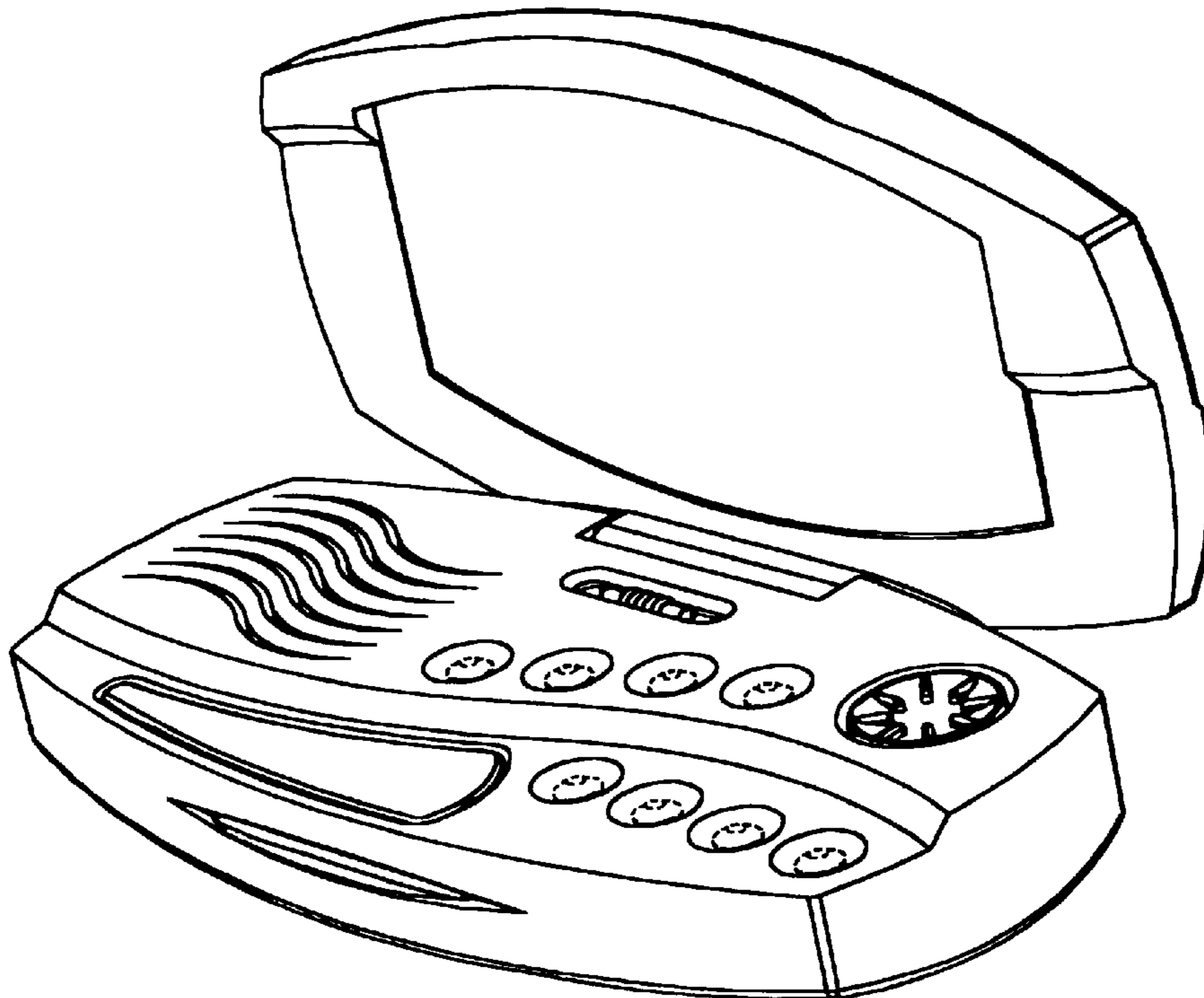
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the clock of the present invention in an open position;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the clock of FIG. 1 in an open position;  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the clock of FIG. 1 in an open position;  
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the clock of FIG. 1 in an open position, the left side being a mirror image;  
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the clock of FIG. 1 in a closed position;  
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the clock of FIG. 1 in a closed position;  
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the clock of FIG. 1 in a closed position; and,  
 FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the clock of FIG. 1 in a closed position, the left side being a mirror image.  
