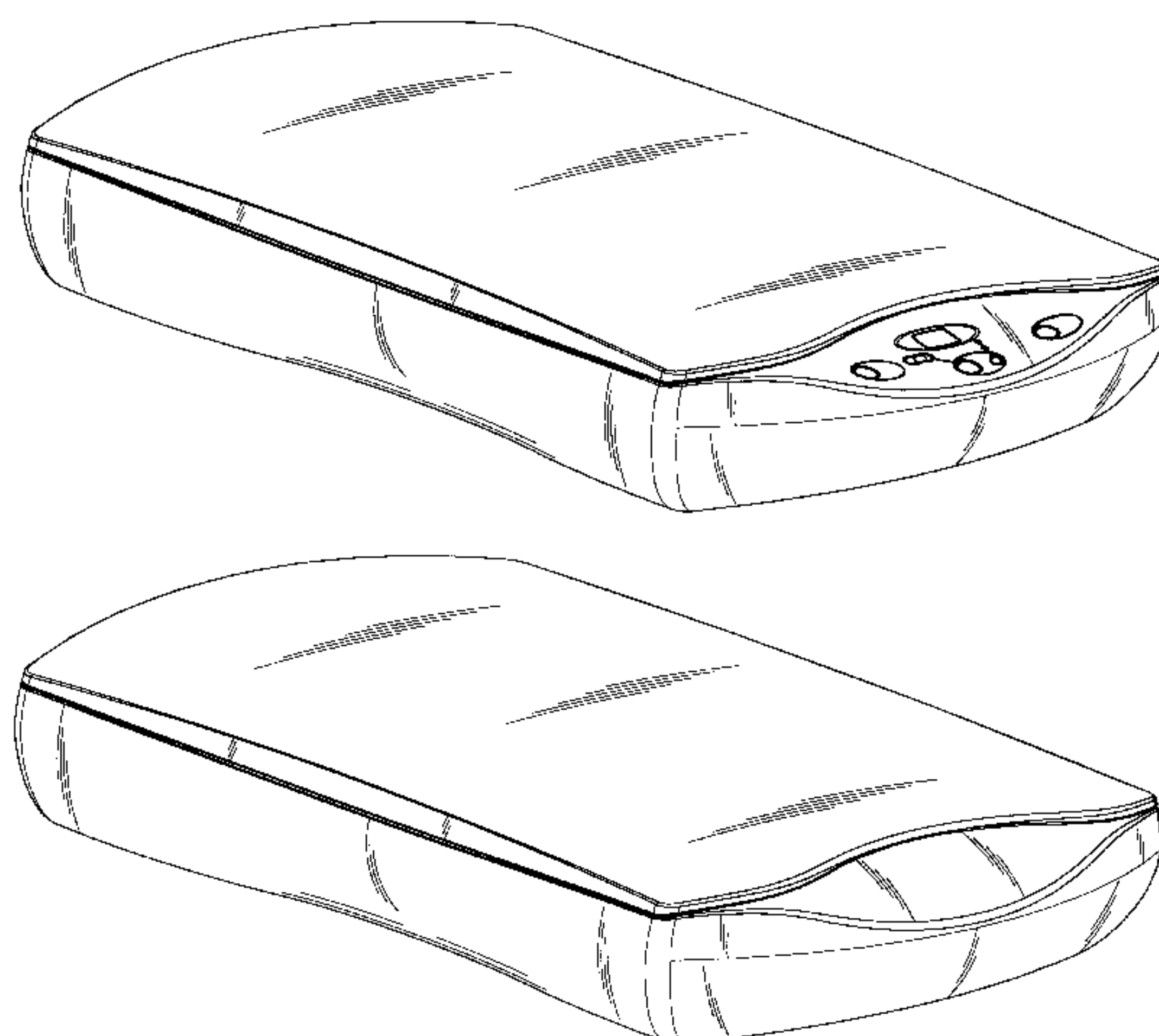
The ornamental design for a scanner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a scanner;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a cross sectional elevation view of a front portion thereof taken along line 8—8 in FIG. 2;
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a scanner;
FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the second embodiment;
FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment;
FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of the second embodiment;
FIG. 13 is a rear elevation view of the second embodiment;
FIG. 14 is a left side elevation view of the second embodiment;
FIG. 15 is a right side elevation view of the second embodiment; and,
FIG. 16 is a cross sectional elevation view of a front portion of a second embodiment thereof taken along line 16—16 in FIG. 10.

