**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a lateral side elevational view of a first embodiment of the footwear;

FIG. 2 is a rear, lateral perspective view of the first embodiment of the footwear;

FIG. 3 is a front, lateral perspective view of the first embodiment of the footwear;

FIG. 6 is a front, medial perspective view of the first embodiment of the footwear;

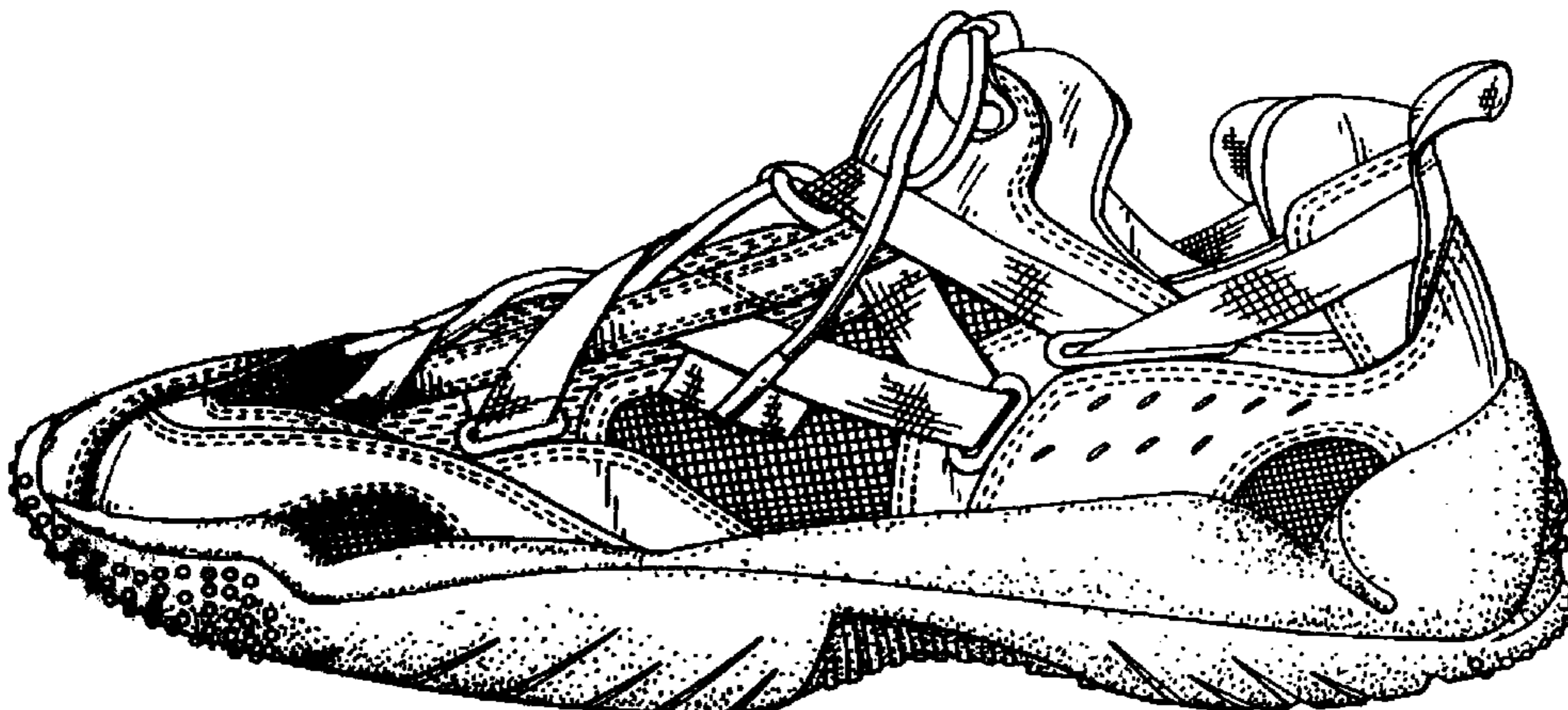
