new design;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

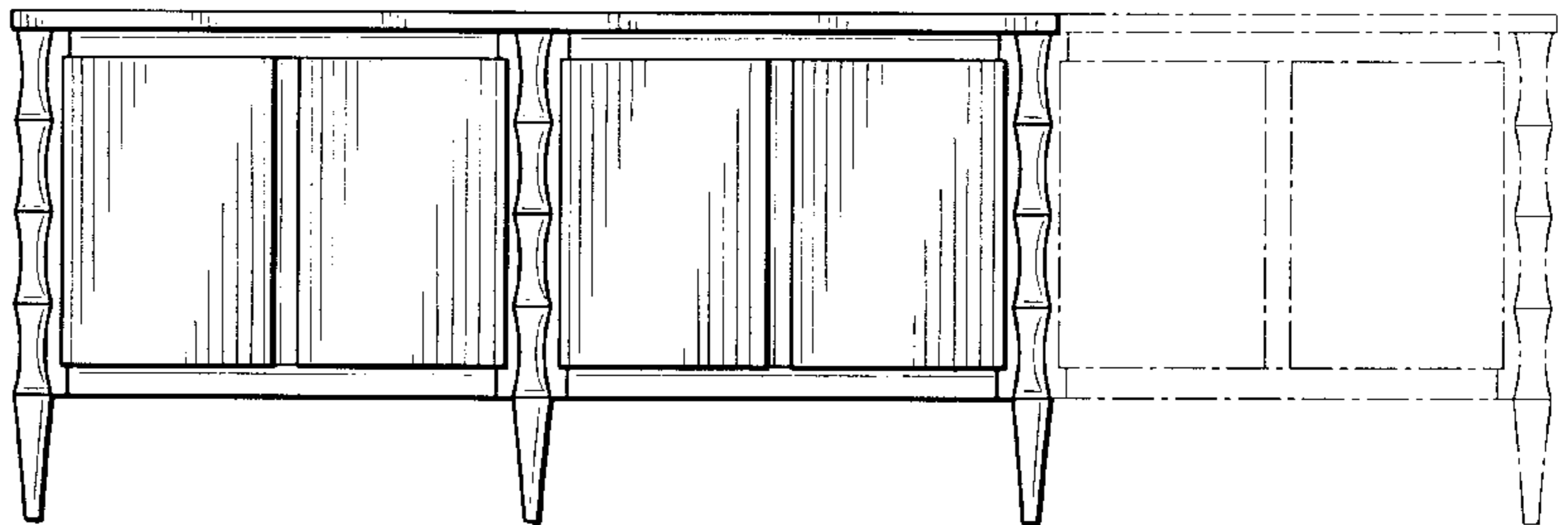
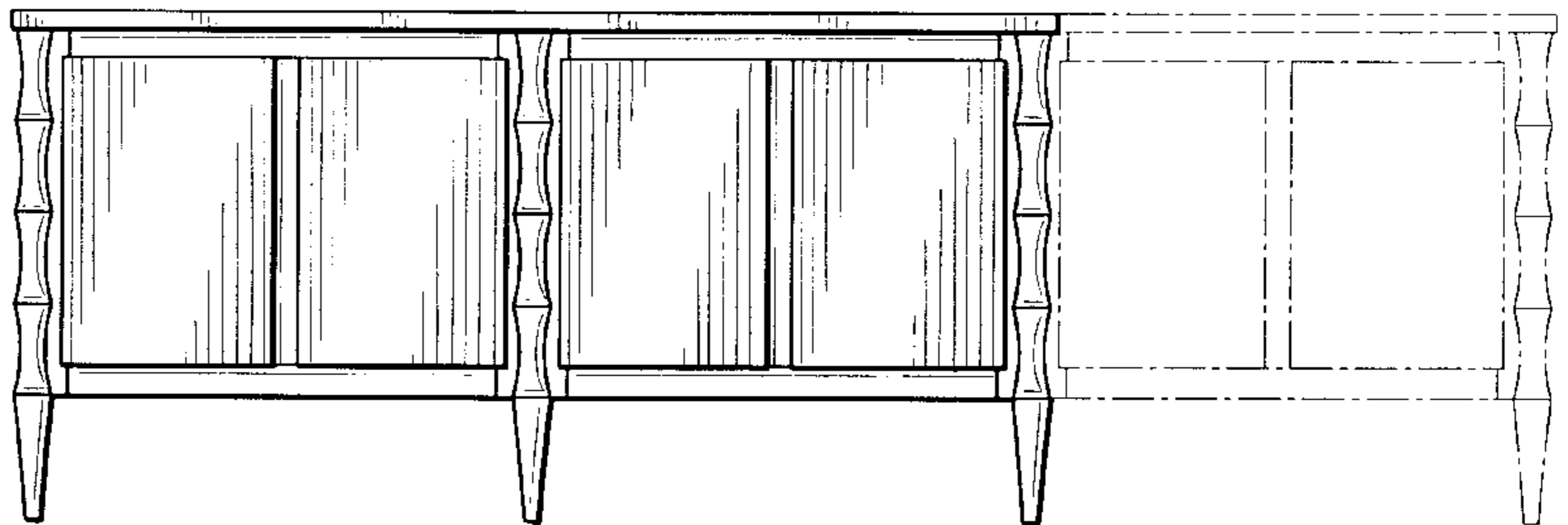
