FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

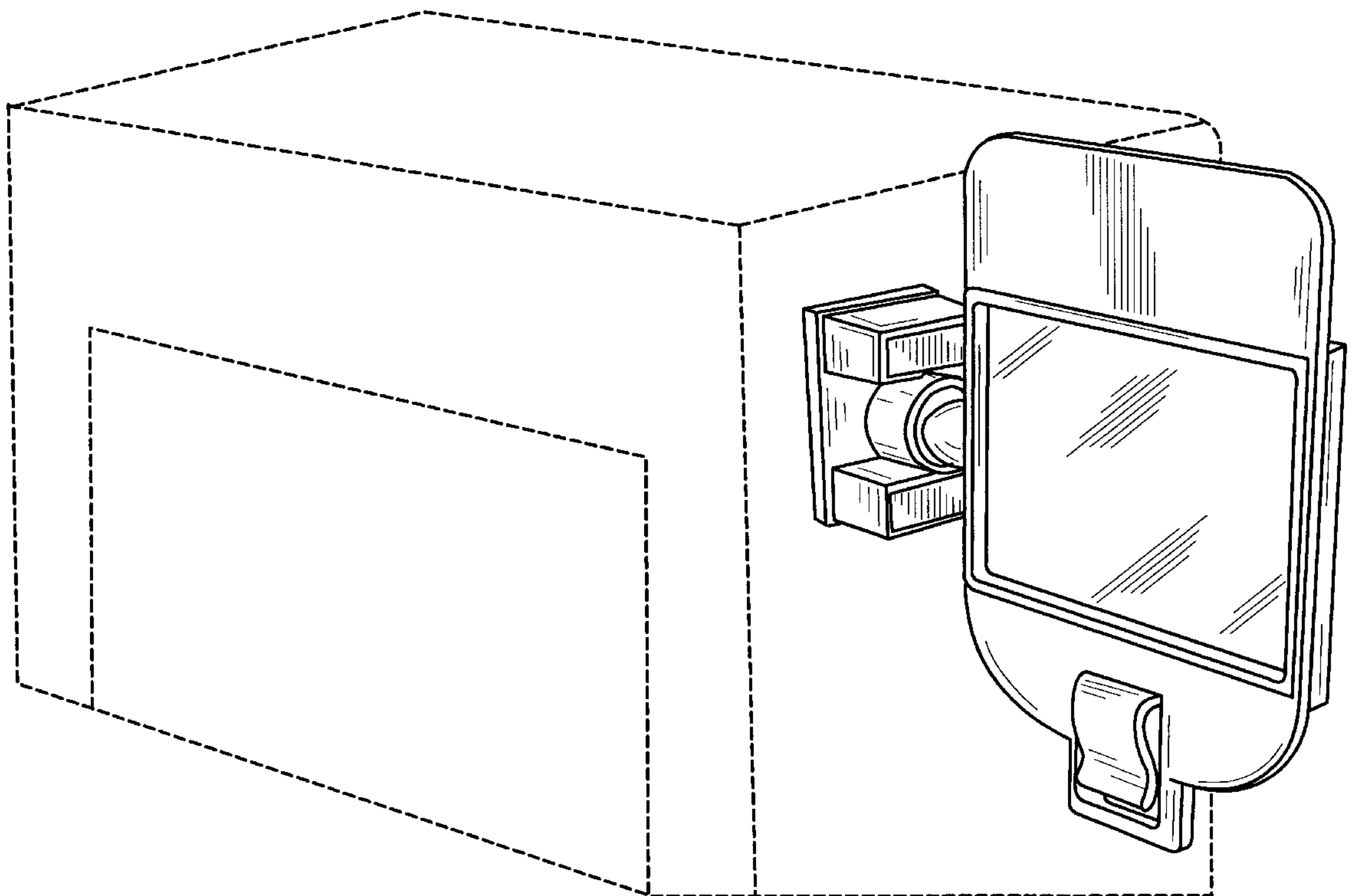
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

