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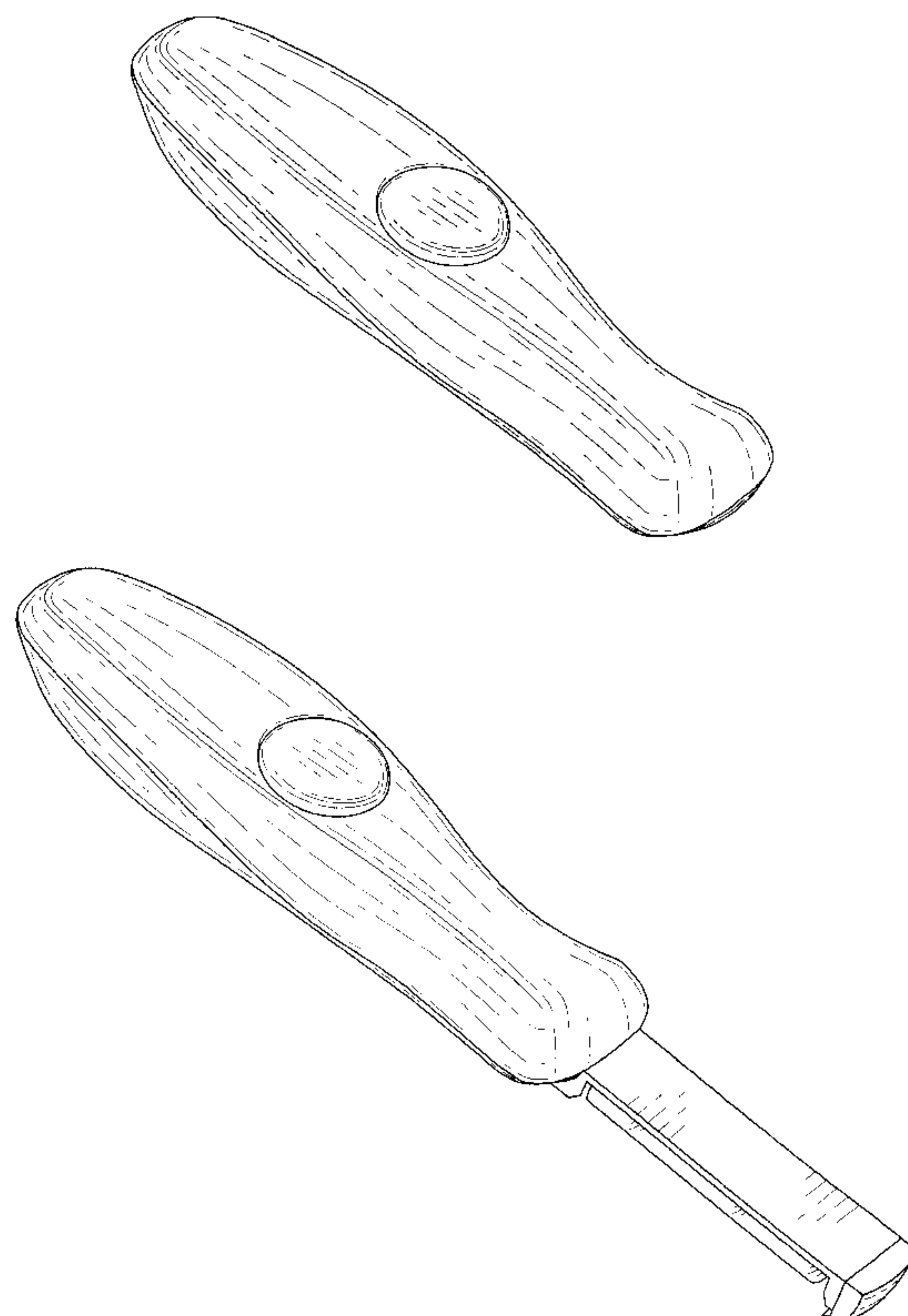
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a retractible peeler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a retractible peeler showing our new design with the blade in a closed position; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof. FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof. FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof and the left side is a mirror image of the right side. FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof. FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof. FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof with the blade in an extended position; FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof. FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof. FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof and the left side is a mirror image of the right side. FIG. 11 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof.

