FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view; and,

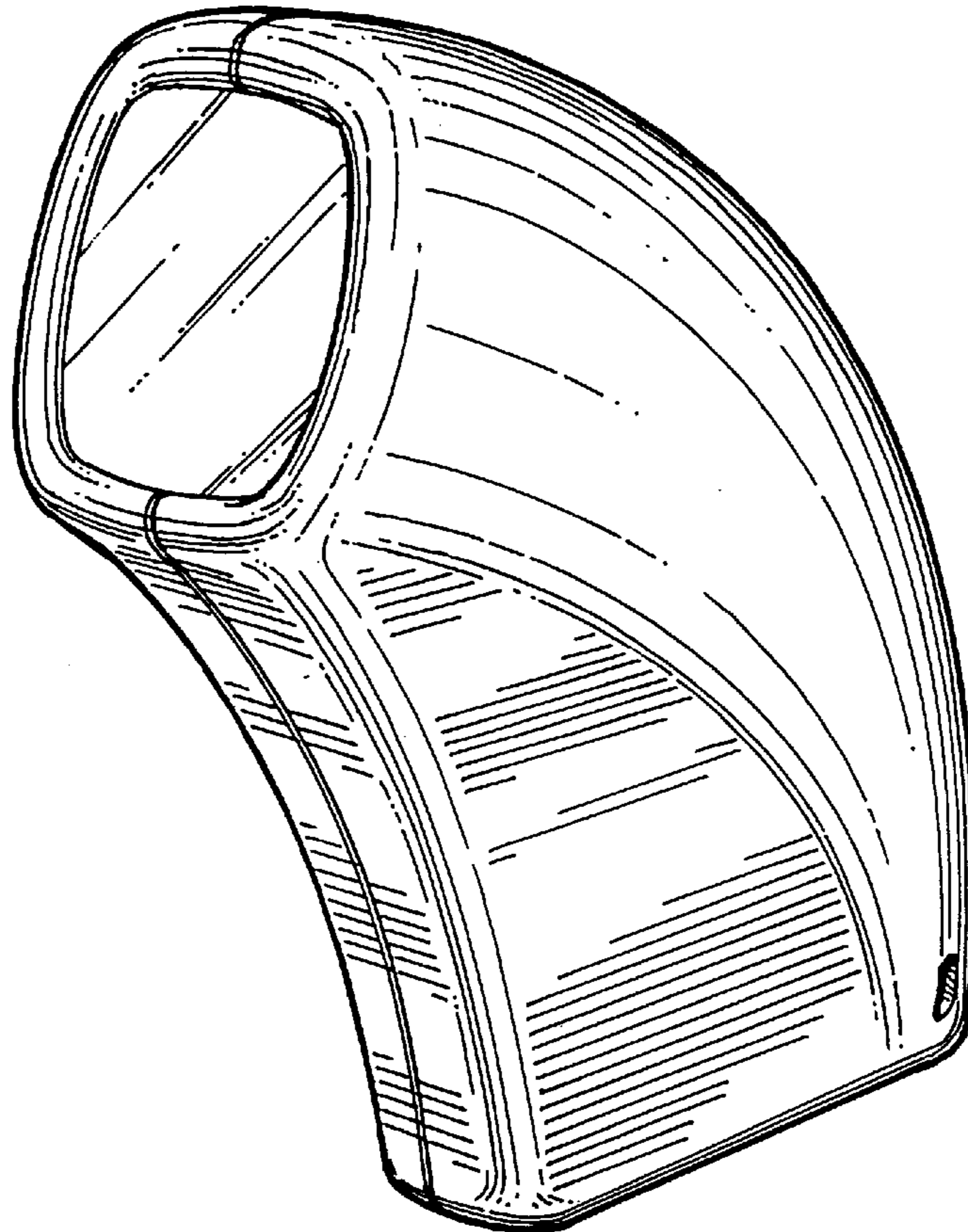
FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view.

