(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bicycle saddle, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top view of a first embodiment of a bicycle saddle according to the invention;

FIG. 2. is a left side elevation view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a bicycle saddle according to the invention;

FIG. 8 is a left side elevation view of the saddle shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 10. is a rear elevation view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a bottom view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 12 is a right side elevation view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 7;

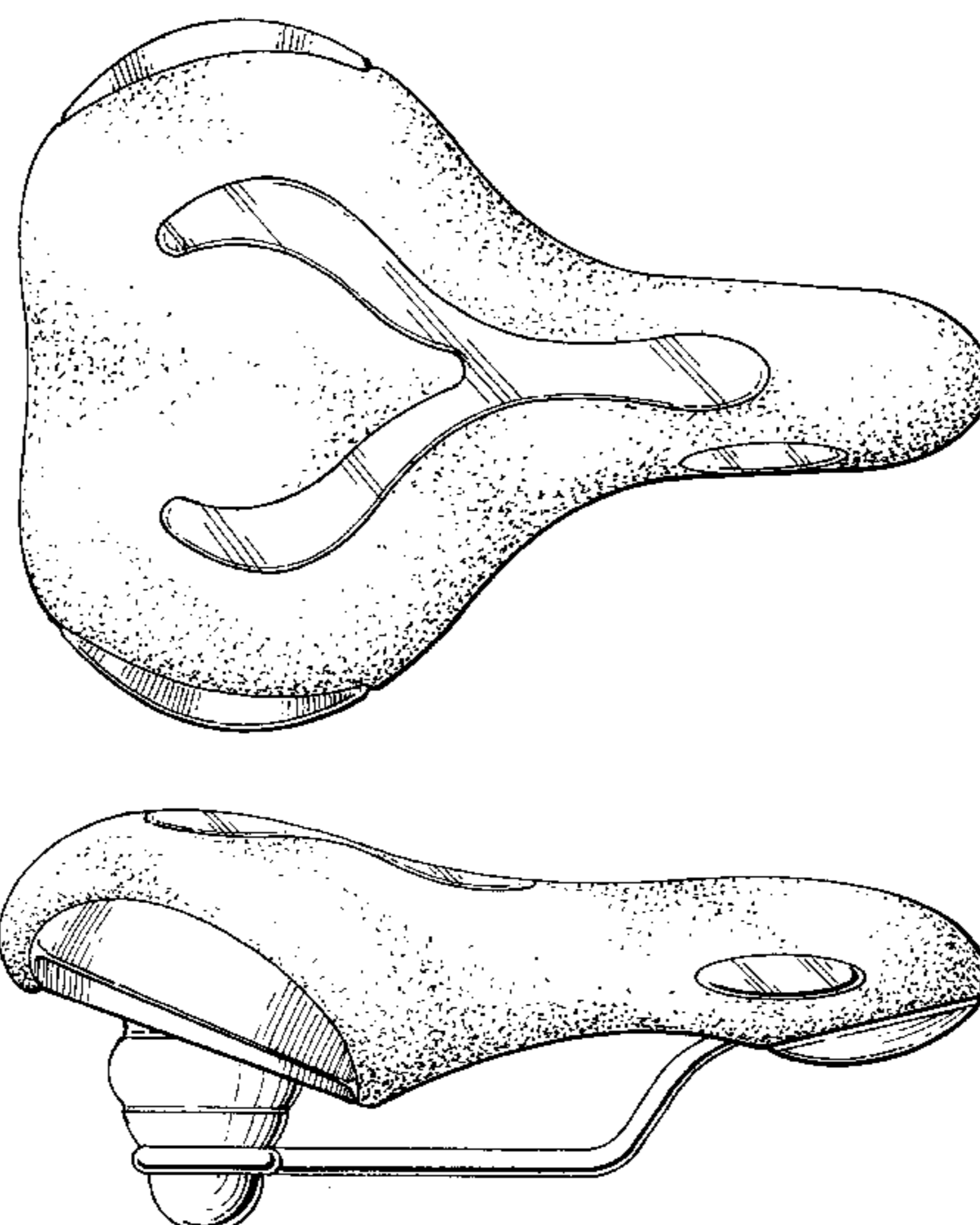
FIG. 13 is a rear elevation view of a third embodiment of a bicycle saddle according to the invention; and,

FIG. 14 is a bottom view of the bicycle saddle shown in FIG. 13.

The top, front and right side views of the third embodiment are the same as in the first and second embodiments.

