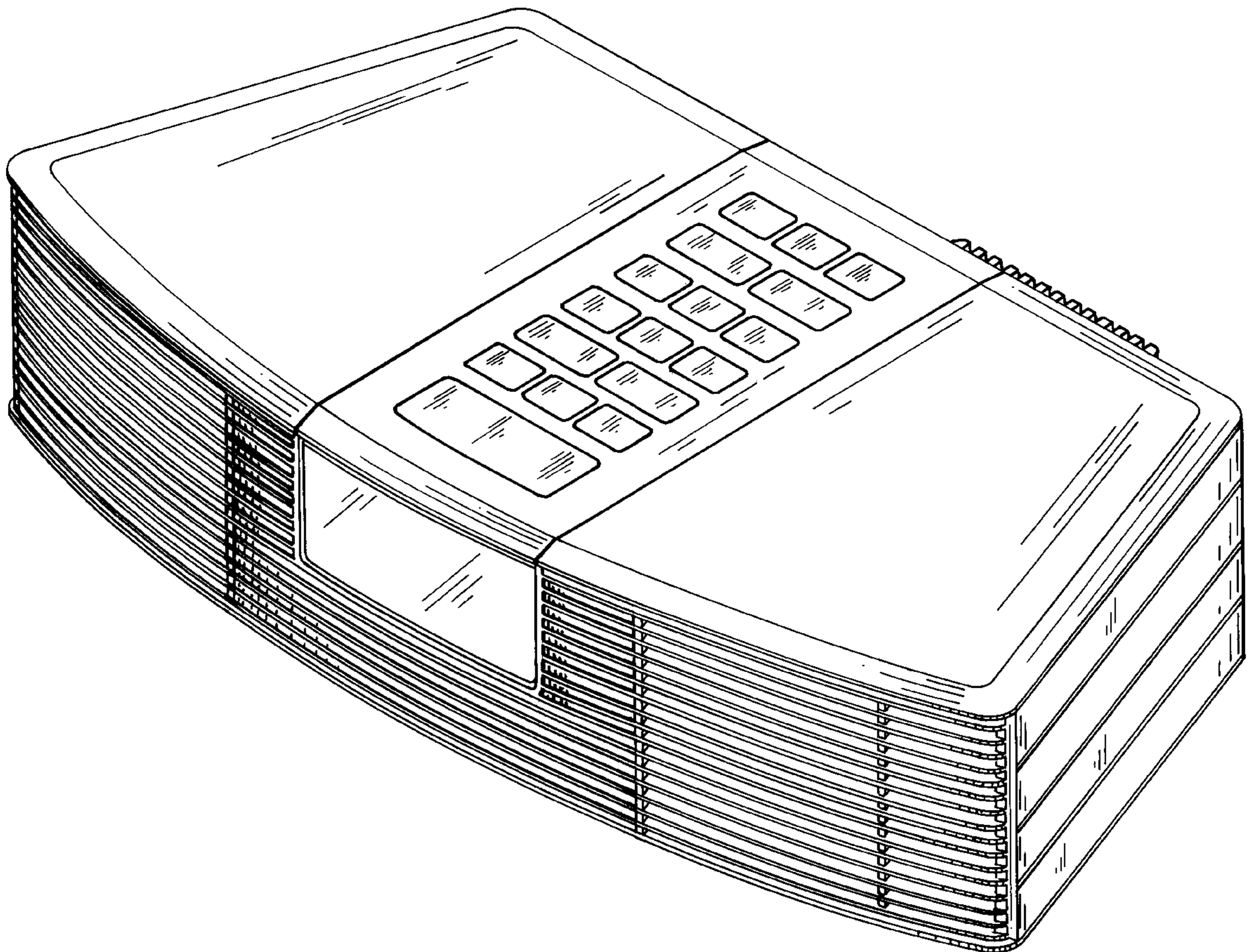