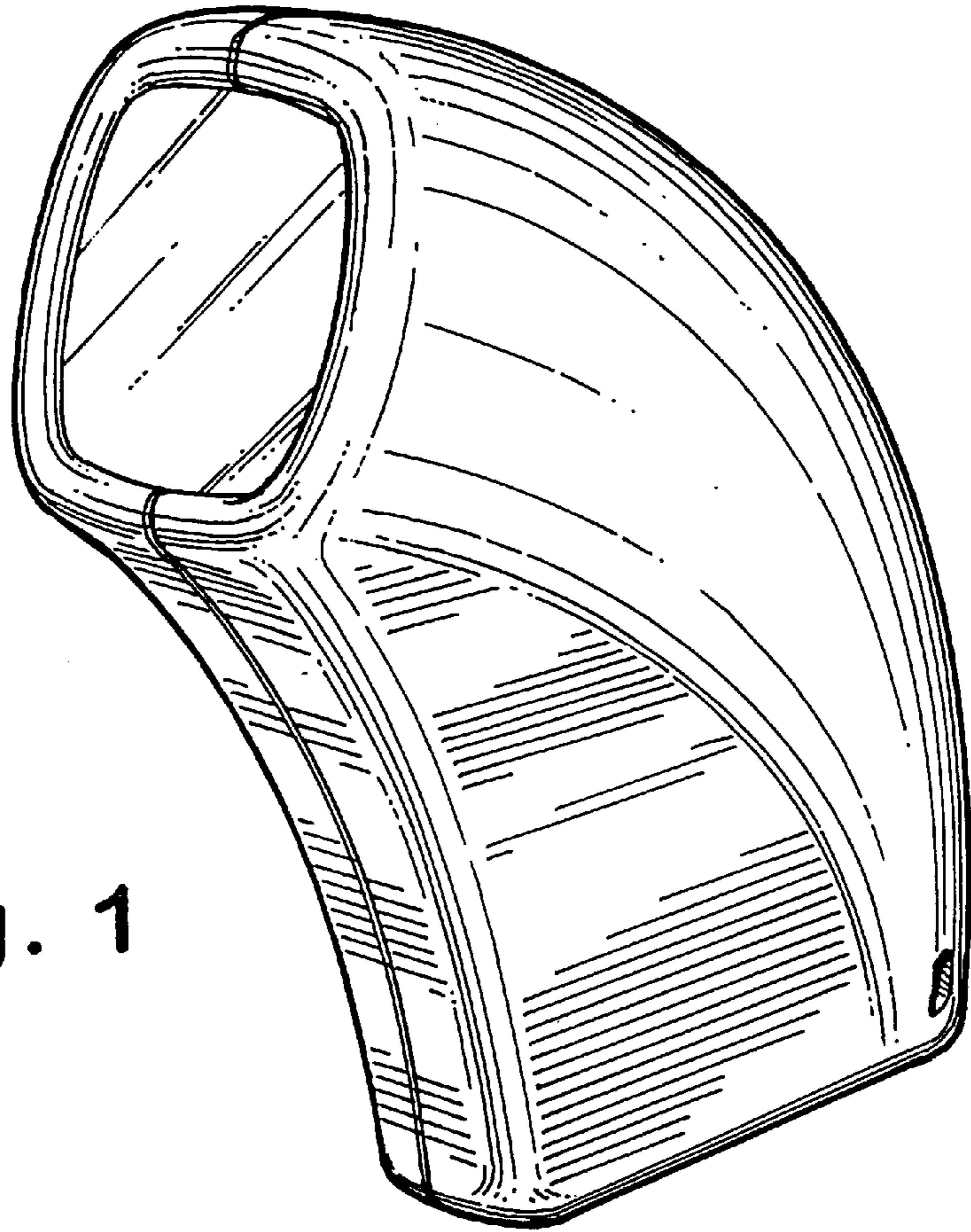

