1;

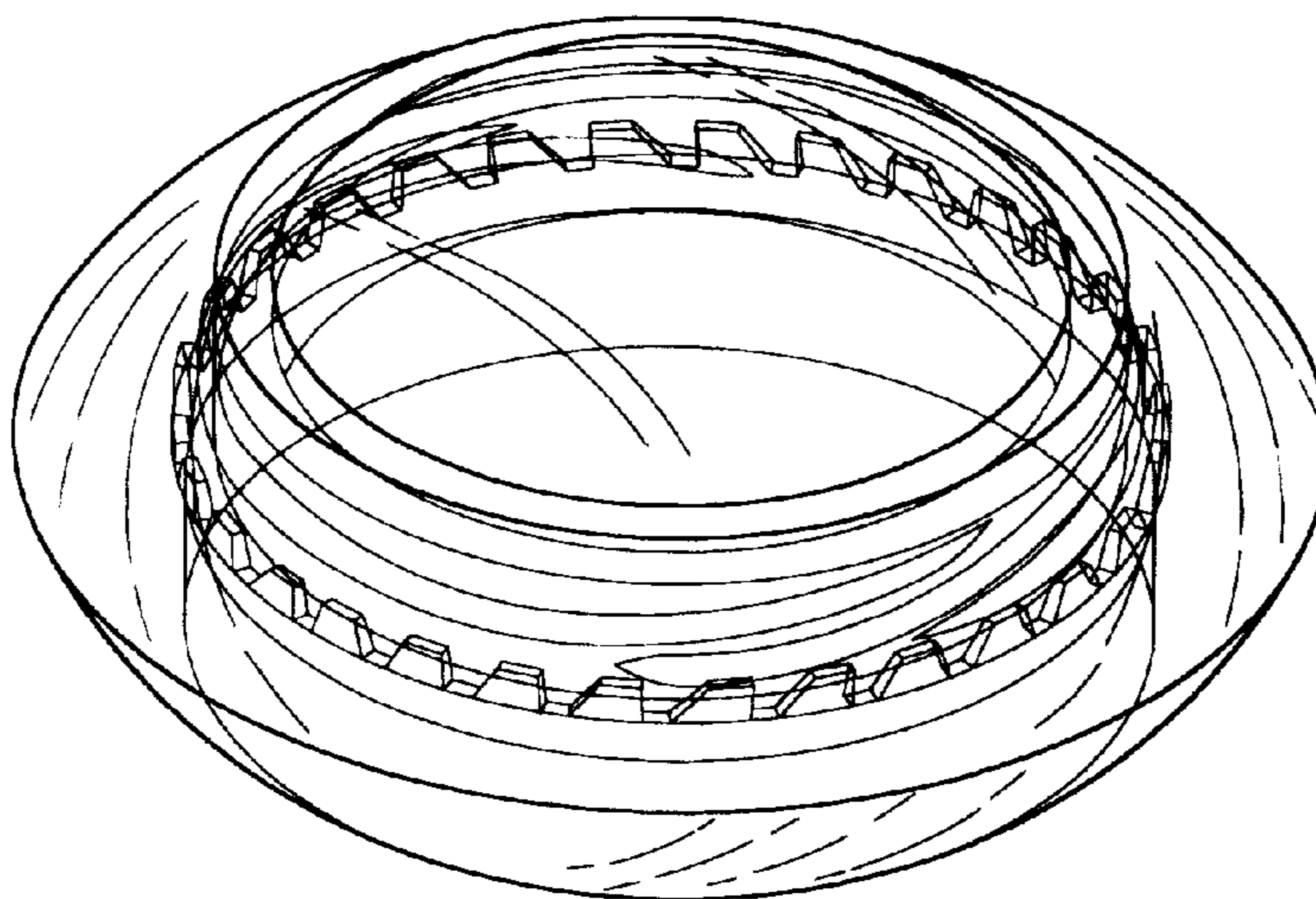
FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of the body of the jar in

through 15 are shown separately for clarity of illustration.



