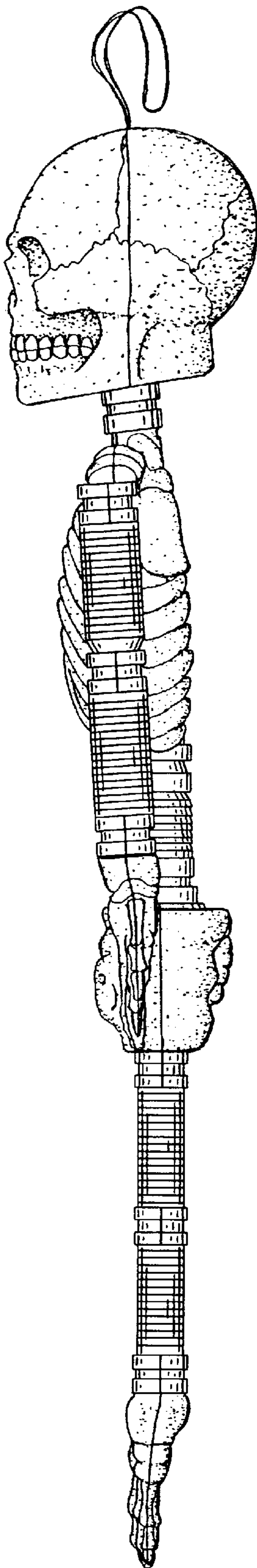