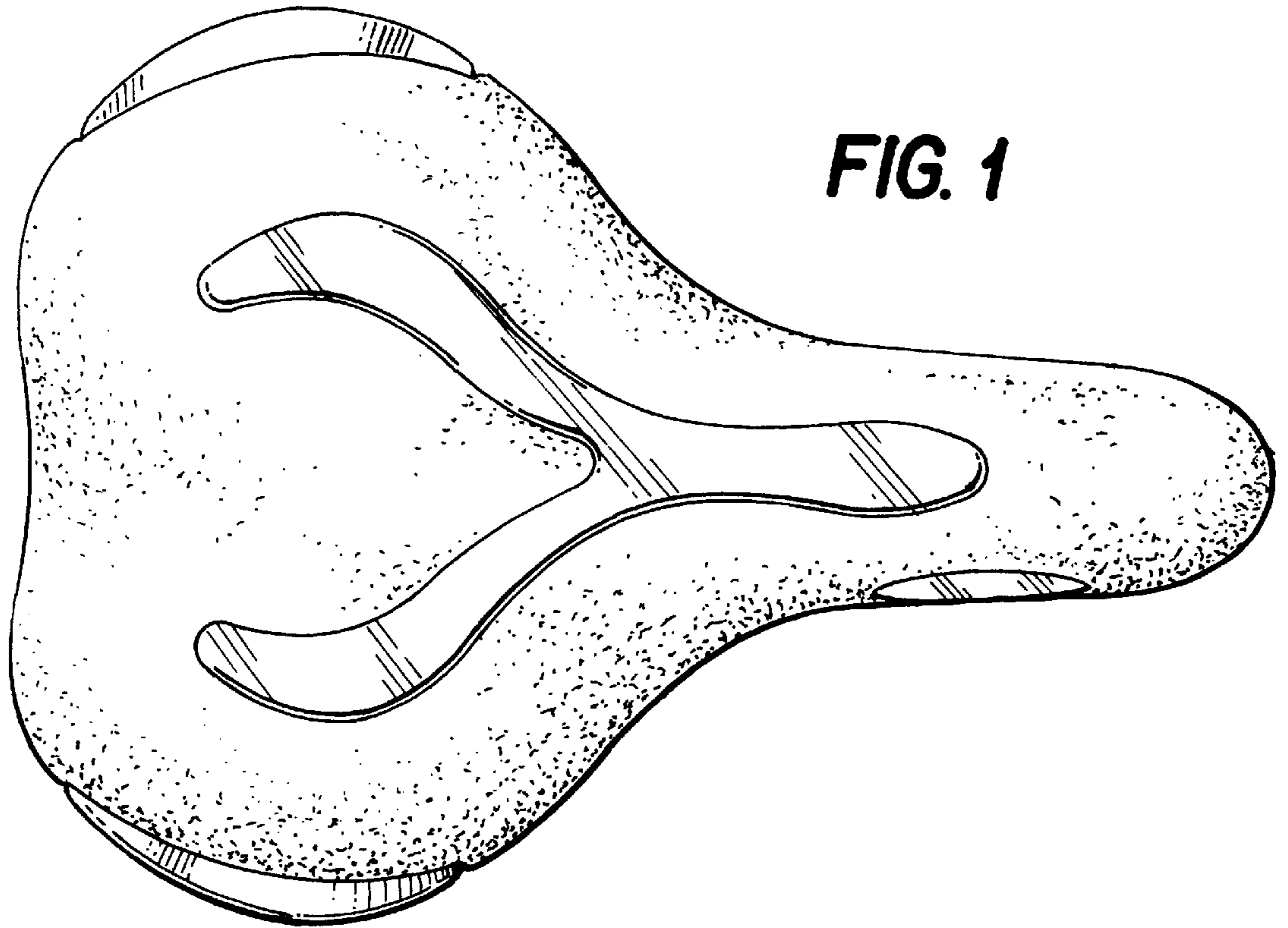
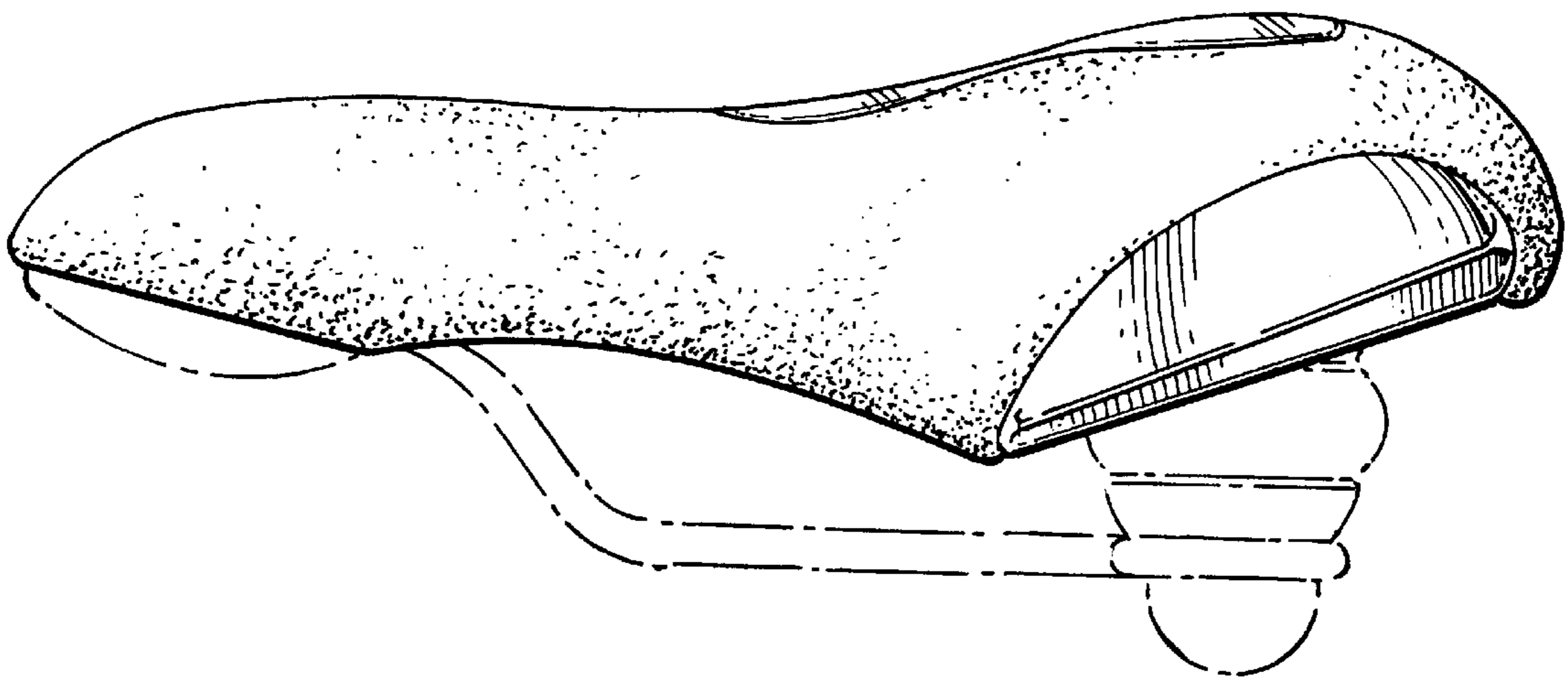