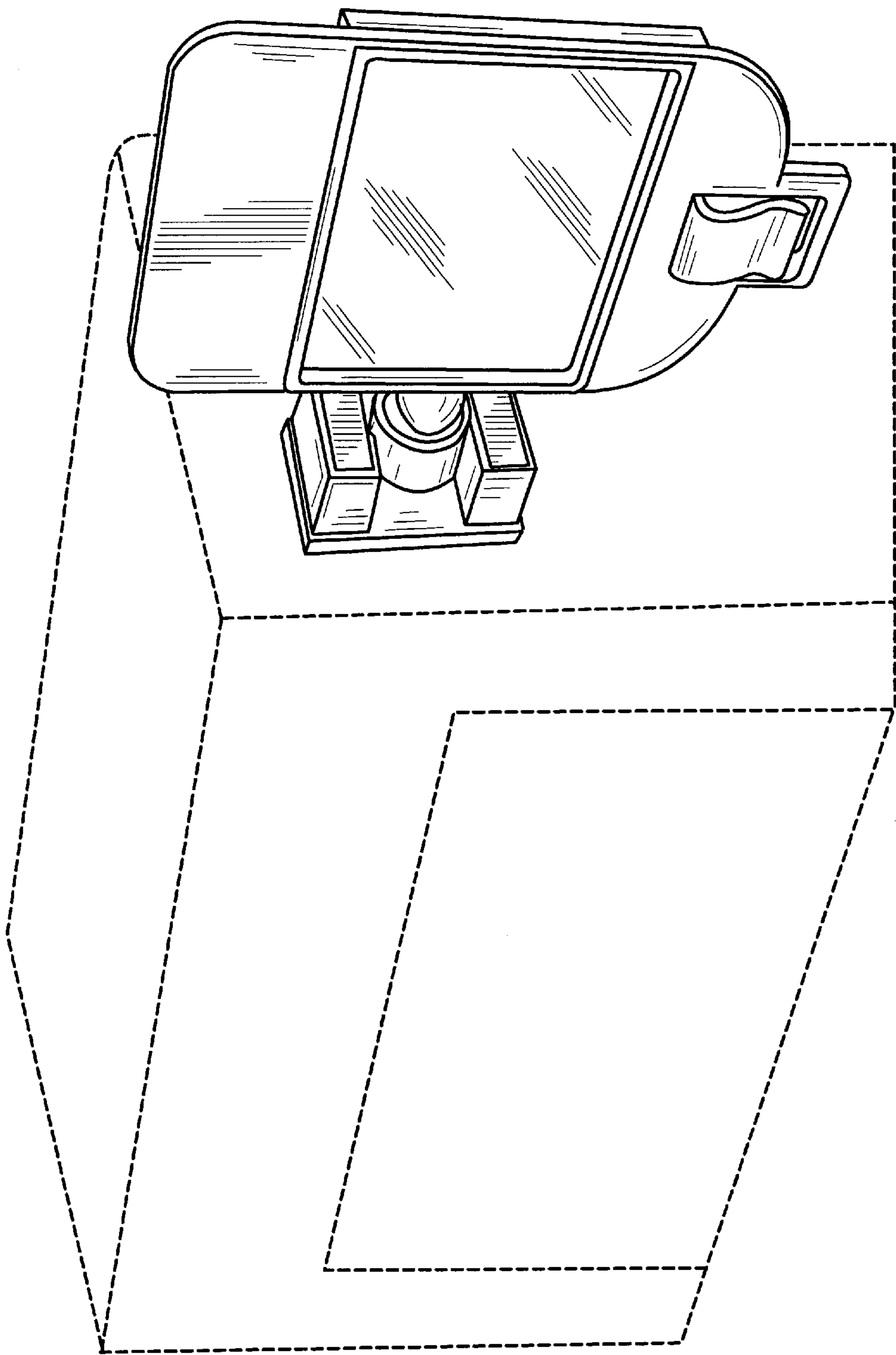

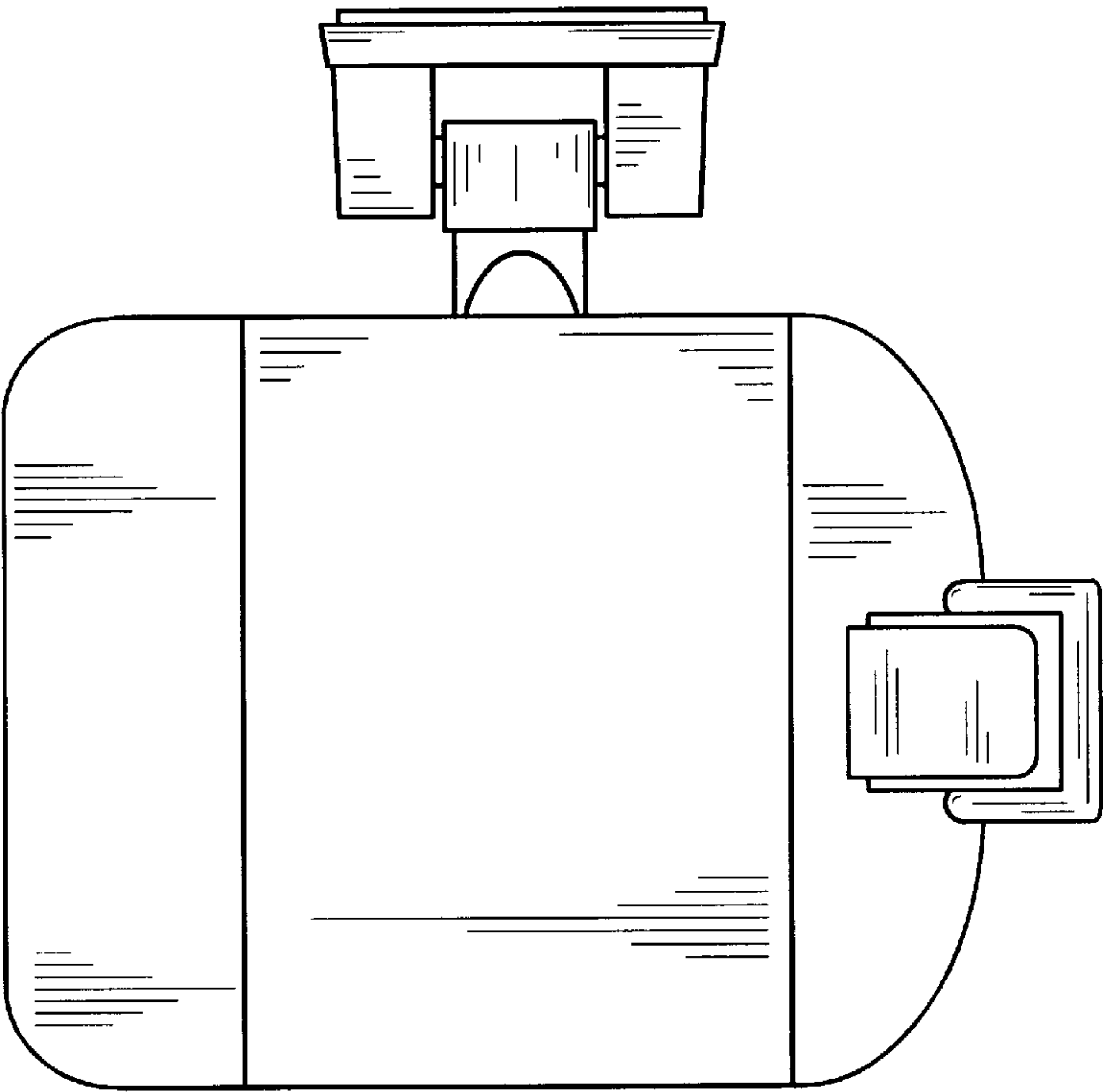