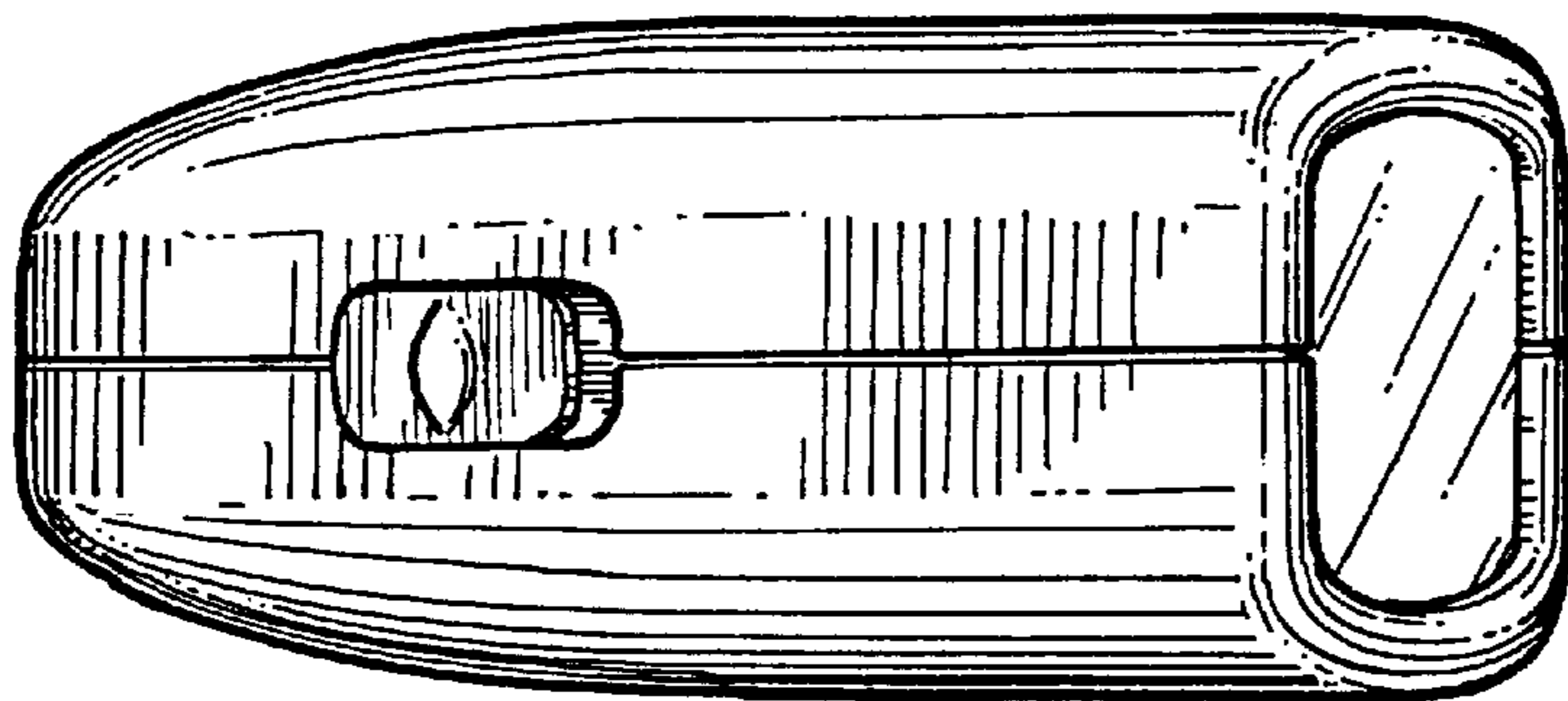