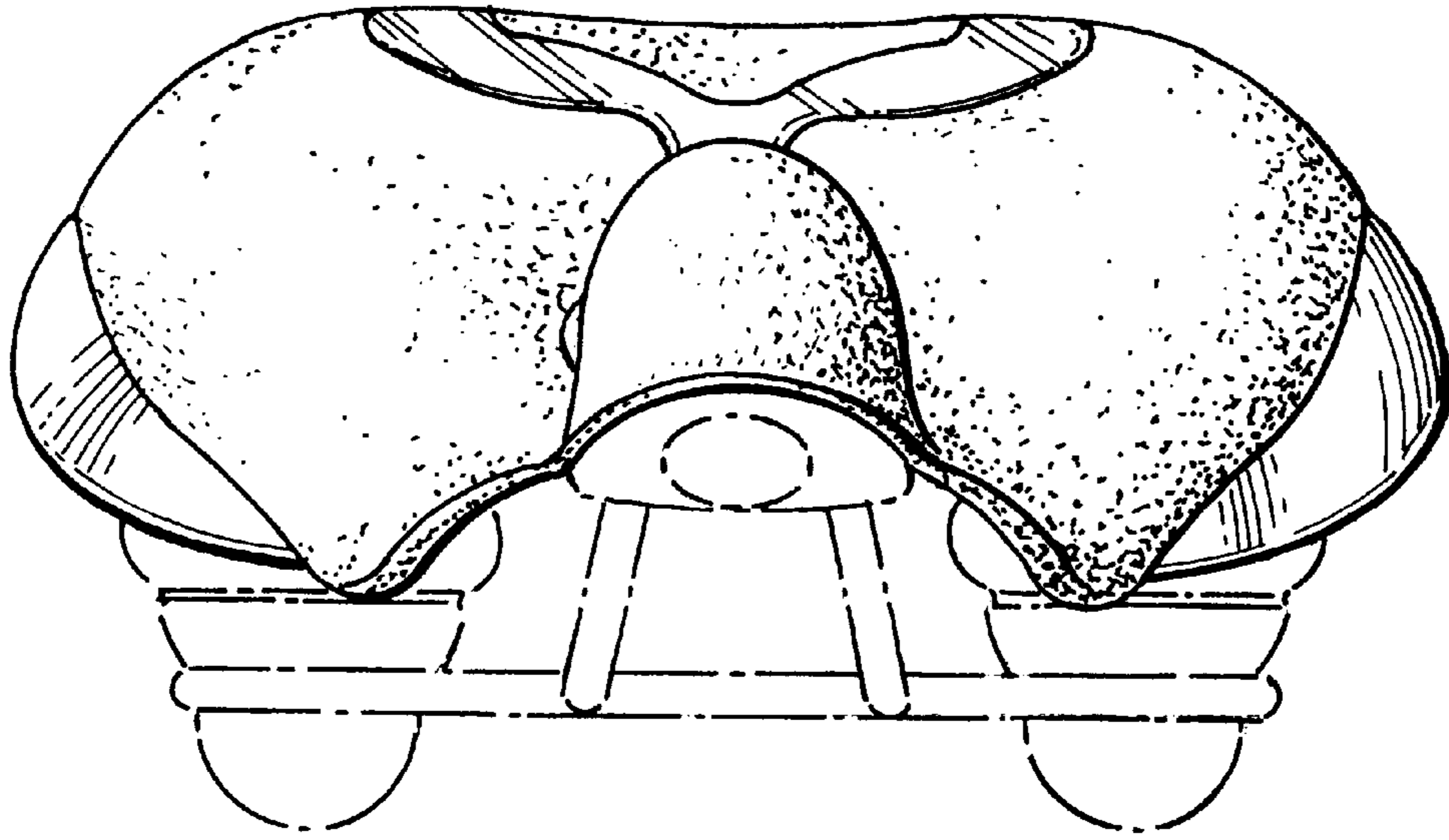

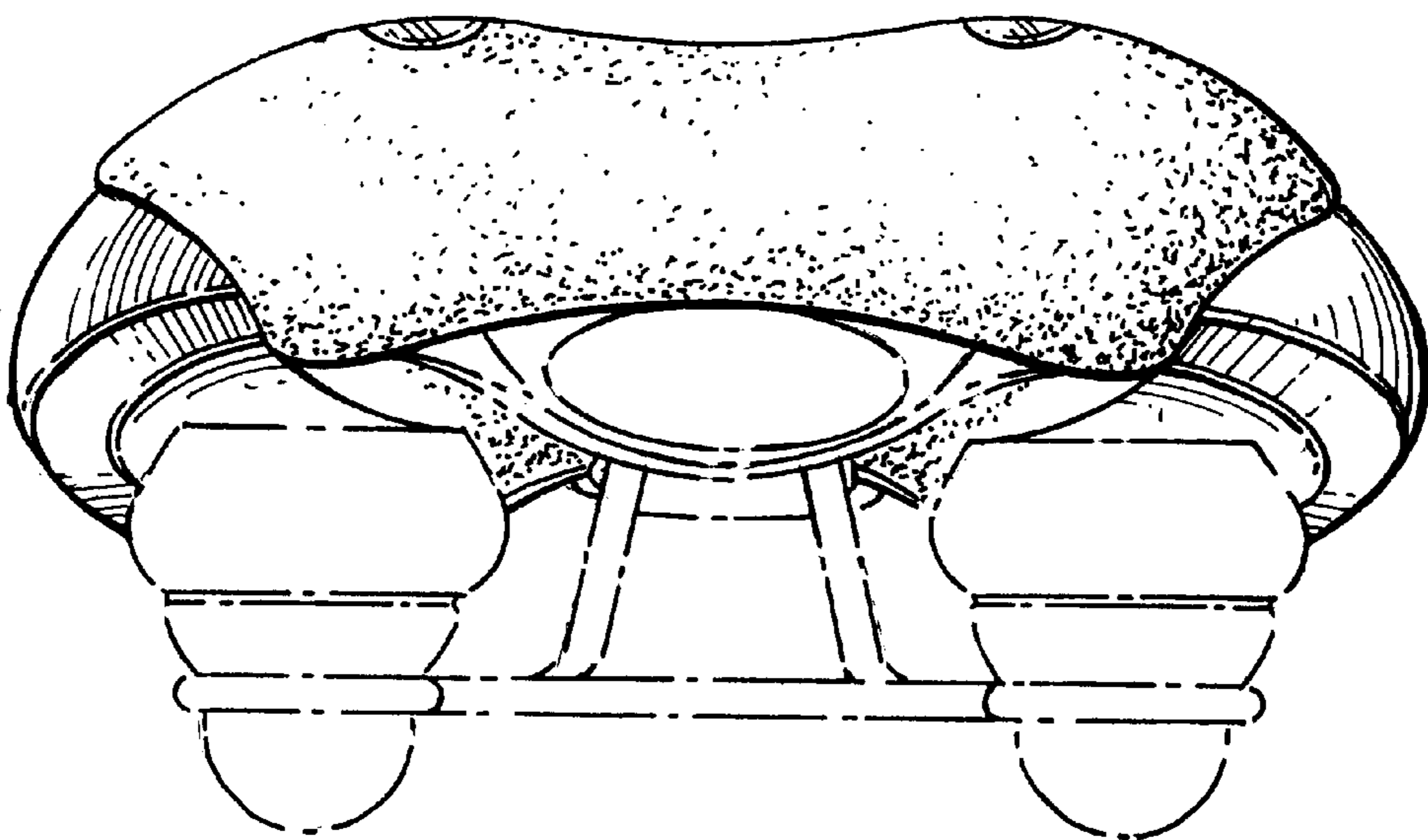

