(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a novelty gift package, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the novelty gift package;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package from the side opposite to that of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package seen in FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package seen in FIGS. 1–3;

FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 1–4, with the opposite left-side elevation view being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is an under-side view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 1–5, showing the bottom of the package;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of another embodiment of a novelty gift package;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIG. 7 from the side opposite to that of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 7 and 9;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 7–9;

FIG. 11 is a right-side elevation view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 7–10, with the opposite left-side elevation view being a mirror image;

FIG. 12 is an under-side view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 7–11, showing the bottom of the package;

FIG. 13 is a perspective view of yet another embodiment of the novelty gift package;

FIG. 14 is a perspective view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIG. 13 from the side opposite to that of FIG. 13;

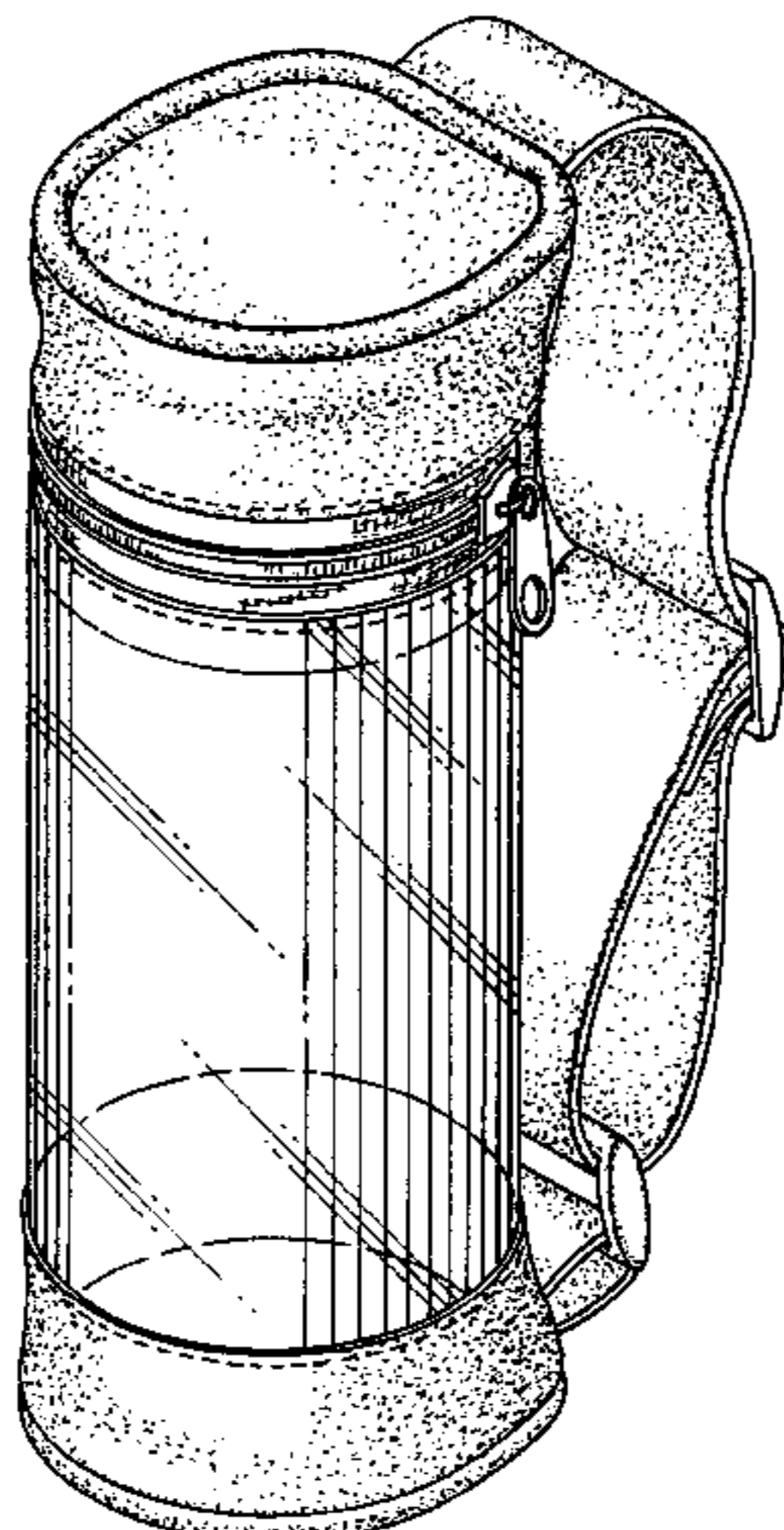
FIG. 15 is a front elevation view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 13 and 14;

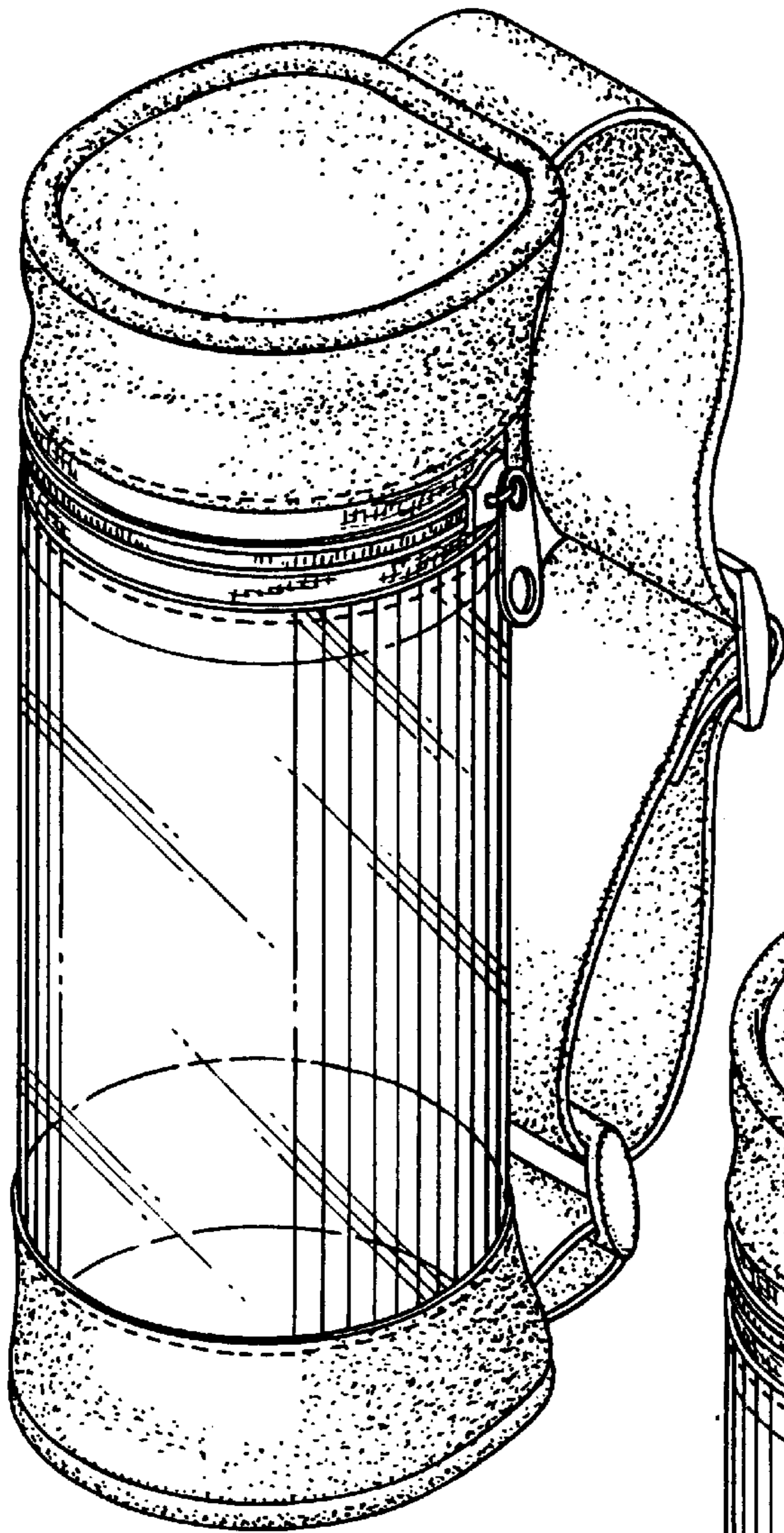
FIG. 16 is a top plan view of the embodiment of the novelty gift package of FIGS. 13–15;

