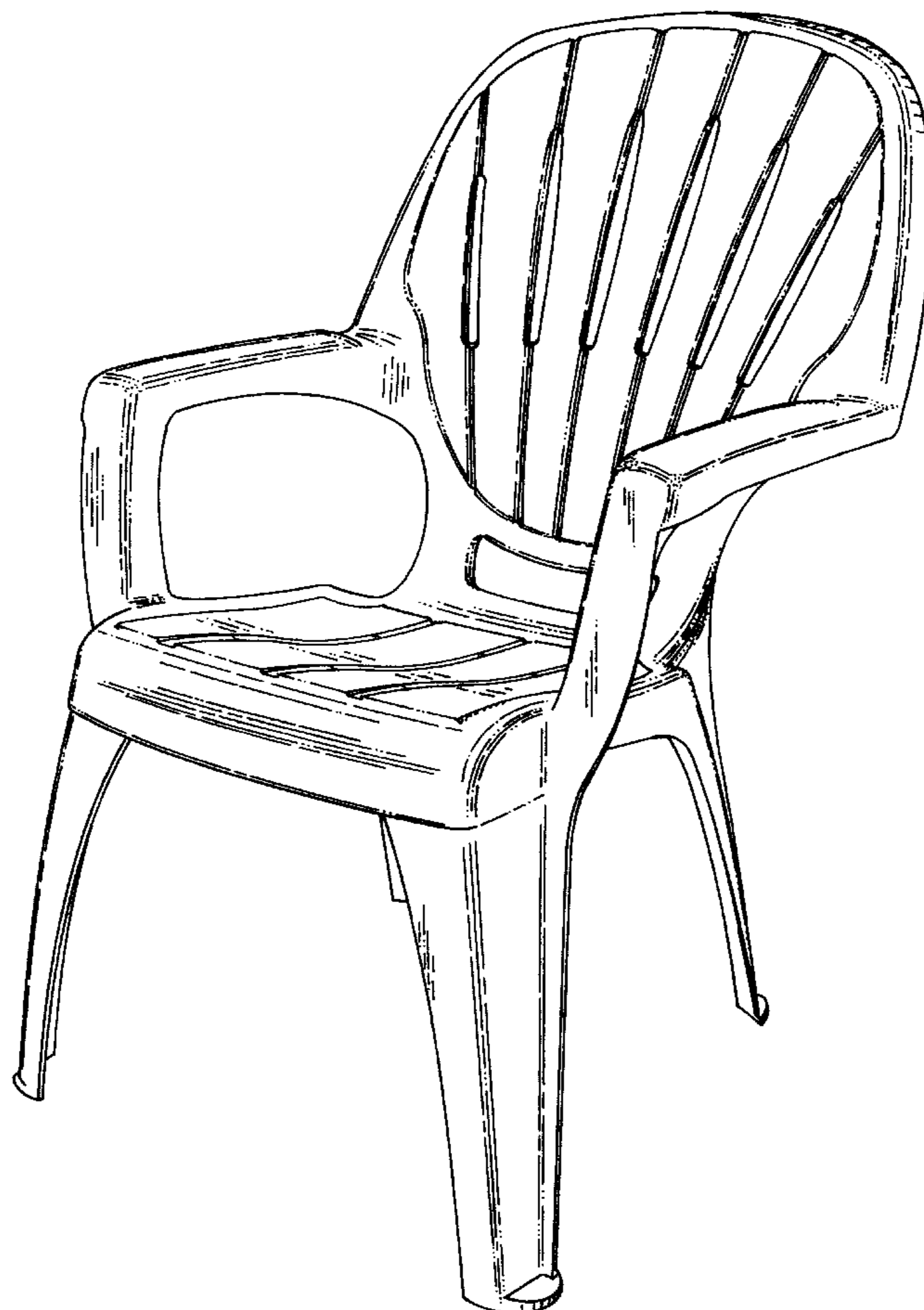
(57) **CLAIM**

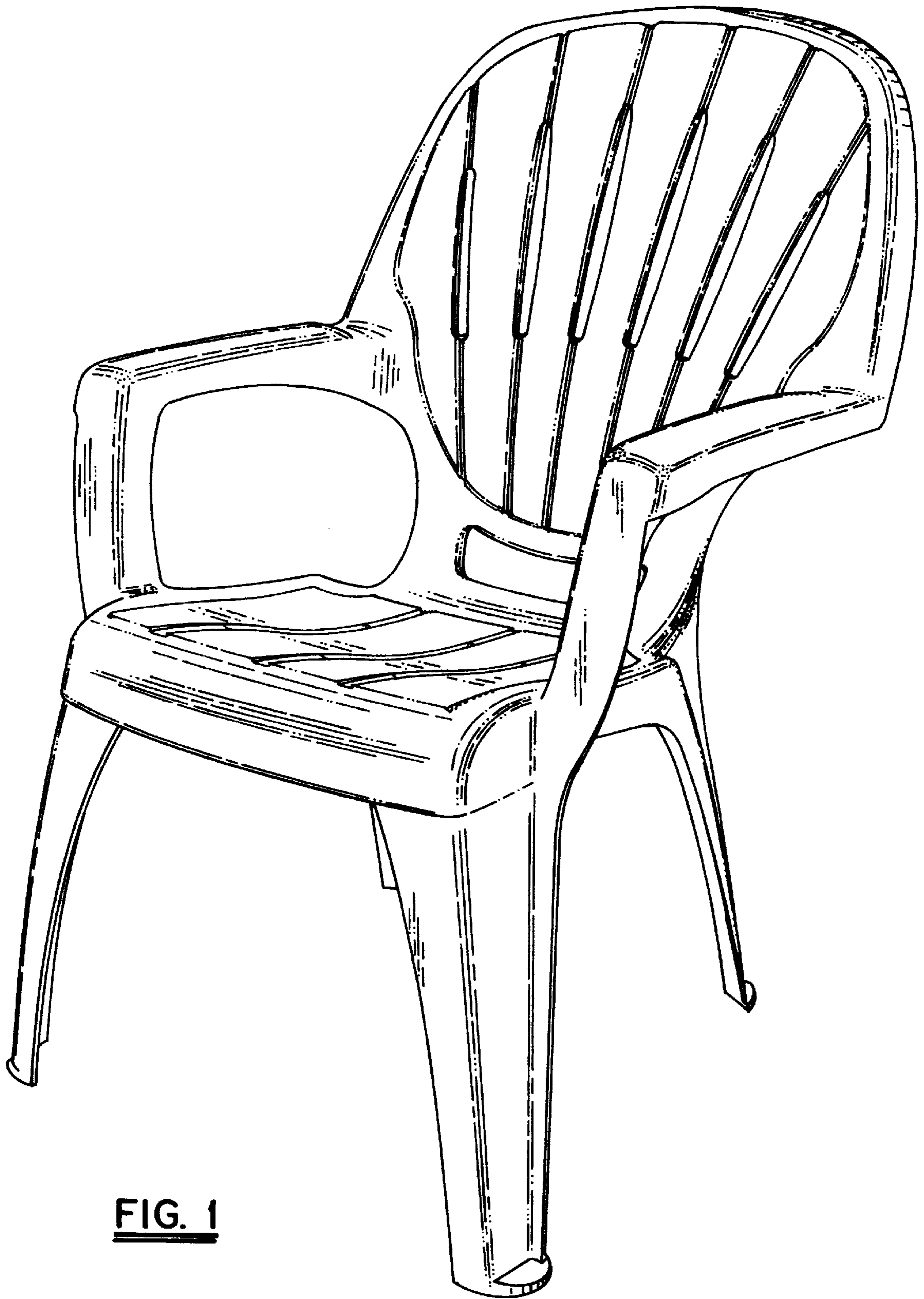