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a clock radio receiver showing my new design;

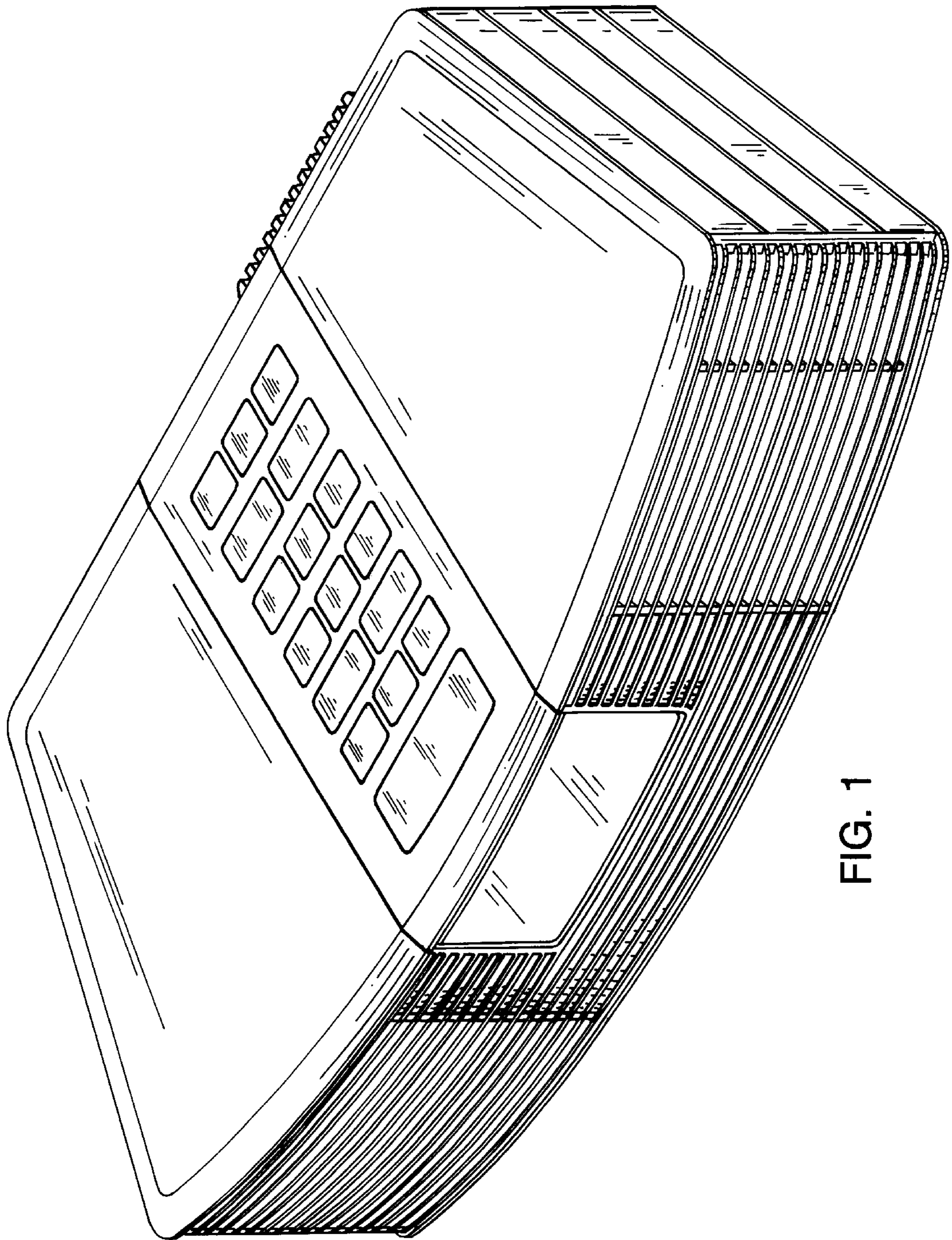

