FIG. 4 is a left side view of the door for a vehicle according to my novel design;

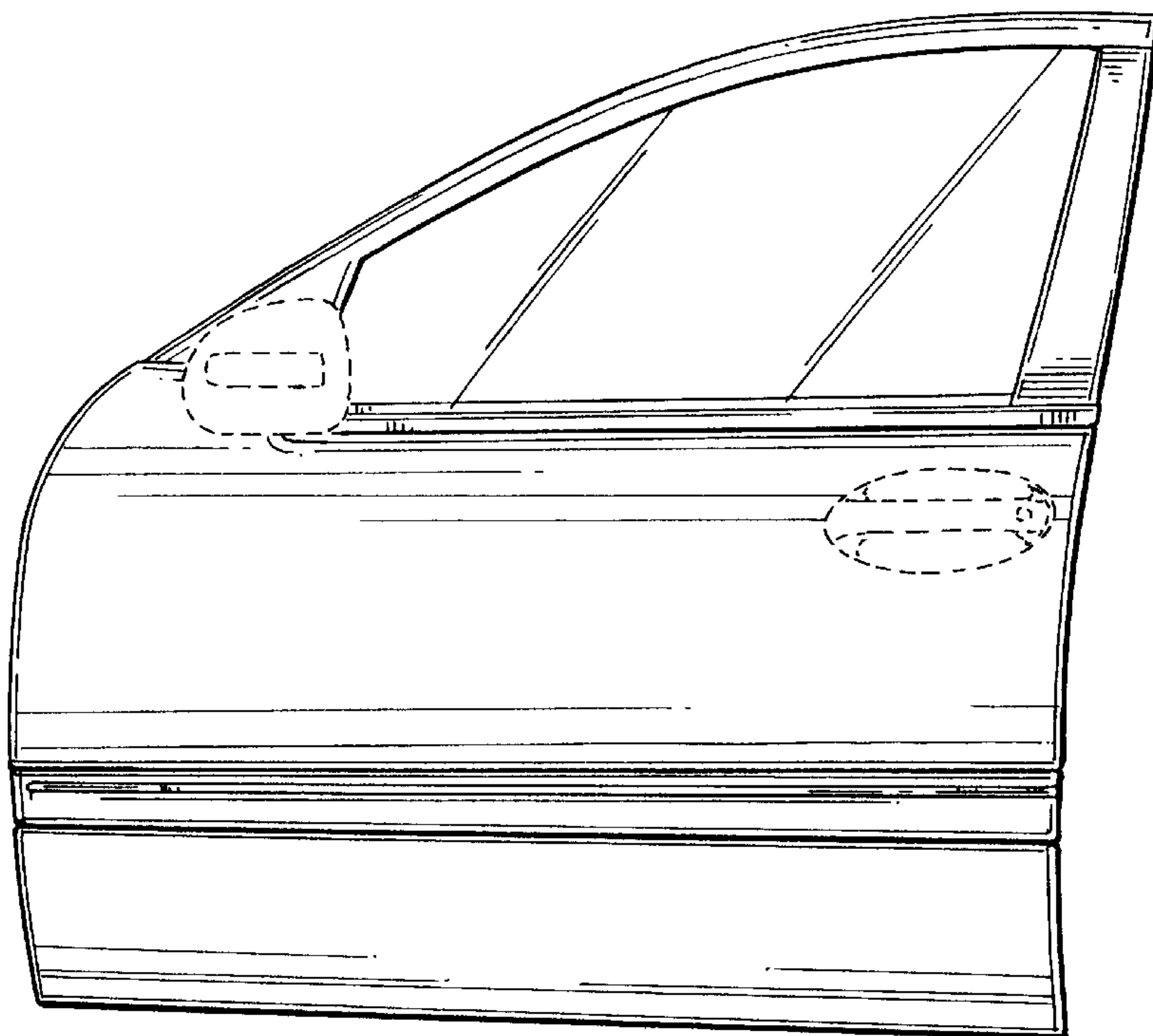
FIG. 5 is right side view of the door for