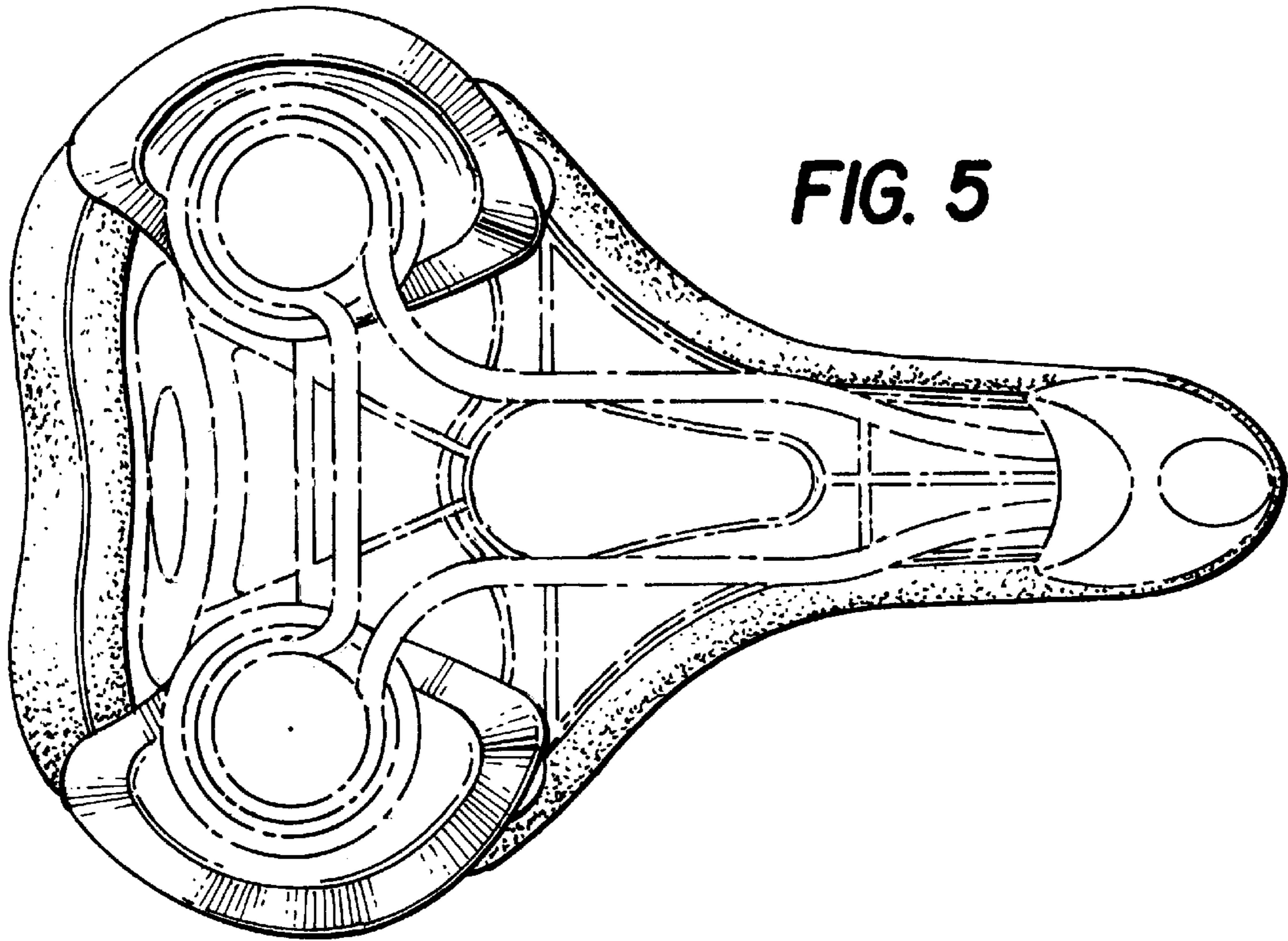
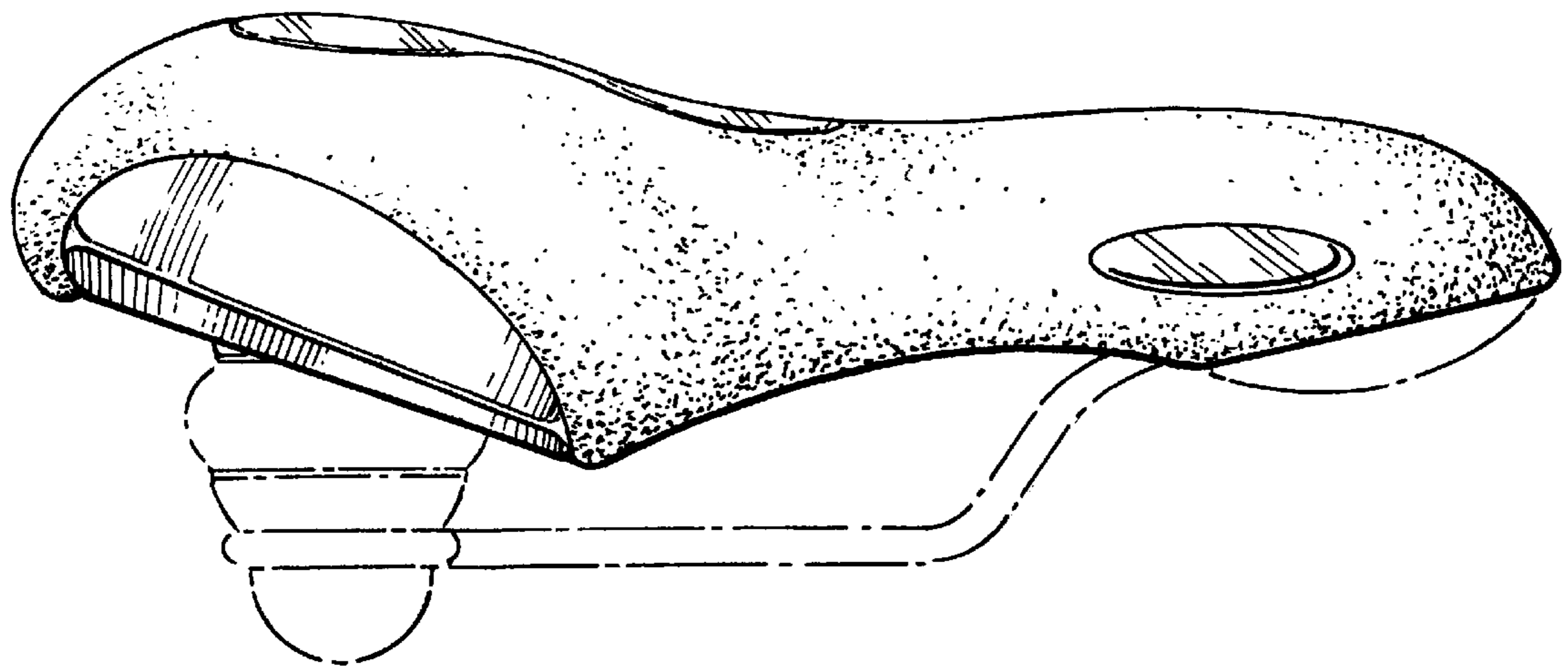

