(57) **CLAIM**

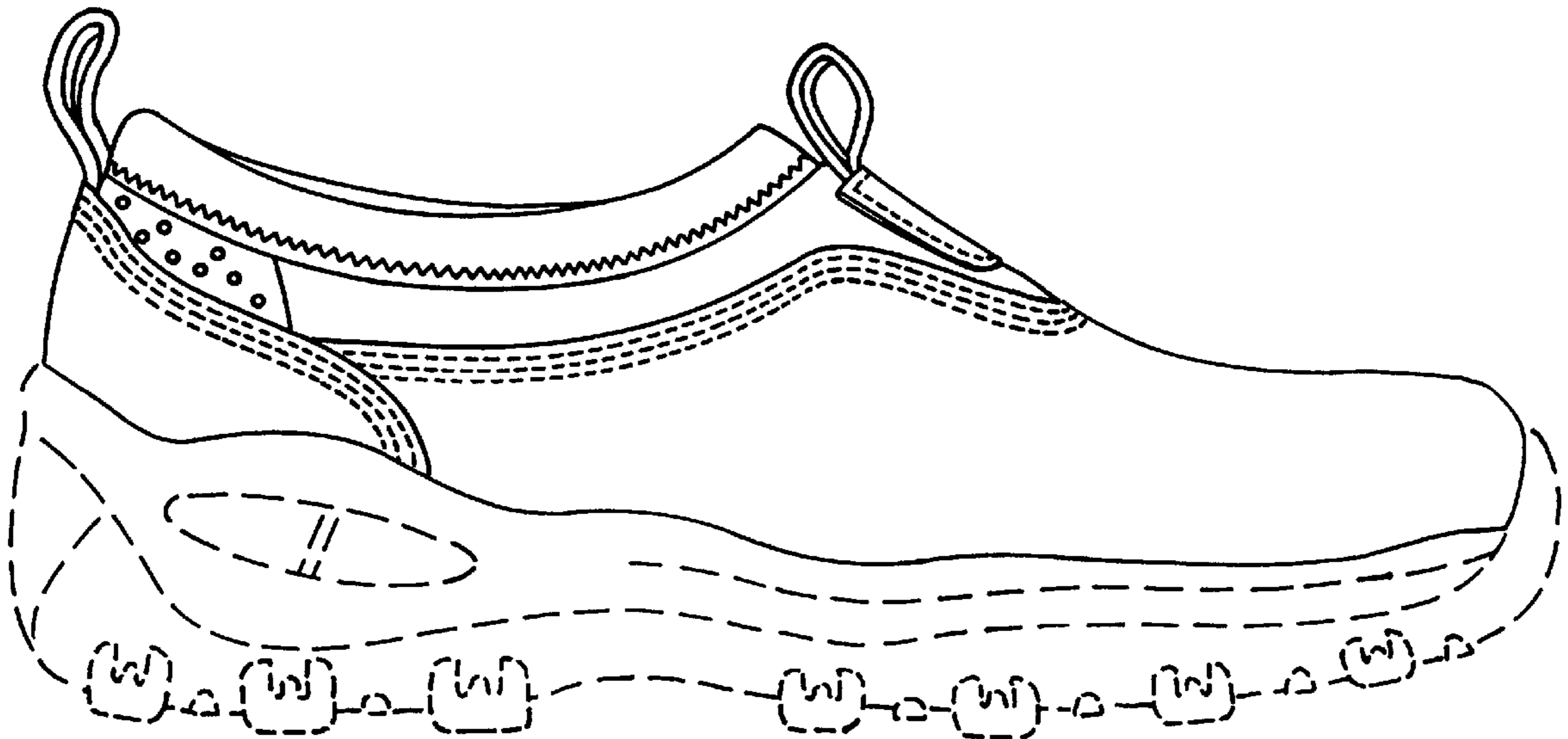
The ornamental design for a shoe upper, as shown as described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left elevation view of the shoe upper; FIG. 2 is a right elevation view of the shoe upper; FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the shoe upper; FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the shoe upper; and, FIG. 5 is a top view of the shoe upper.

