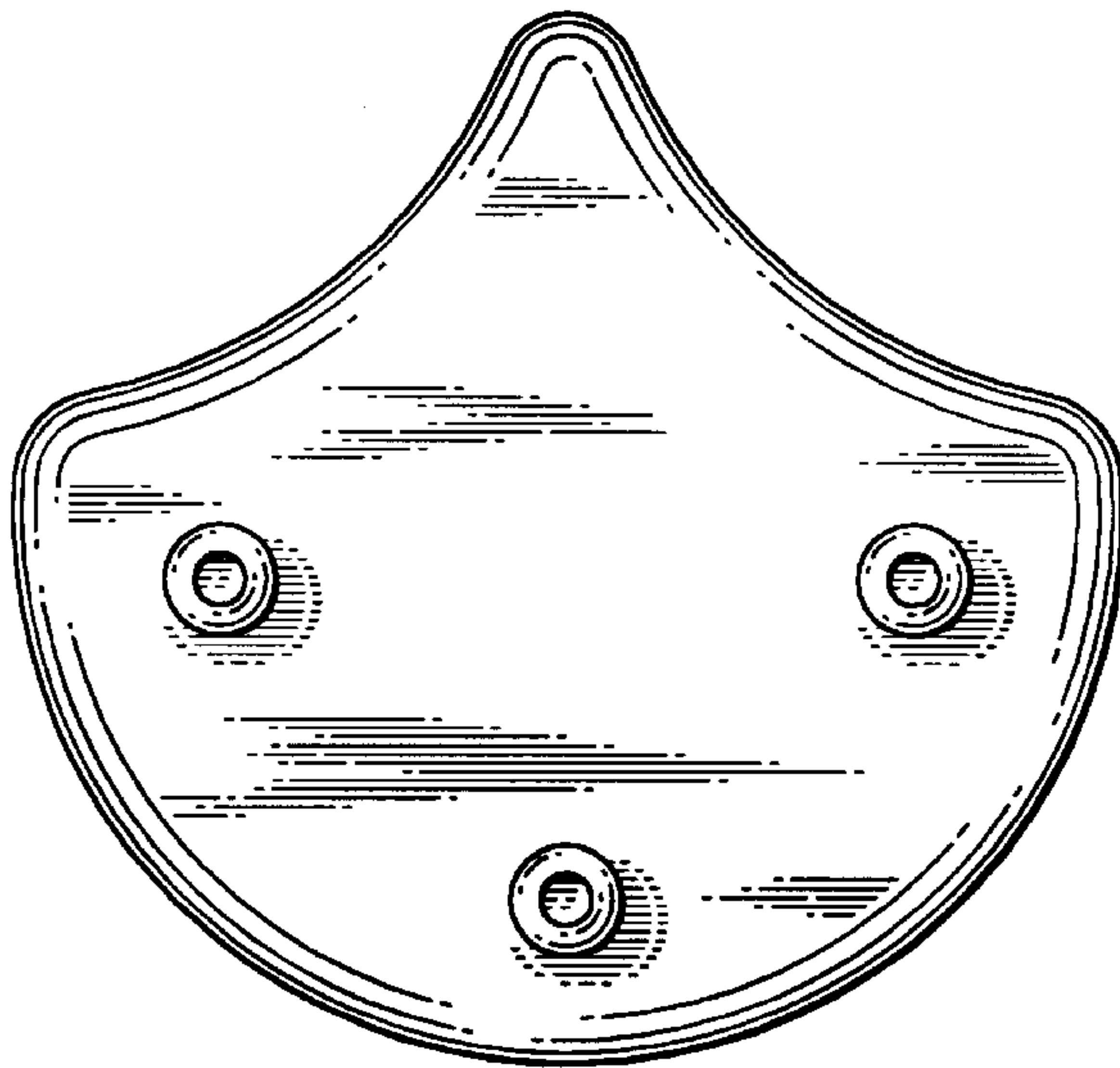
The ornamental design for a medallion for a ceiling fan blade, as shown.

