DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the top portion of a water heater according to the present invention;

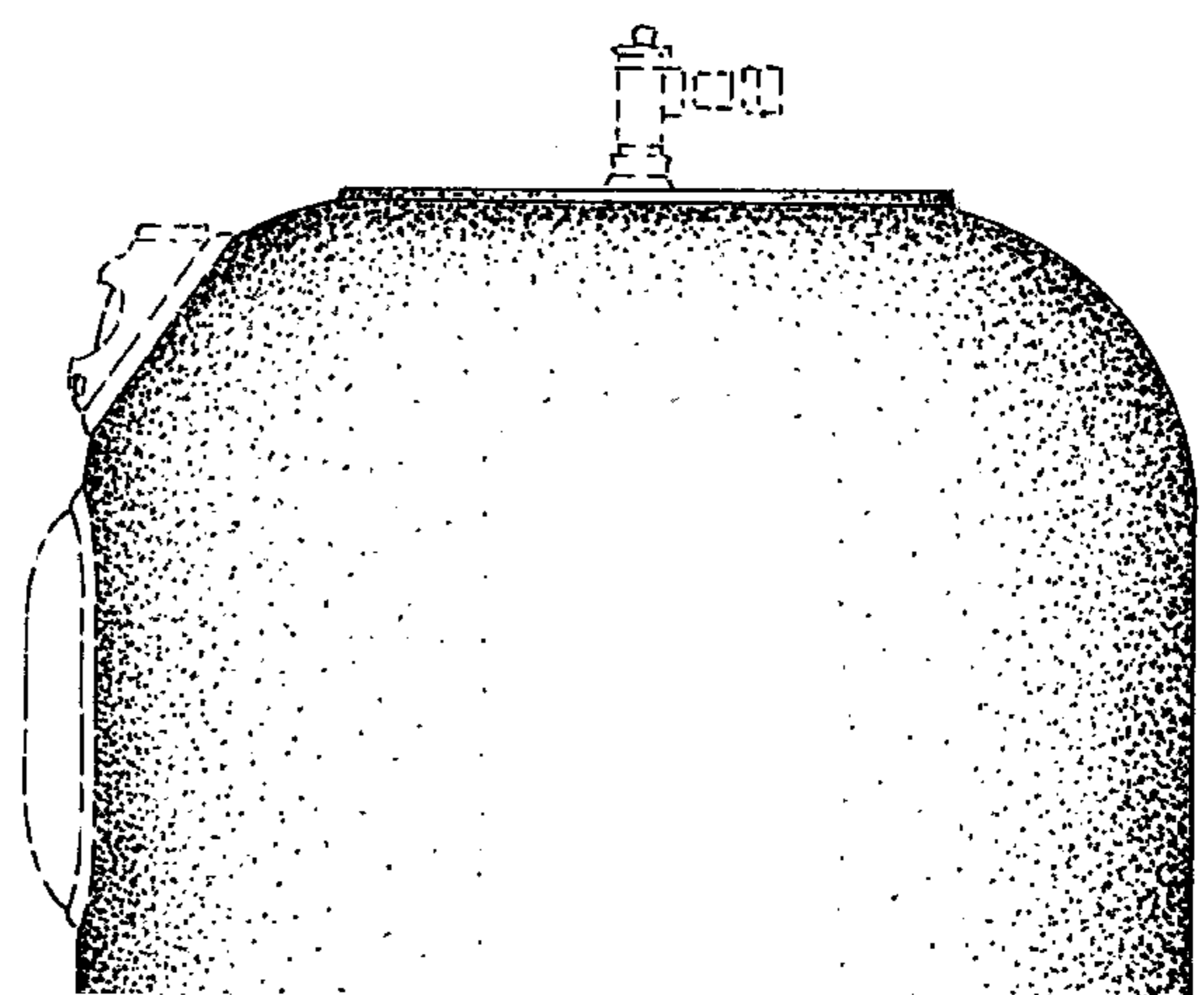
