FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a preferred embodiment of the invention.

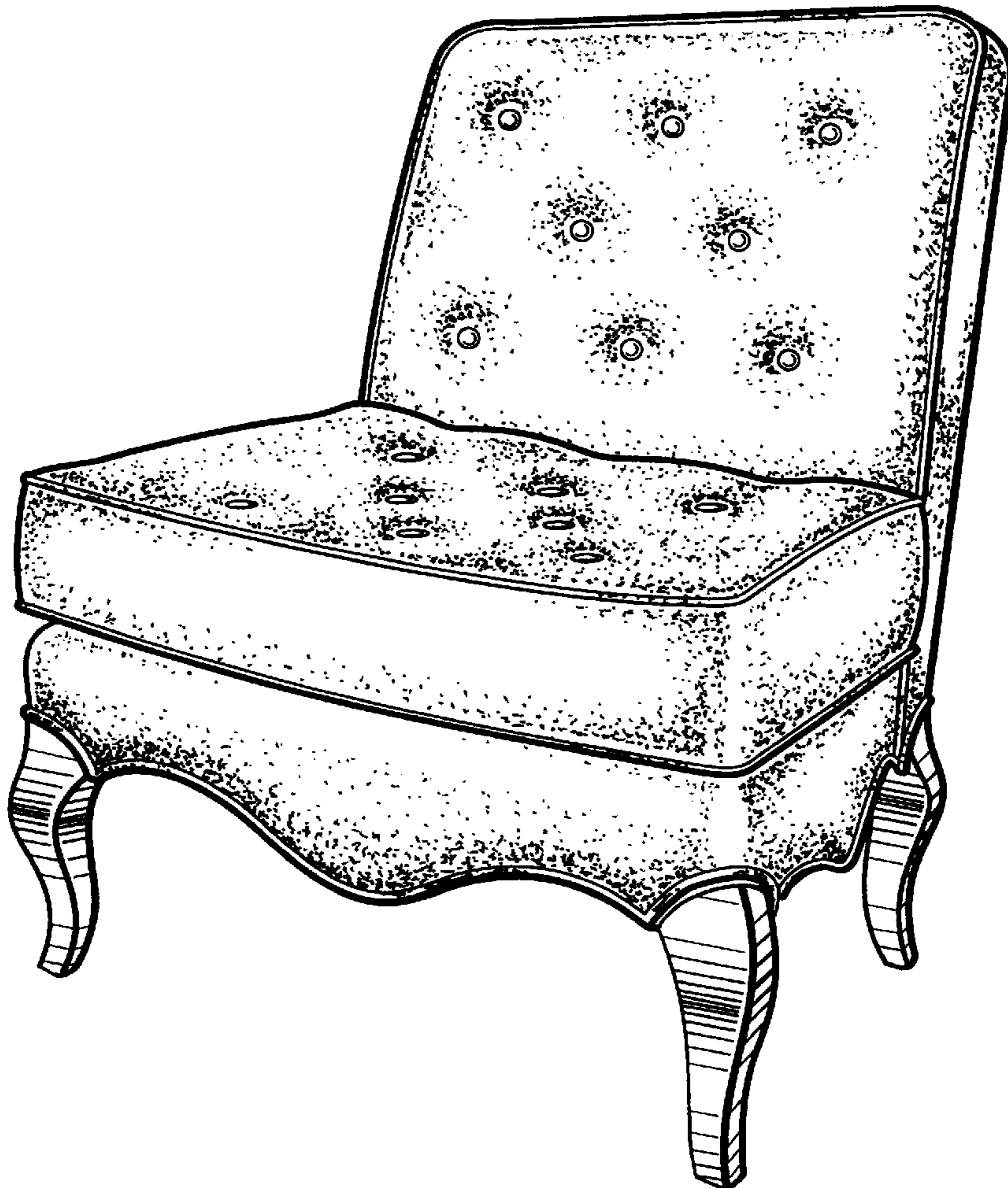
FIG. 2 is a front view of the embodiment of FIG. 1.

