DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electronic transmitter in accordance with the present invention shown with antenna in an extended position.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the electronic transmitter illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the electronic transmitter illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the electronic transmitter illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the electronic transmitter illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the electronic transmitter illustrated in FIG. 1 but shown with the antenna in a retracted position; and,

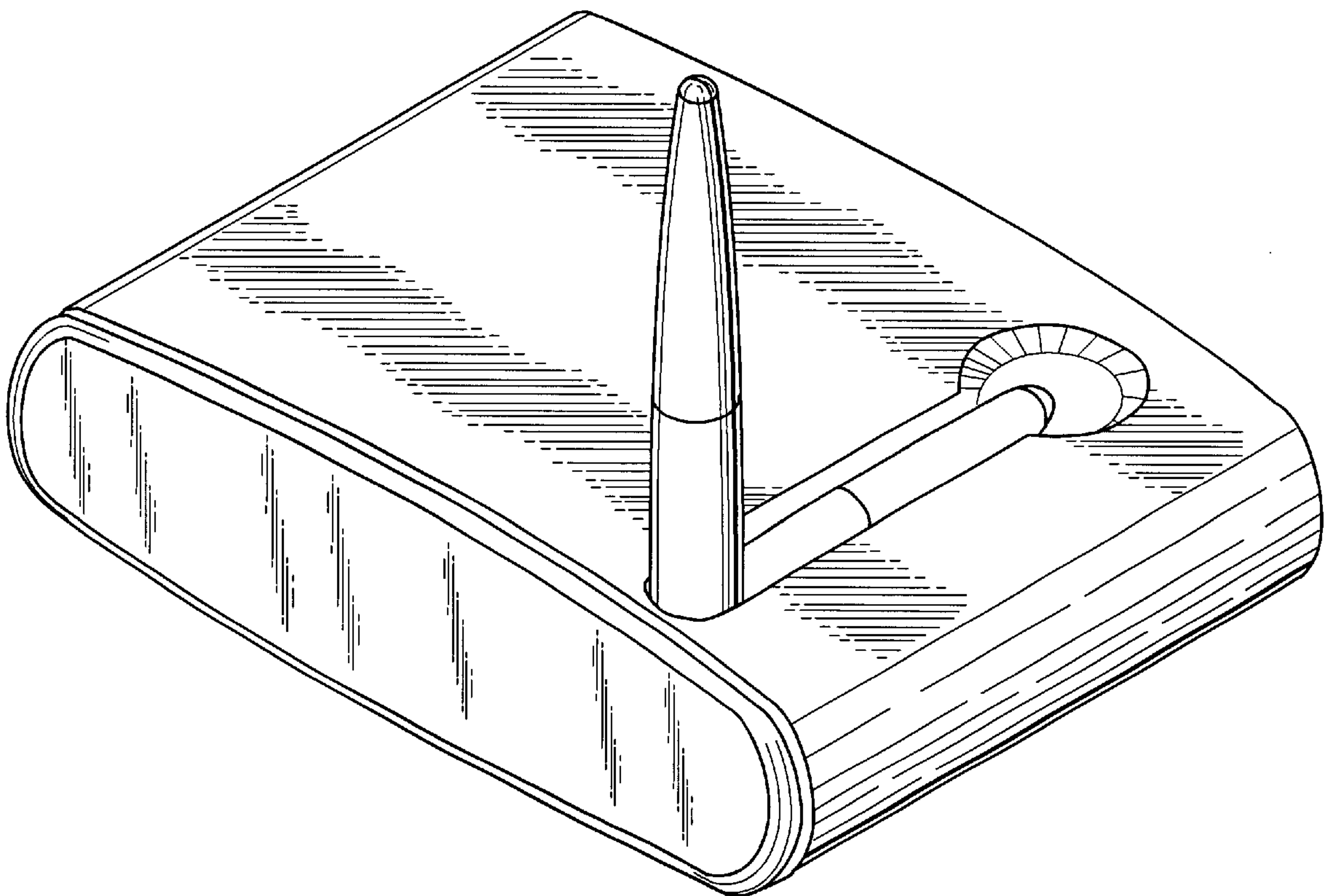