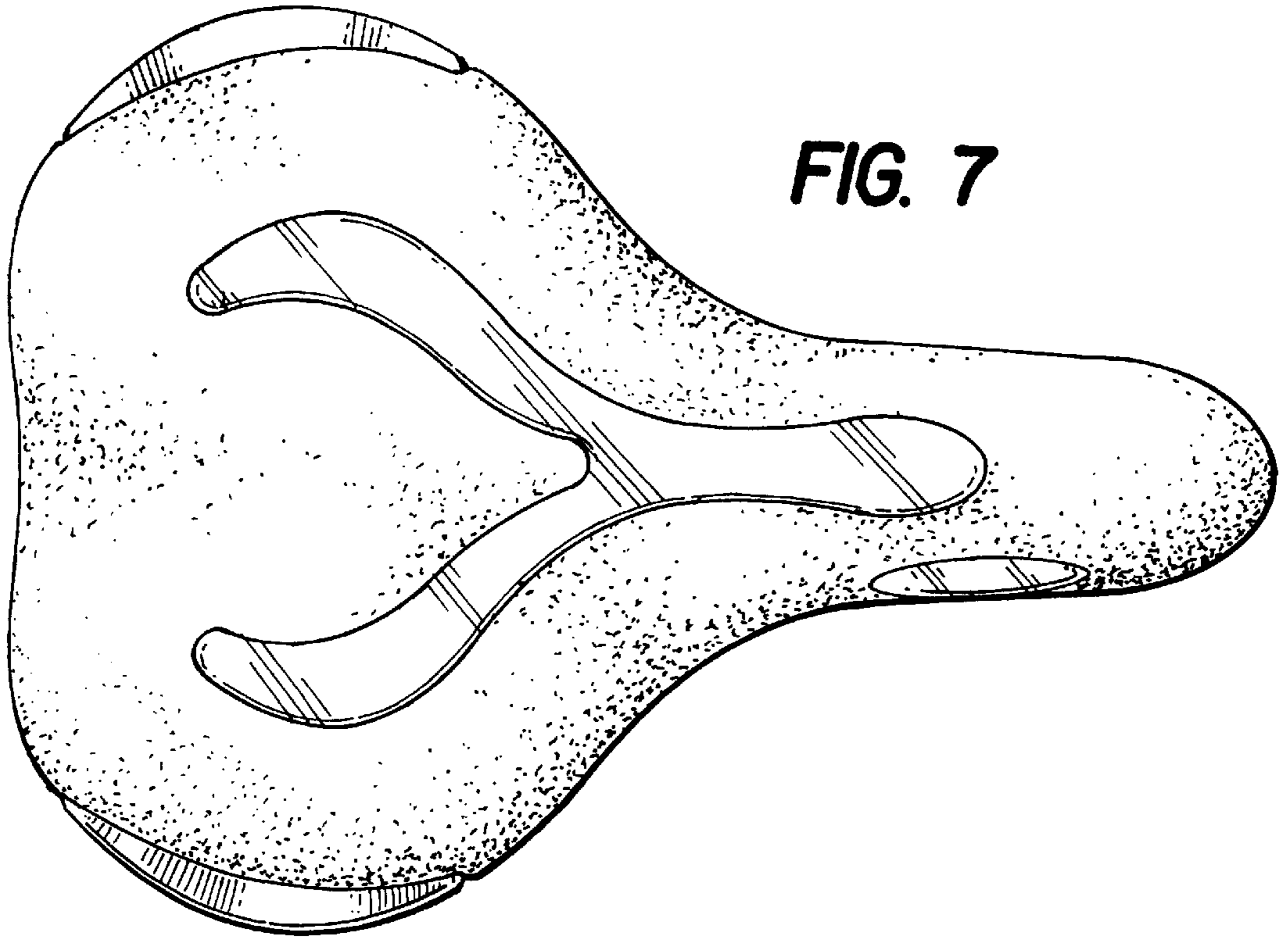

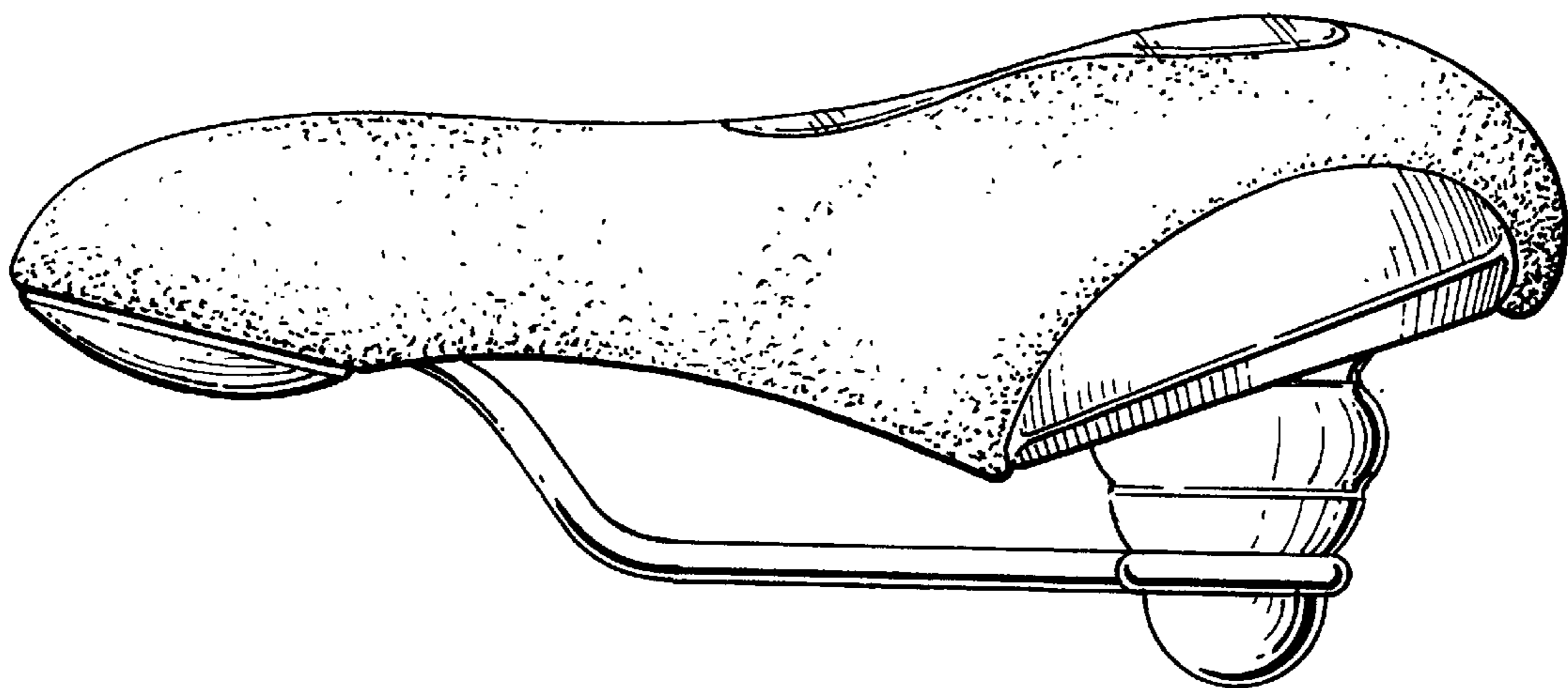

