FIG. 2 is a front view of the three leaf glass shade in accordance with the present invention;

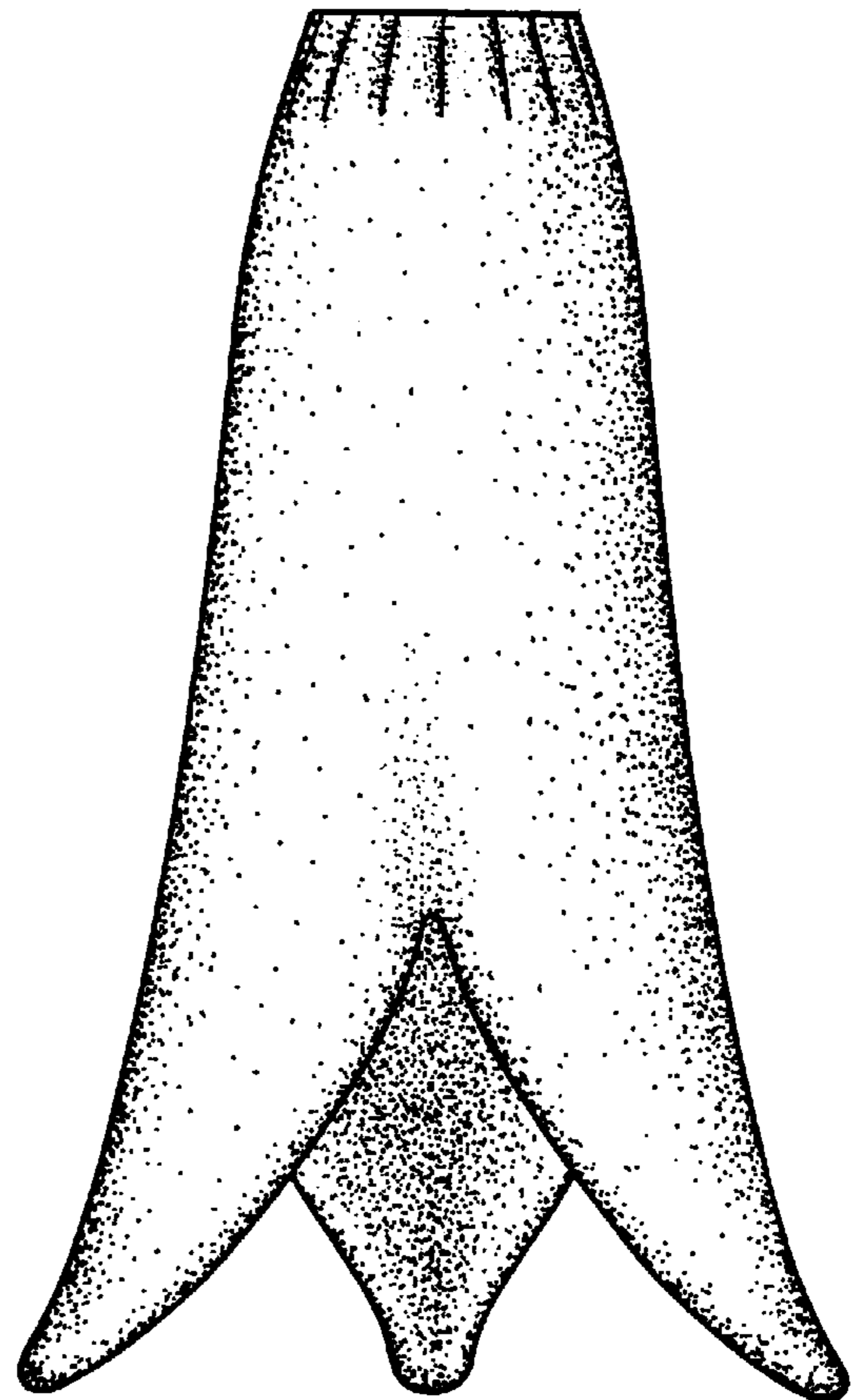
