DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

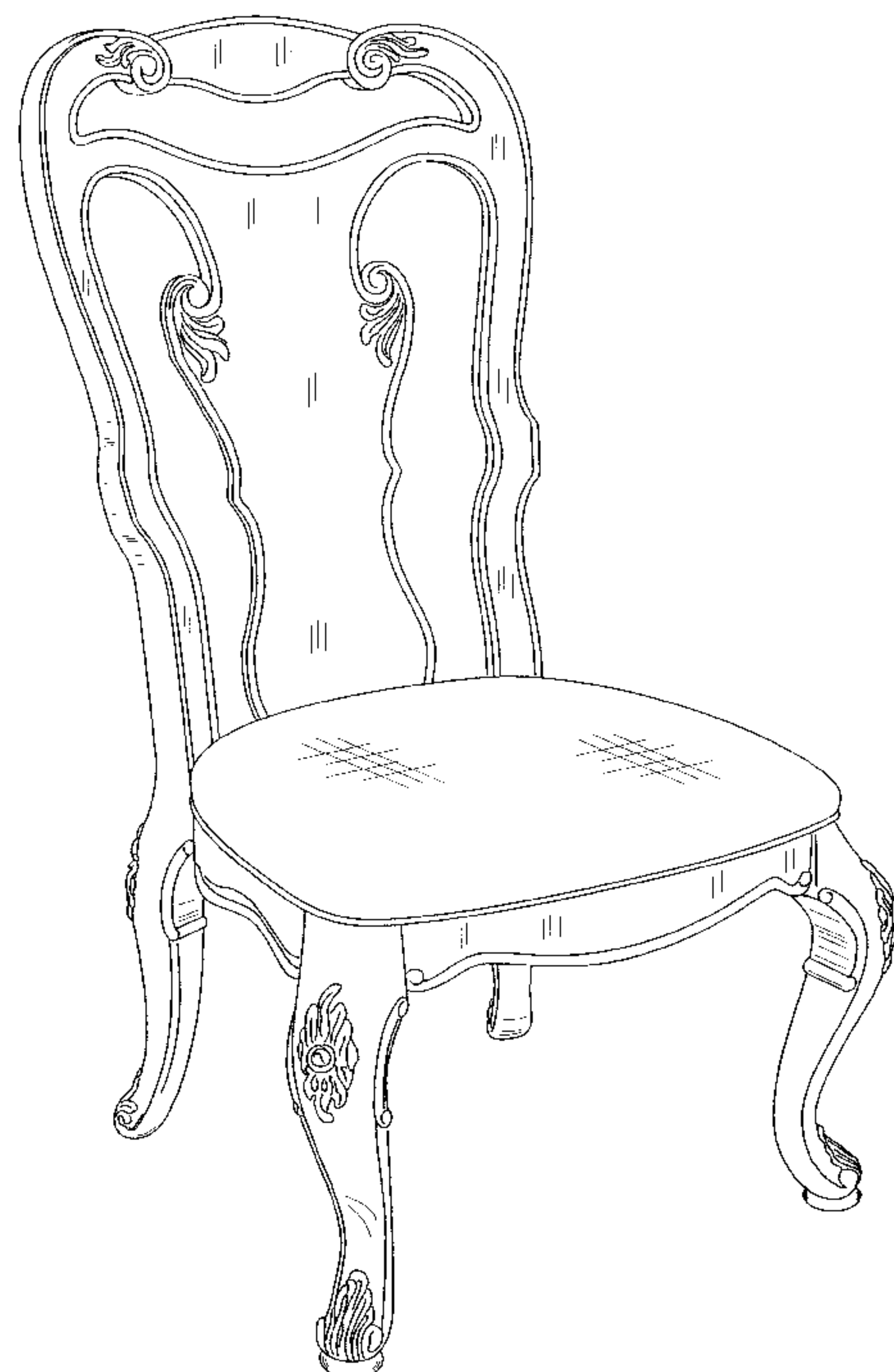
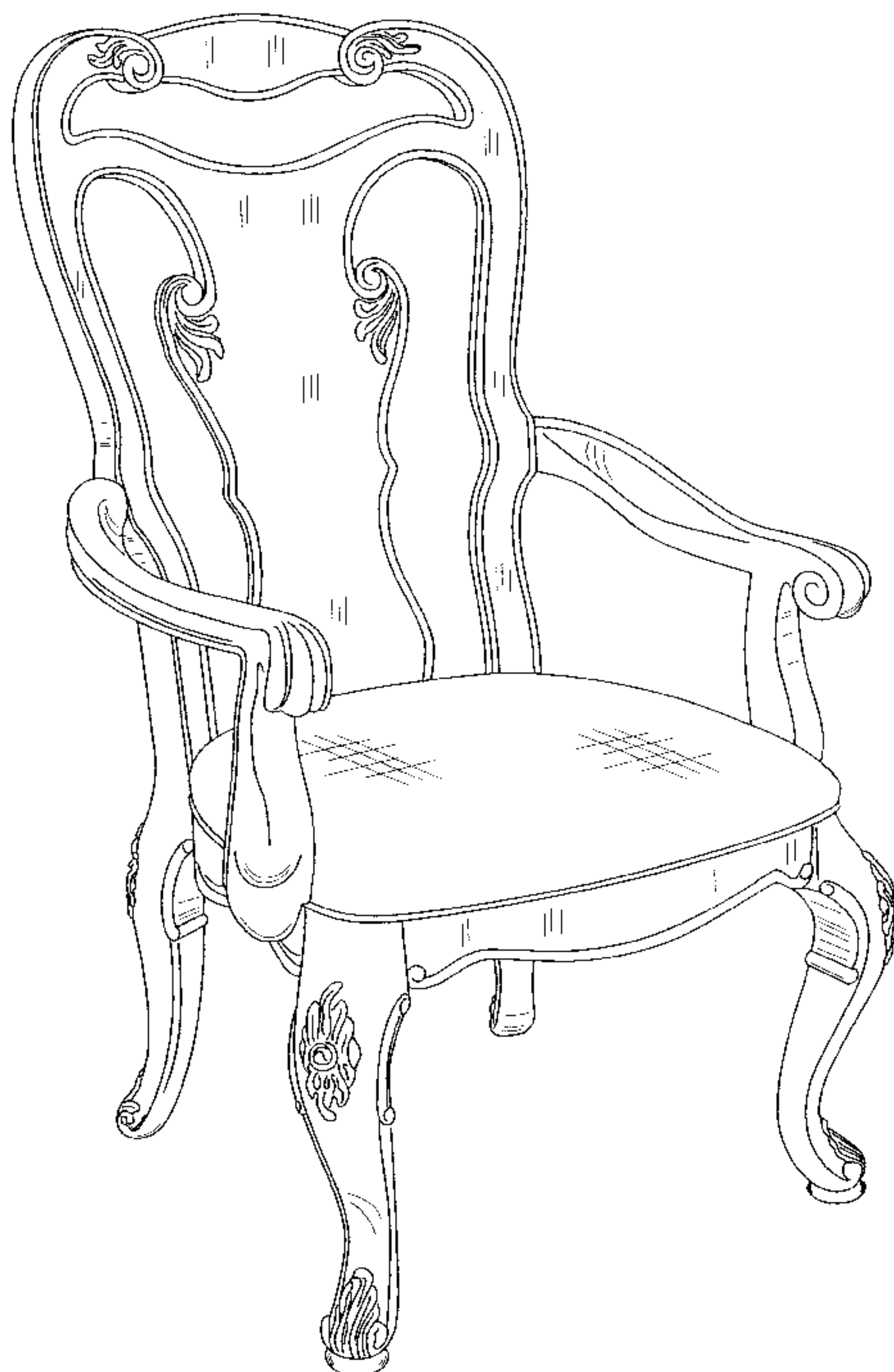
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;

The sole difference between the first embodiment and the second embodiment residing in the absence of the arms in the second embodiment.