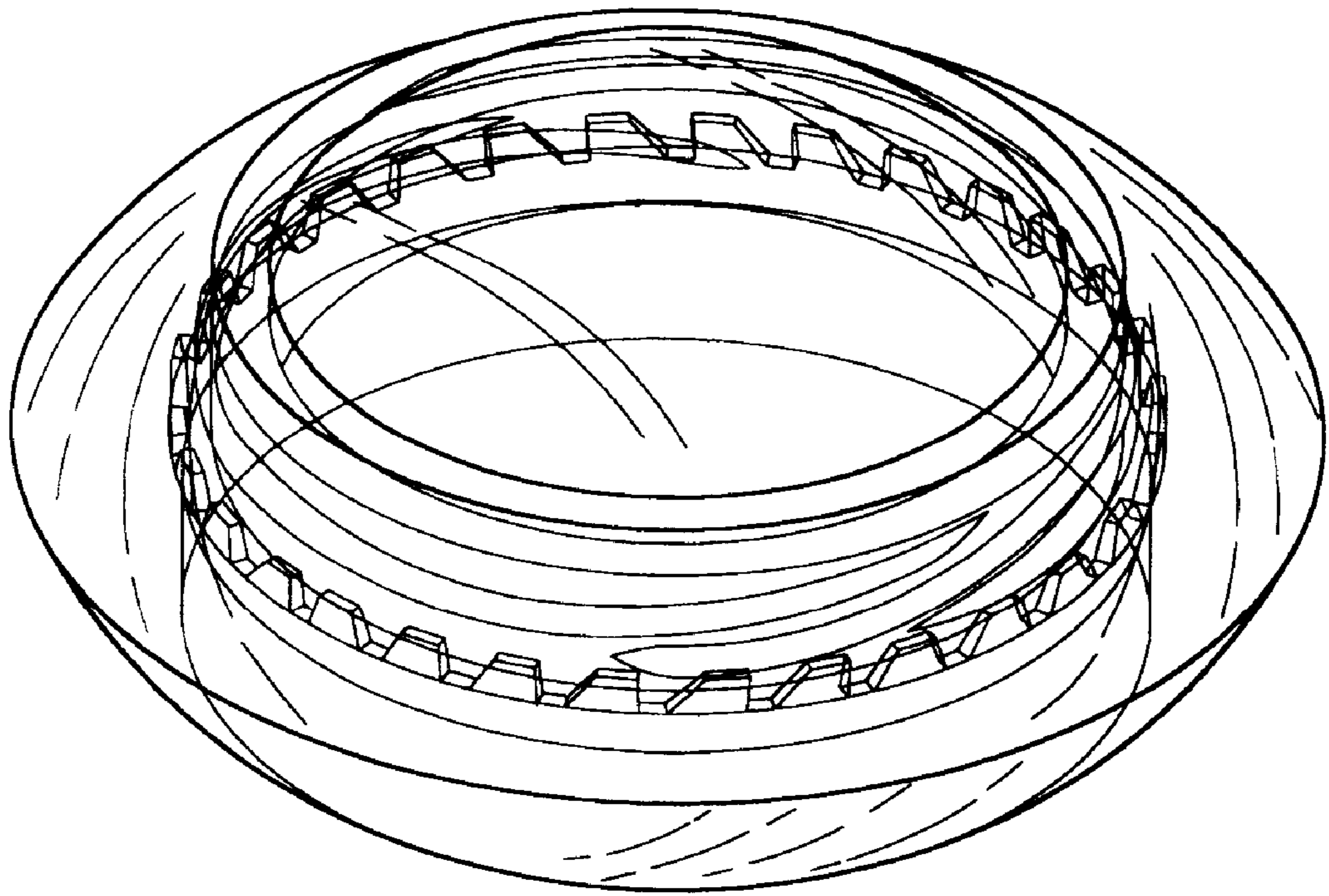

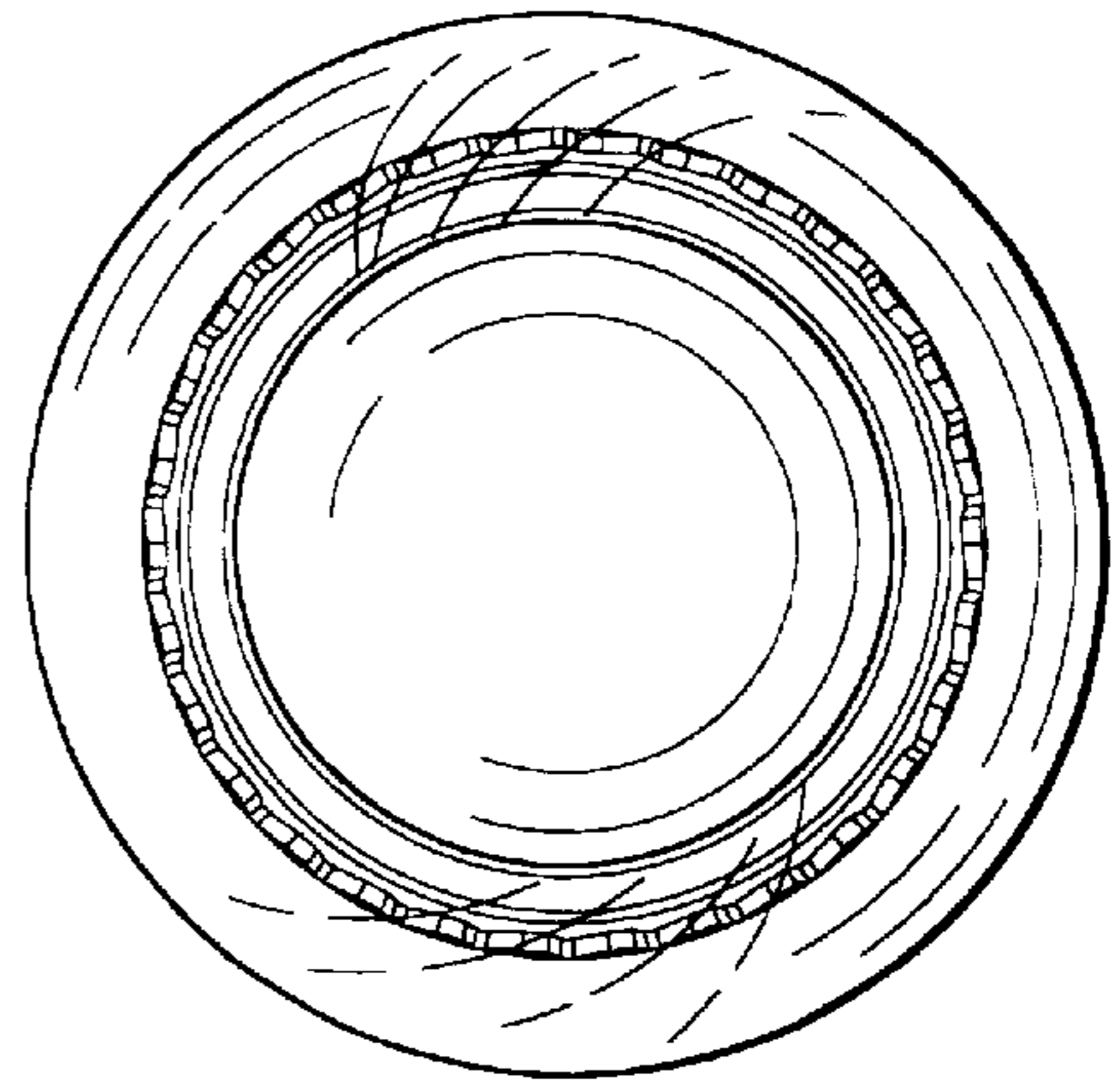