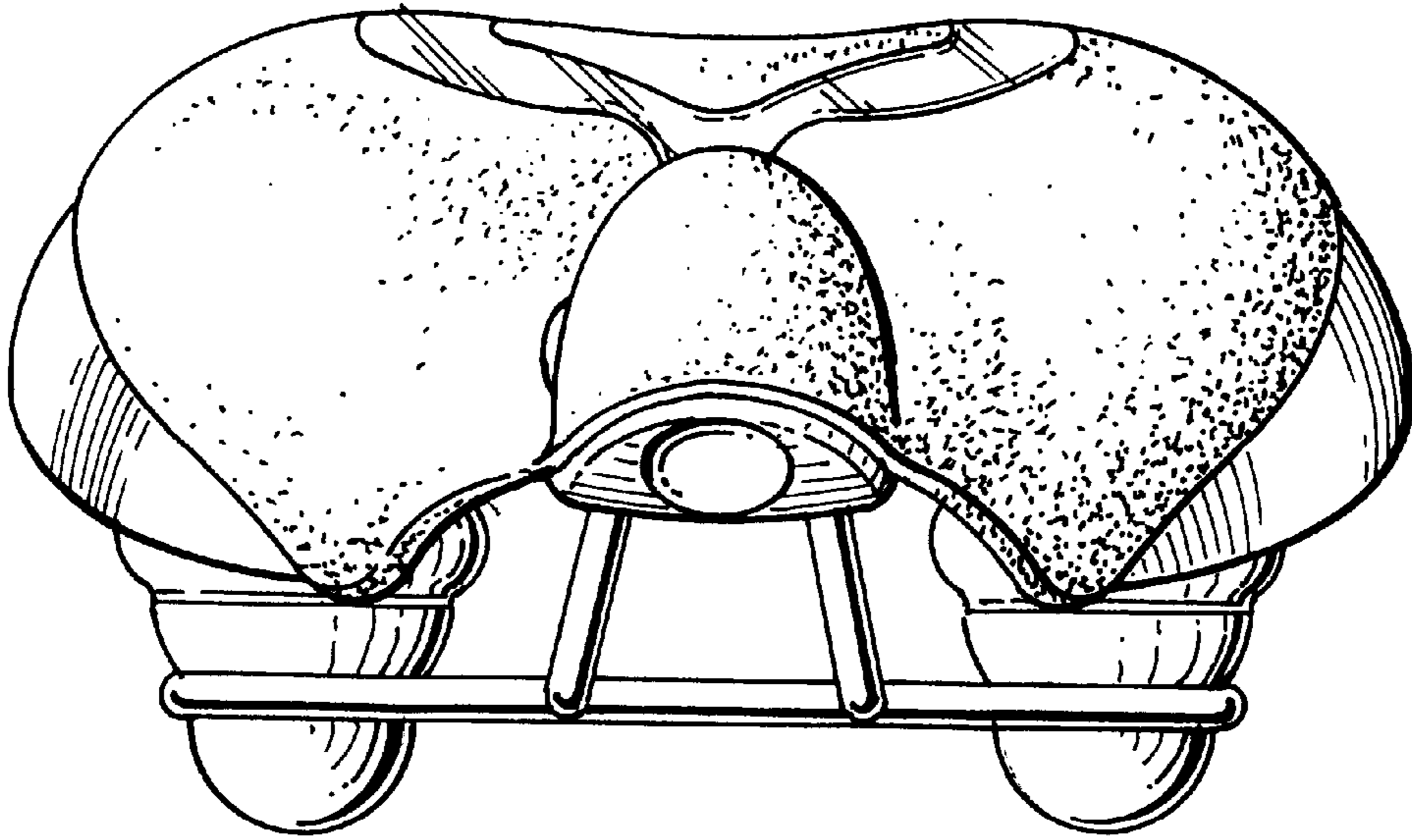

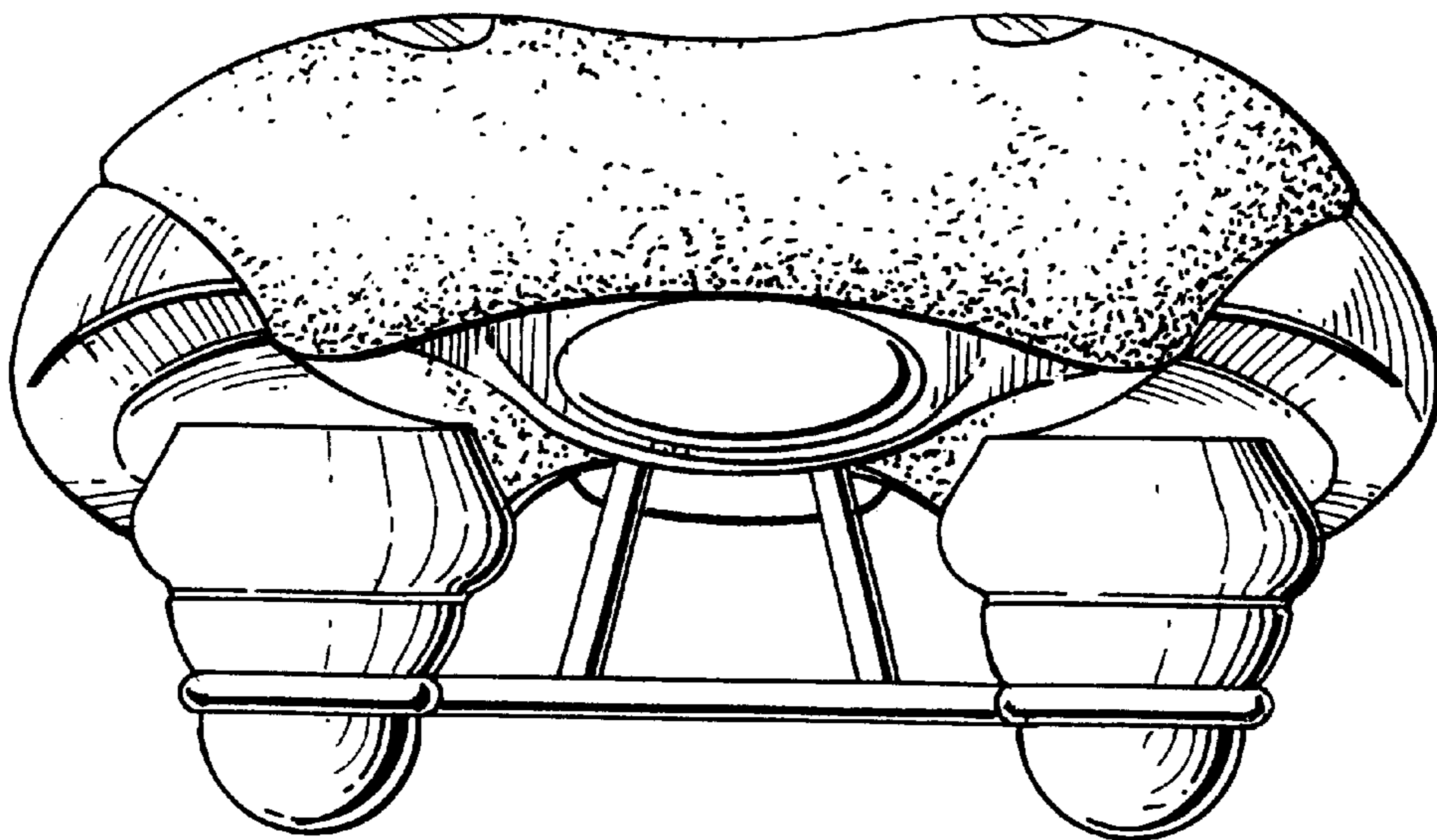