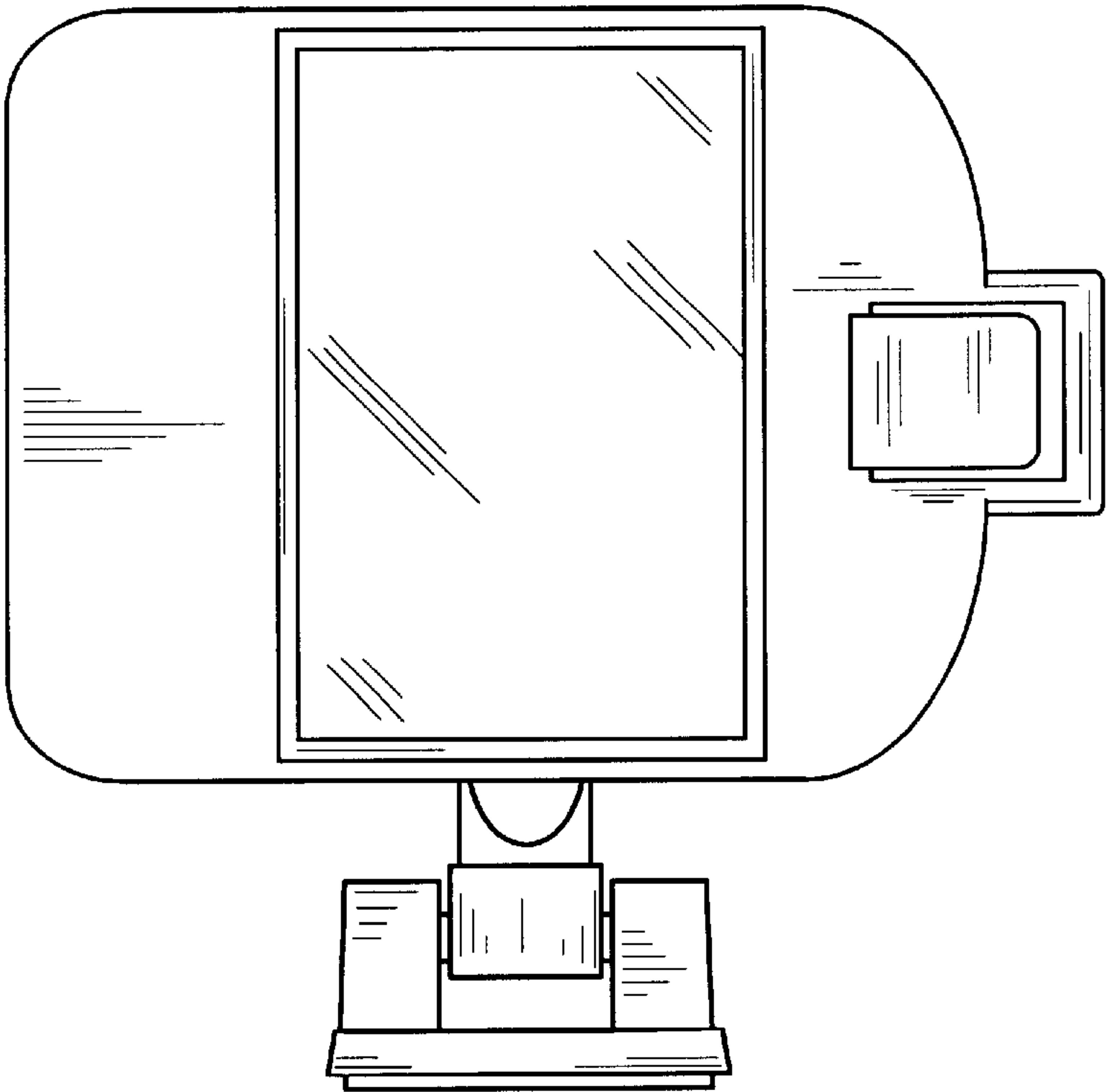

