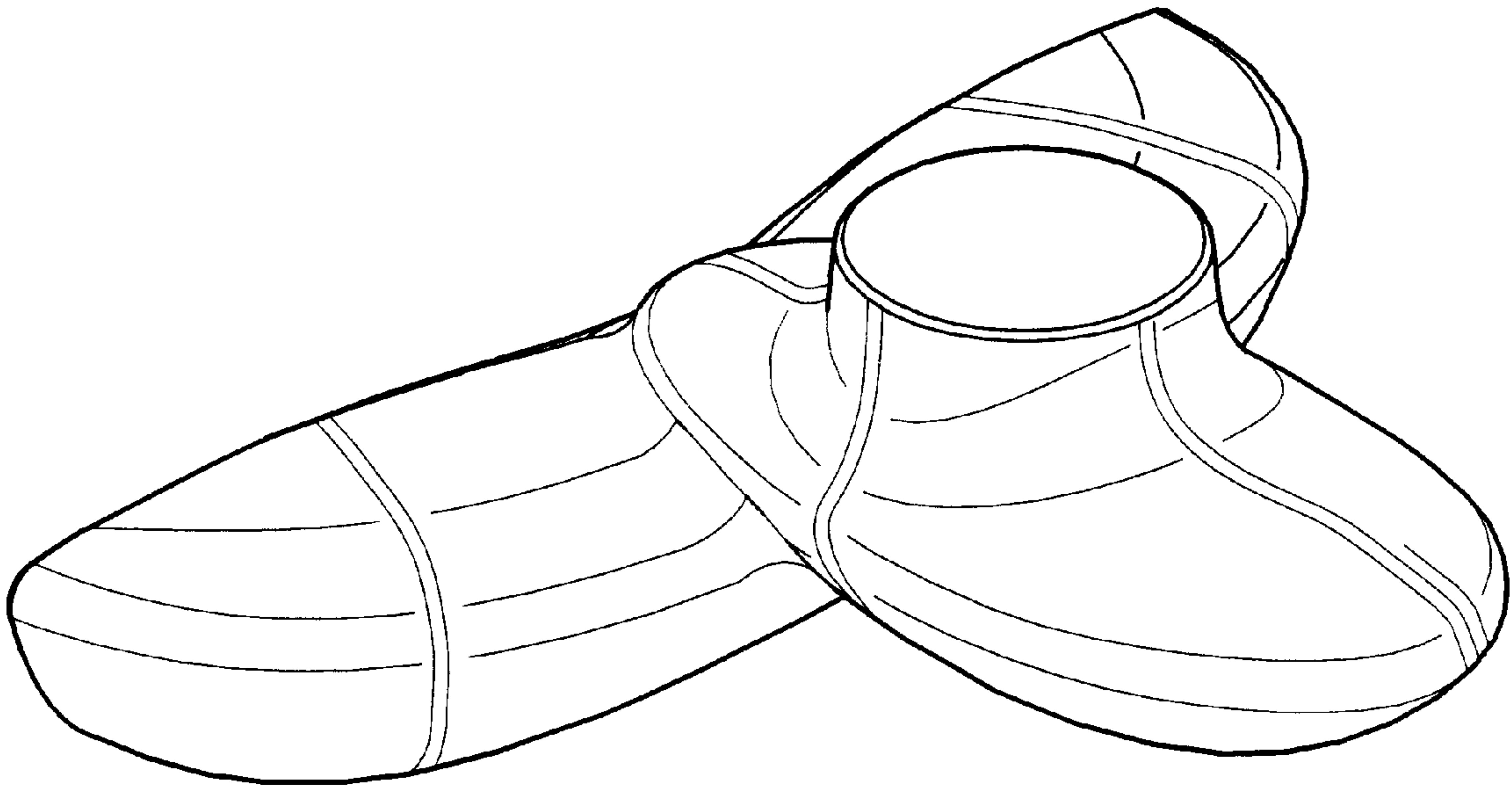
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tub/shower faucet body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a tub/shower faucet body showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view, the other side being a mirror image of the side shown.

