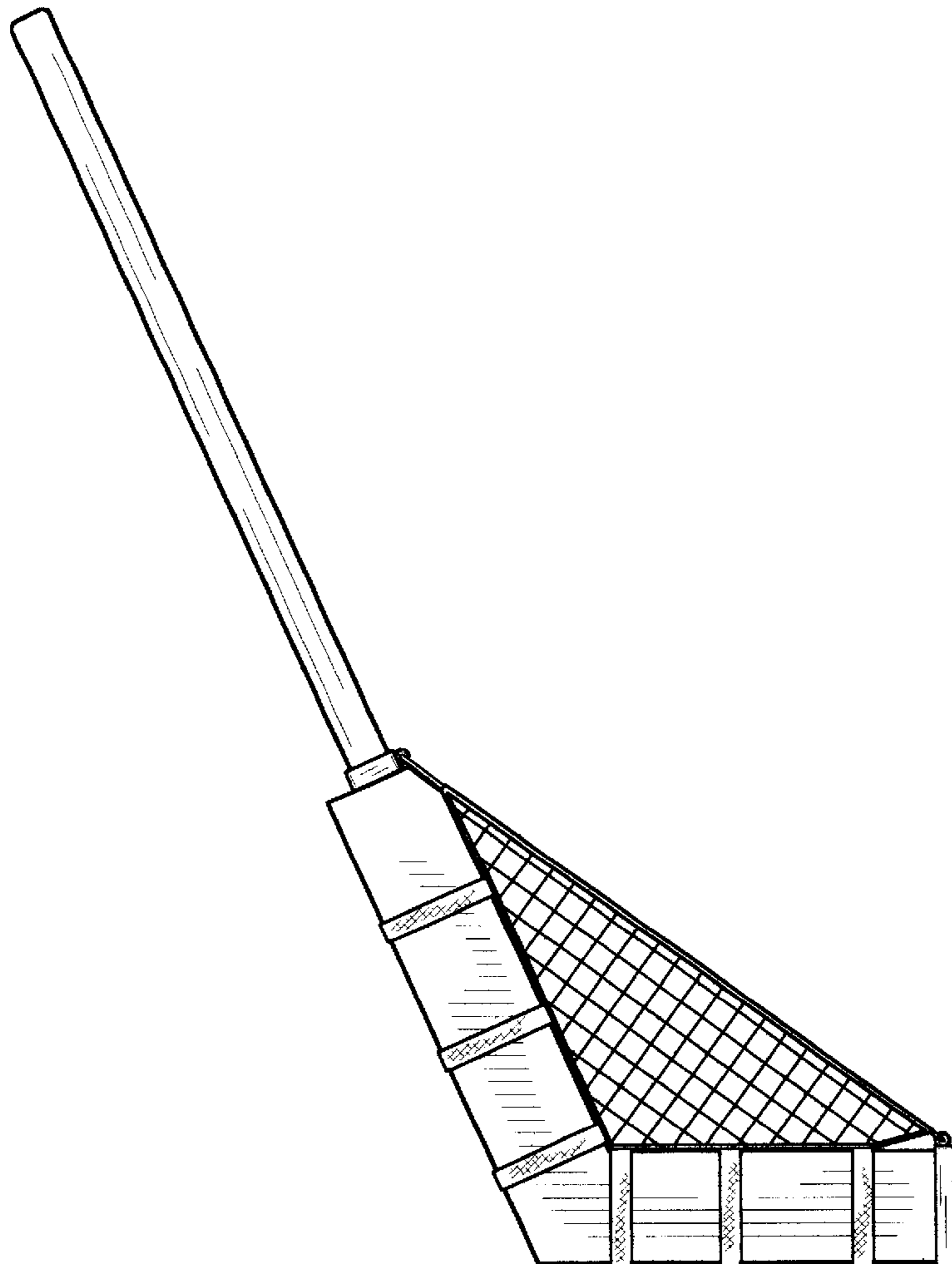
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