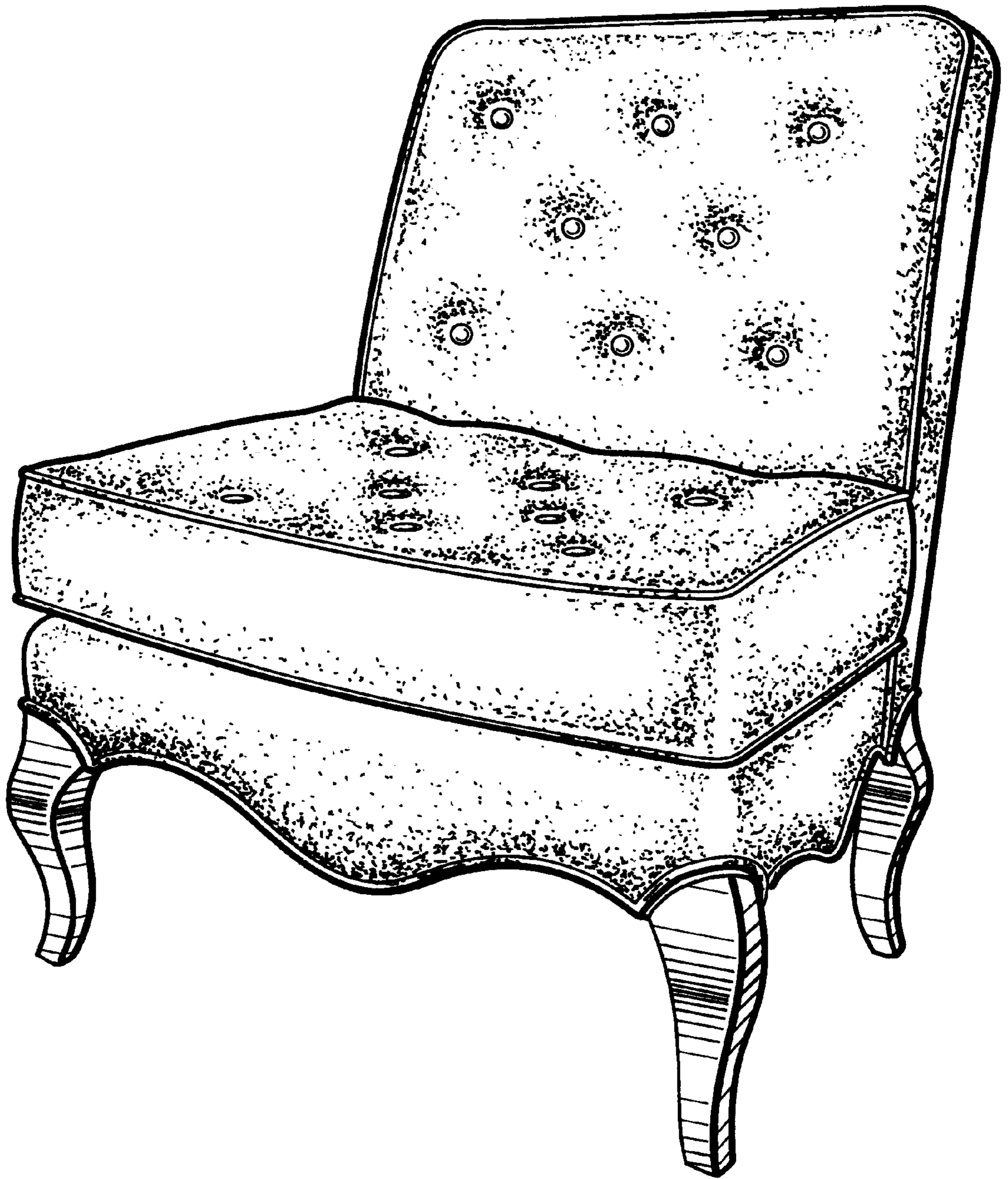