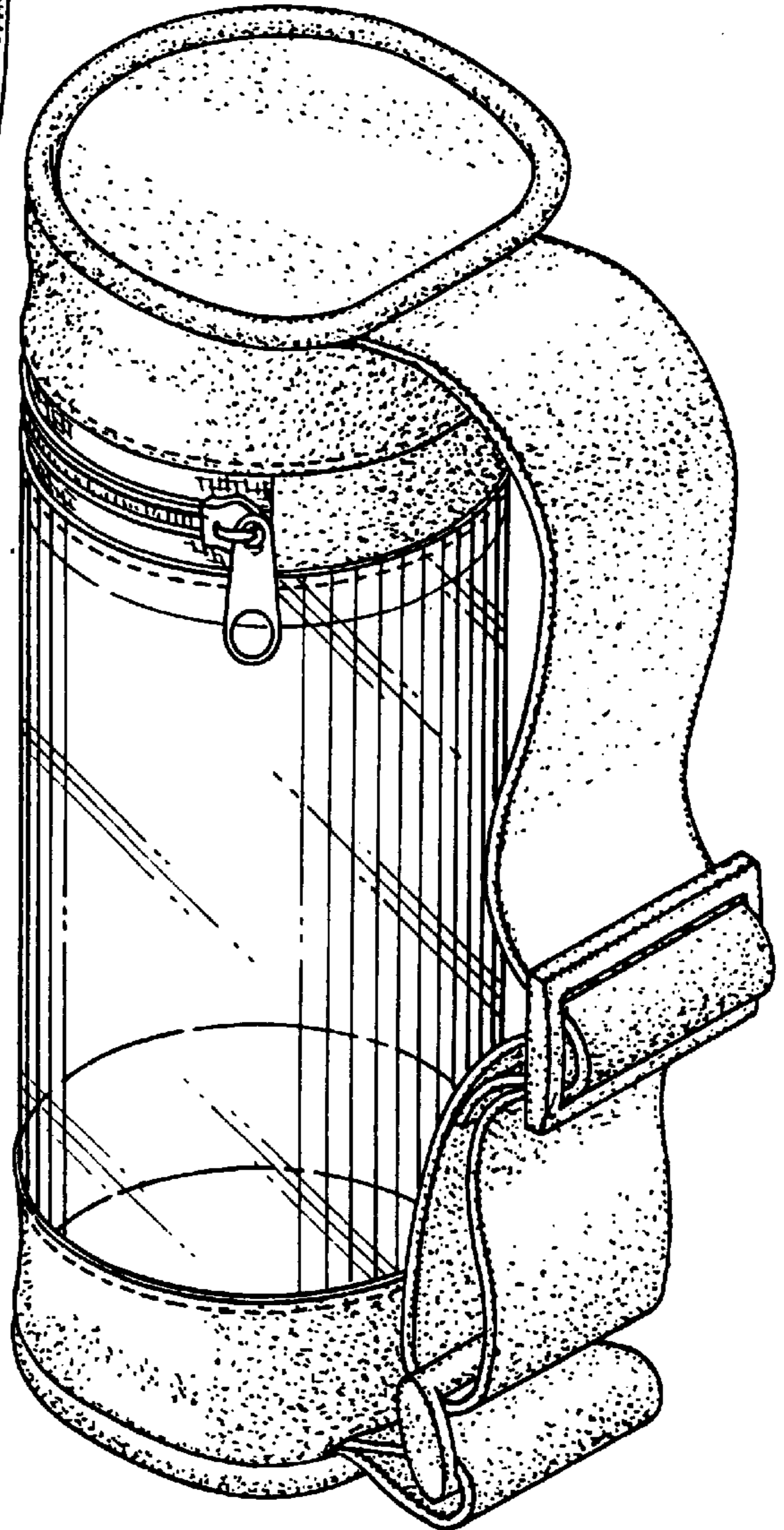

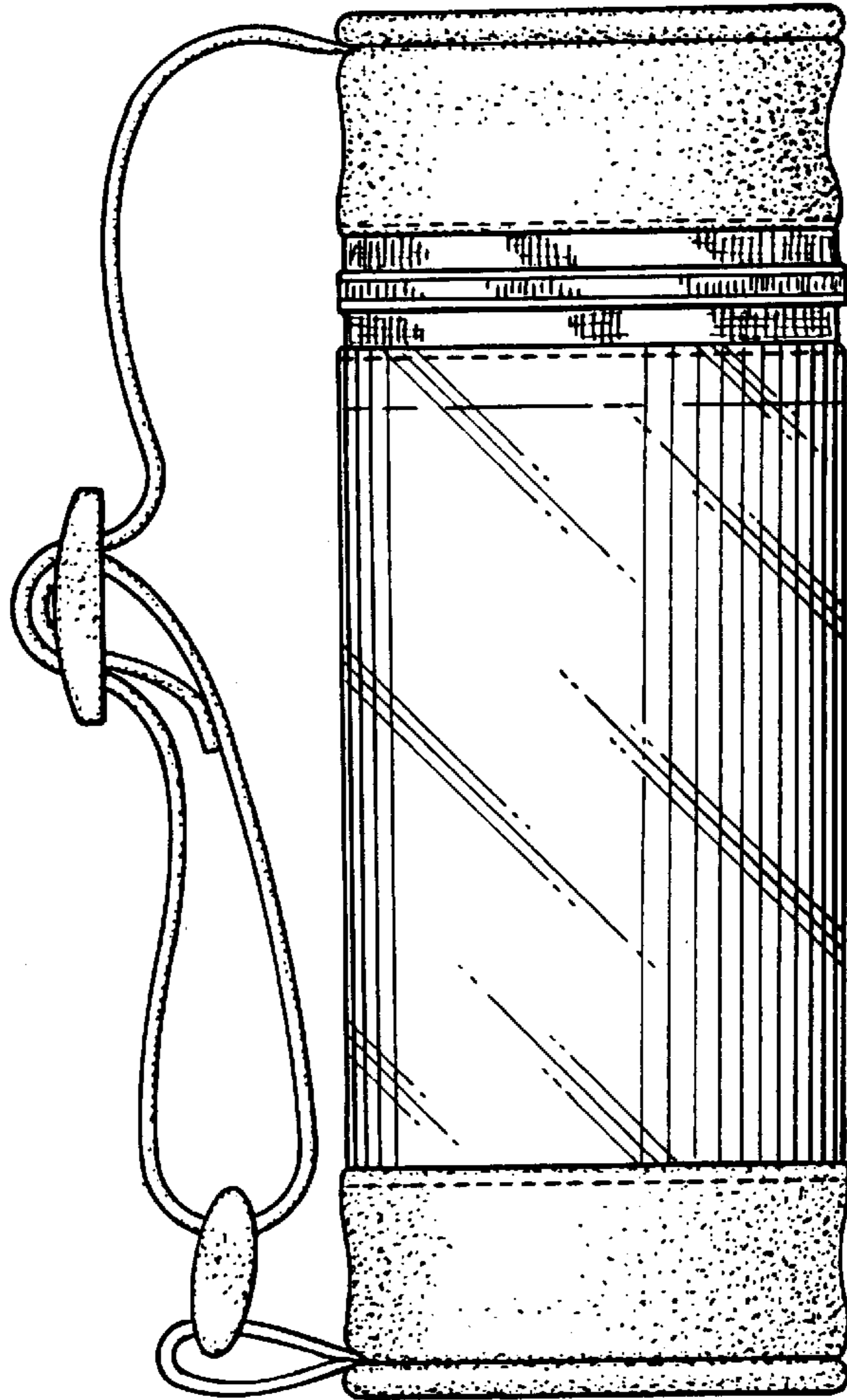
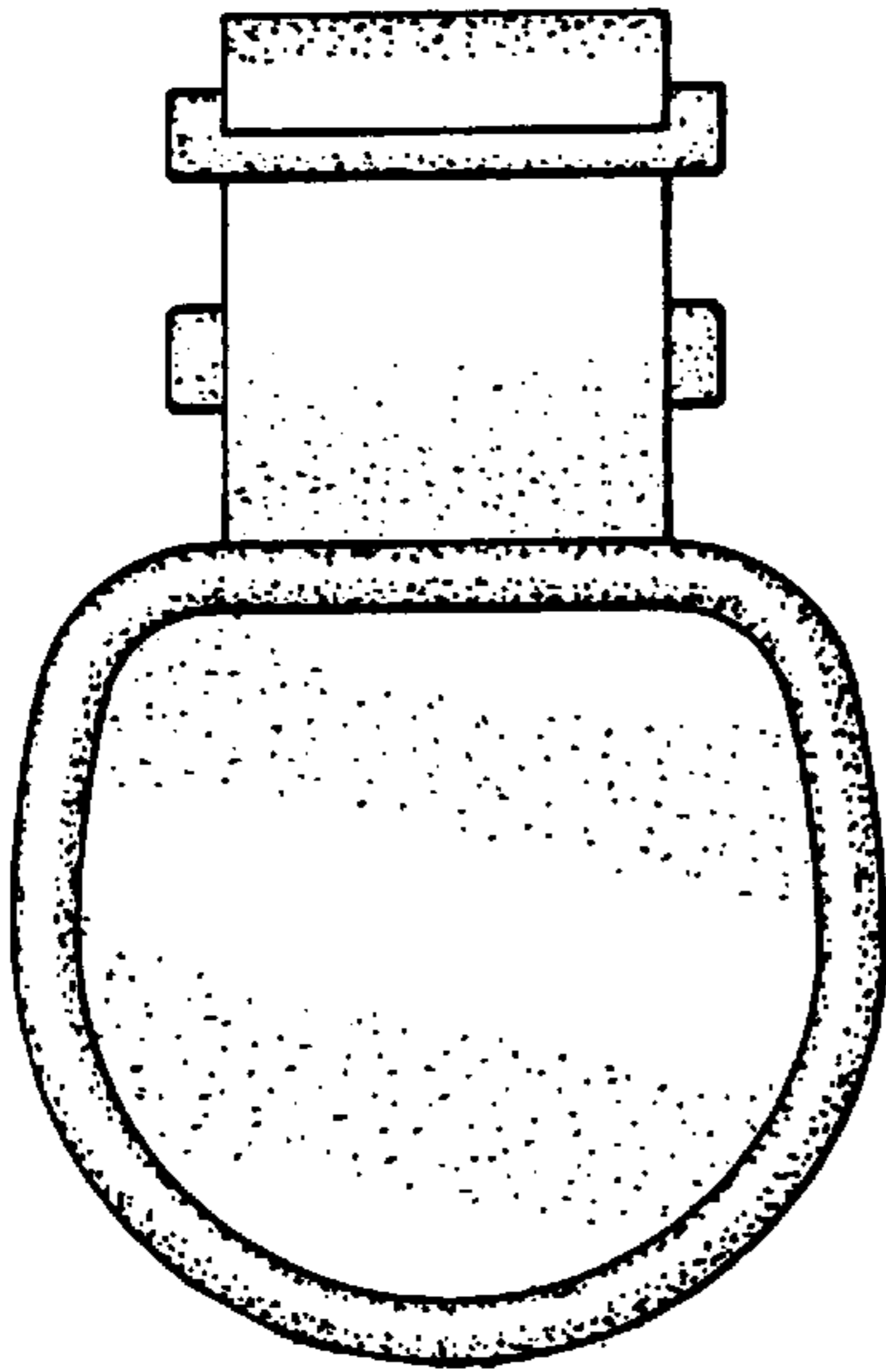

