(57) **CLAIM**

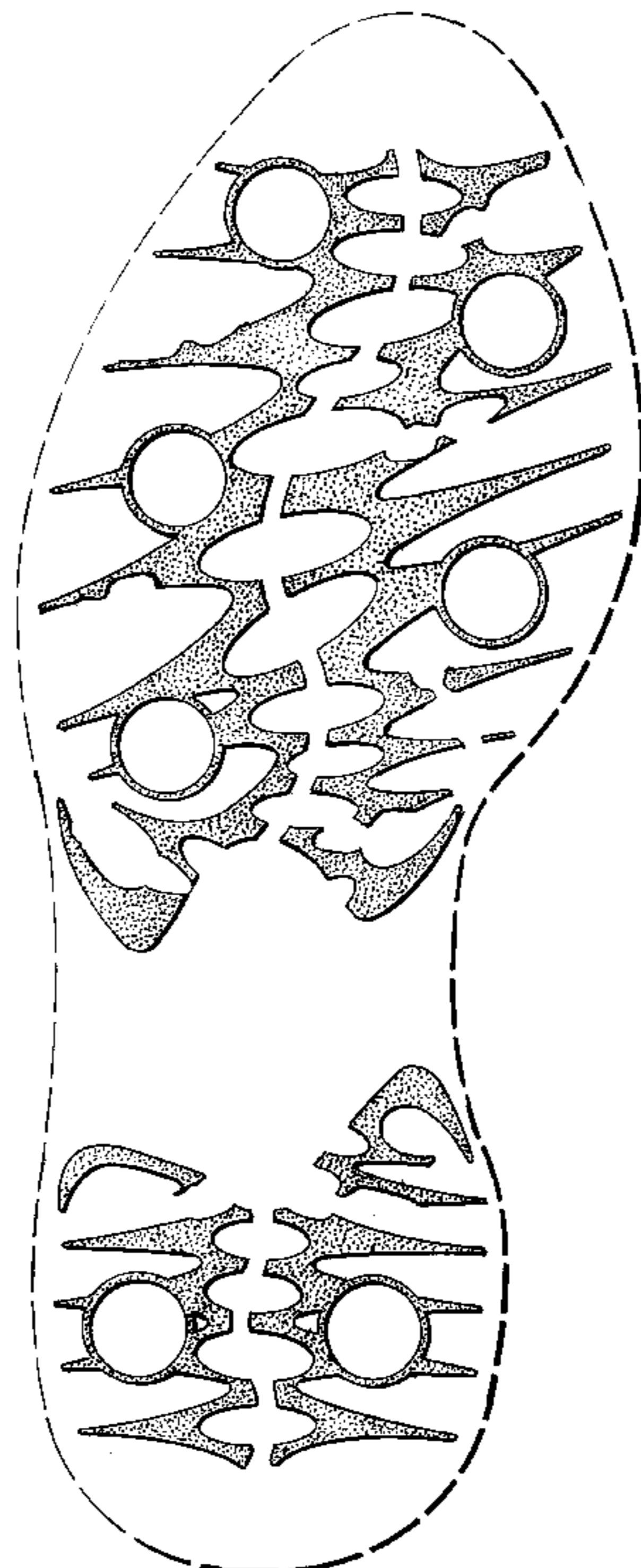
The ornamental design for a portion of a golf shoe outsole, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a portion of a golf shoe outsole showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side view of the portion of a golf shoe outsole of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a left side view of the portion of a golf shoe outsole of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a front view of the portion of a golf shoe outsole of FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 5 is a rear view of the portion of a golf shoe outsole of FIG. 1.

The broken line showing the outline of a shoe sole throughout the views illustrates environmental subject matter which forms no part of the claimed design.