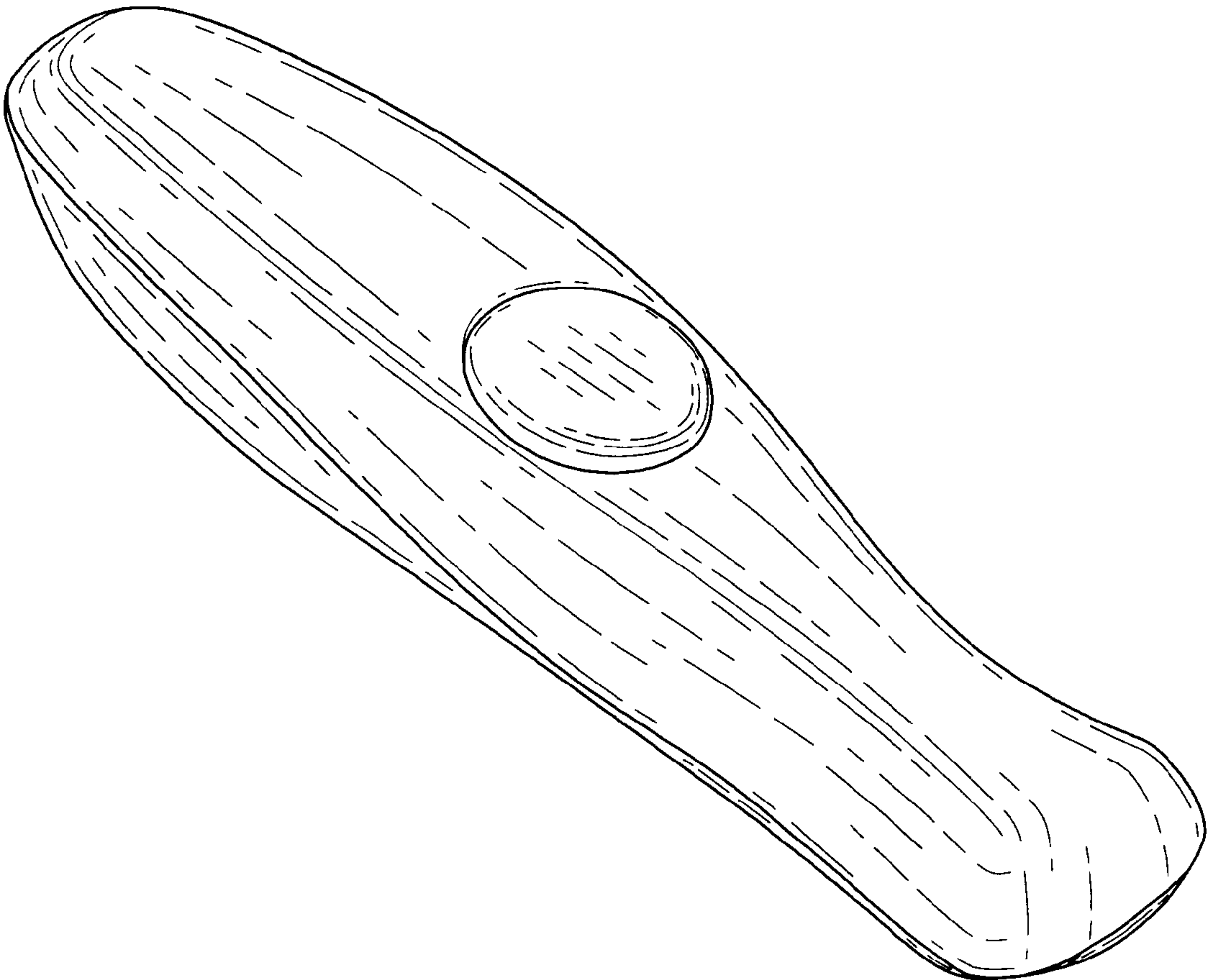

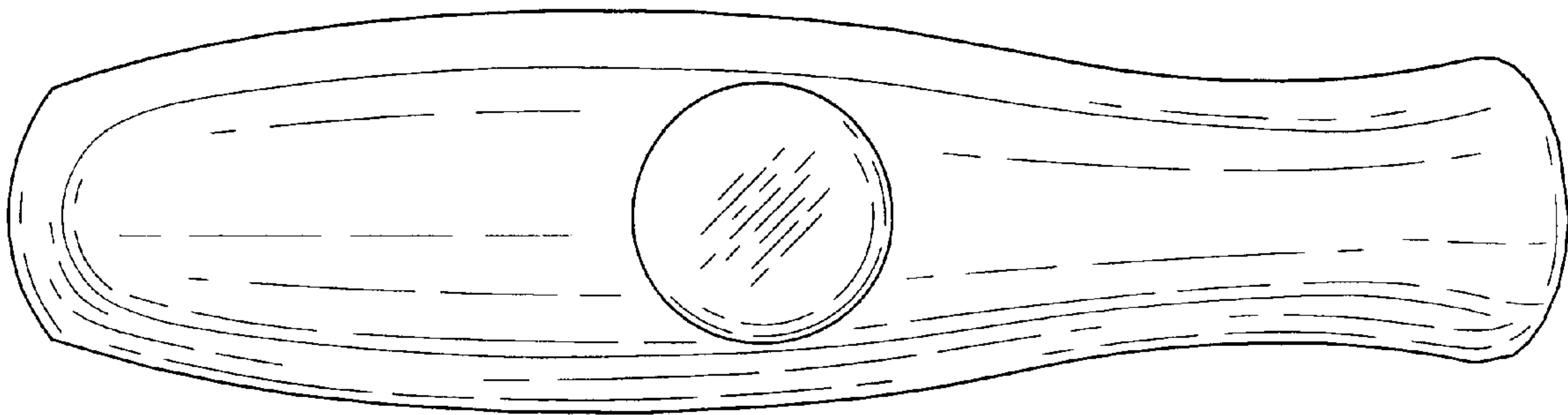