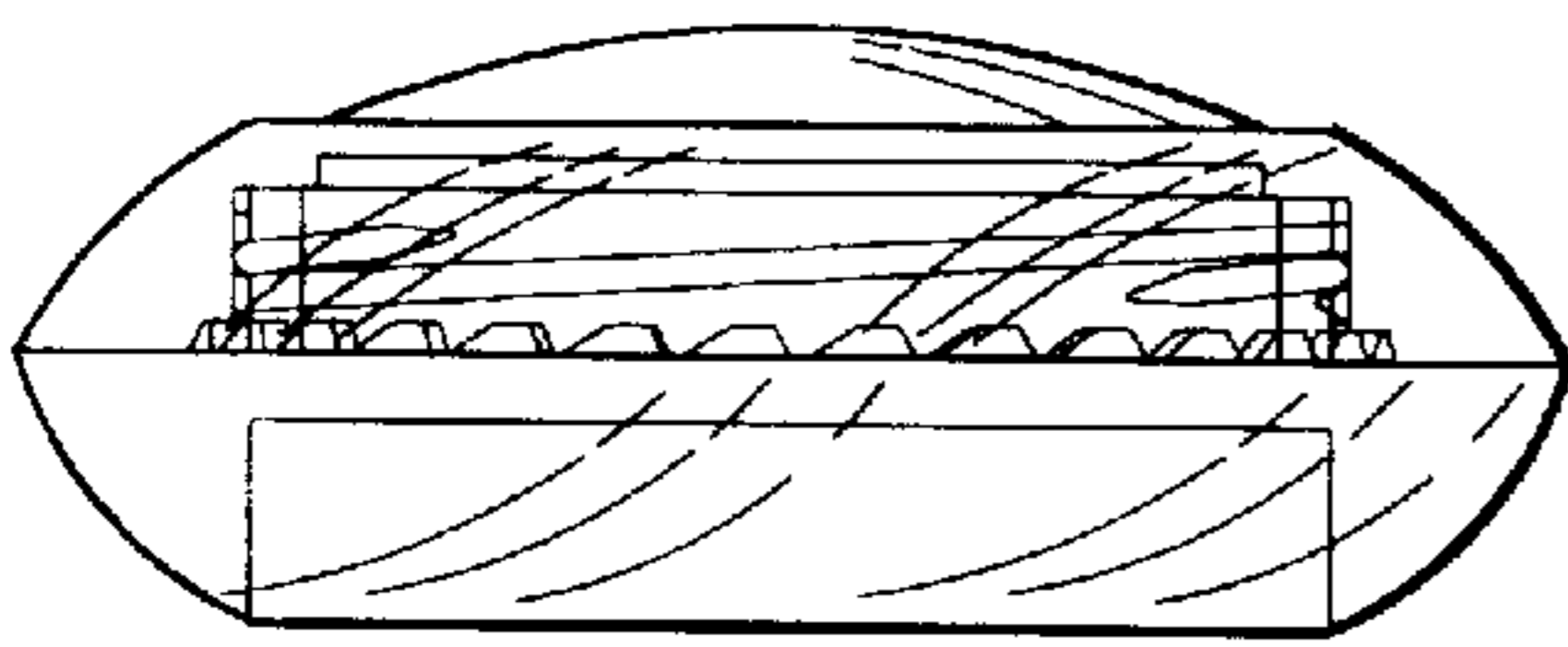

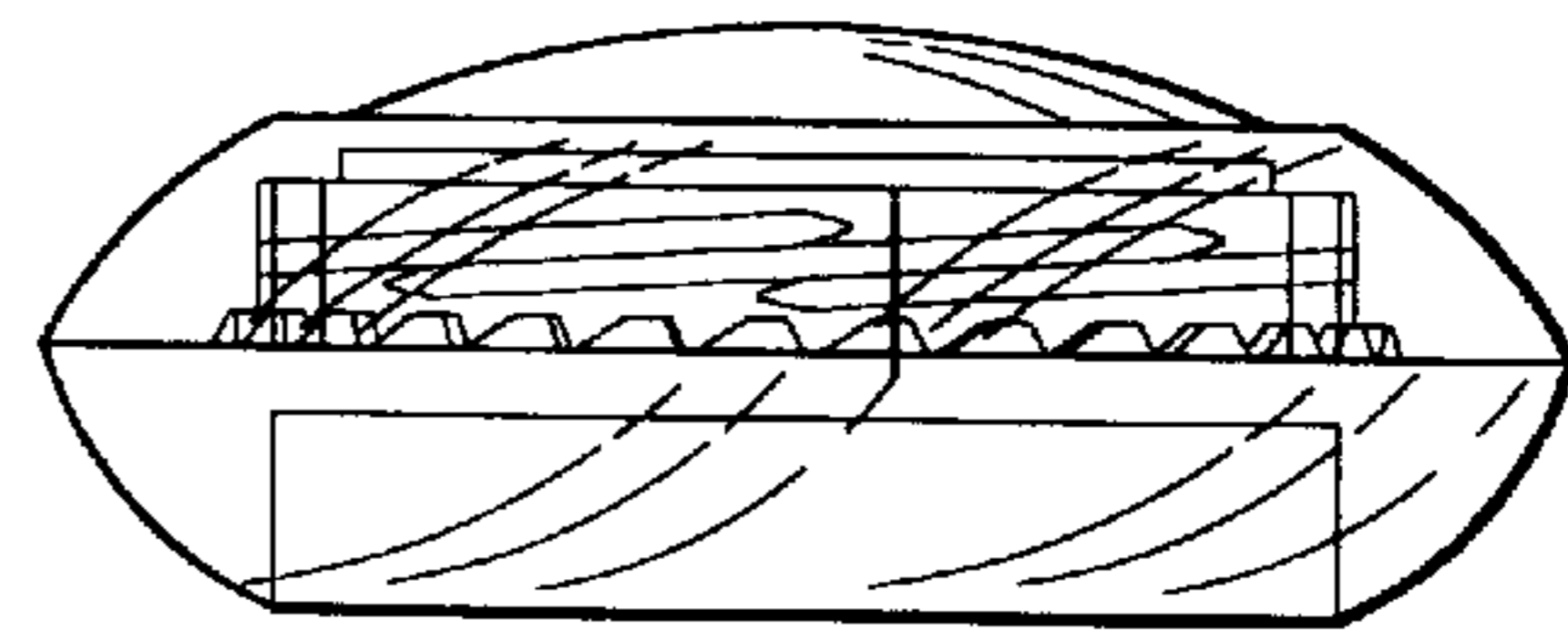