 The broken line showing of “buttons” and other representations appearing in FIGS. 1-3 are for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

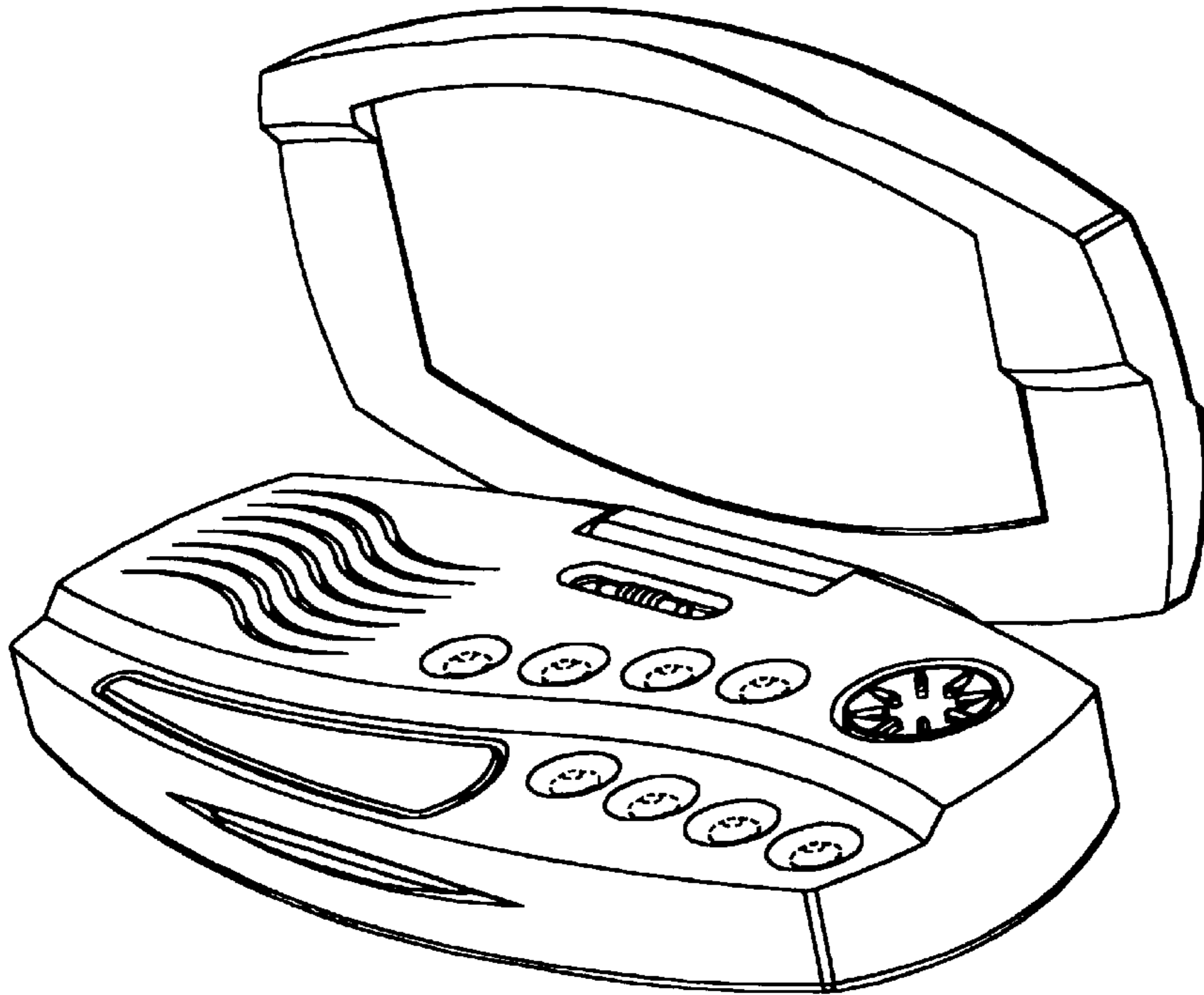