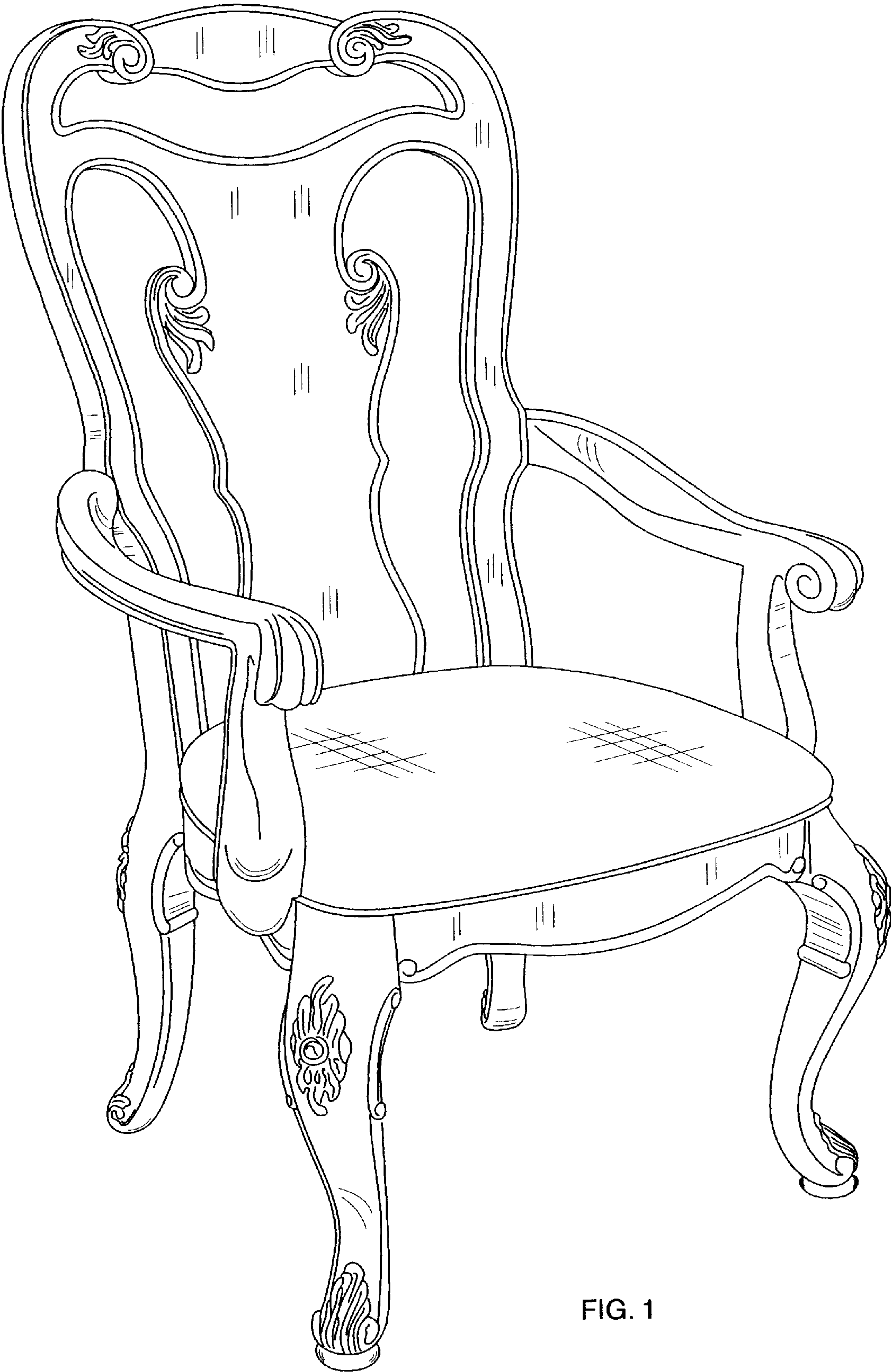