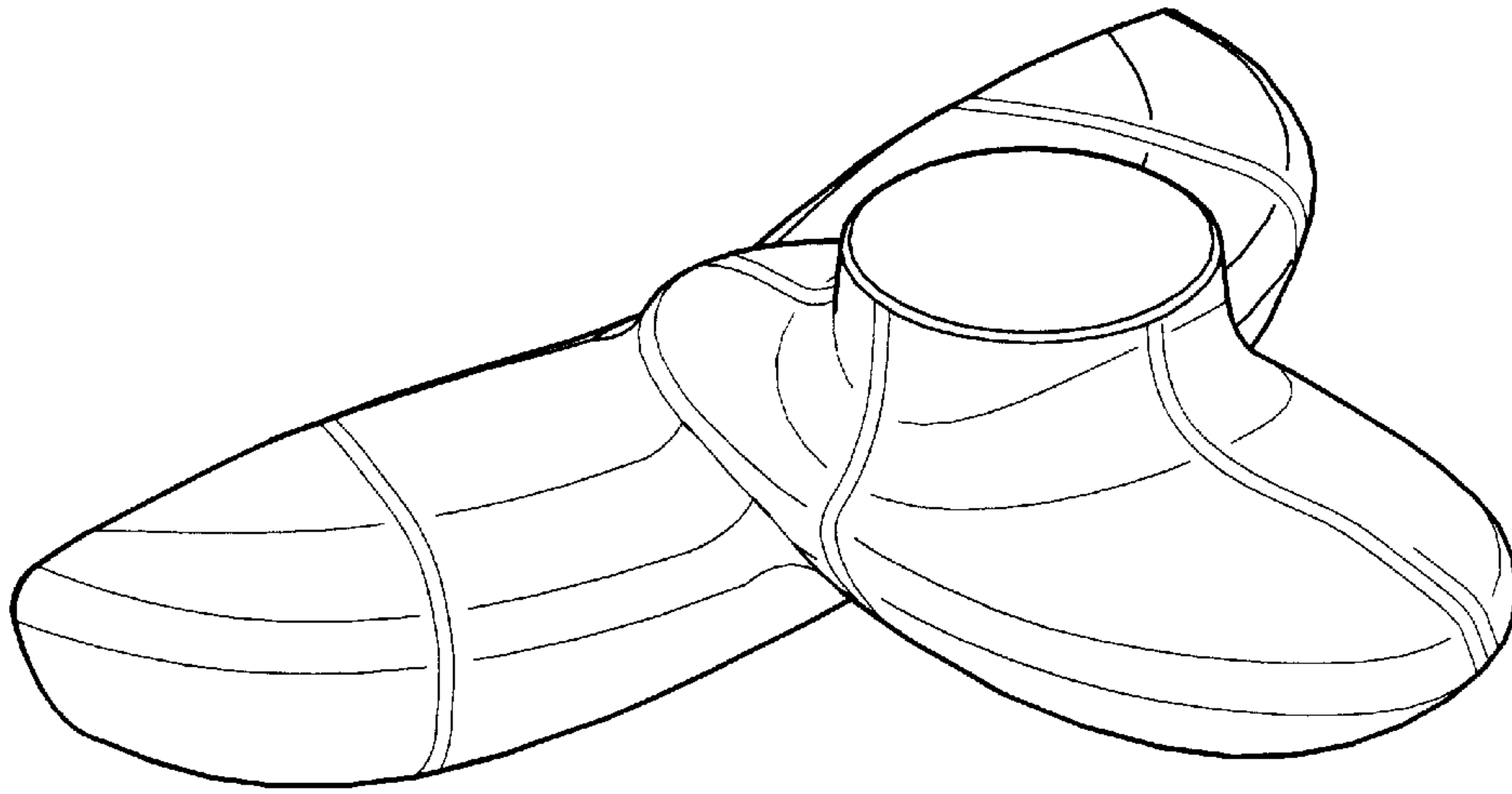