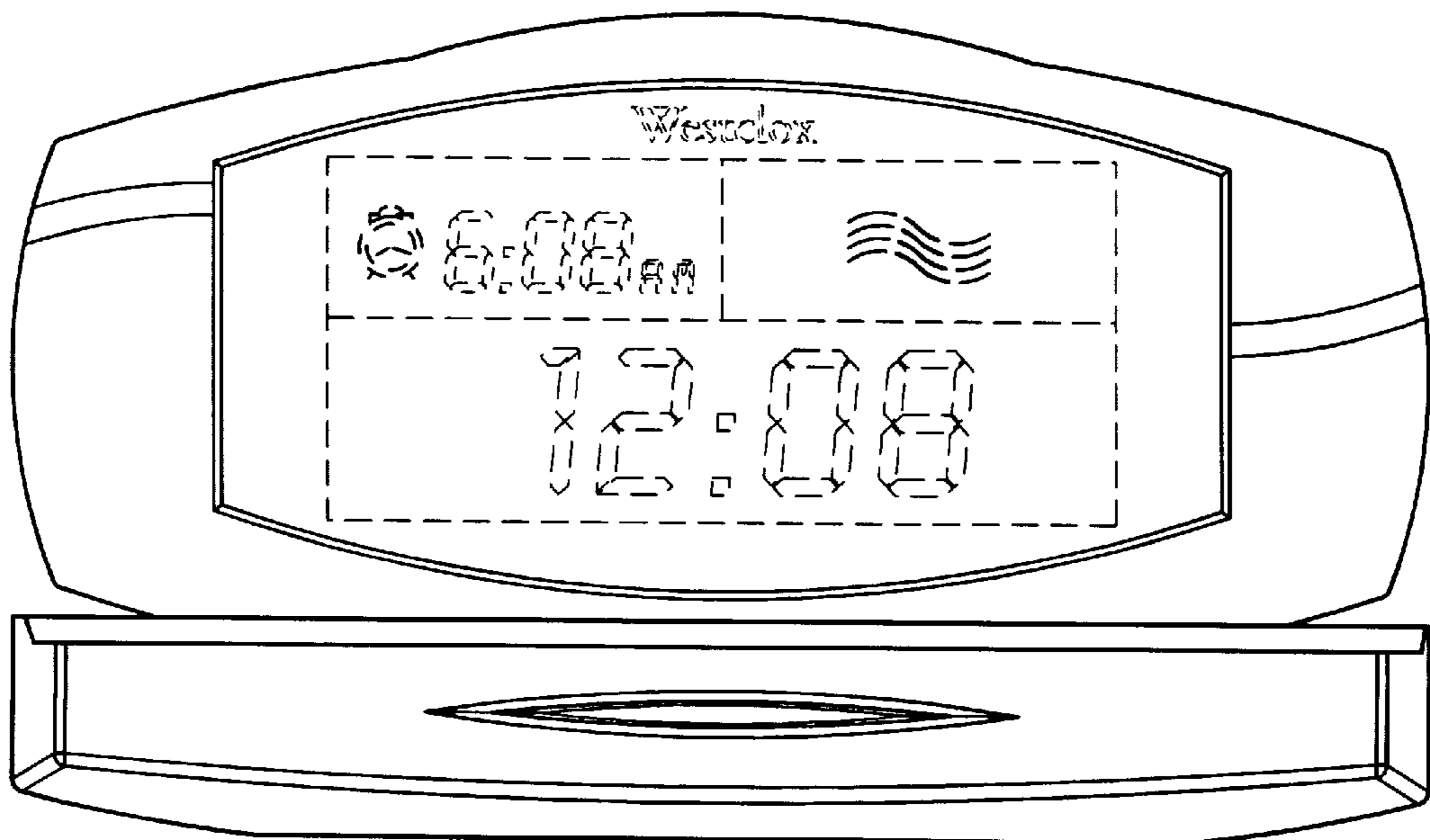

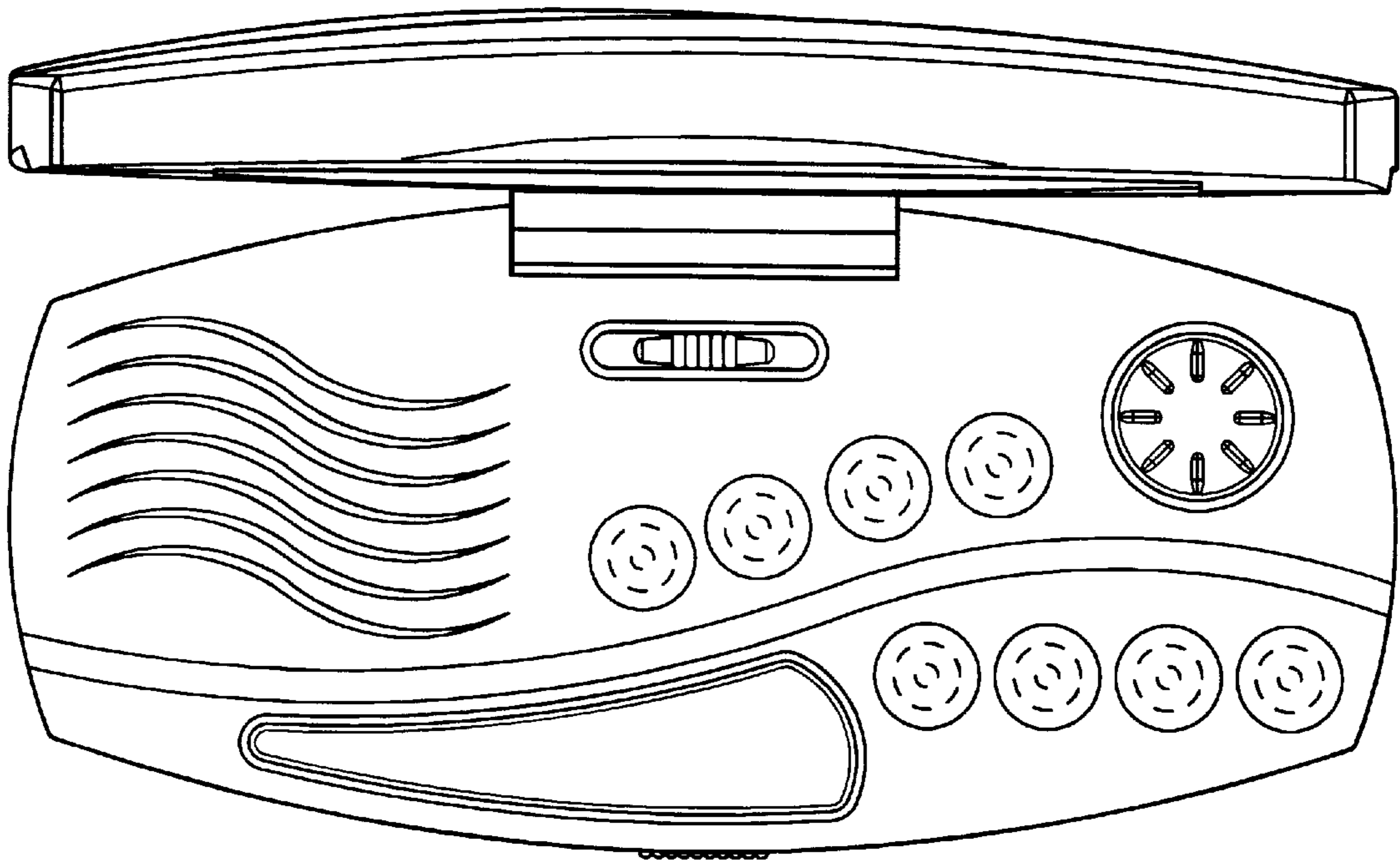

