DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a reflector for a vehicular bicycle rack constructed in accordance with the present invention;

FIG. 2 is an isometric view of the embodiment of FIG. 1 mounted to a vehicular bicycle rack;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

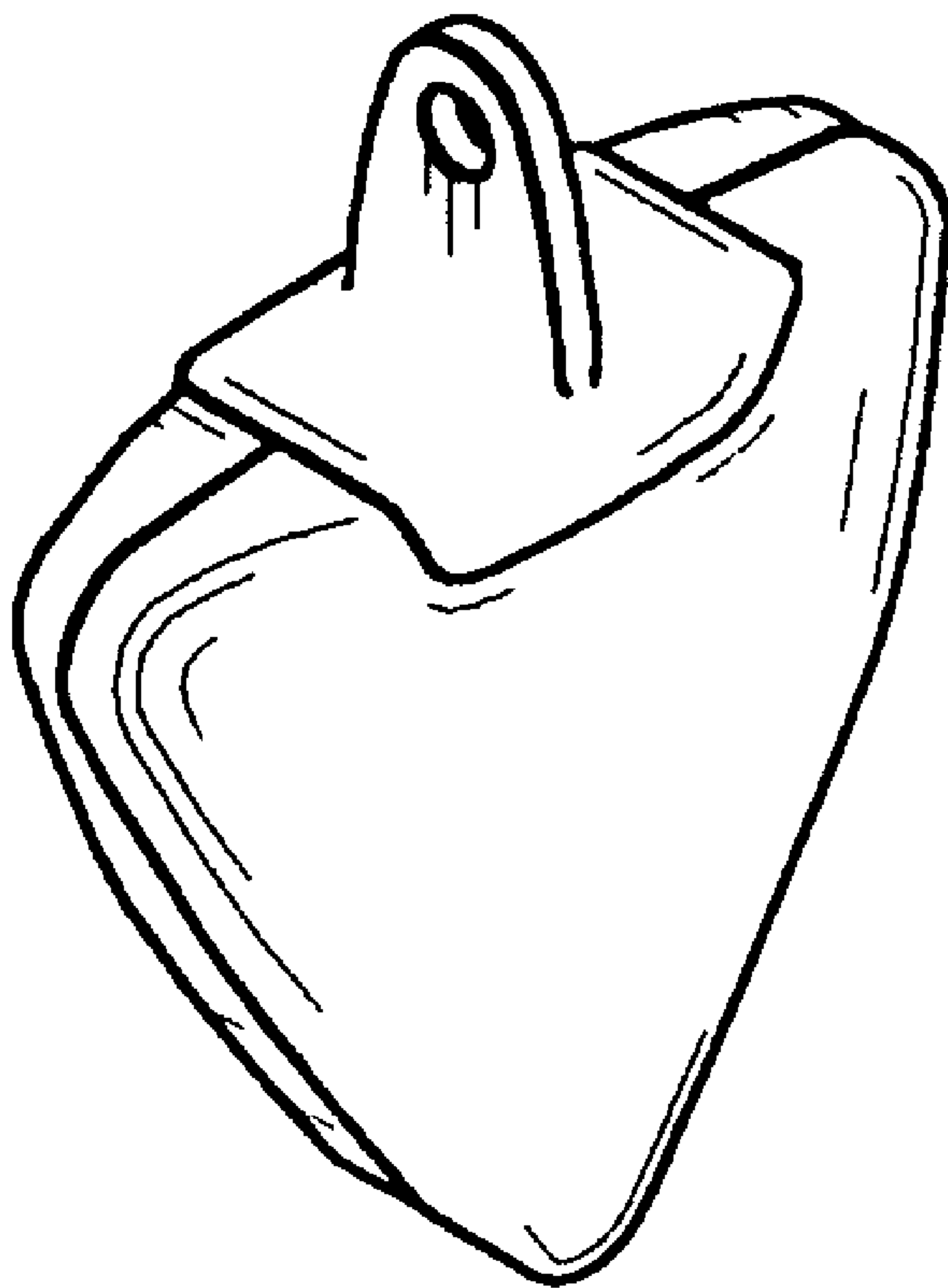