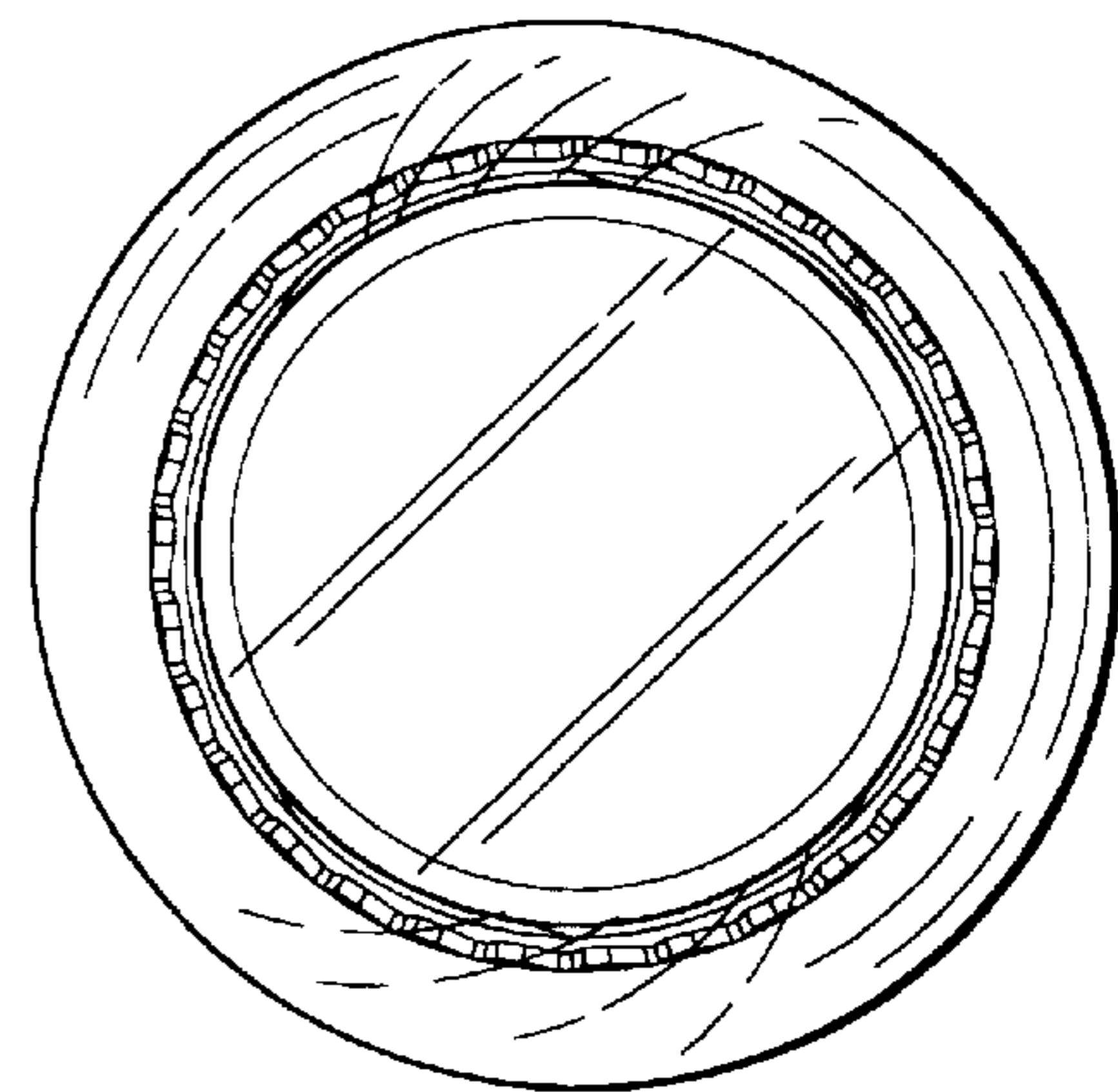

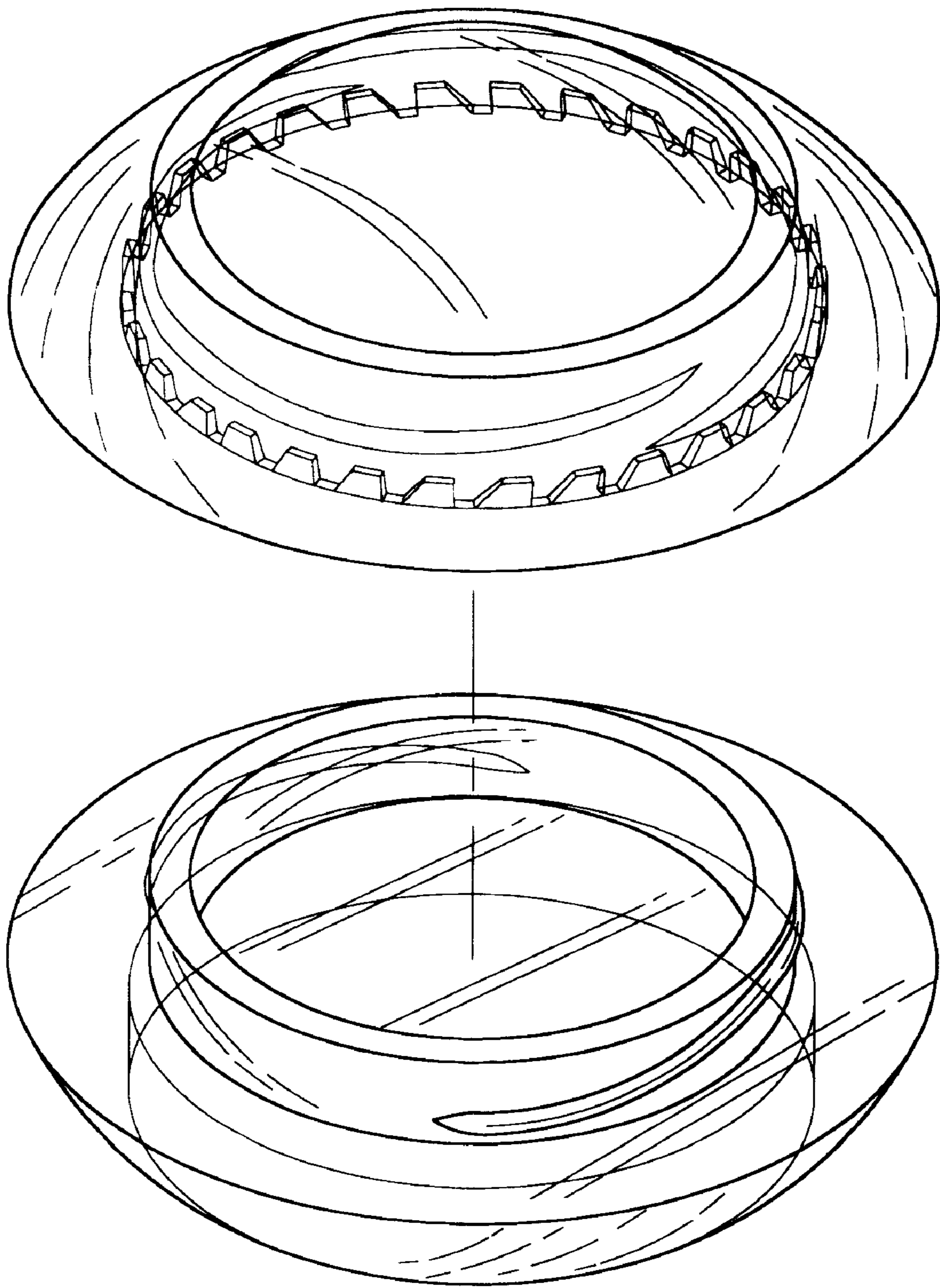

