(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a set of road barrier and executive toy pieces, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a female end segment of the set of road barrier and executive toy pieces showing my new design, the showing of part of the set in FIGS. 1–9 and 12 is for ease of illustration only;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a bottom perspective view thereof;


FIG. 10 is an exploded view of the set of road barrier and executive toy pieces;


FIG. 11 is a partial perspective view of the set of road barrier and executive toy pieces, in an alternative position;


FIG. 12 is an enlarged perspective view of two segments of the set of road barrier and executive toy pieces; and,


FIG. 13 is an enlarged partial perspective view of the set of road barrier and executive toy pieces.



