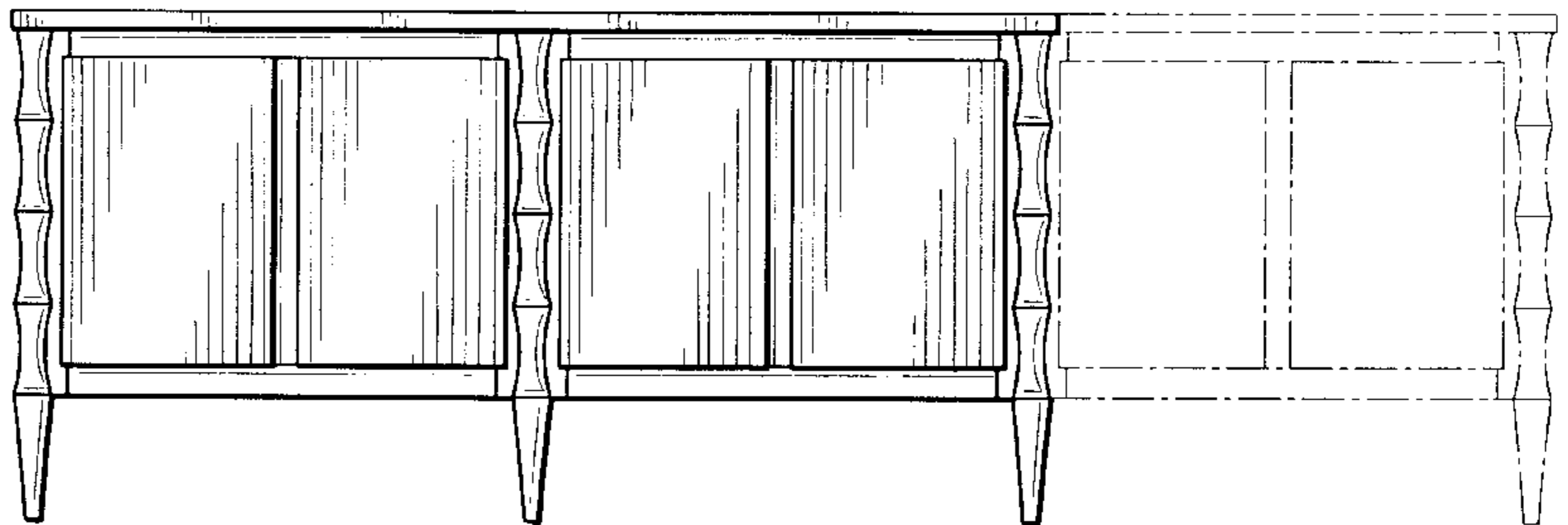