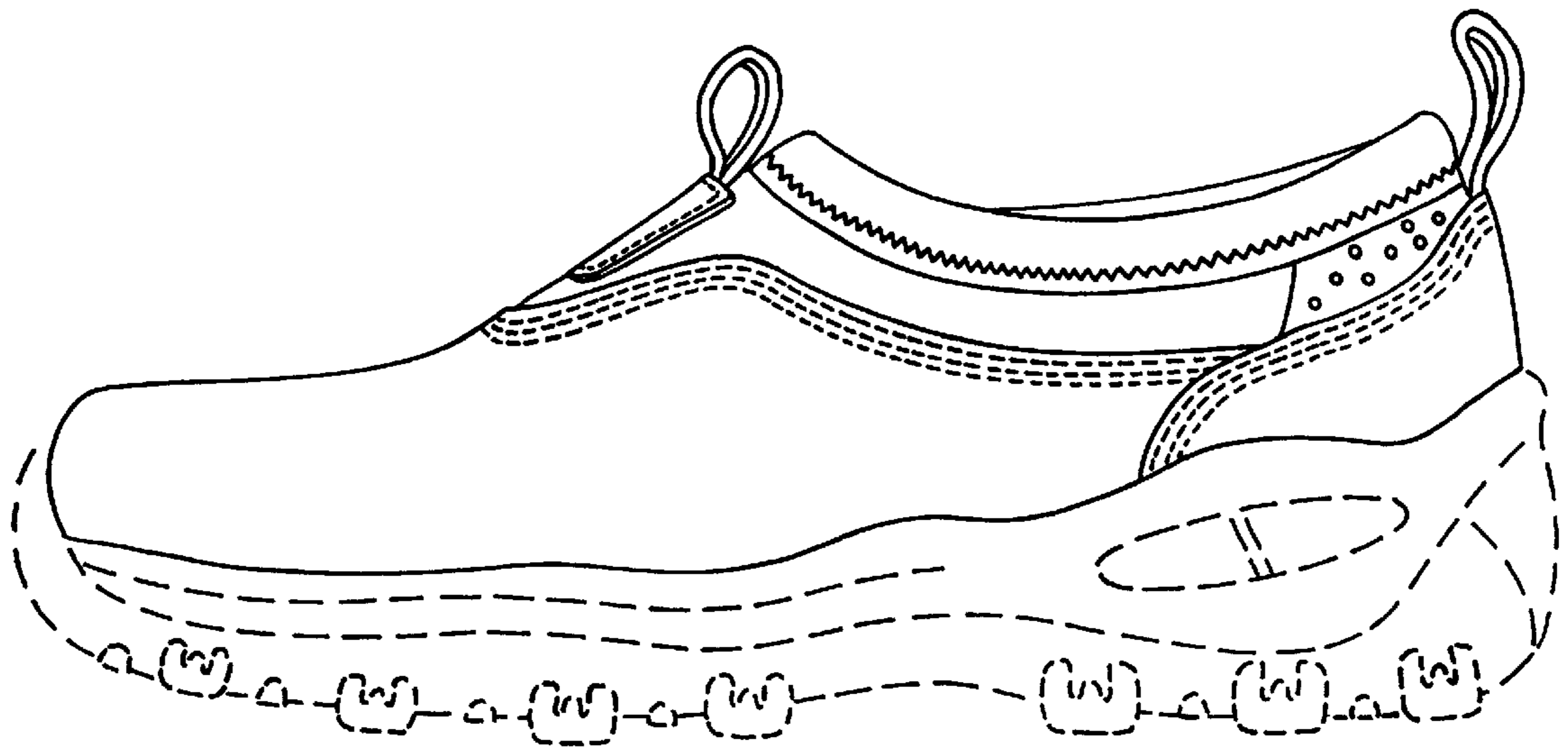