the hockey goalie stick of FIG. 1;

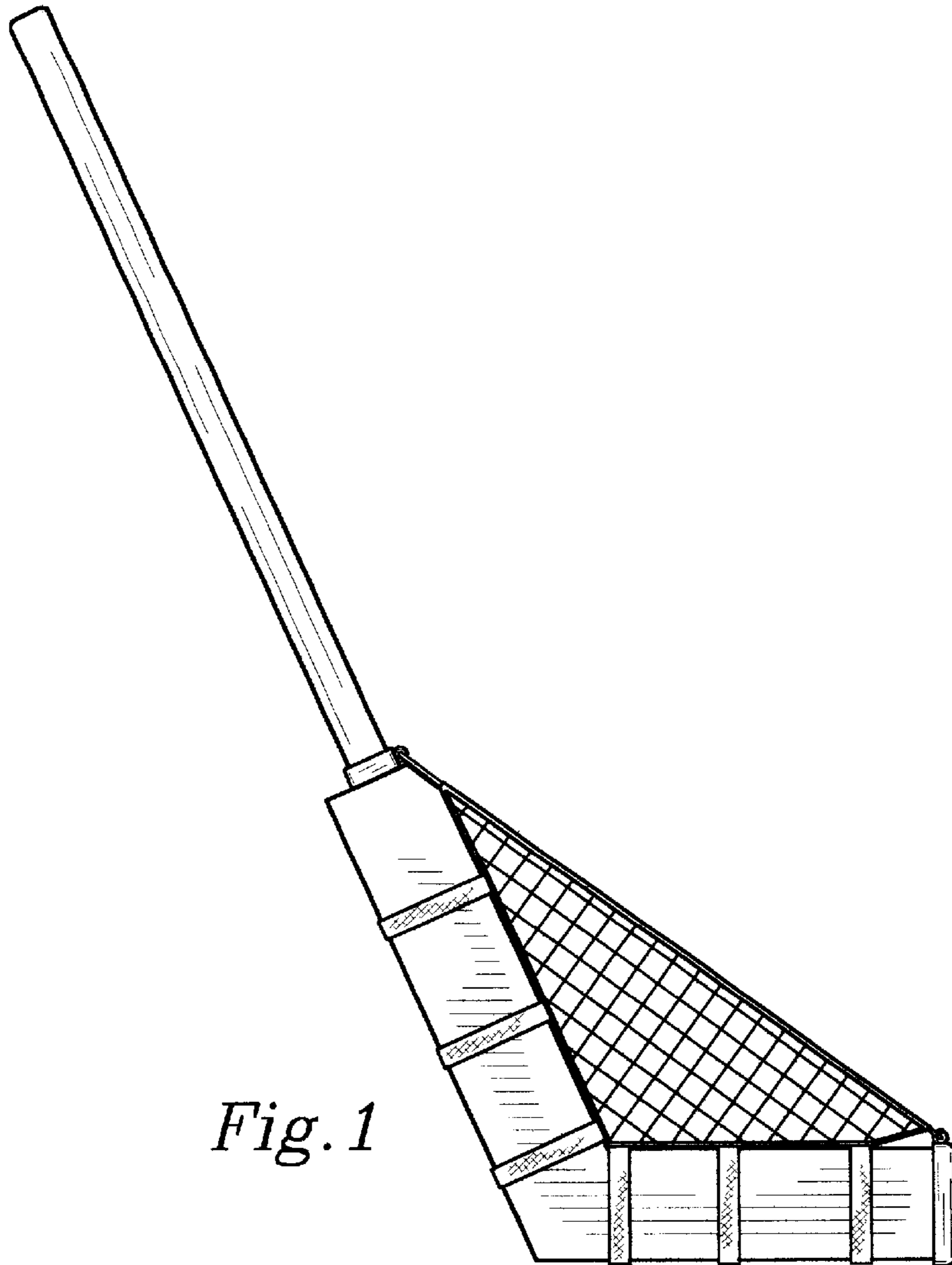

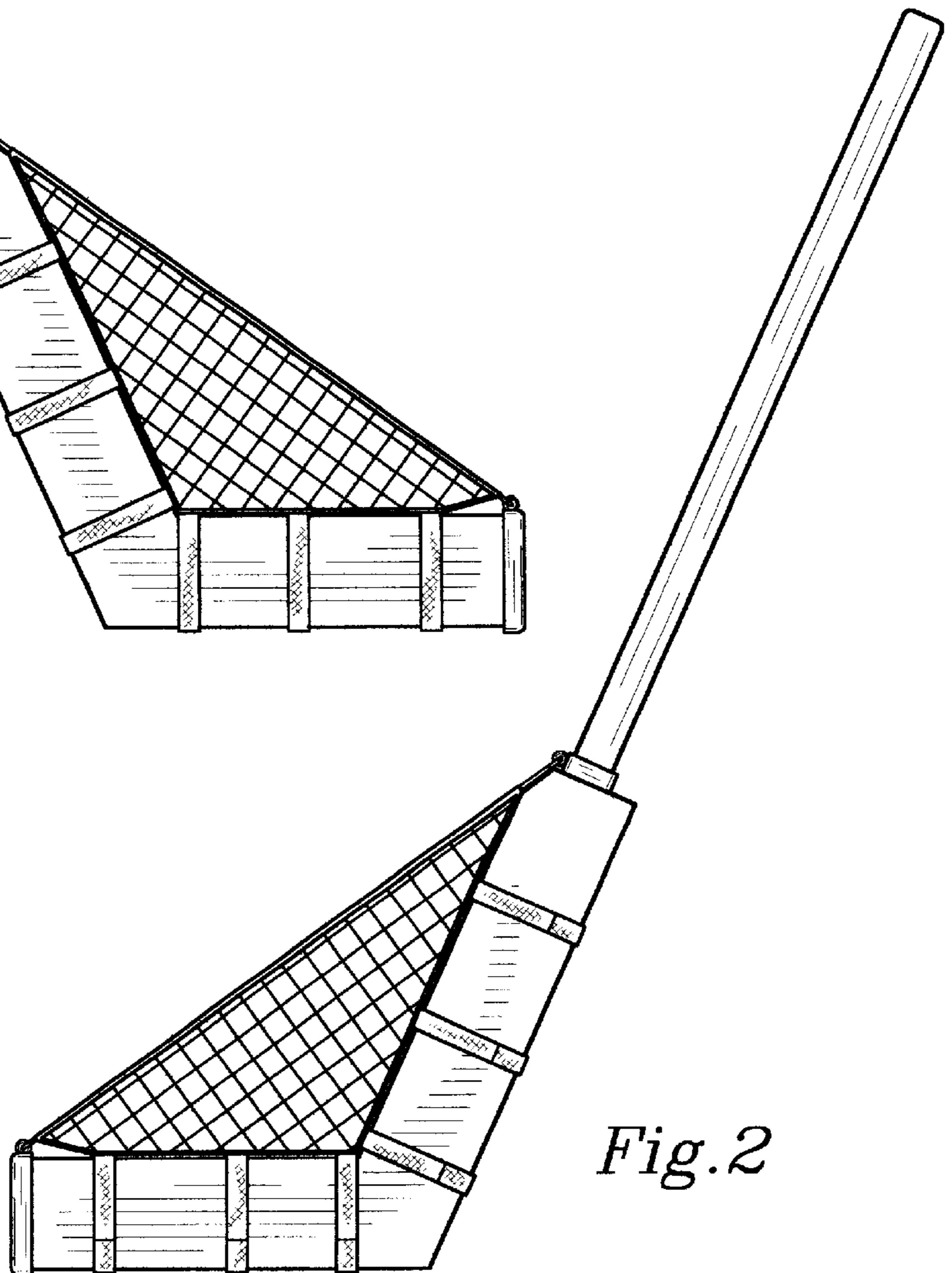