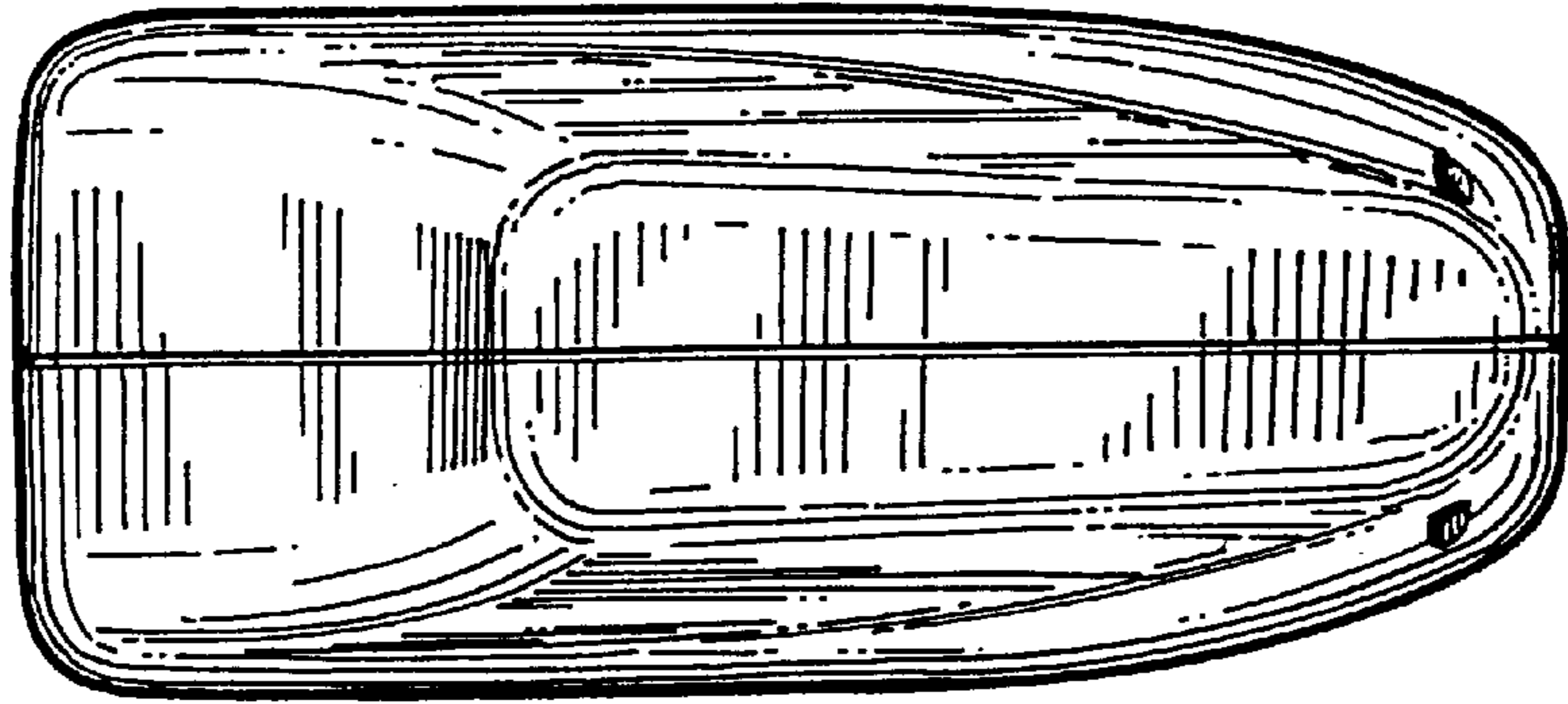