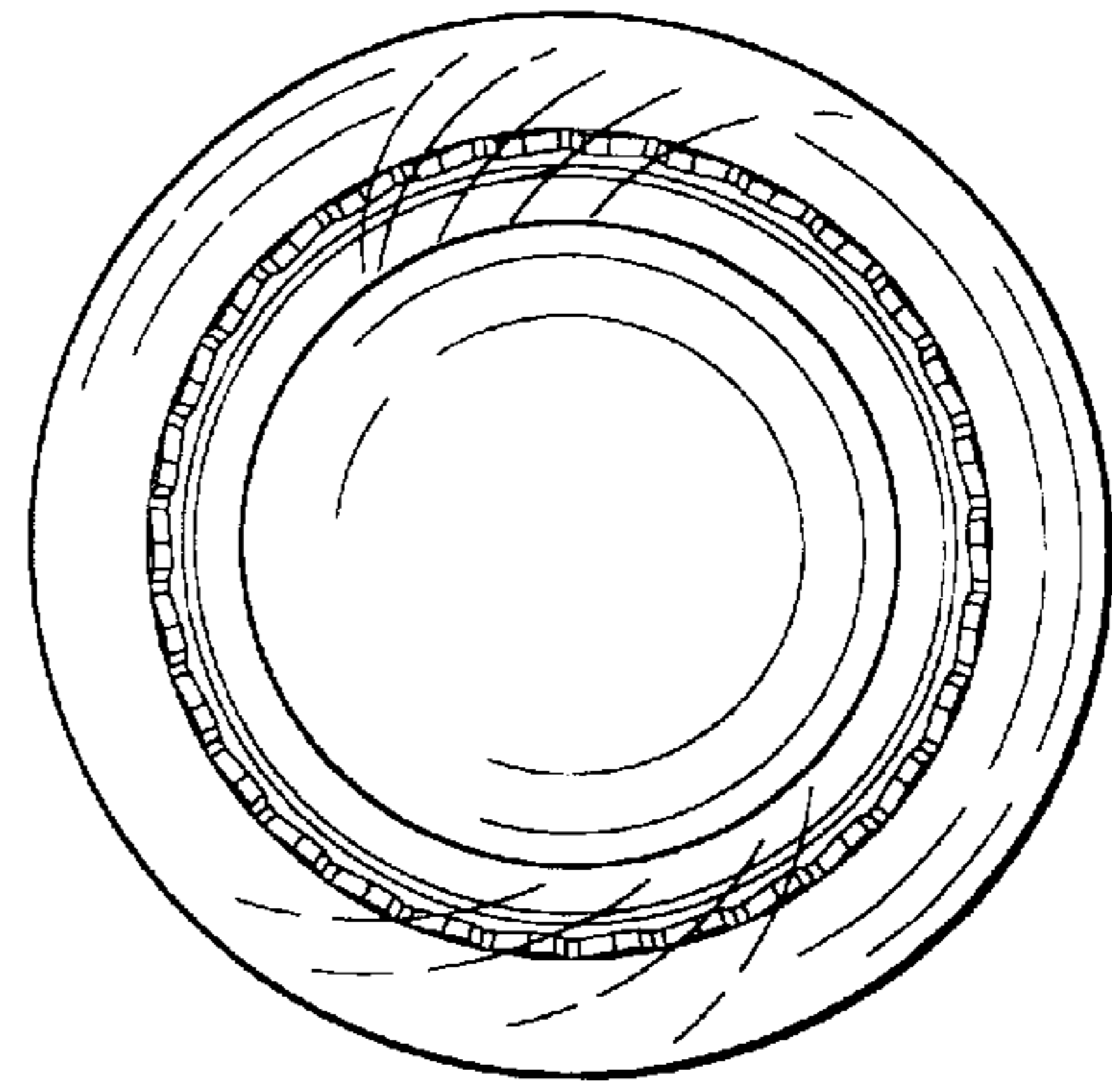

