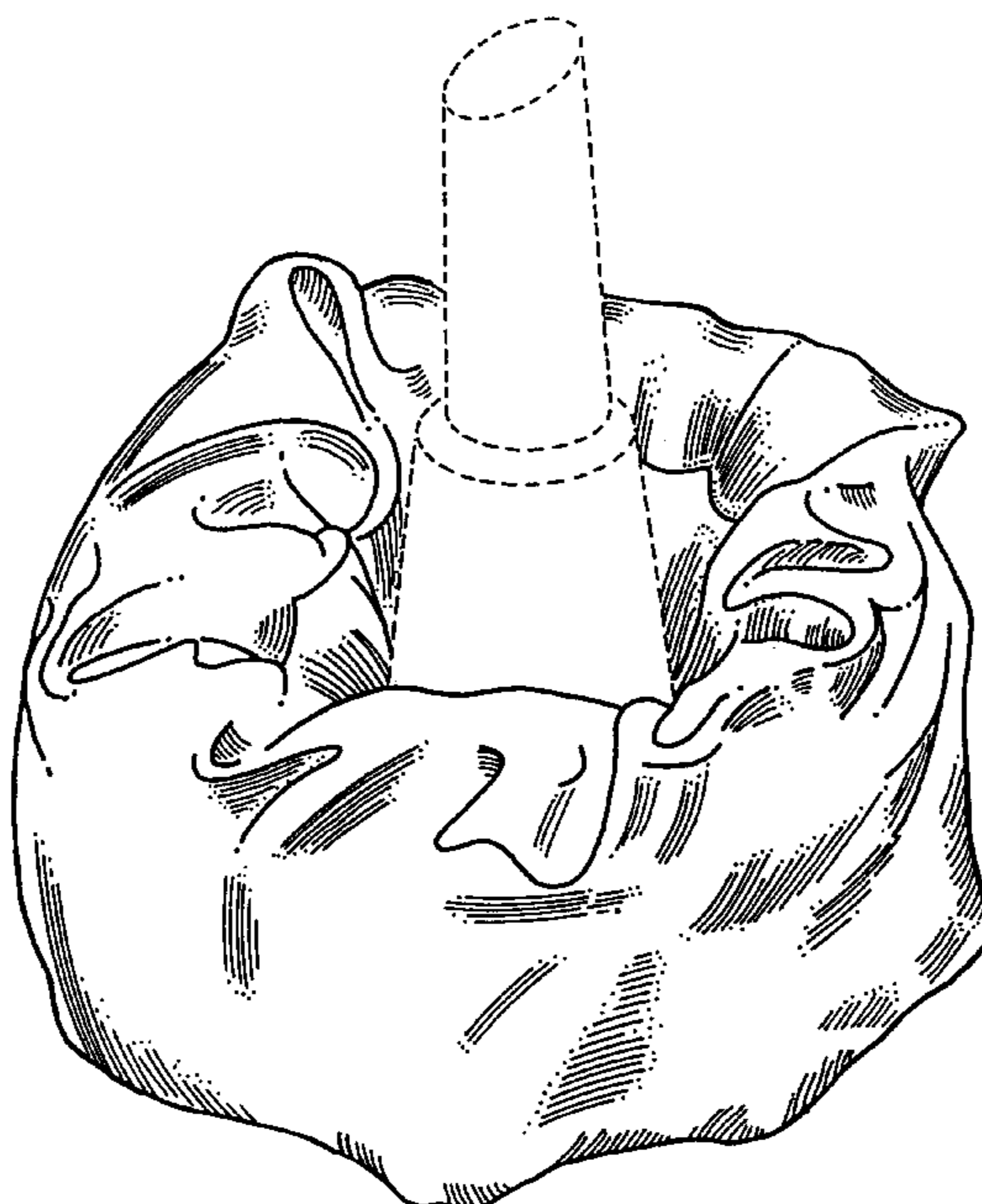
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a nail polish bottle holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a