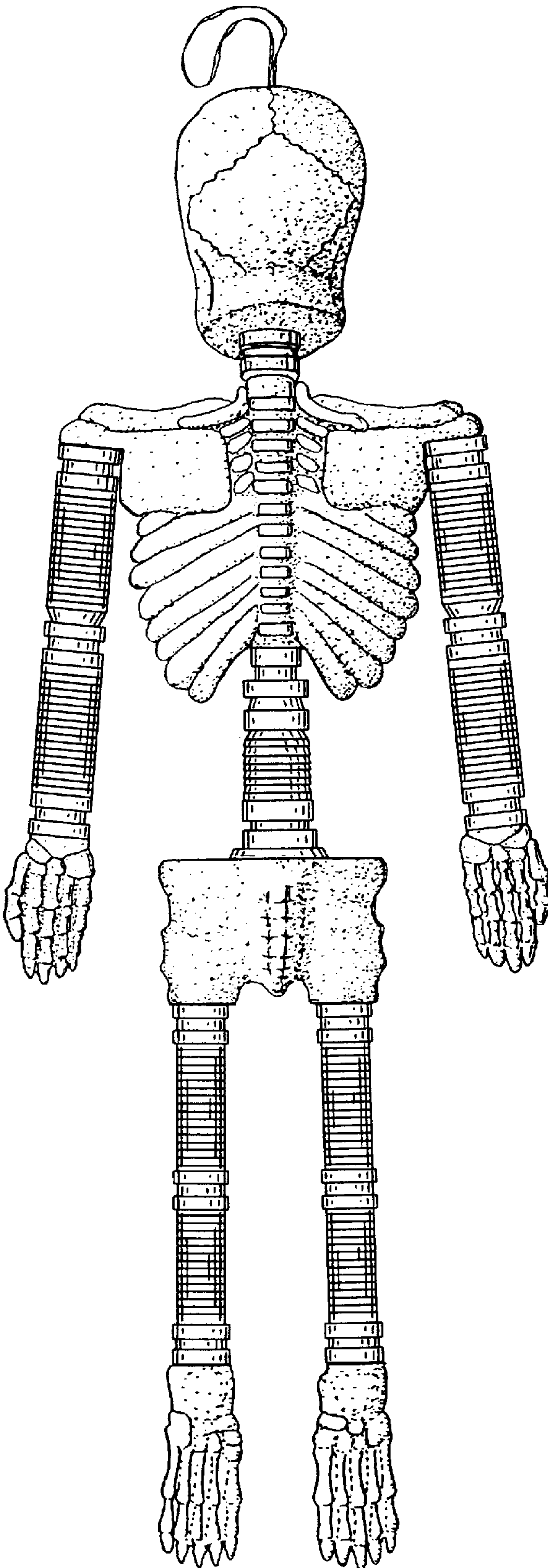

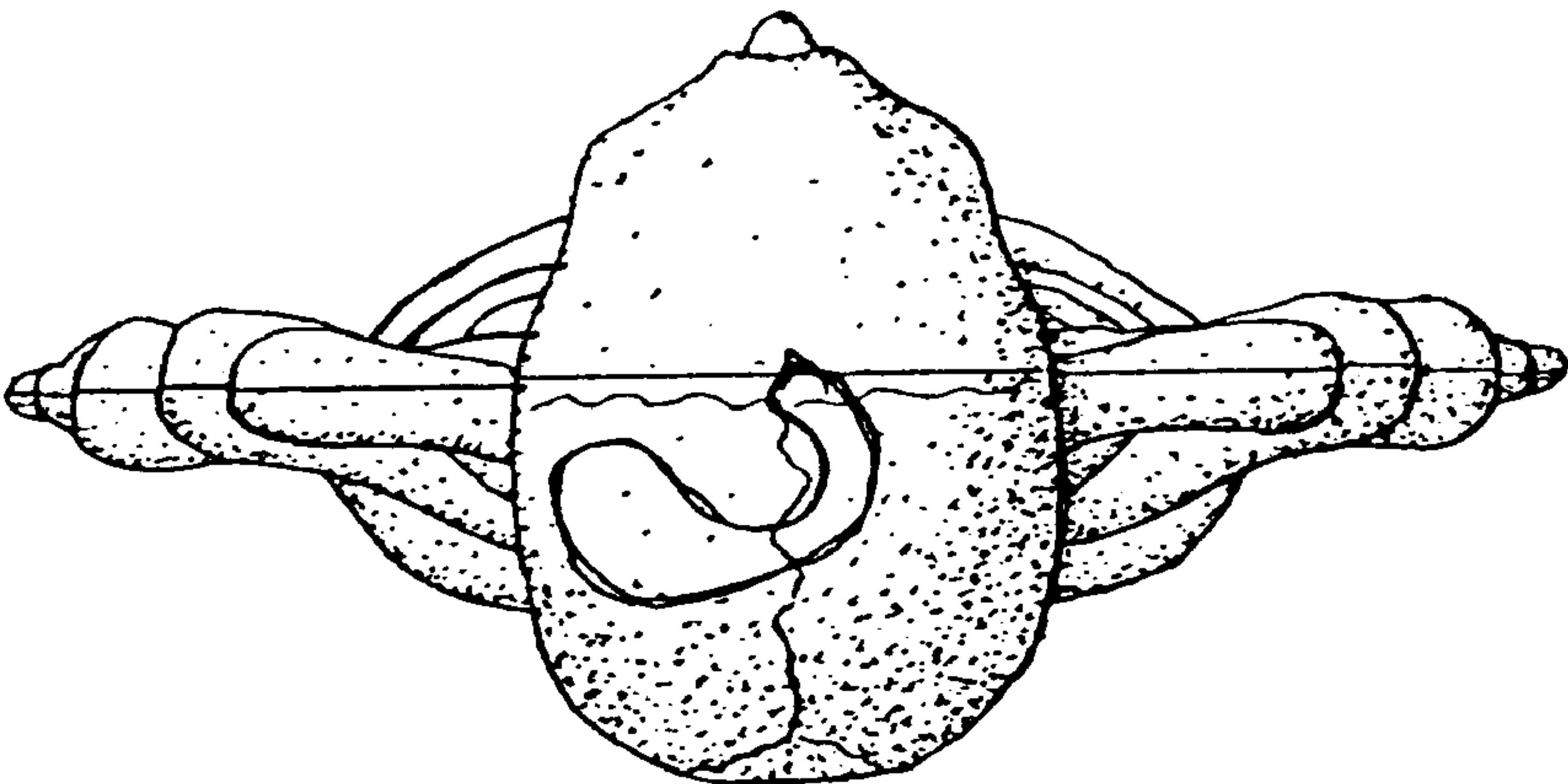