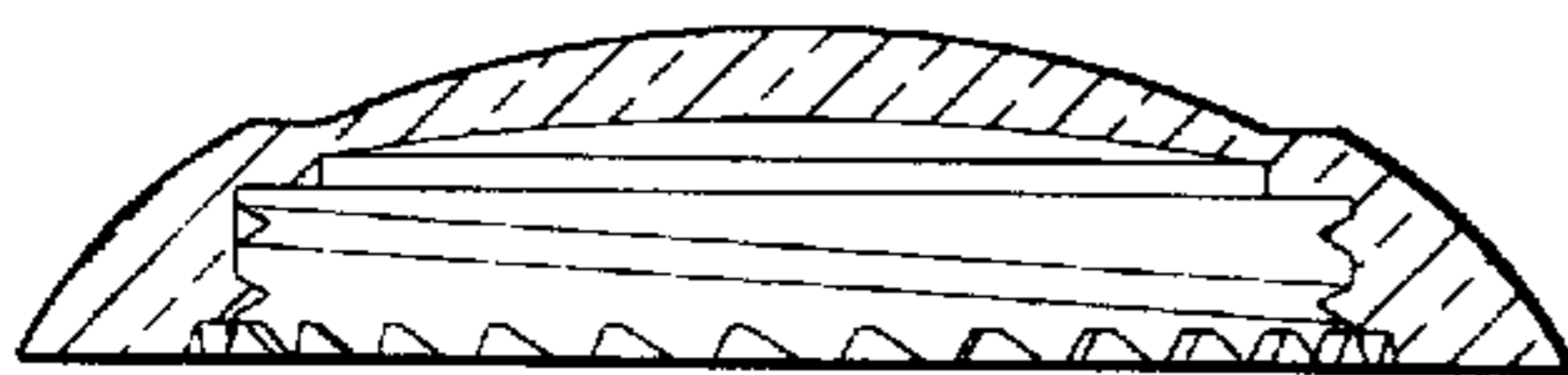

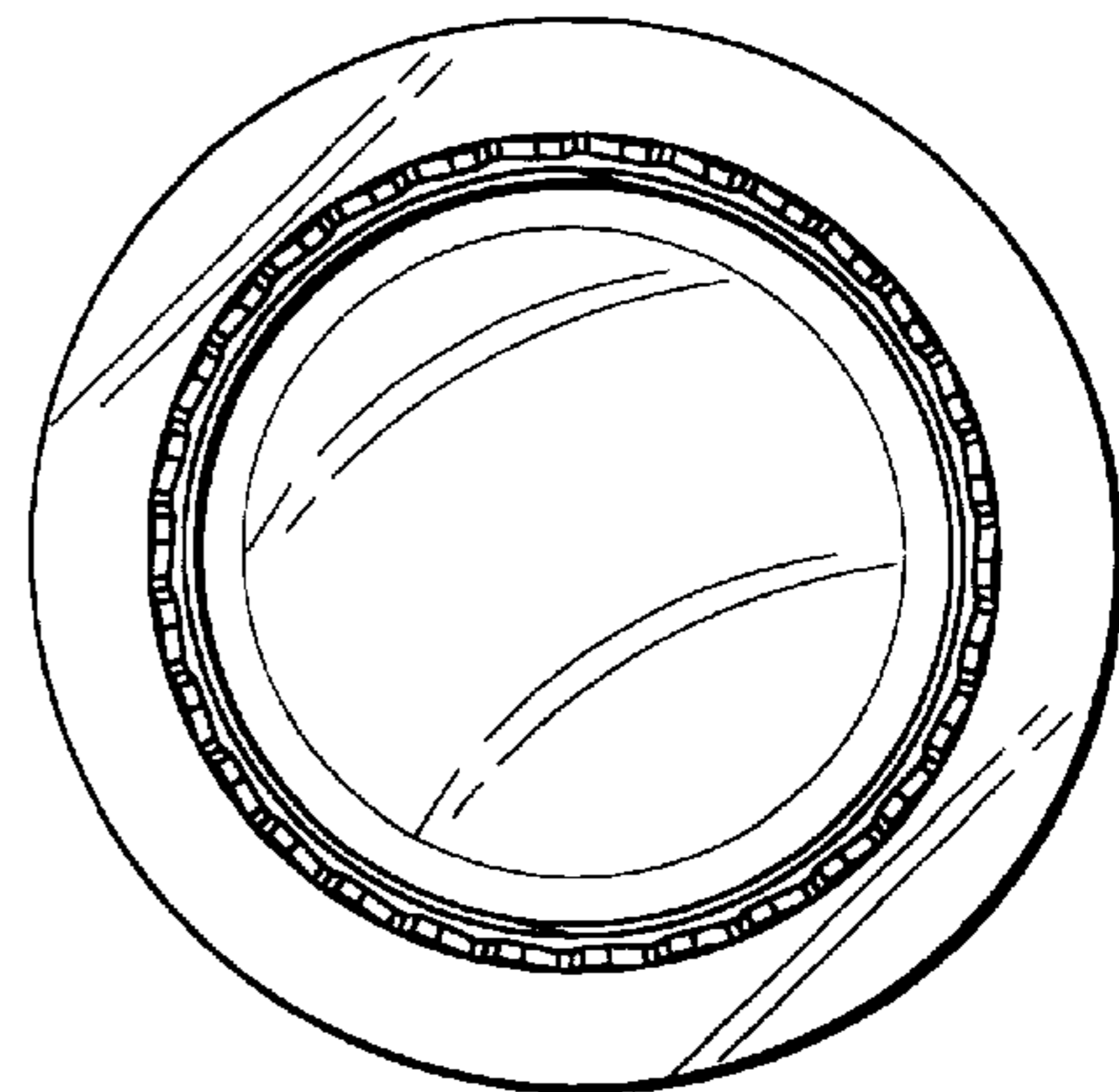