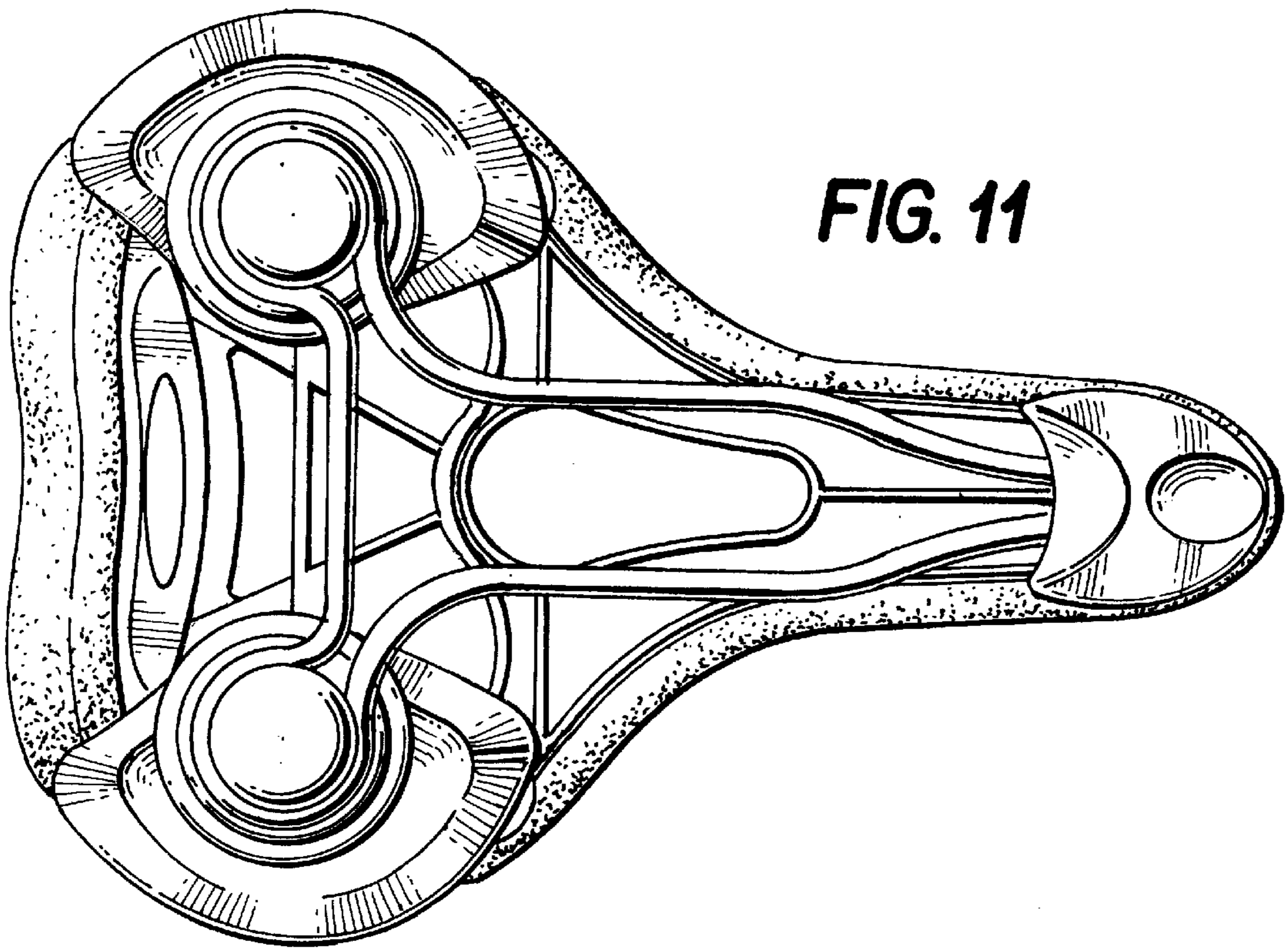
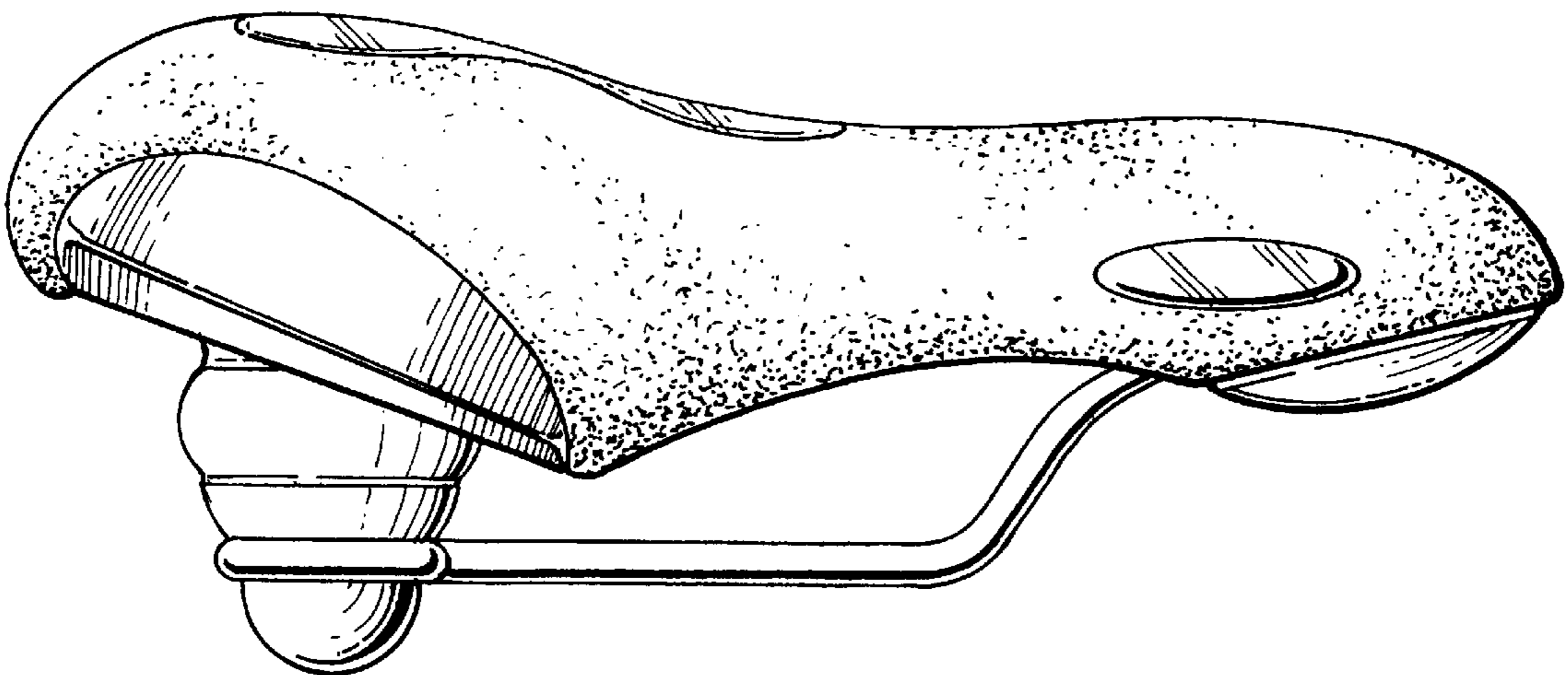