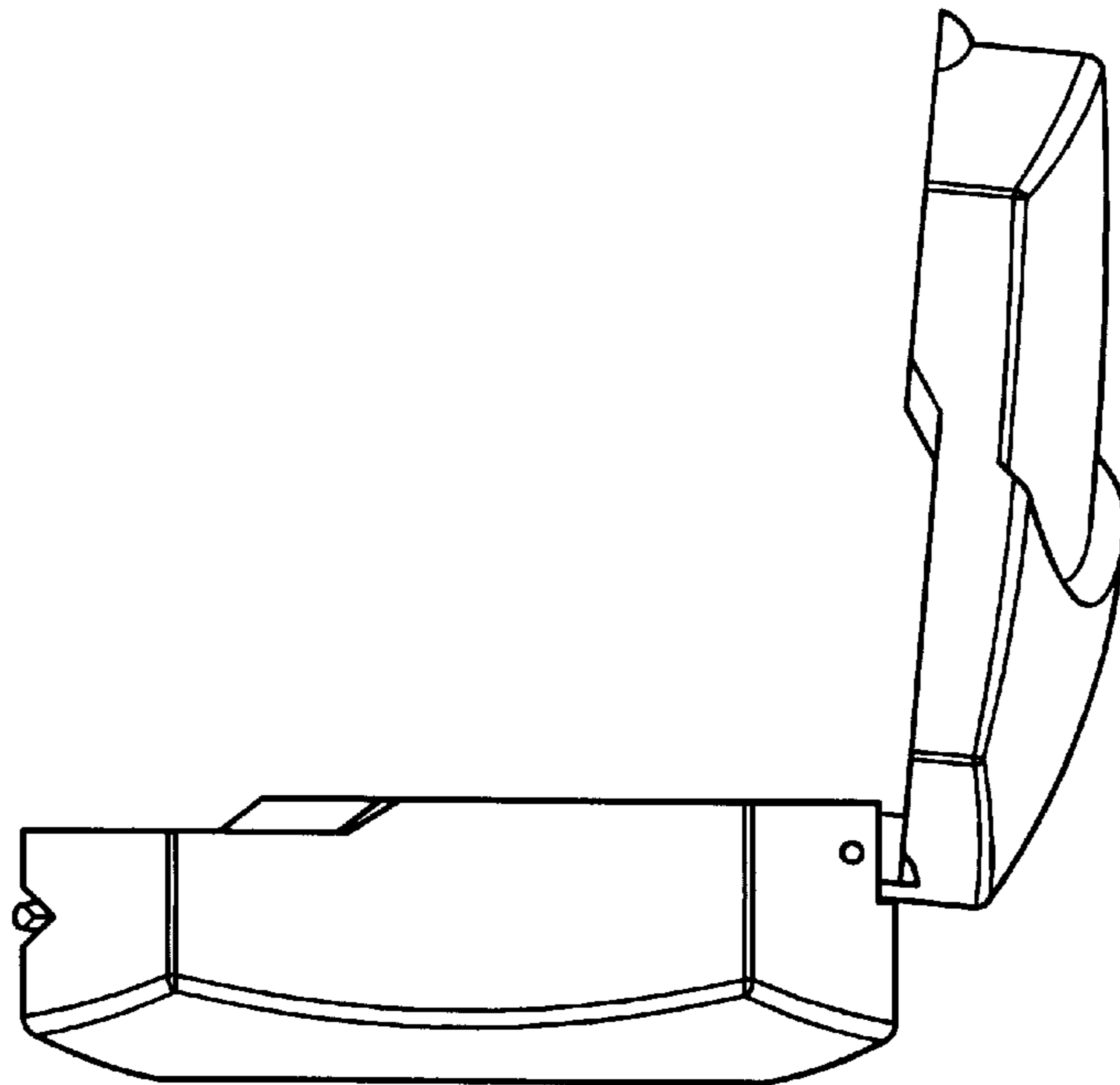

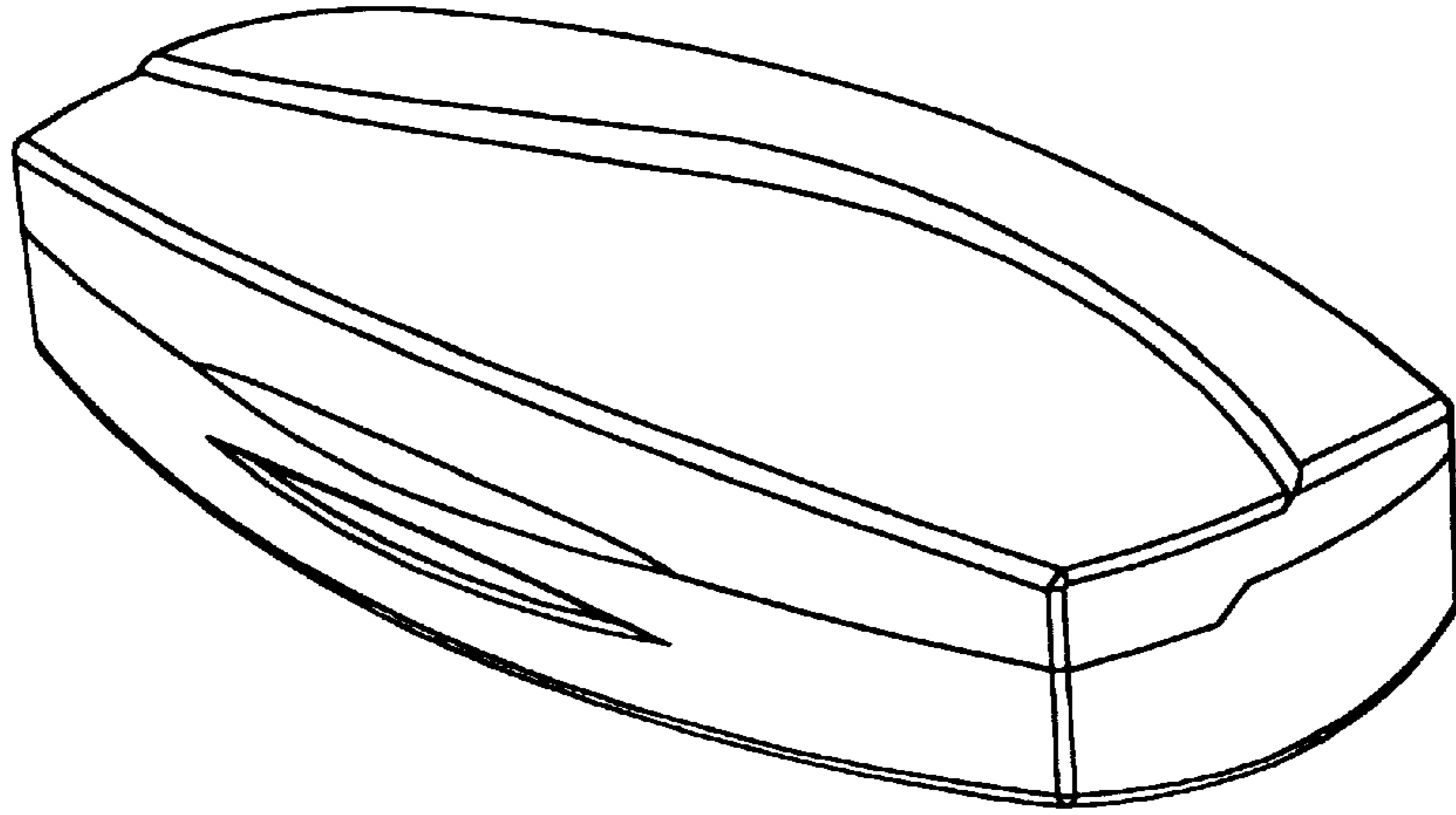

