FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the pet grooming vacuum attachment of FIG. 1.

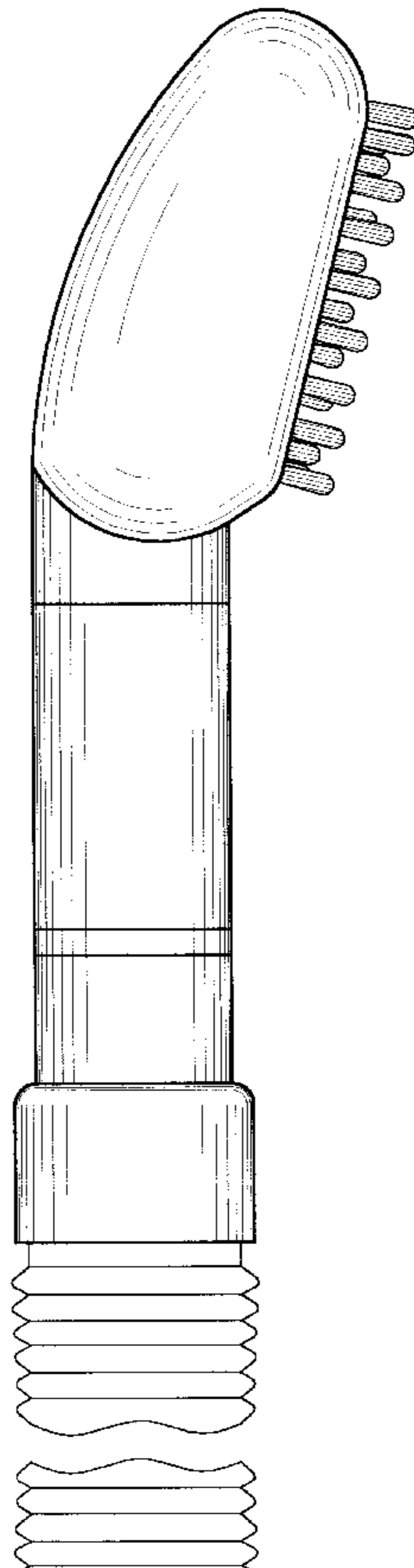

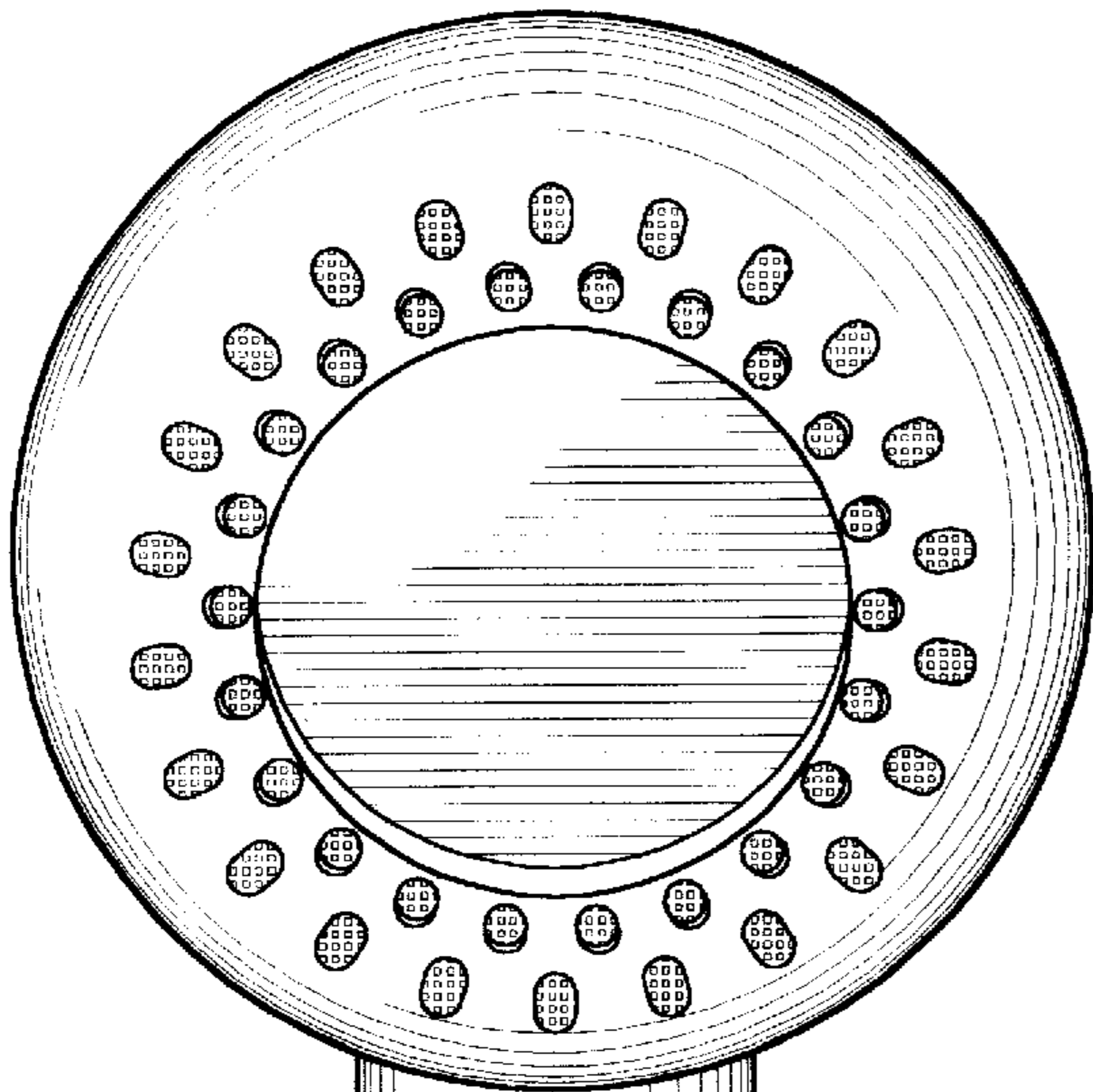