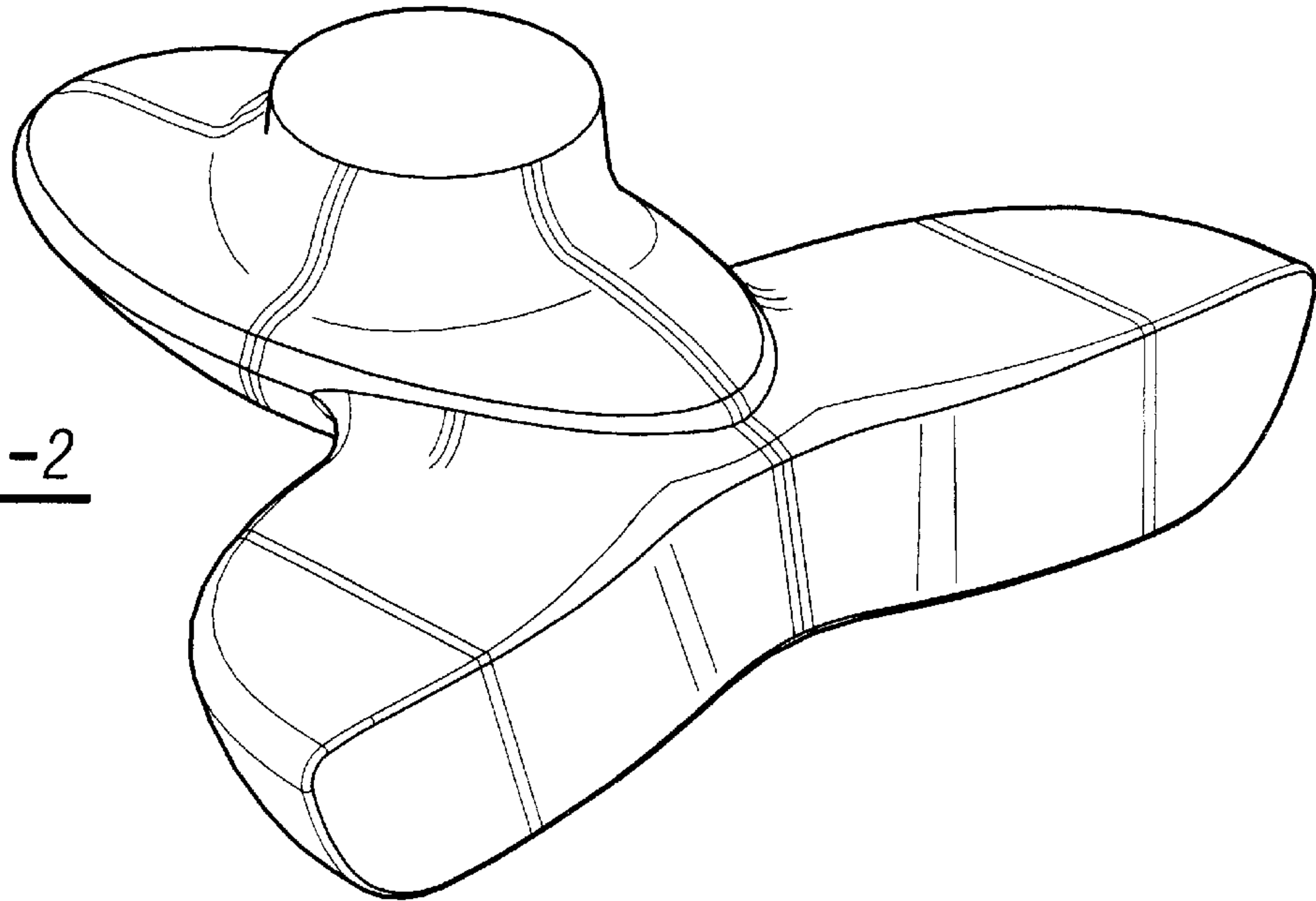

