FIG. 5 is a front view thereof.

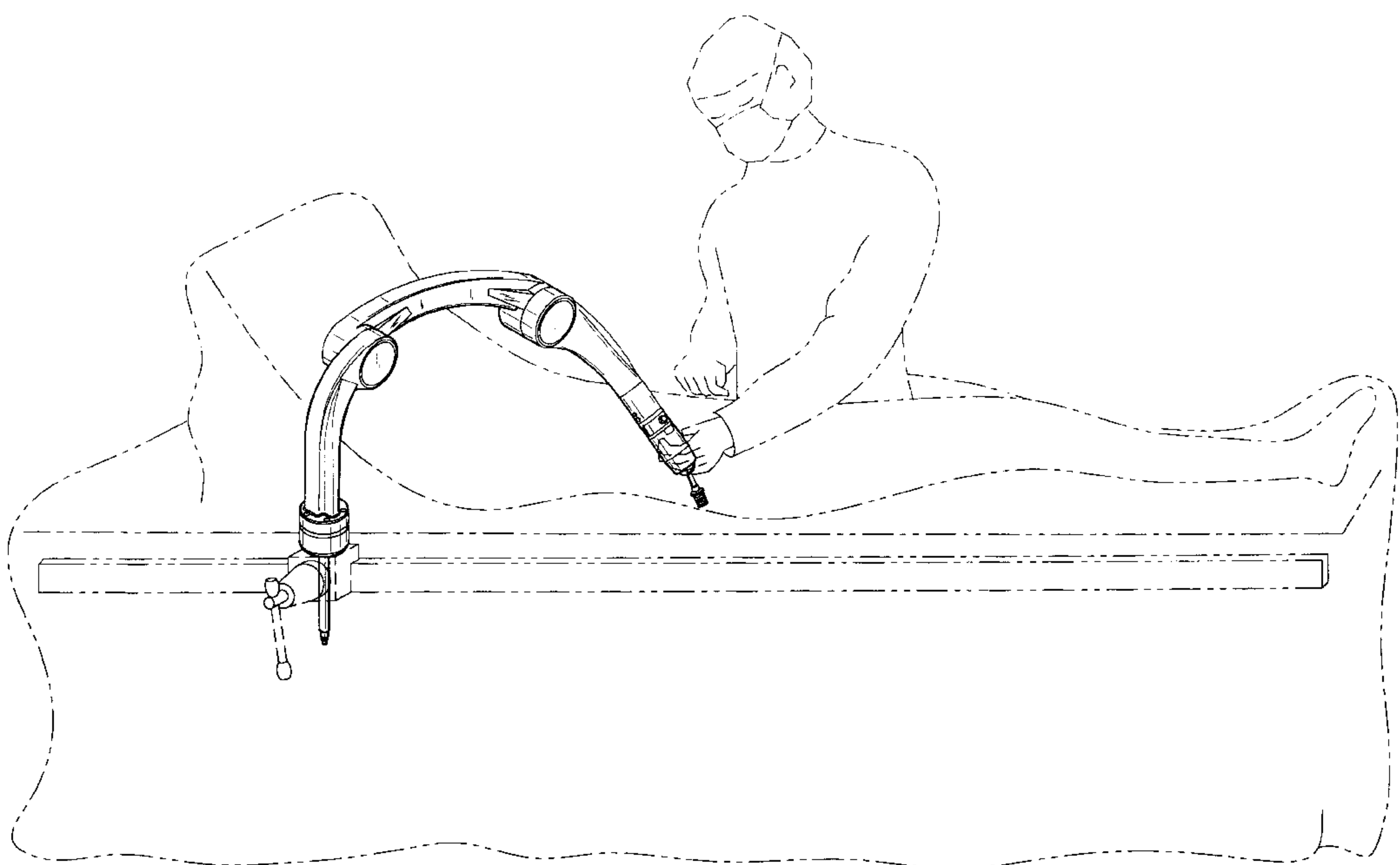
FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof.