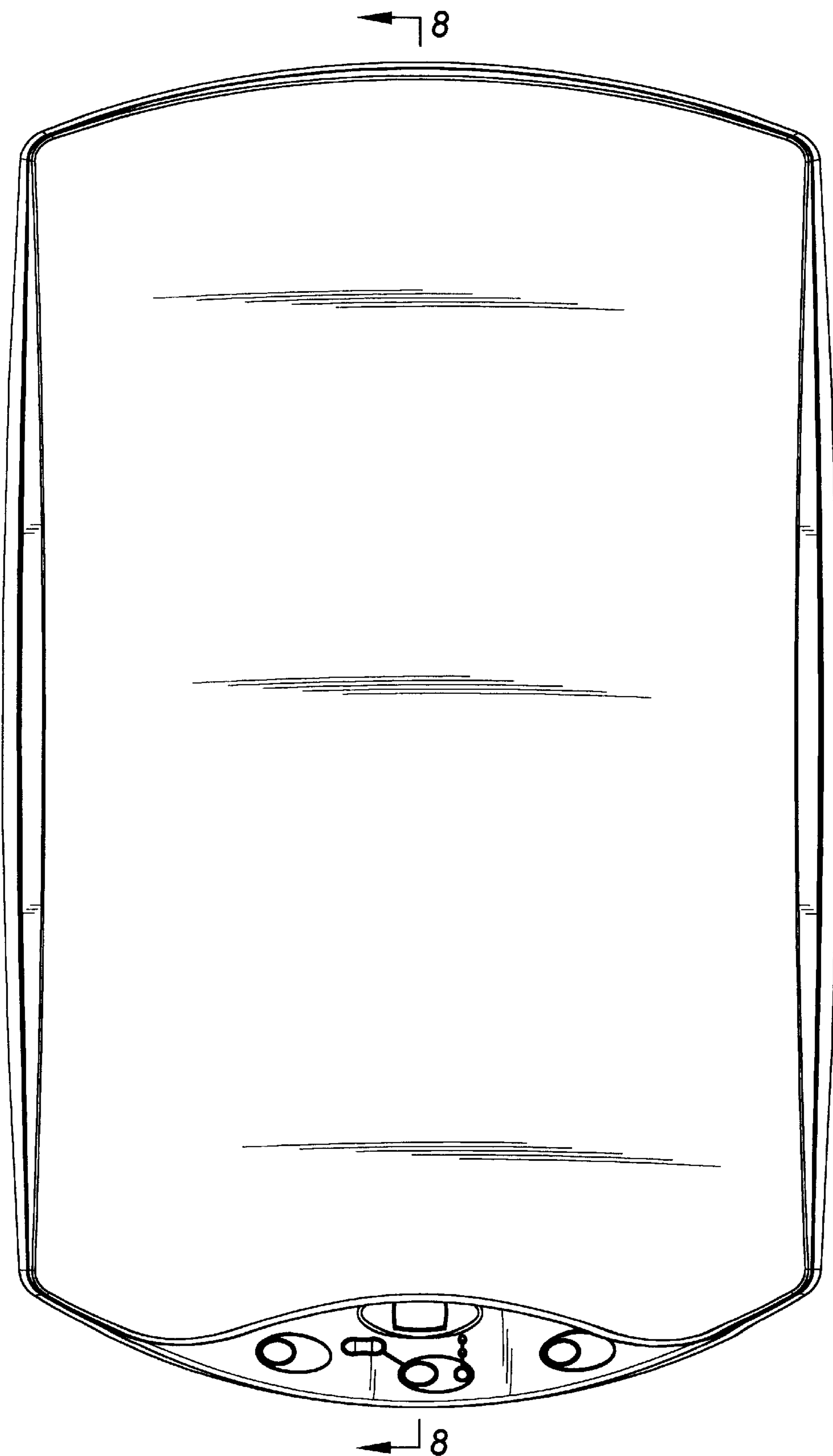

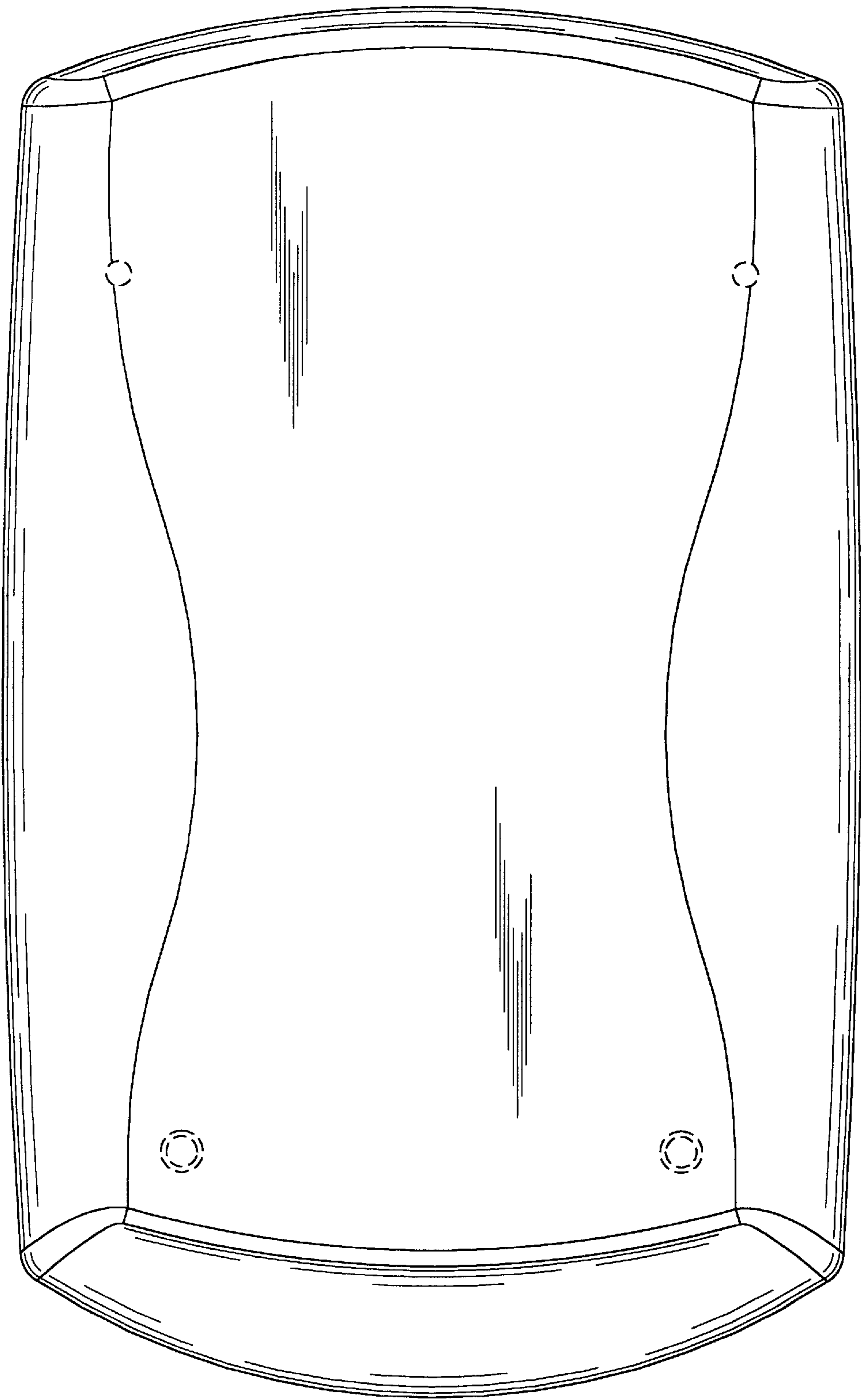