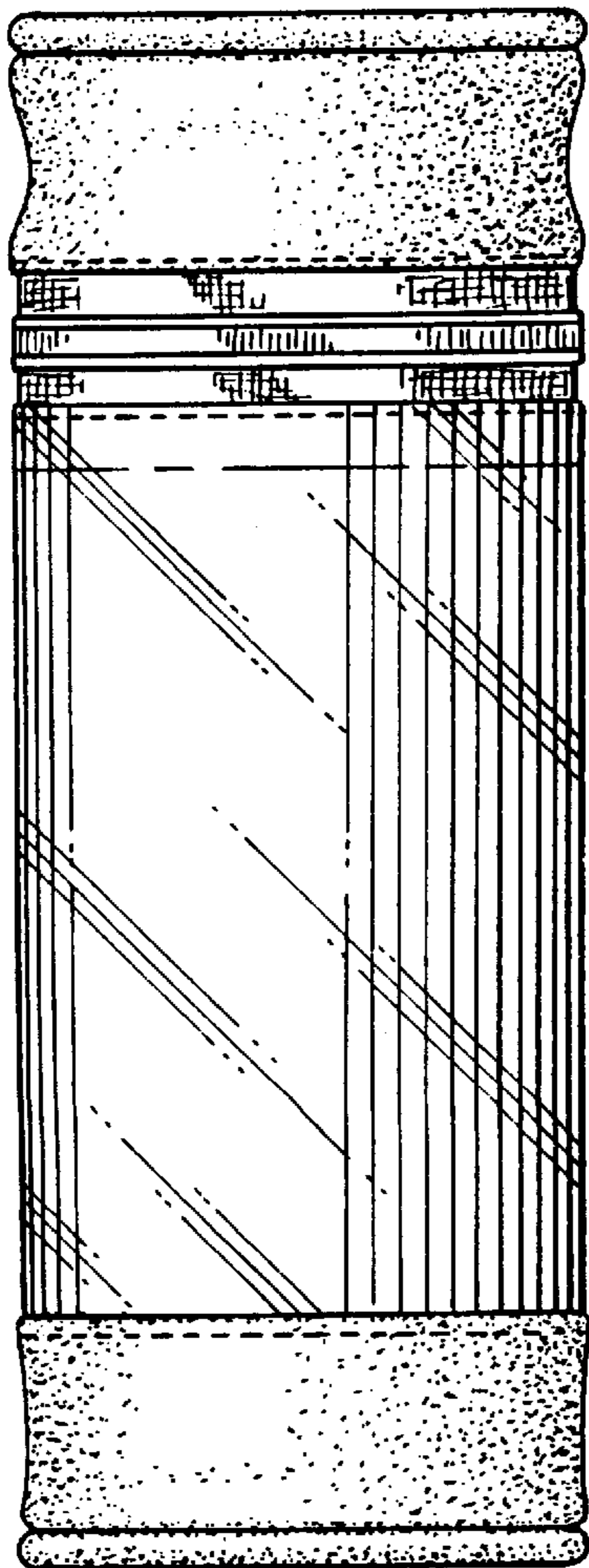
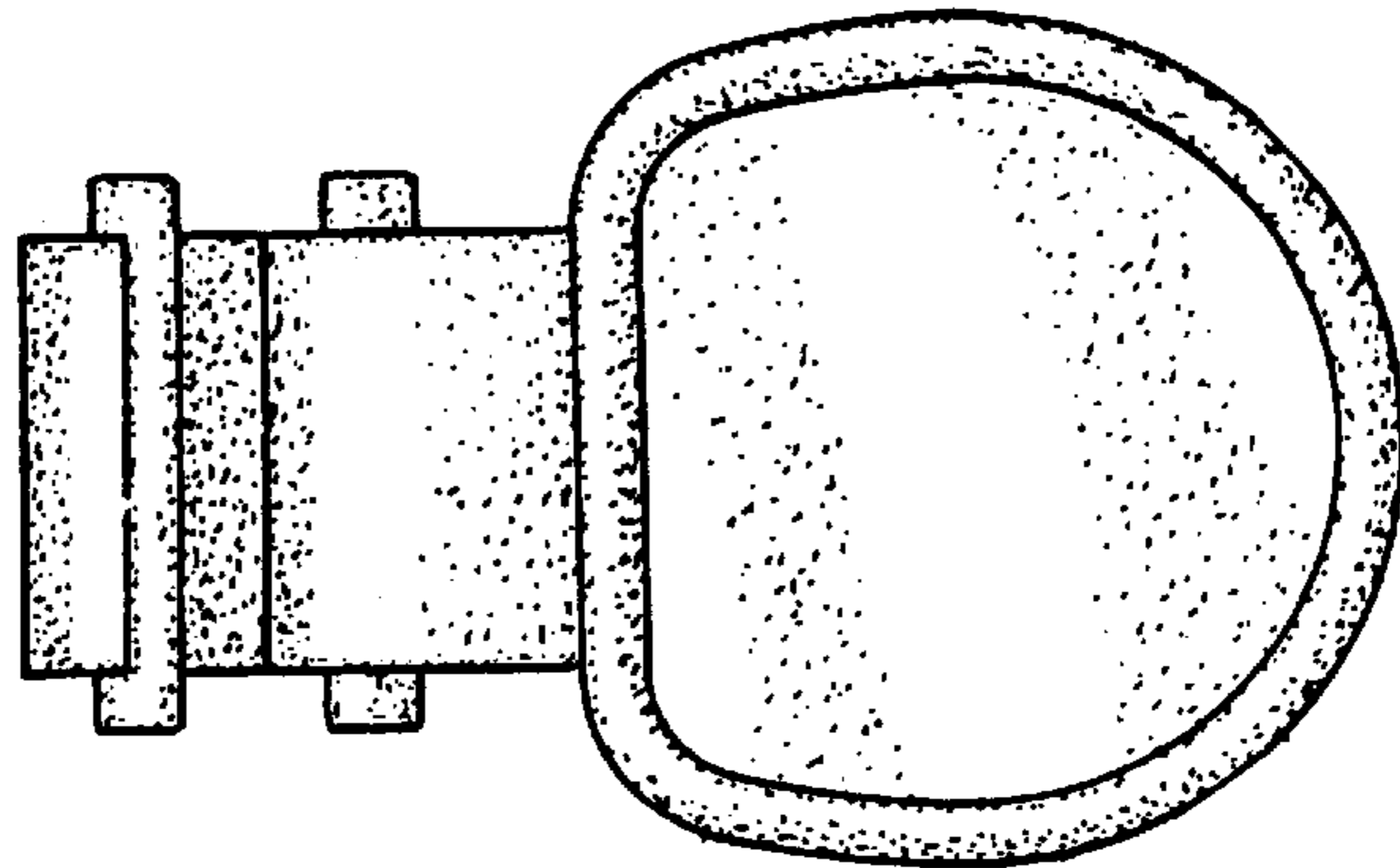