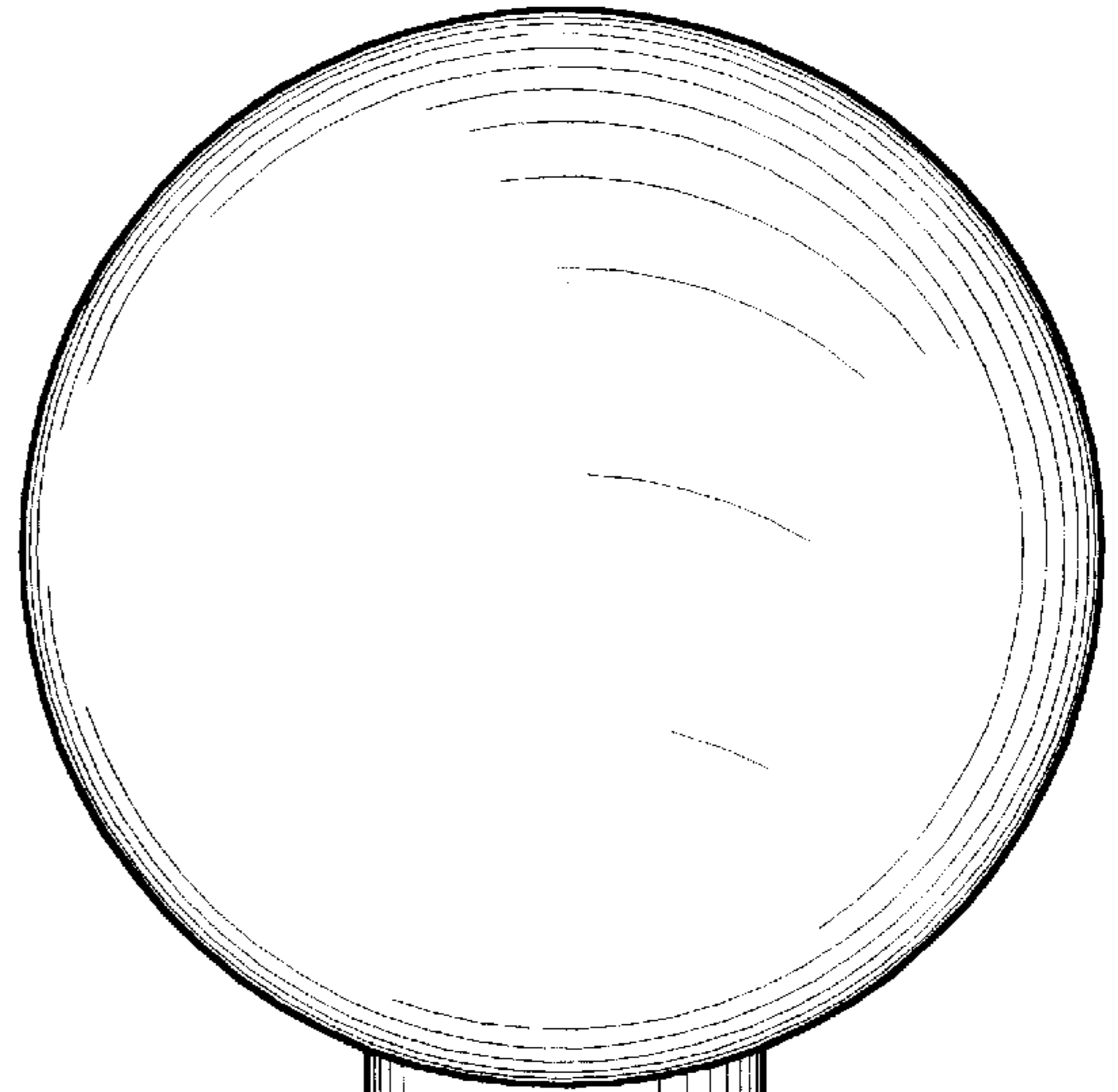
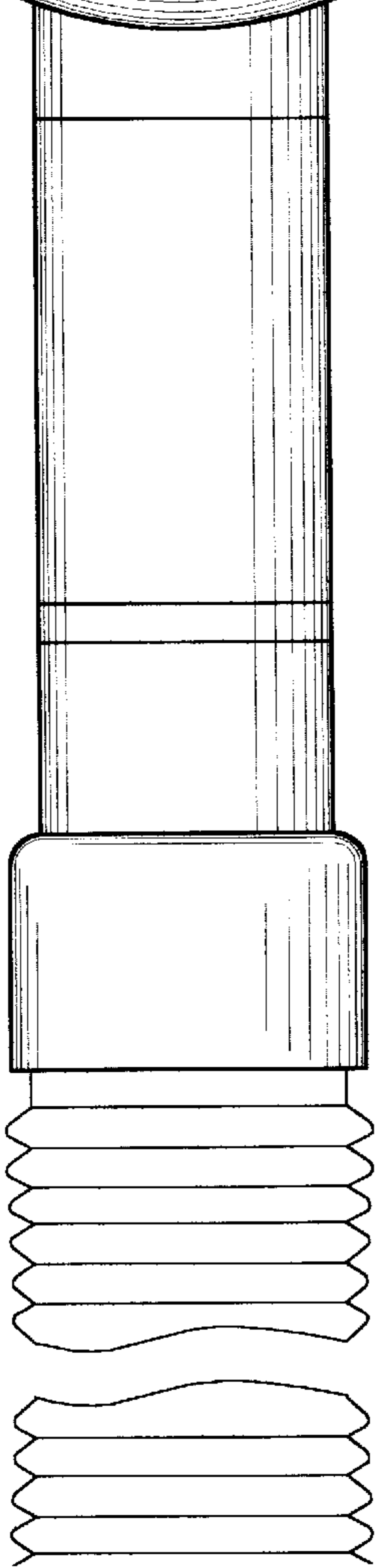

