(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a plastic bag carrier/handle, as shown and described.

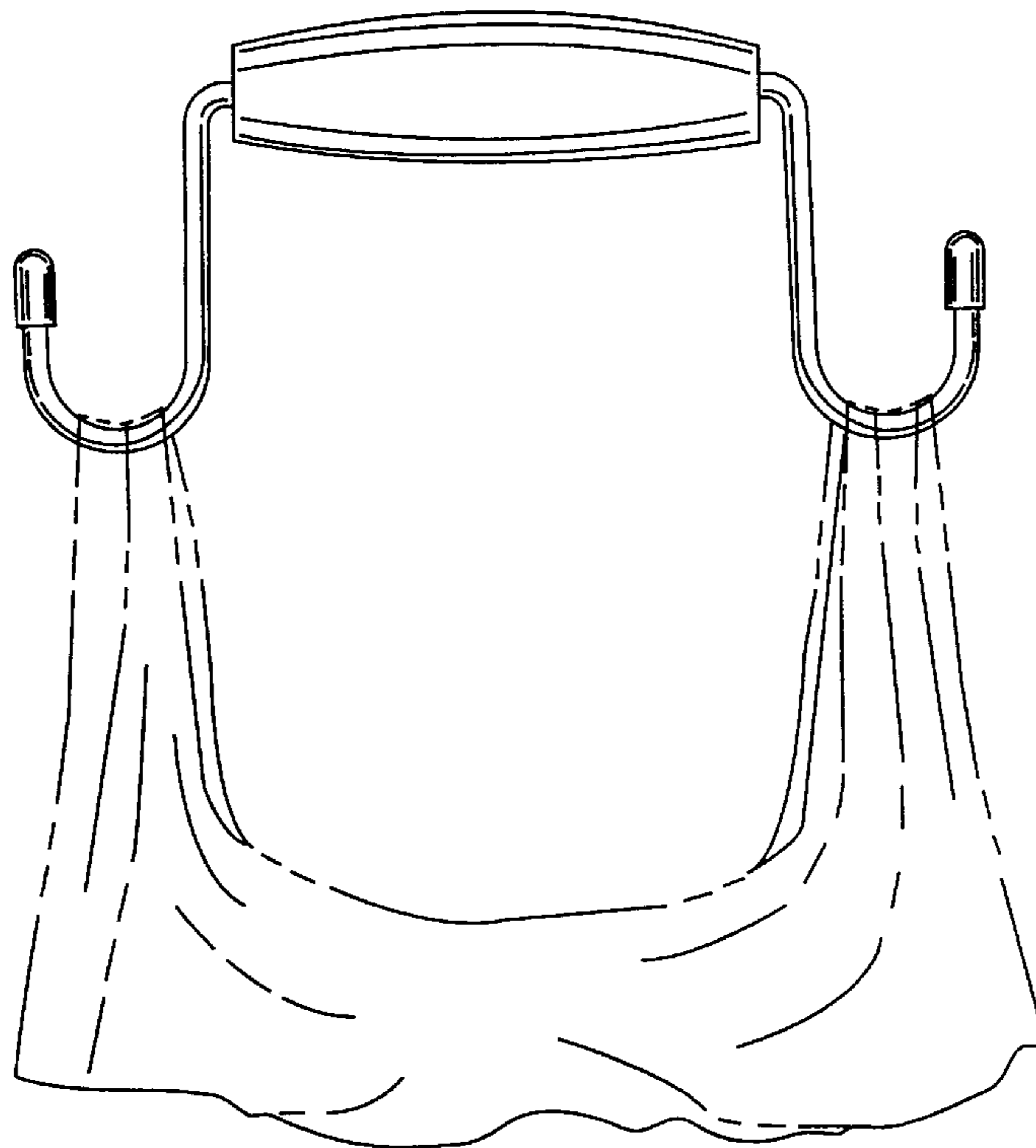