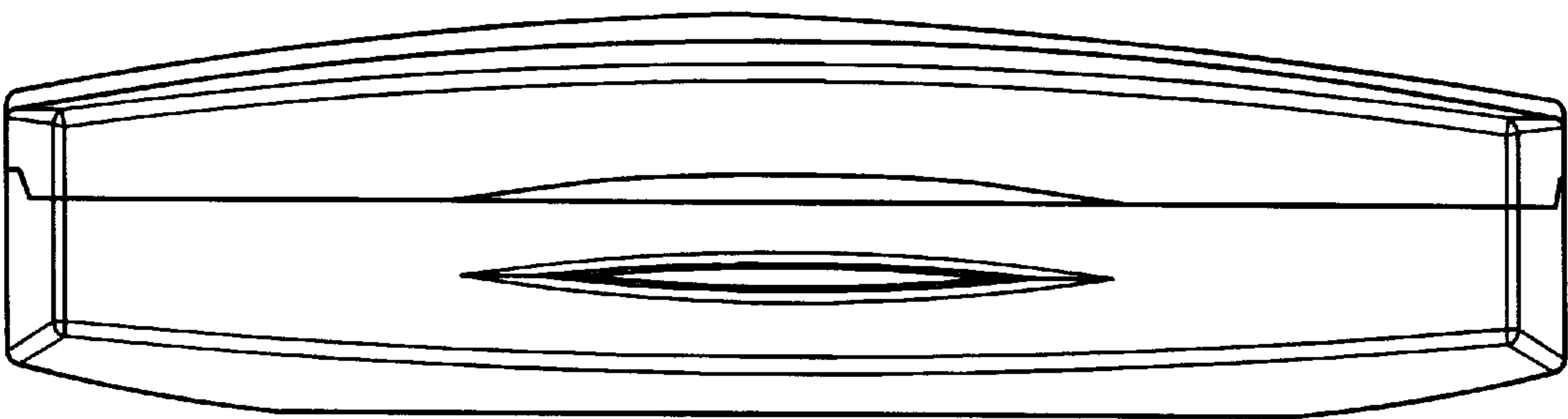