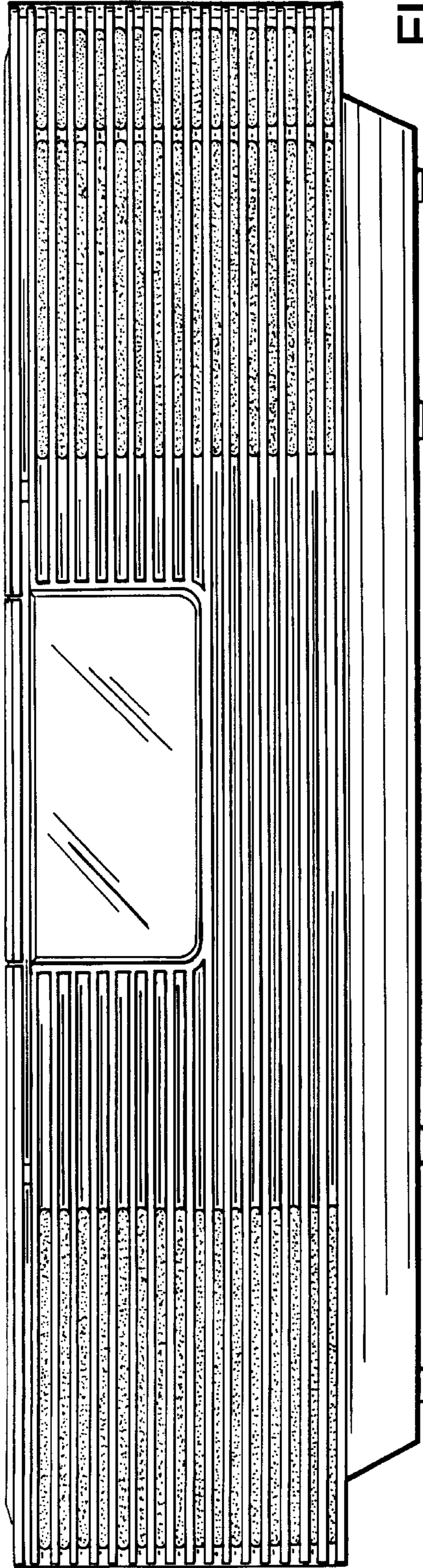

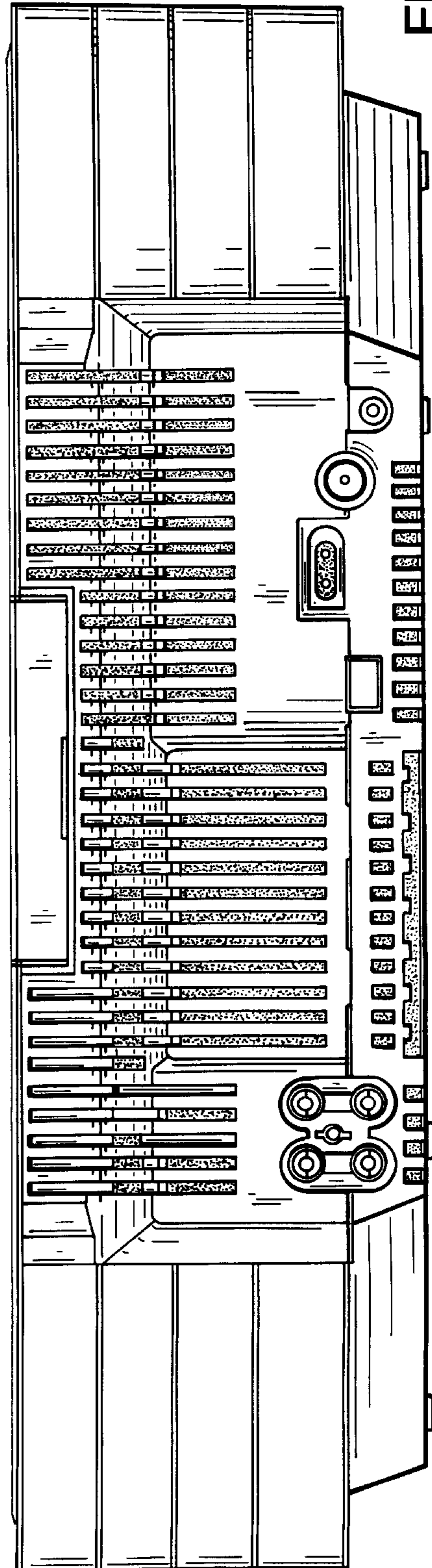