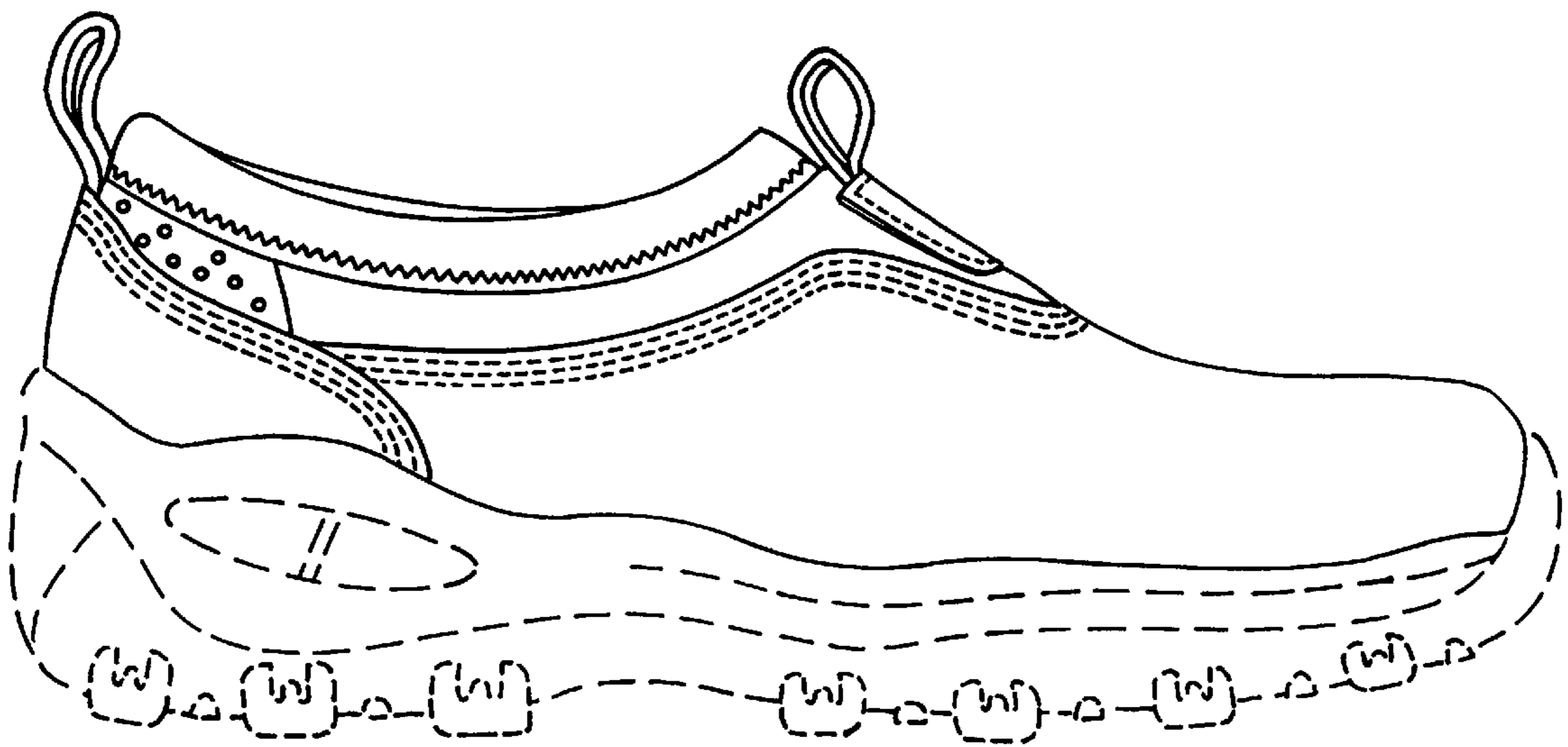

