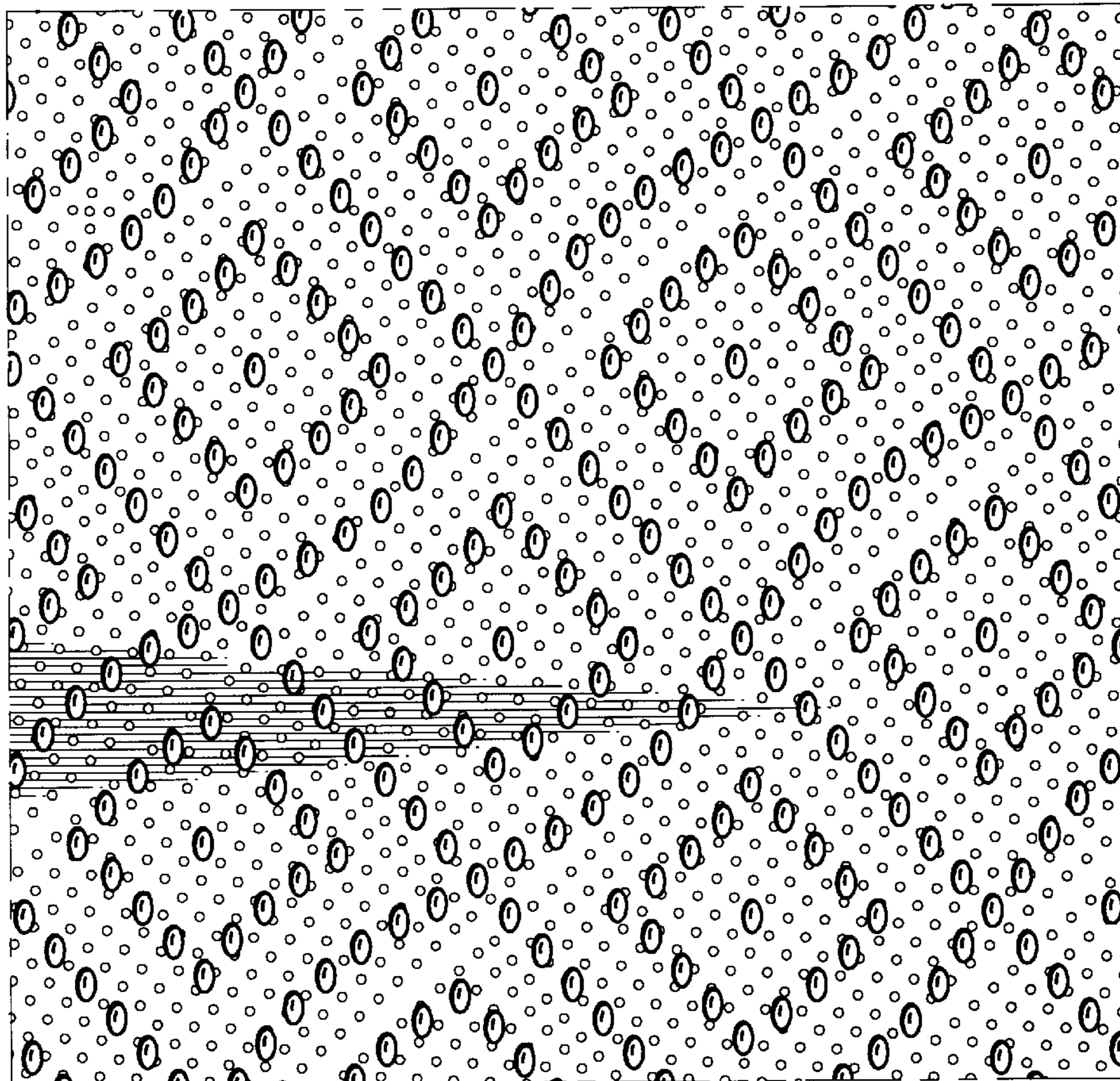
In the drawings, the broken lines depict the boundaries of the claimed design and form no part thereof.