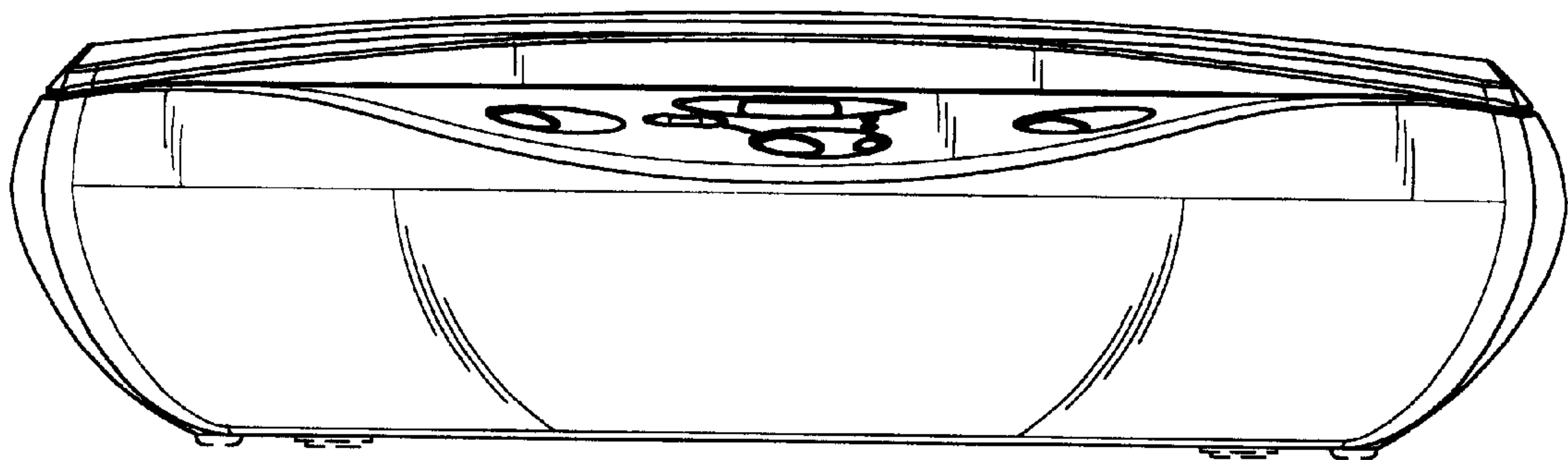

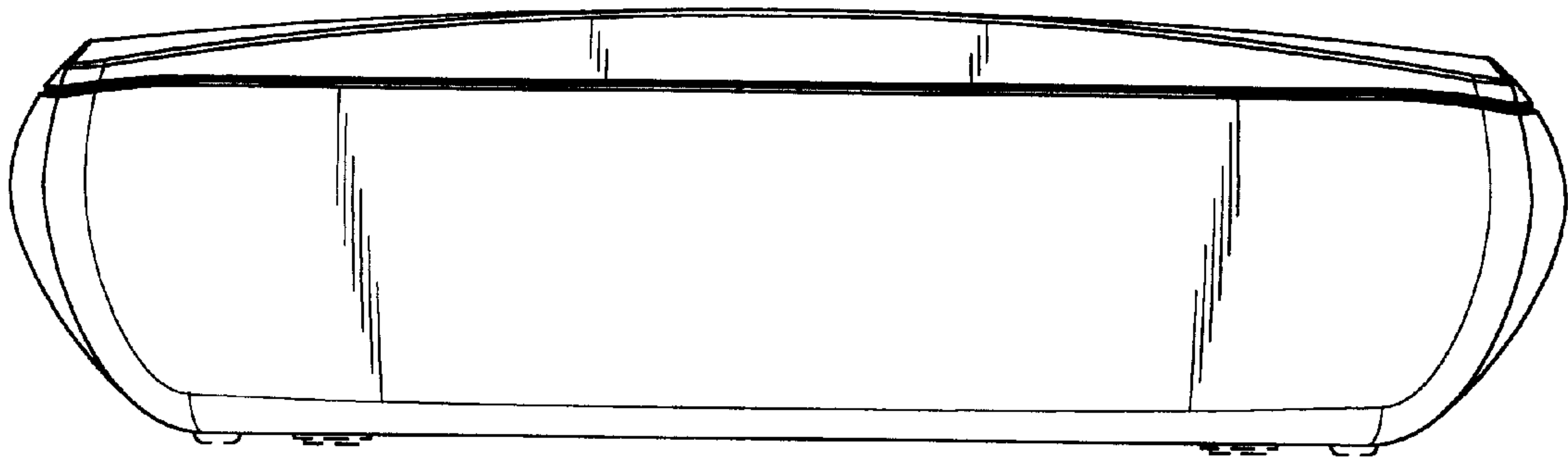