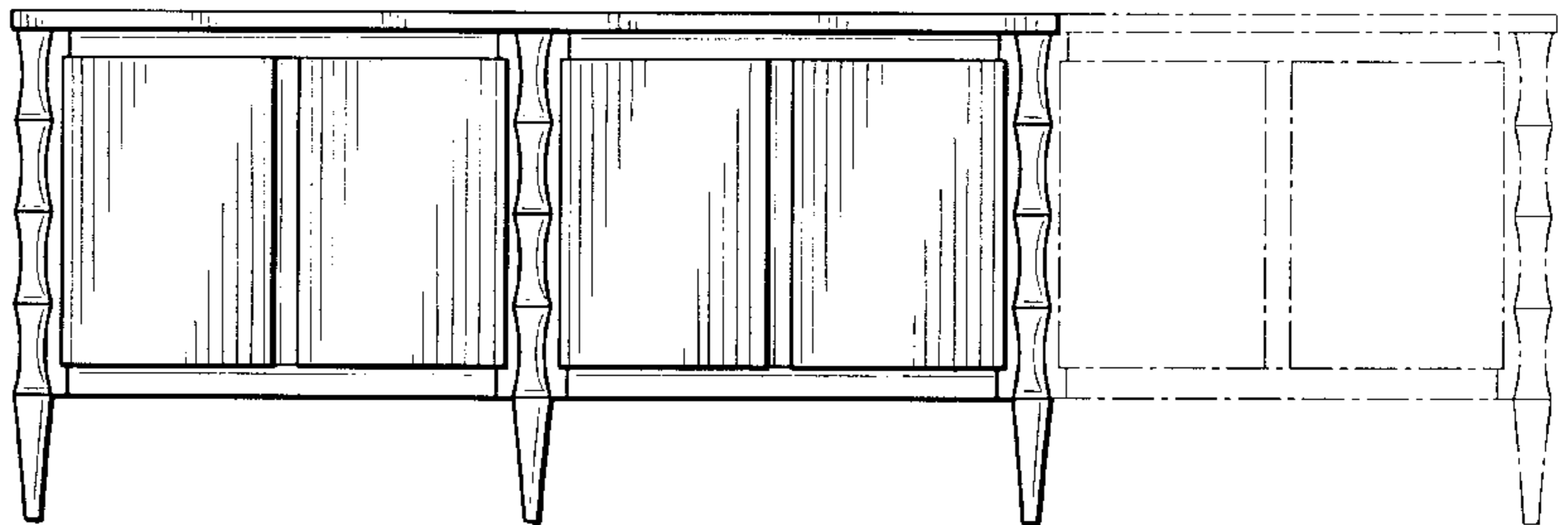
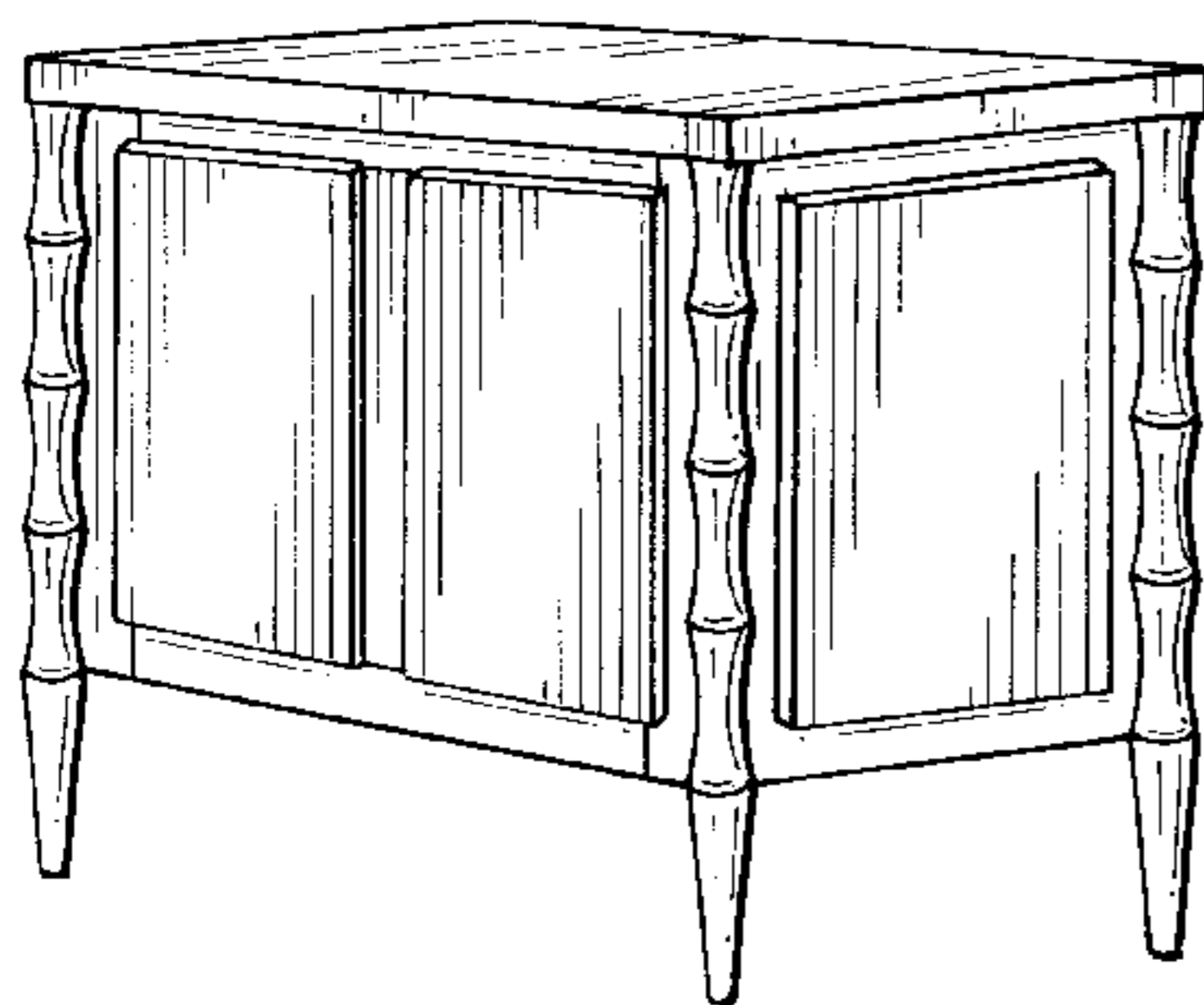
