FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the modular game piece of the present invention;

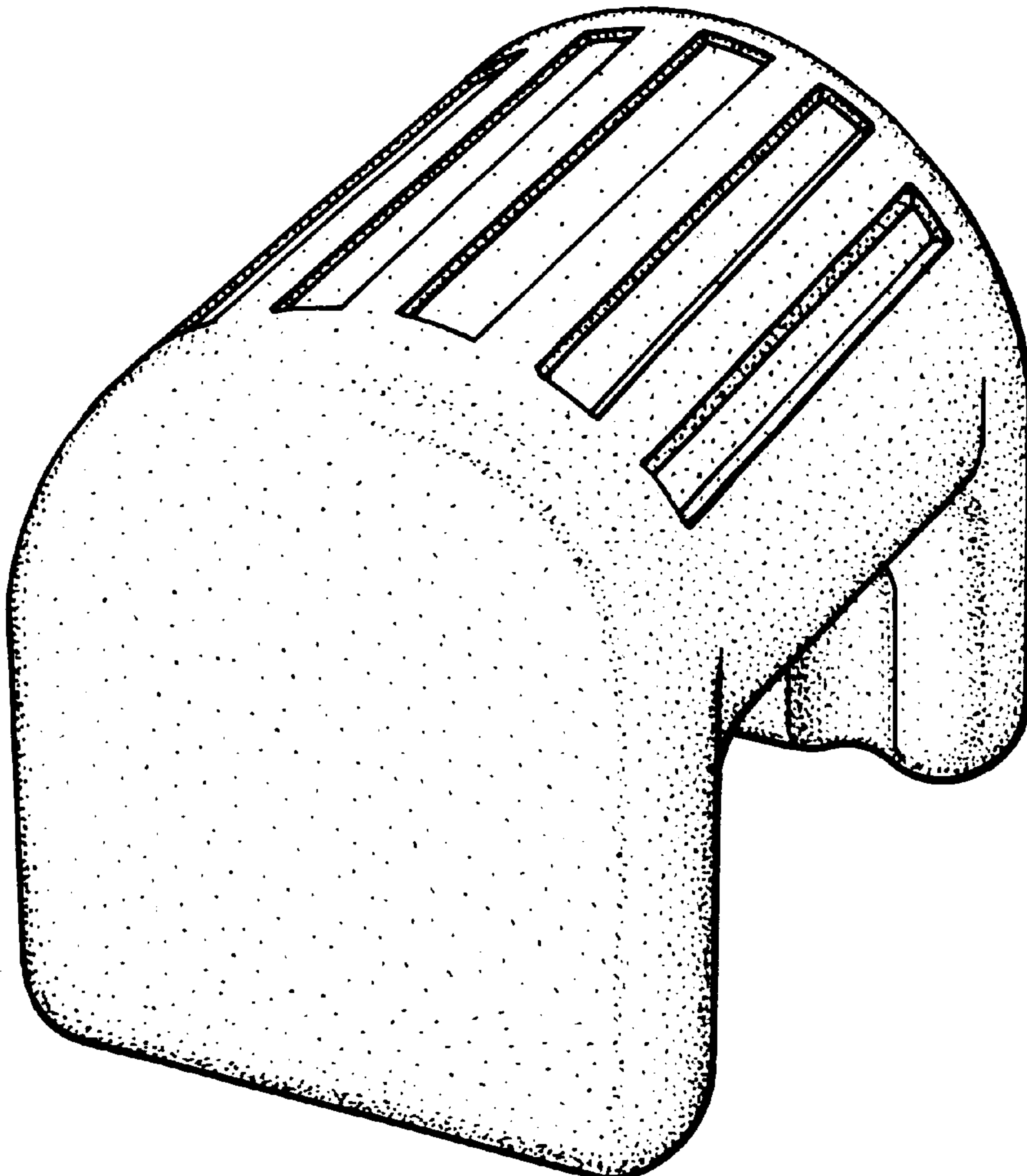
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the modular game