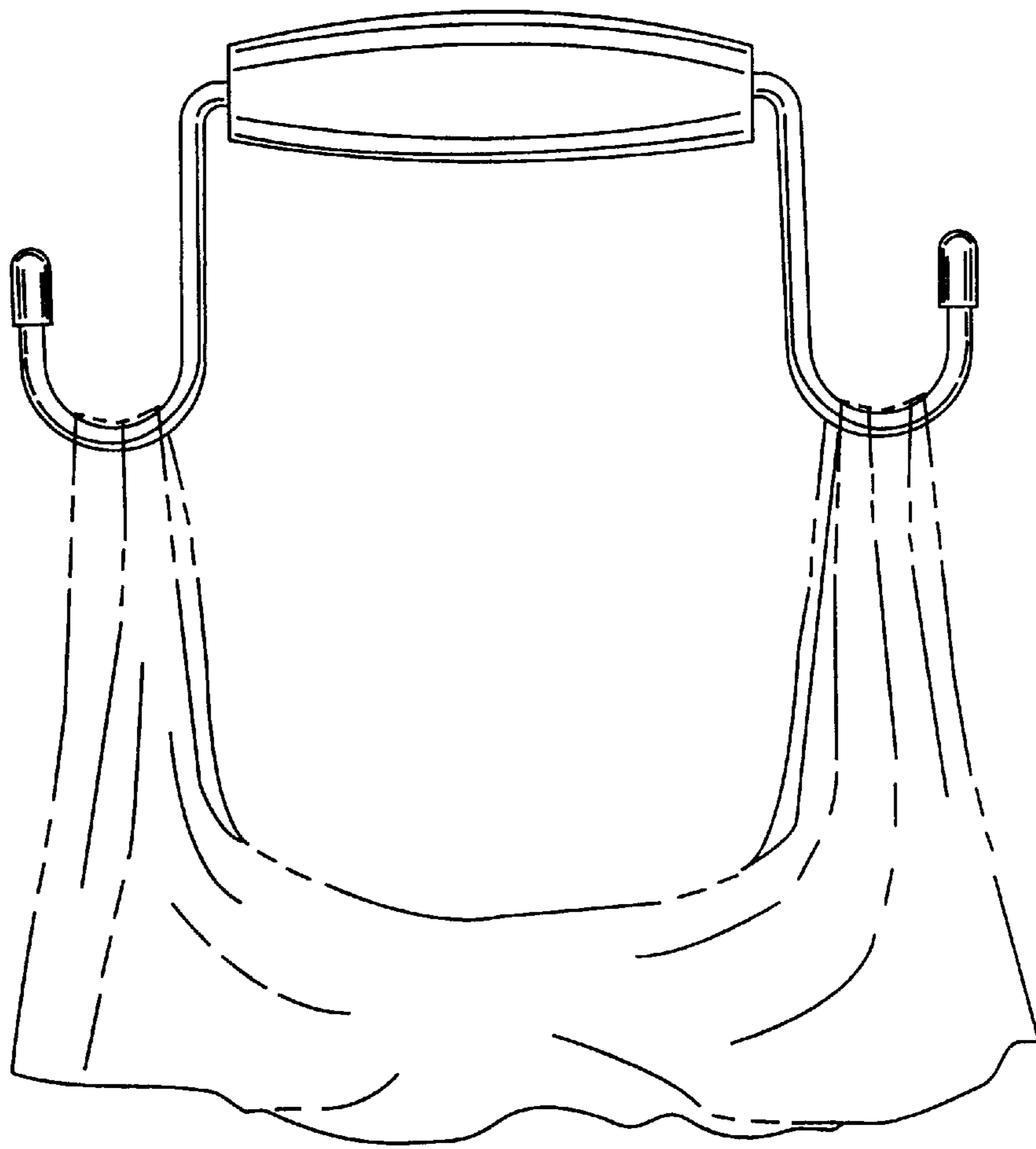
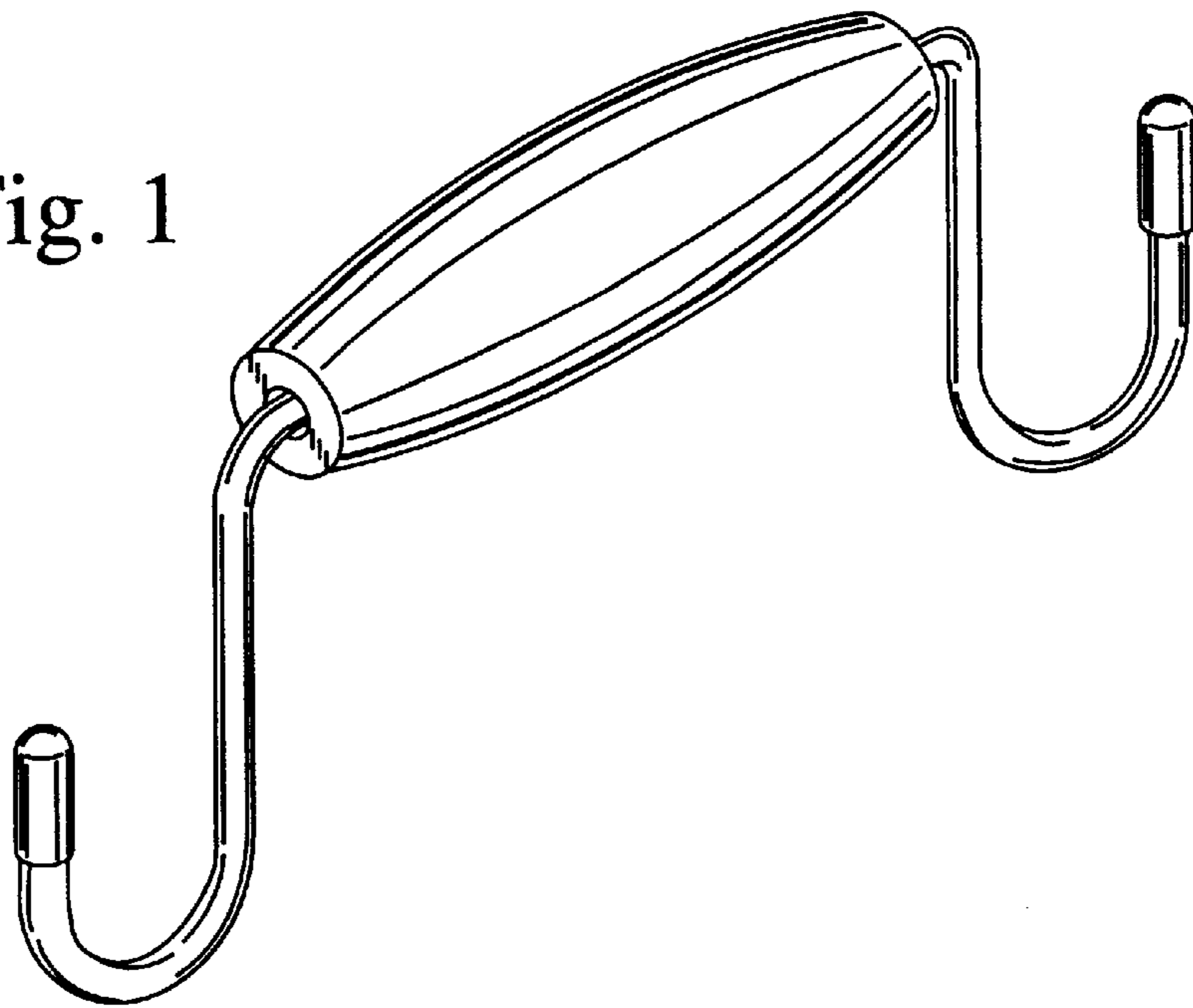