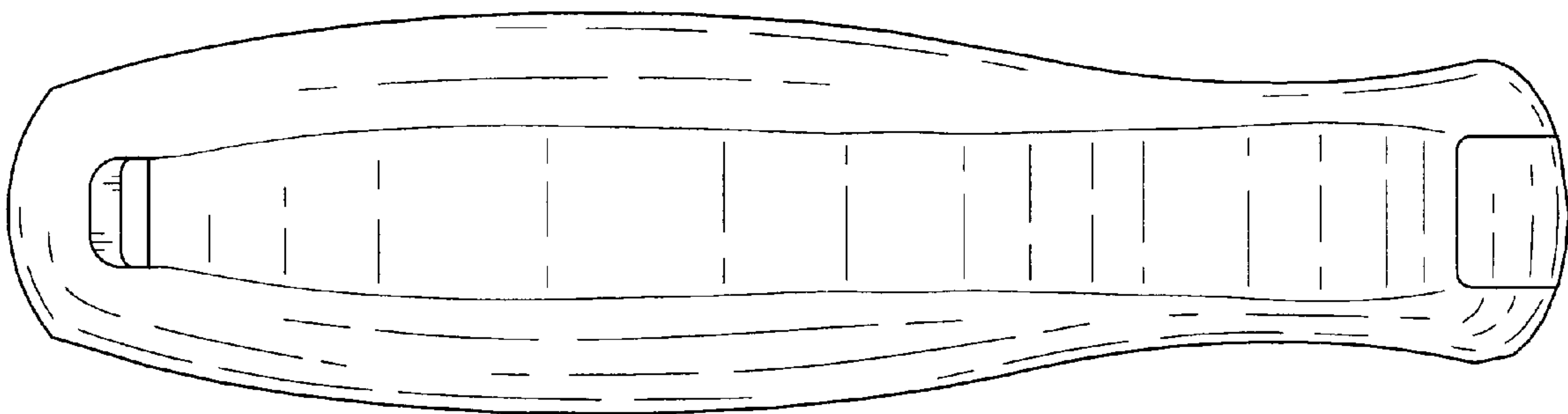