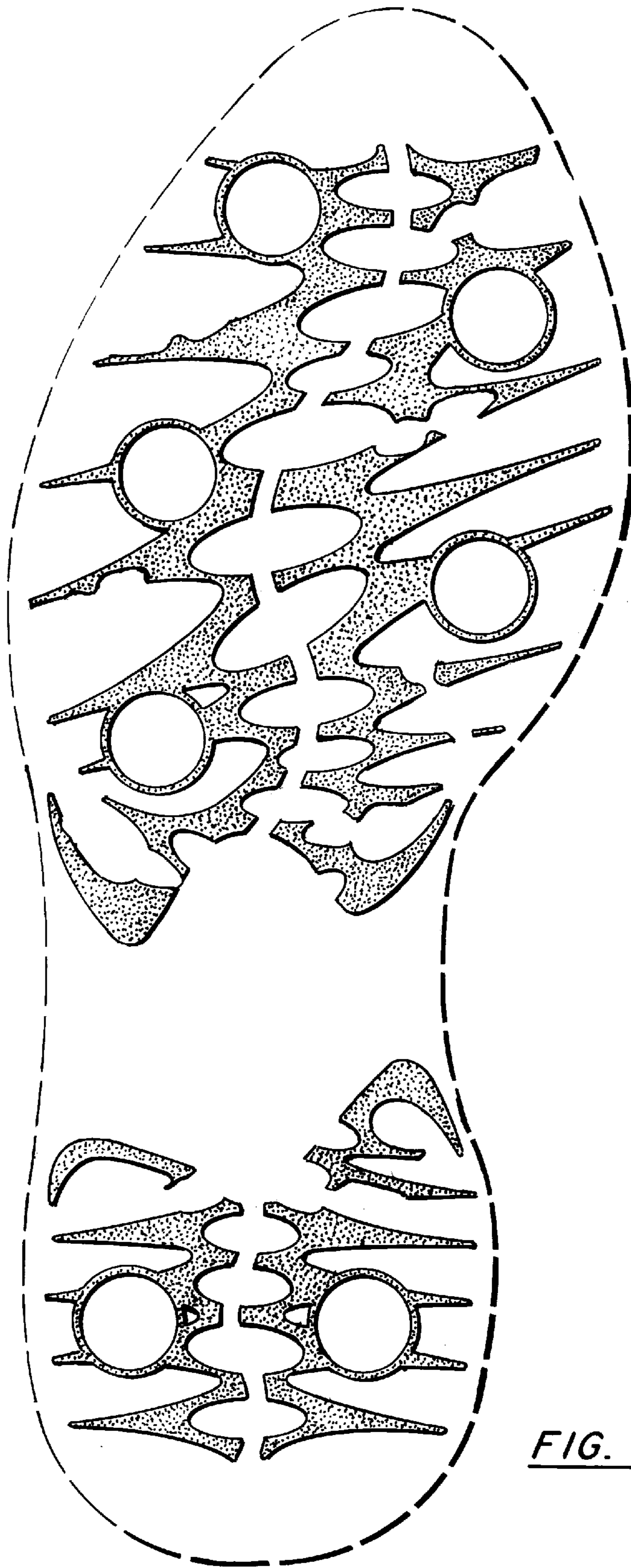

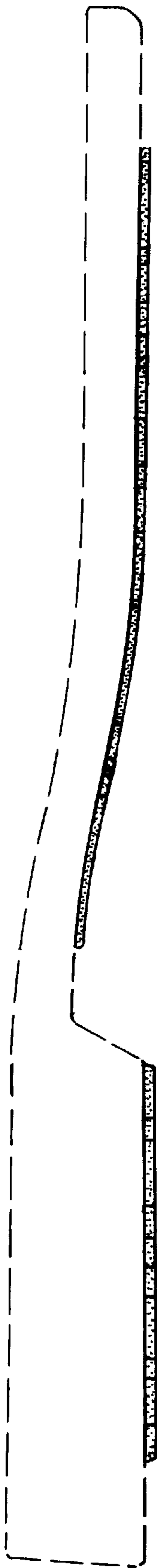