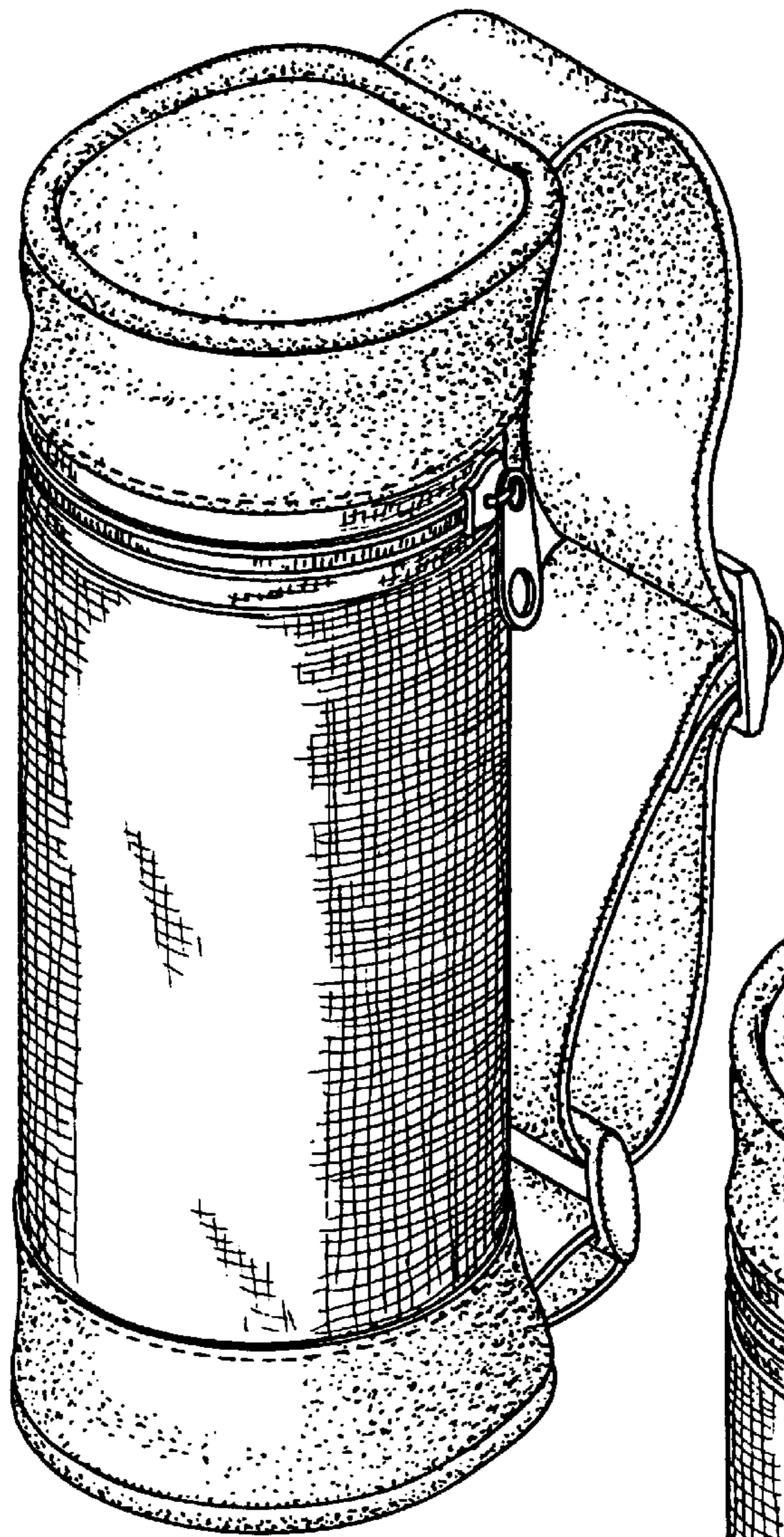

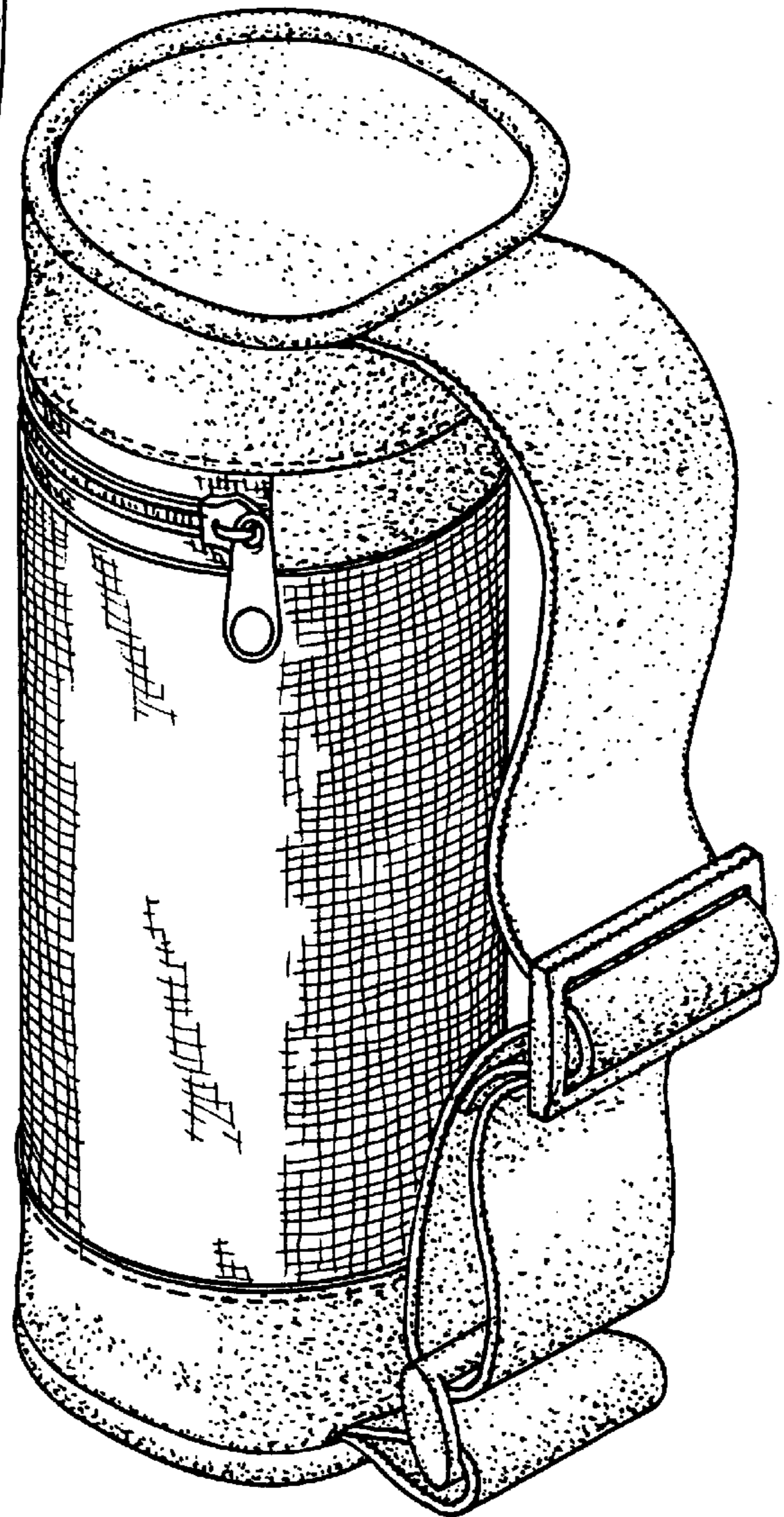