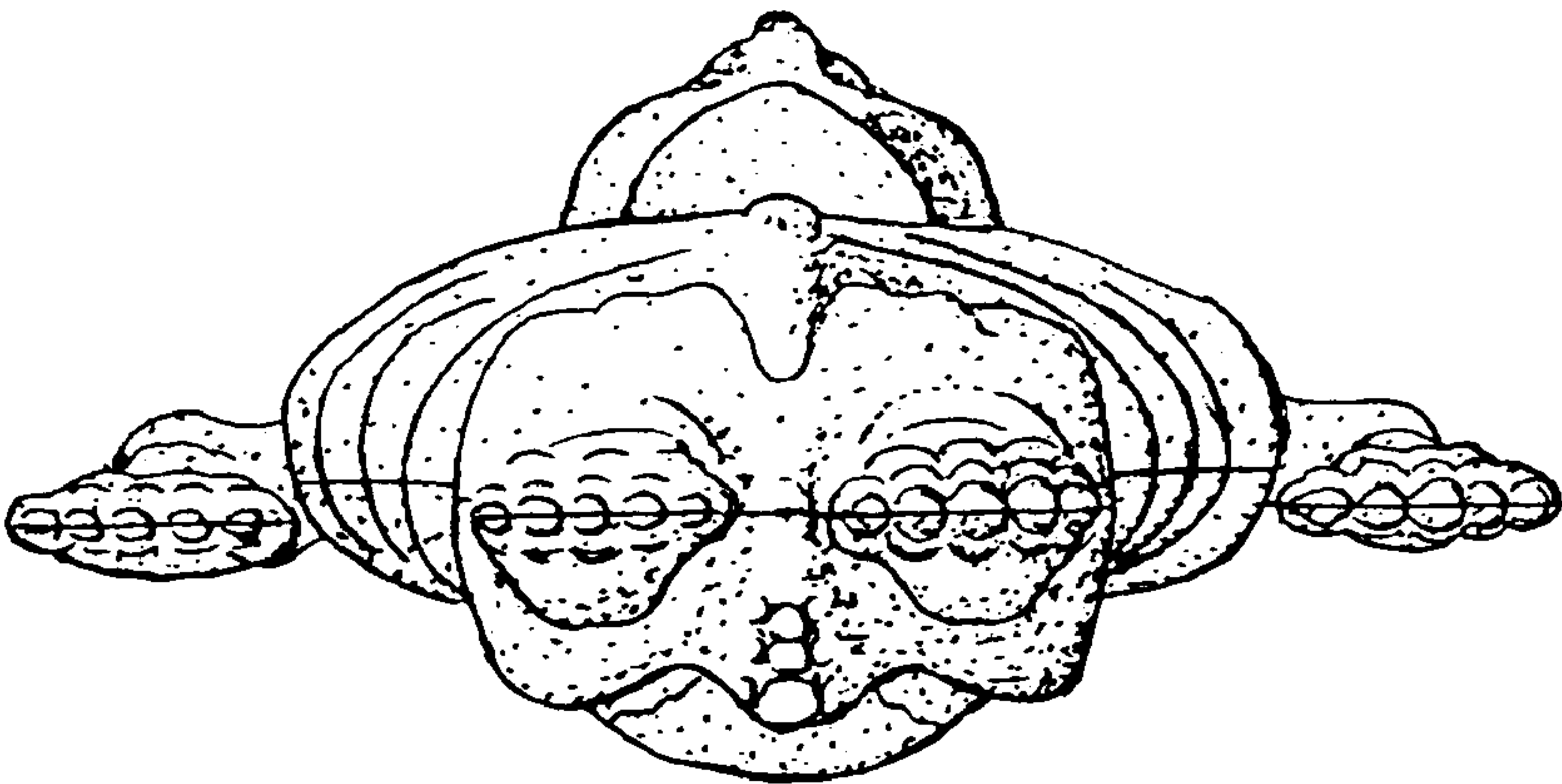