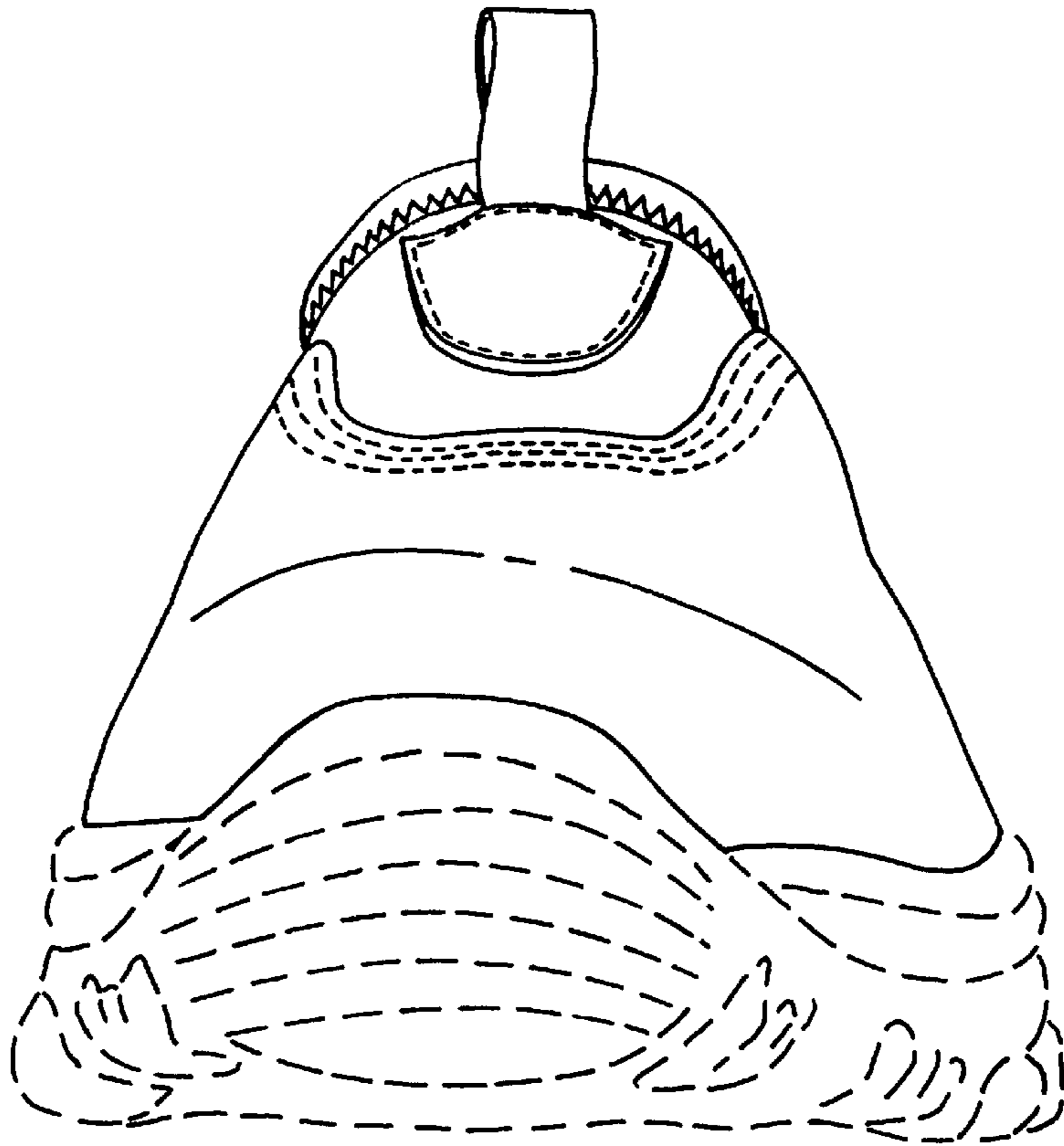

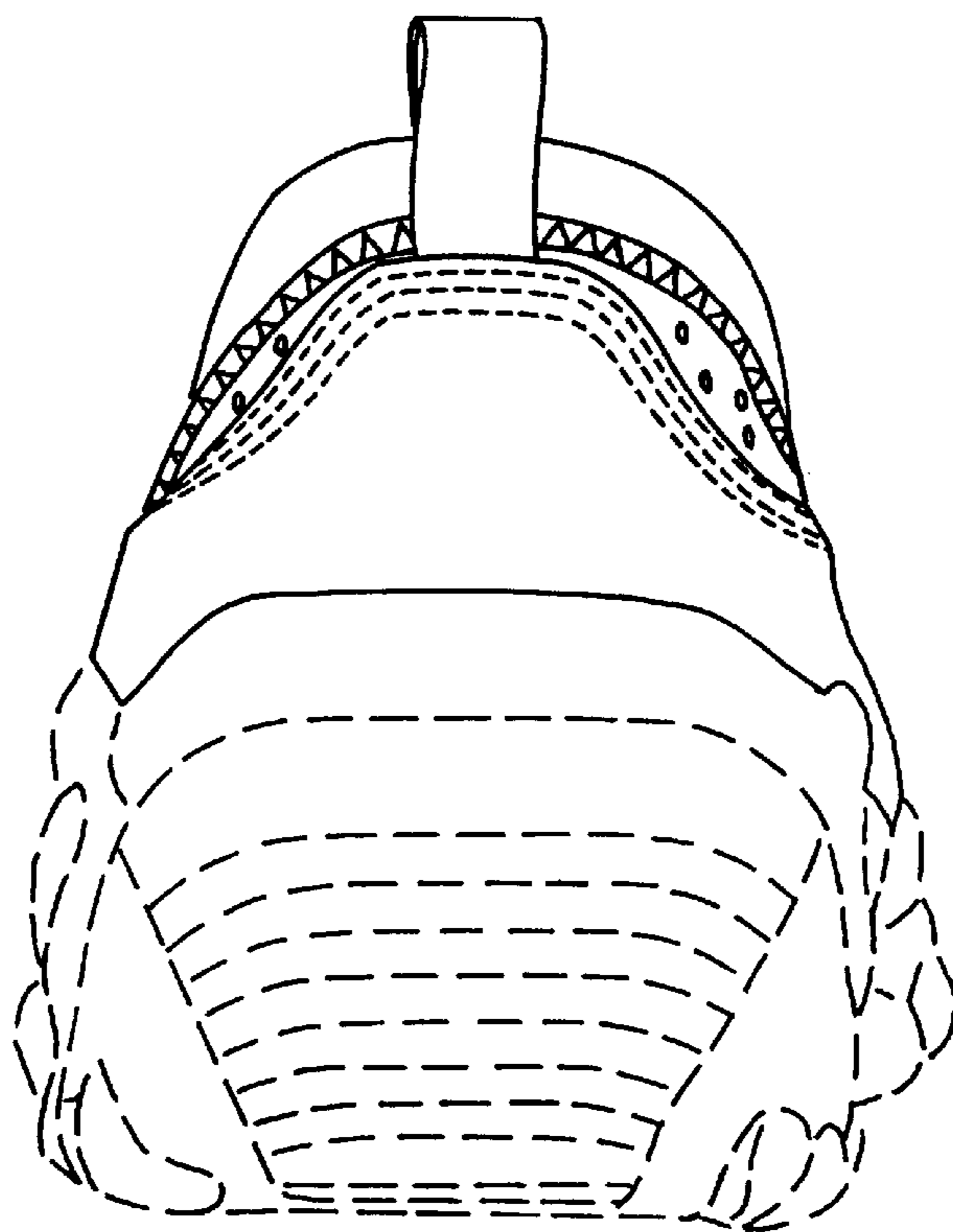