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the first embodiment of the footwear;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the first embodiment of the footwear;

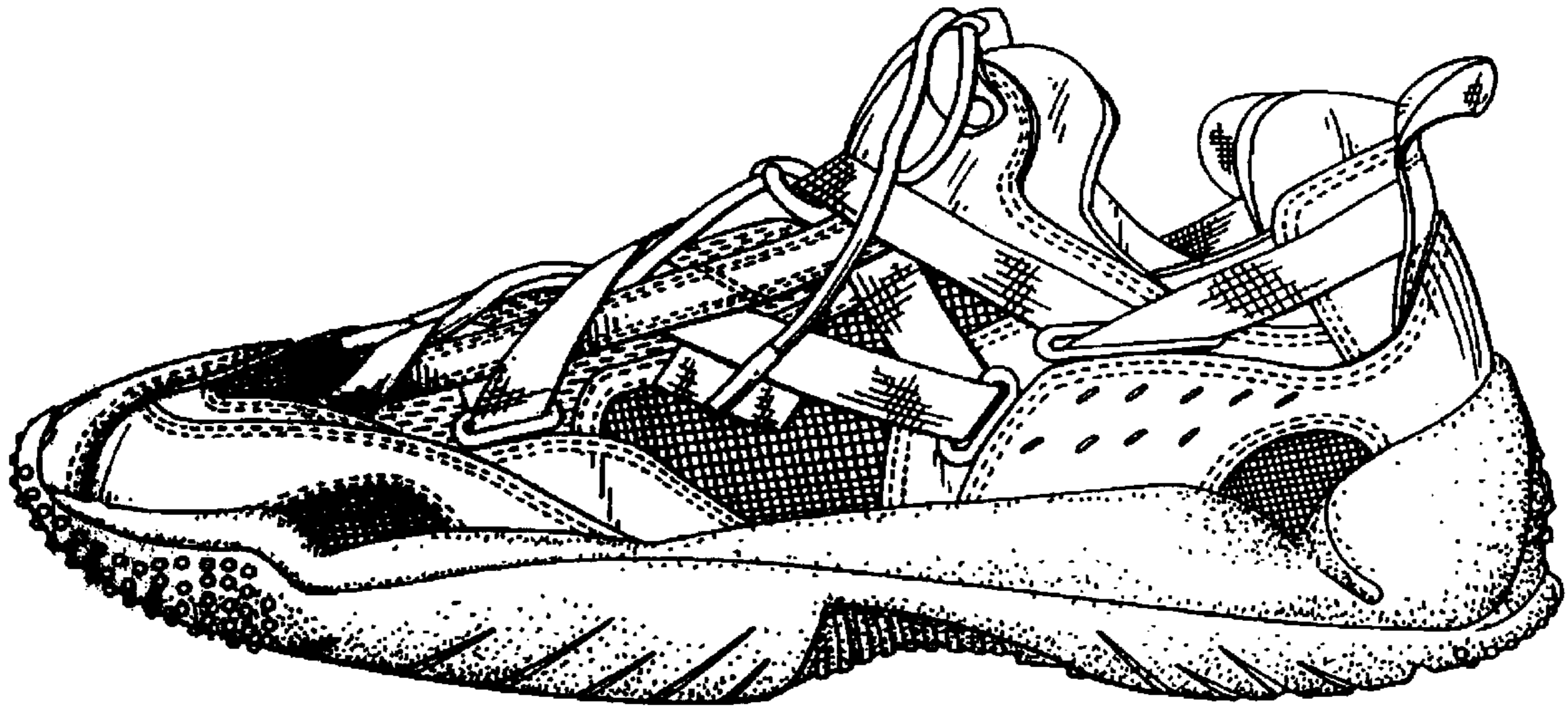
FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the first embodiment of the footwear; and,

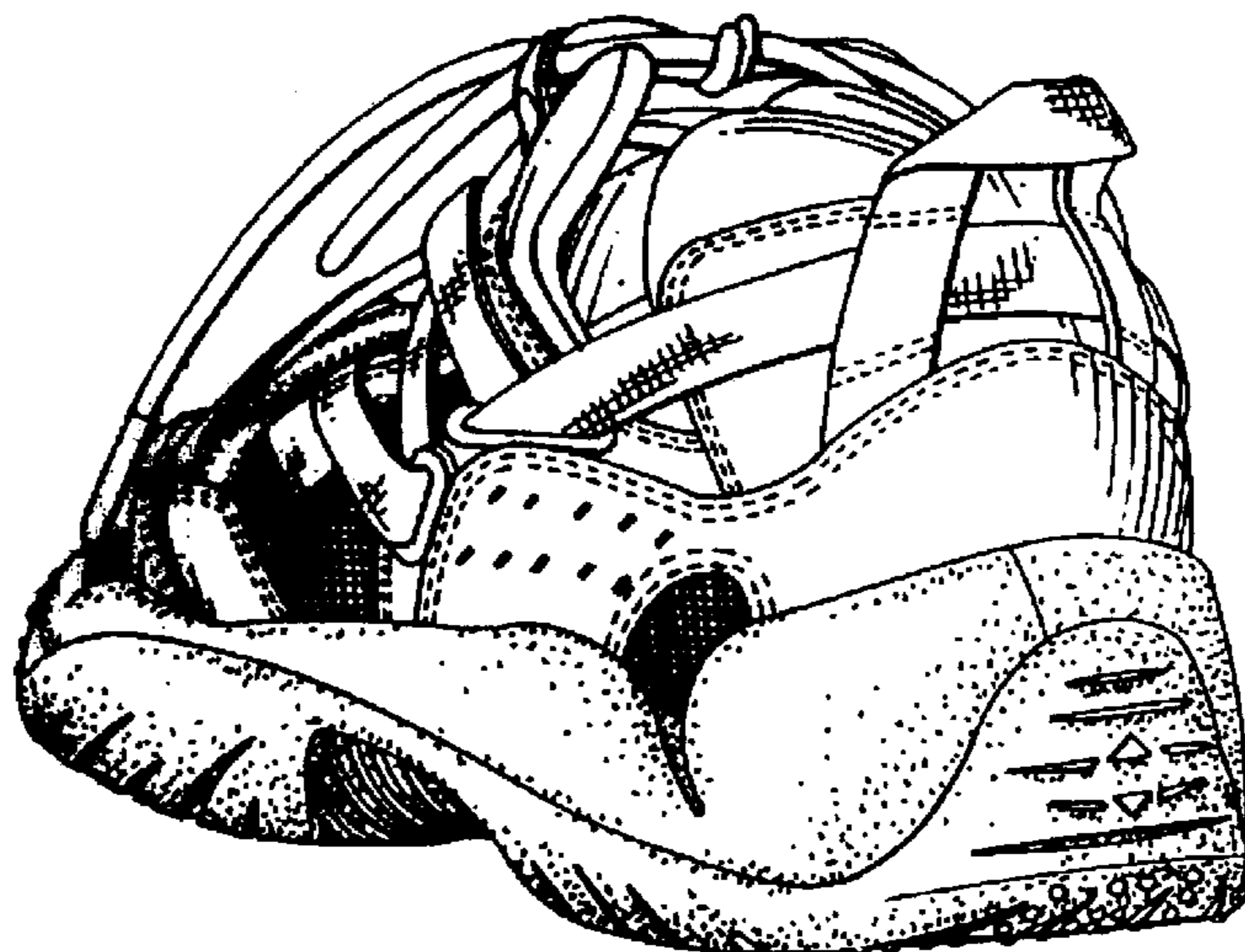

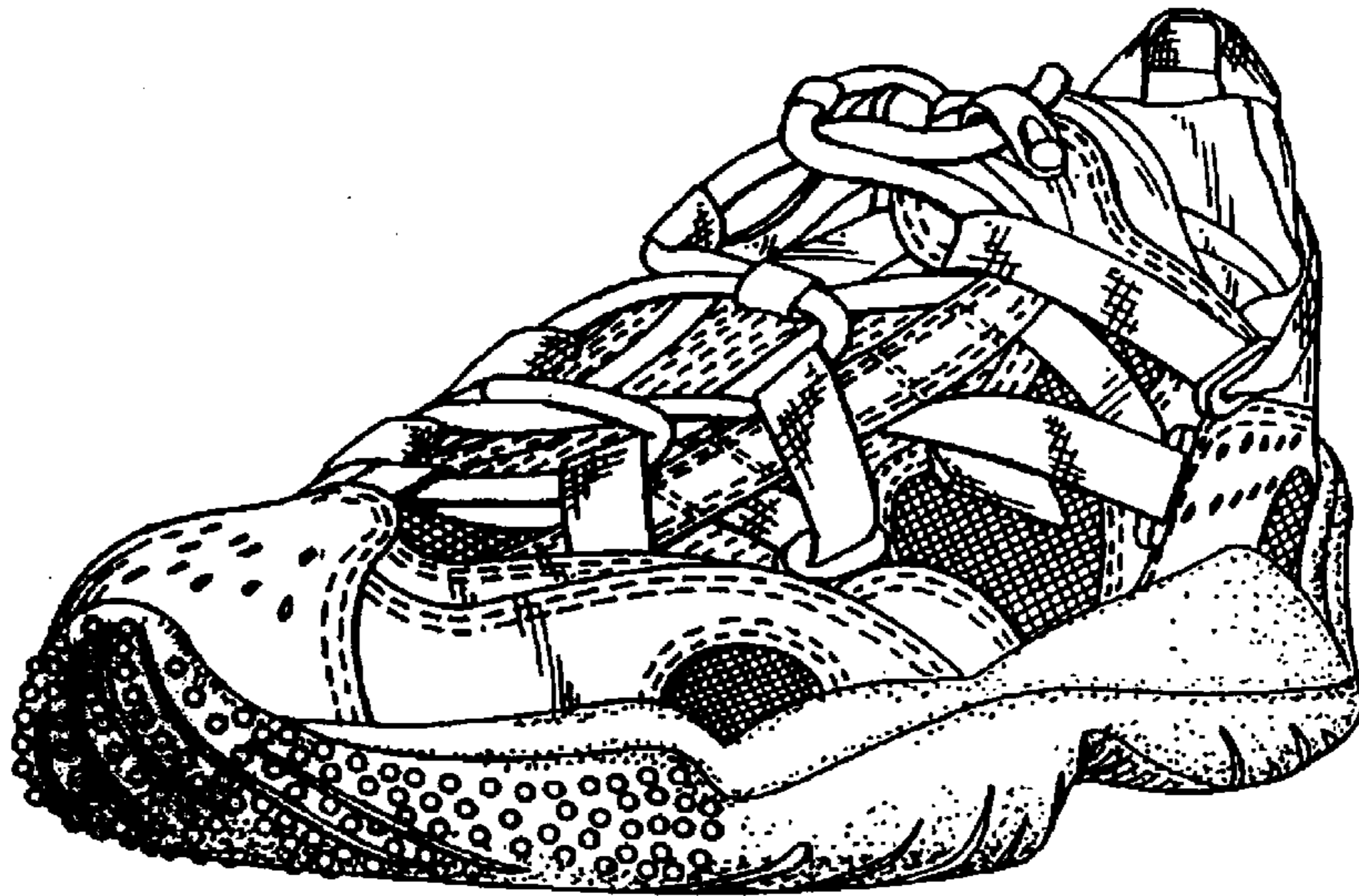