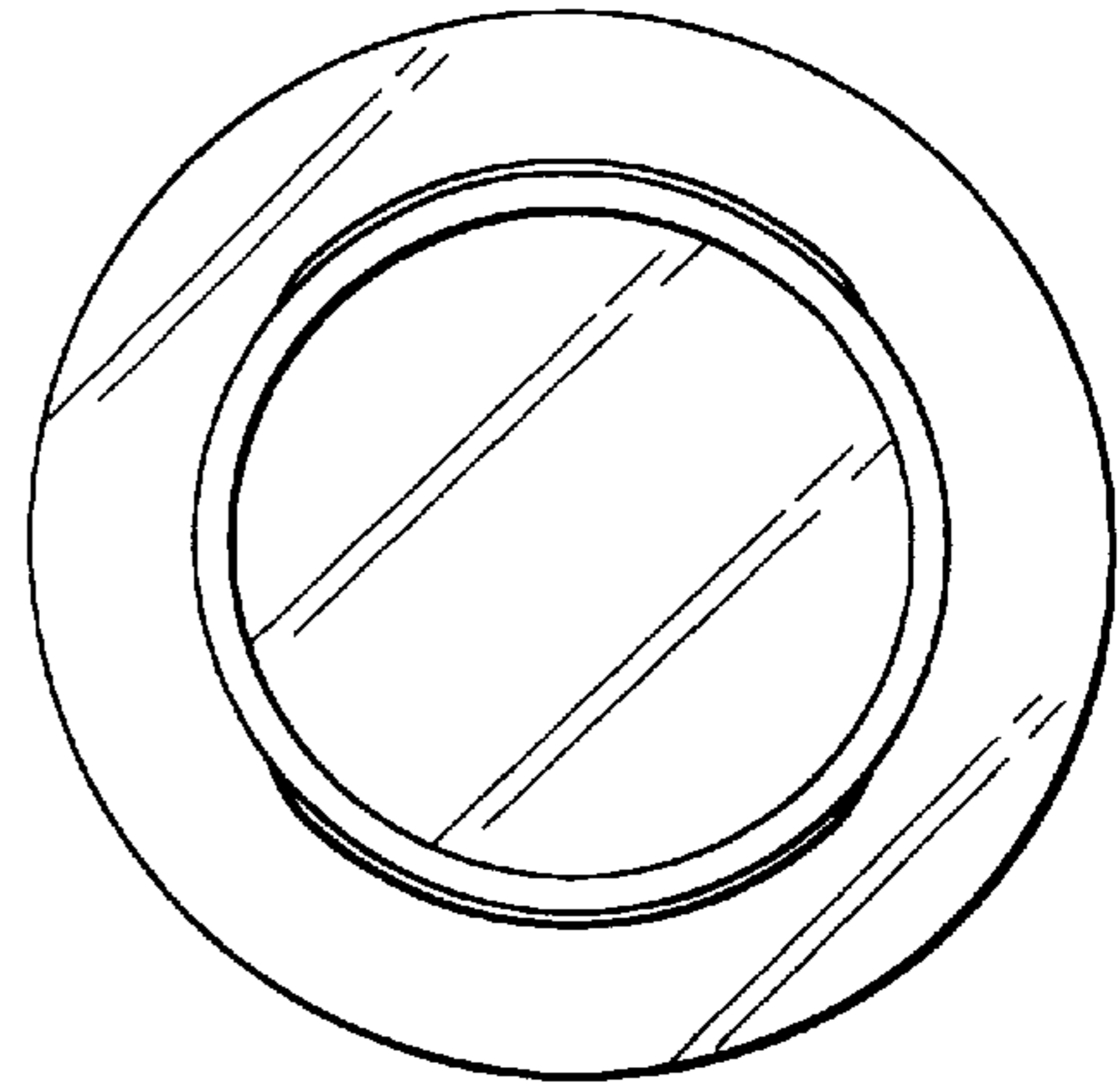

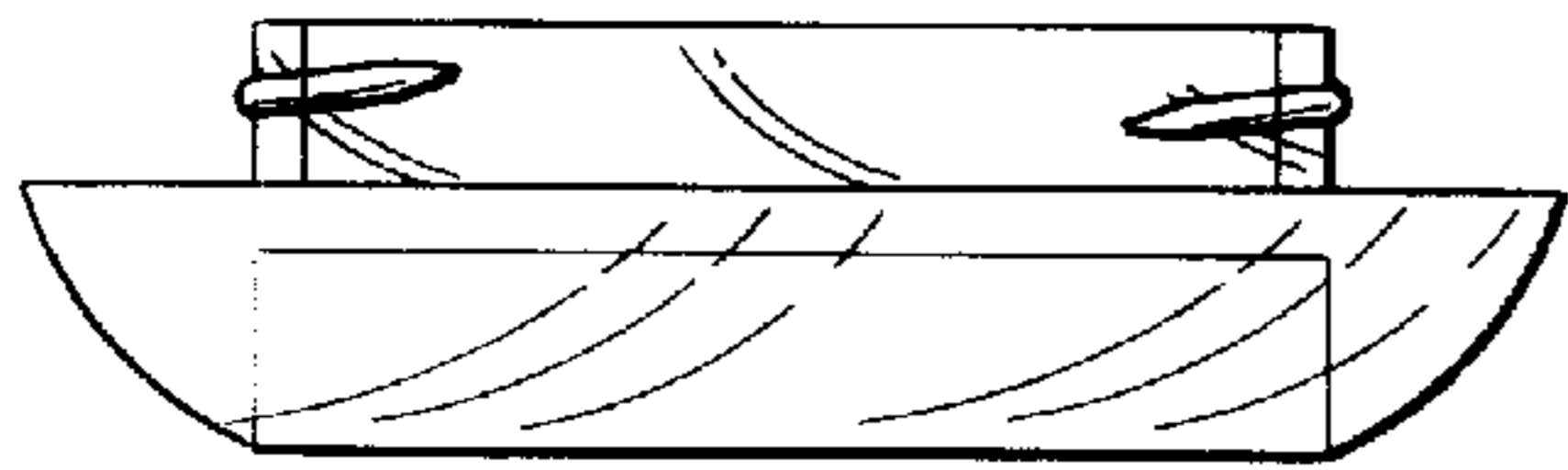