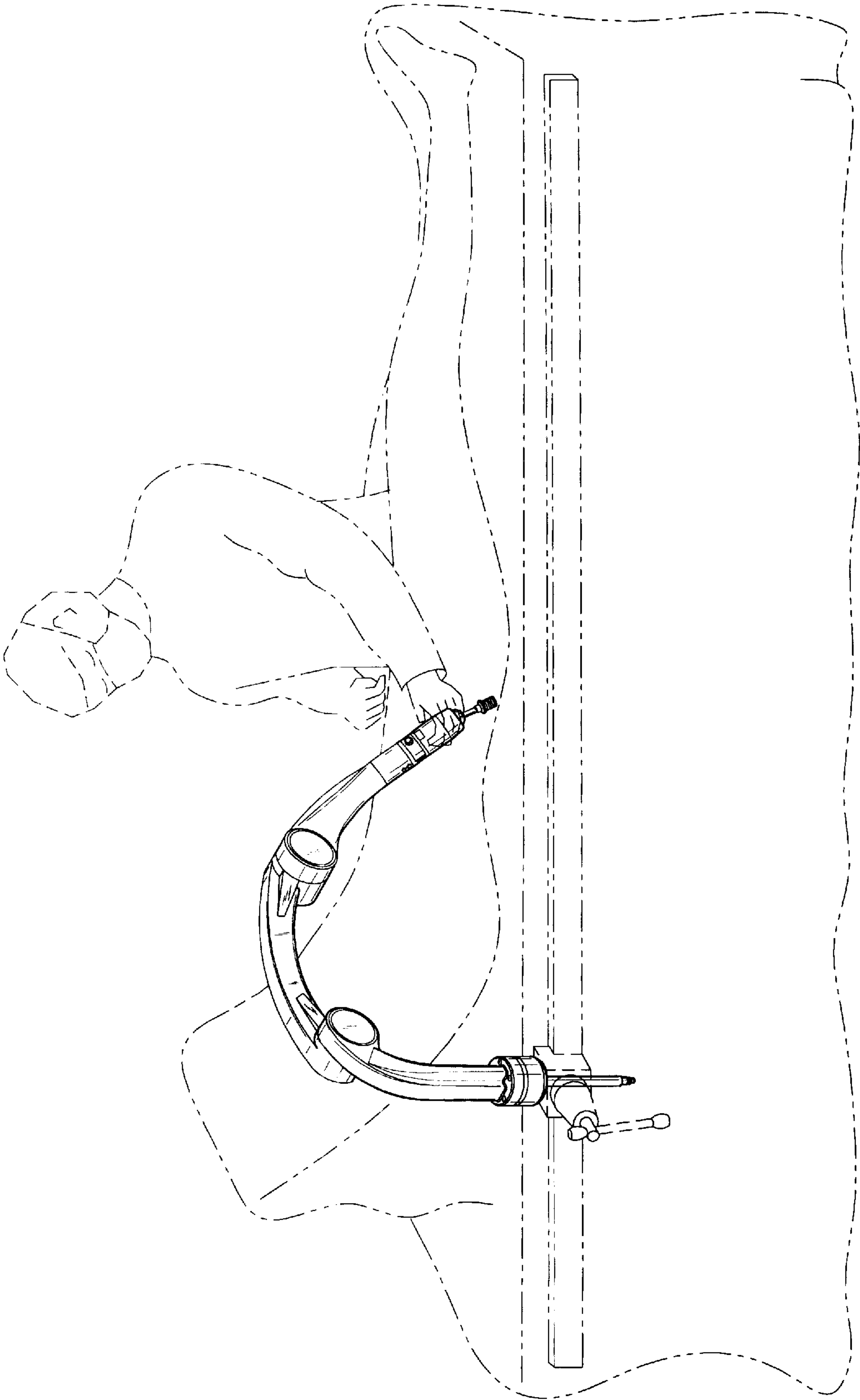
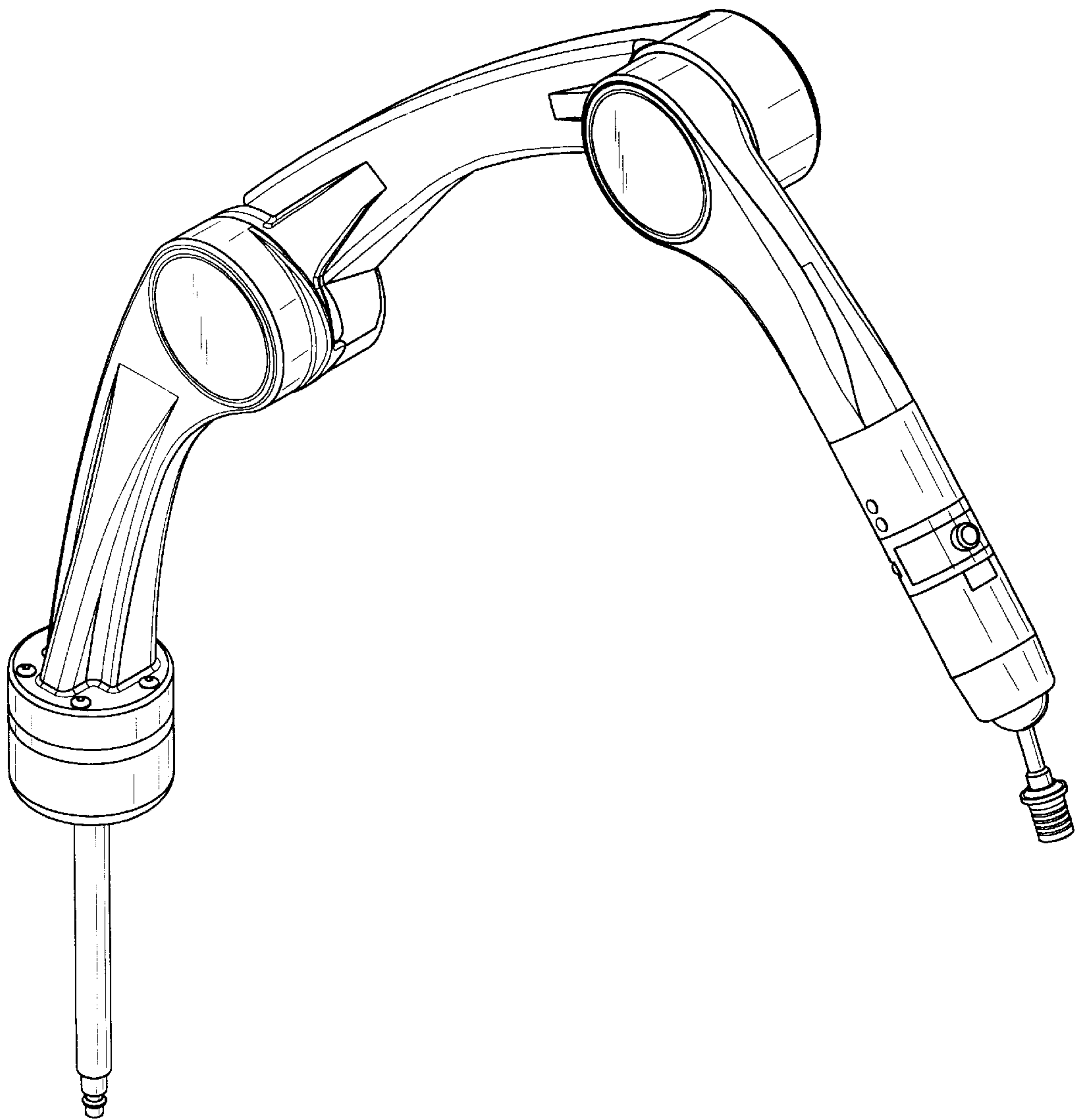