a vehicle according to my novel design;

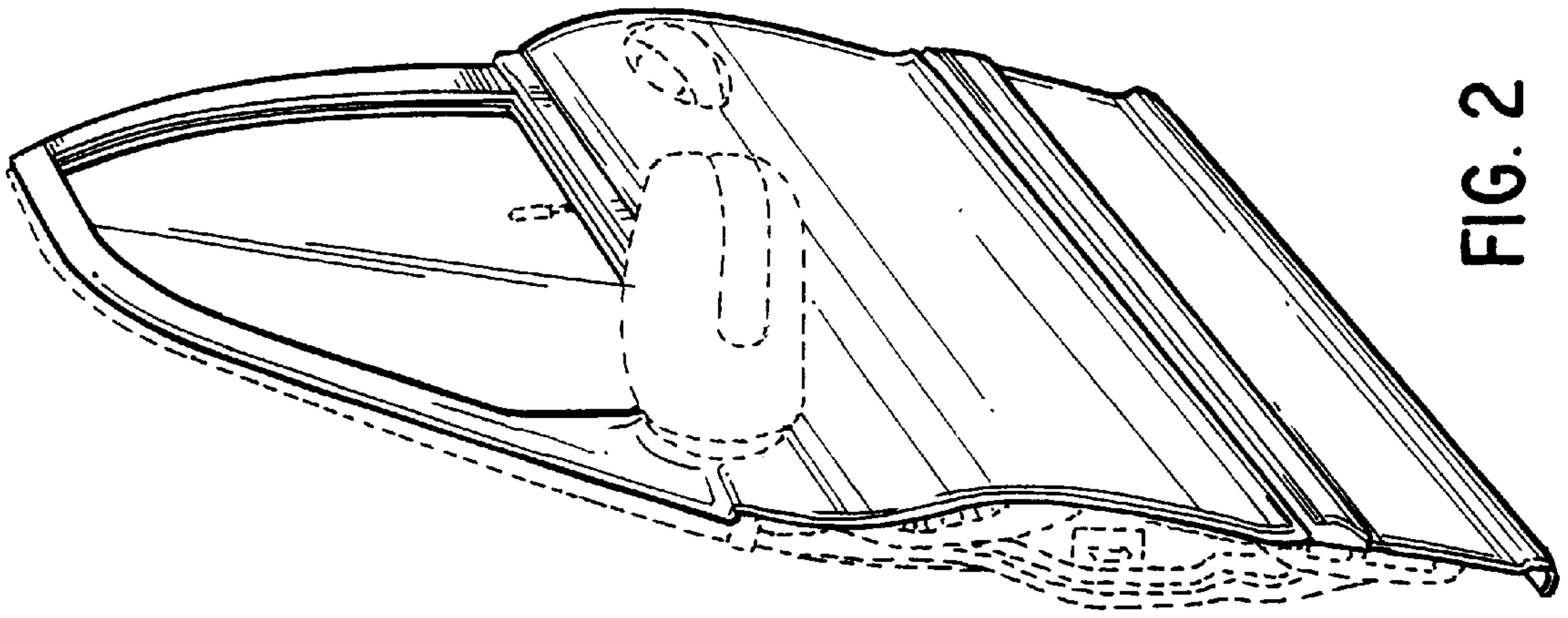