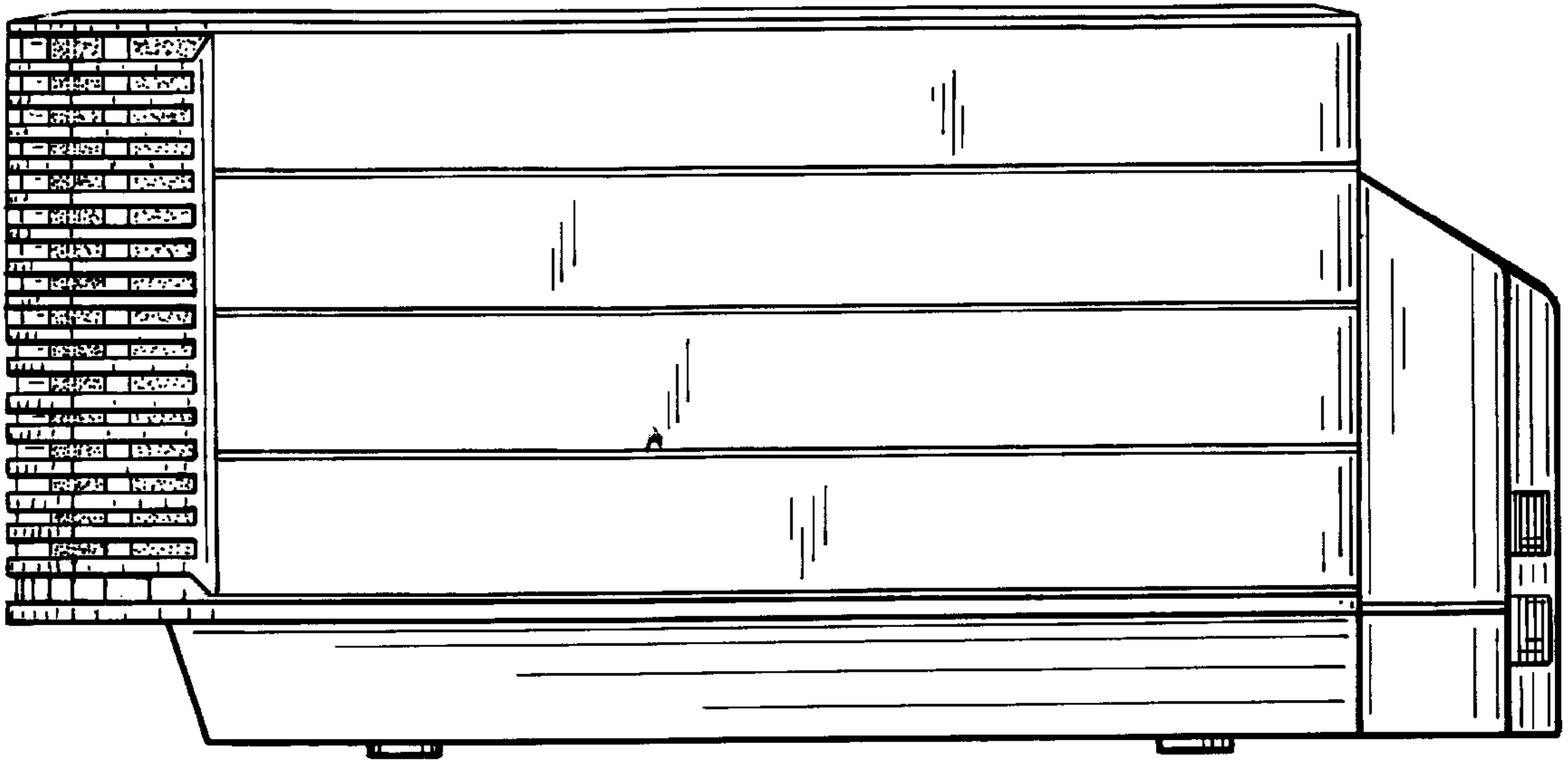