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side

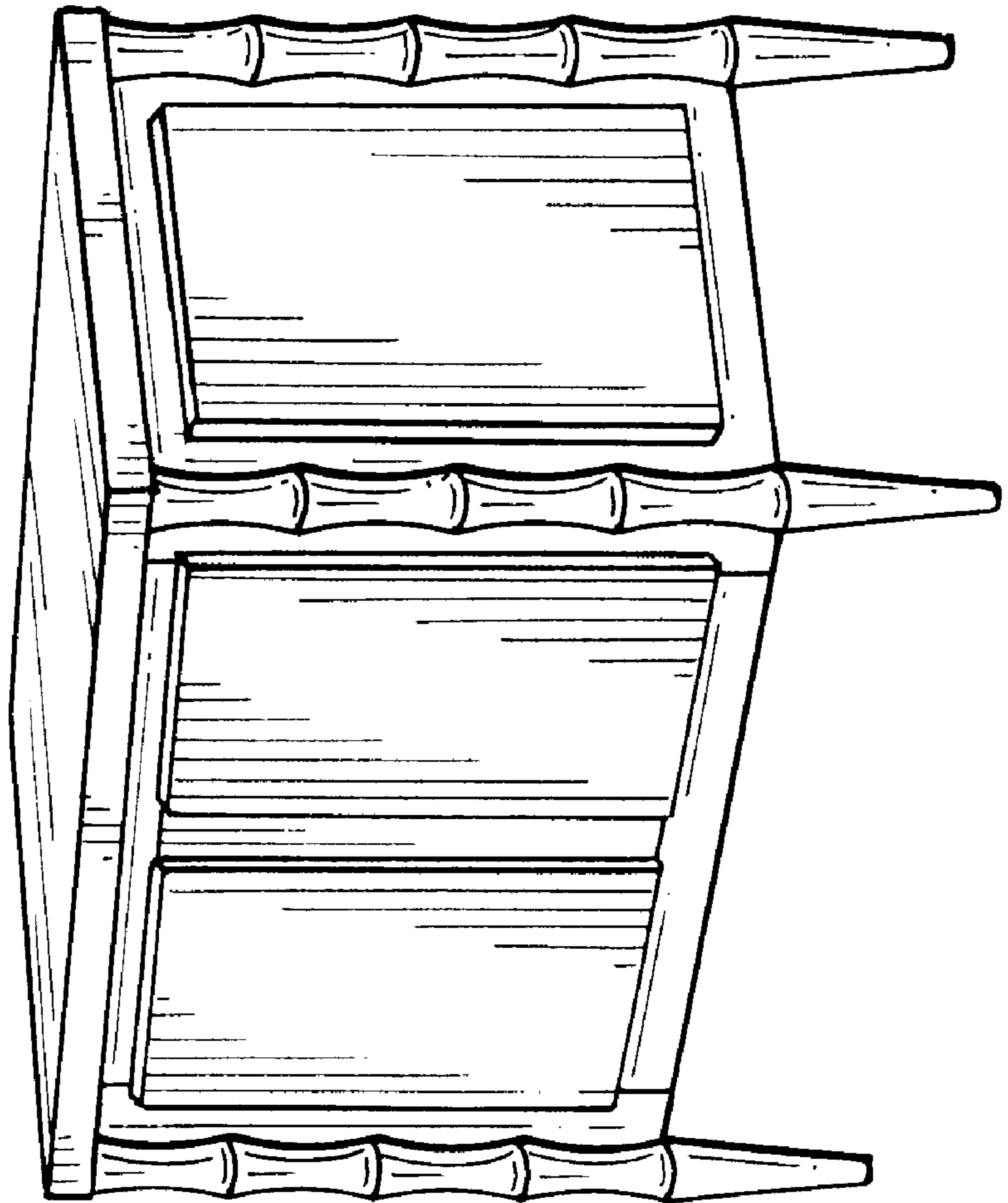

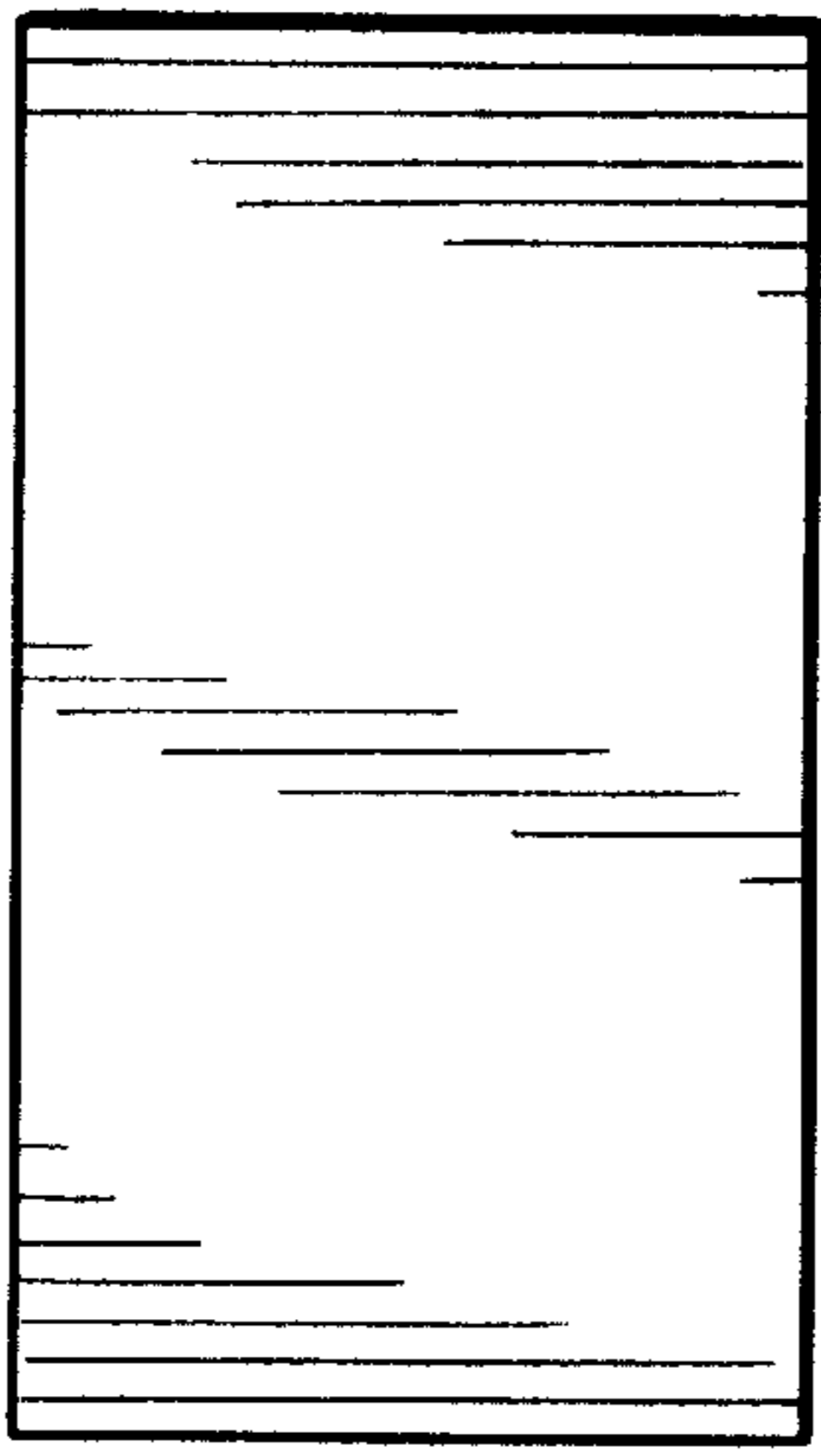