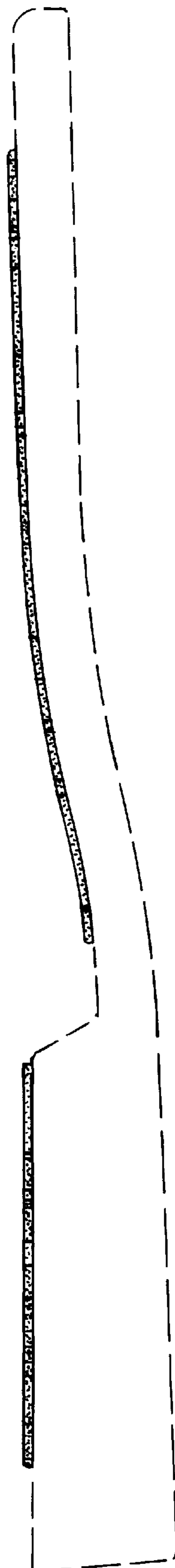

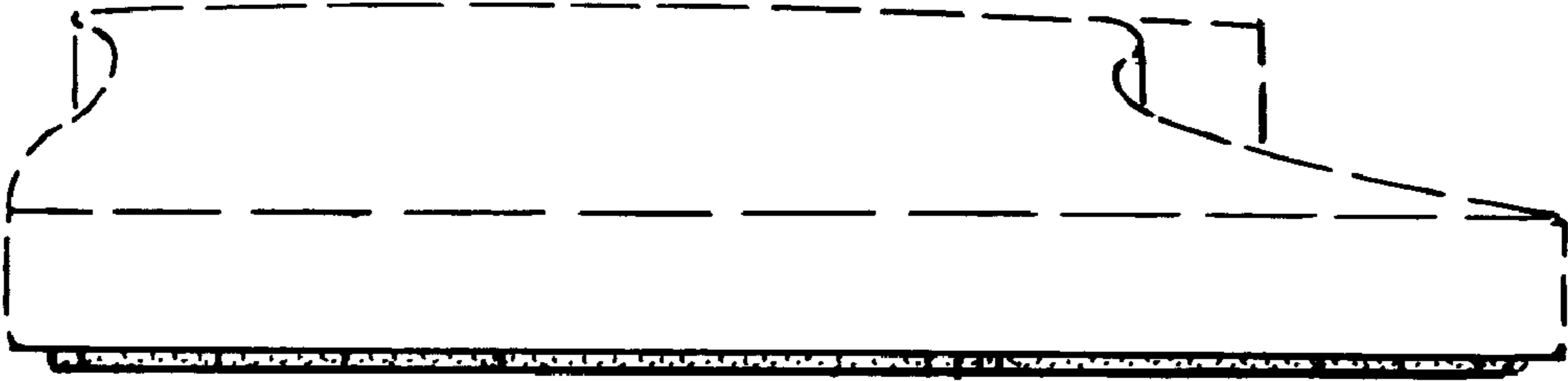

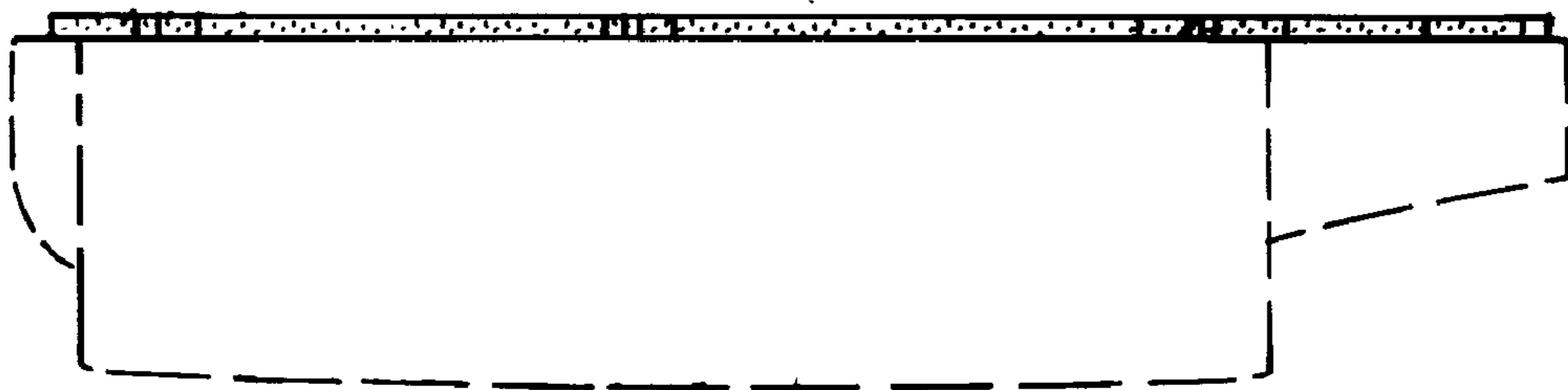
