#### **CLAIM** (57)

The ornamental design for sports beads, as shown and described.

### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing a first embodiment of my new design, a necklace of relatively small football-shaped beads having a relatively large football-shaped bead attached thereto as a pendant;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing the first embodiment of my new design, with the relatively large football-shaped bead turned backward;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing a second embodiment of my new design, a necklace of relatively small baseball-shaped beads having a relatively large baseball-shaped bead attached thereto as a pendant;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing the second embodiment of my new design, with the relatively large baseball-shaped bead turned sideways;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing a third embodiment of my new design, a necklace of relatively small basketball-shaped beads having a relatively large basketball-shaped bead attached thereto as a pendant;

FIG. 6 is another perspective view of a sports beads showing the third embodiment of my new design, with the relatively large basketball-shaped bead turned differently from the first view;

FIG. 7 is another perspective view of a sports beads showing the third embodiment of my new design, with the relatively large basketball-shaped bead turned from the other views;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing a fourth embodiment of my new design, a necklace of relatively small soccer ball-shaped beads having a relatively large soccer ball-shaped bead attached thereto as a pendant; FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing a fifth embodiment of my new design, a necklace of relatively small football-shaped beads;

FIG. 10 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing a sixth embodiment of my new design, a necklace of relatively small baseball-shaped beads;

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a sports beads showing a seventh embodiment of my new design, a necklace of relatively small basketball-shaped beads; and,