The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the chair of our invention;  
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the chair shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a left perspective view of the chair shown in FIG. 1; the right perspective view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top perspective view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1; and,

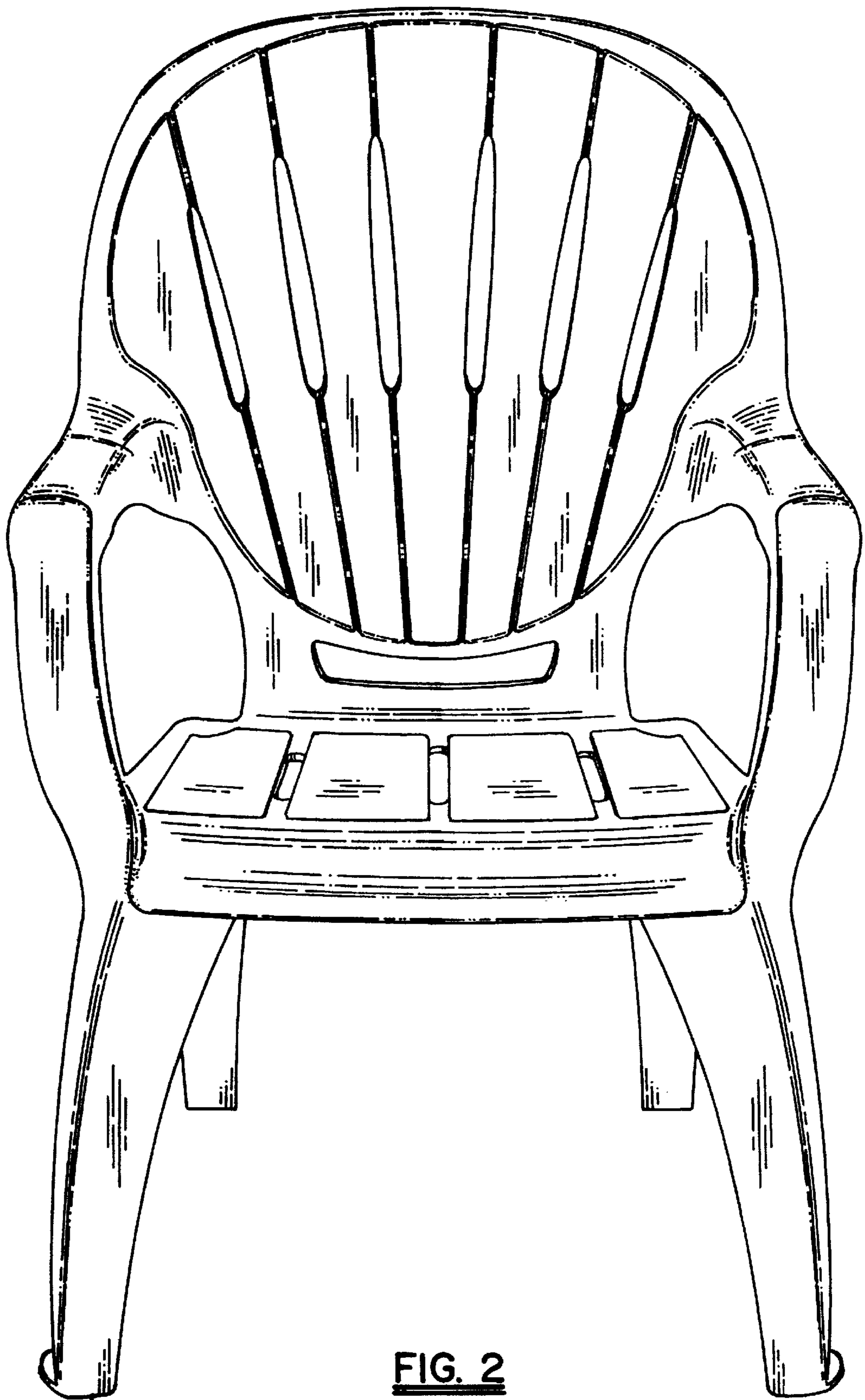

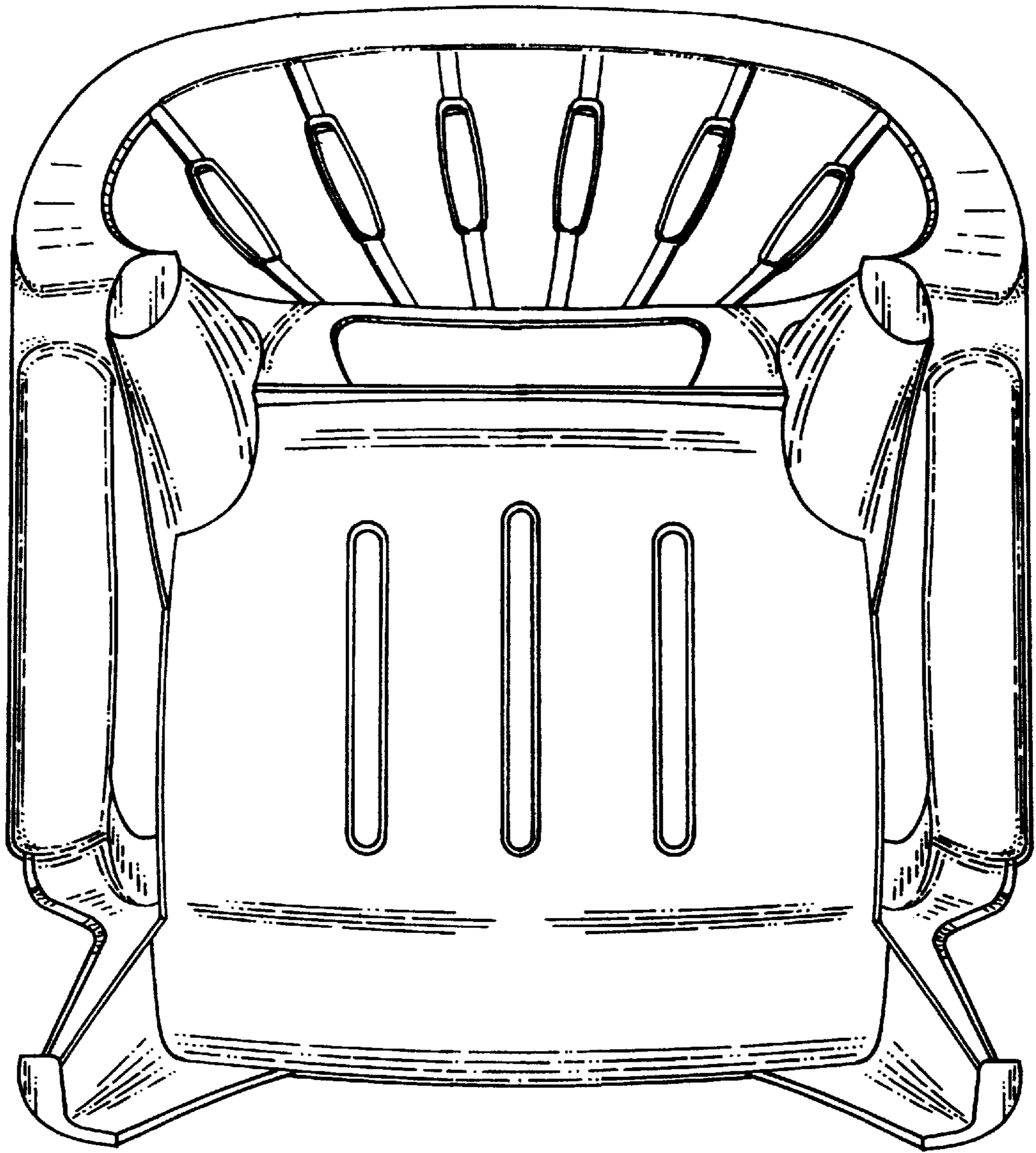

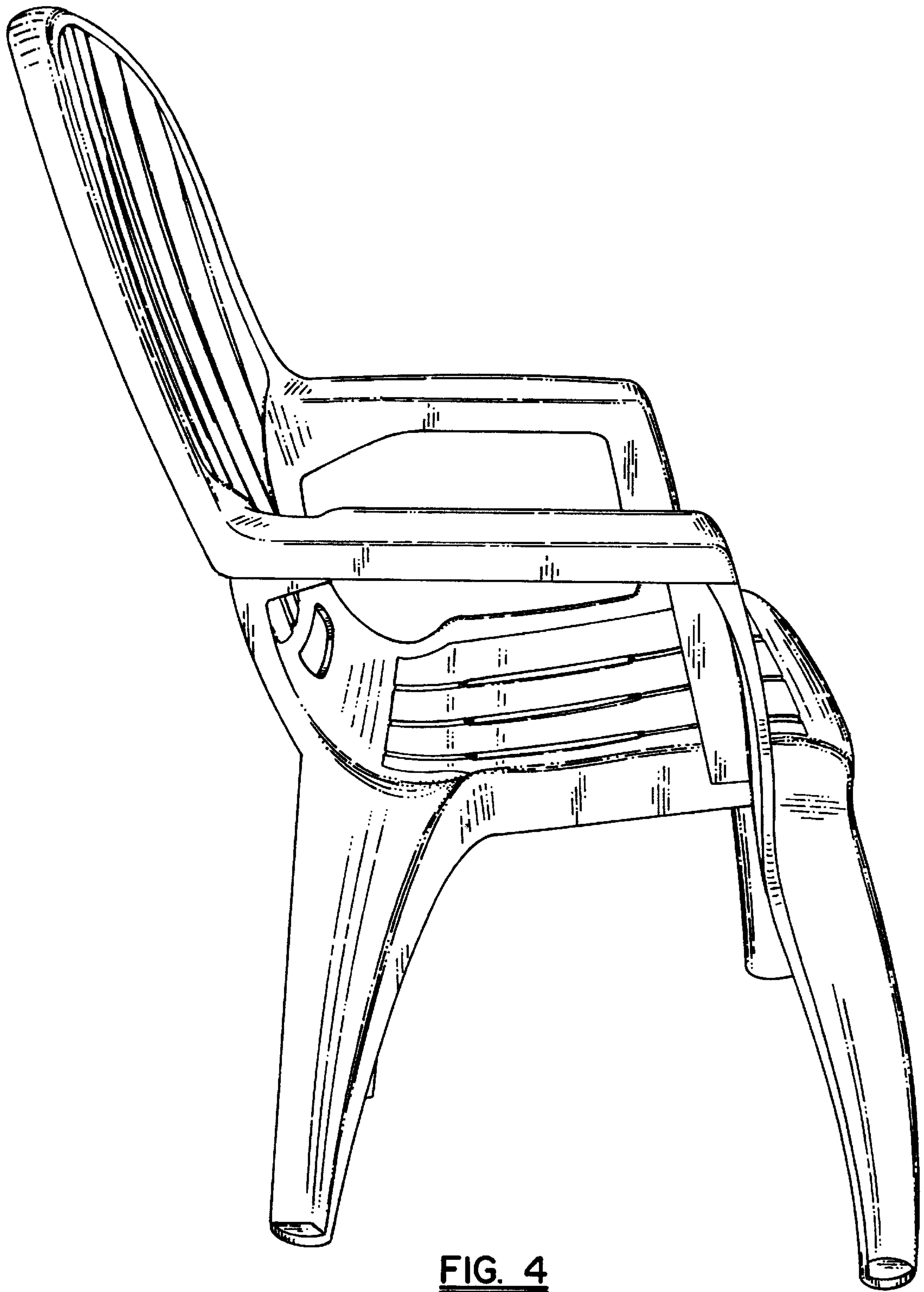

