FIG. 3 is a front view thereof; and,

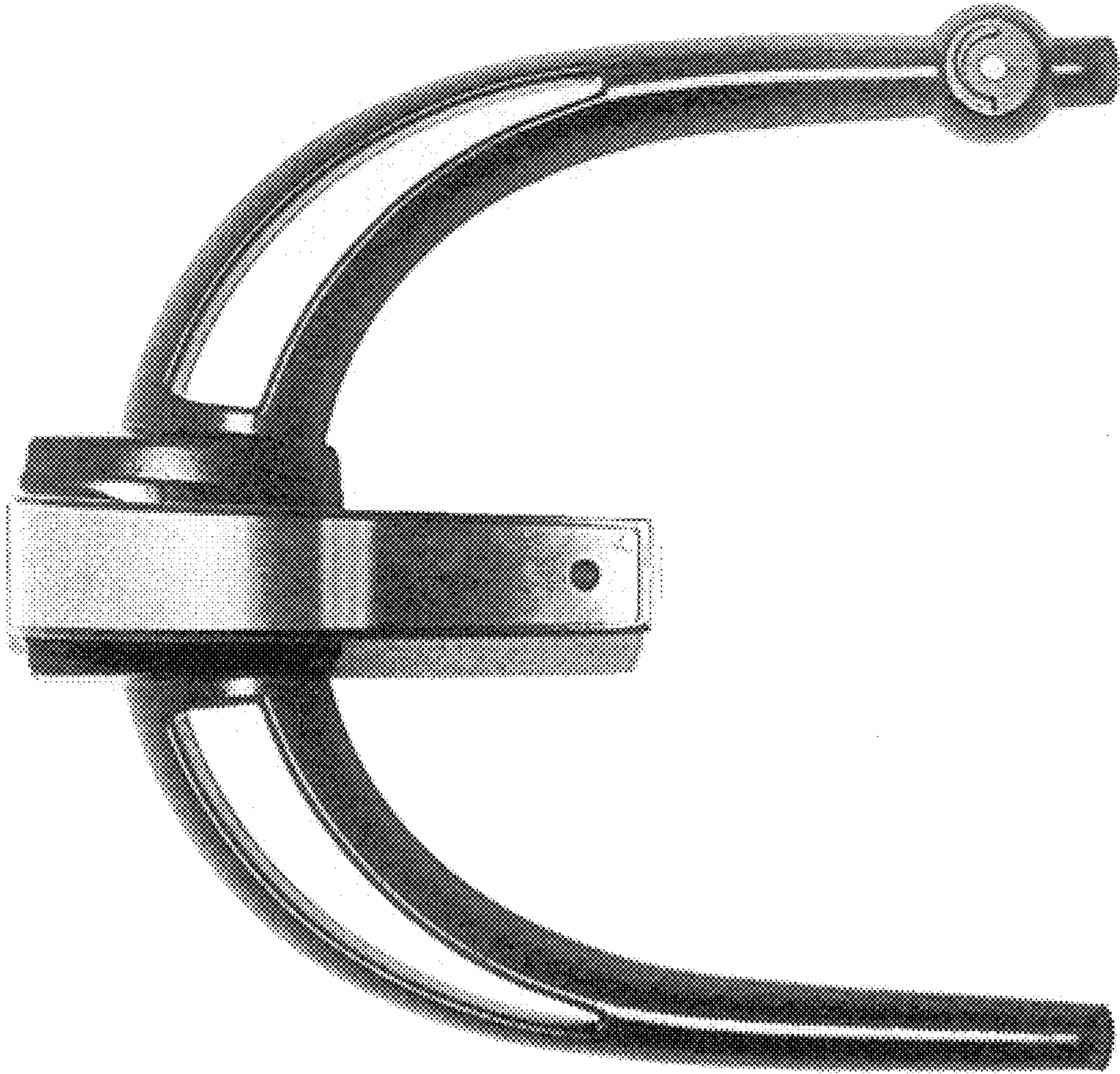
FIG. 4 is a top left side perspective view thereof.