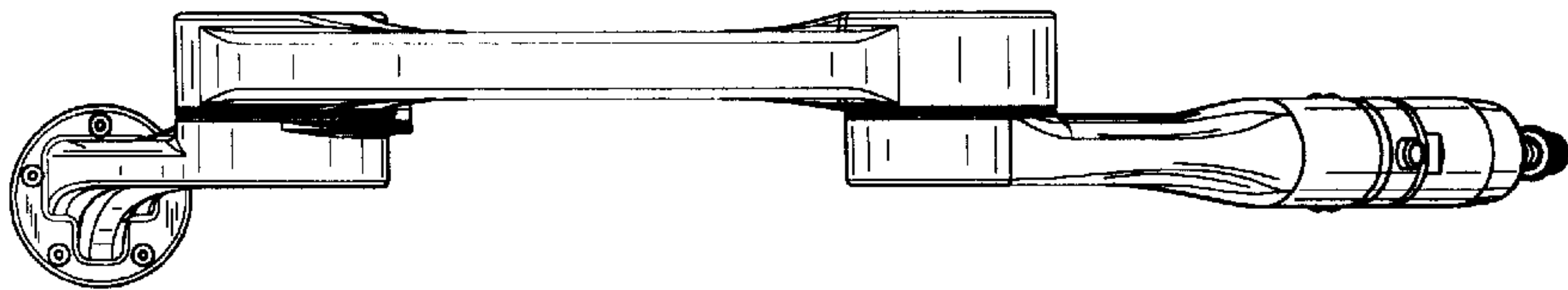