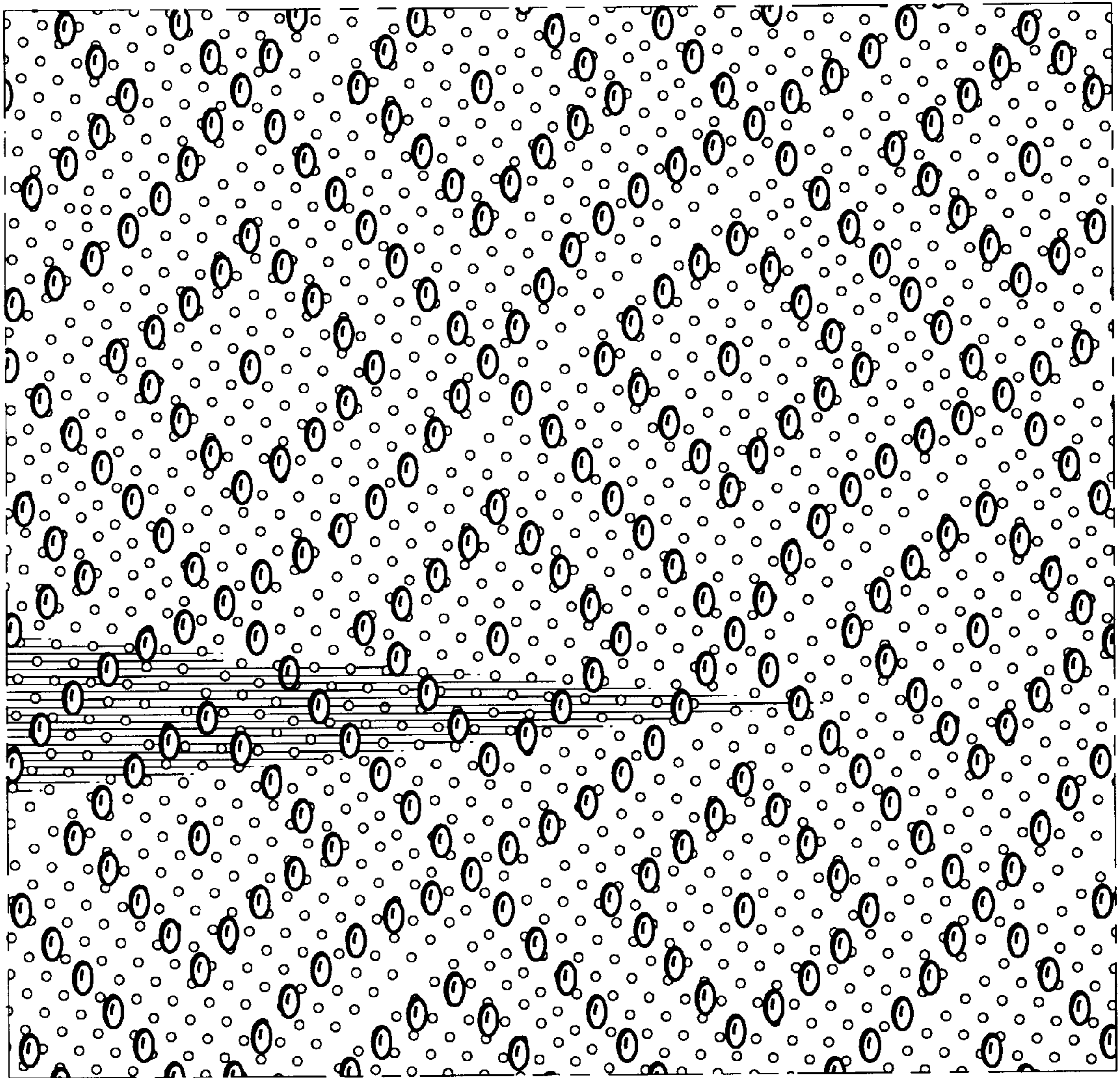