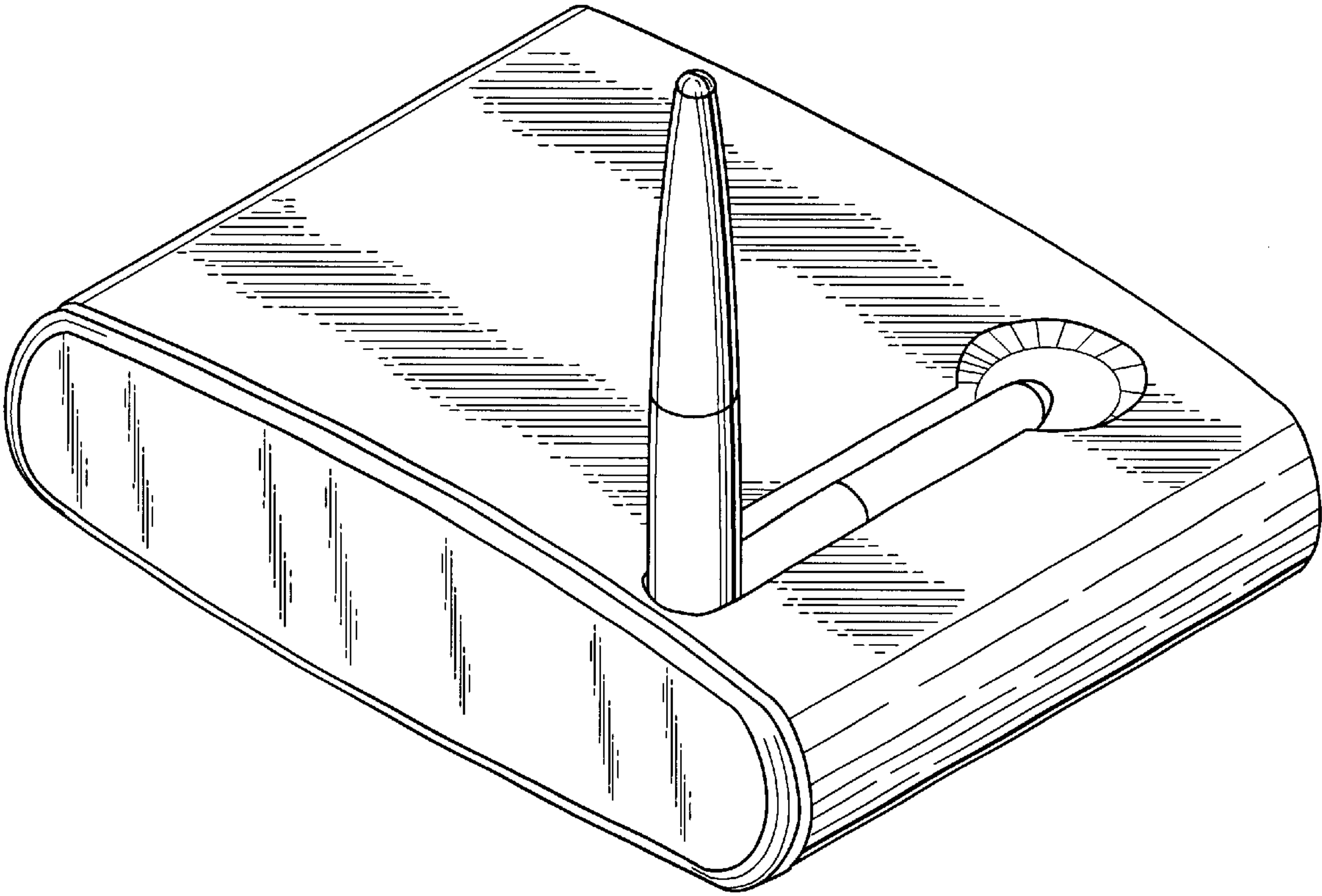

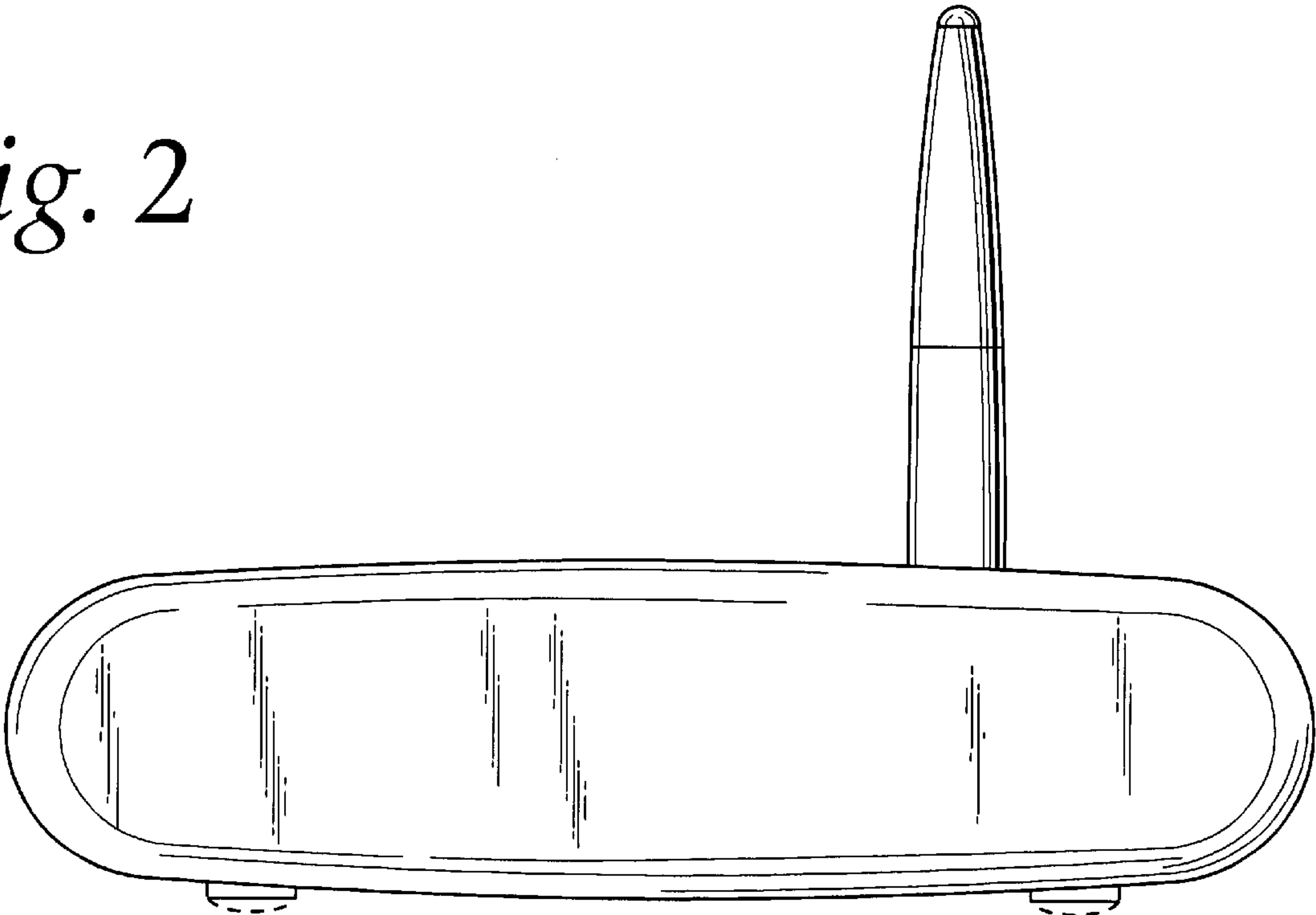

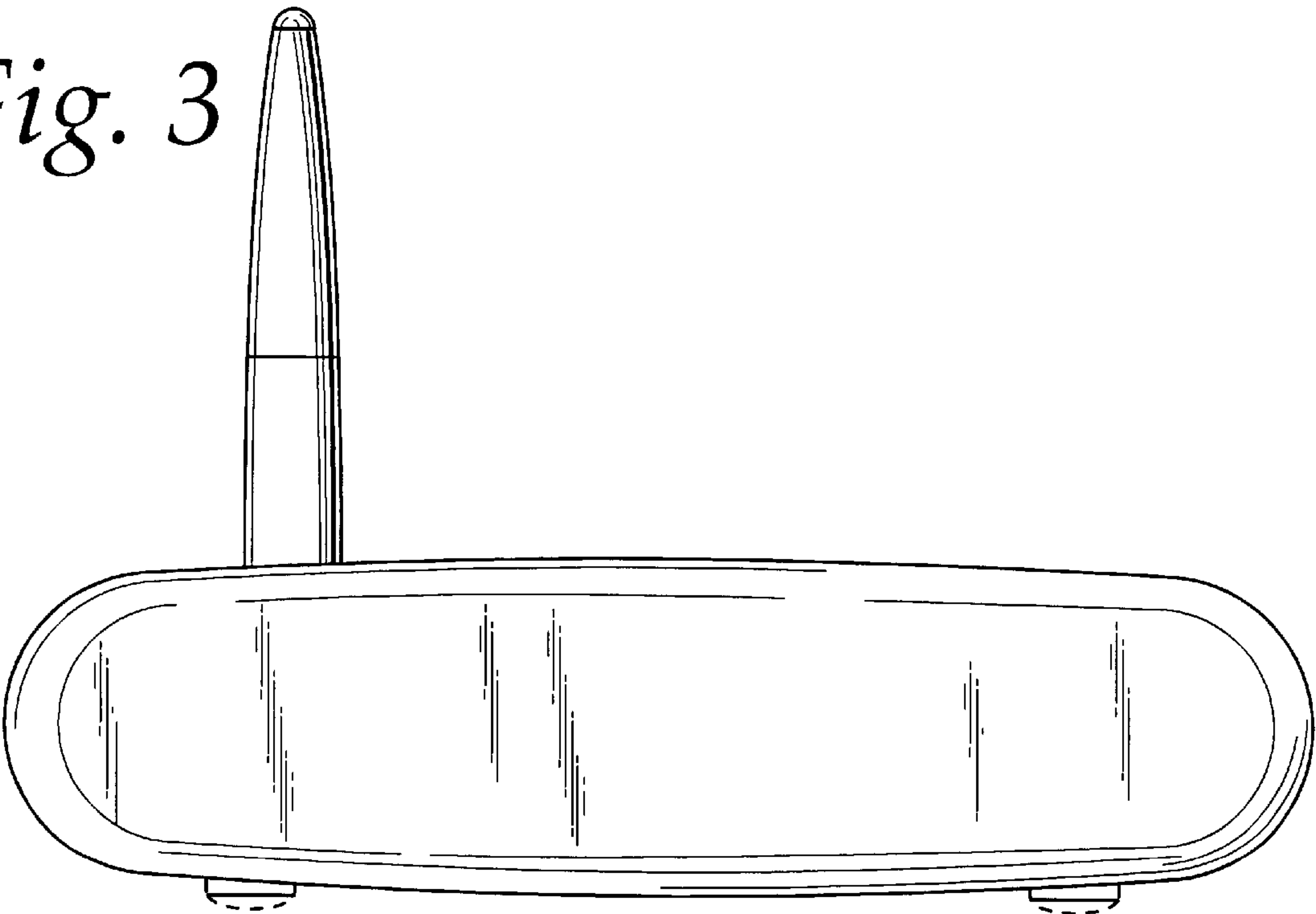