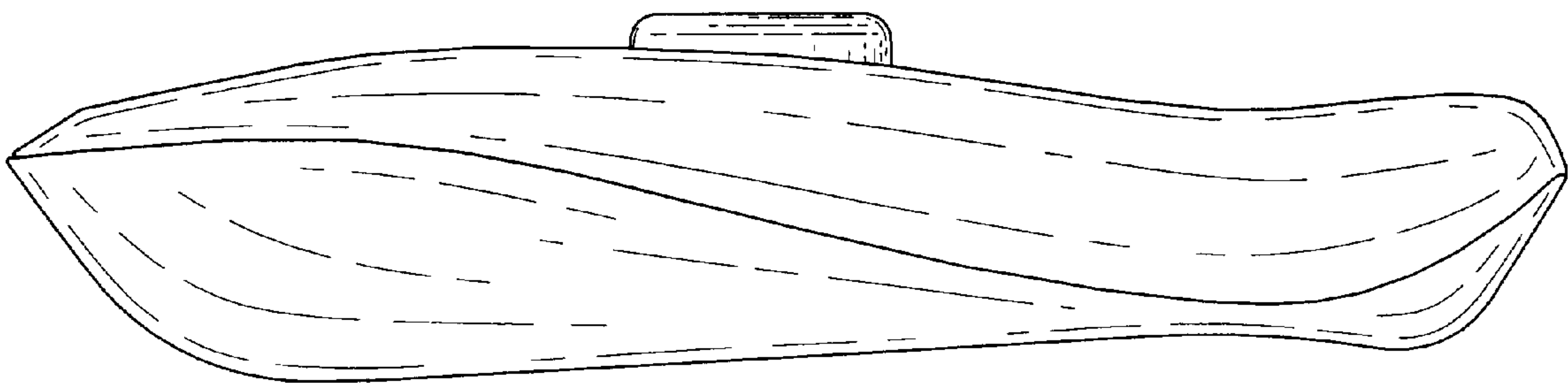

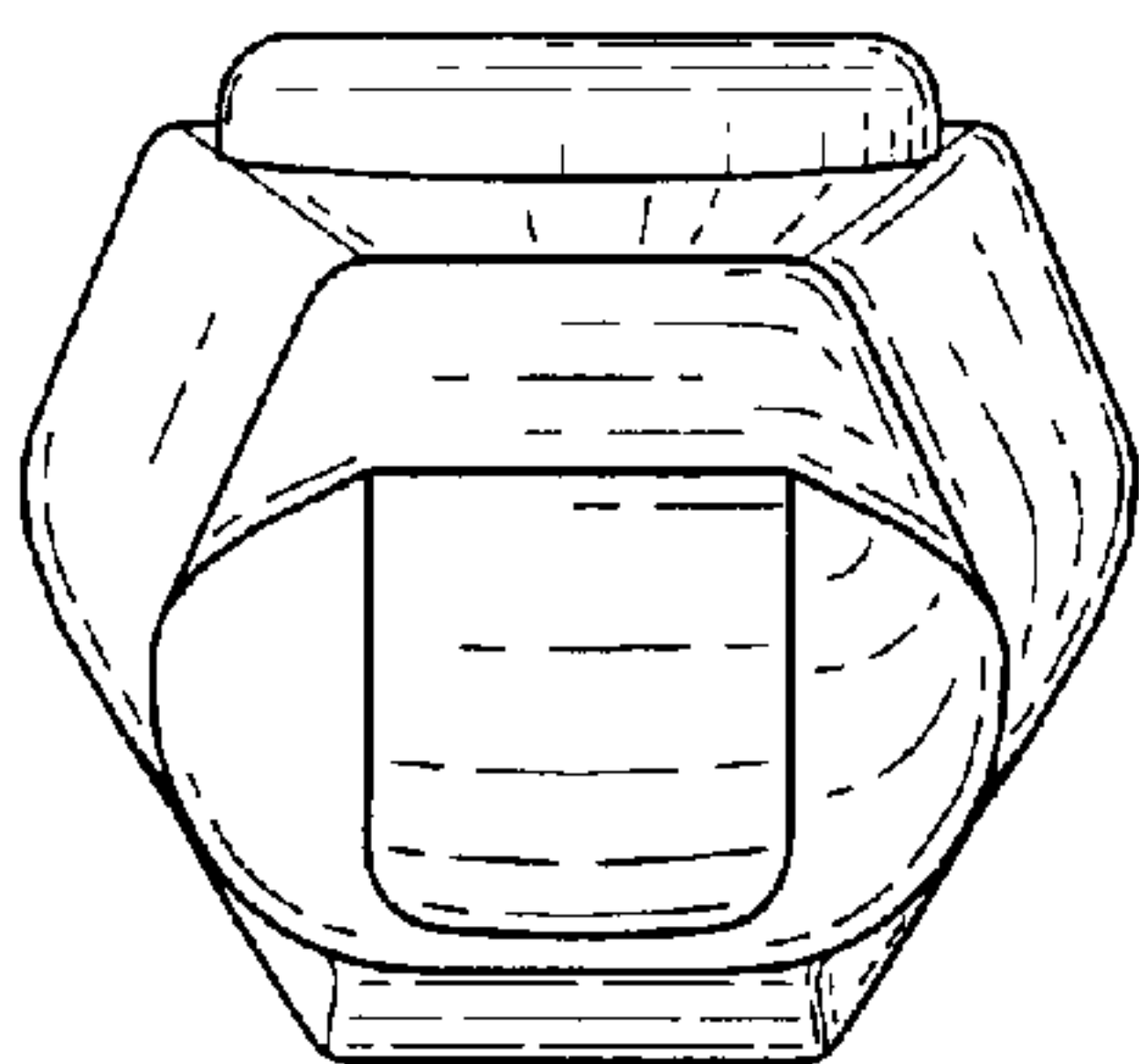