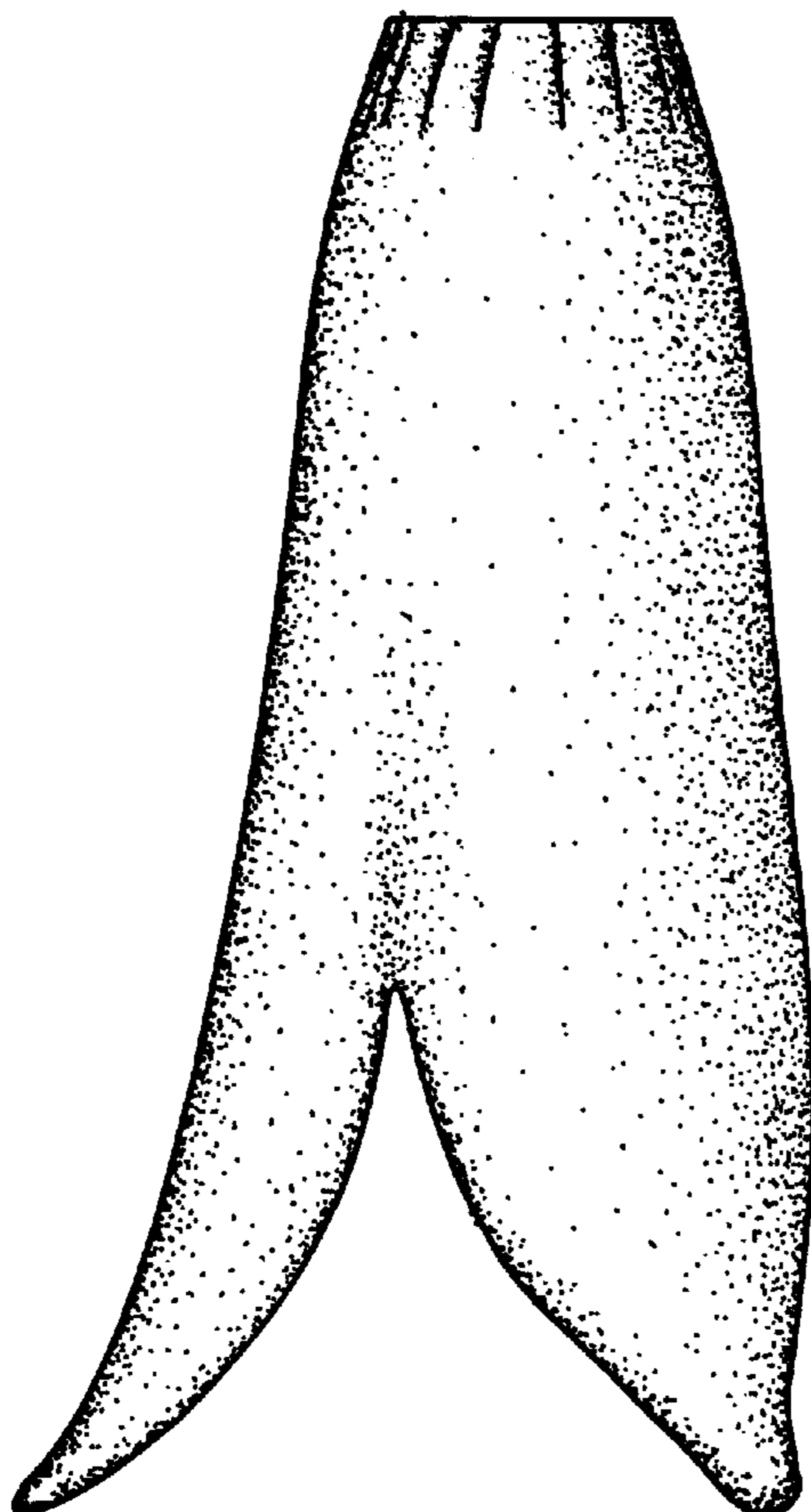
FIG. 3 is a back view of the