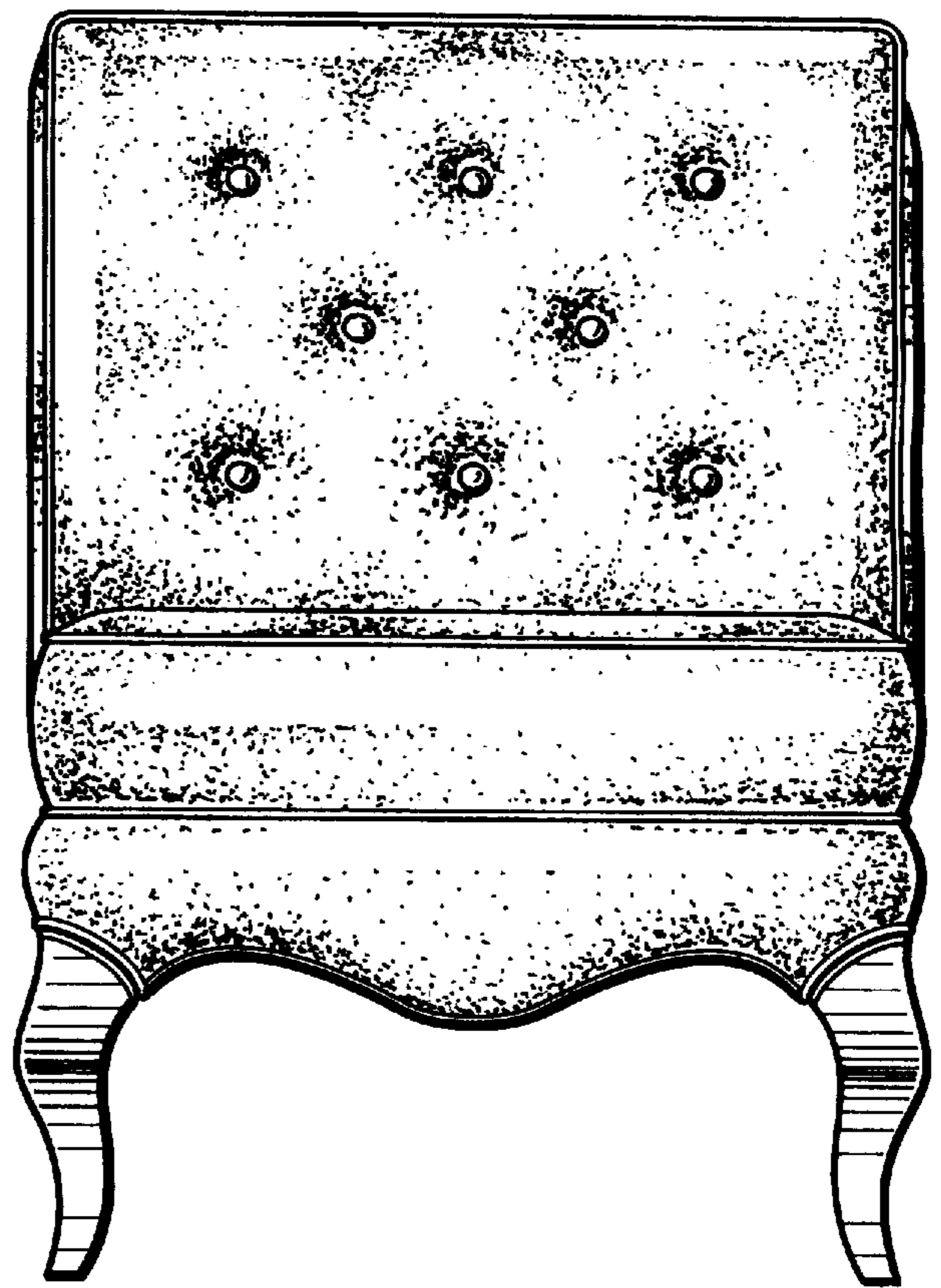