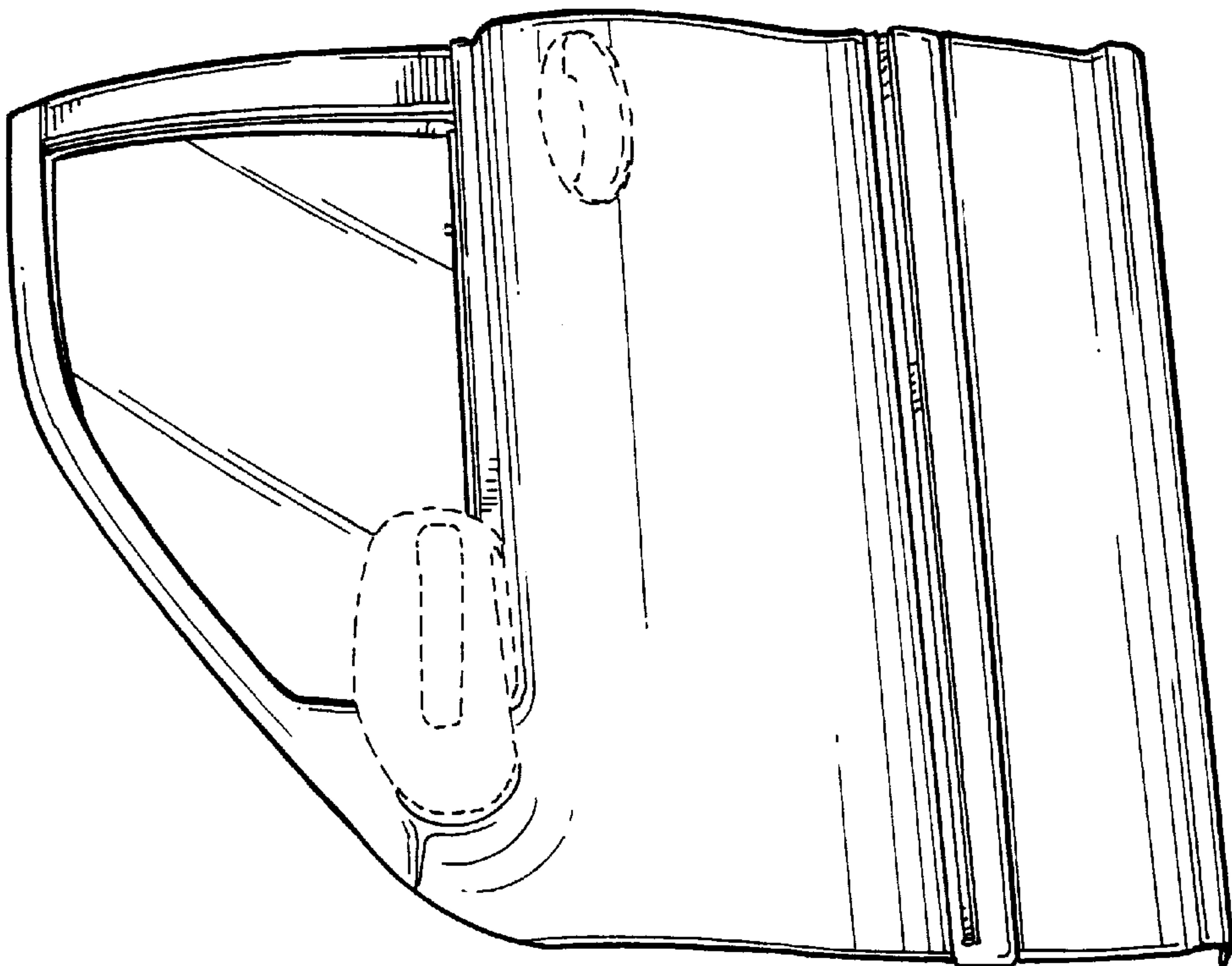

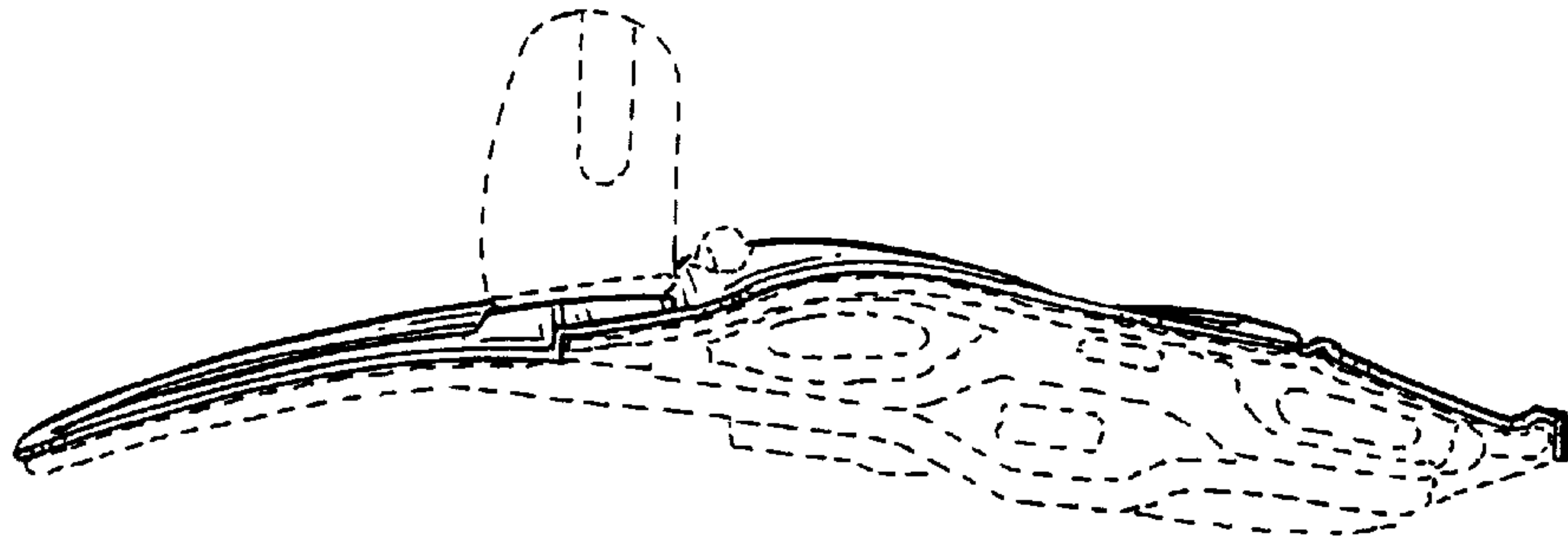