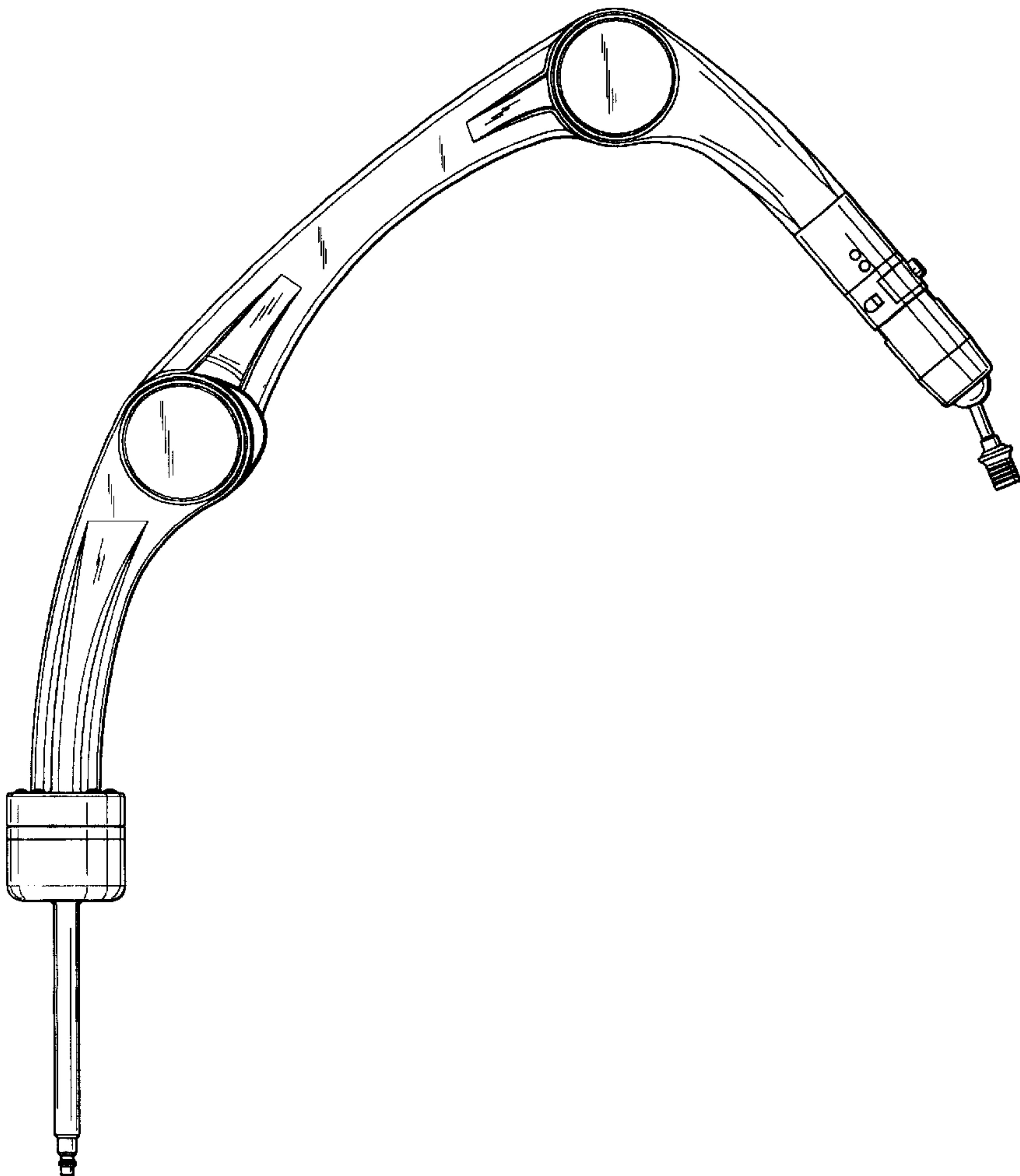