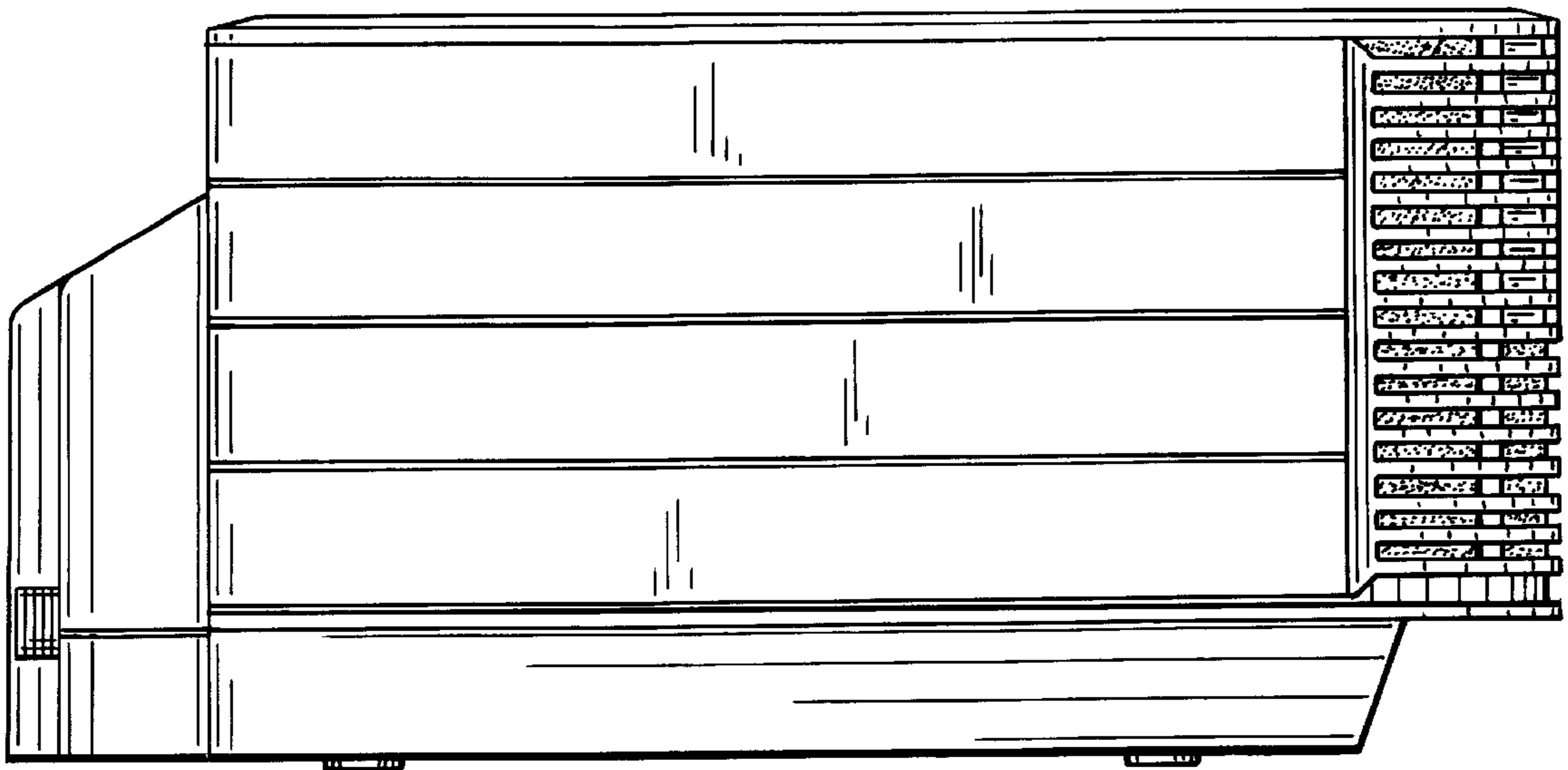

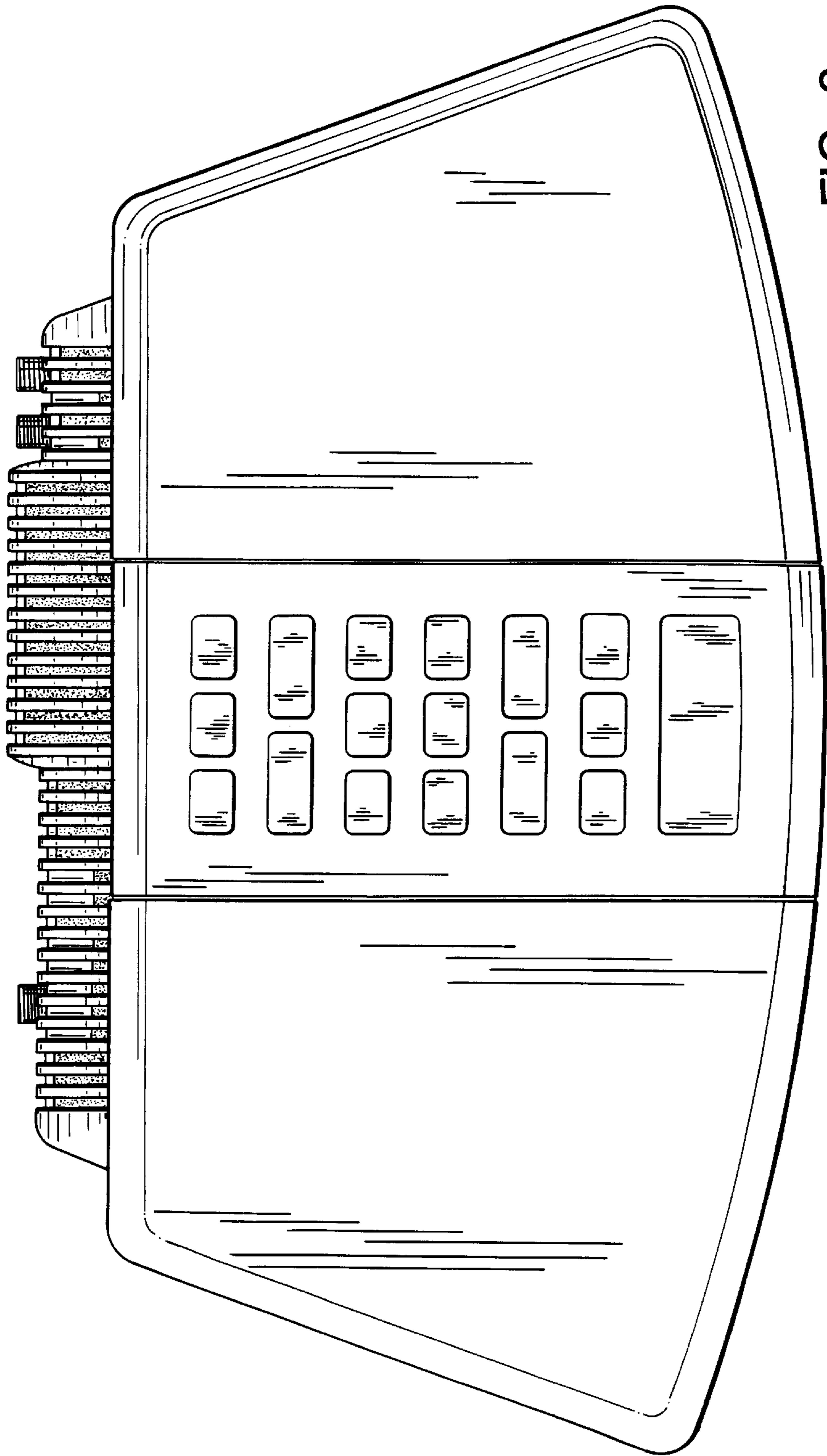