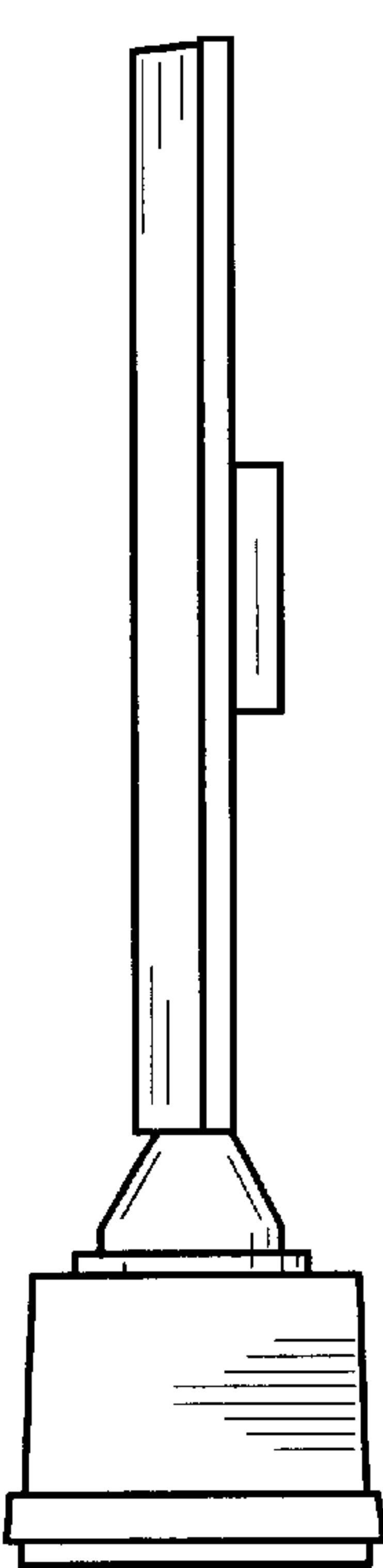

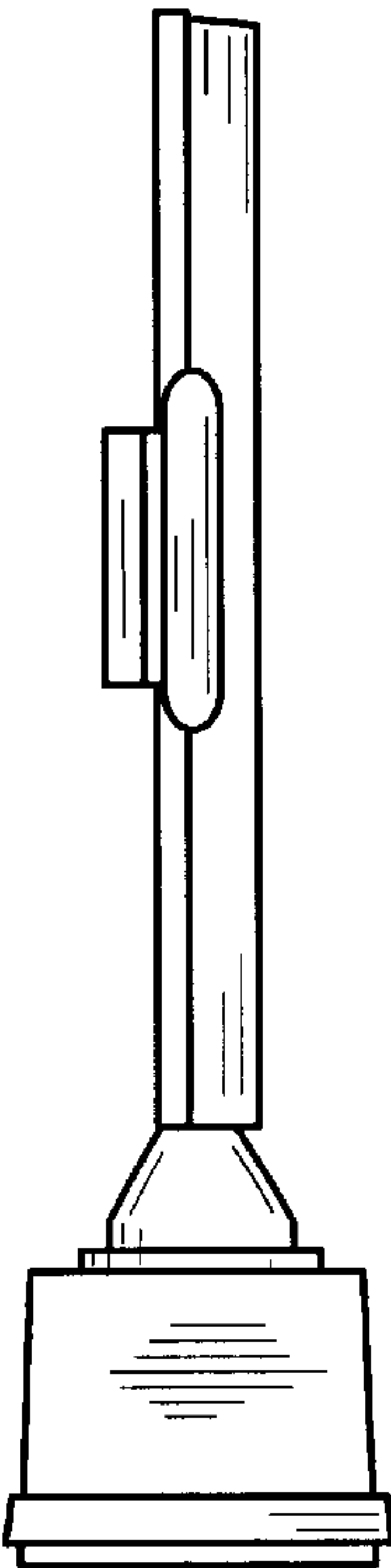