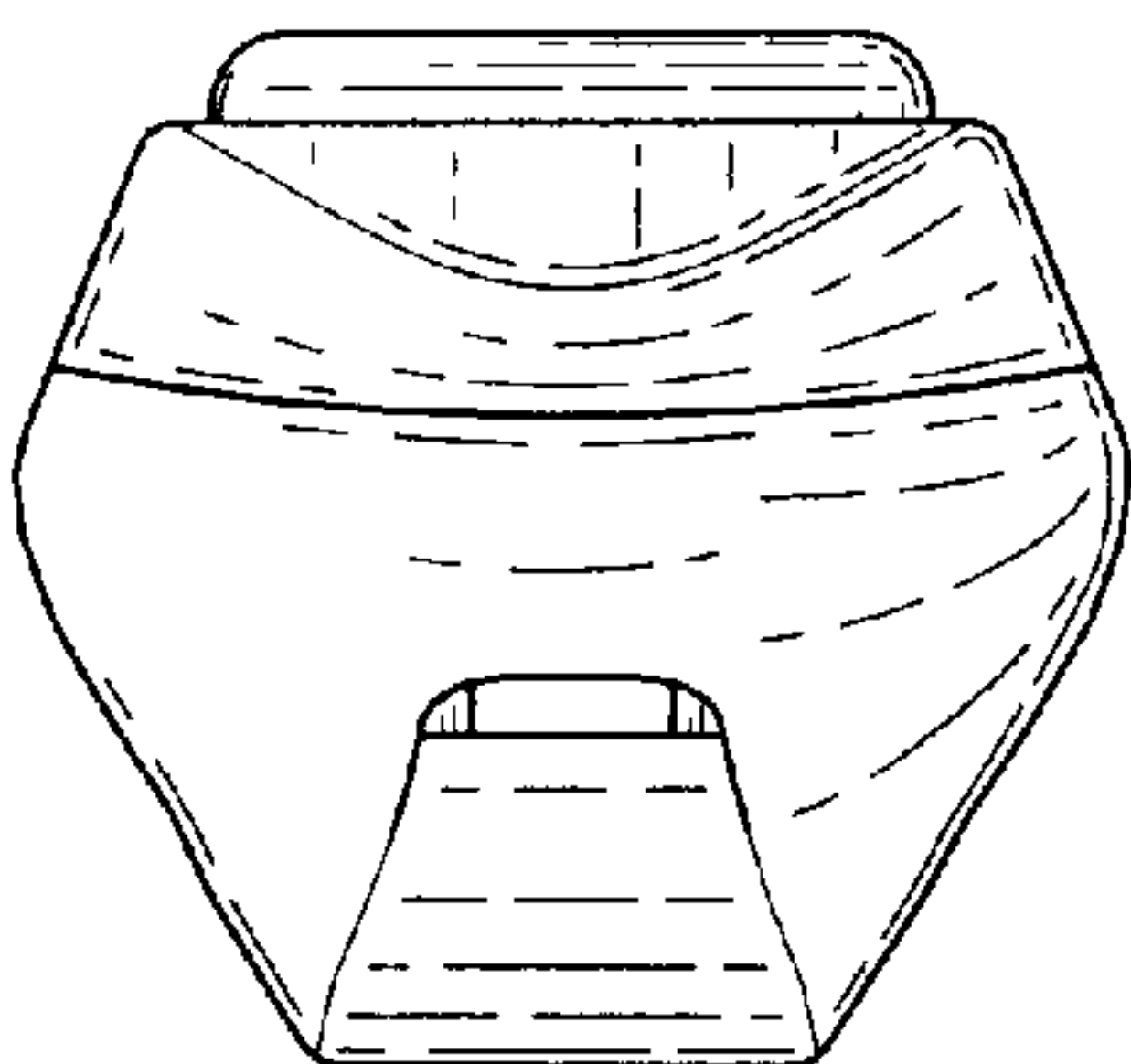