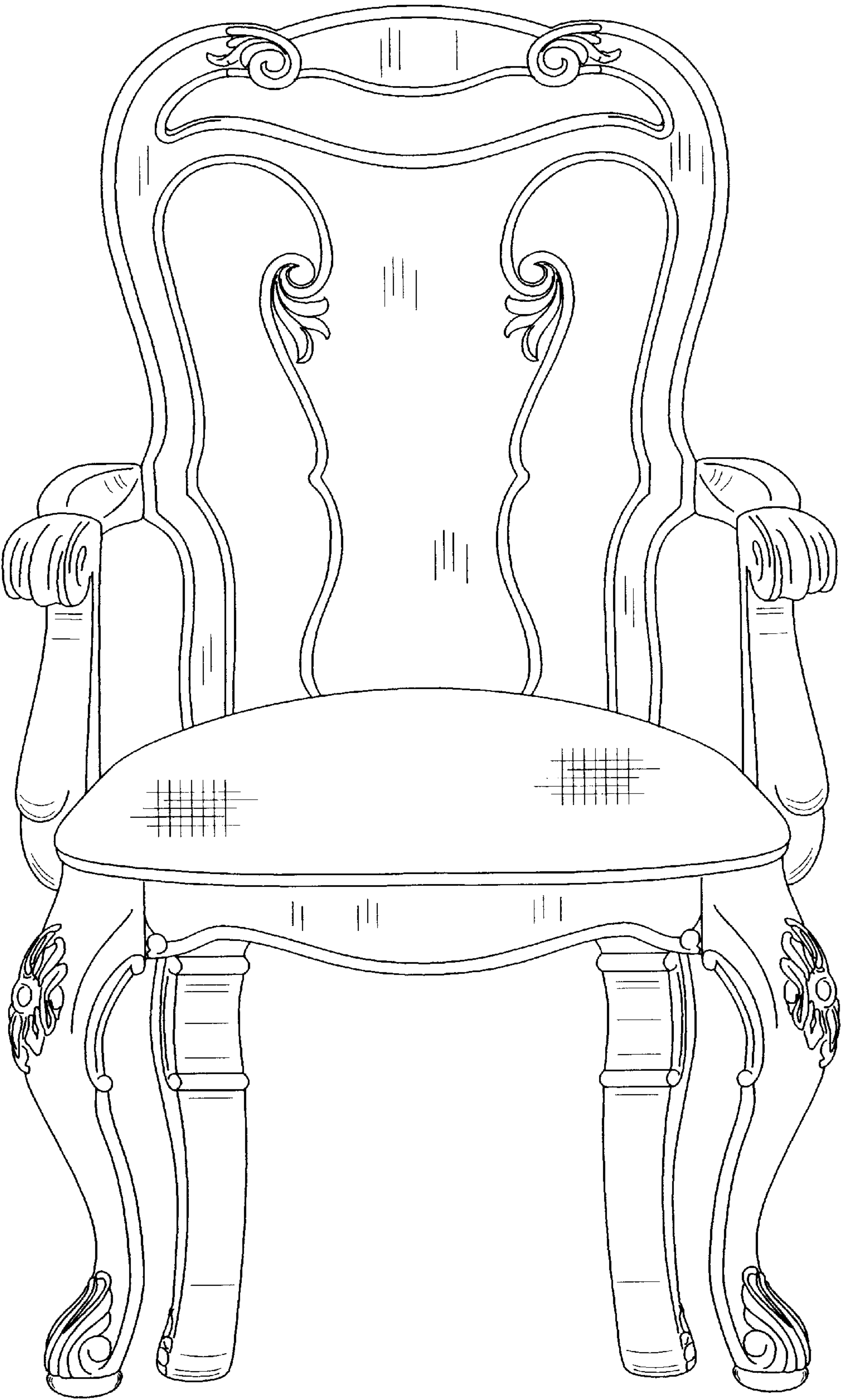