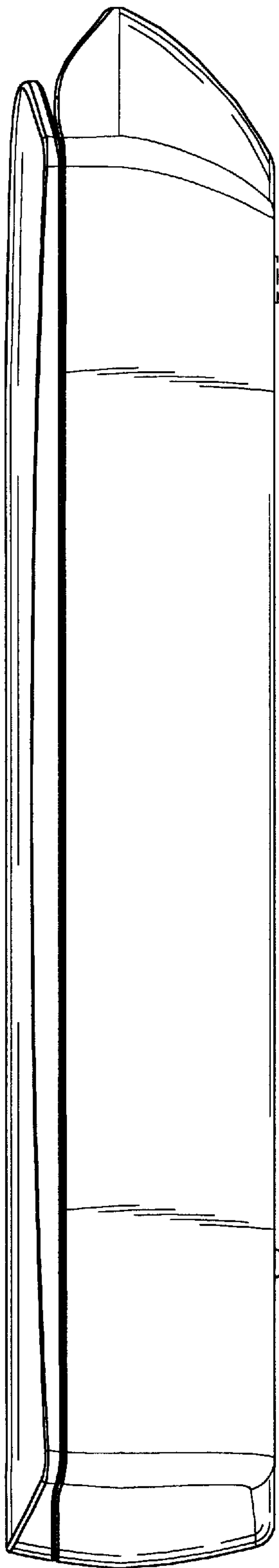

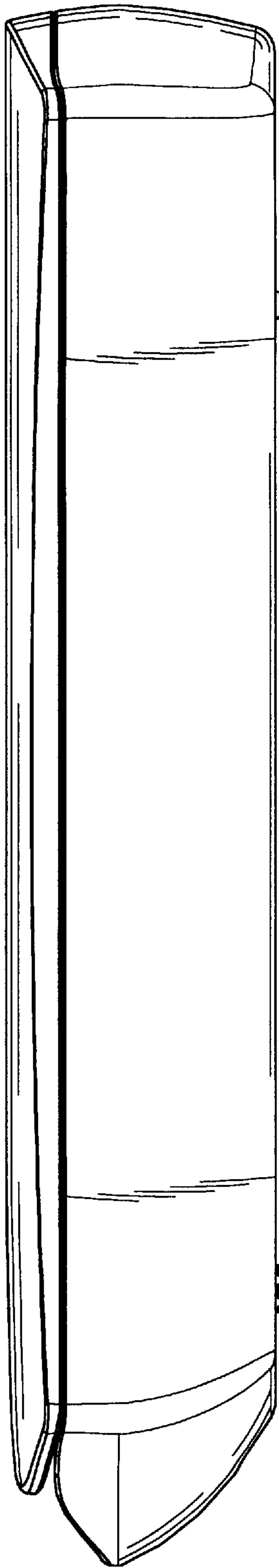