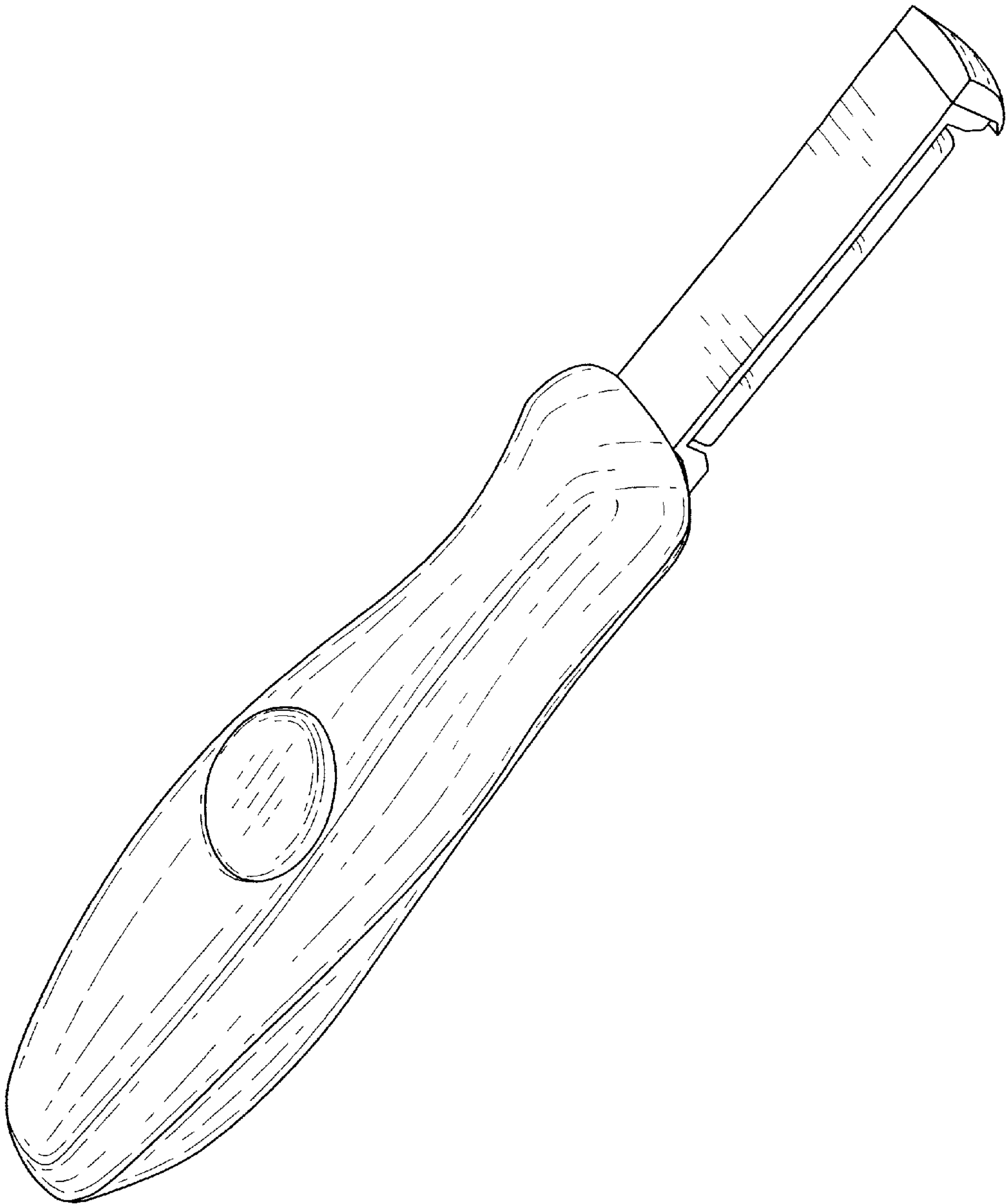

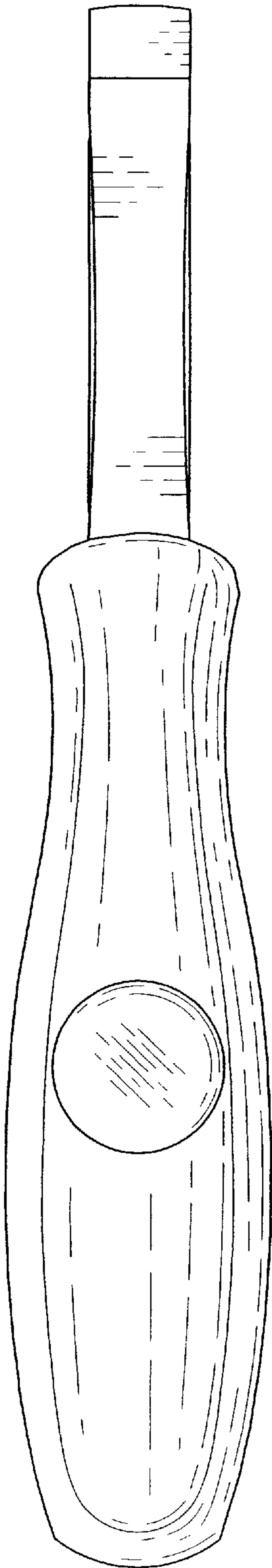