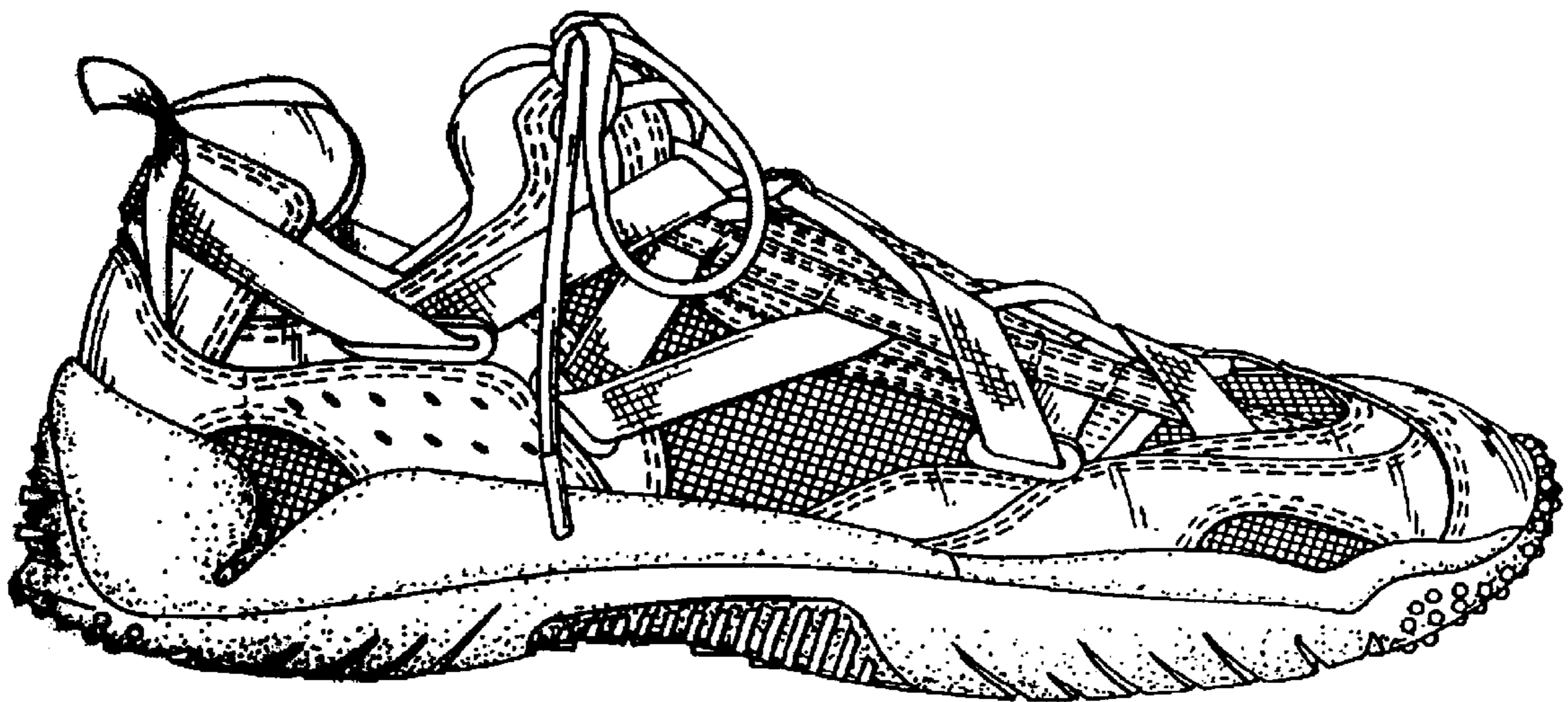
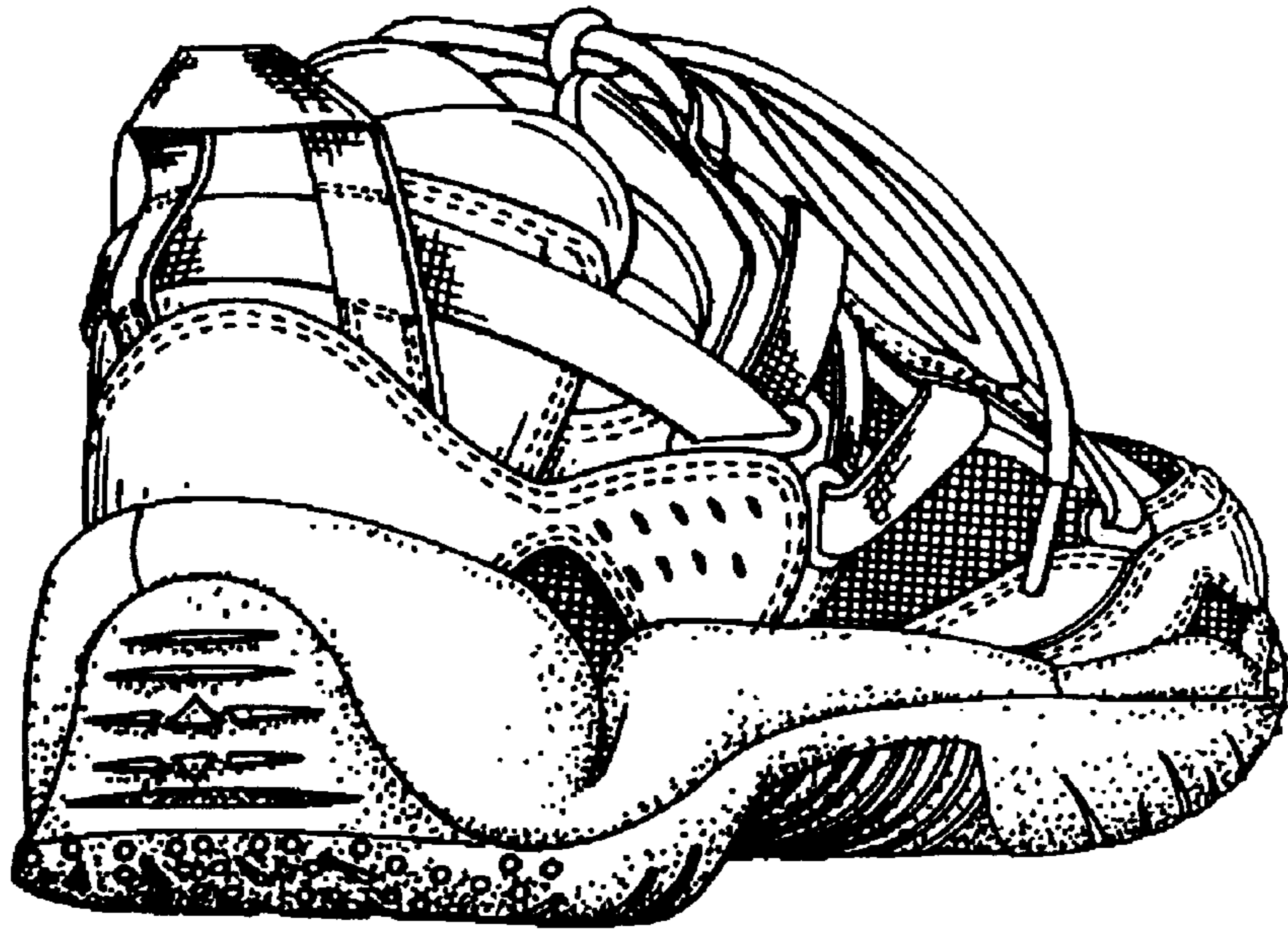

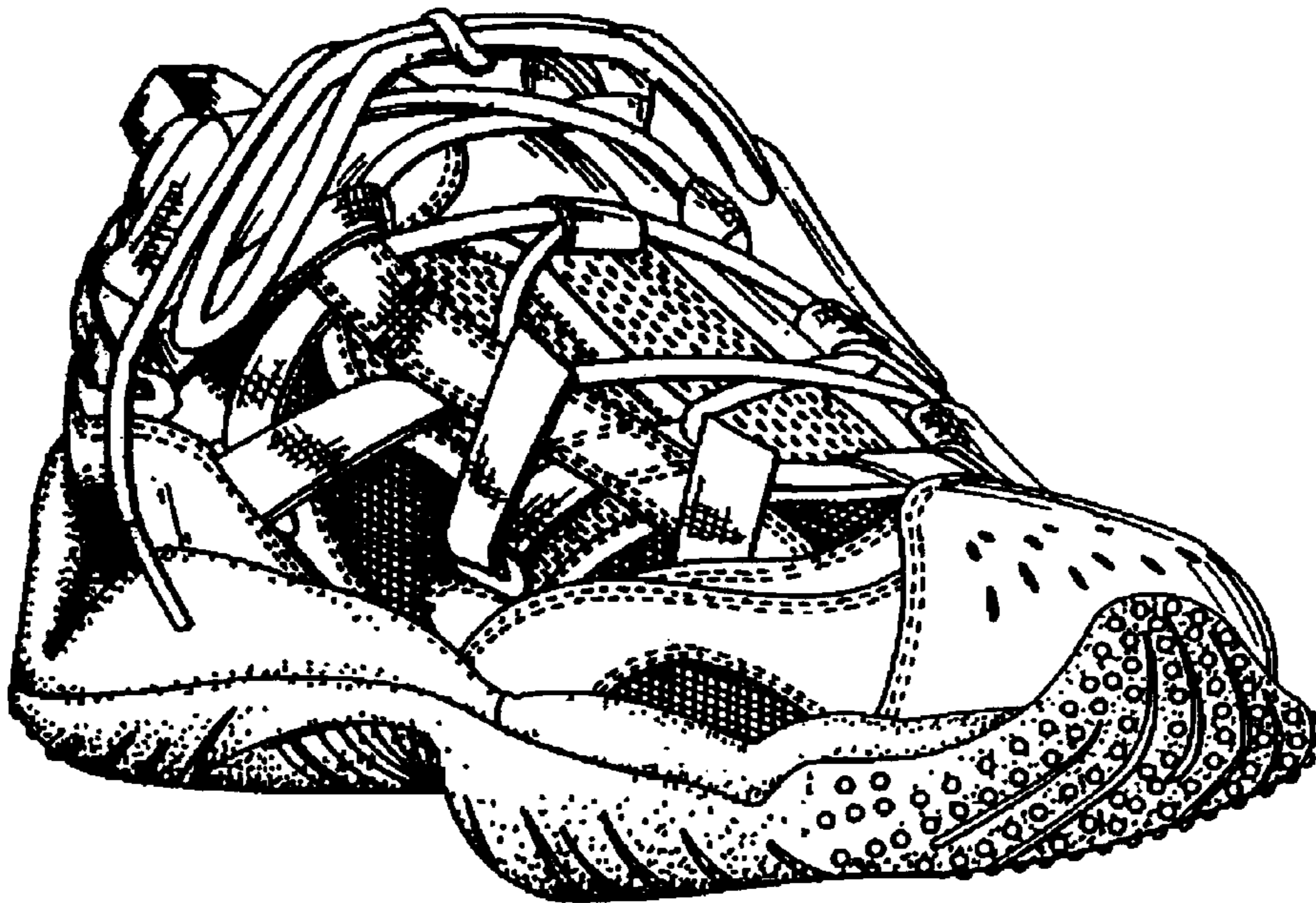