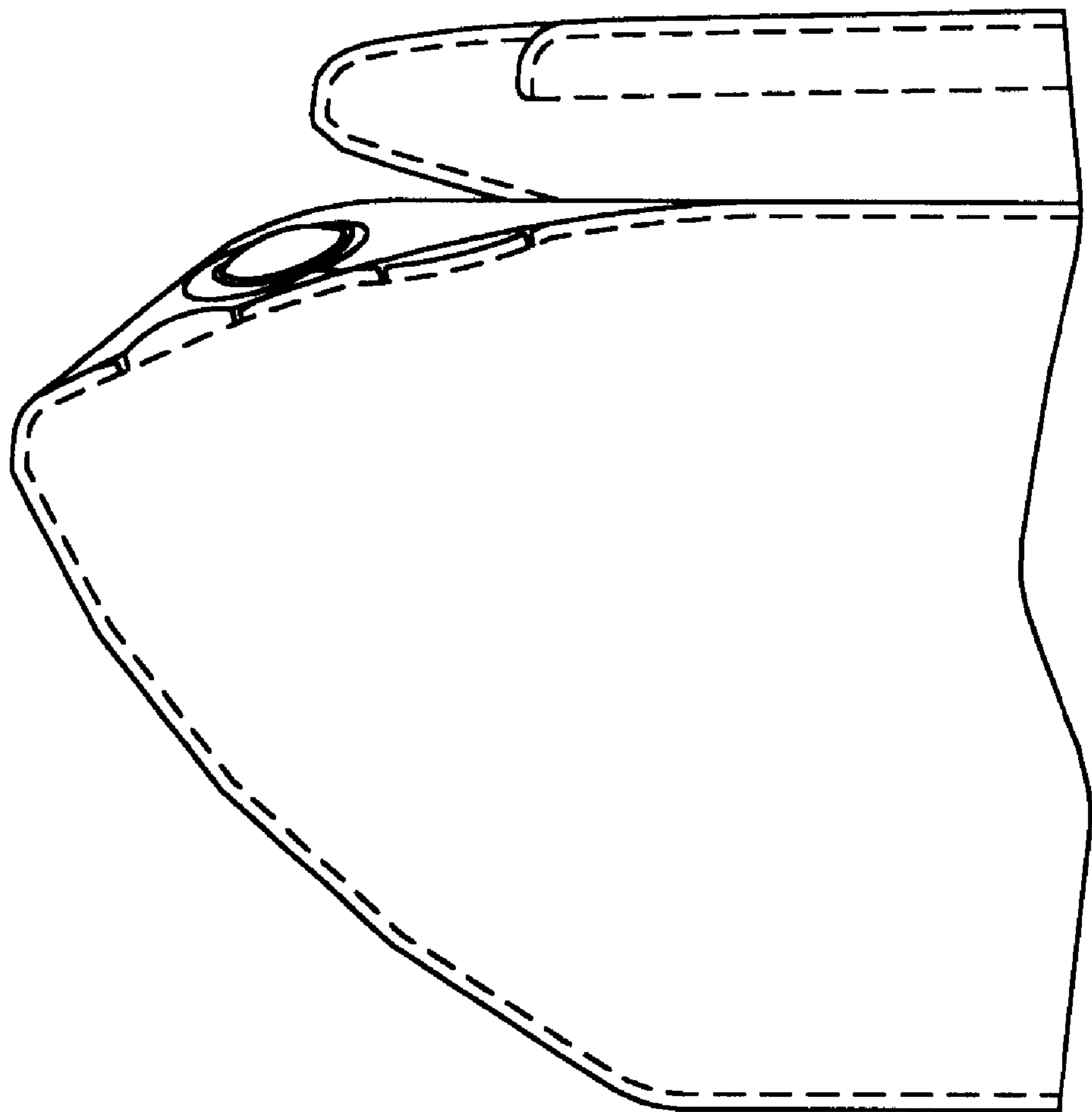

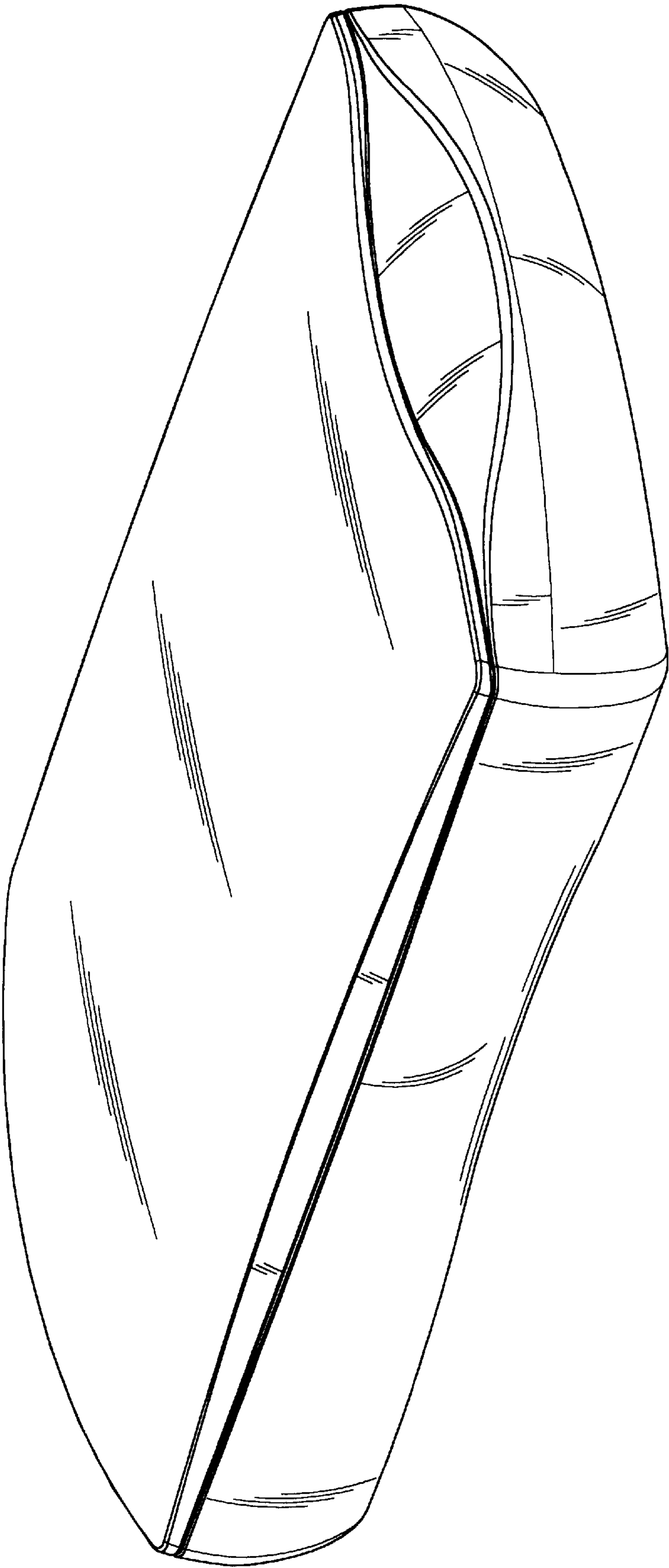

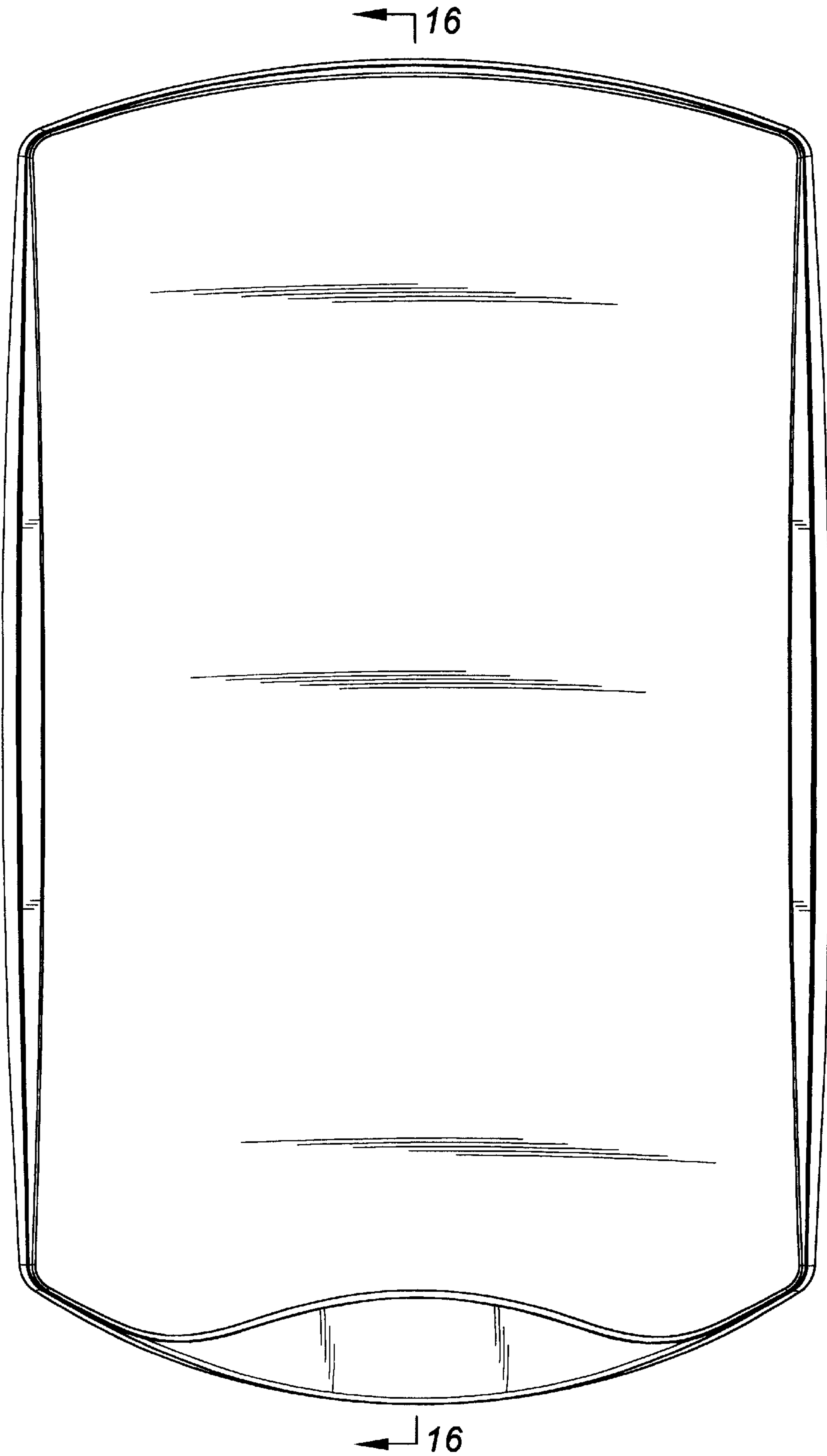