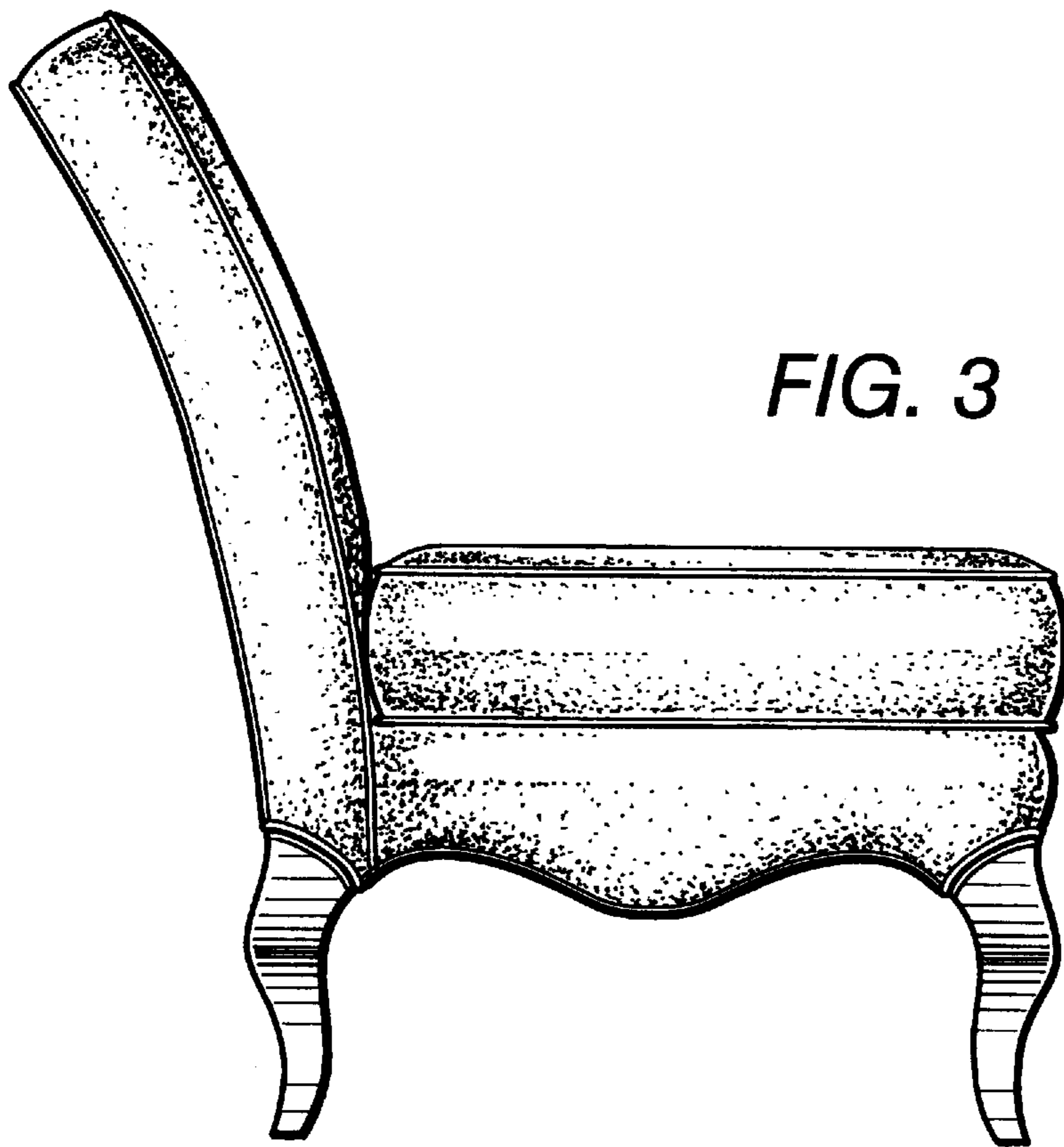

