(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a dispenser aperture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dispenser aperture showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front plan view of the dispenser aperture of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a side plan view of the dispenser aperture of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the dispenser aperture of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the dispenser aperture of FIG. 1.

In the drawings, the solid lines represent the boundaries of the claimed pattern as well as the boundaries of the portion of the dispenser to which the pattern is applied. The broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

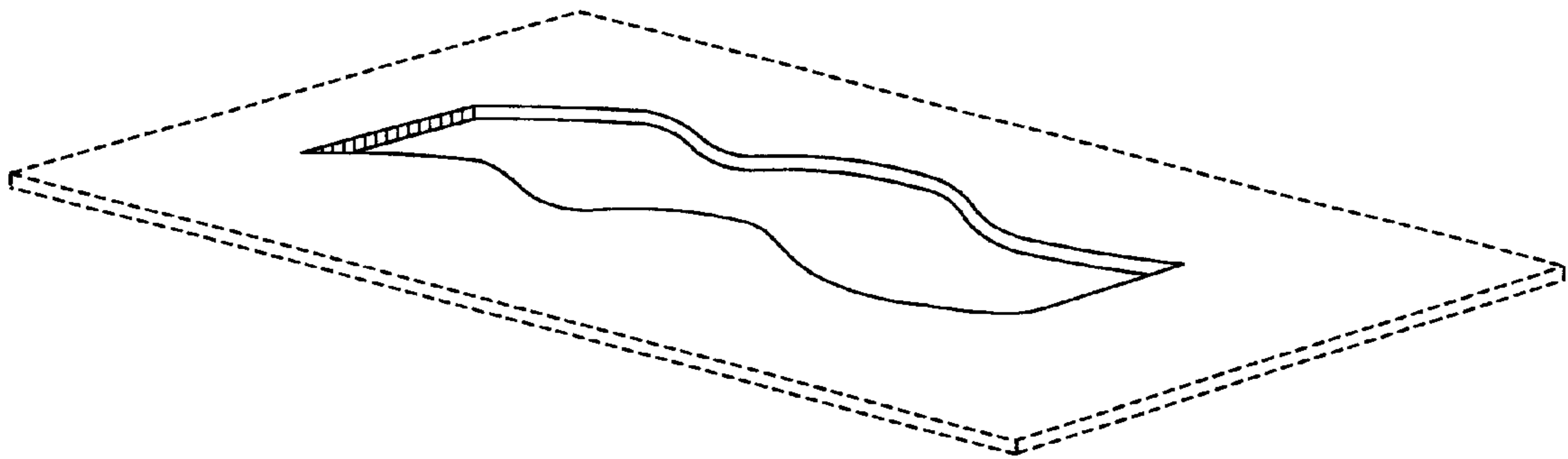

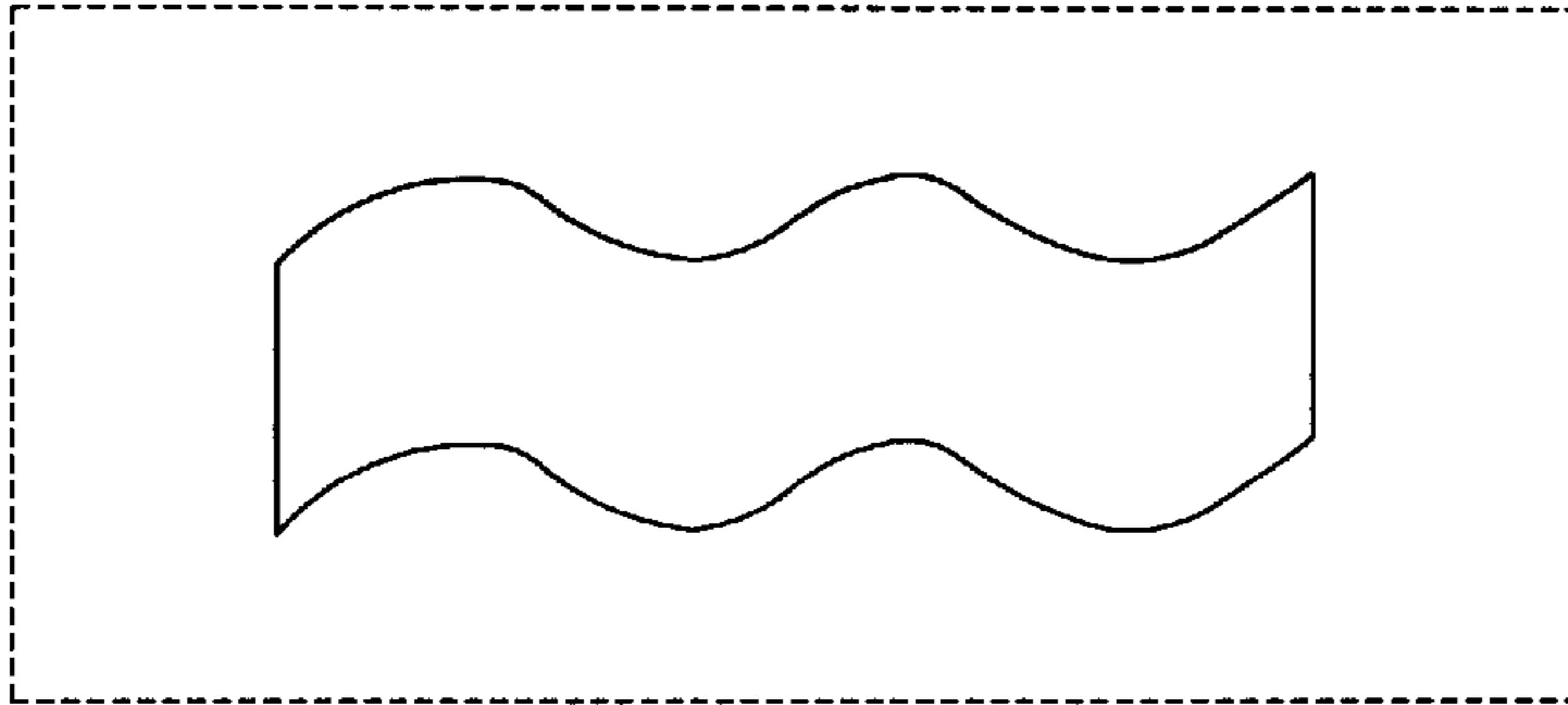

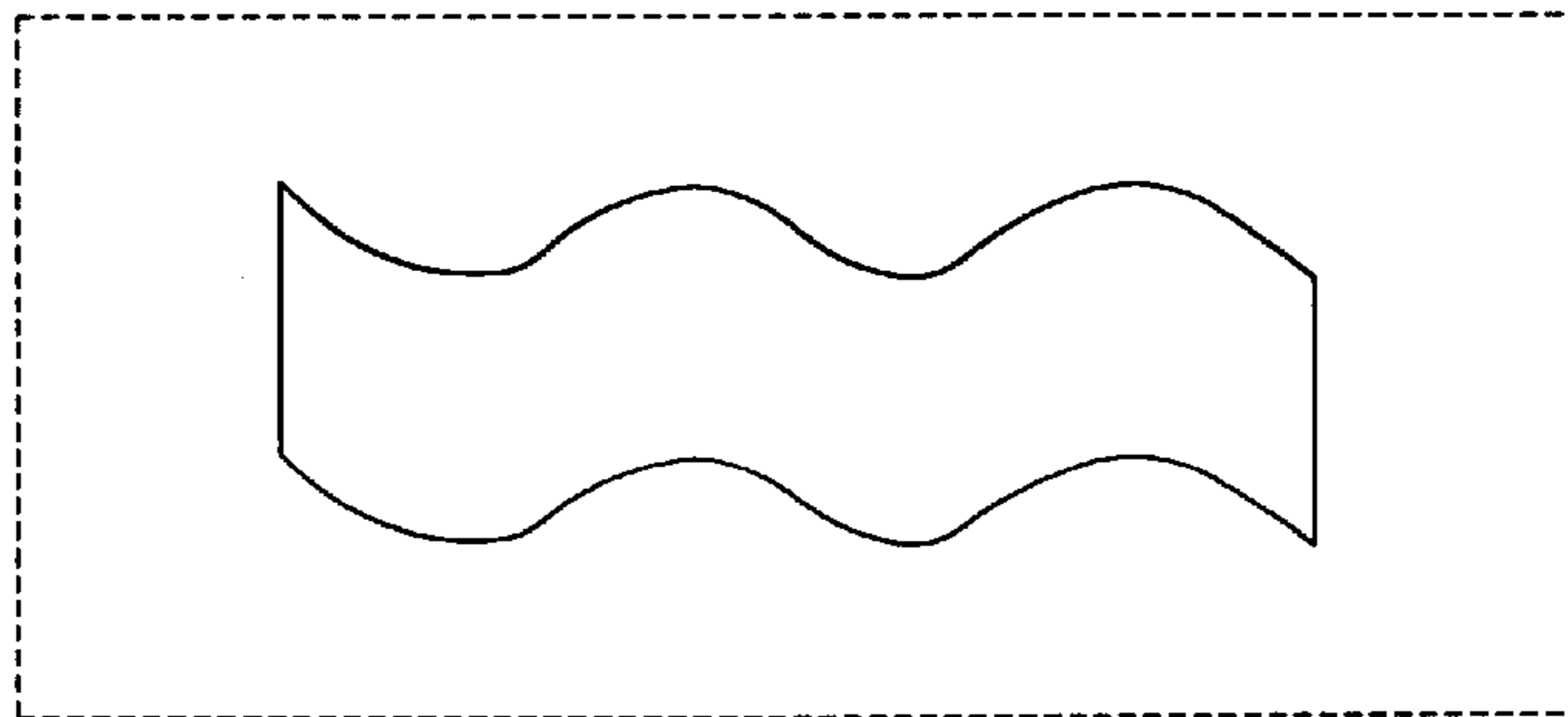
