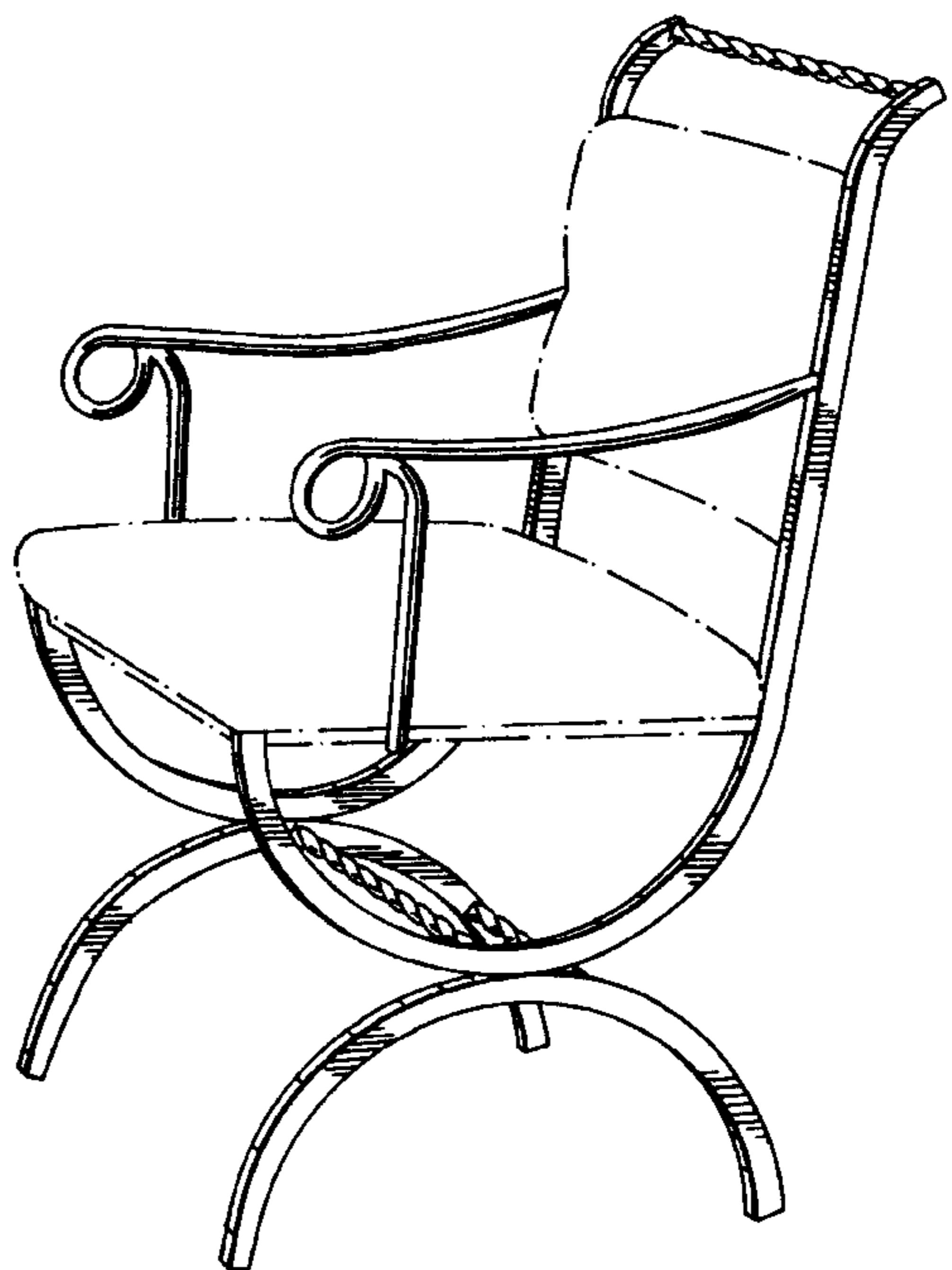
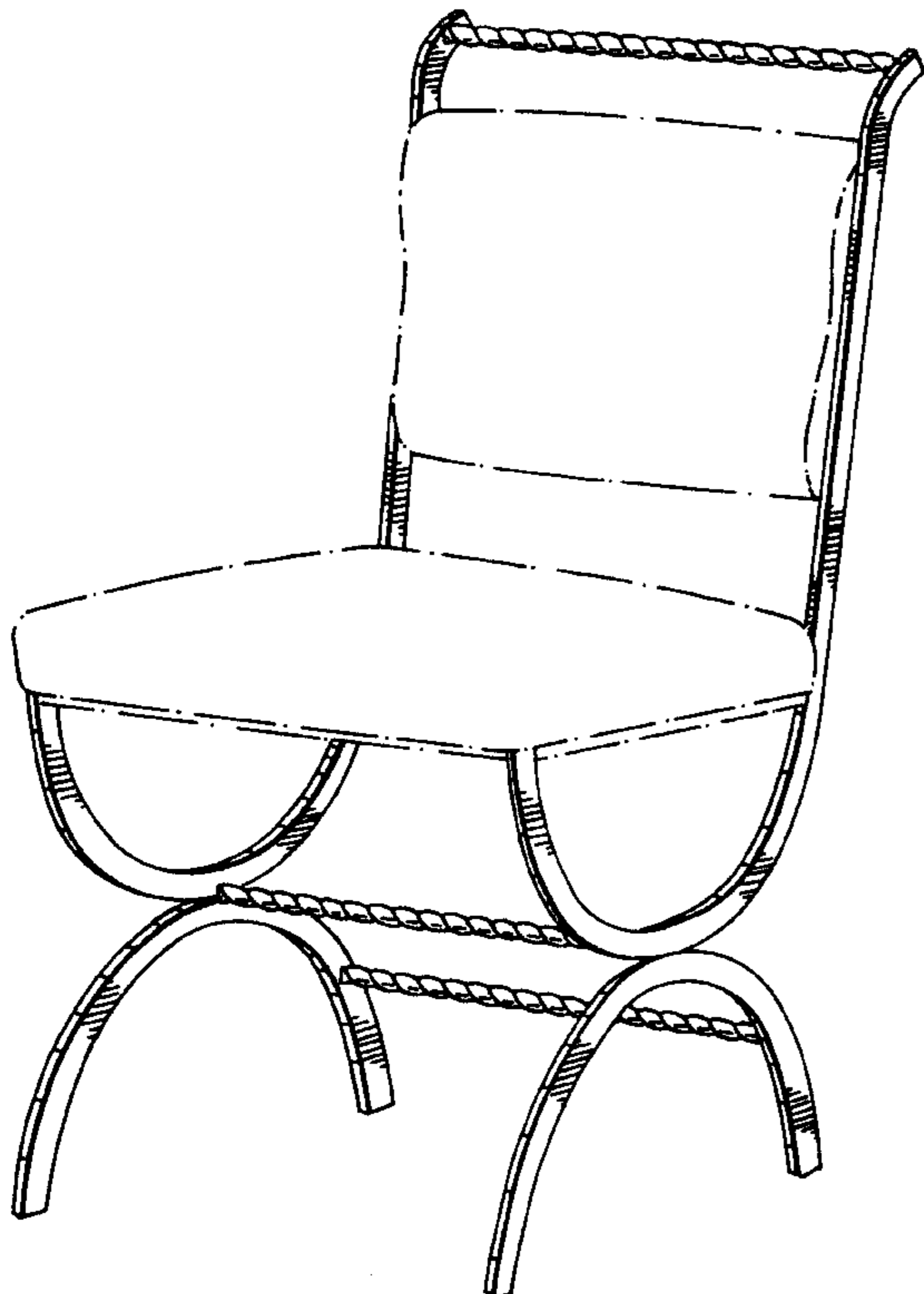
The ornamental design for chair, as shown and described.