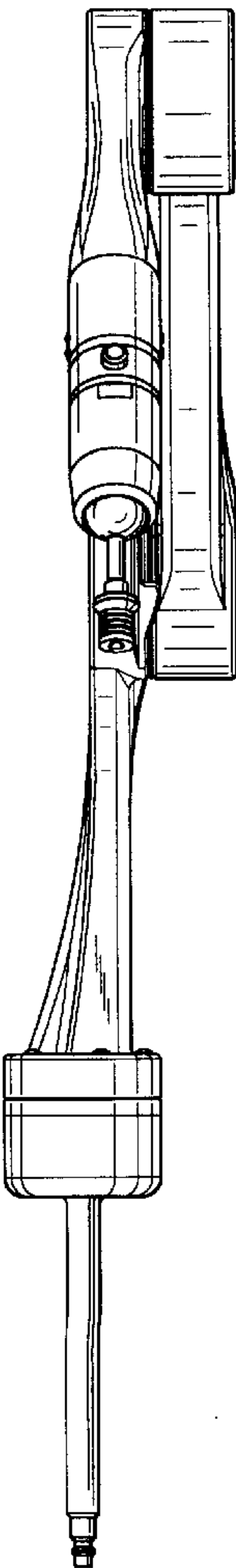

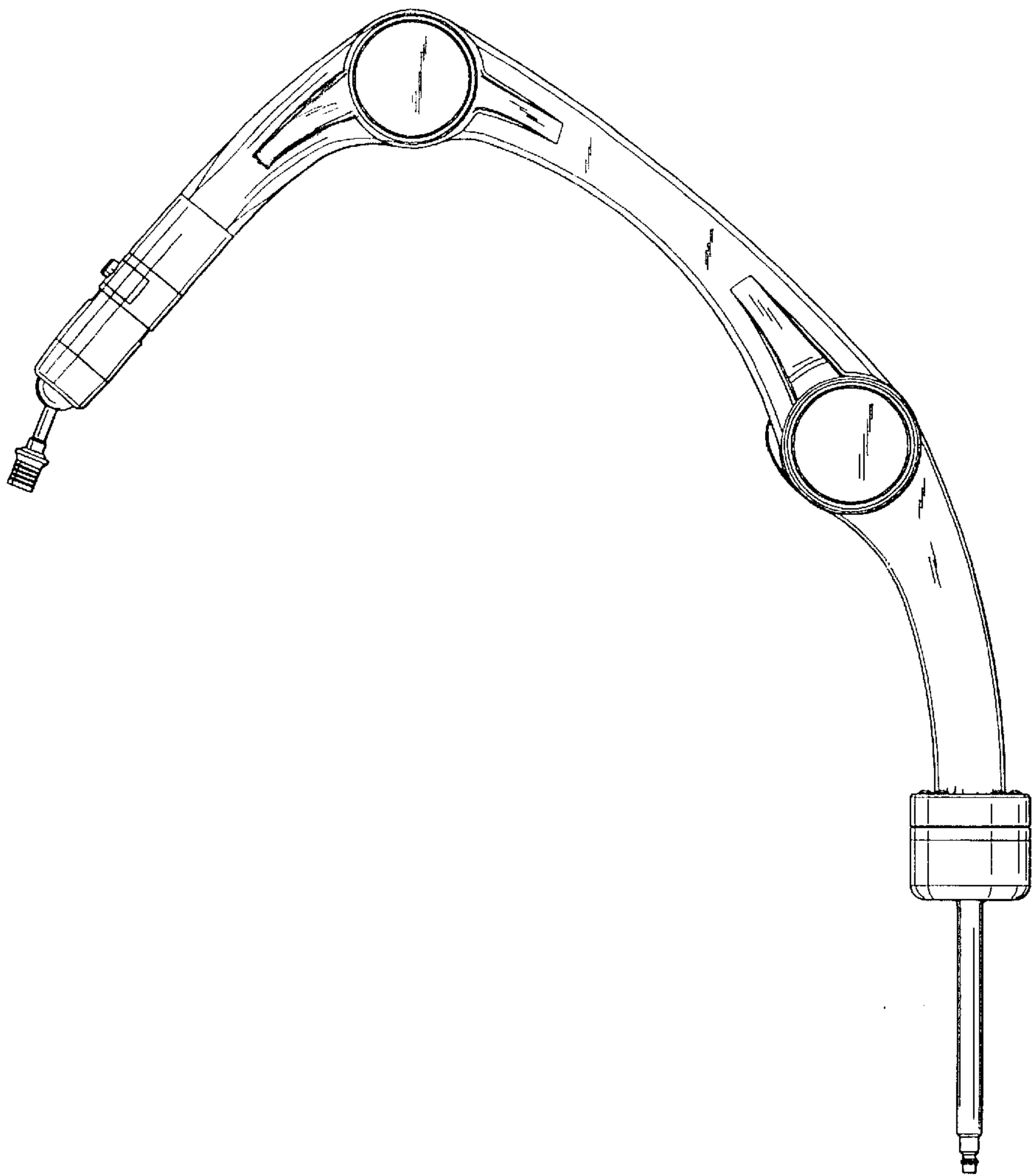