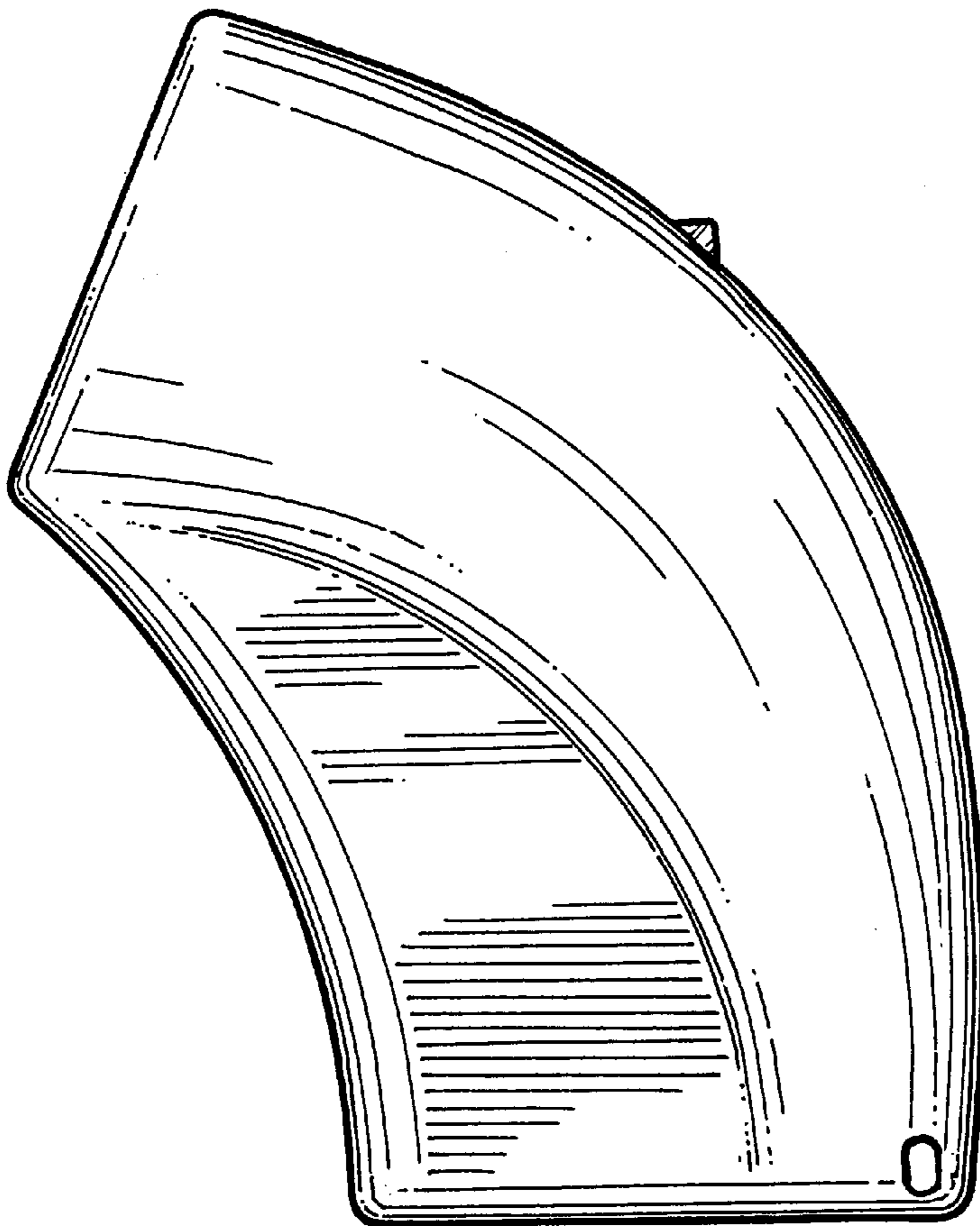

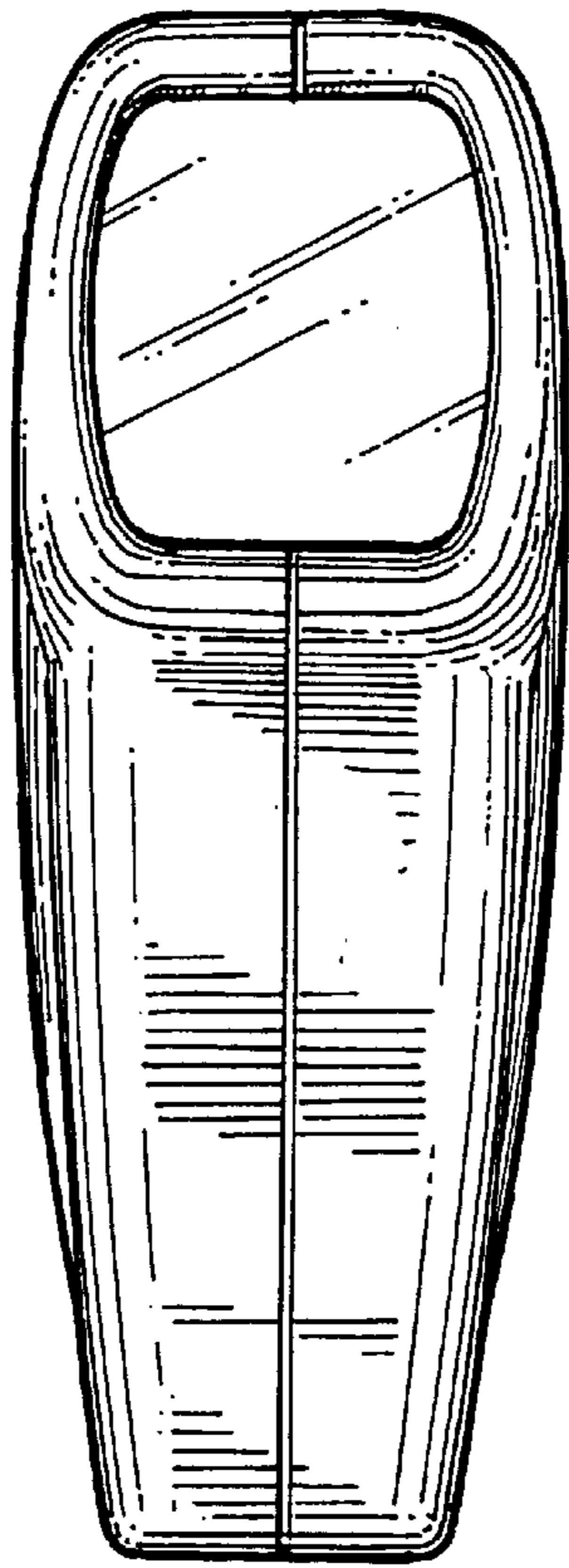