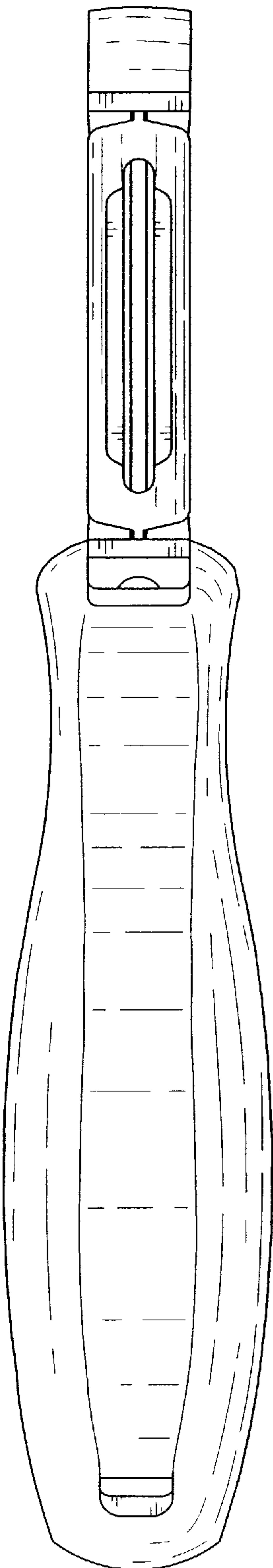