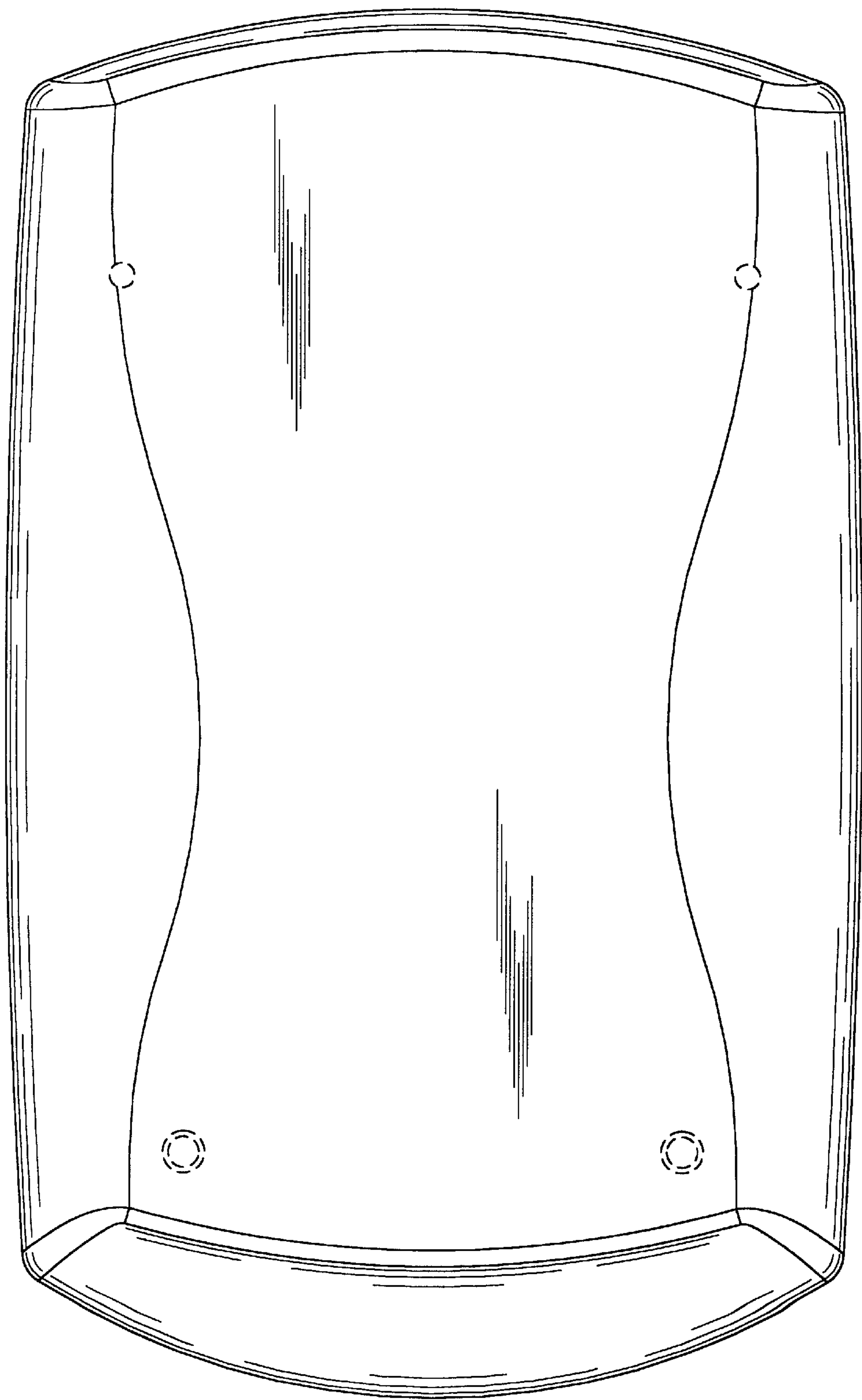

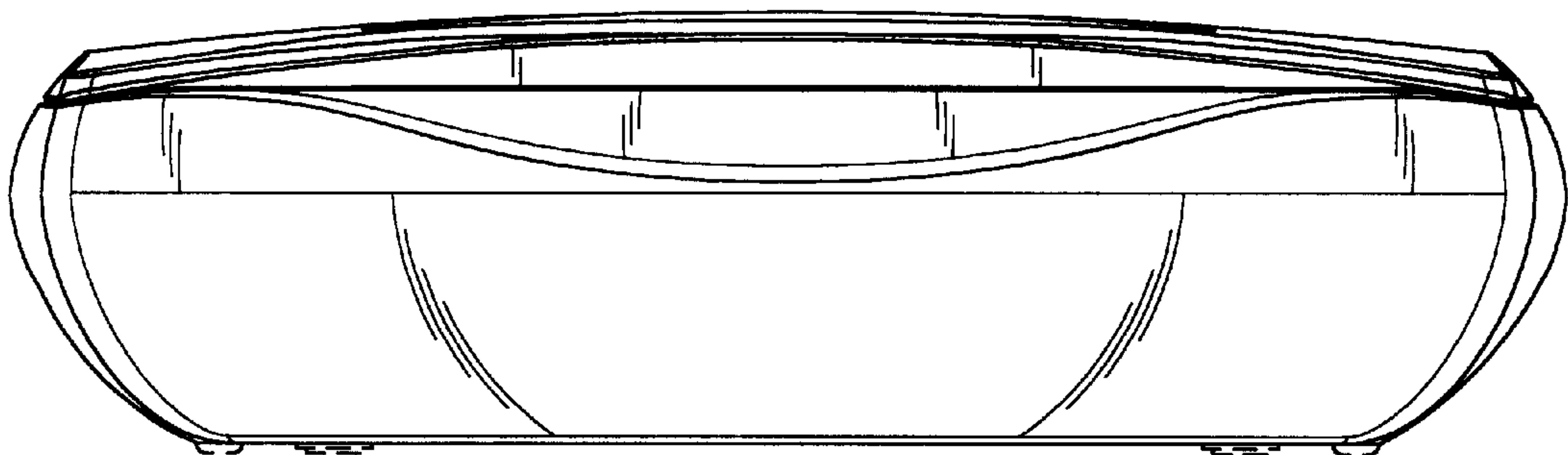