piece;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side of the modular game piece, the other side being identical thereto;

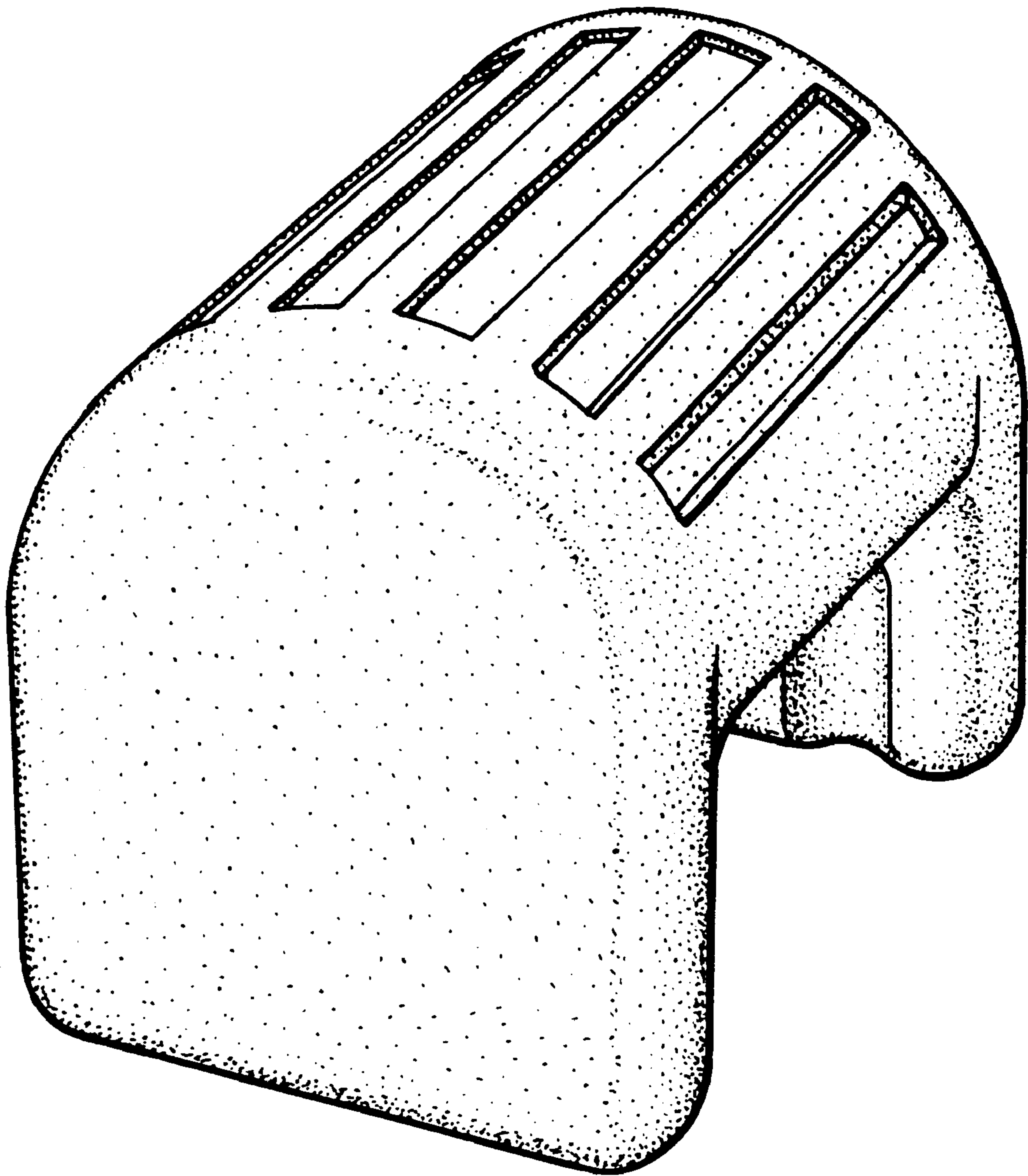
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of