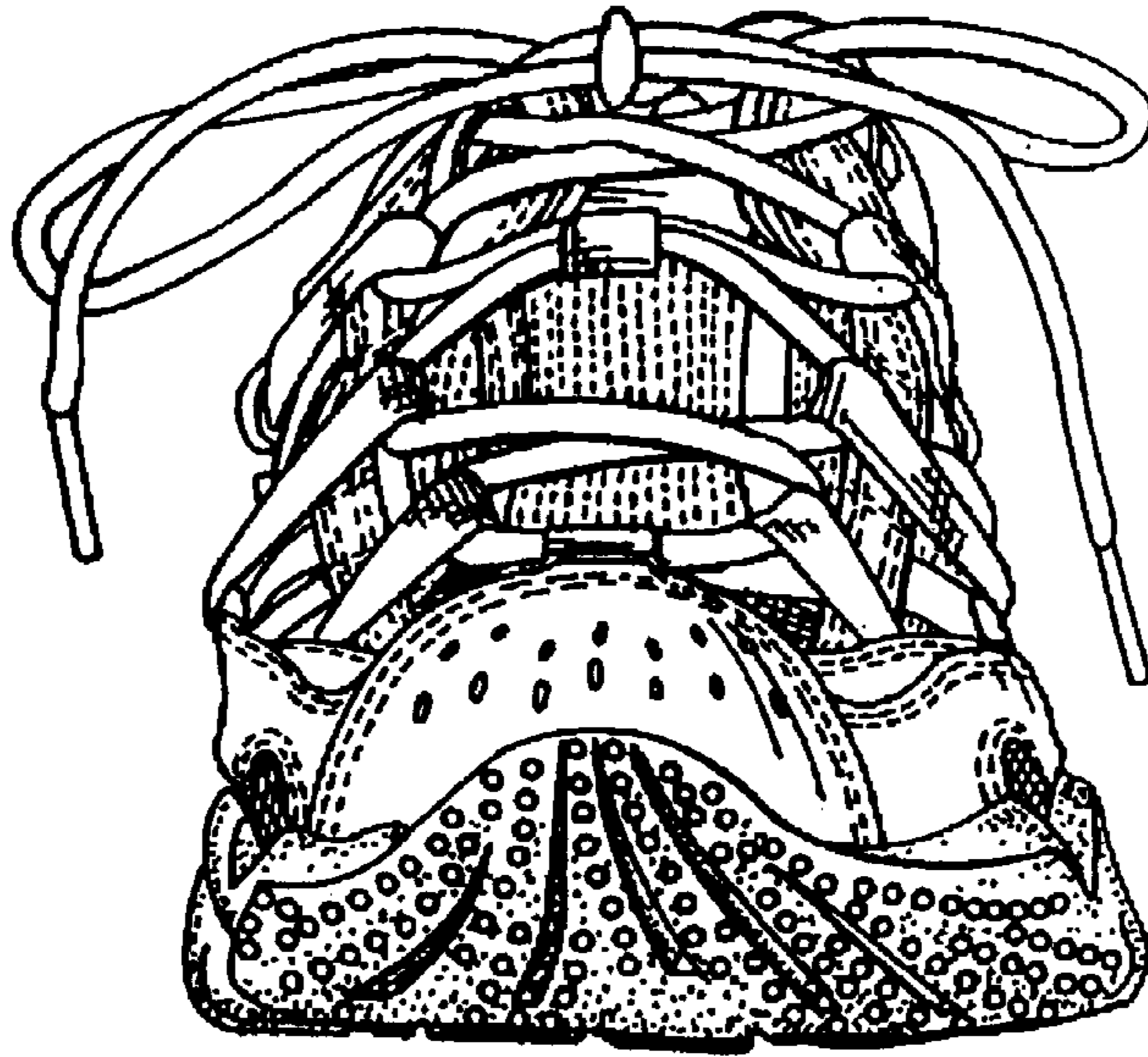

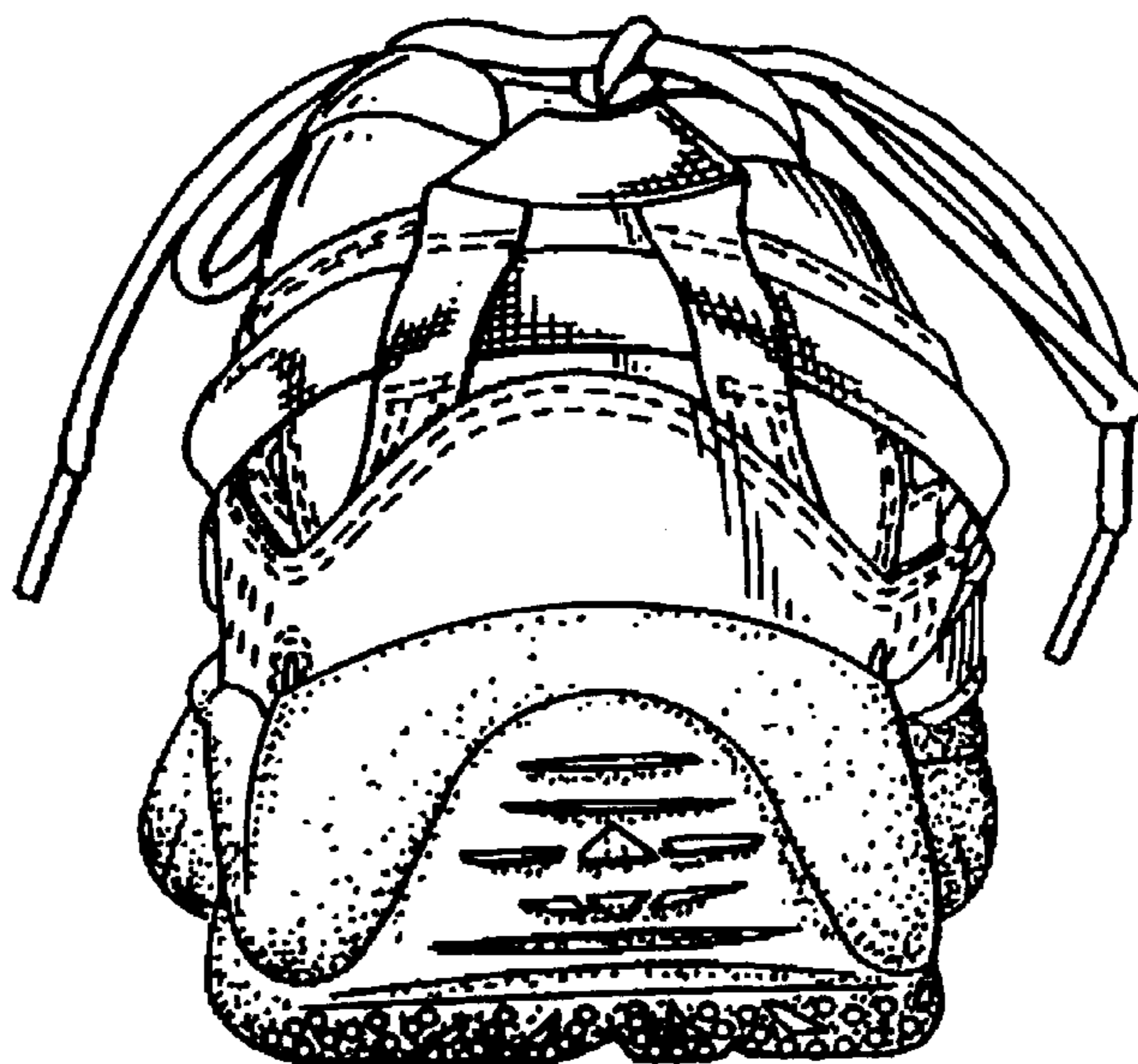

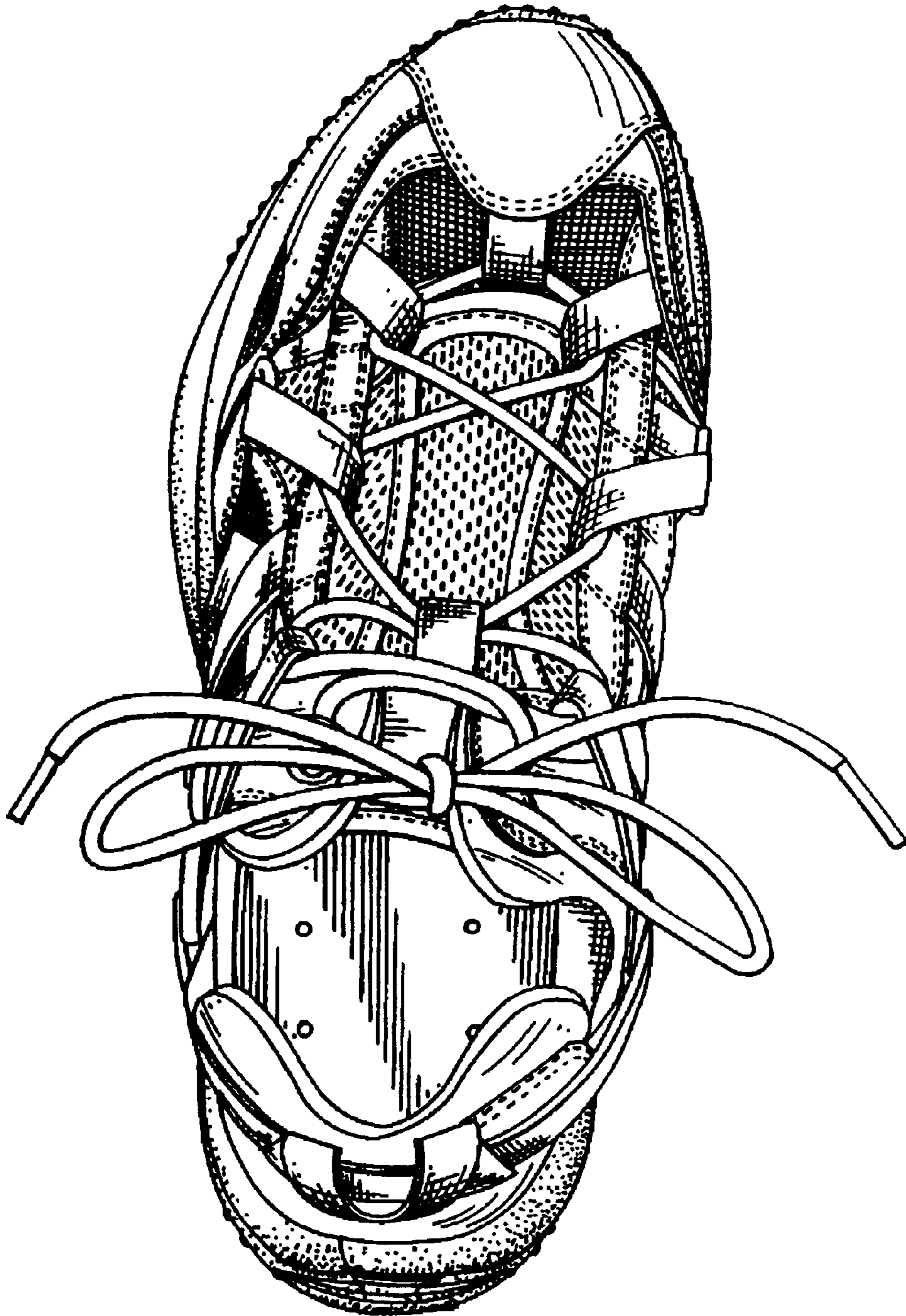