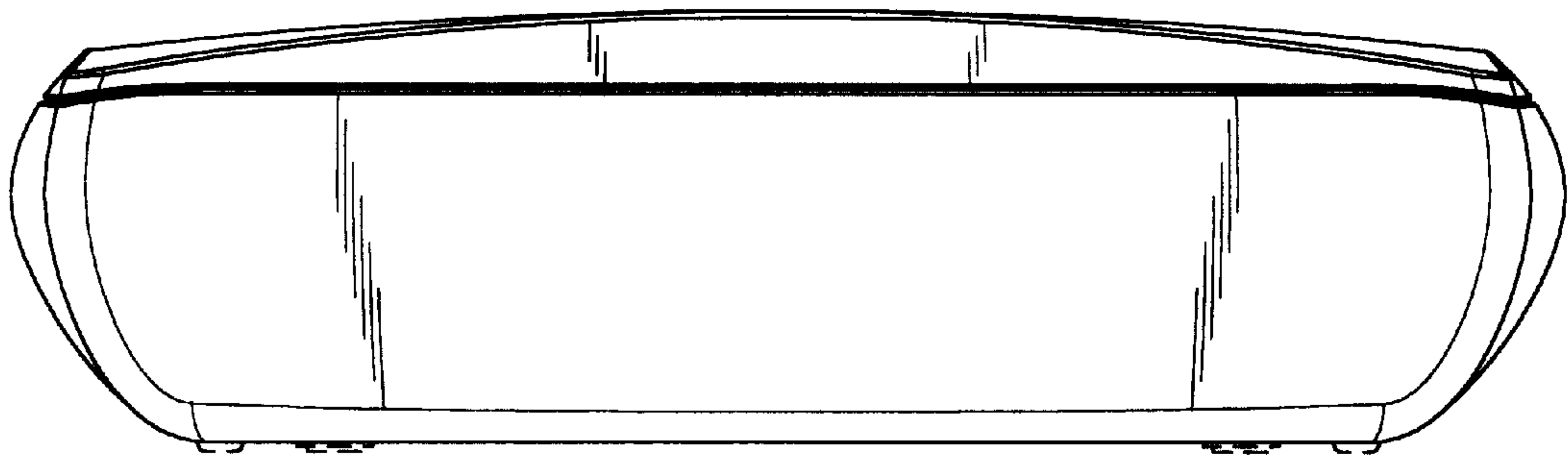

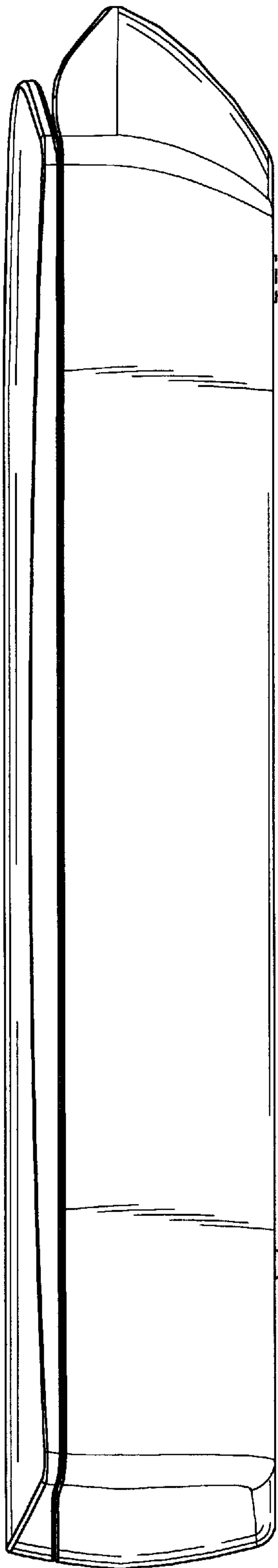