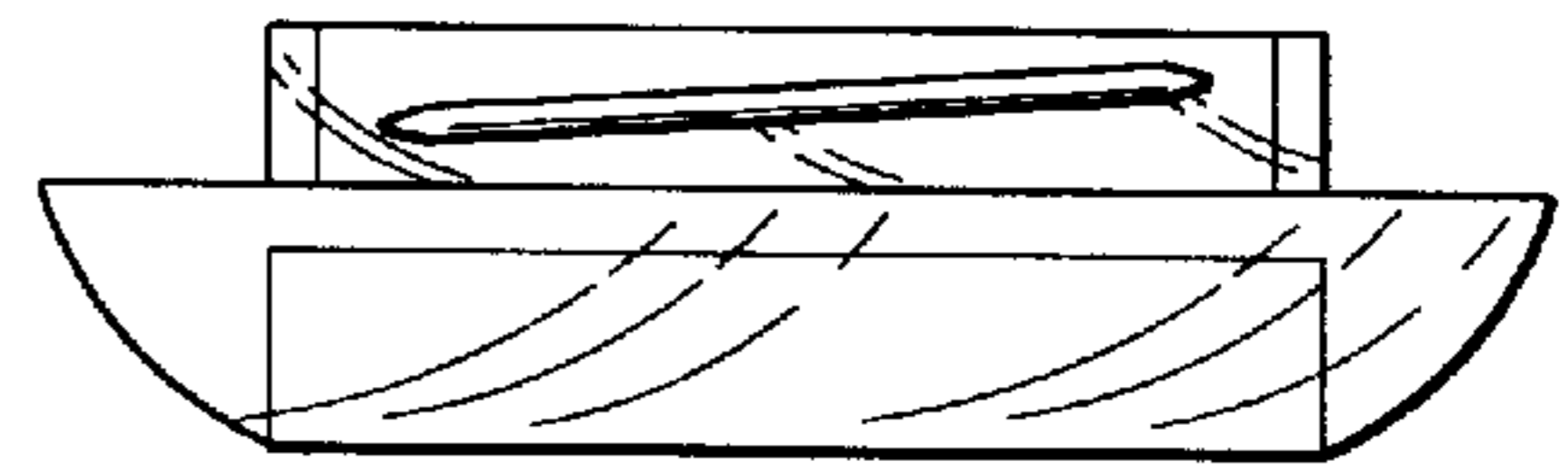

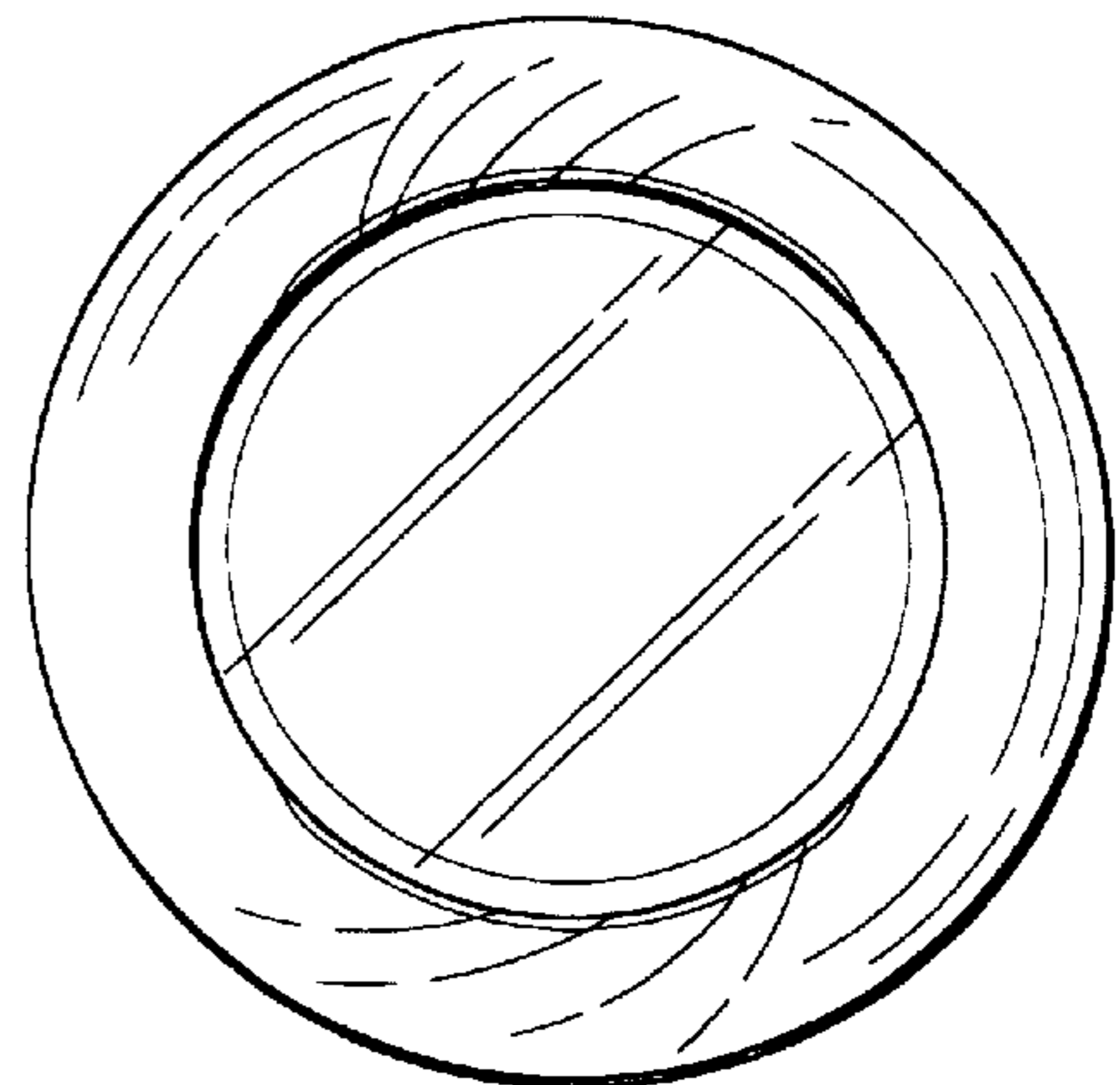