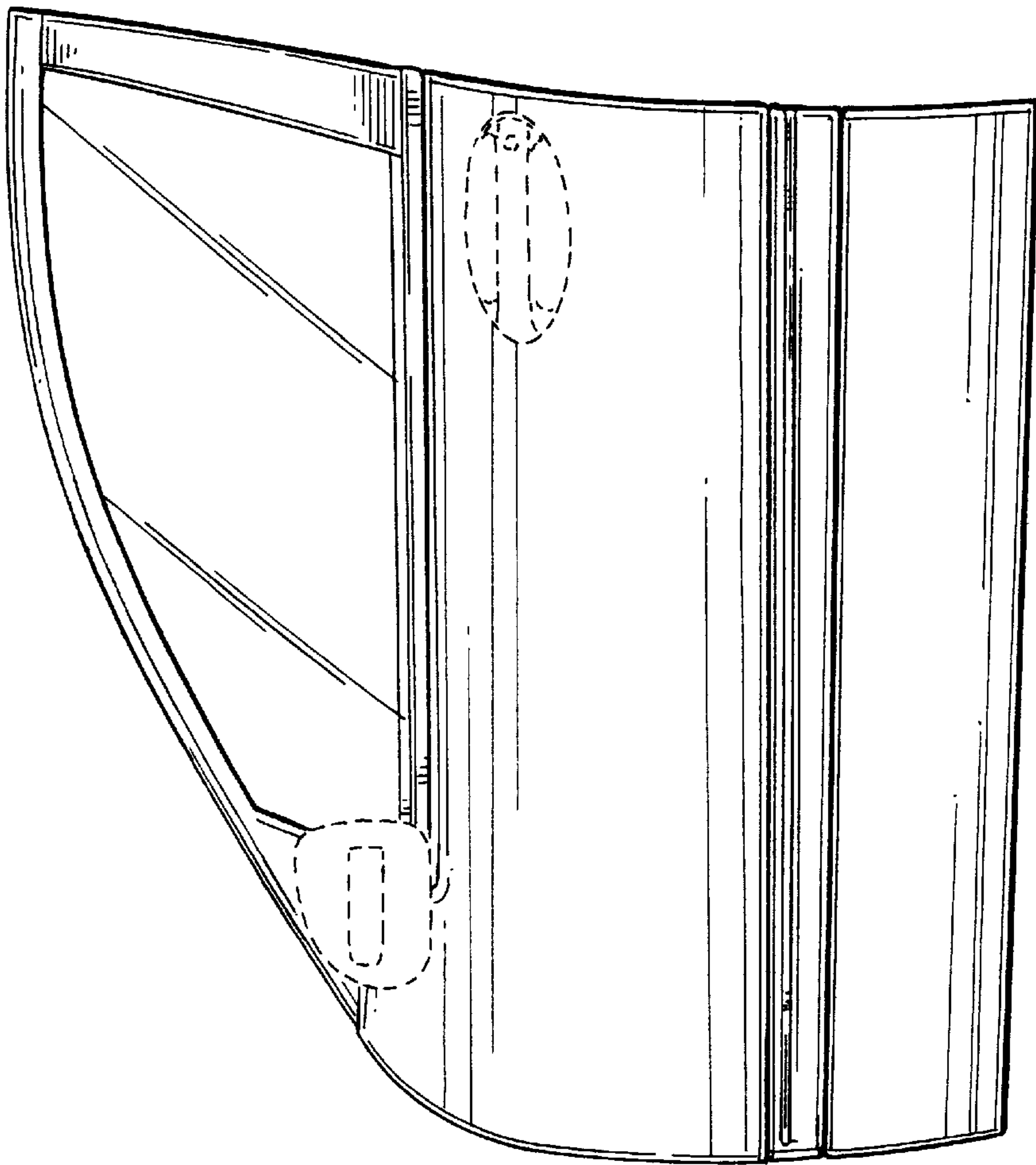

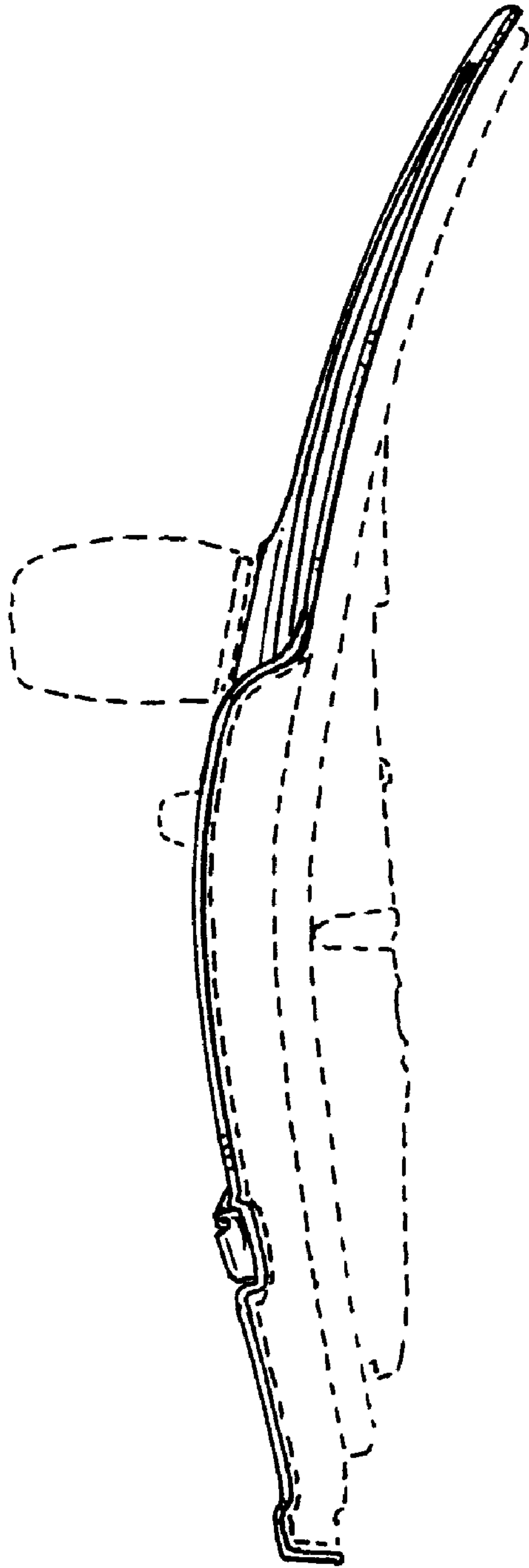