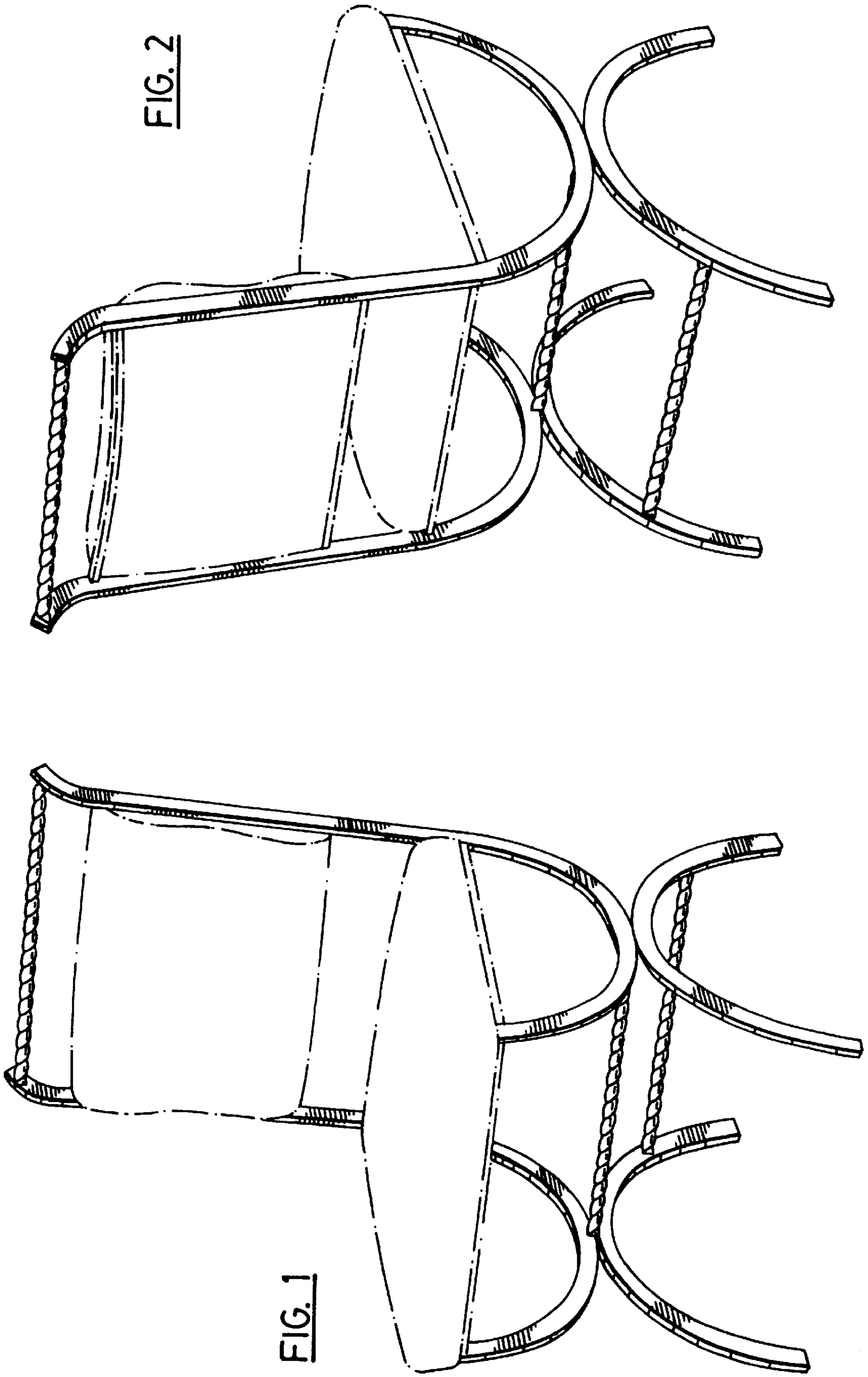
