FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the cup holder of the invention showing it being mounted on an upright post, the post being shown in phantom lines and forming no part of the present invention;

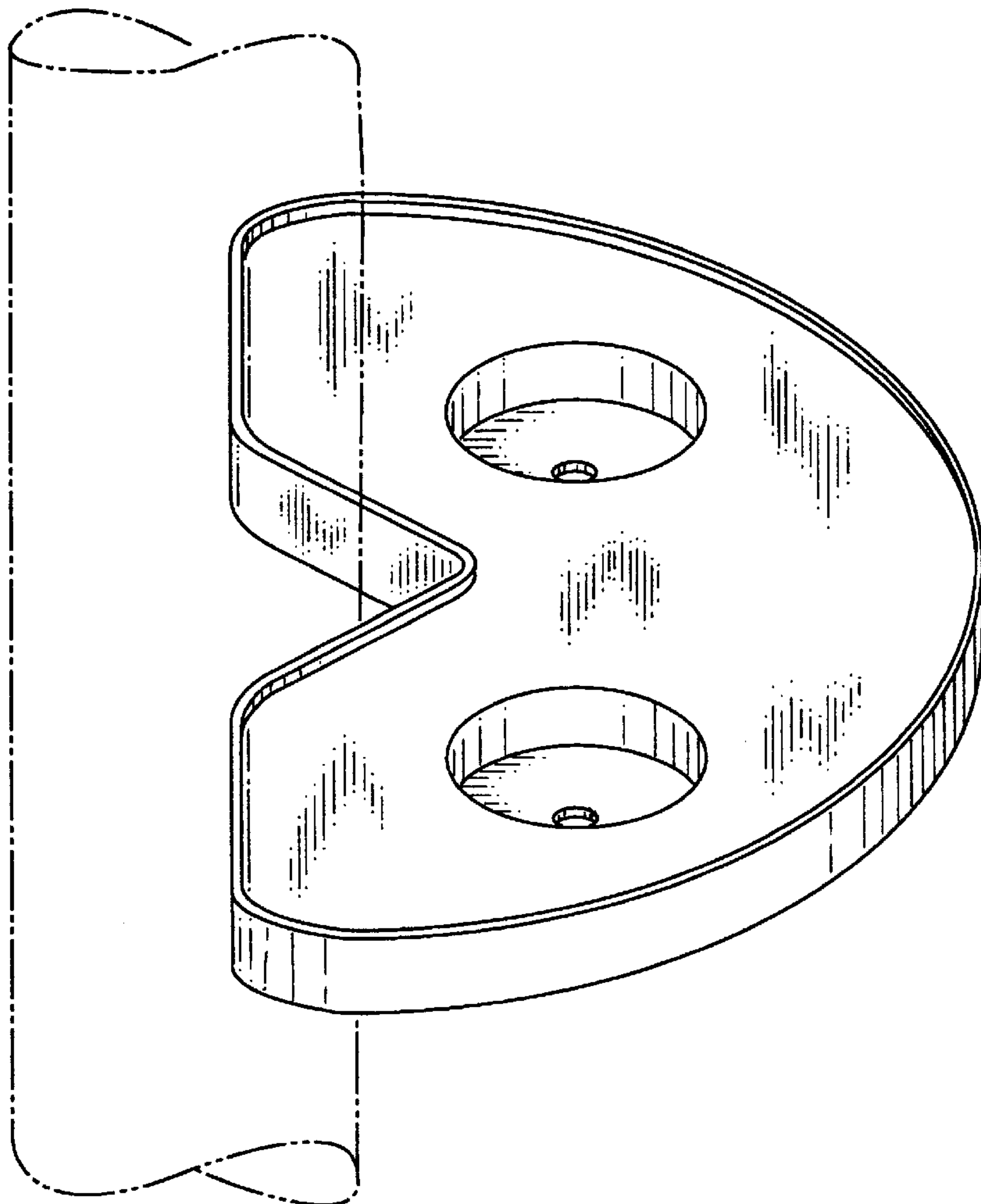
FIG. 2 is a top view of the cup holder of the invention;

