DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a headset showing our new design;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, with some of the broken lines removed for clarity of illustration;


FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, with some of the broken lines removed for clarity of illustration; and,


FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof, with some of the broken lines removed for clarity of illustration.


The broken line showing of the various elements on FIGS. 1–7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.