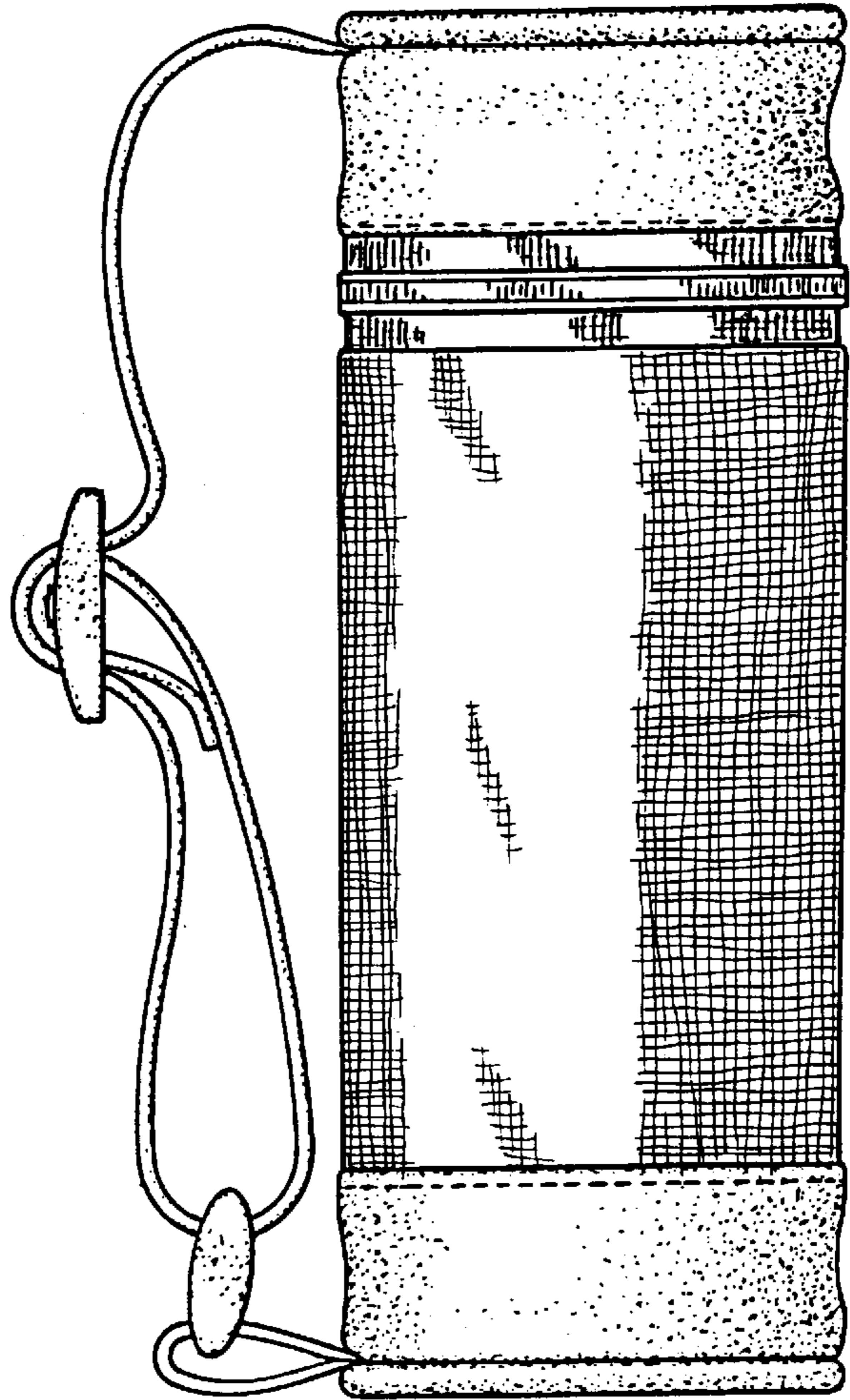
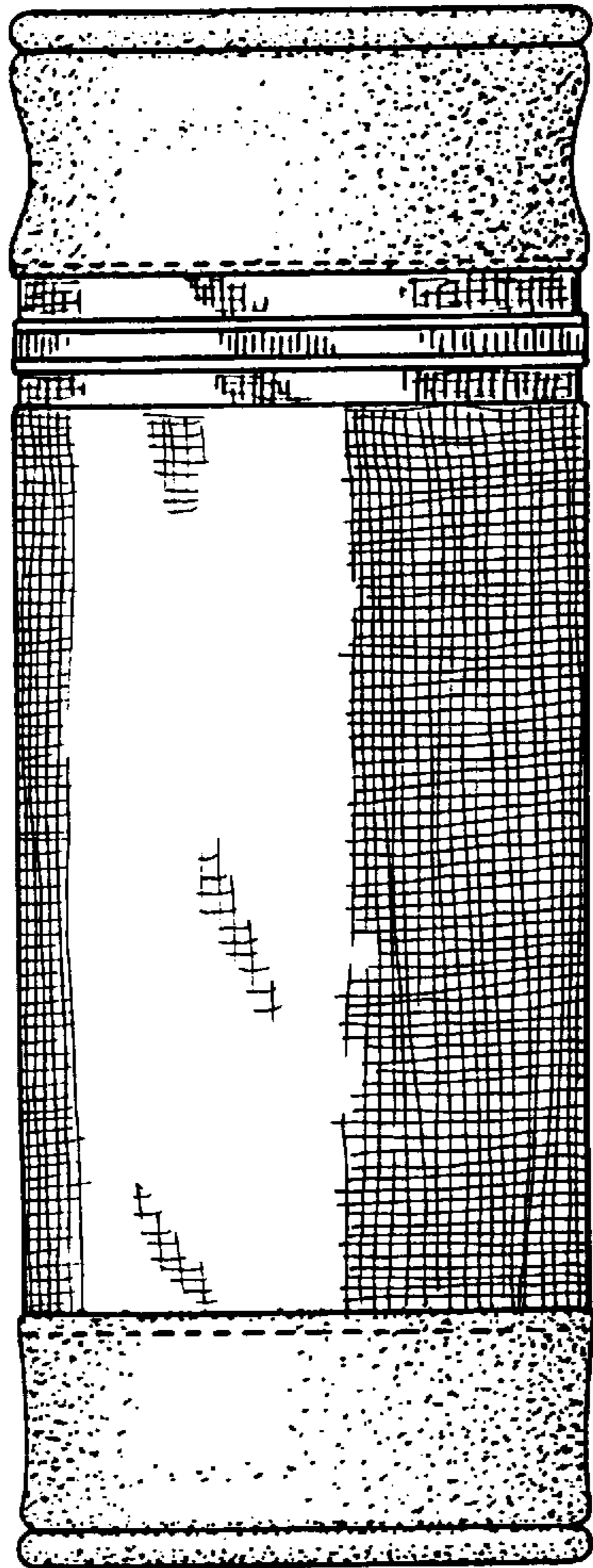