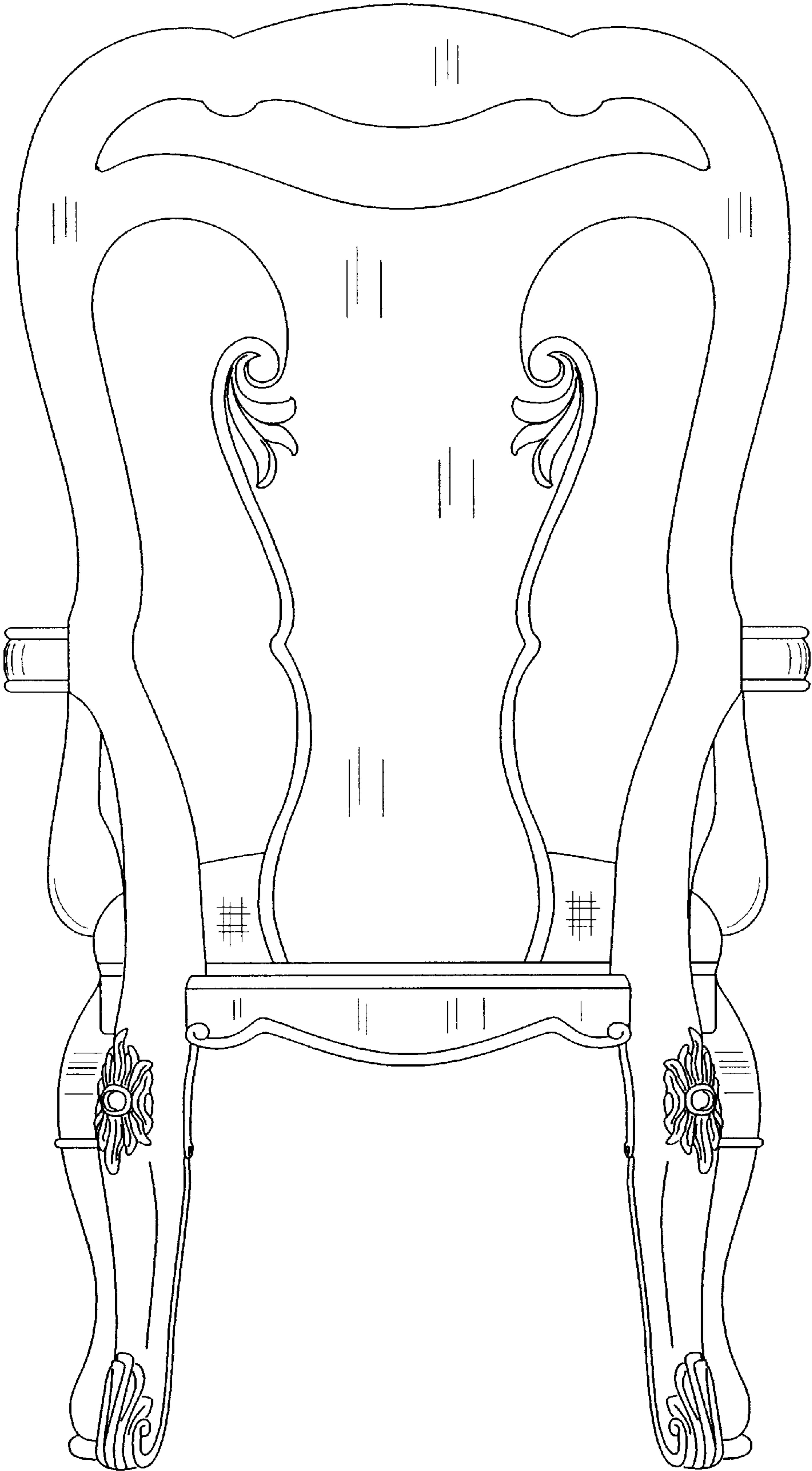