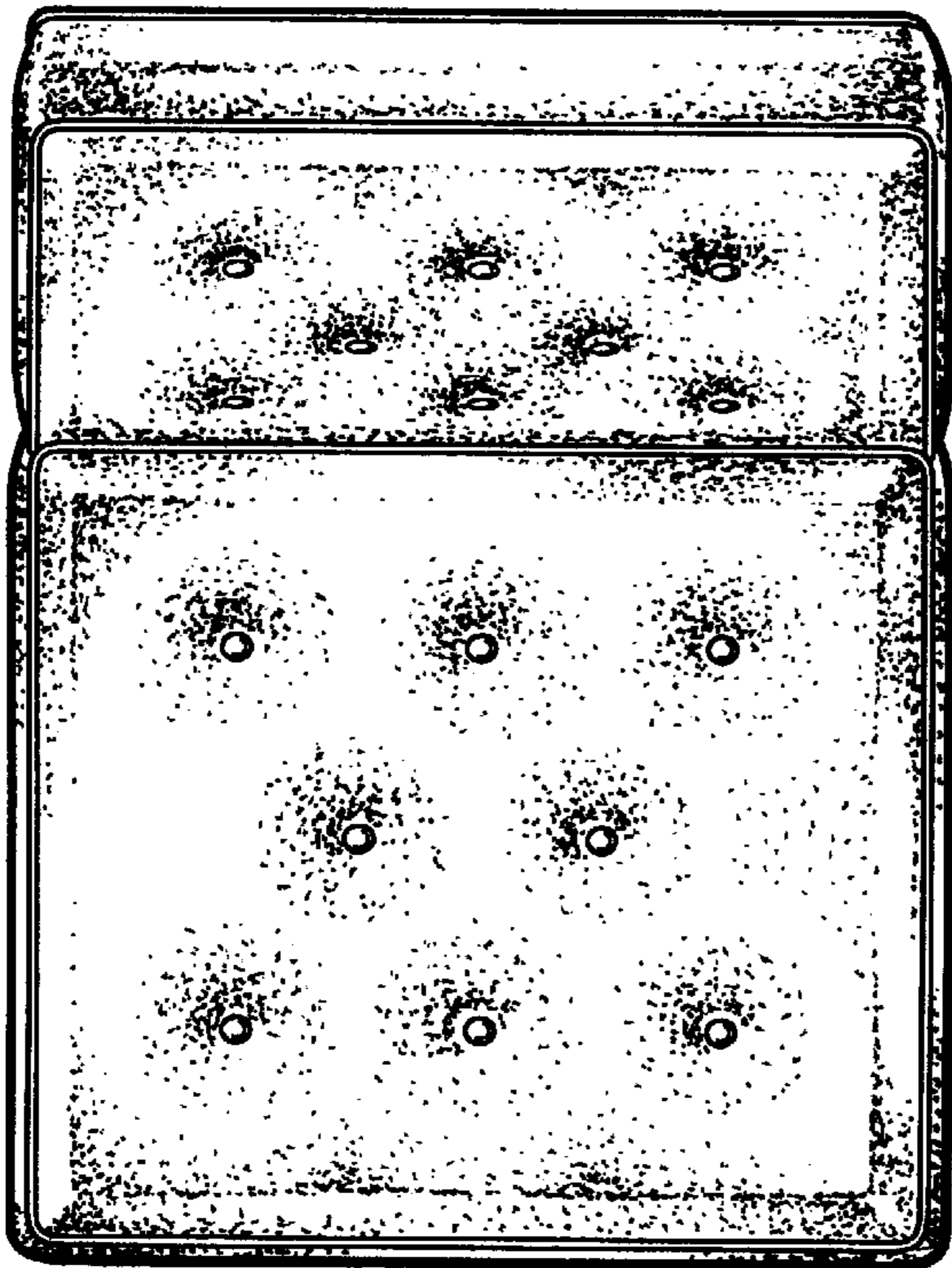