three leaf glass shade in accordance with the present invention;

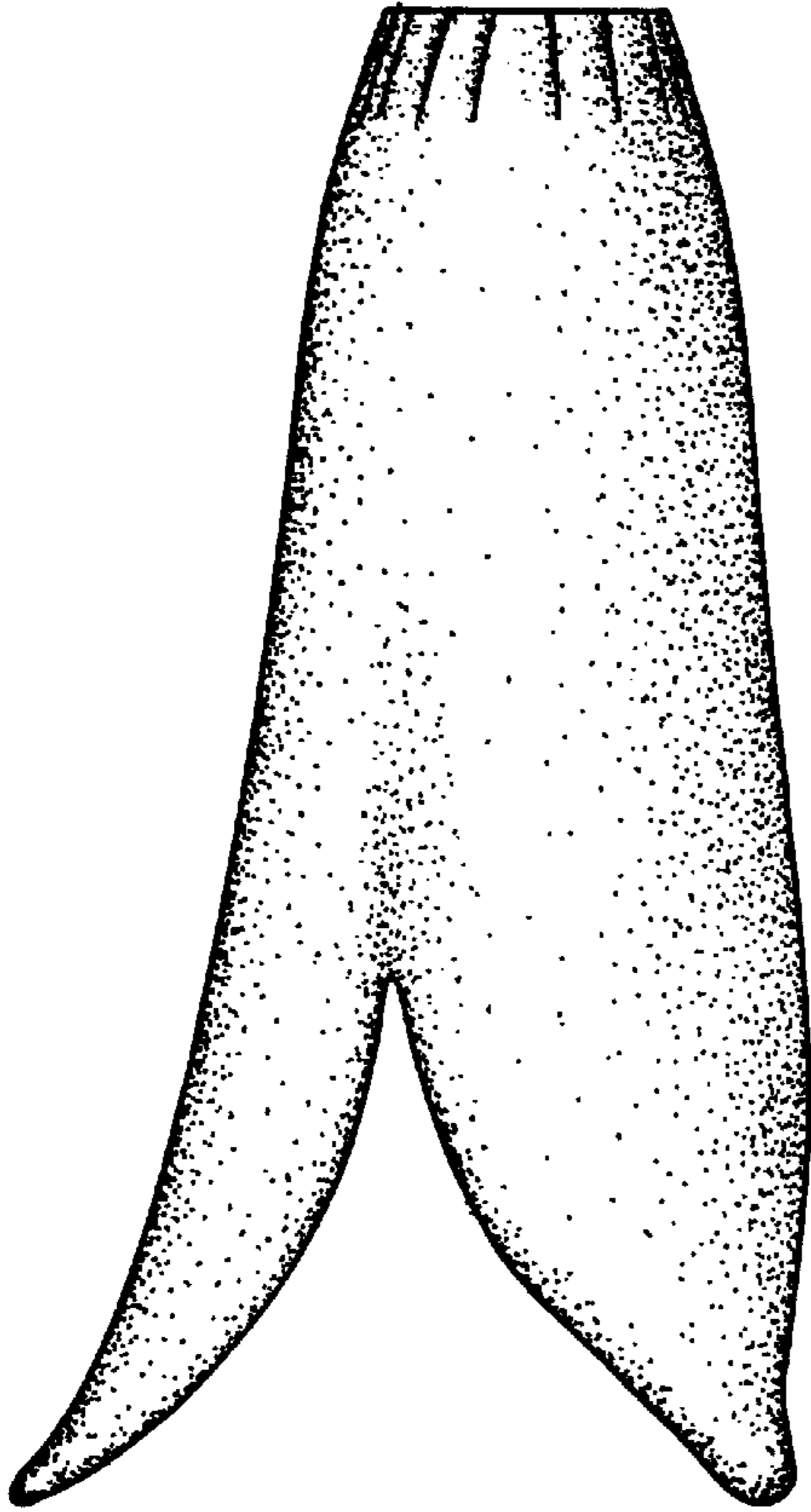

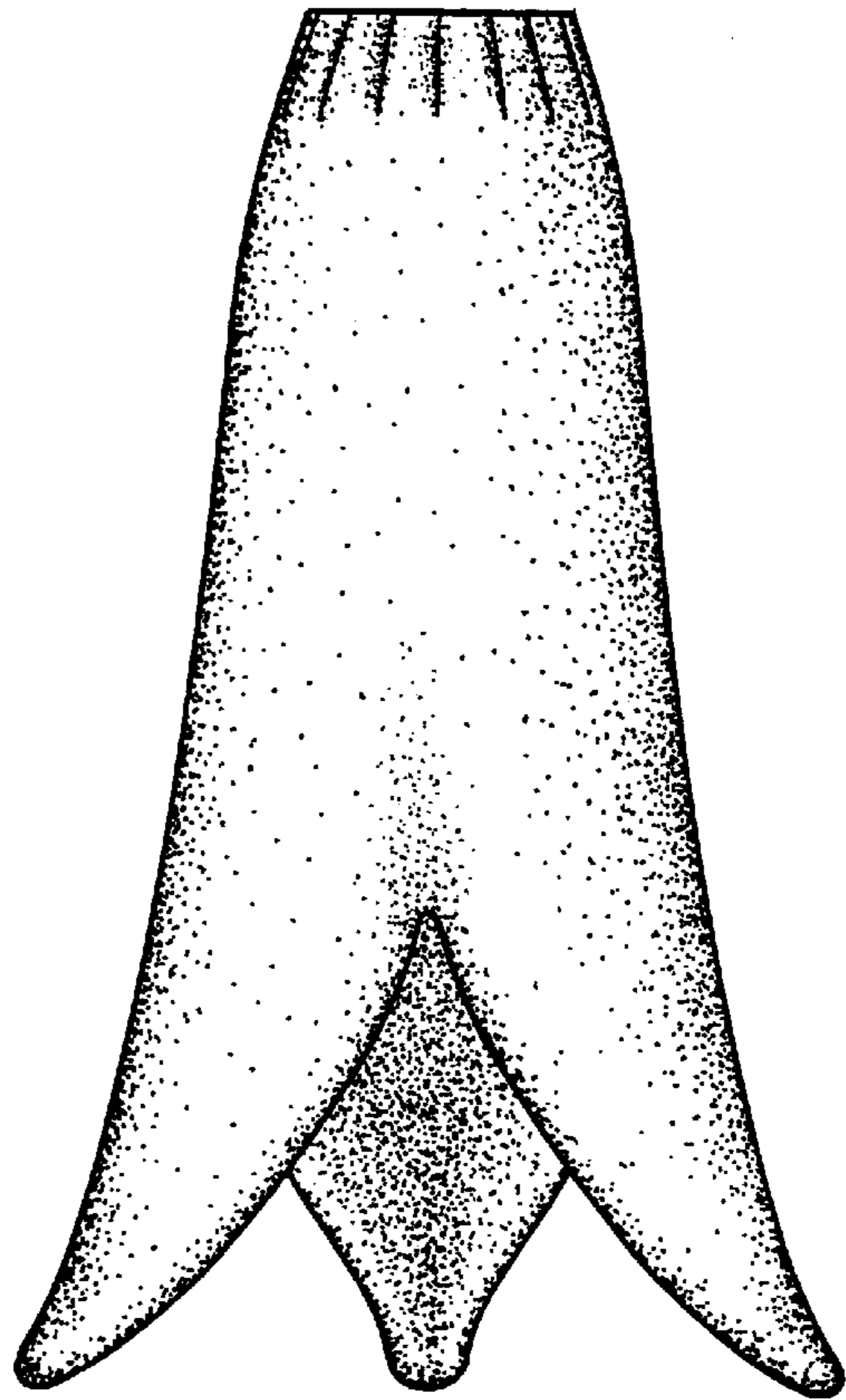