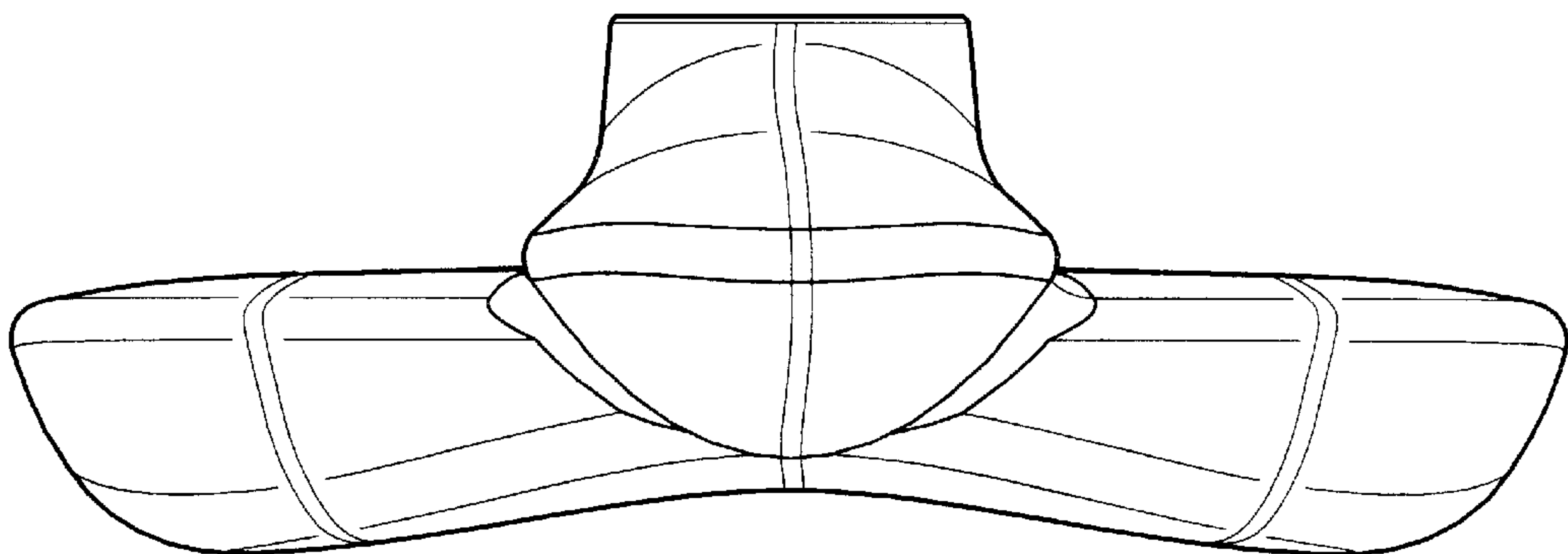