one end of the modular game piece, the other end being identical thereto; and,

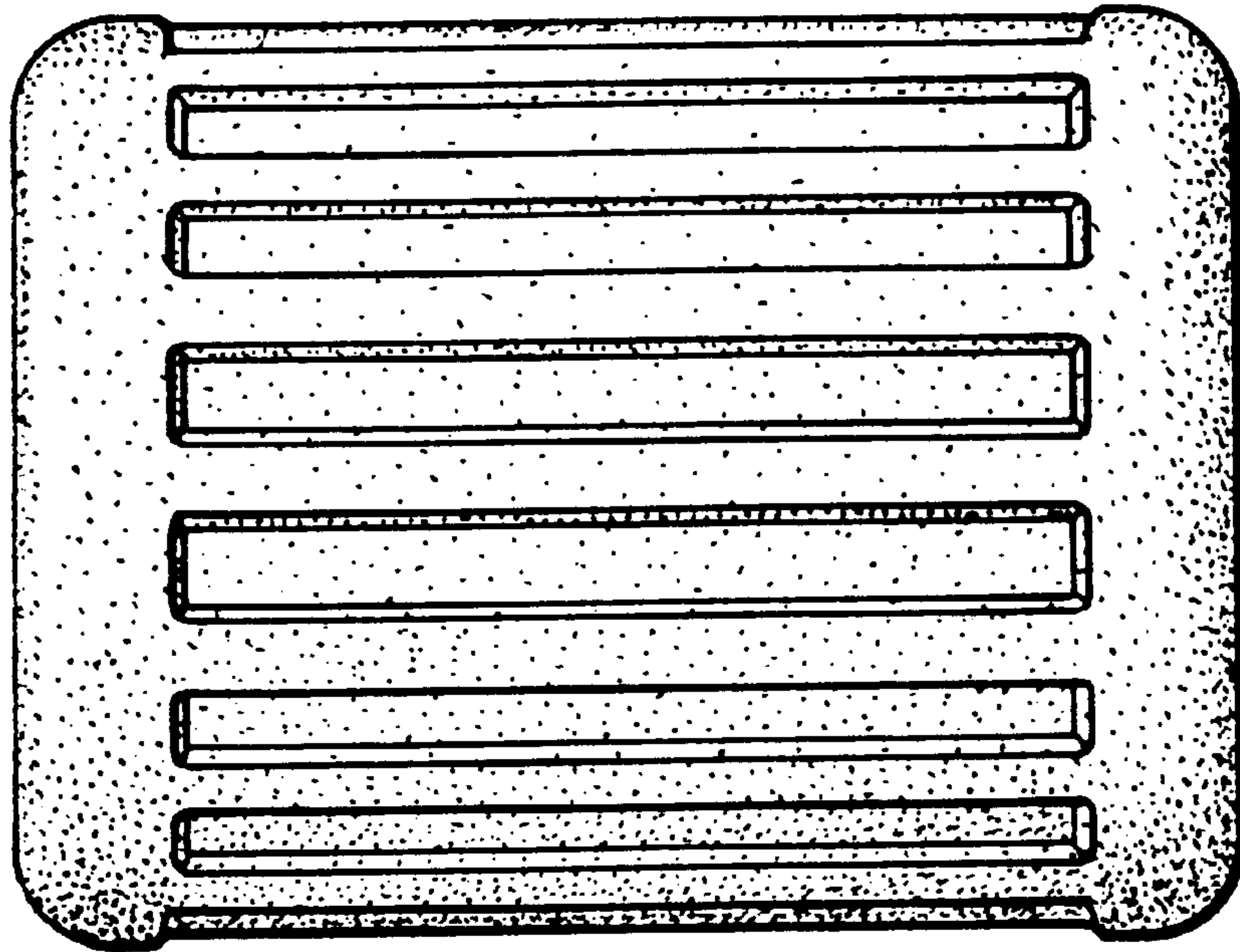
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the modular game piece.