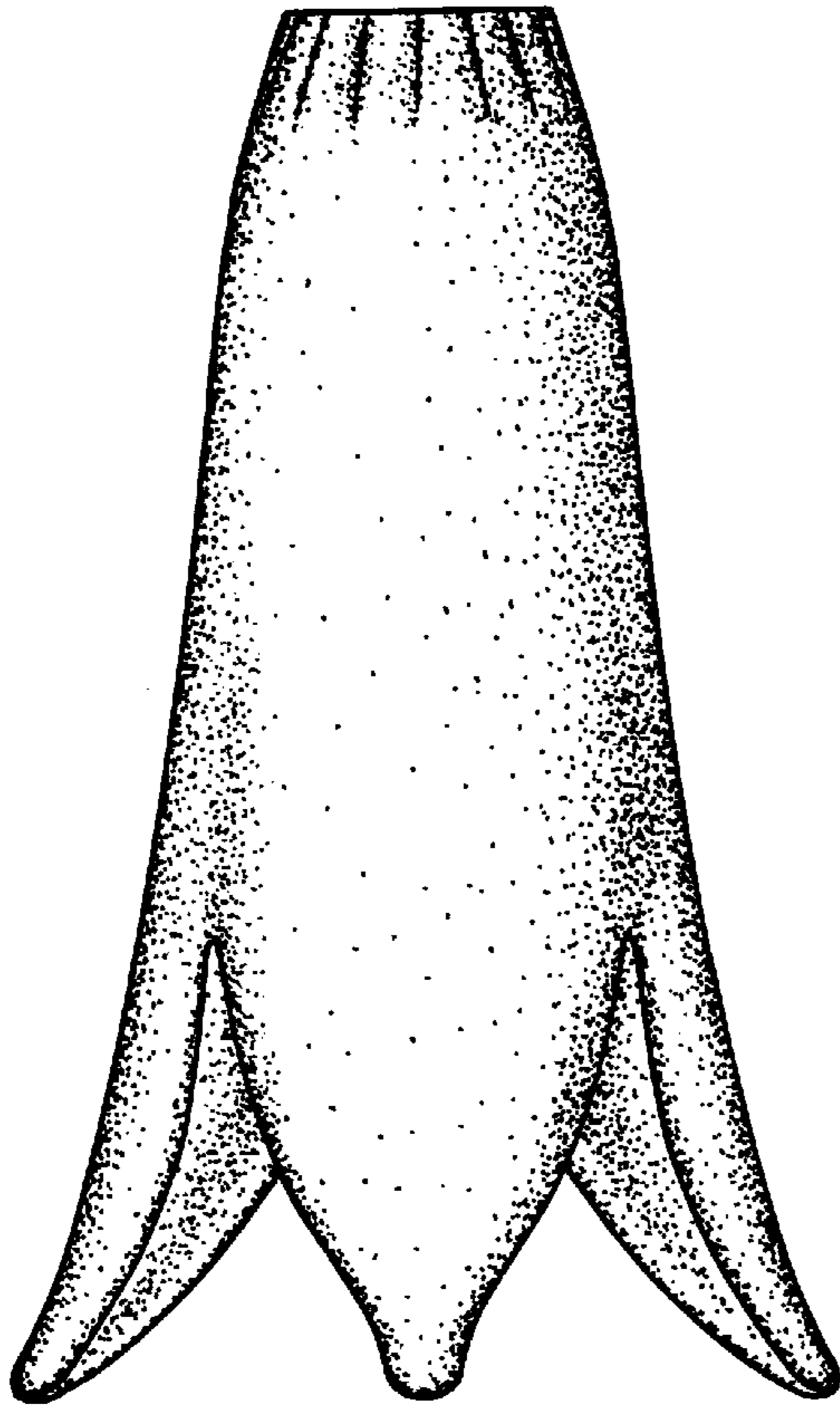