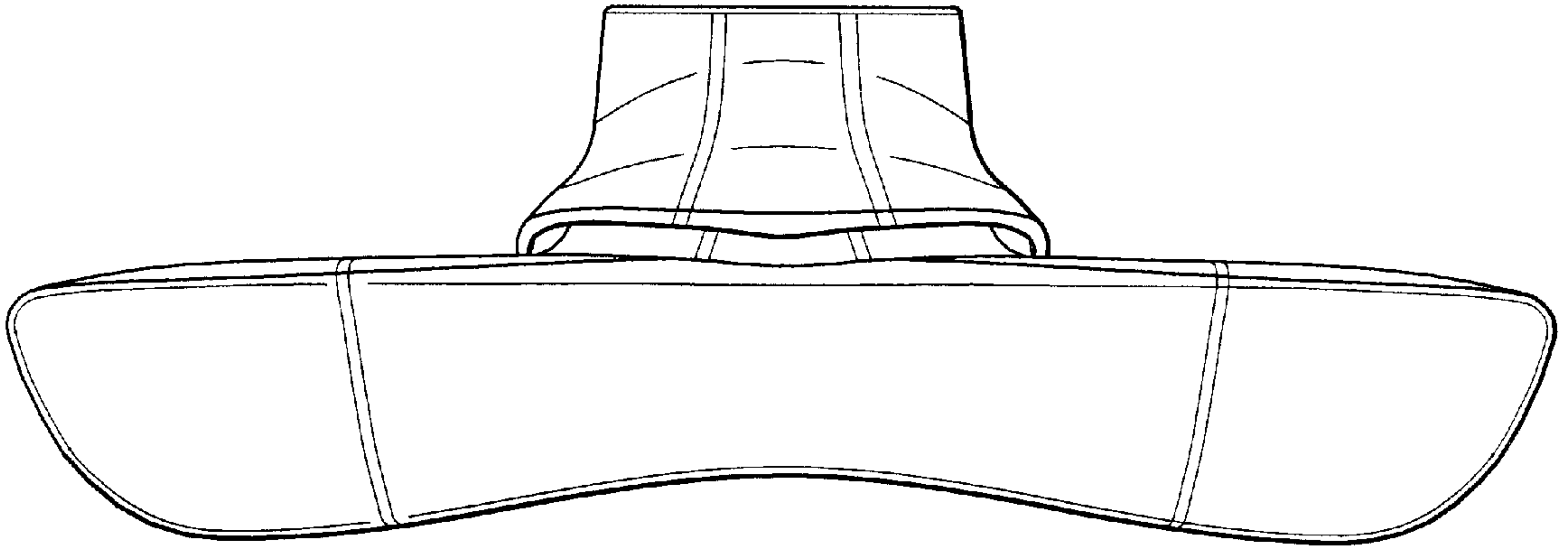

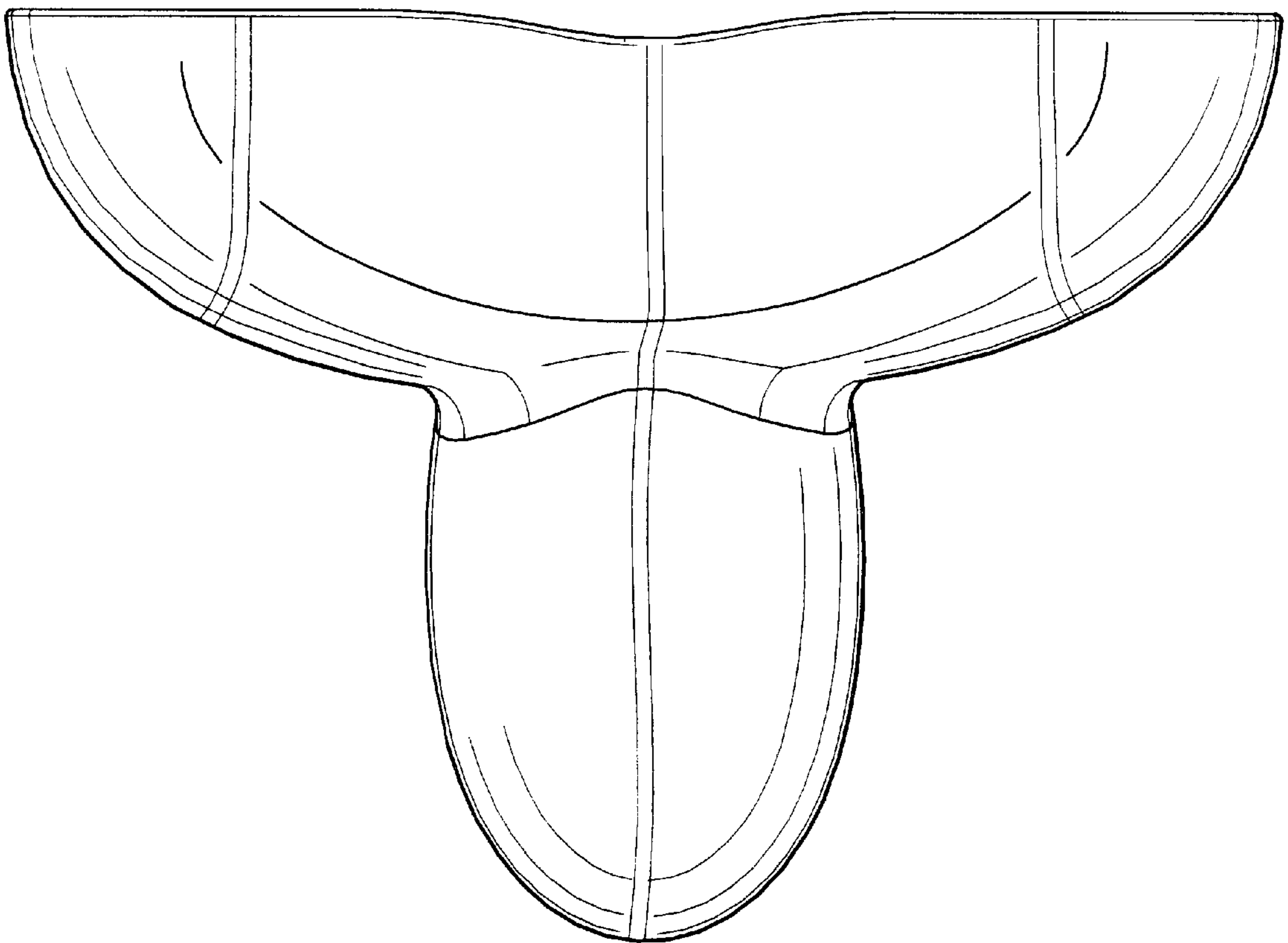