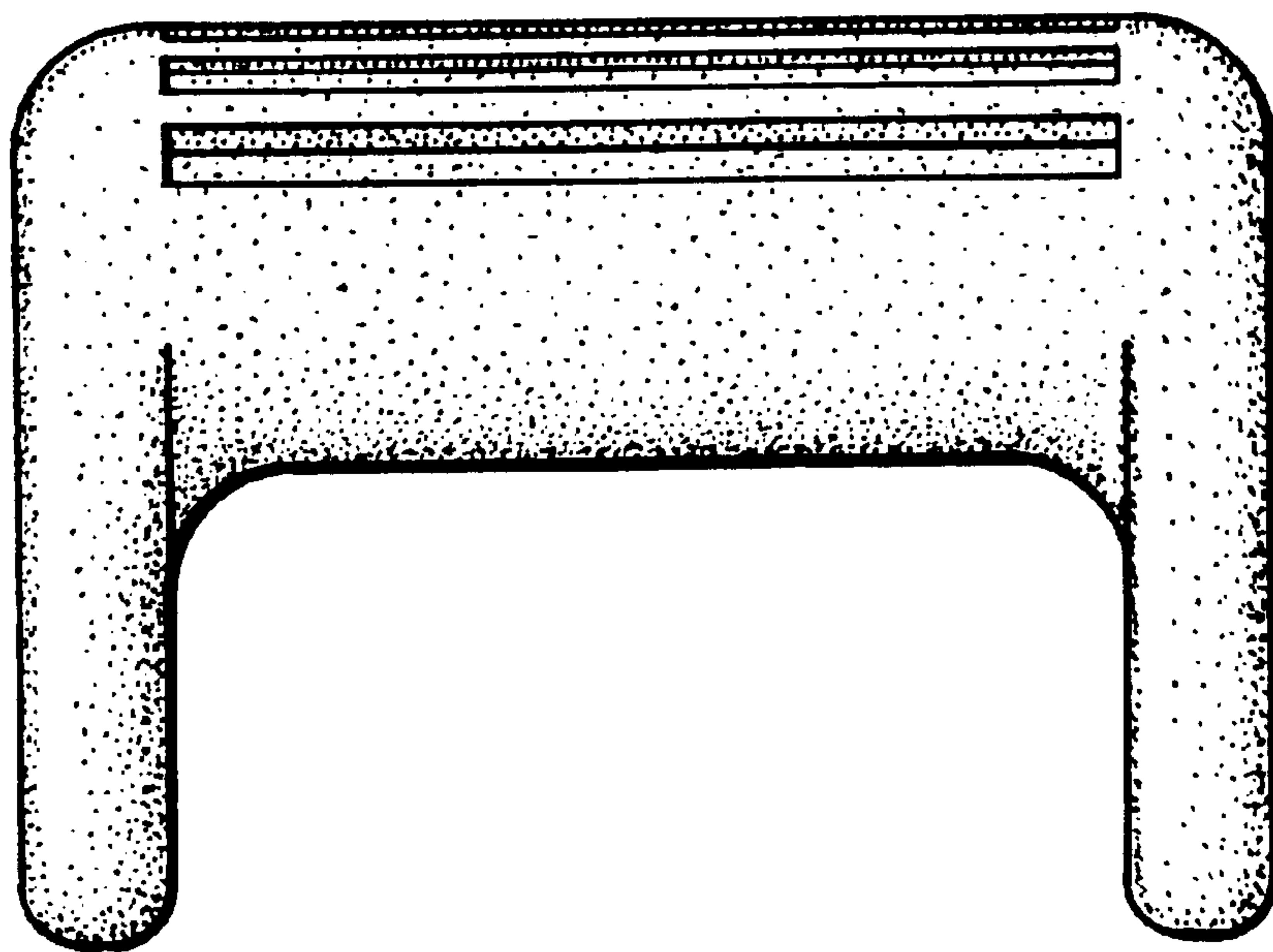