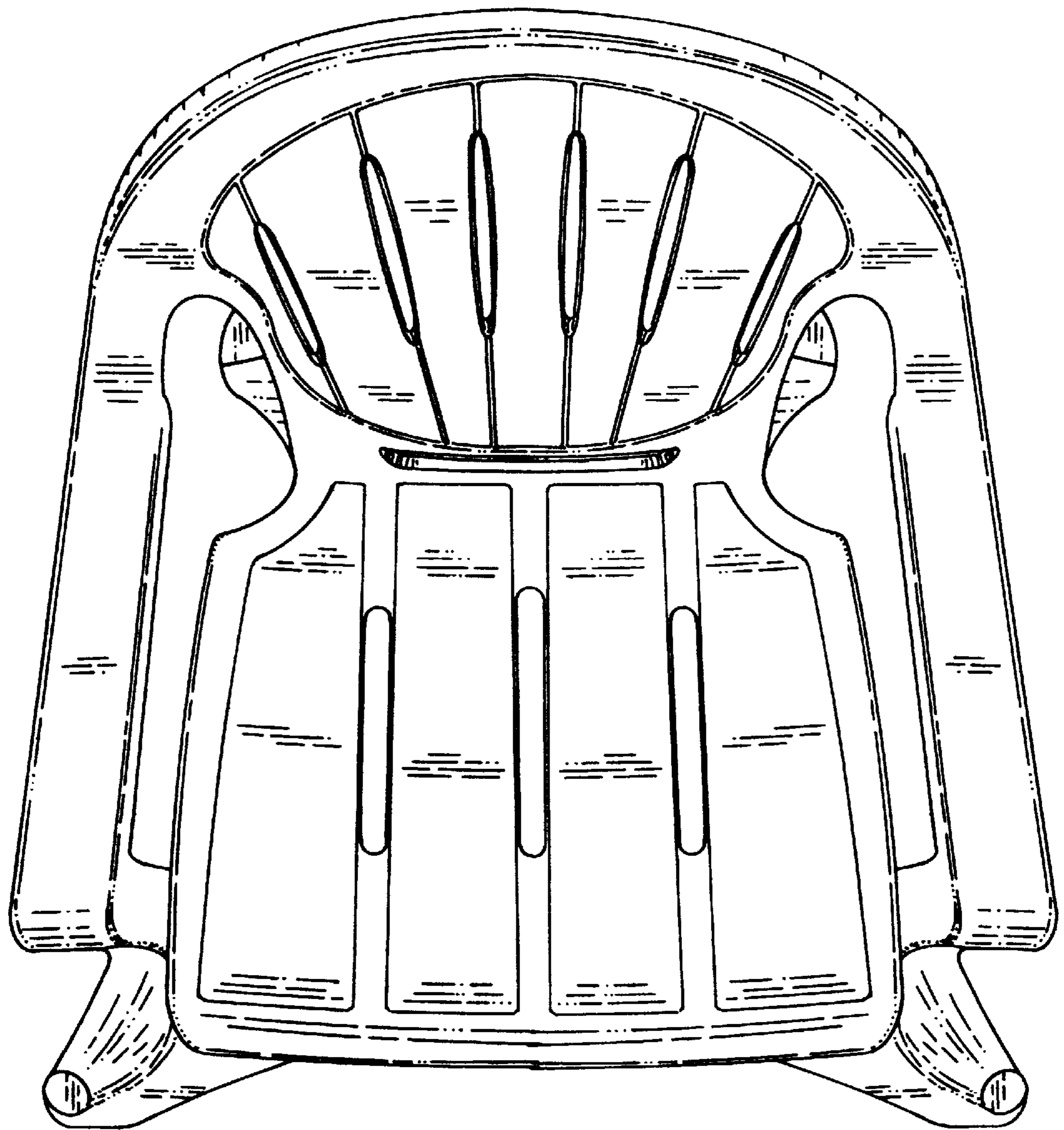

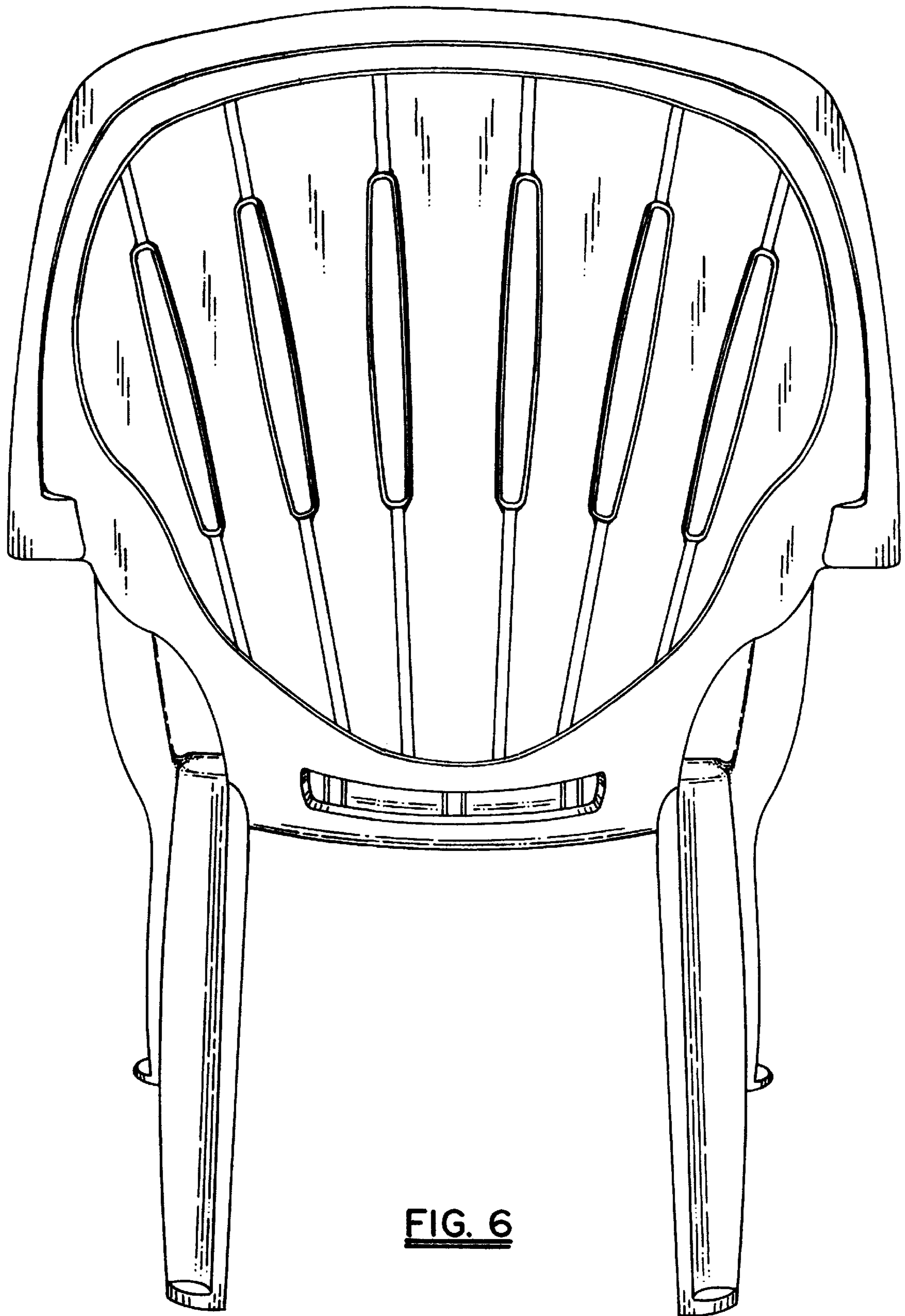