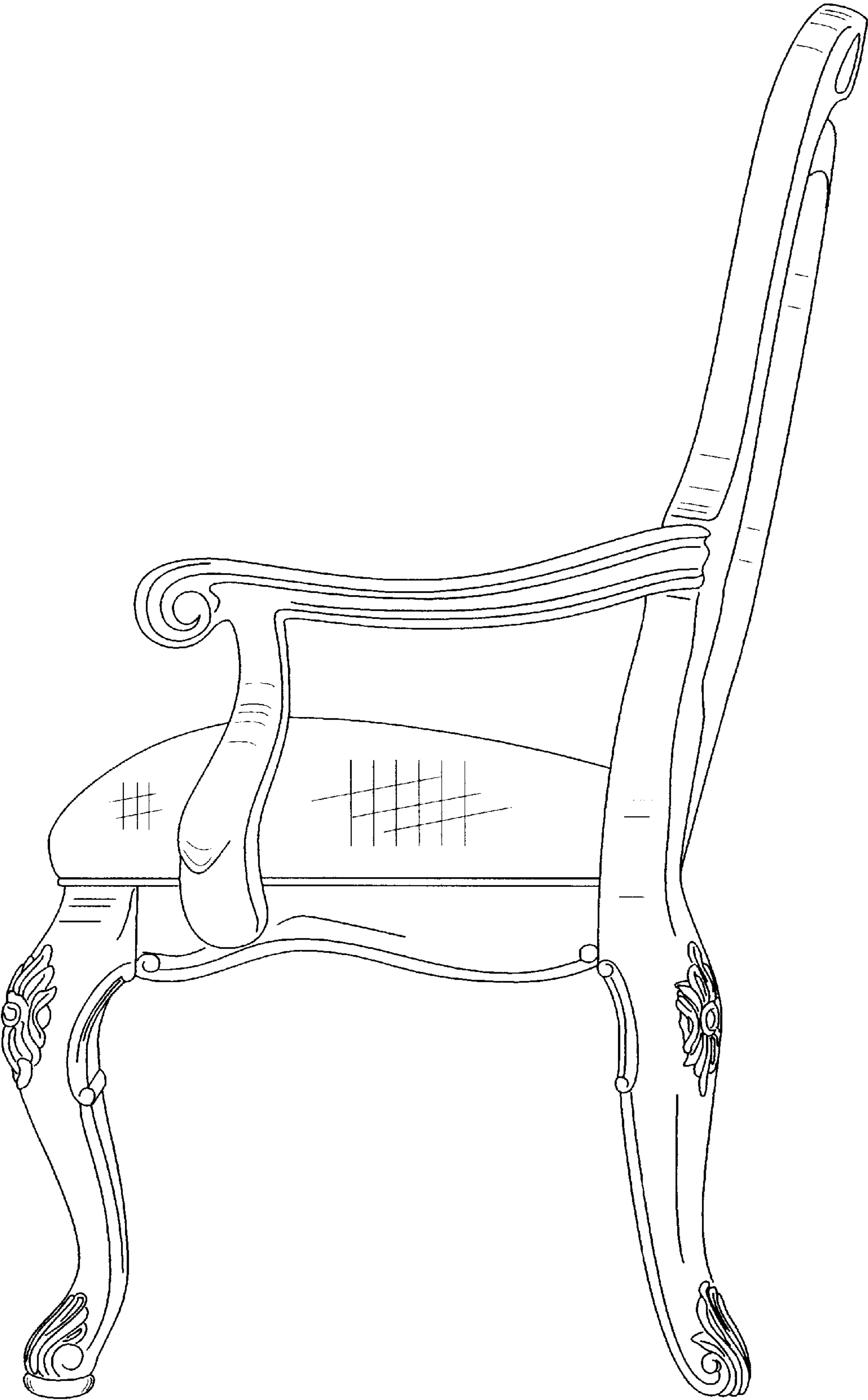

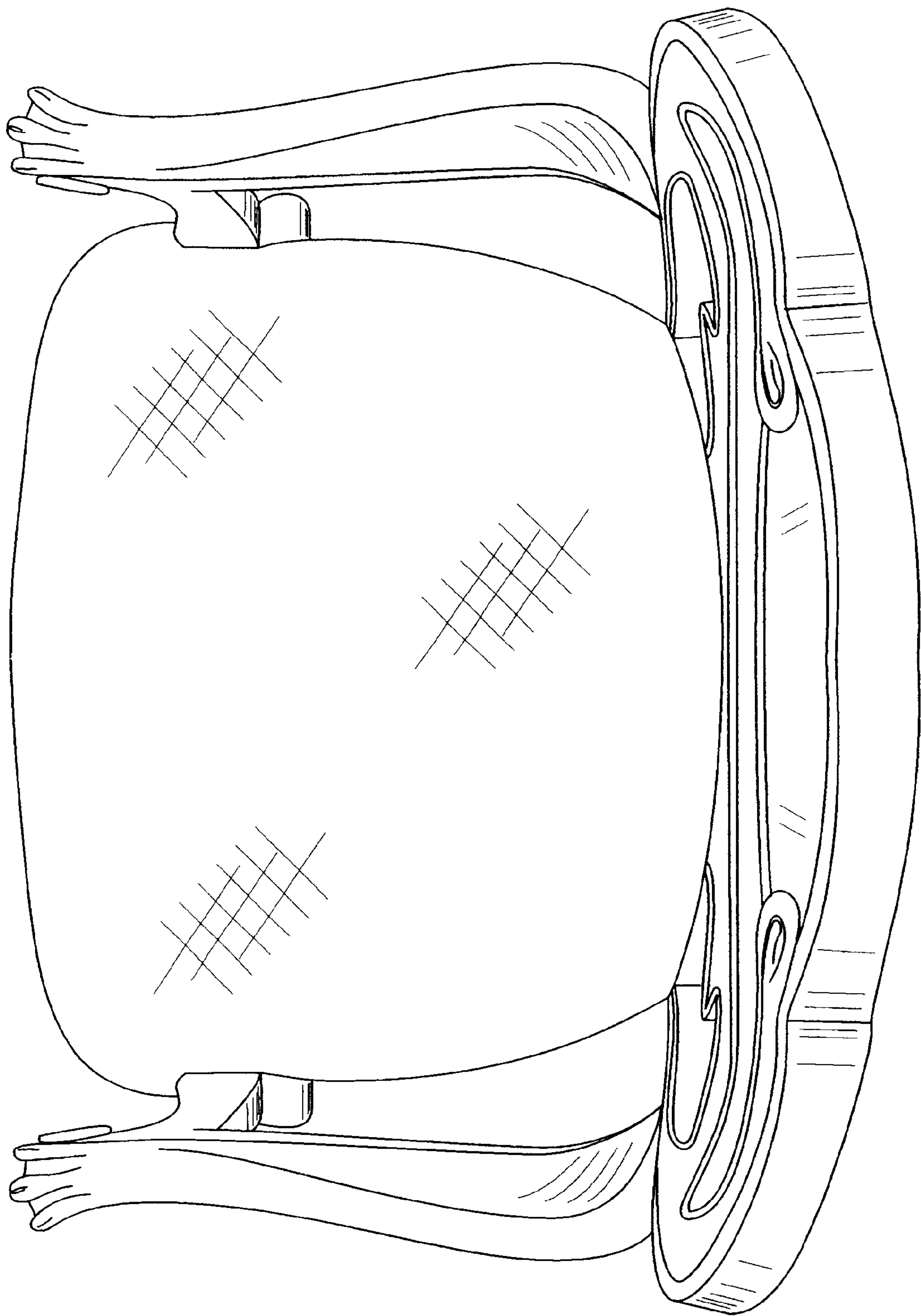