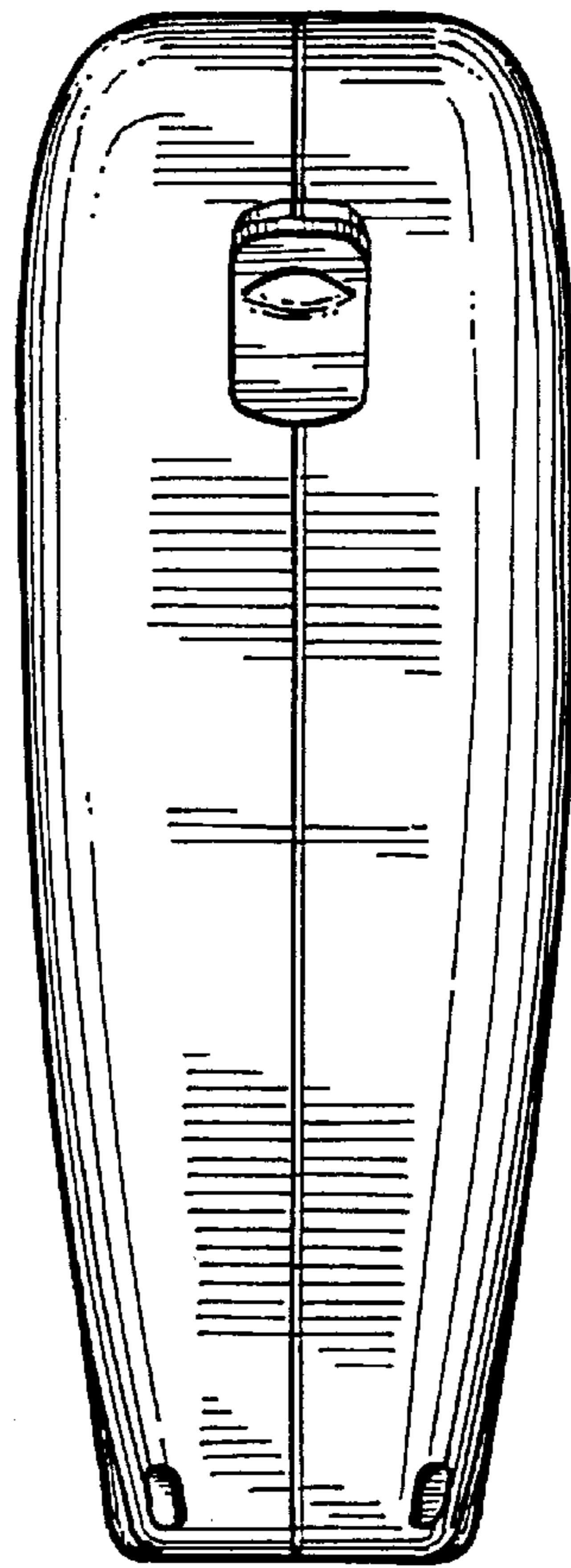