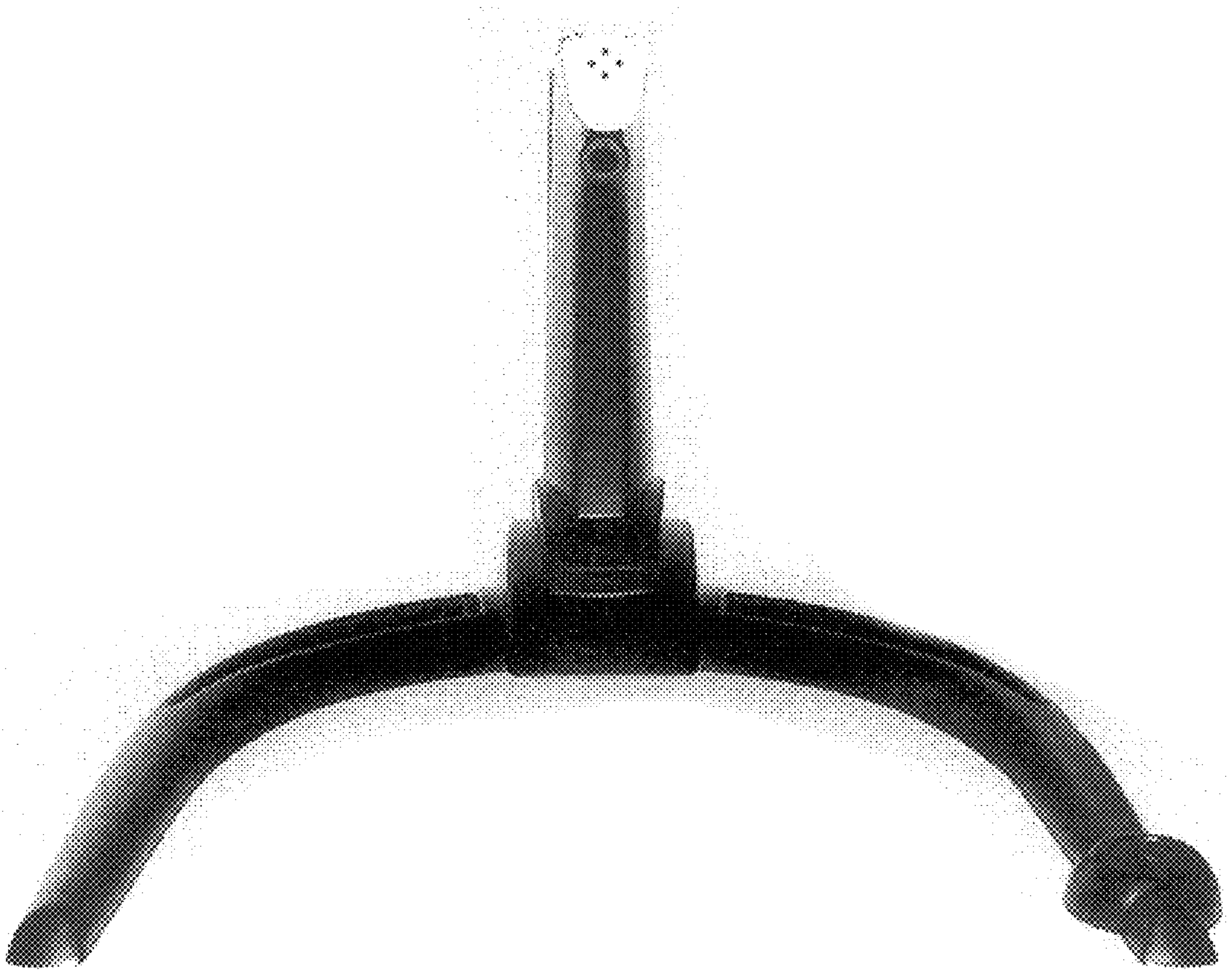