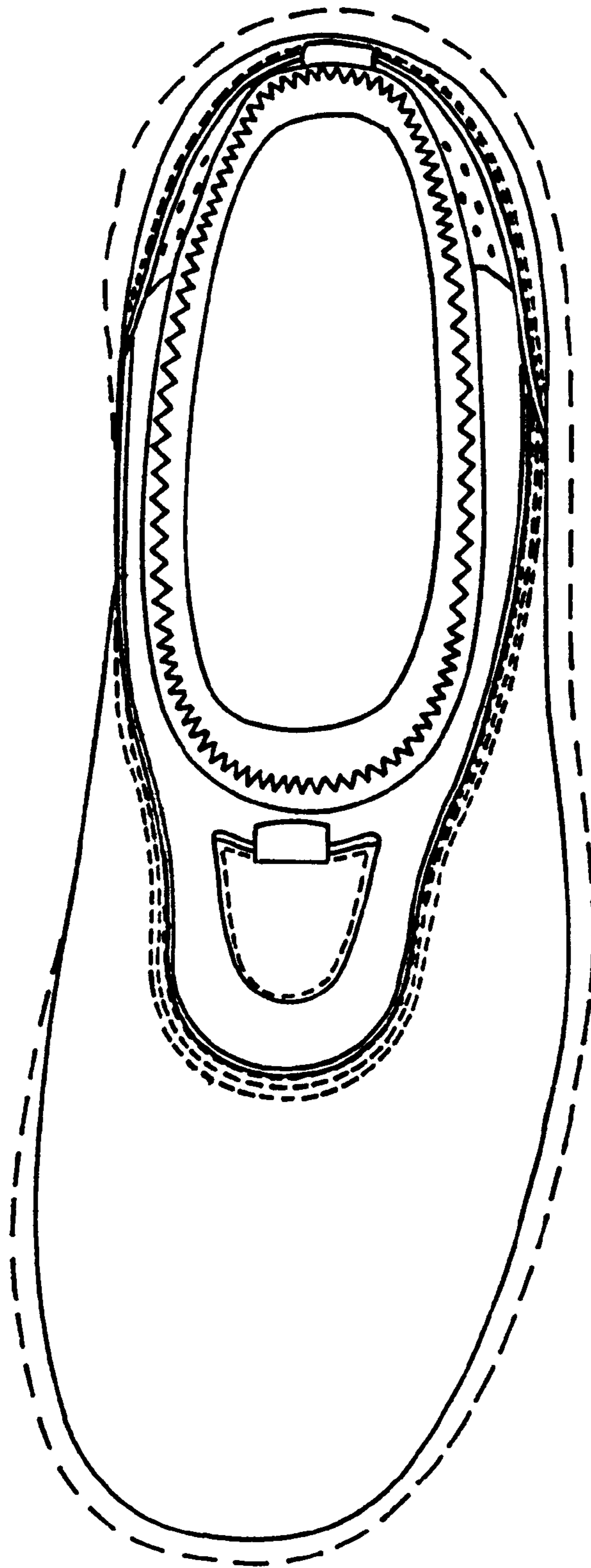