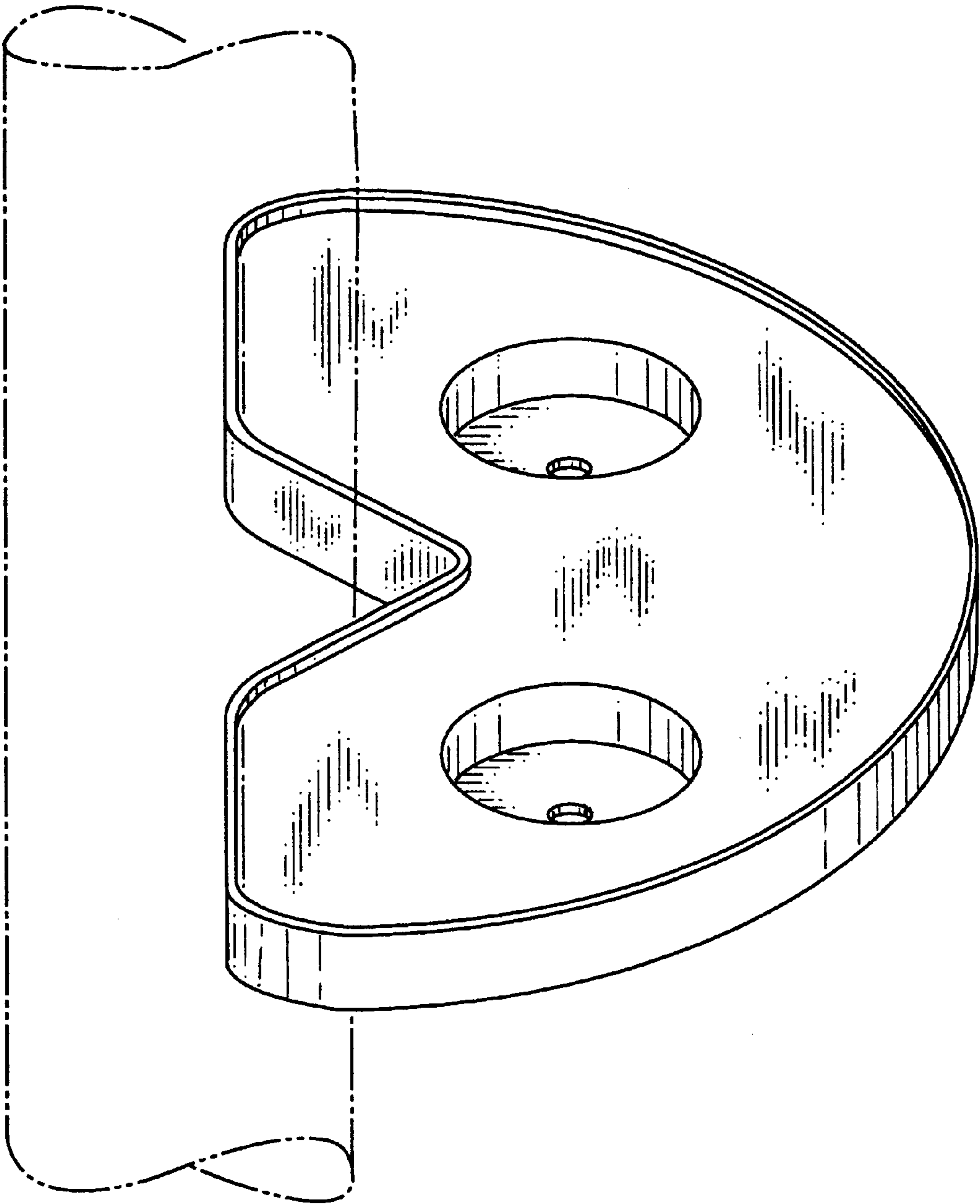

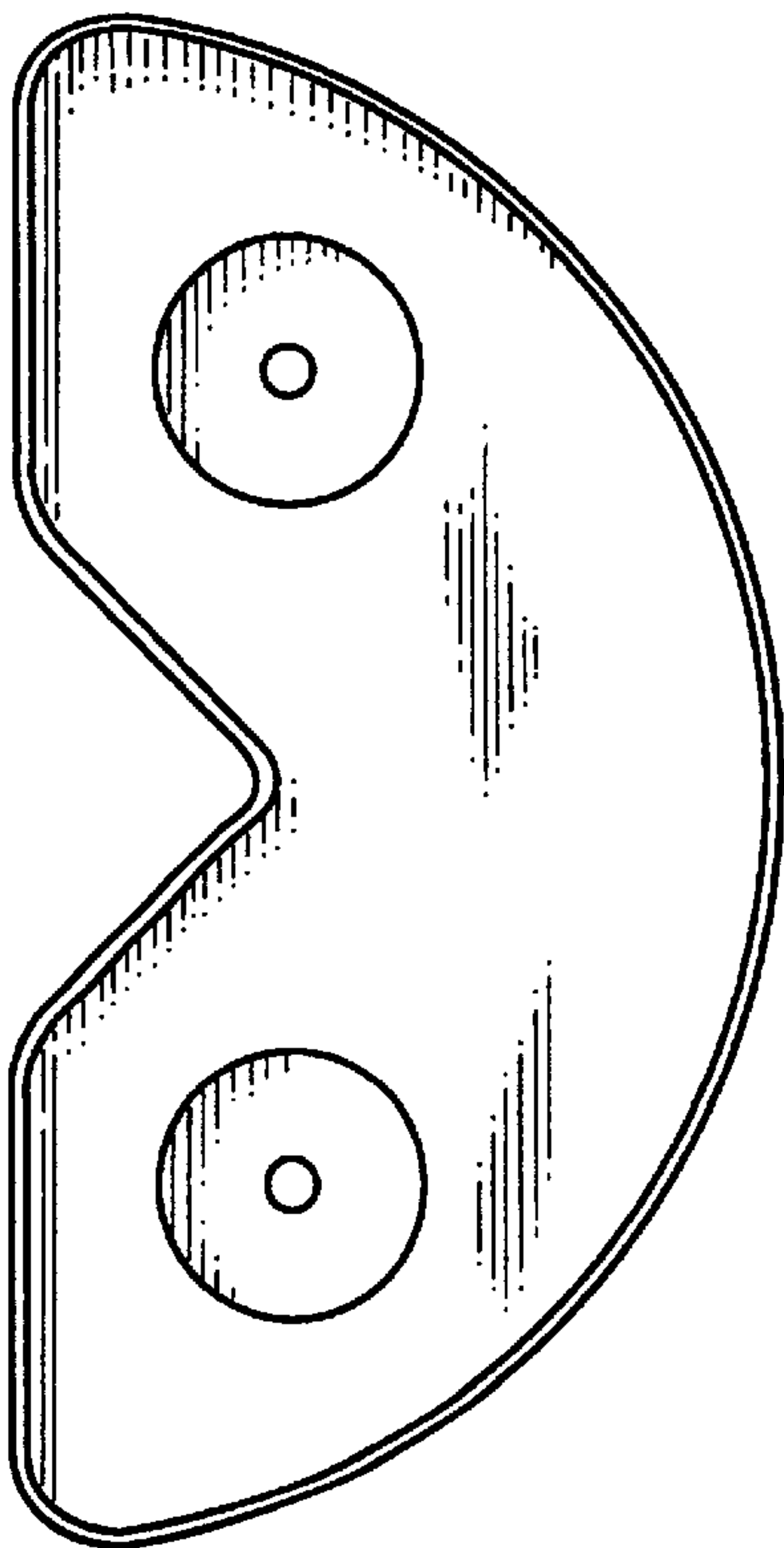

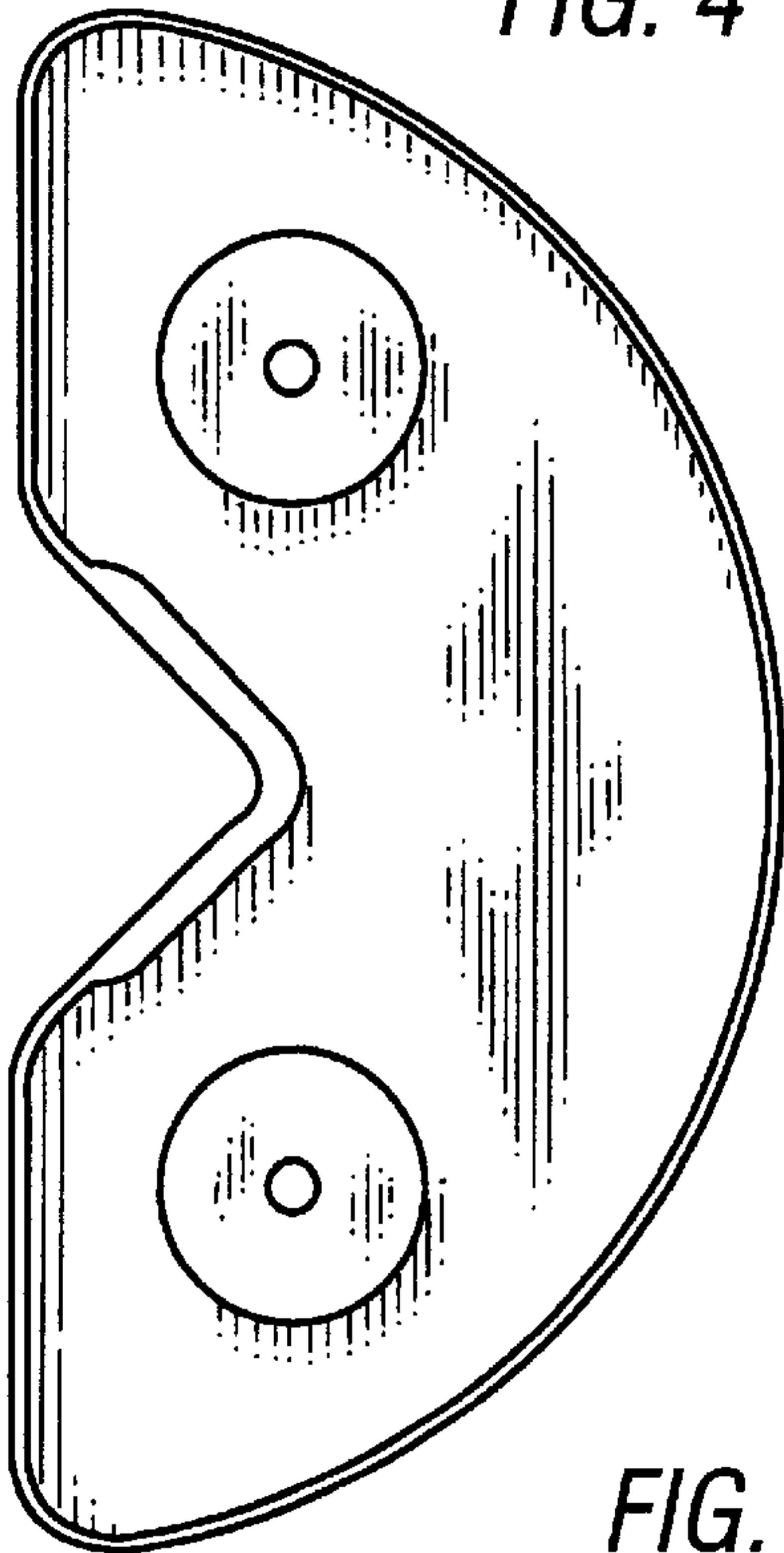
