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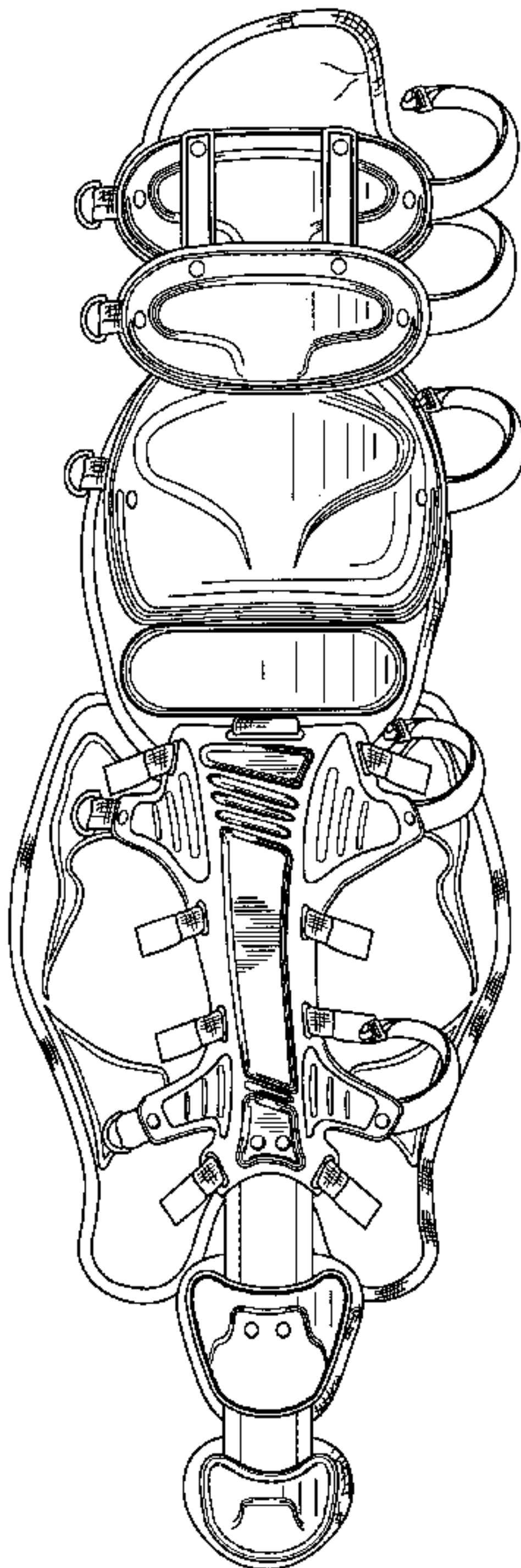
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a catcher’s leg