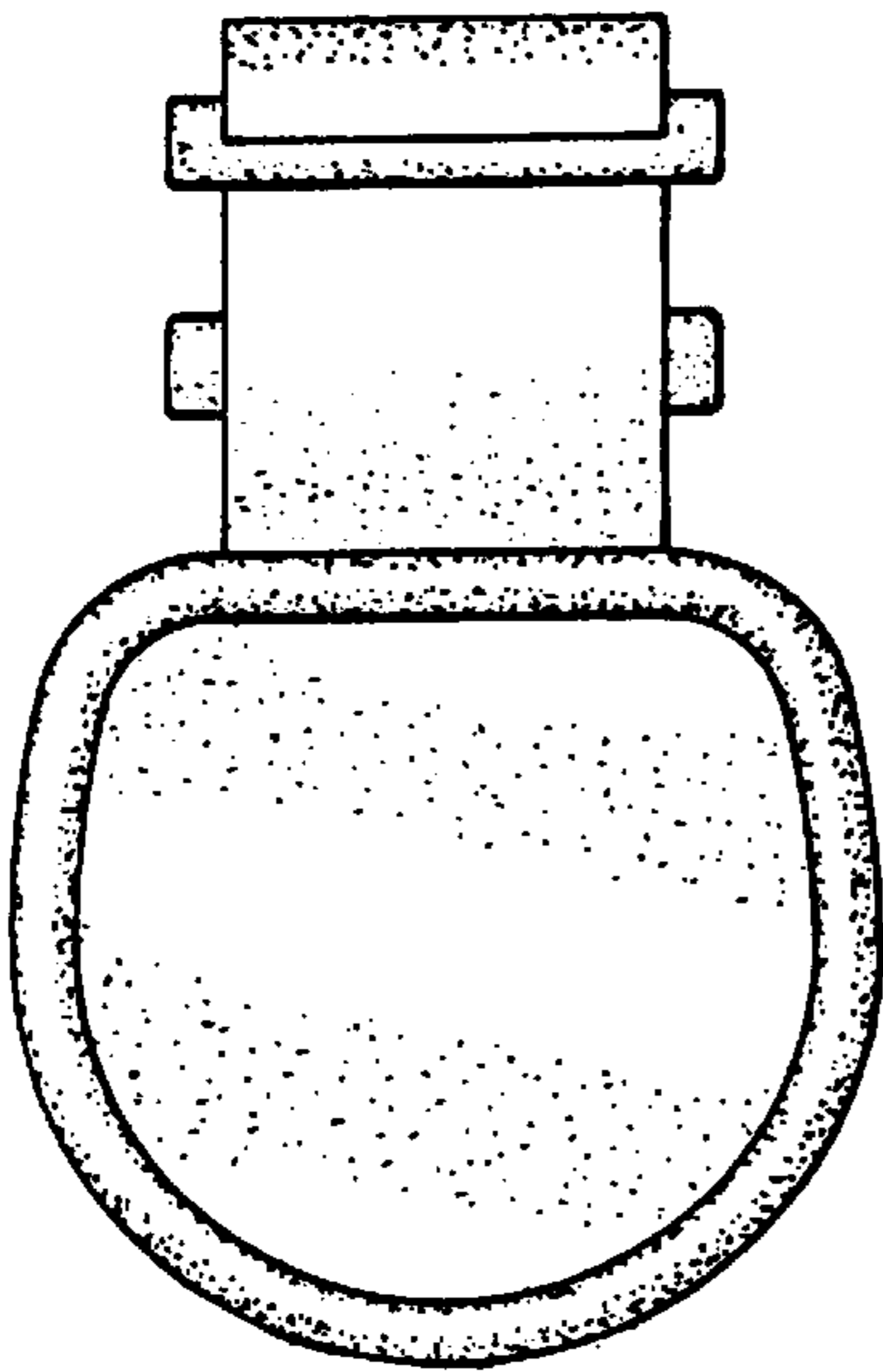
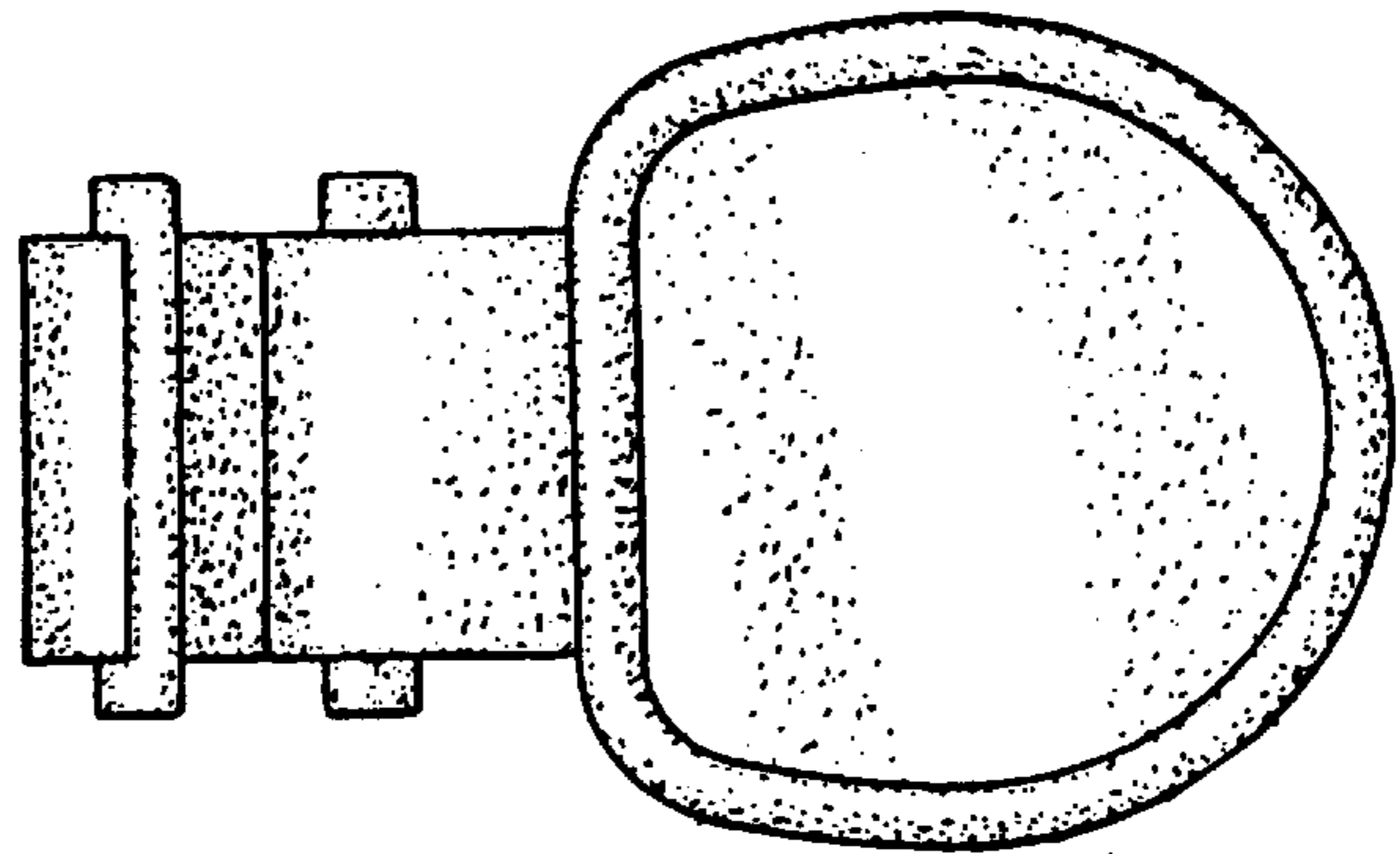