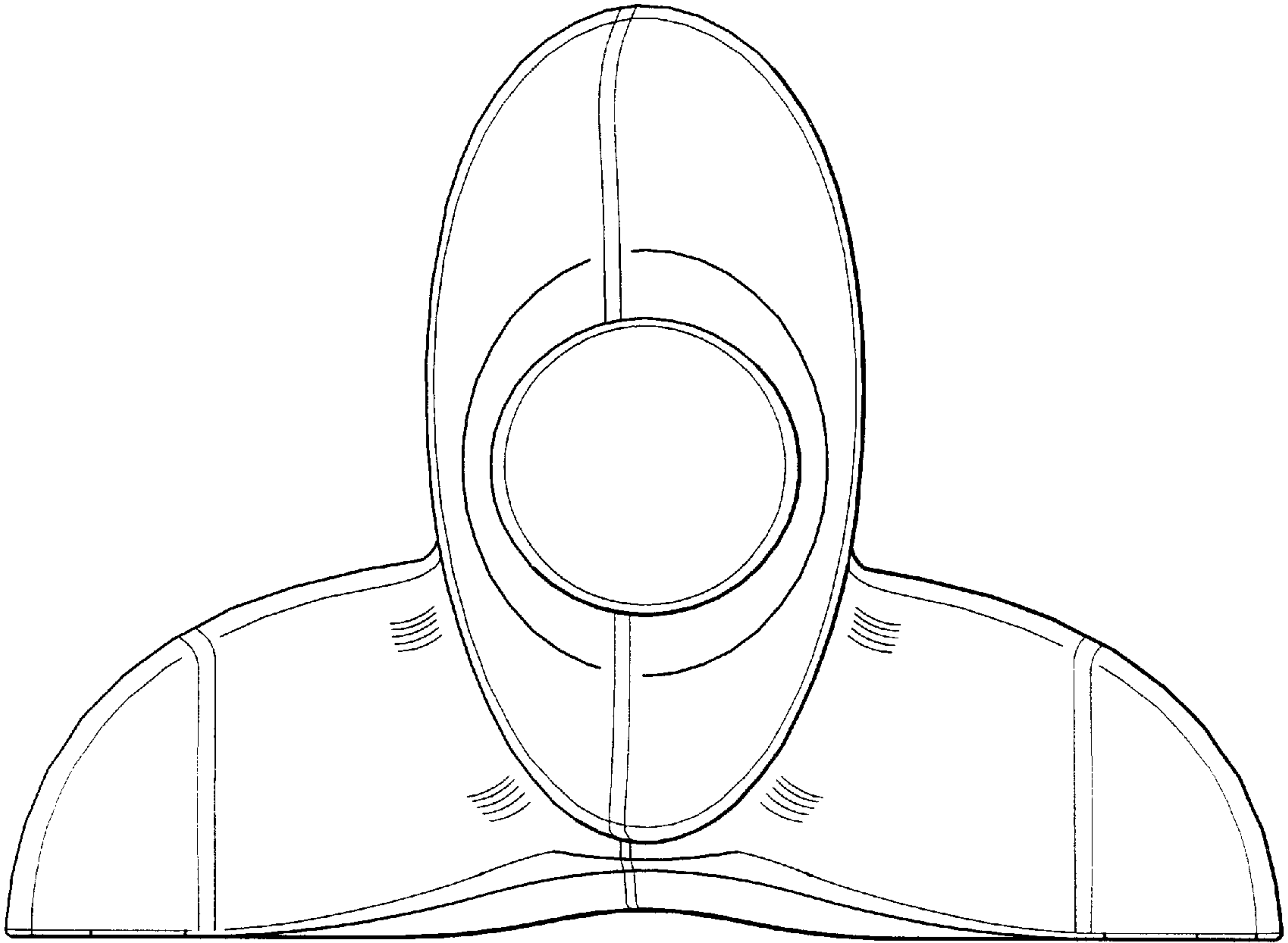