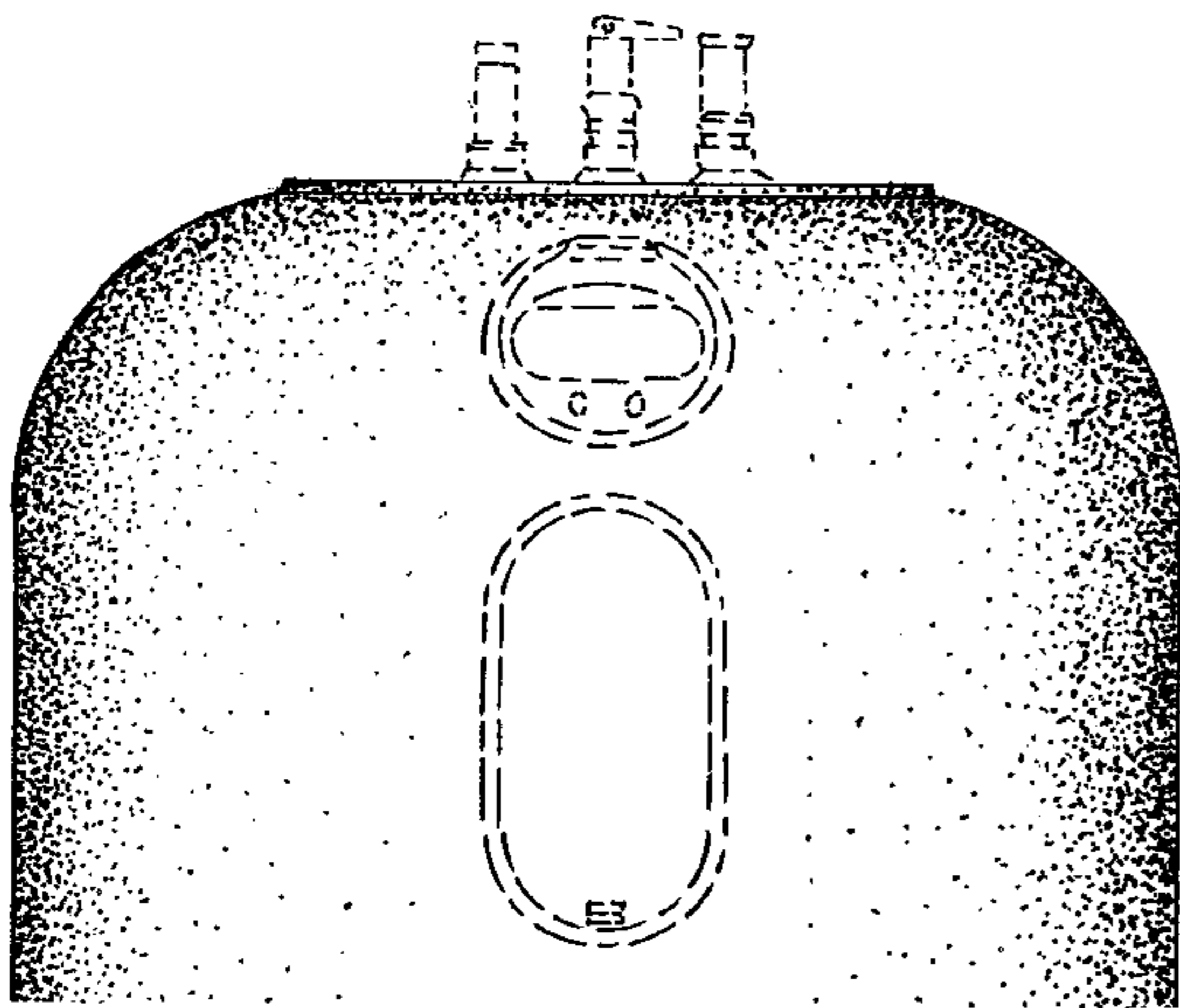
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