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the embodiment of FIG. 1, the left side being a mirror image of the right side;

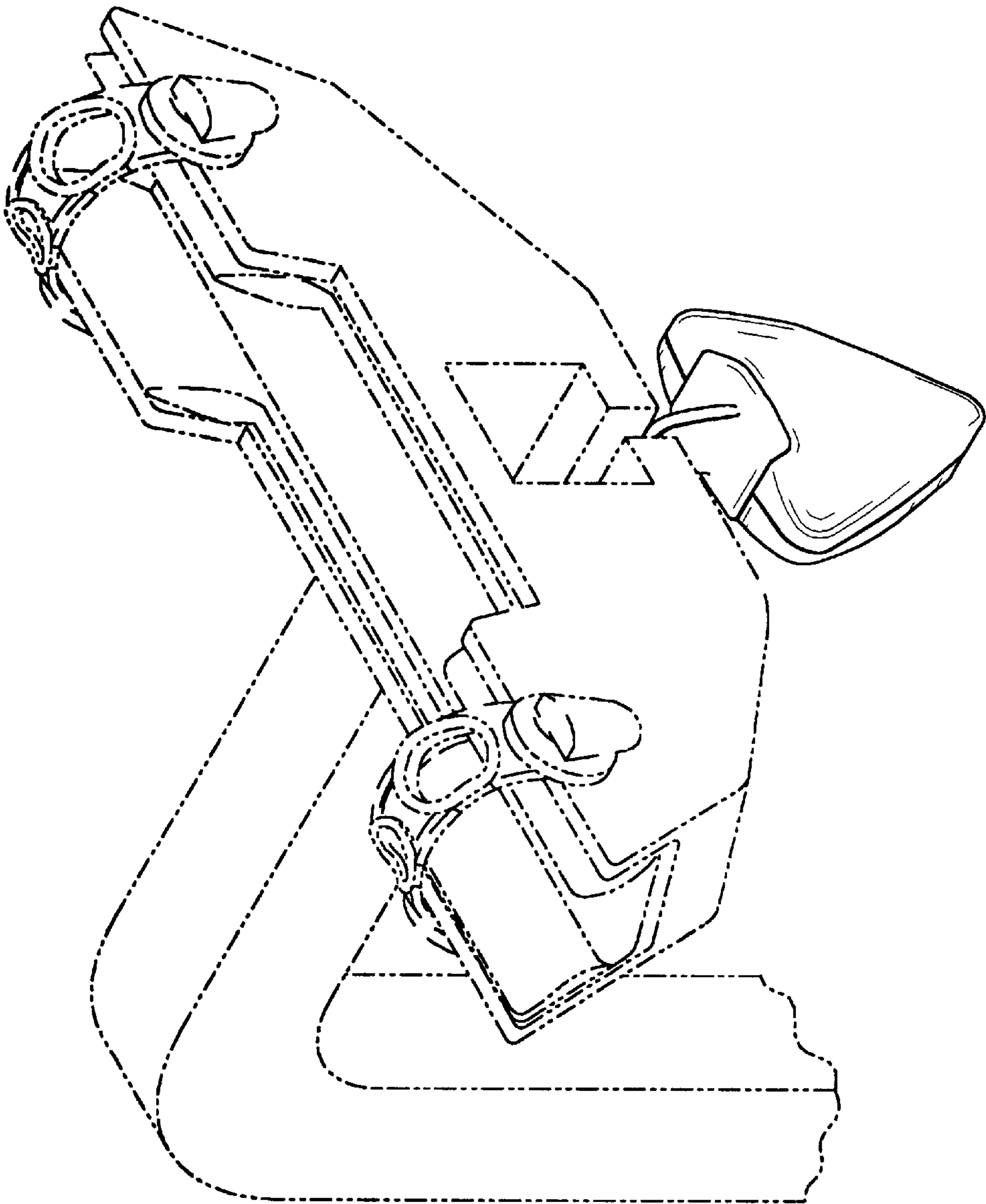

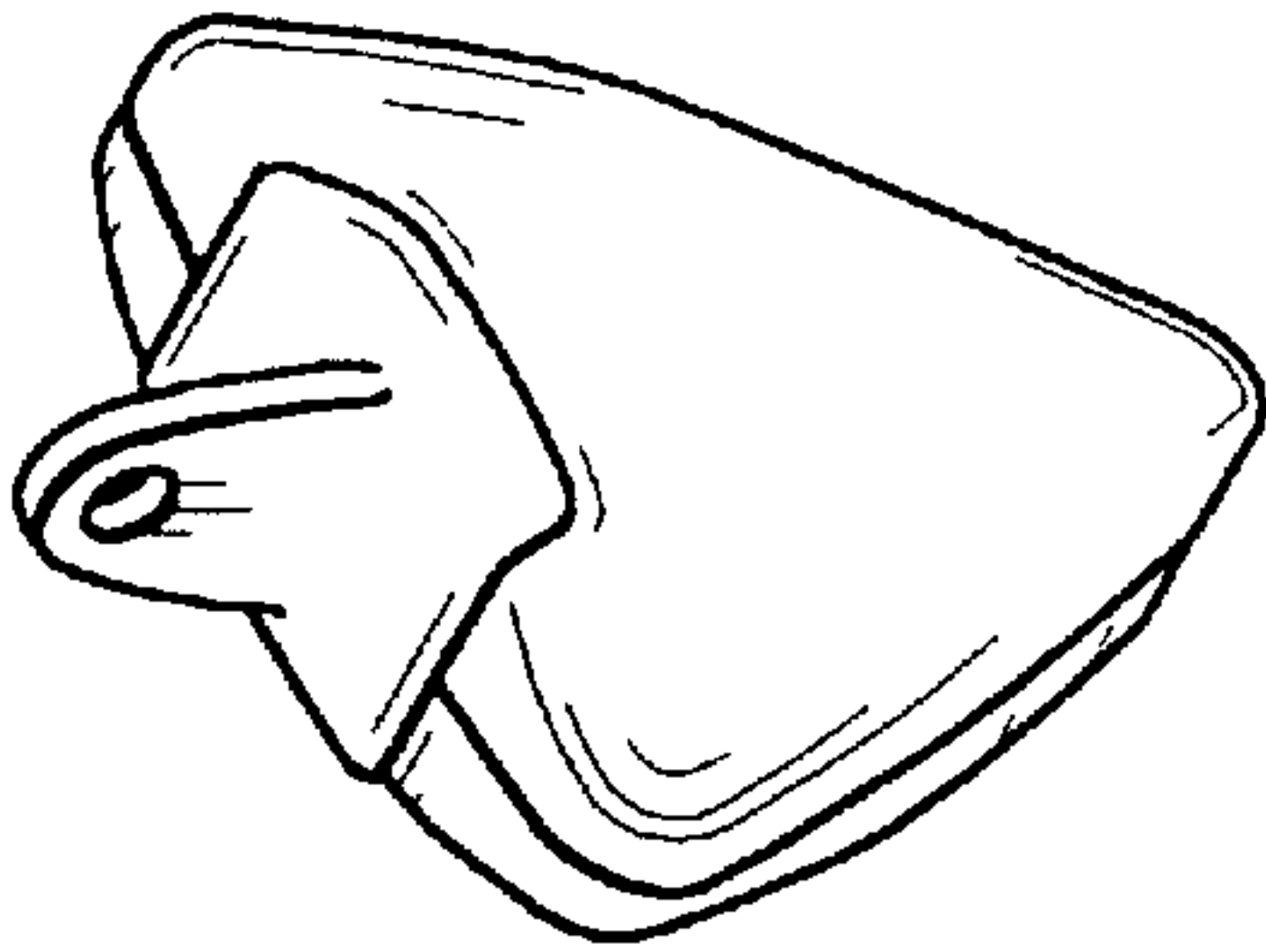

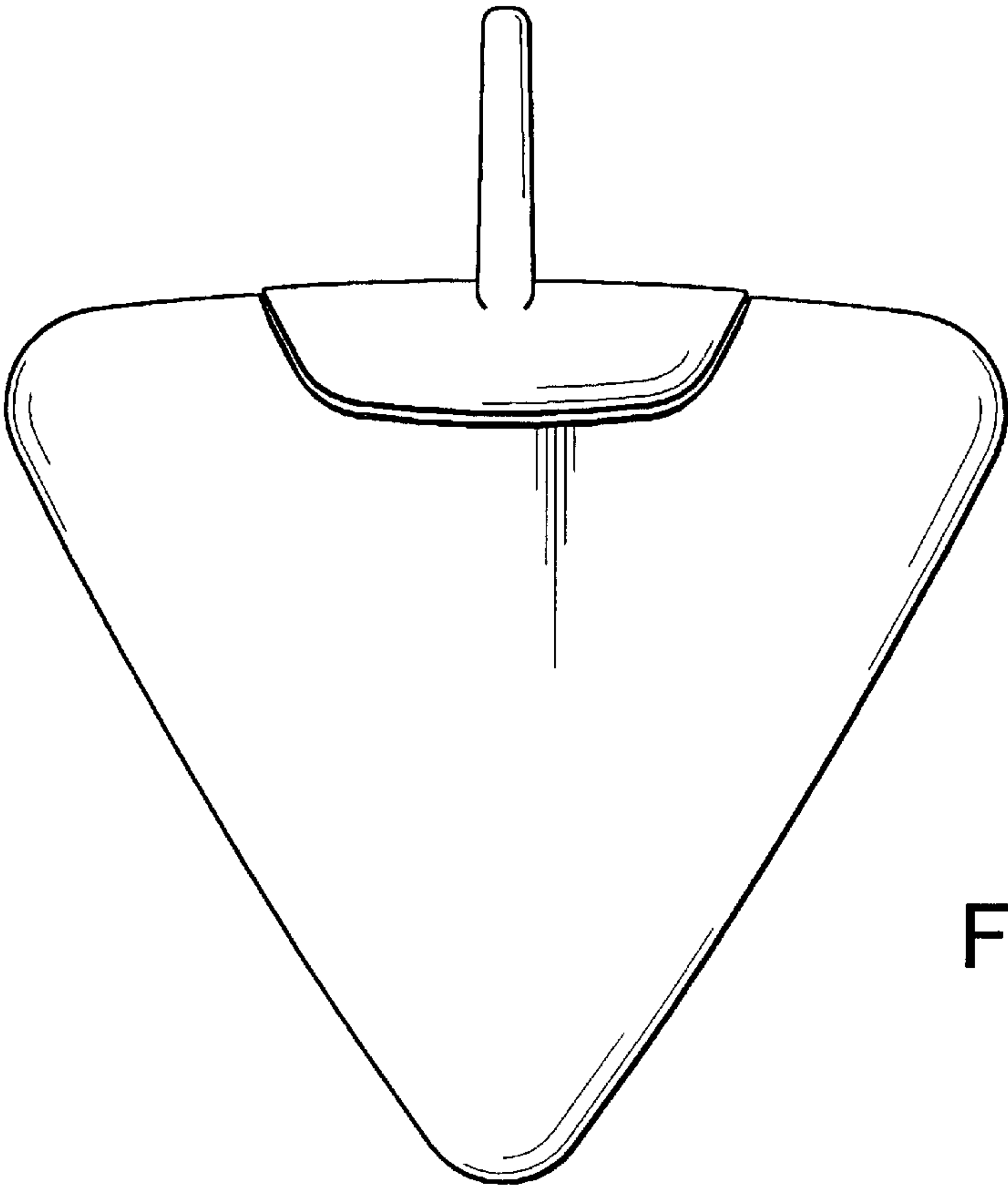