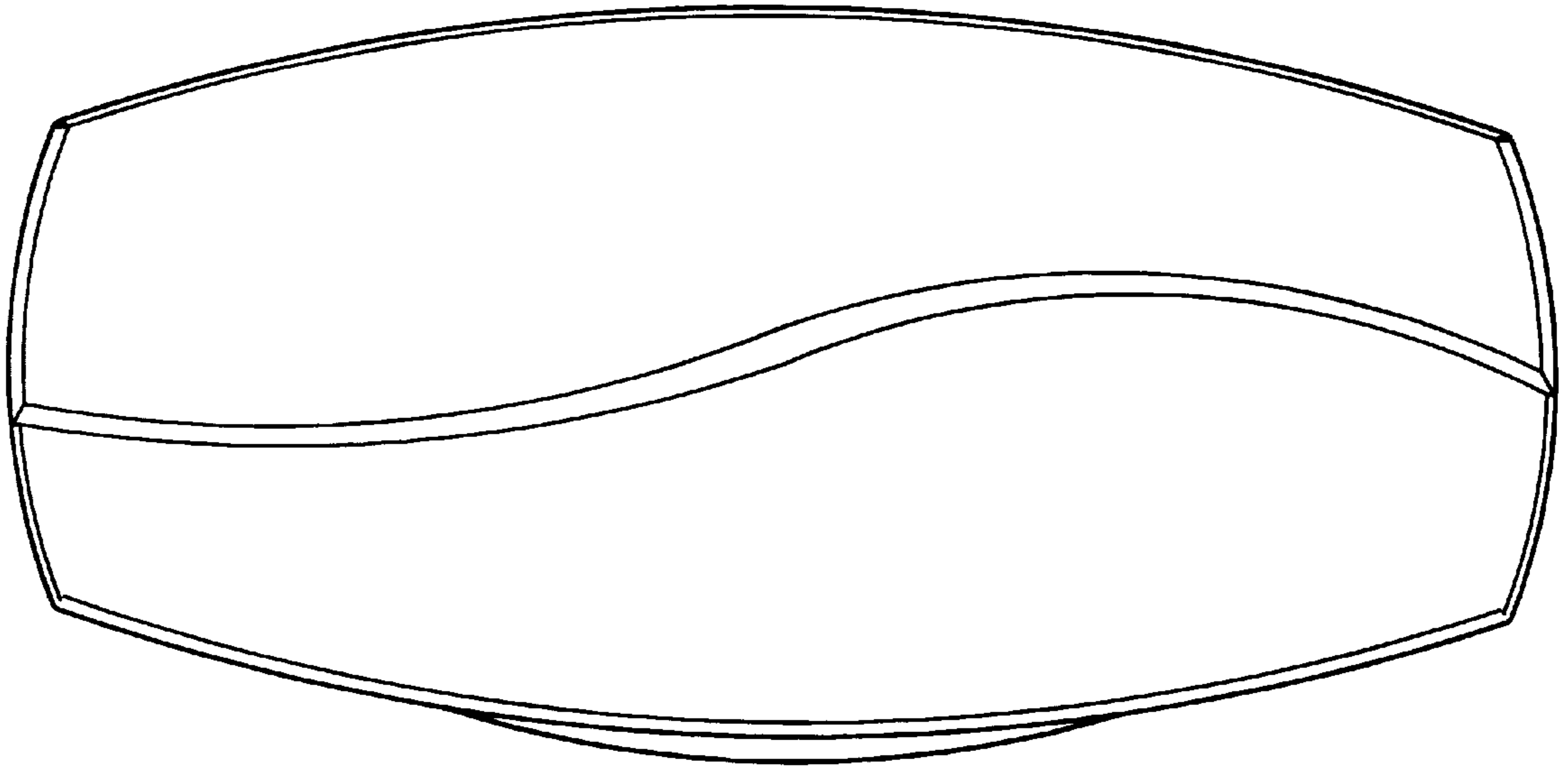

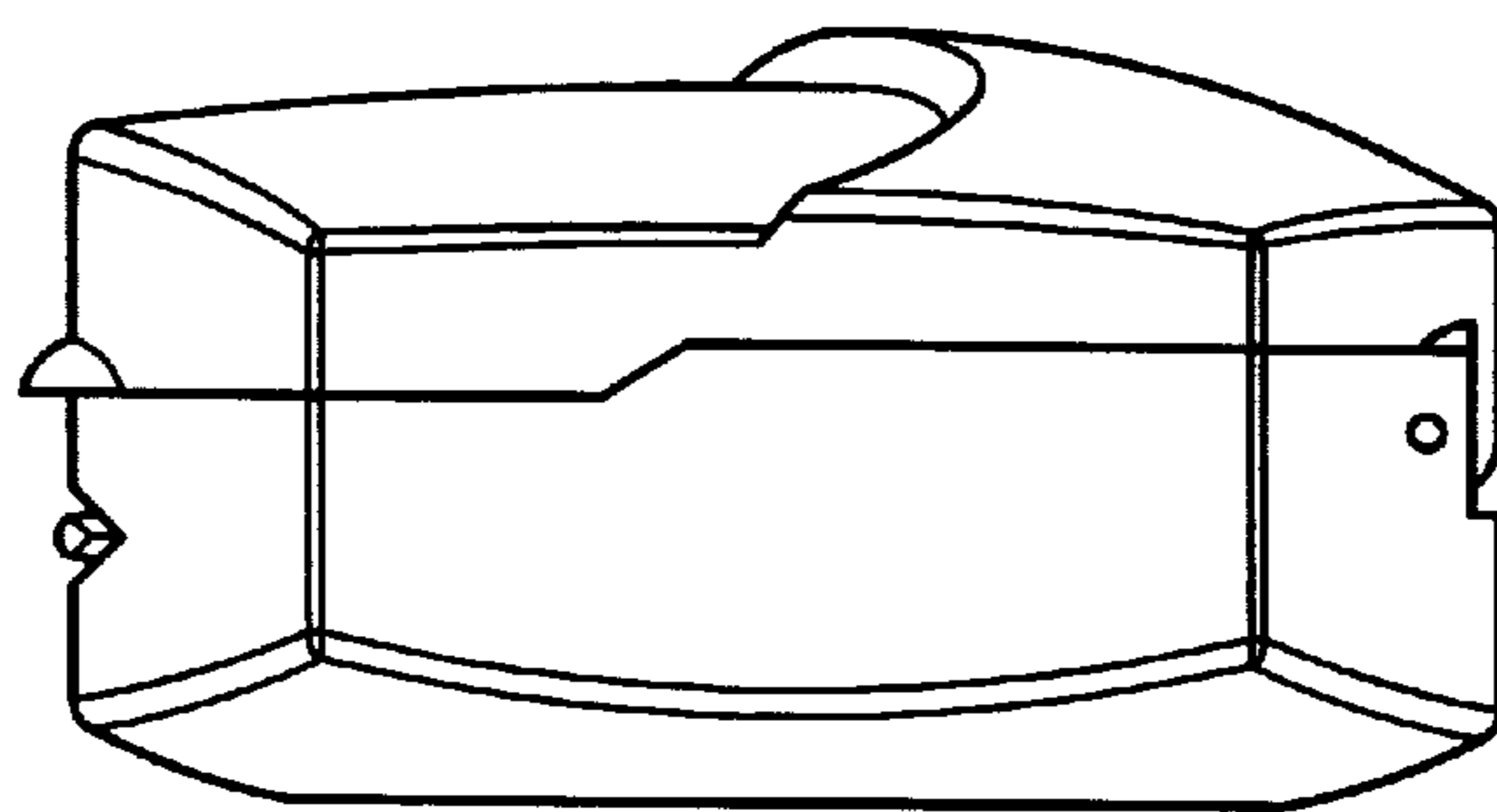