the water heater illustrated in FIG. 1;

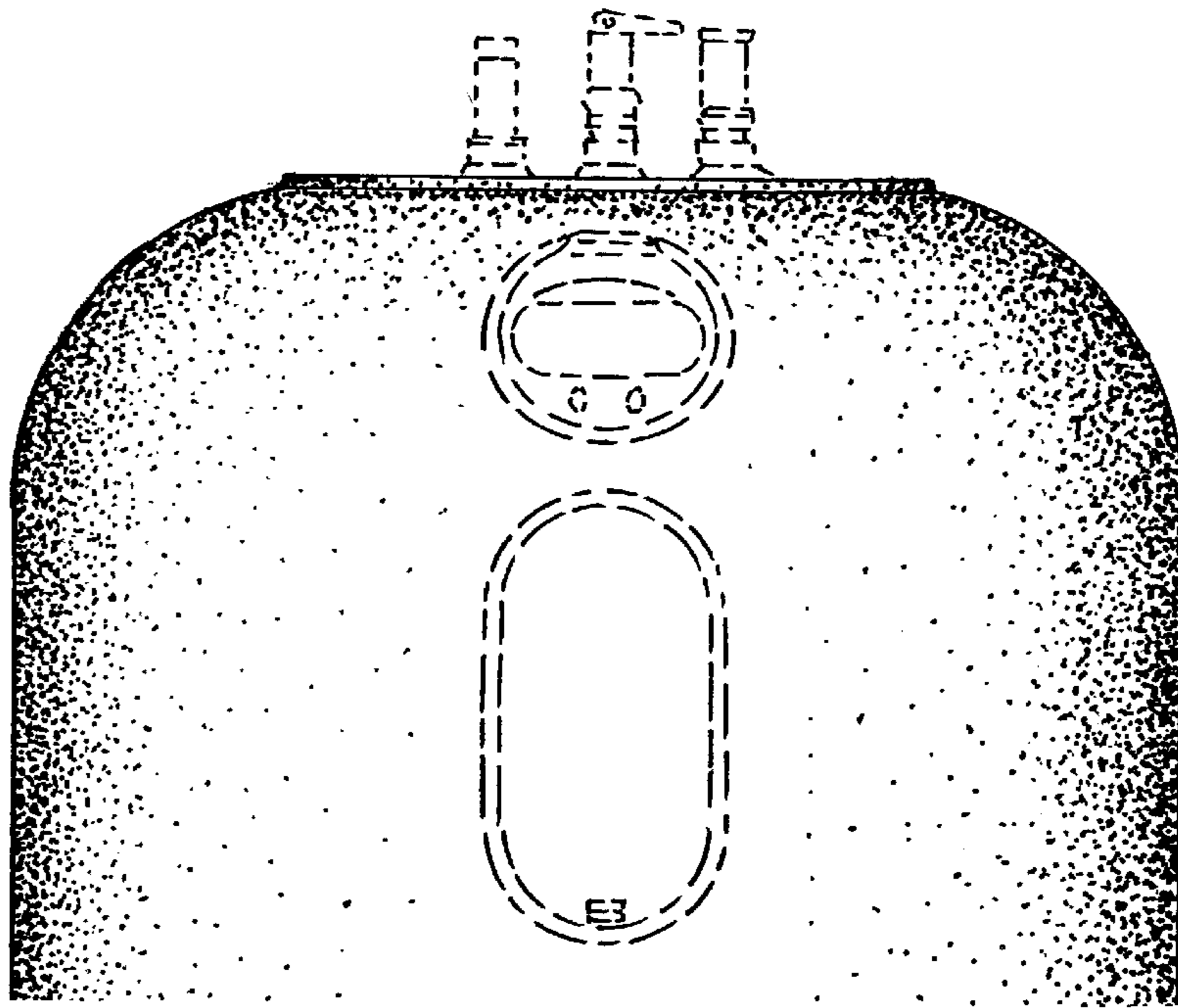

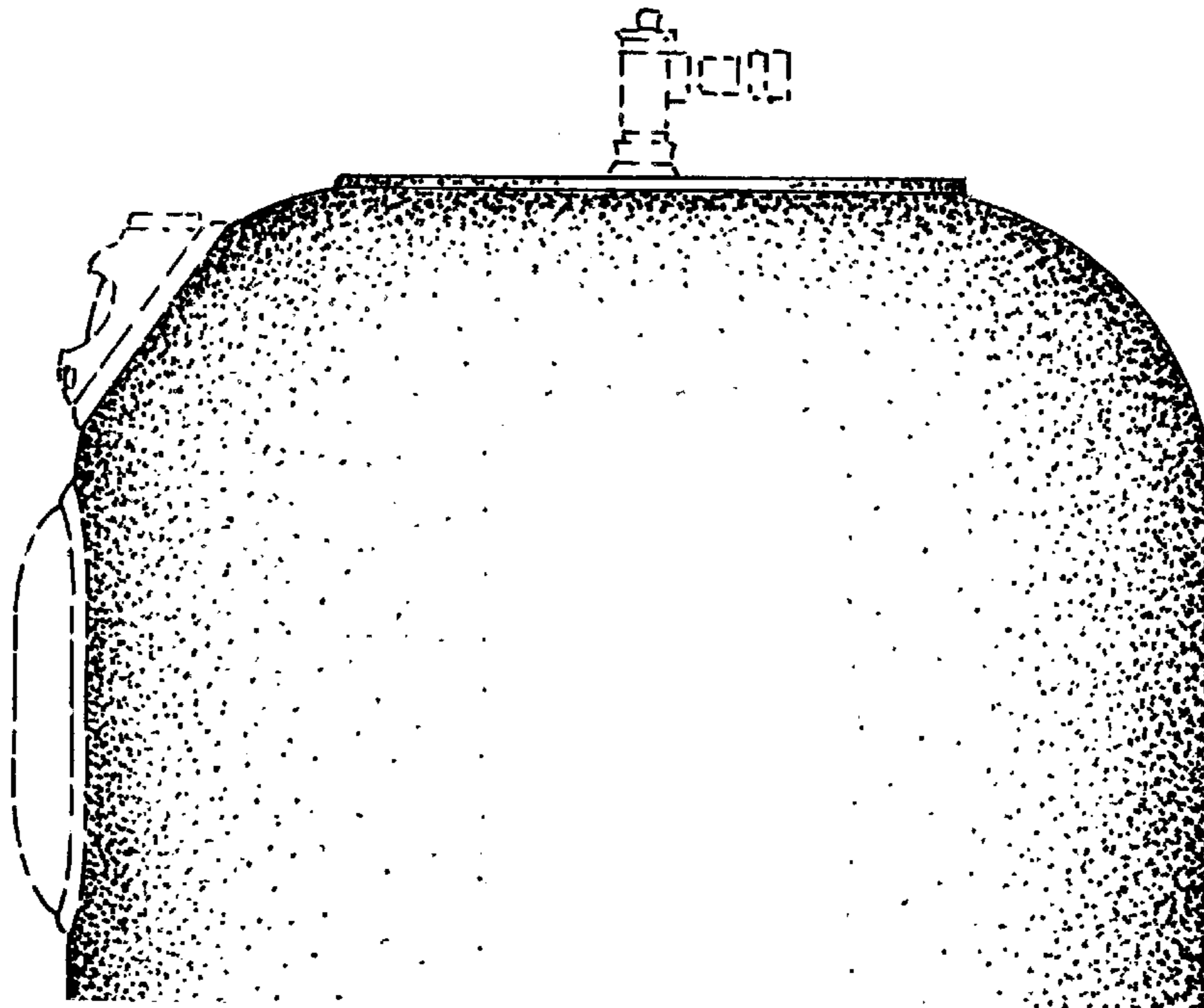