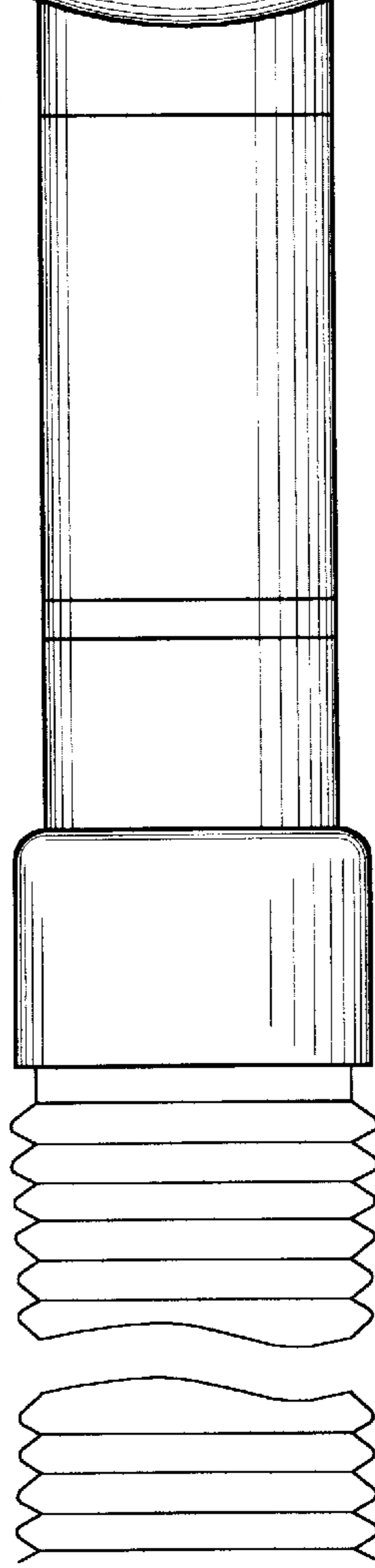

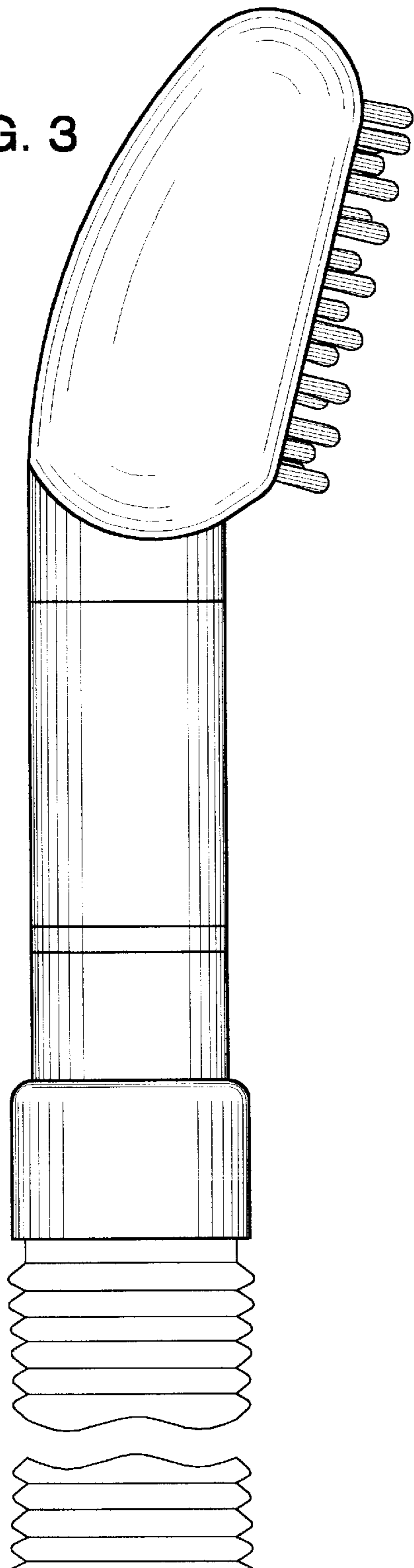