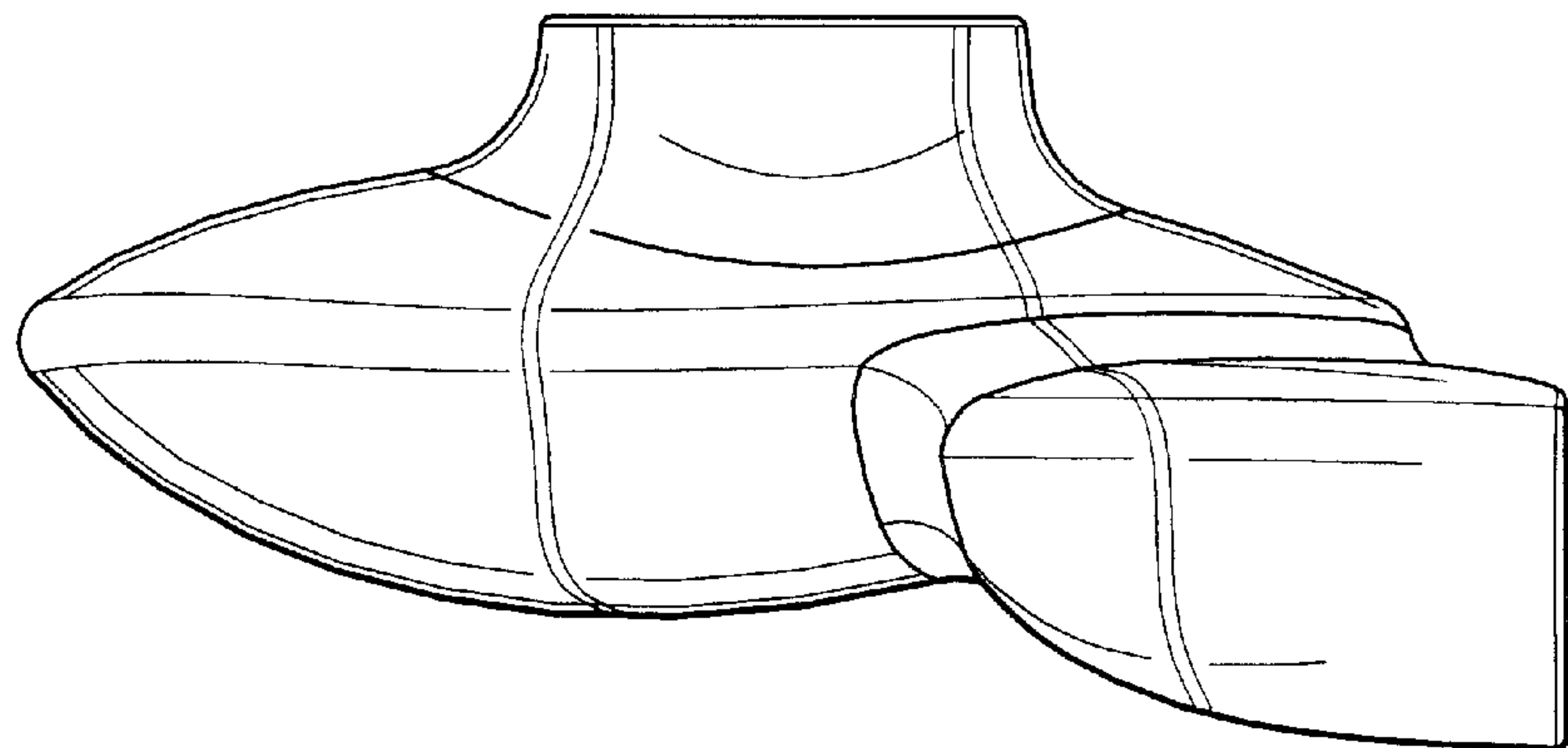