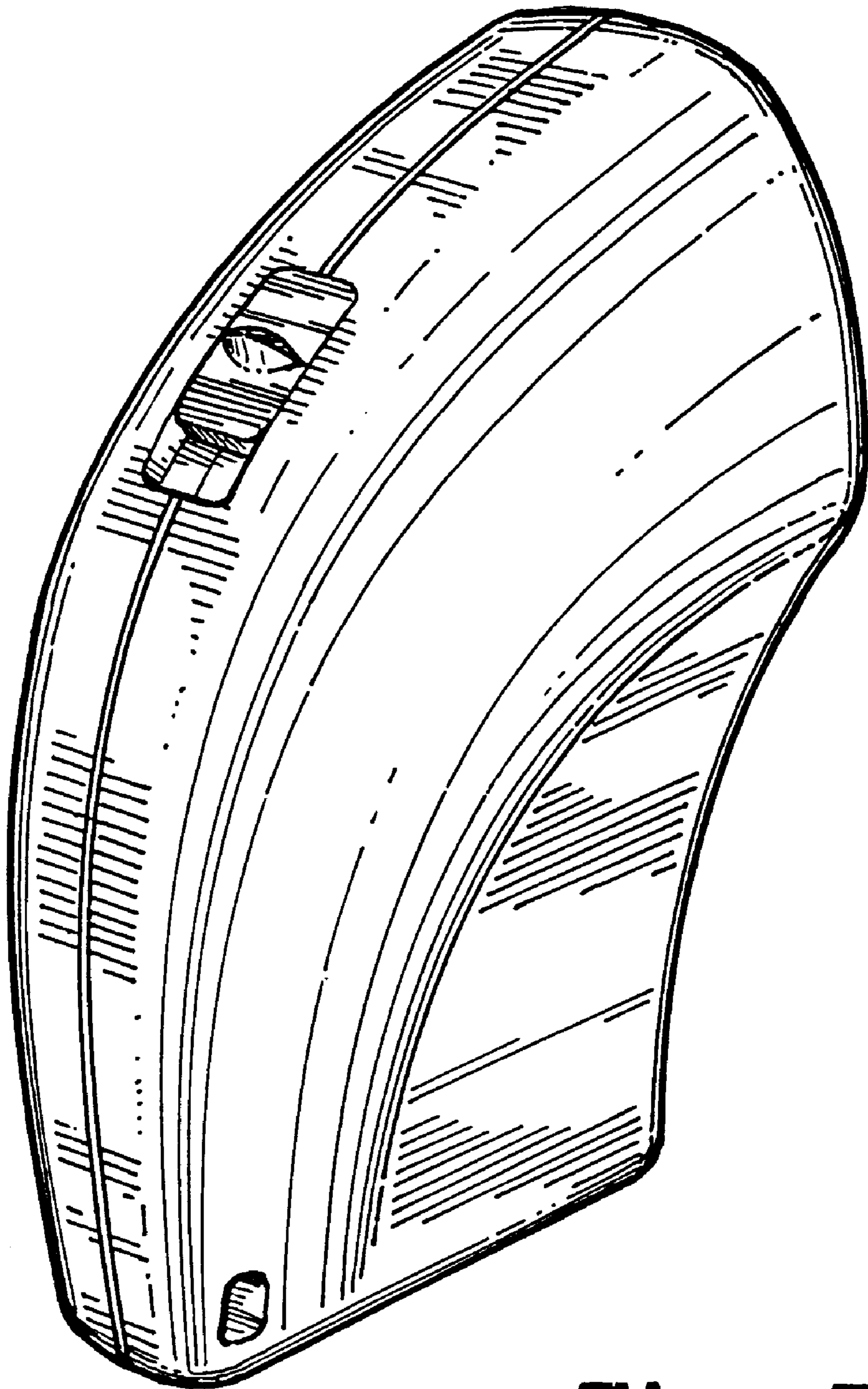