nail polish bottle holder showing the new design with a nail polish bottle (which does not form part of the design) shown in broken lines. The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; and, FIG. 2 is a side perspective view thereof. 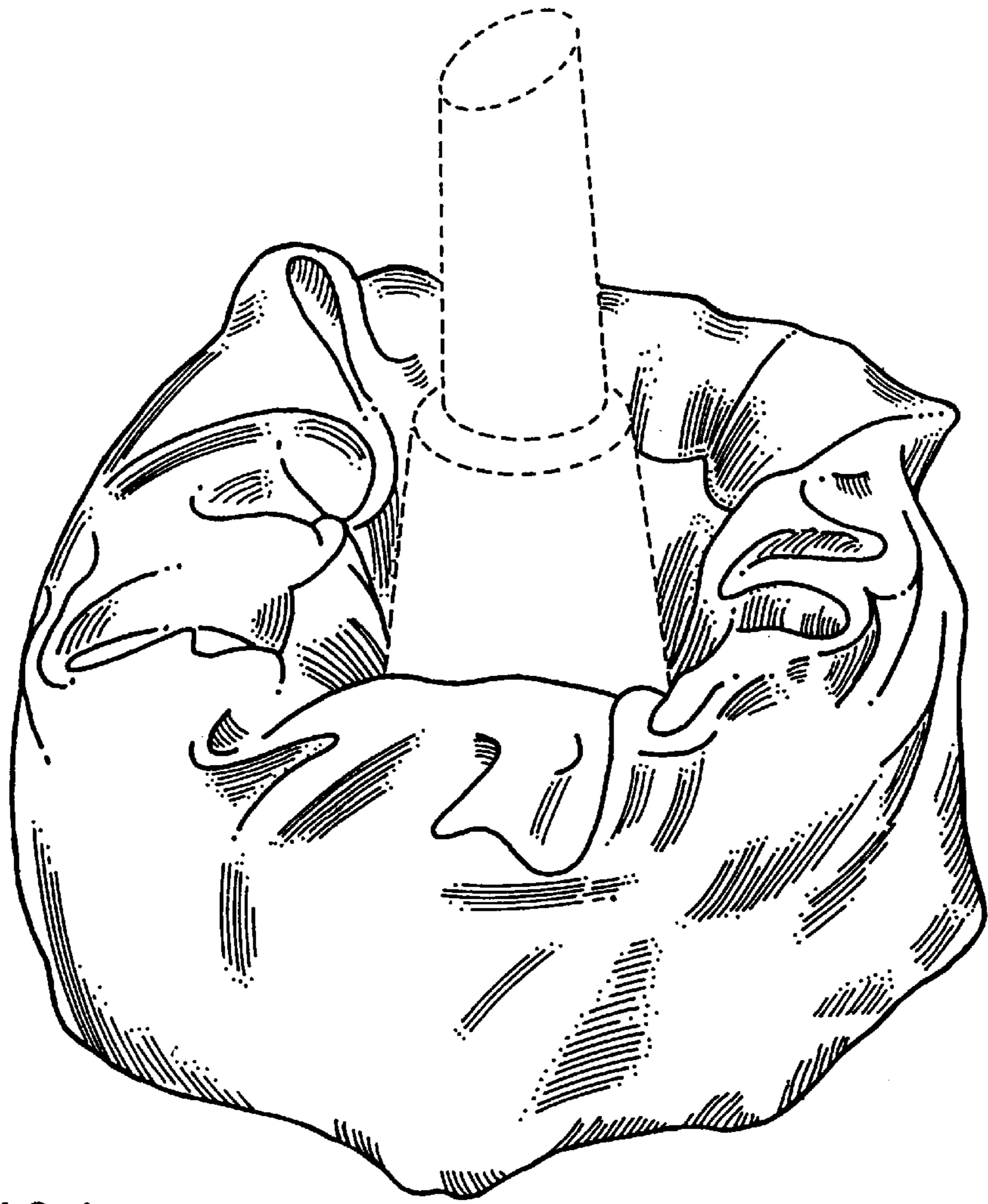

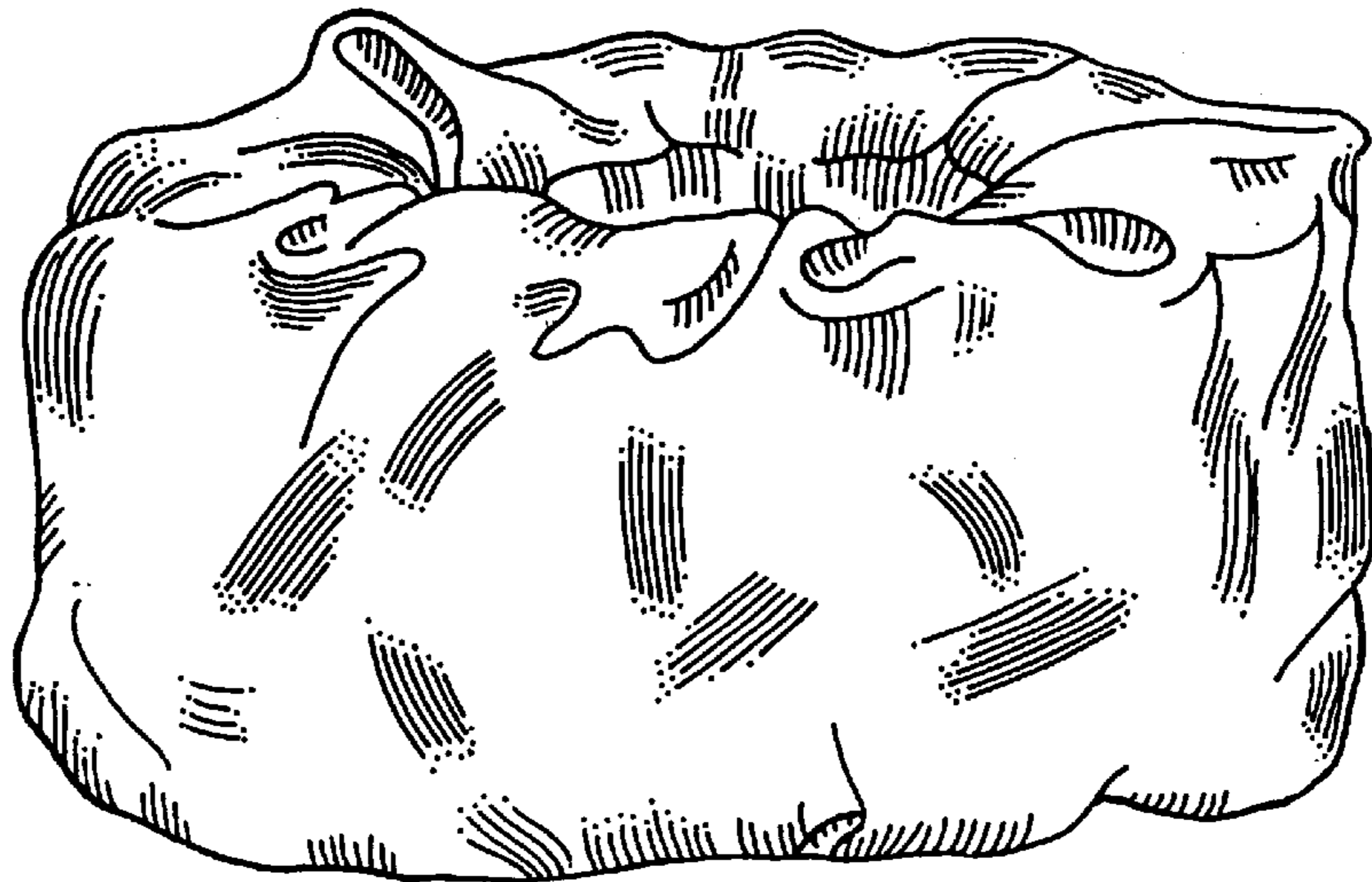