DESCRIPTION

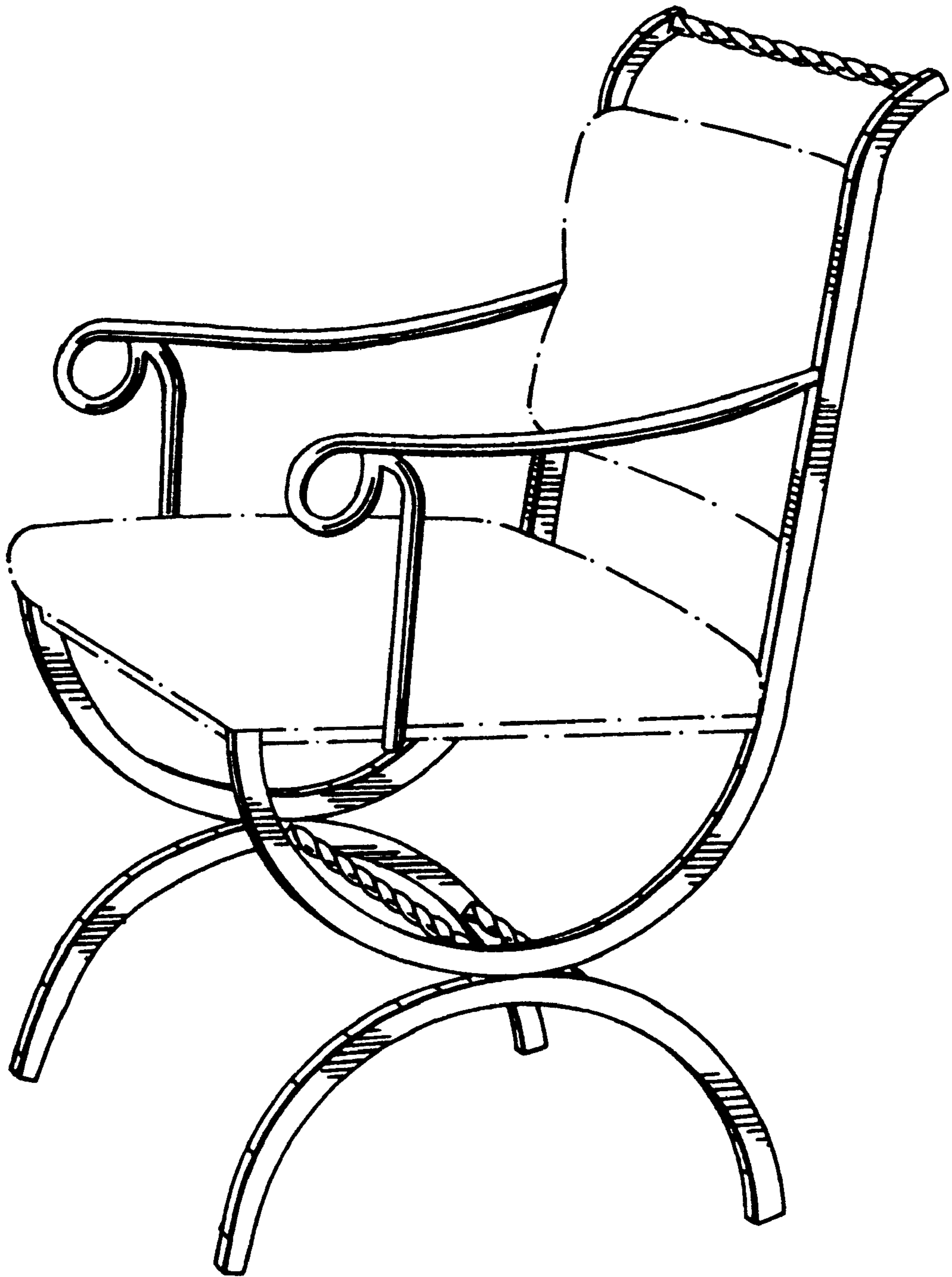