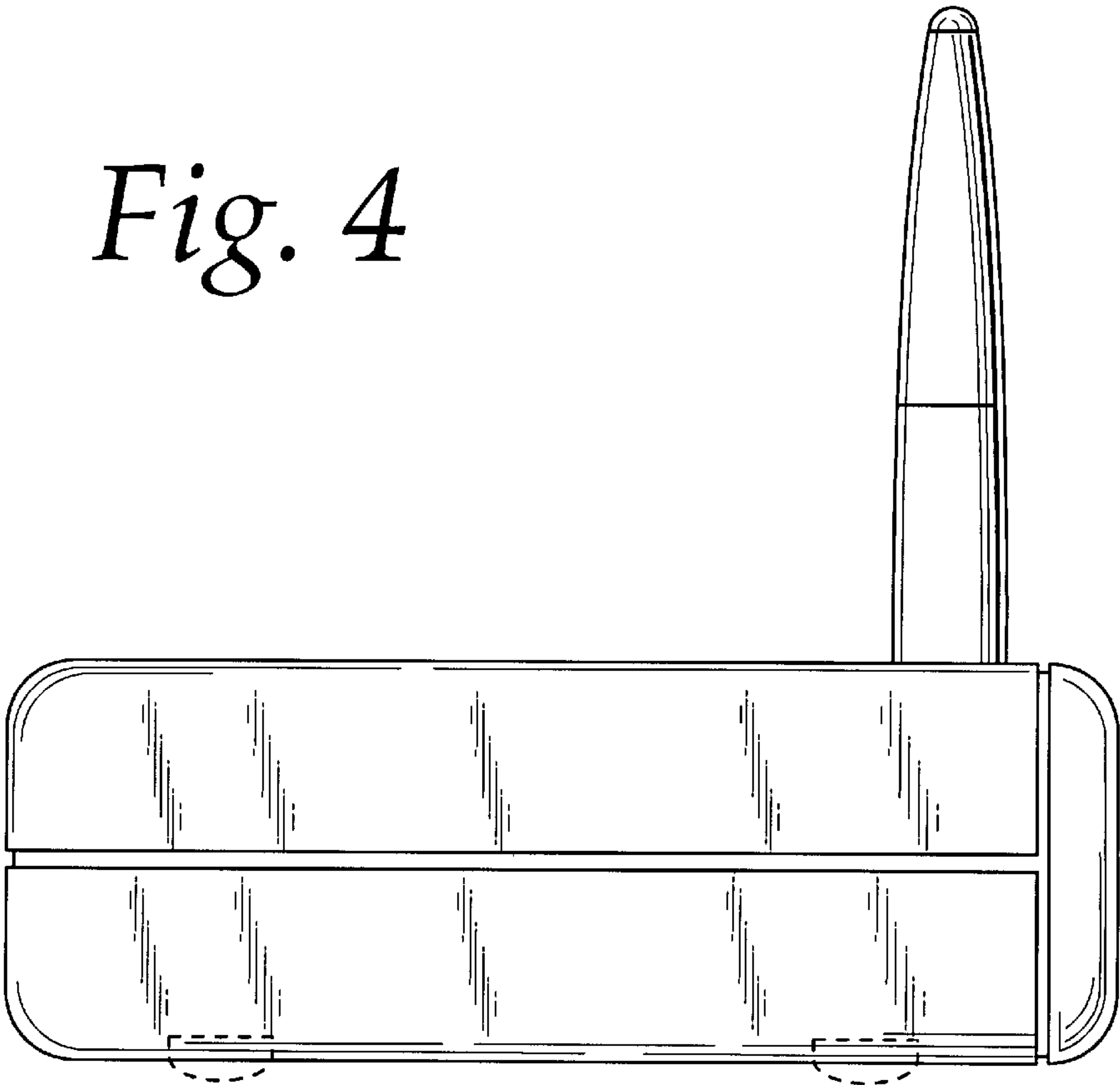

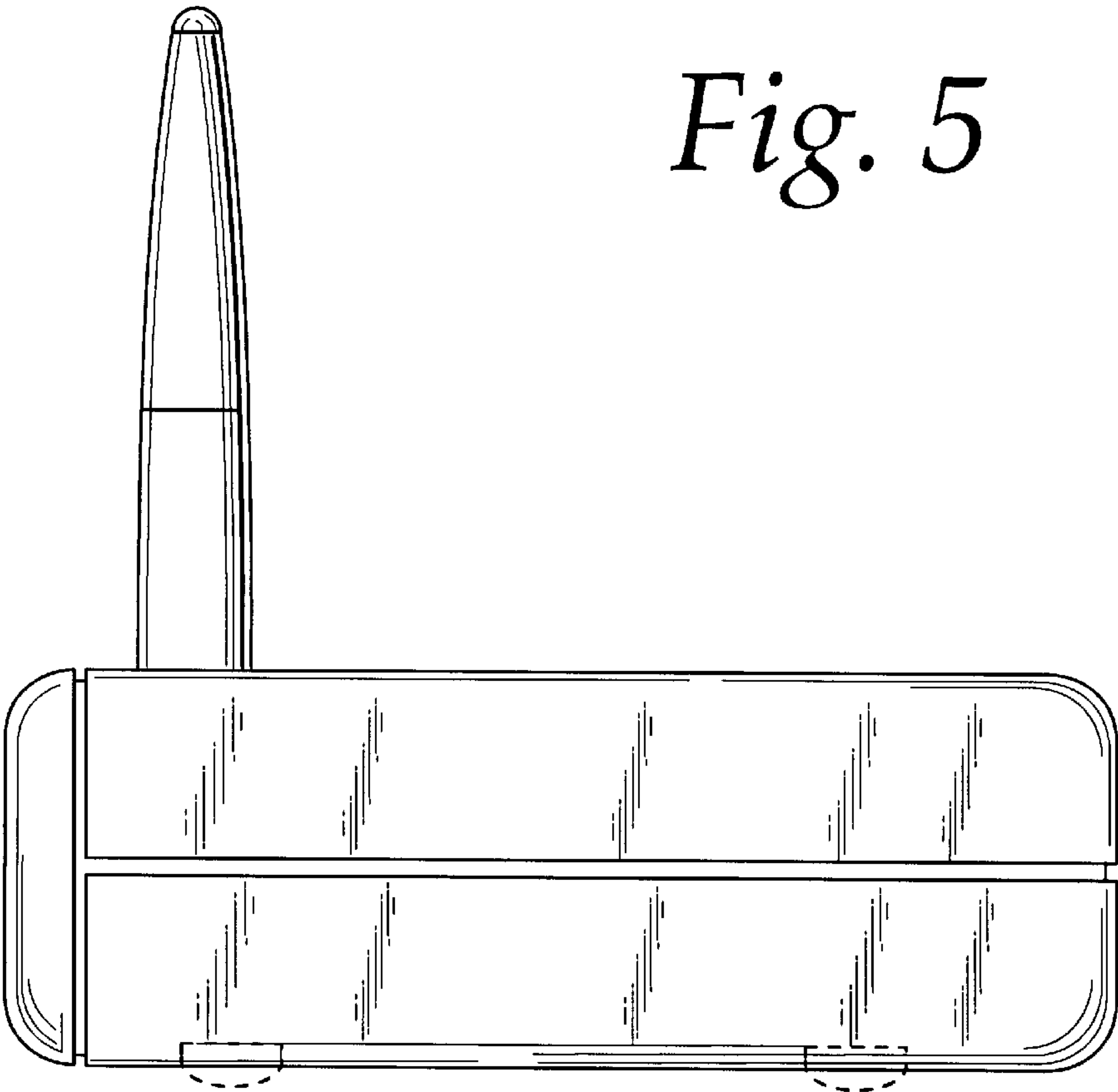

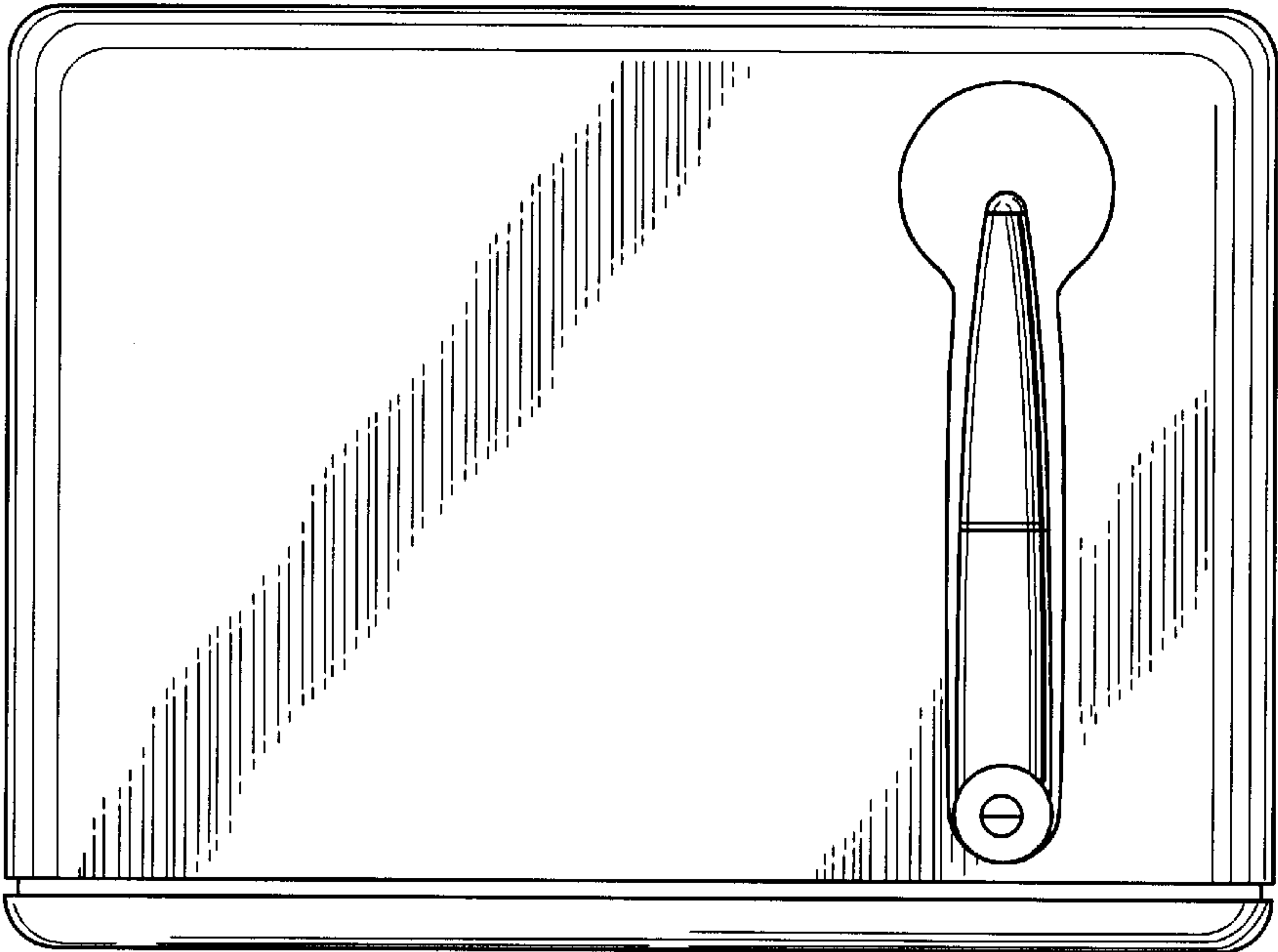