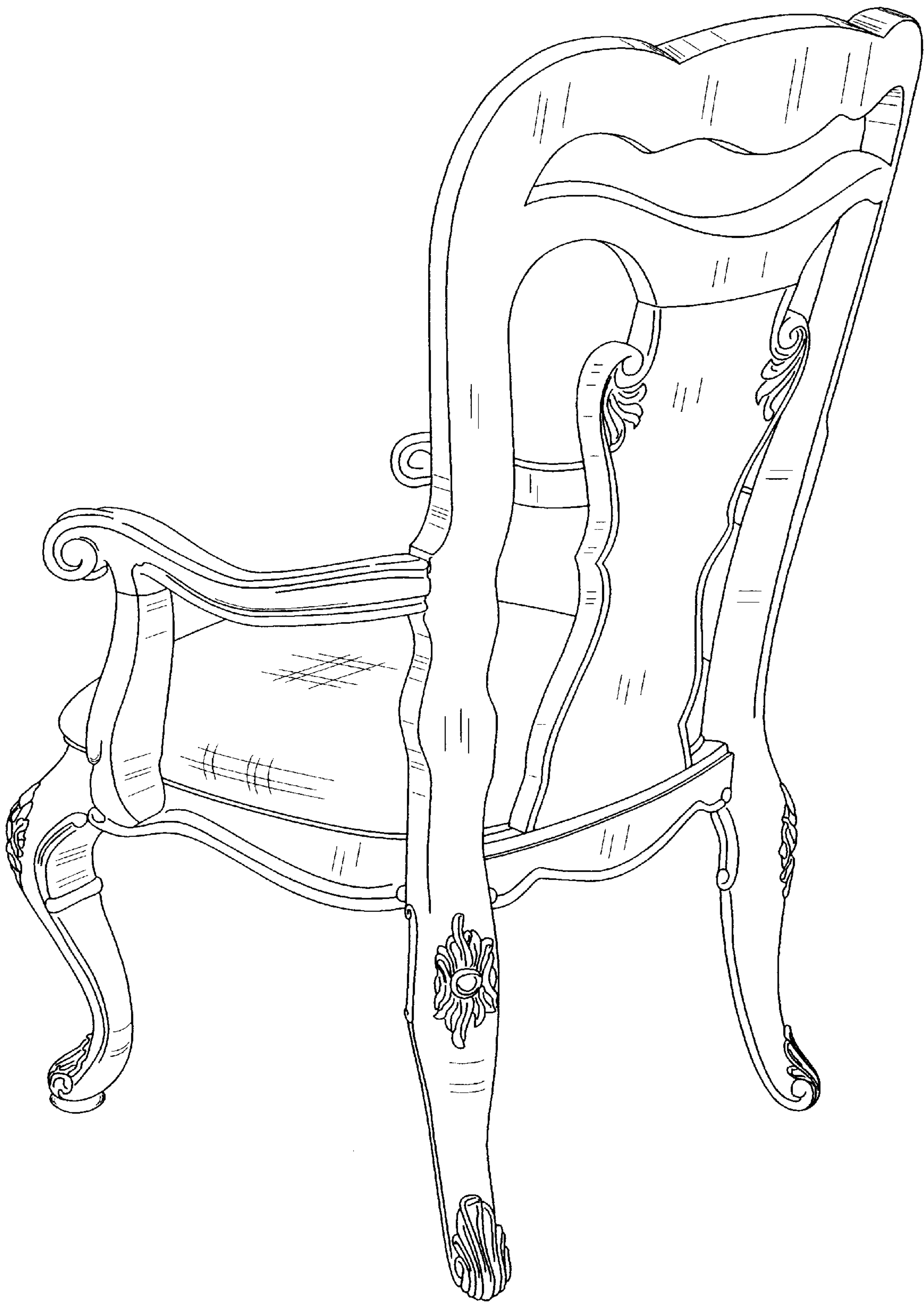