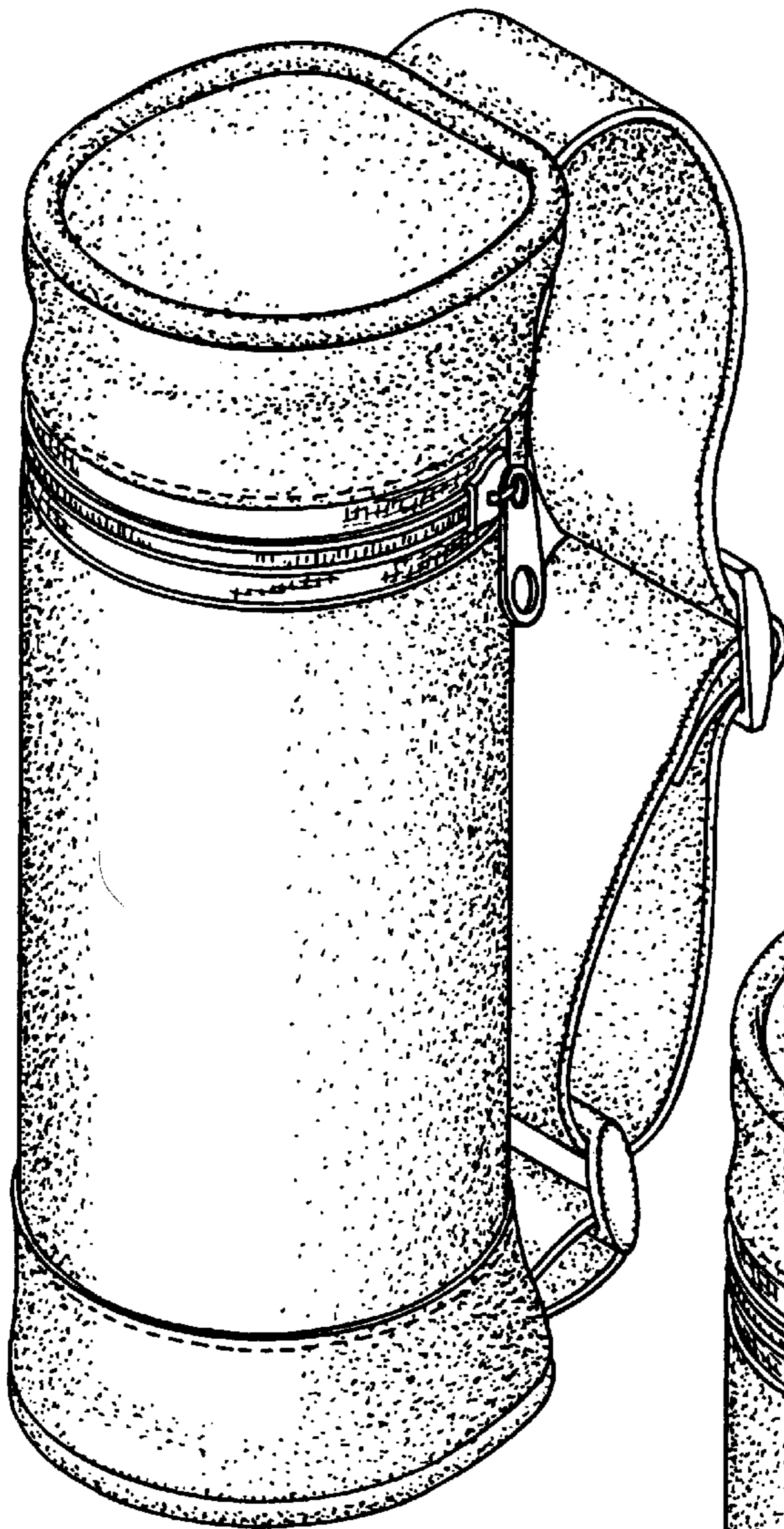

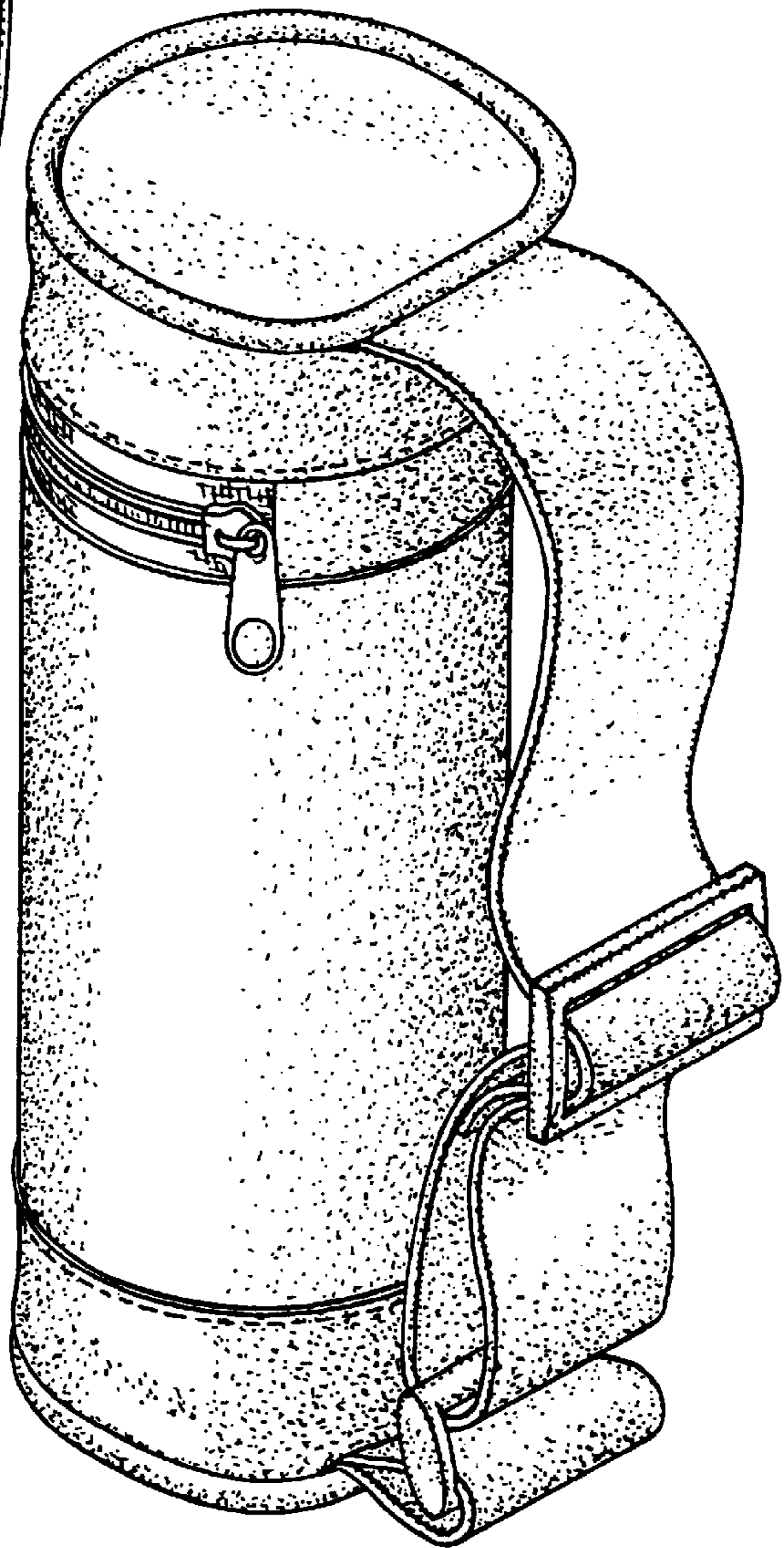