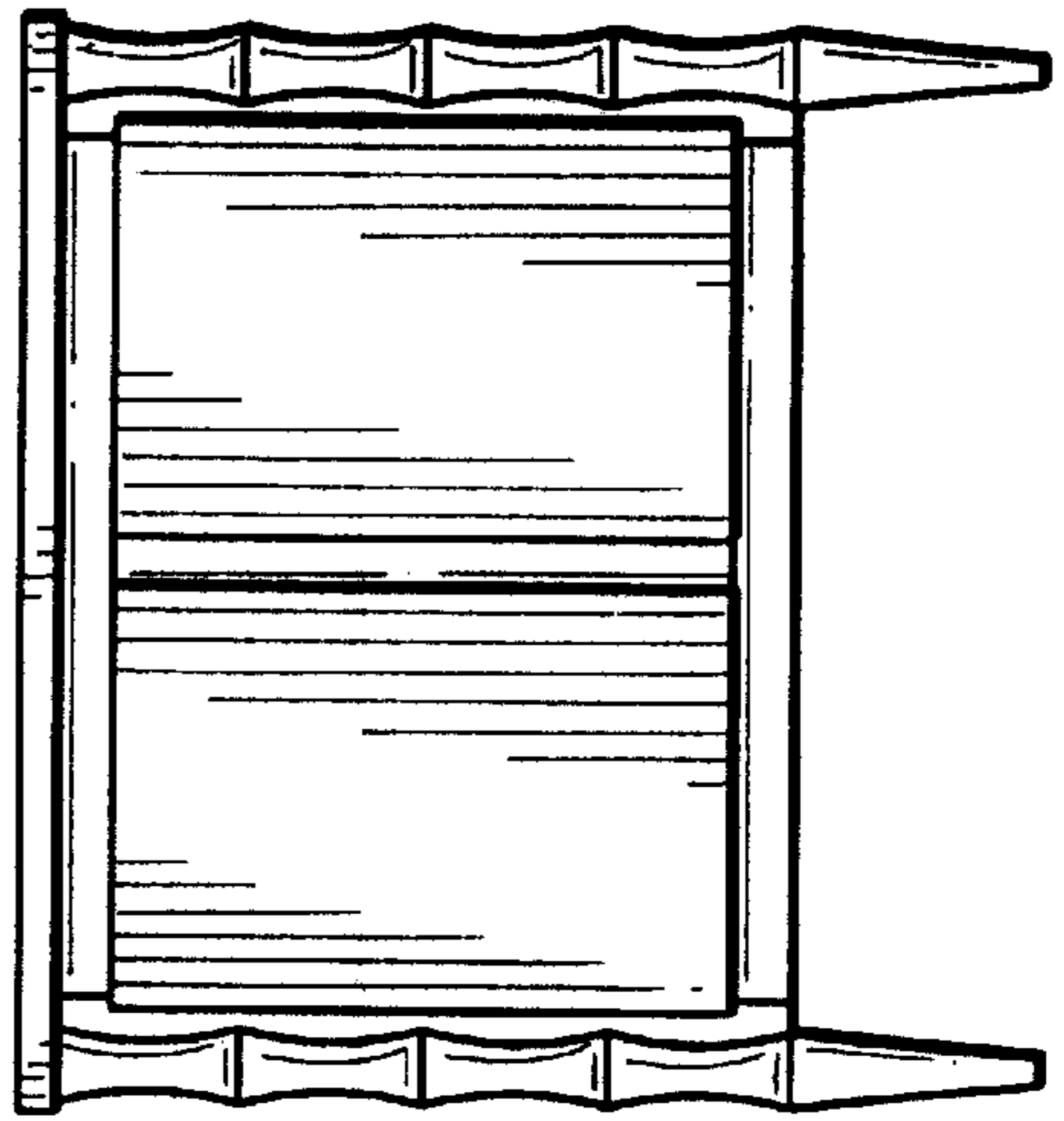