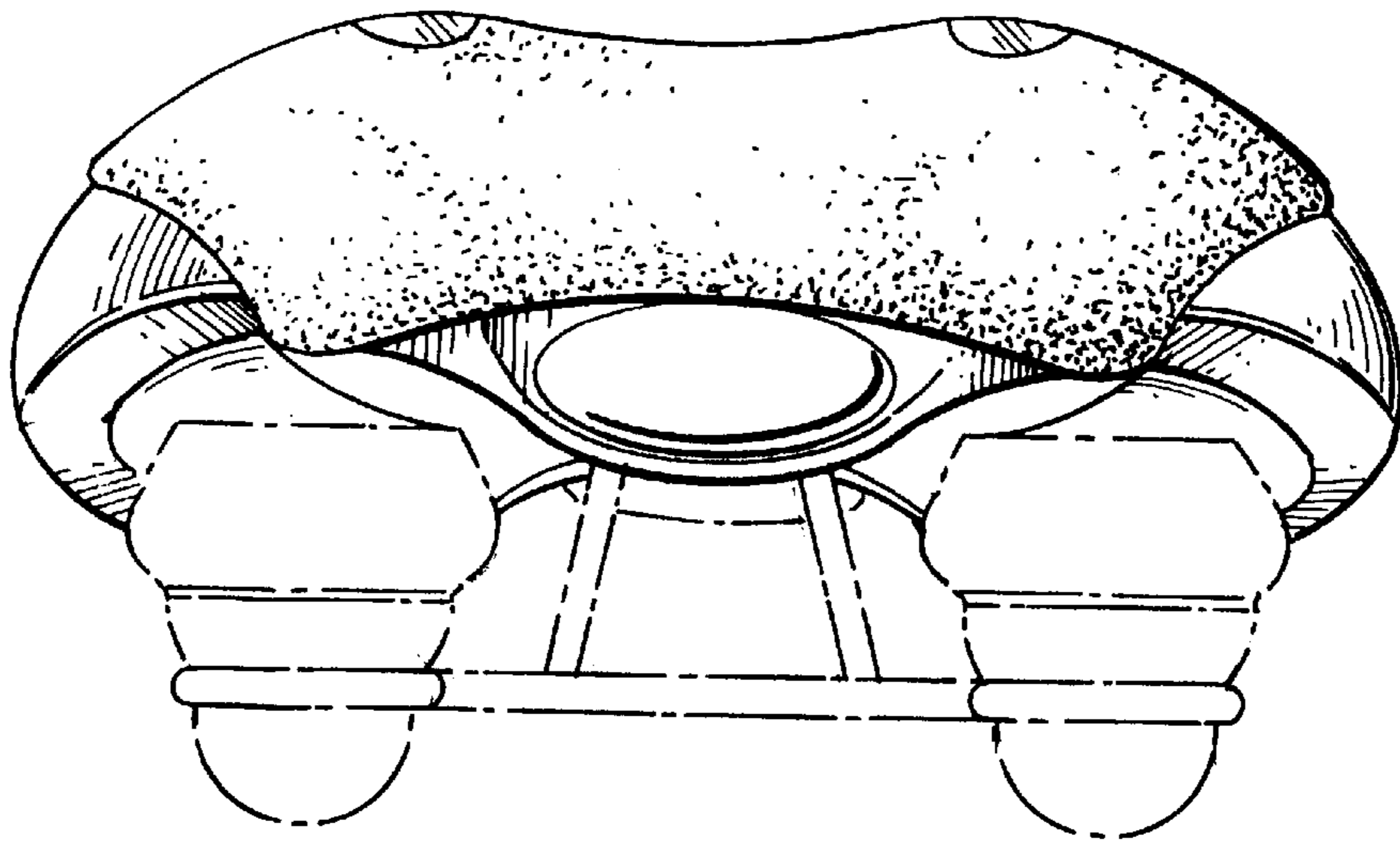

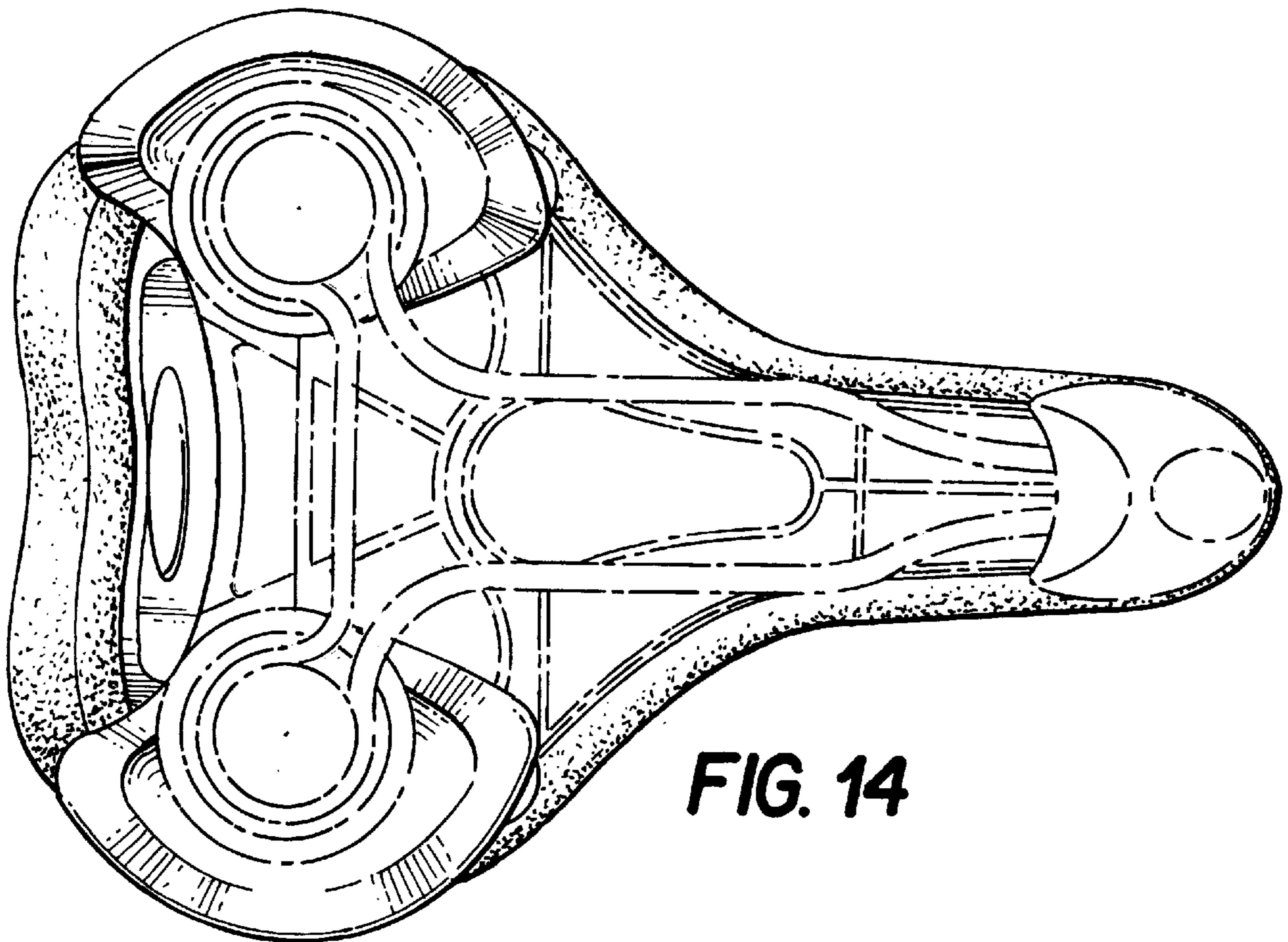