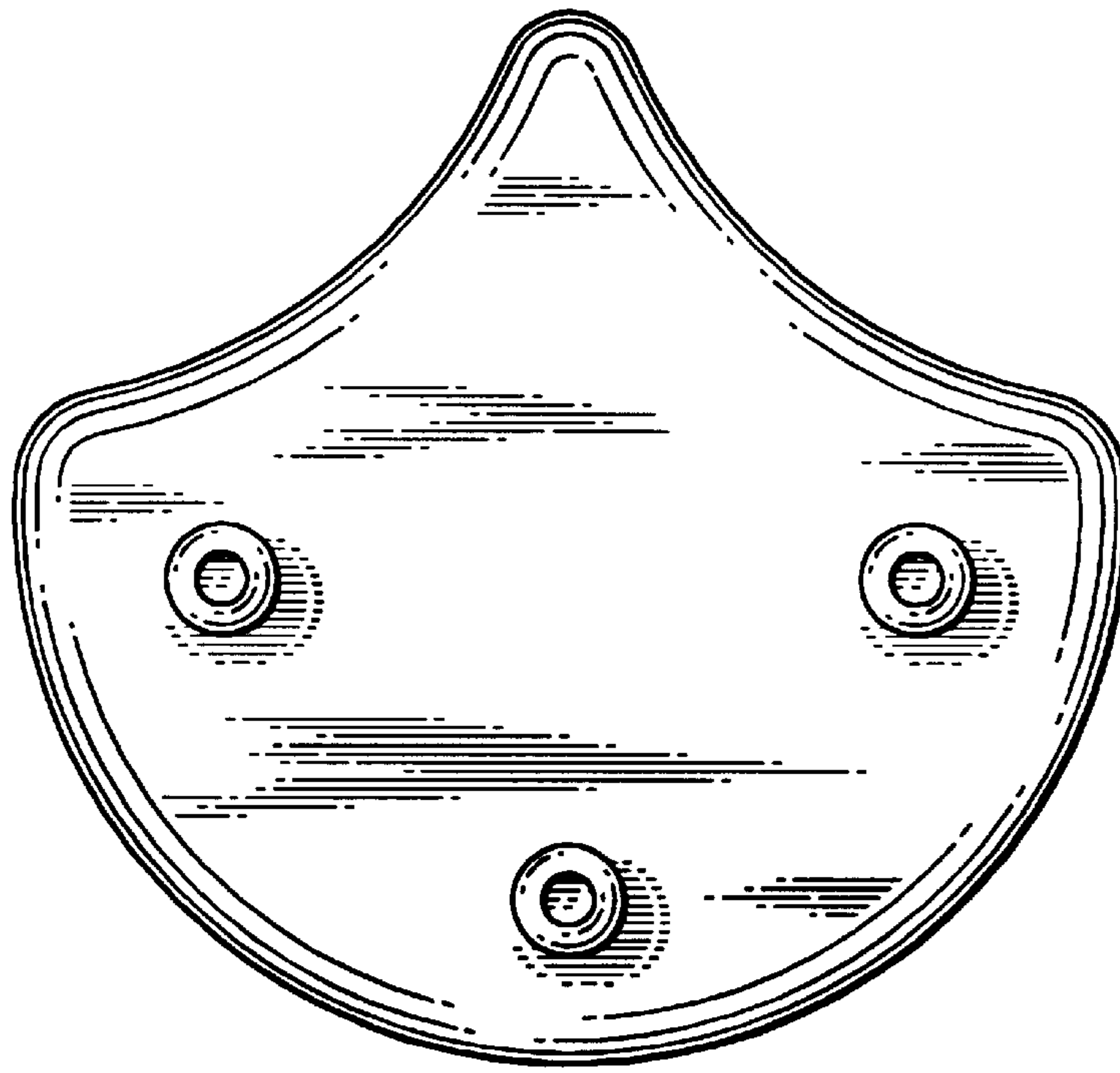
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a back view of the medallion.