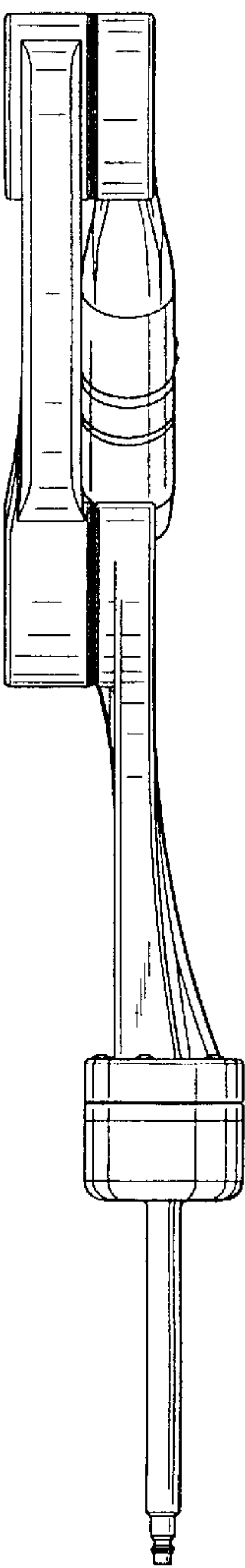

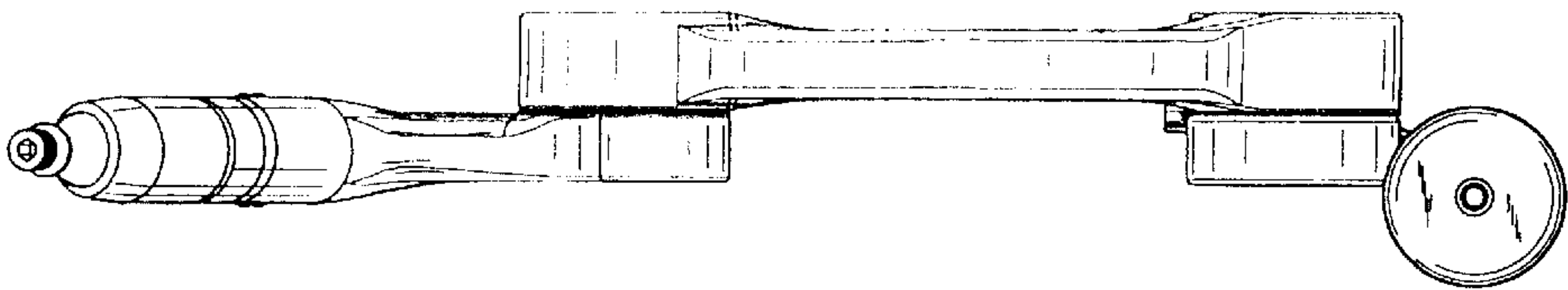

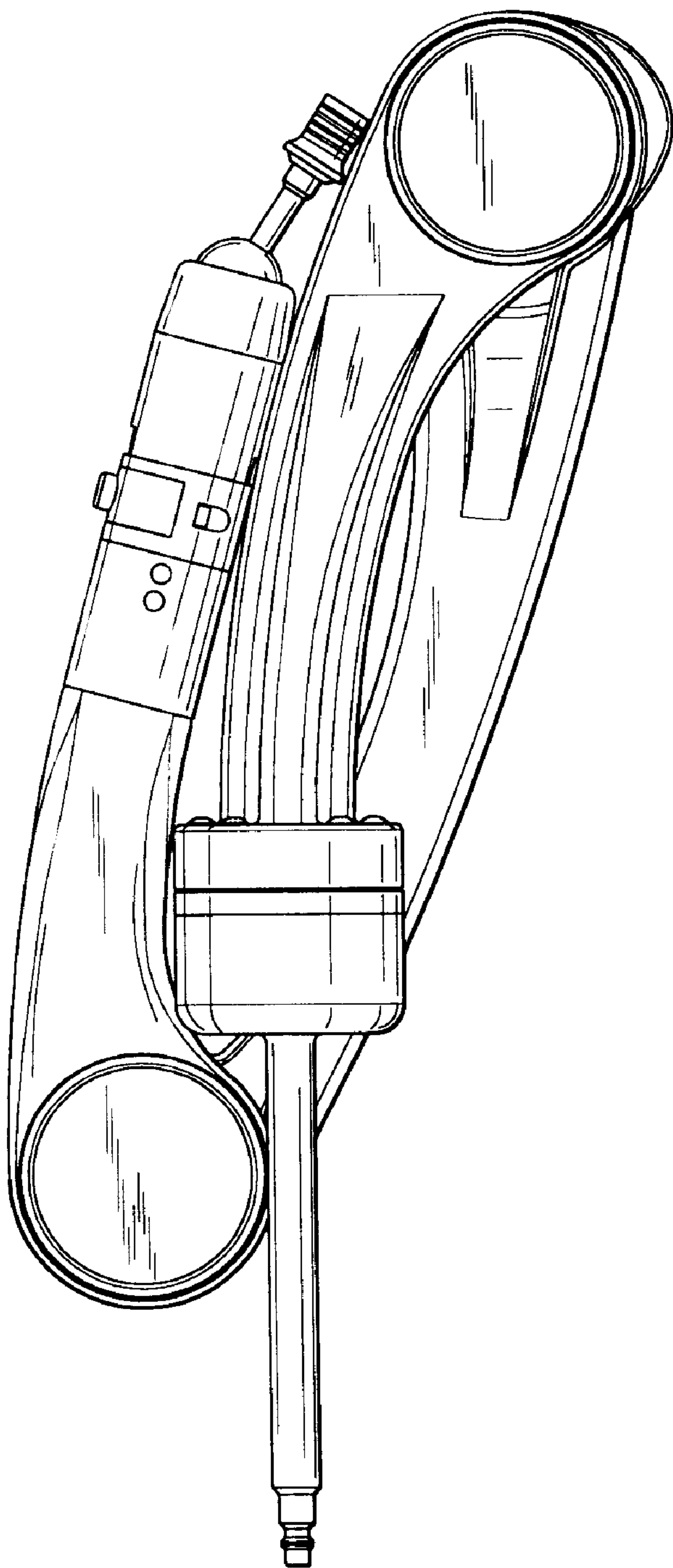