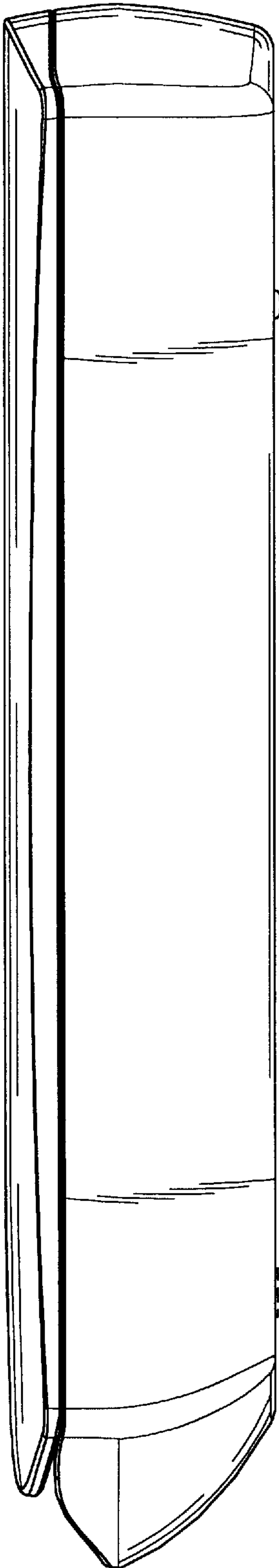

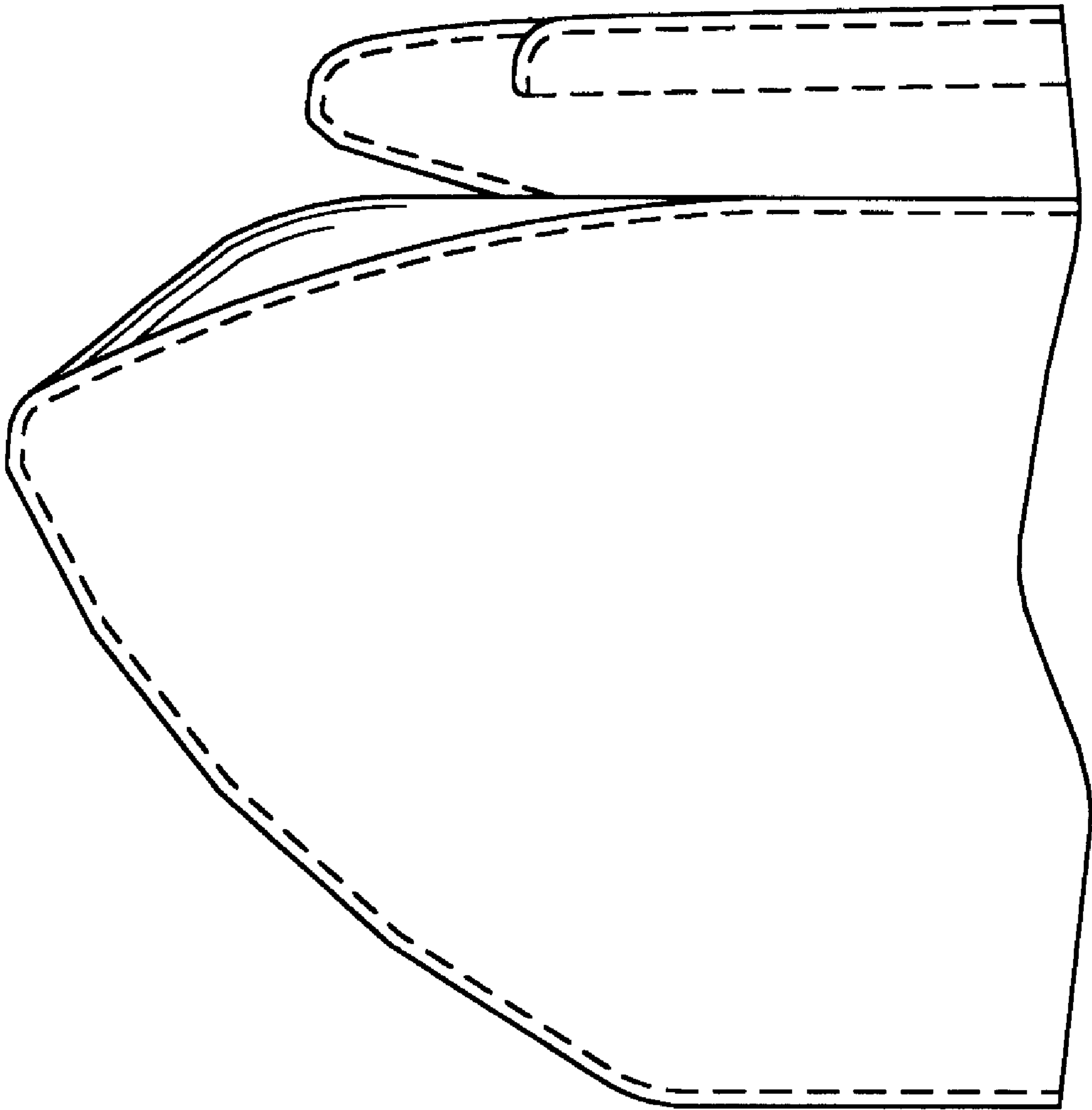