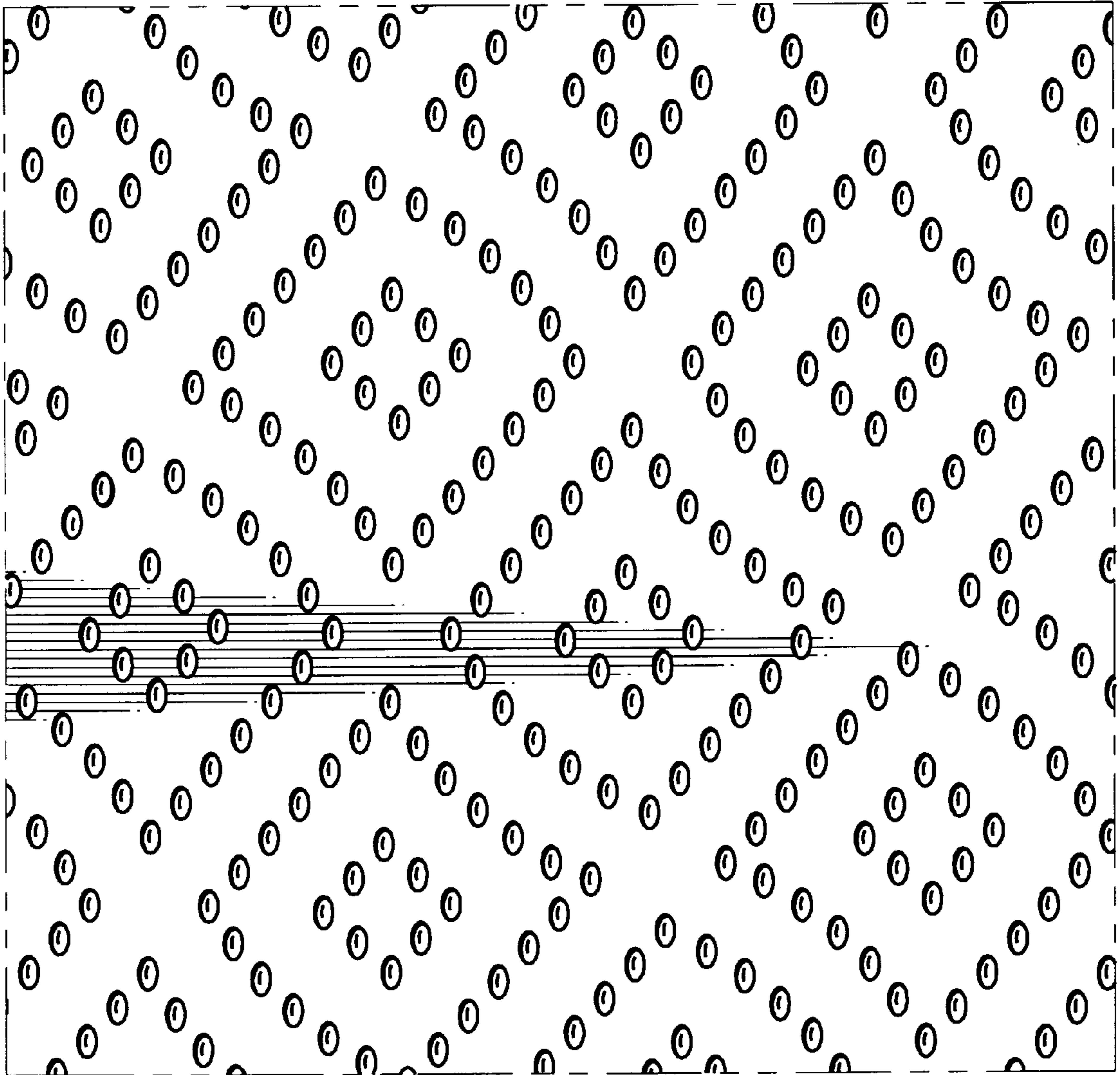