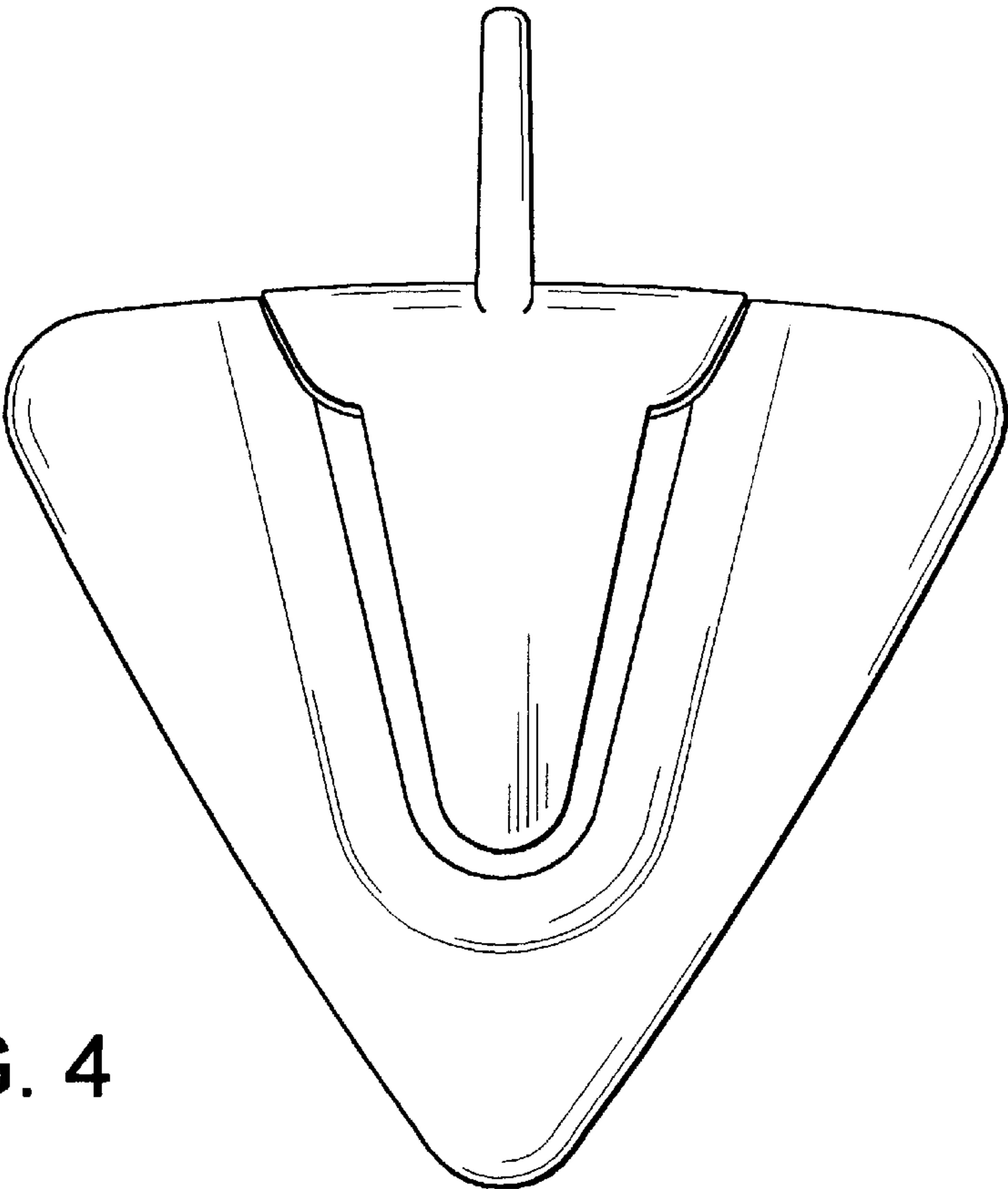

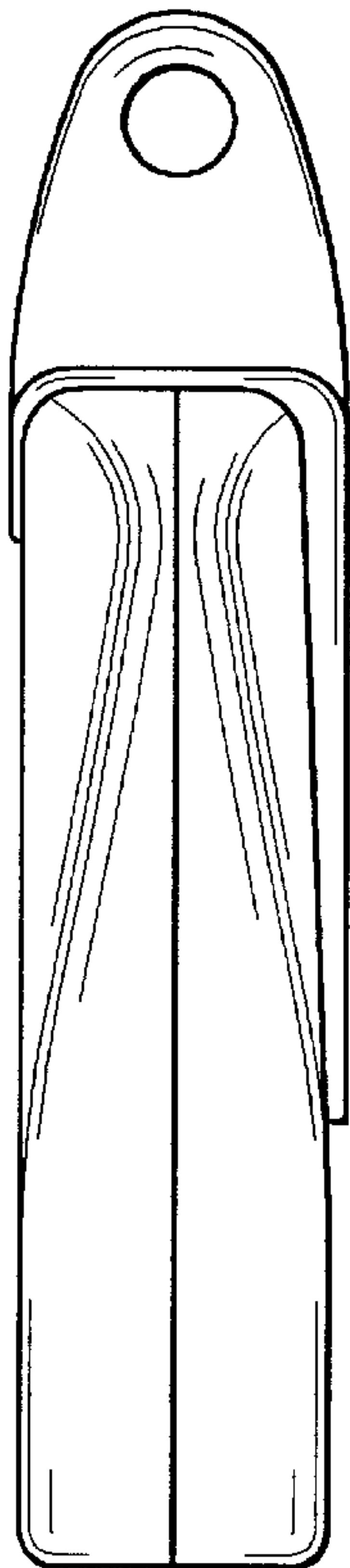

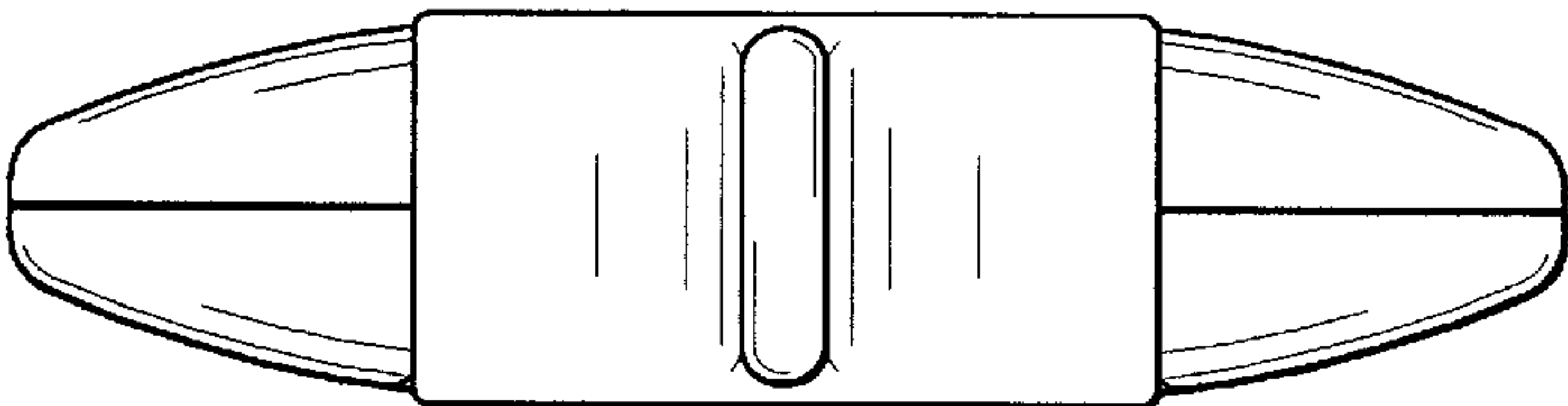