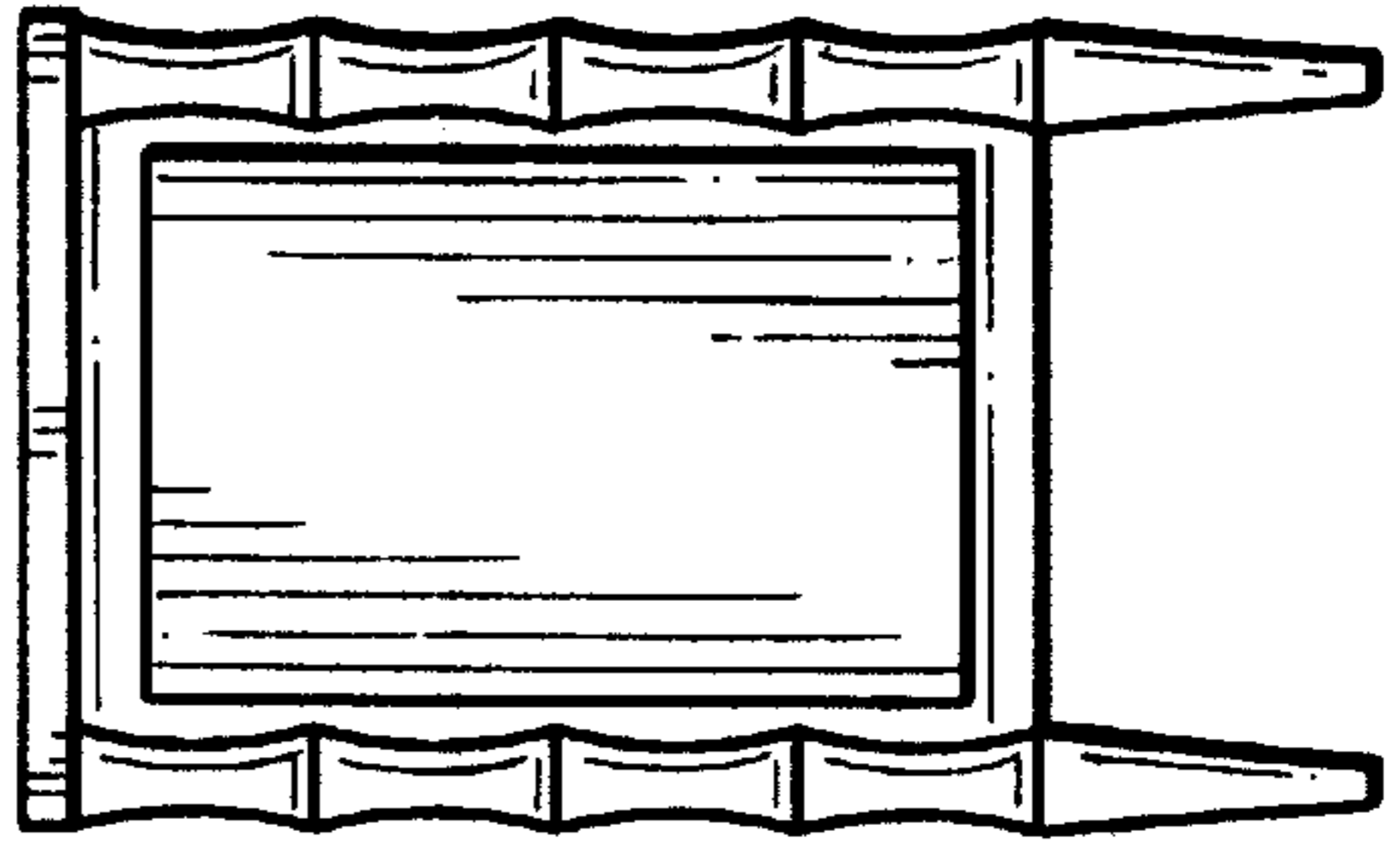

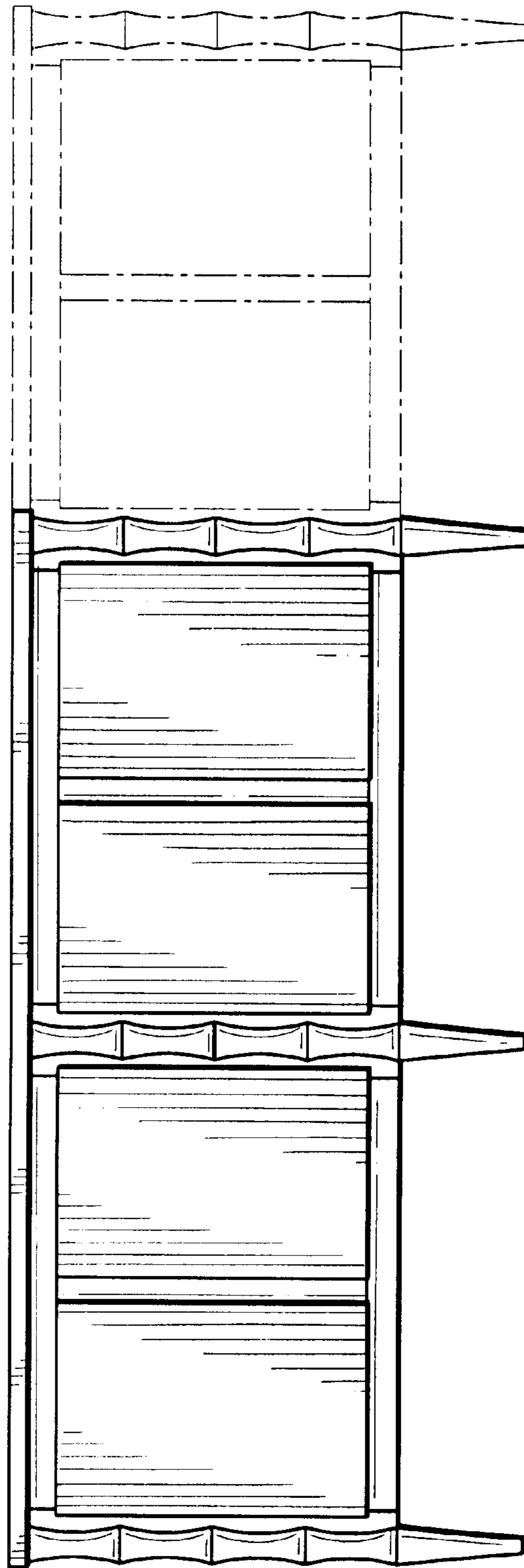