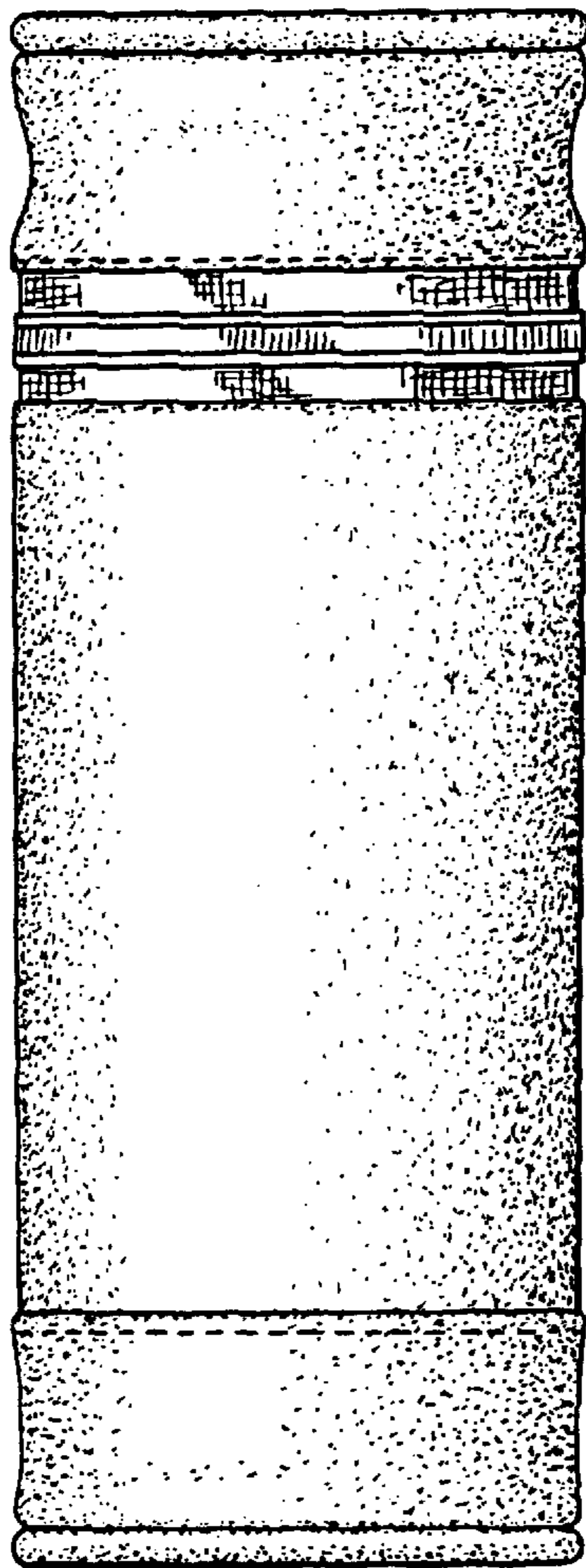
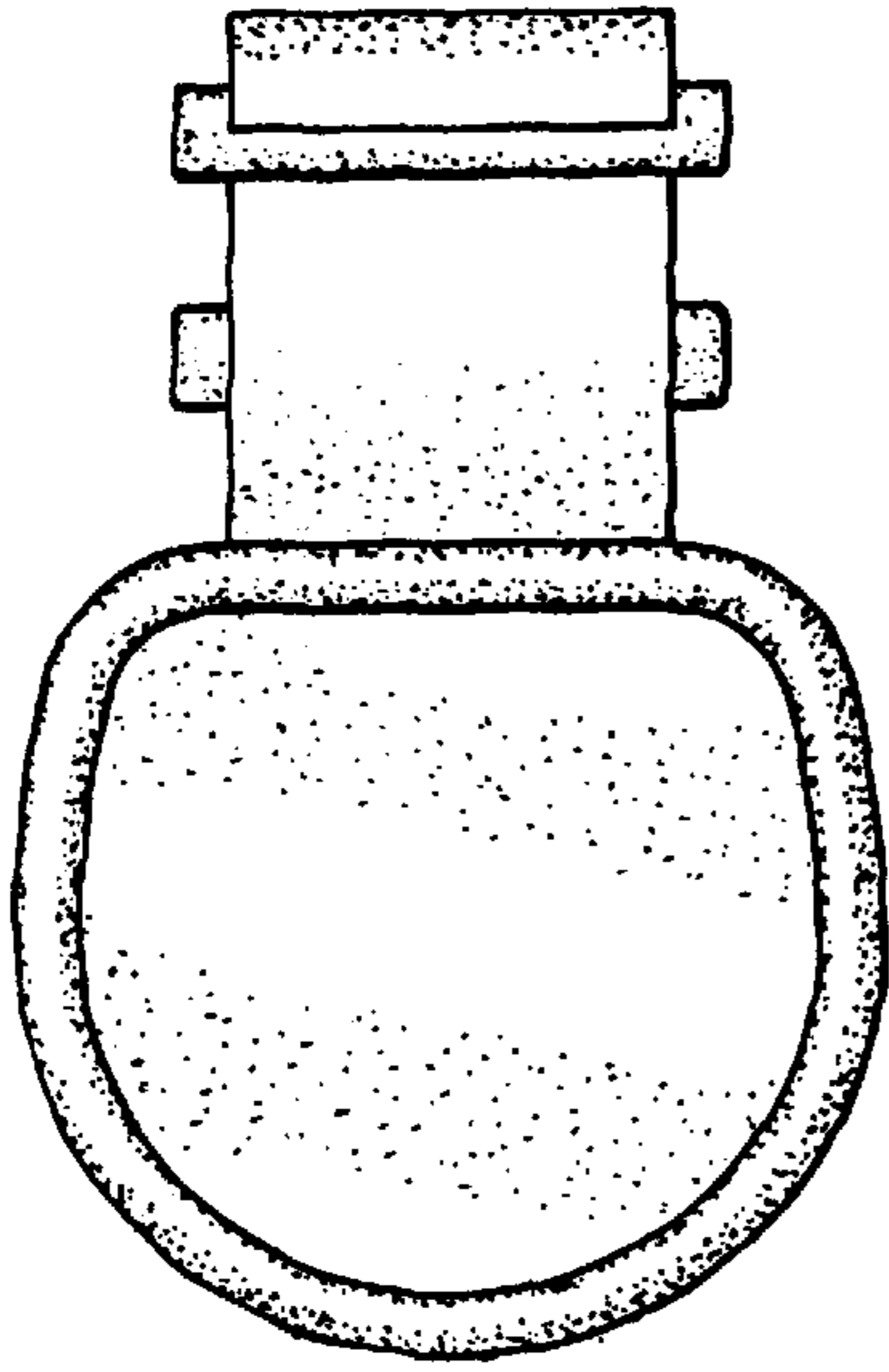

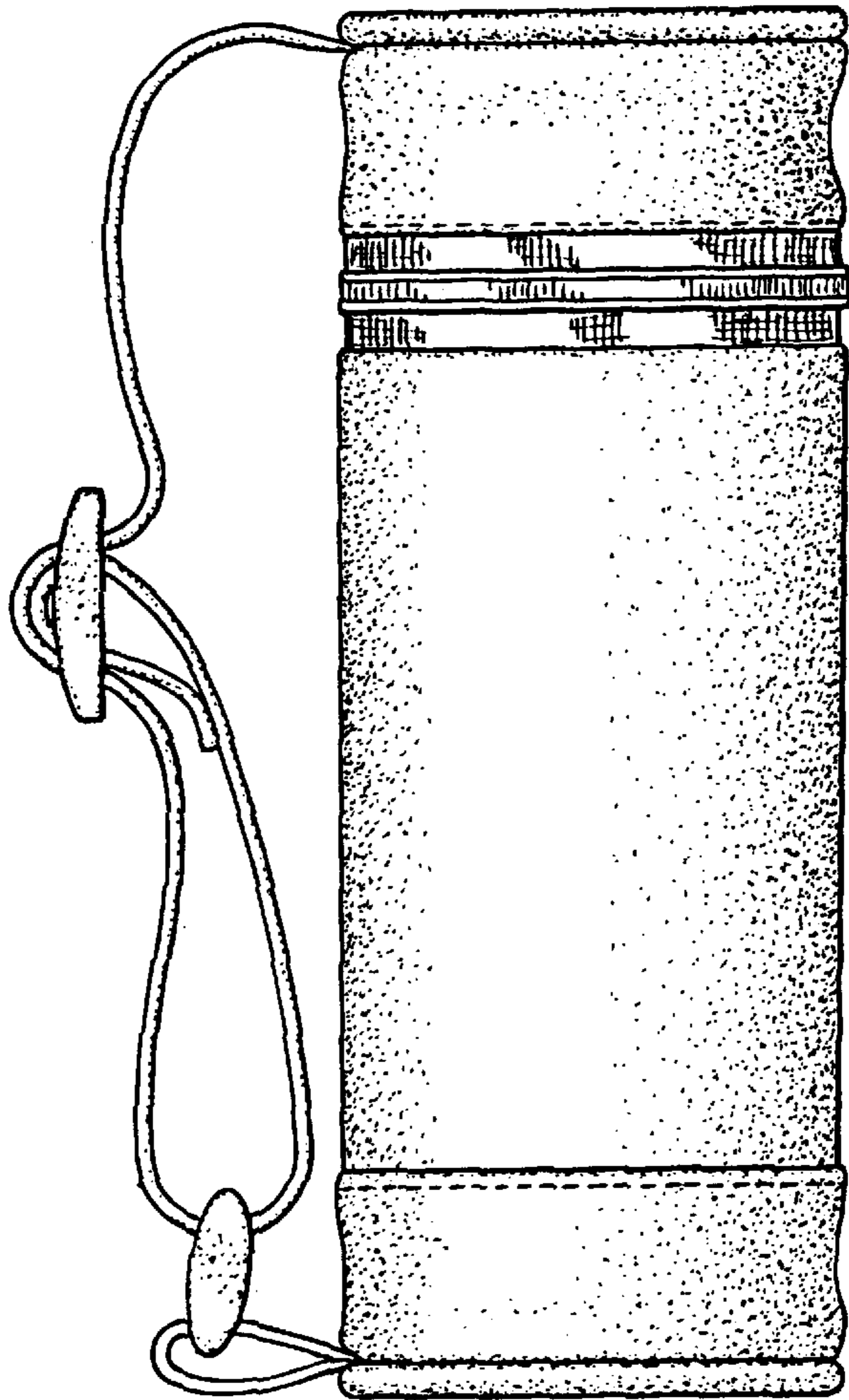