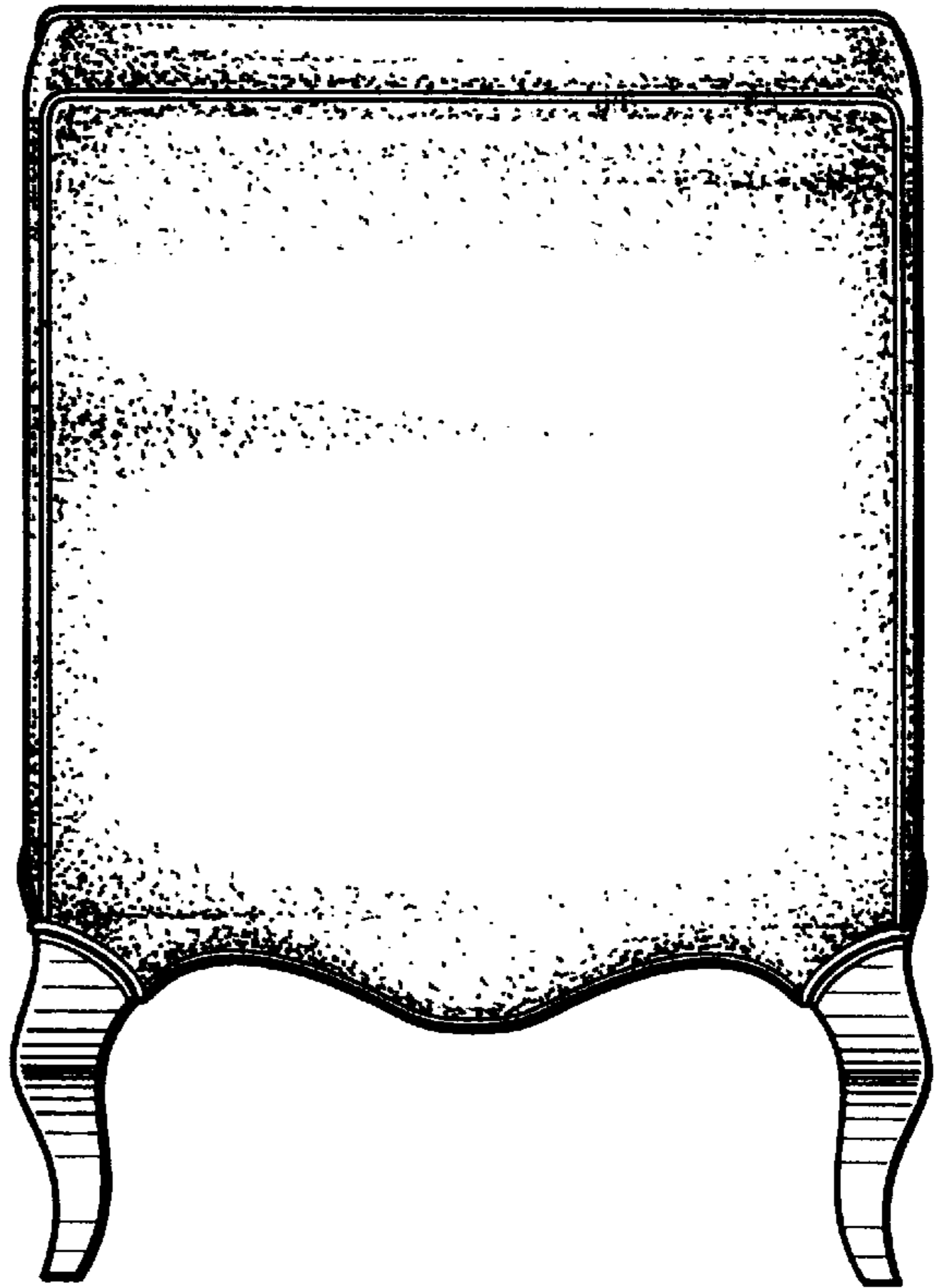