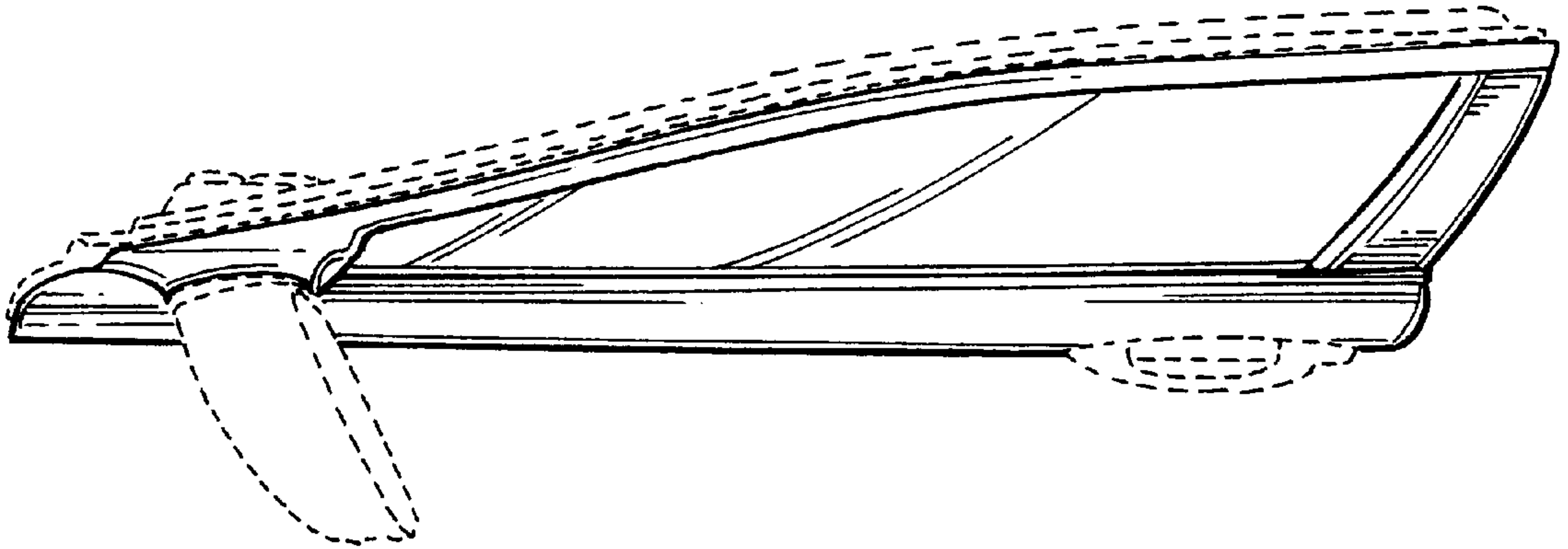

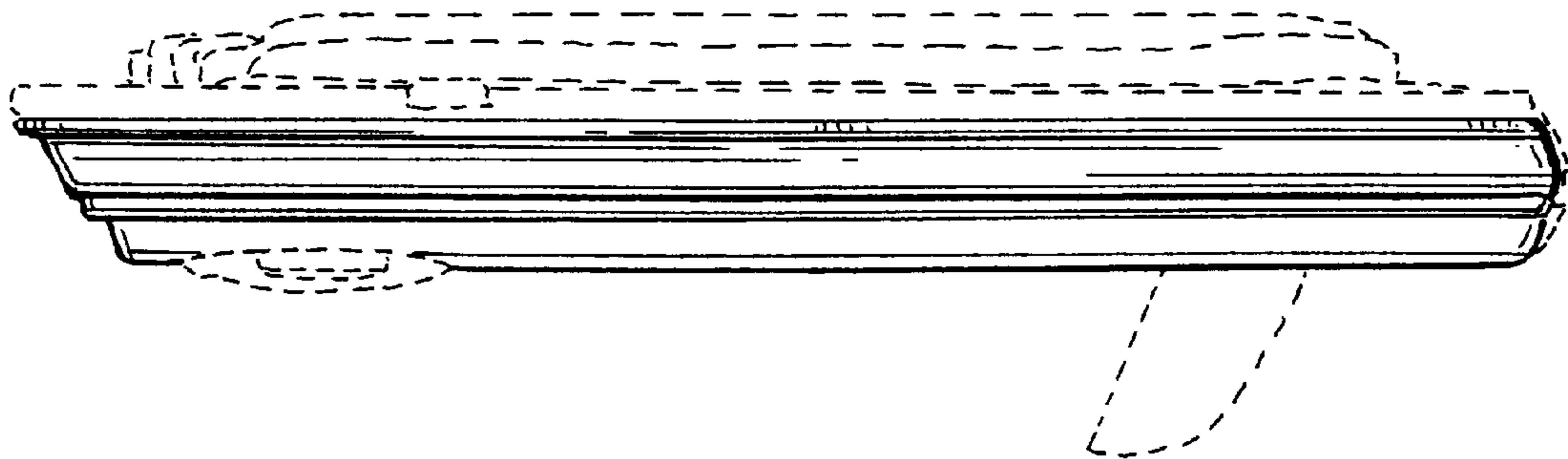