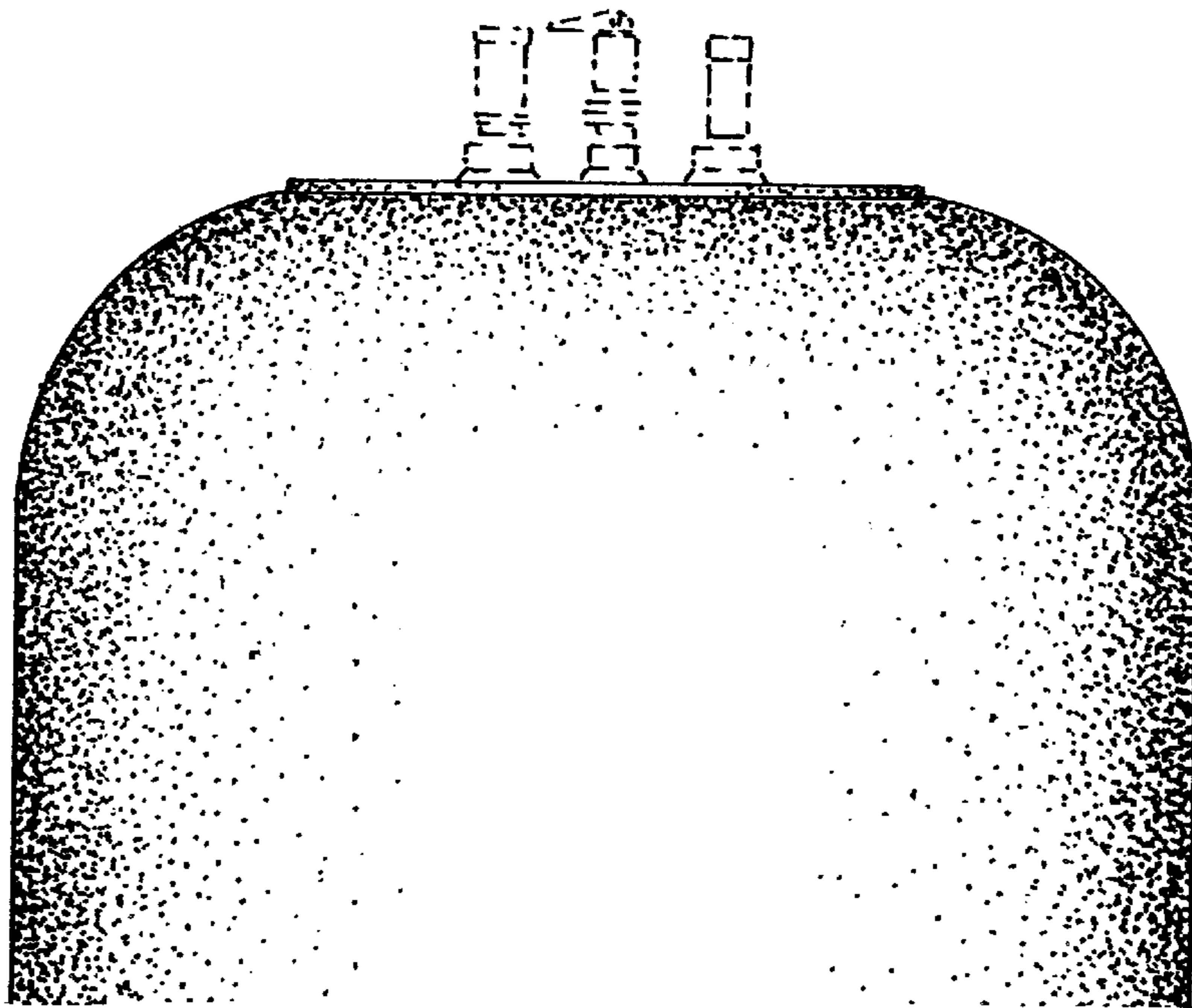

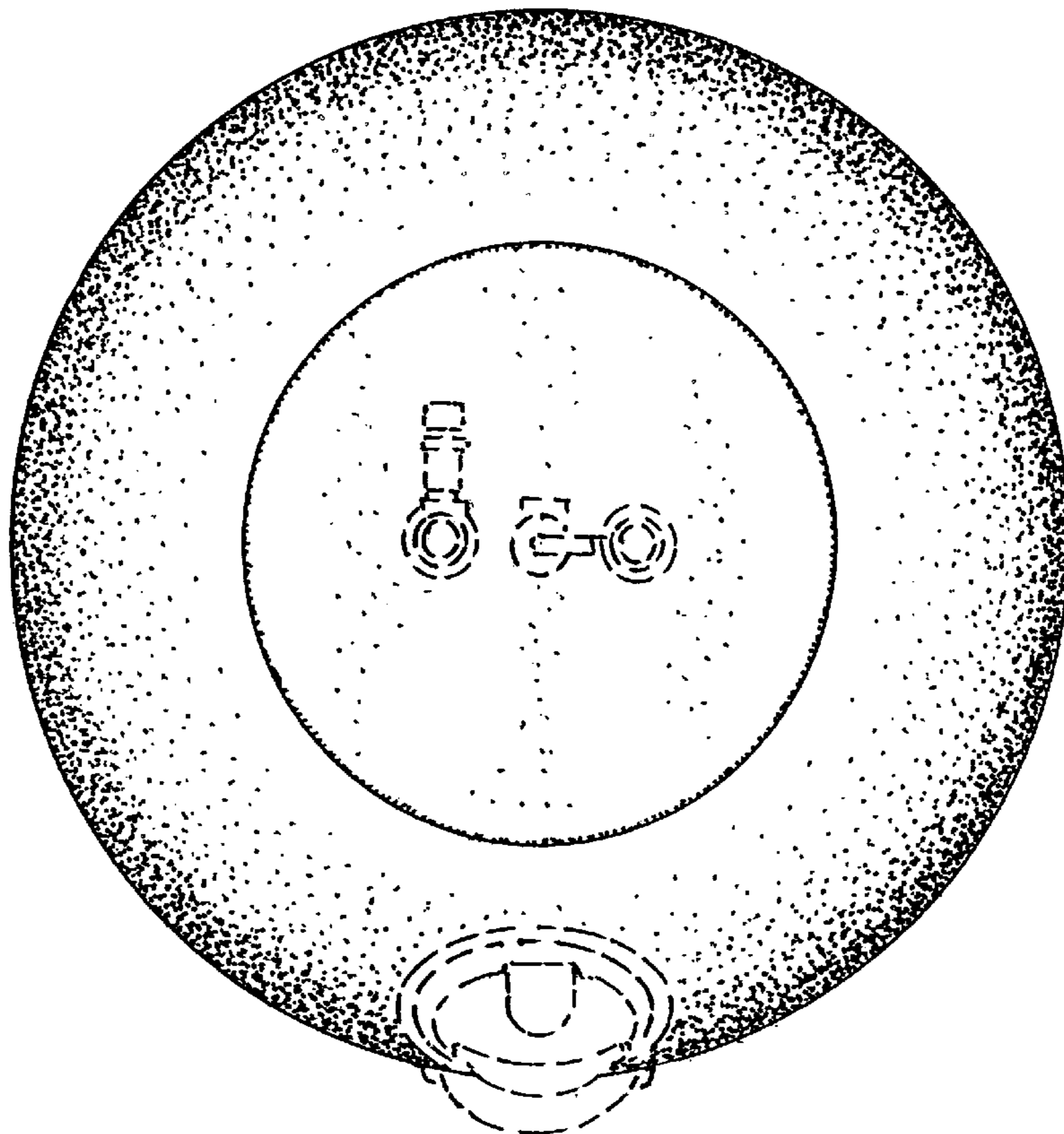