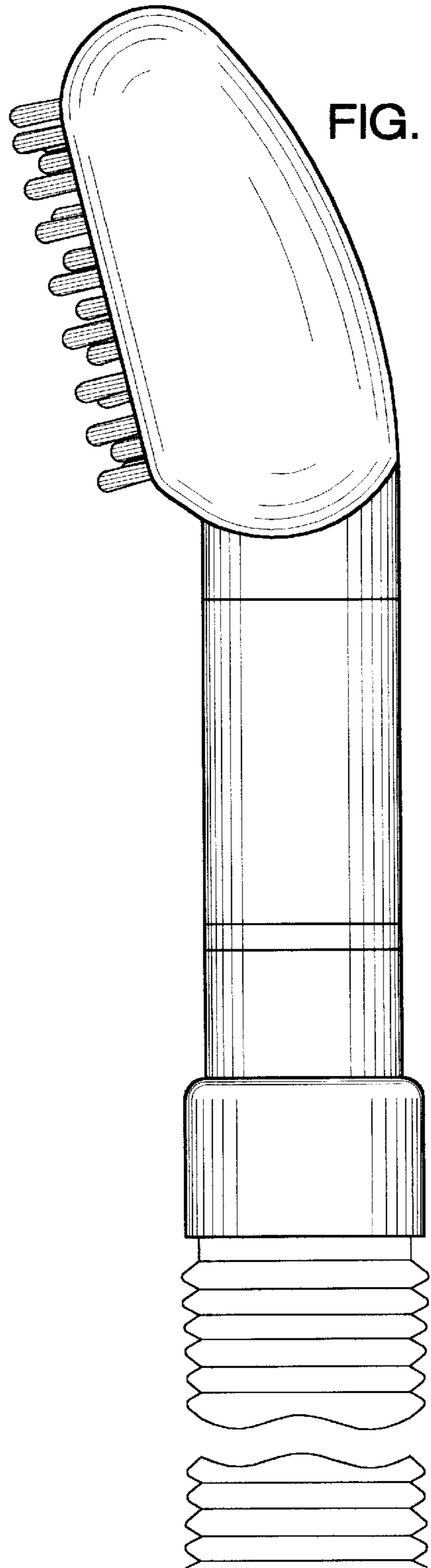

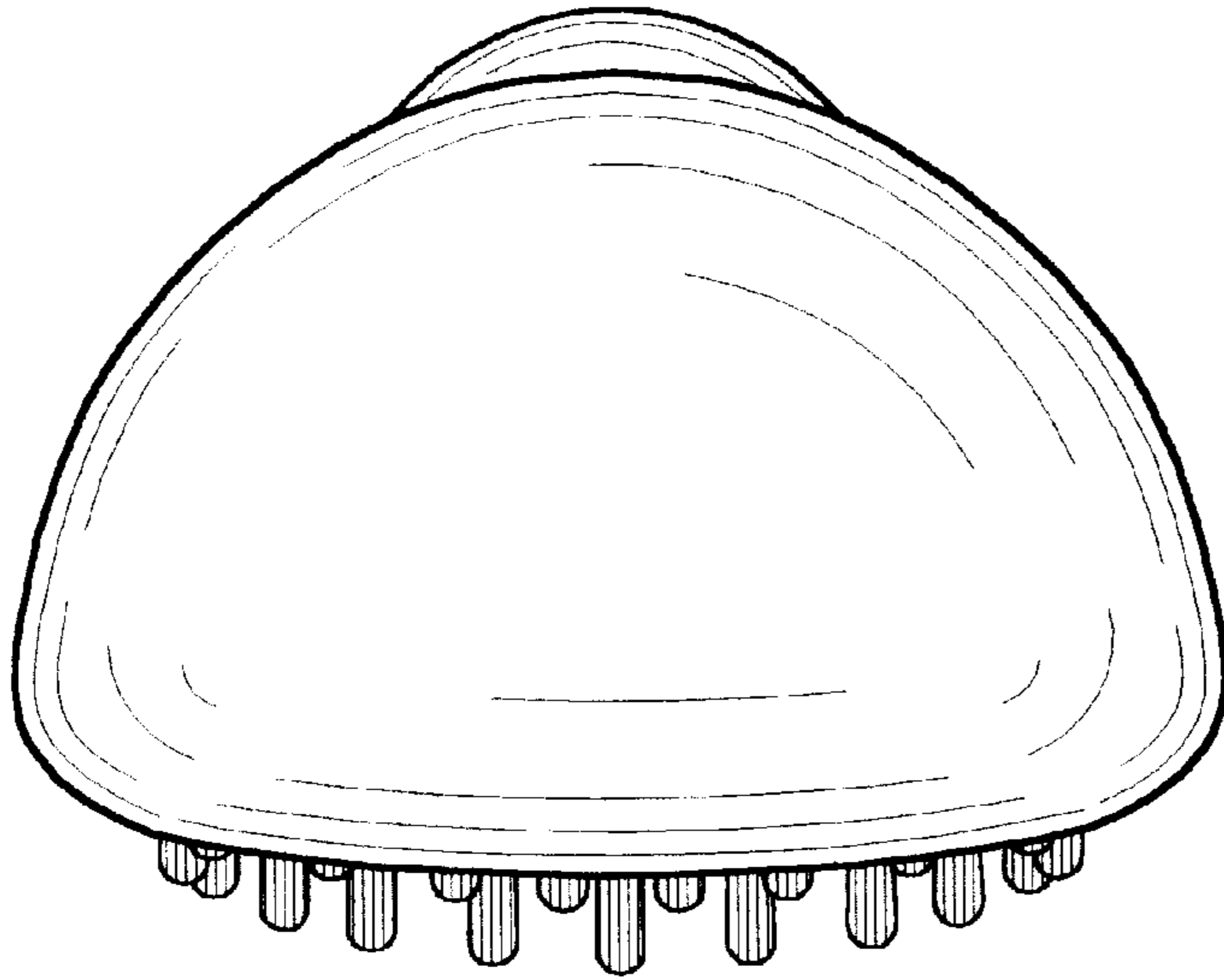