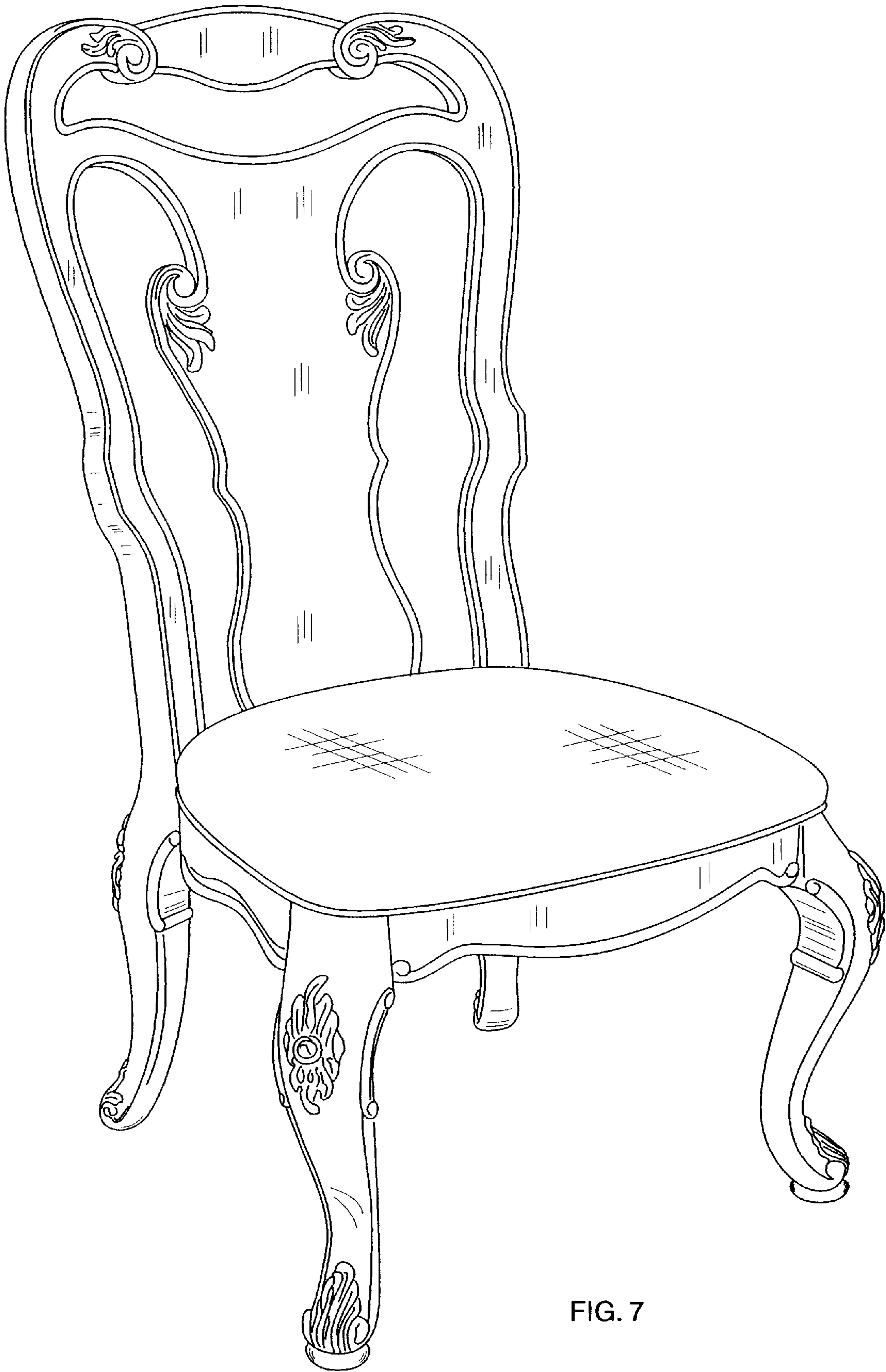