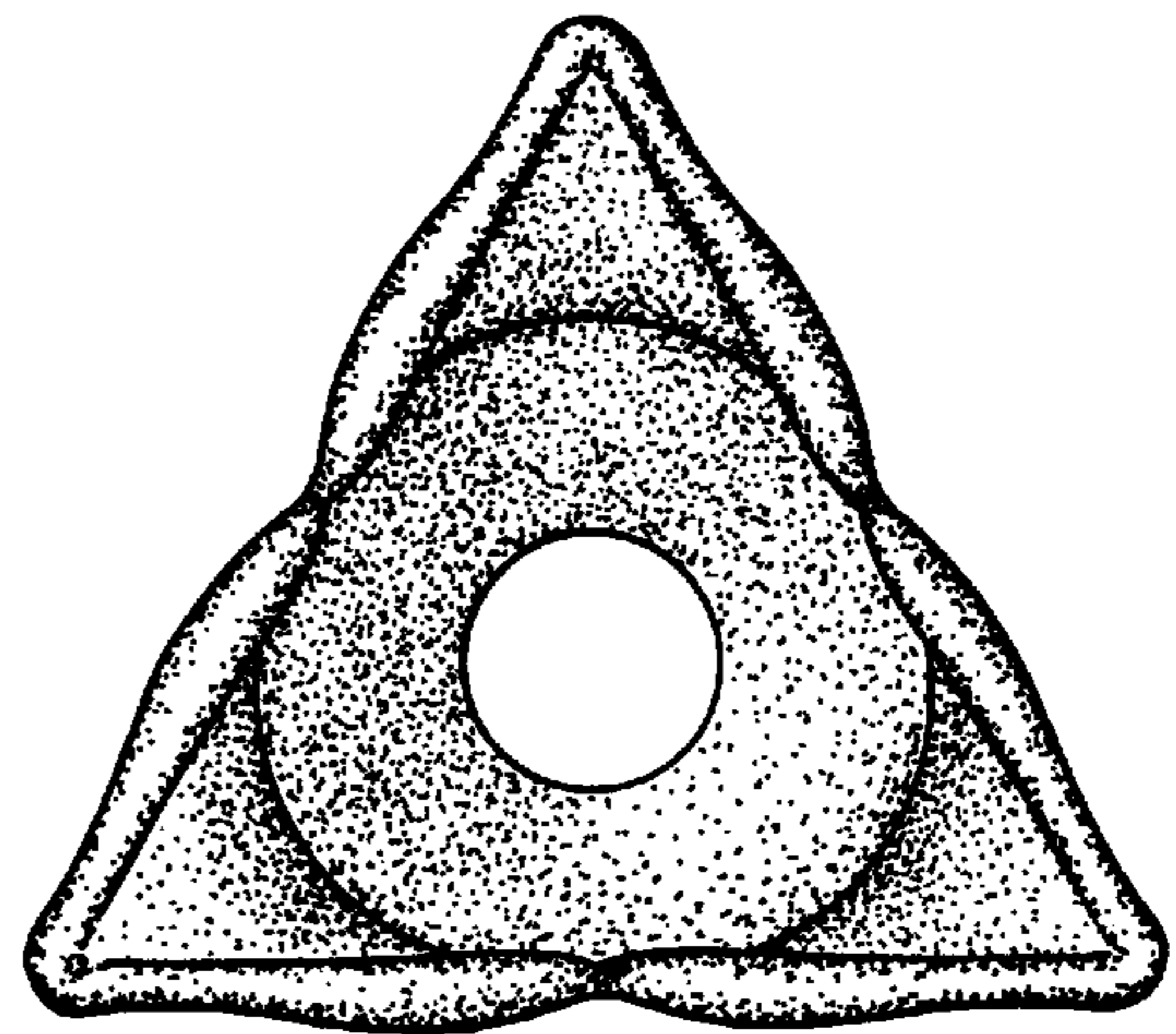

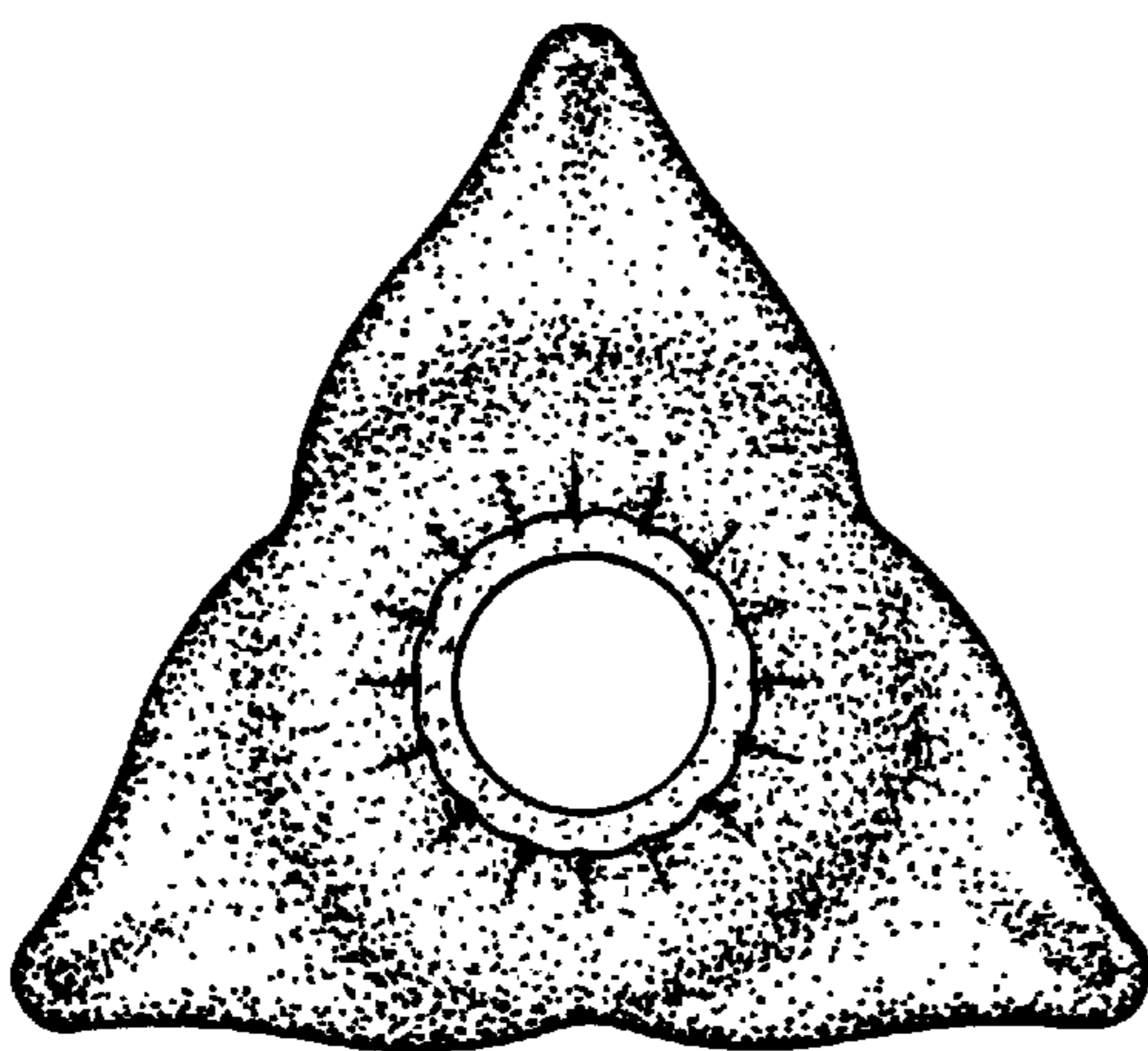