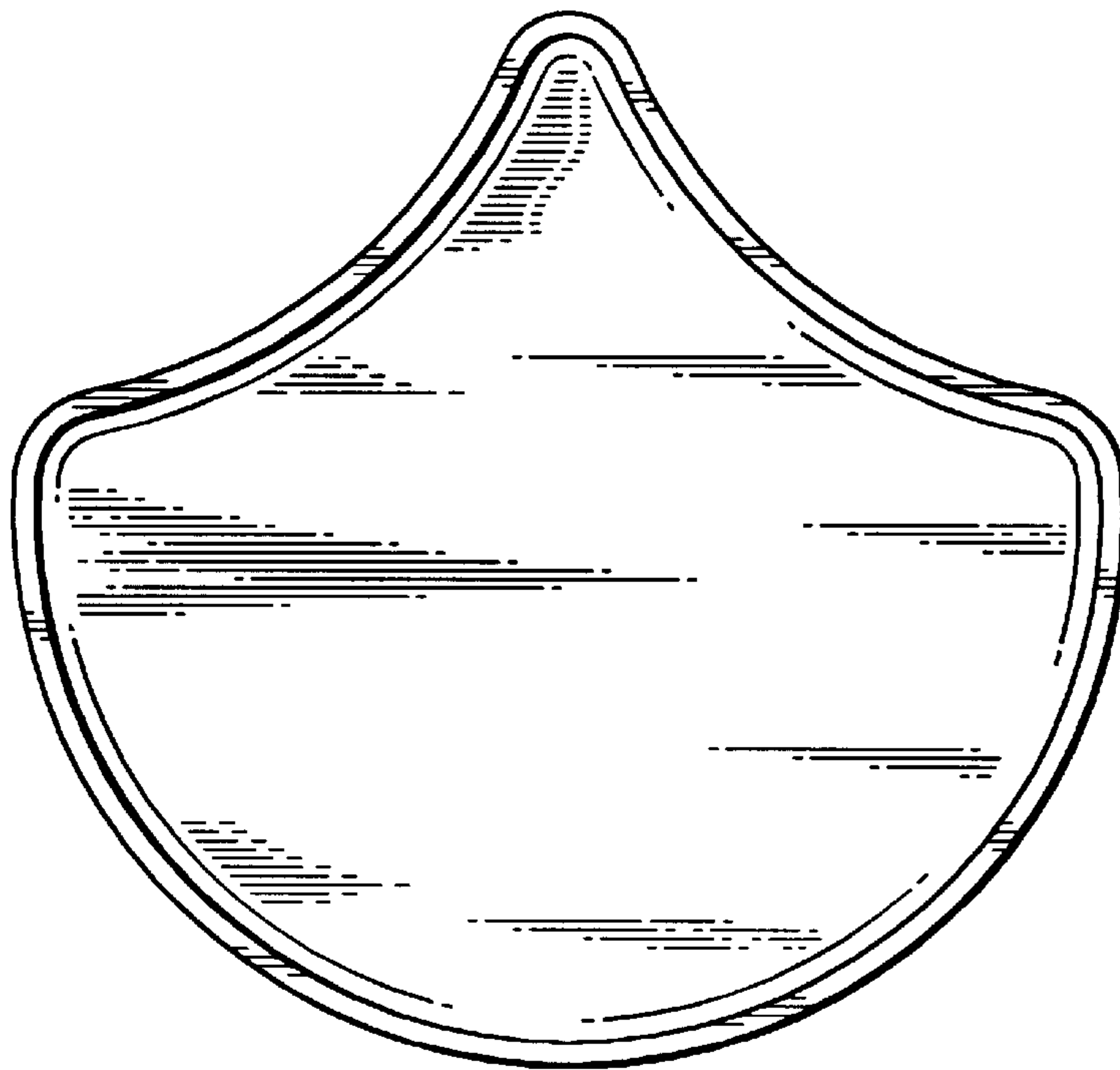