guard, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view of one side of the catcher’s leg guard shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the other side of the catcher’s leg guard shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 4 is an exploded perspective view of the obverse, inwardly-facing side of the catcher’s leg guard shown in FIG. 1.

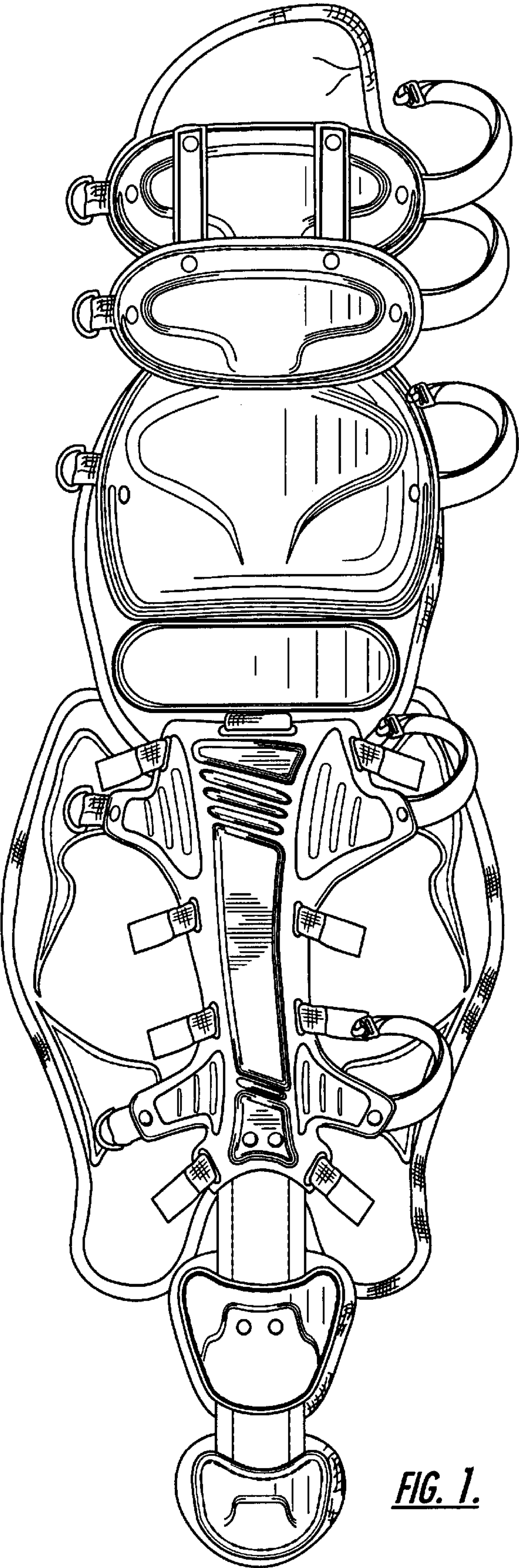

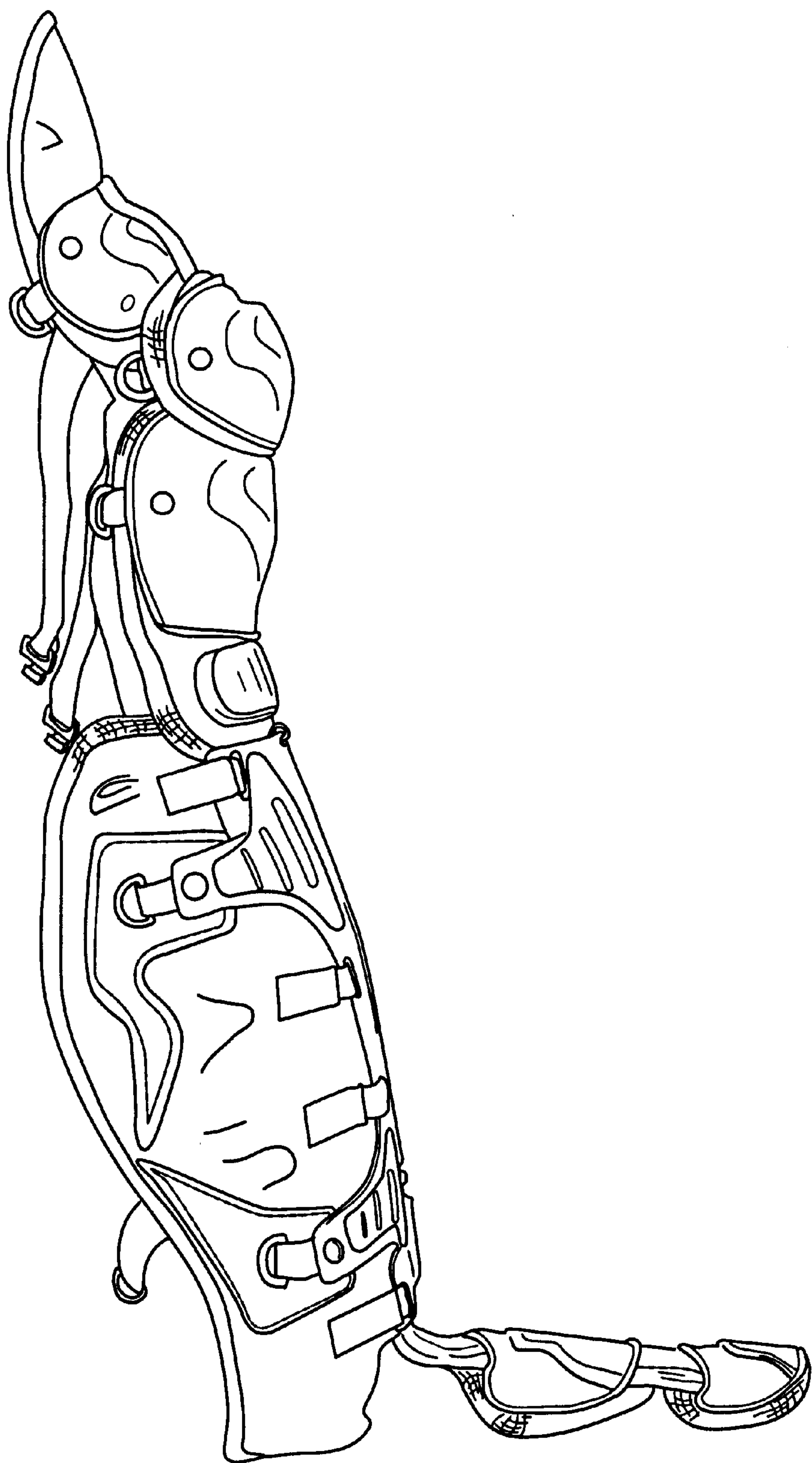

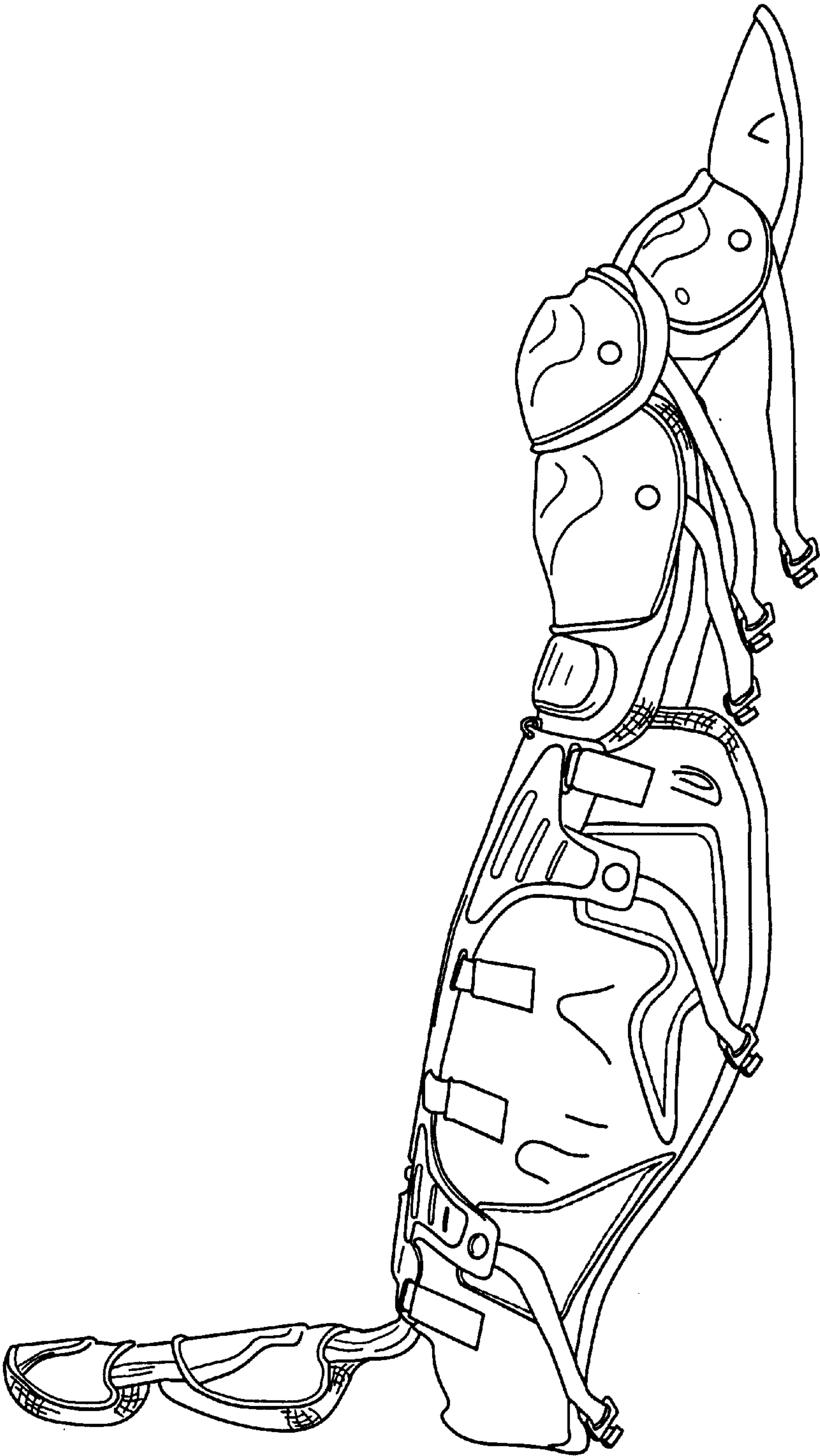

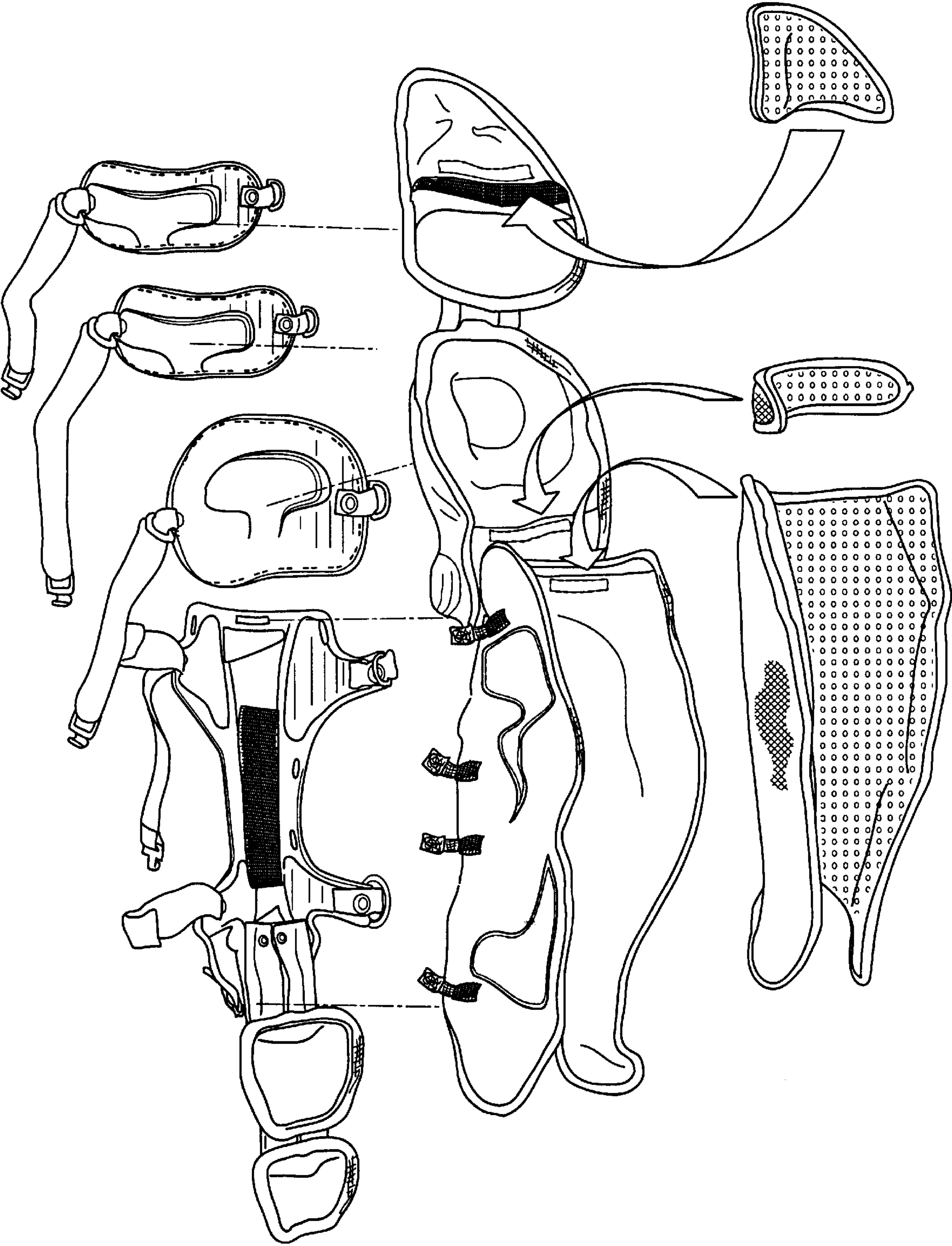