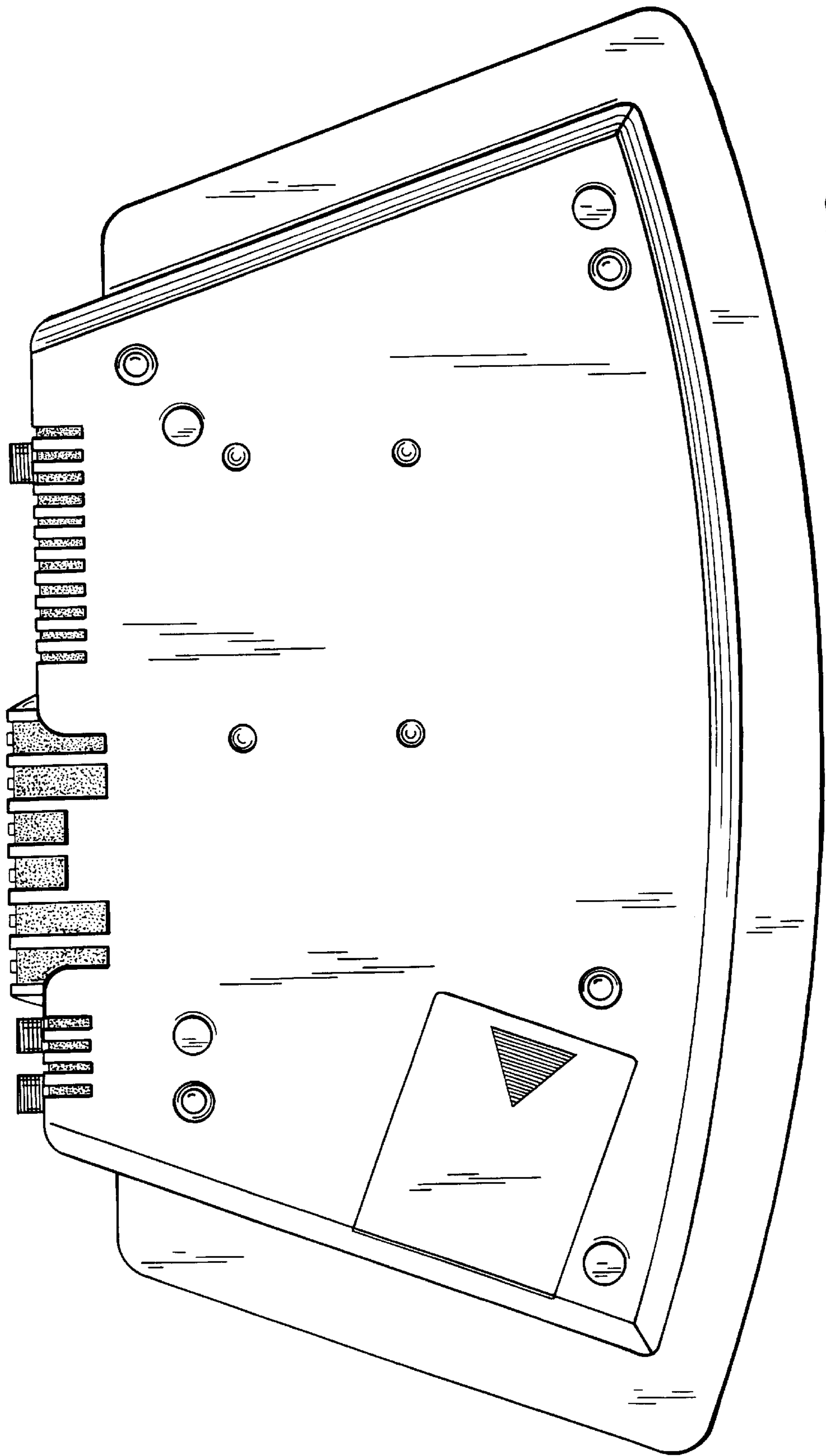