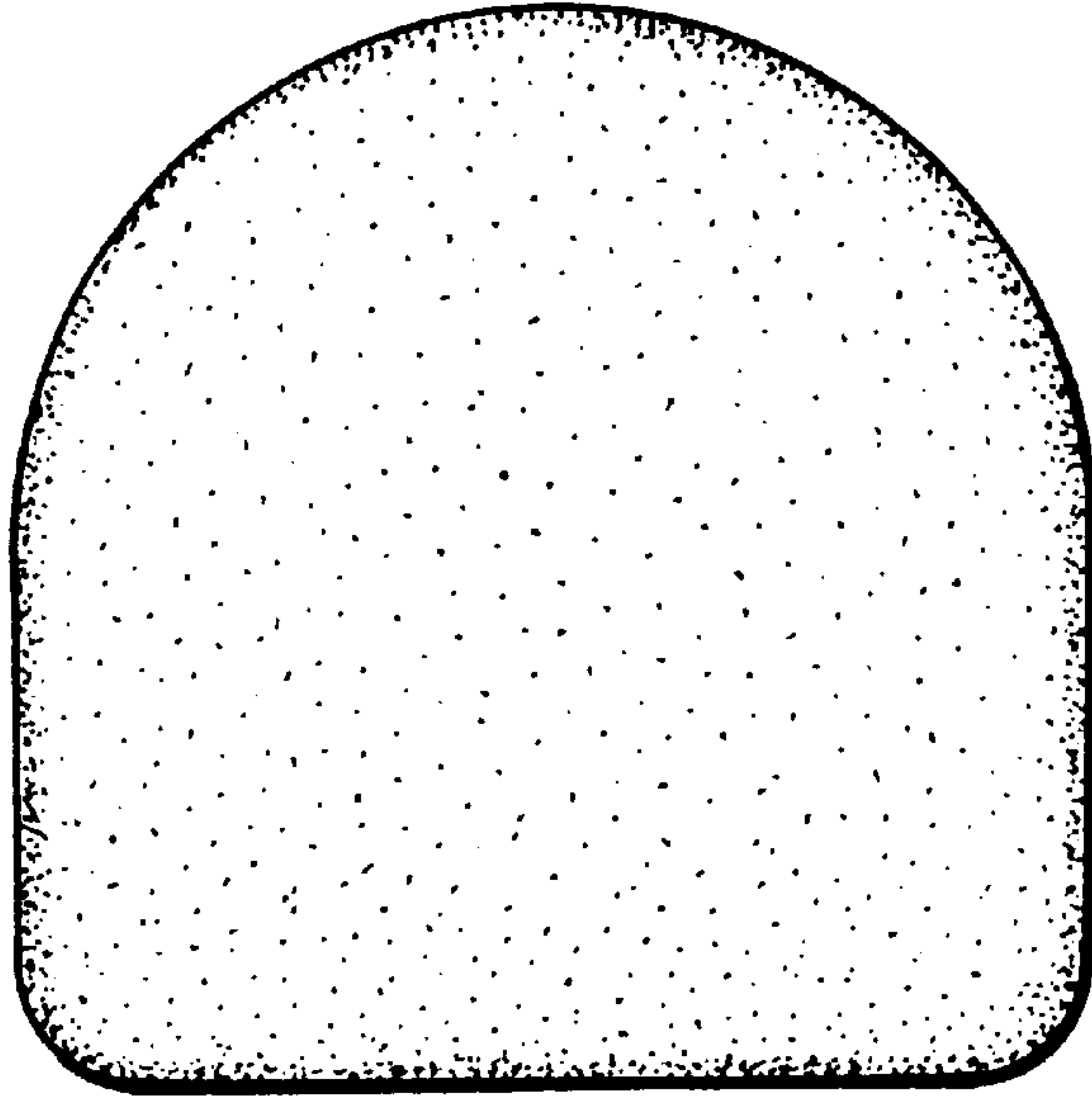