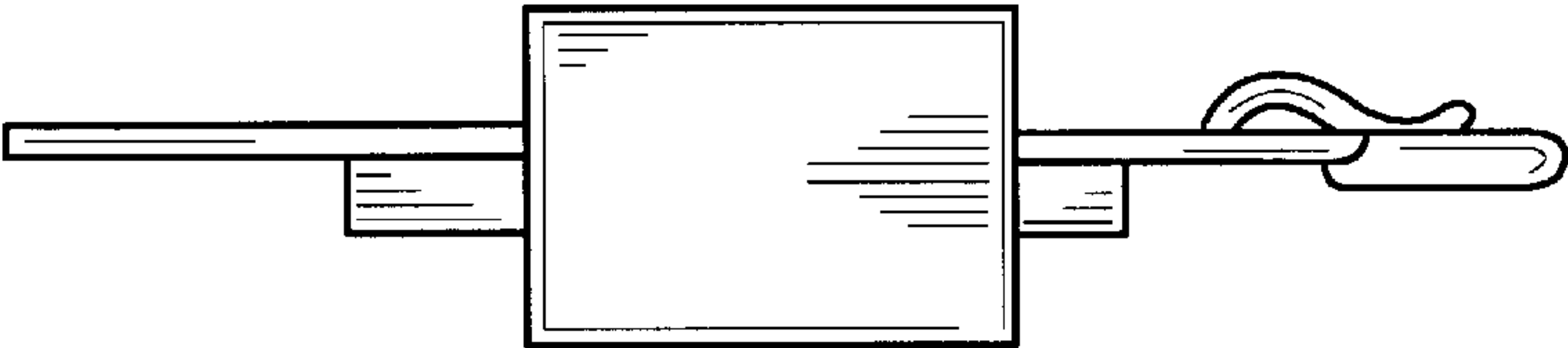

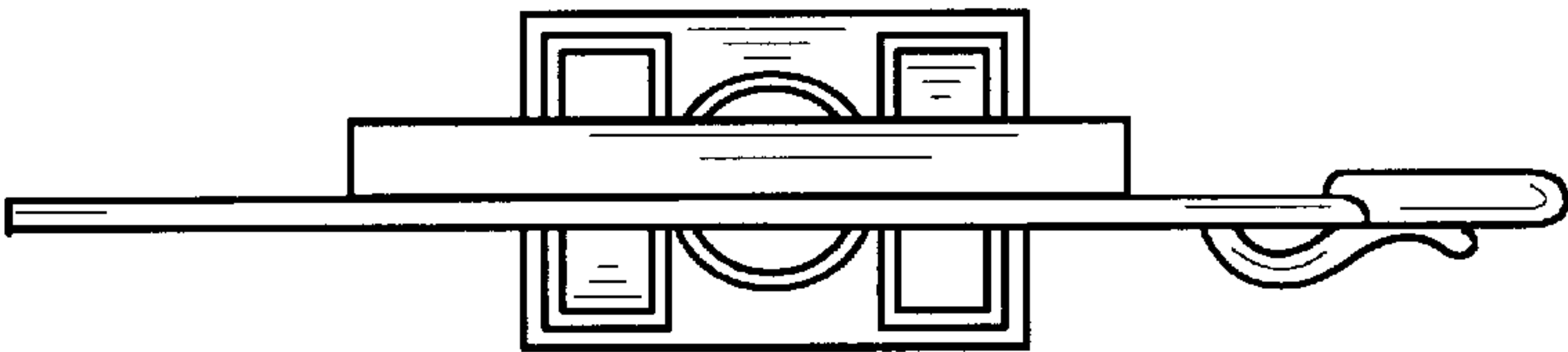