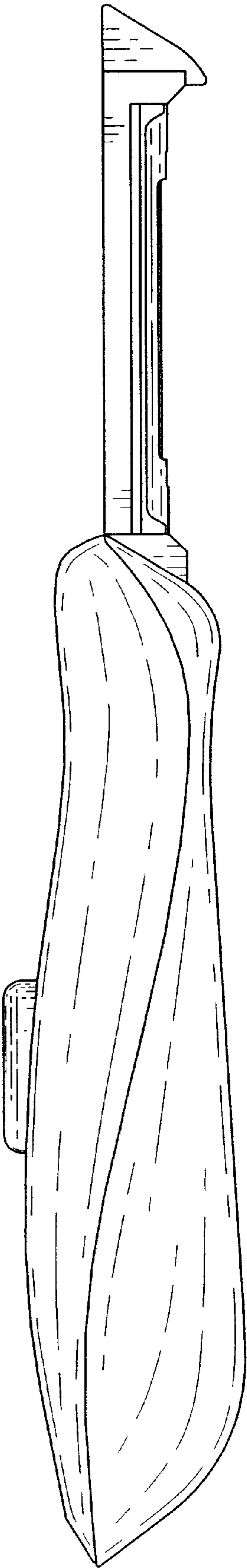

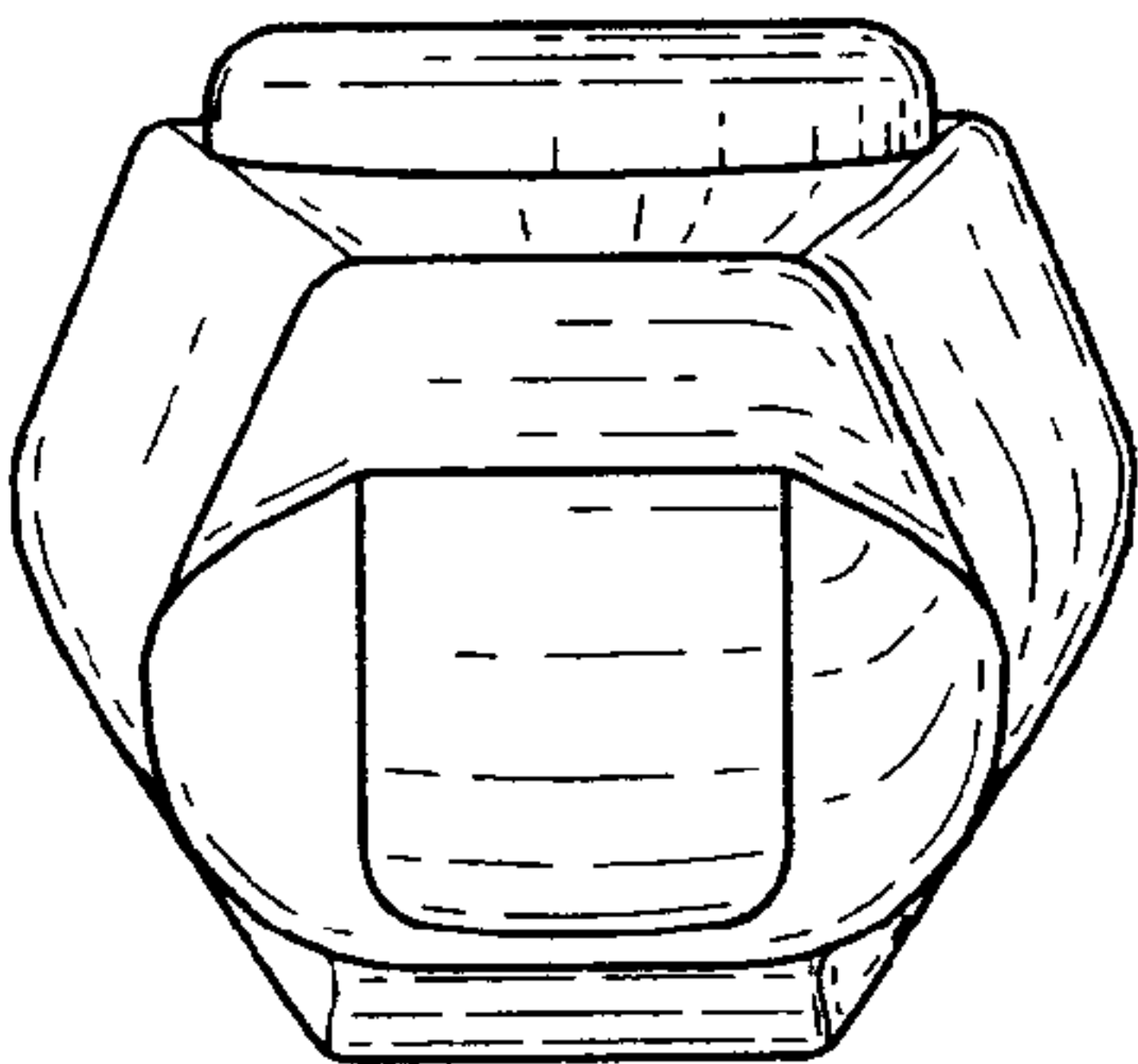

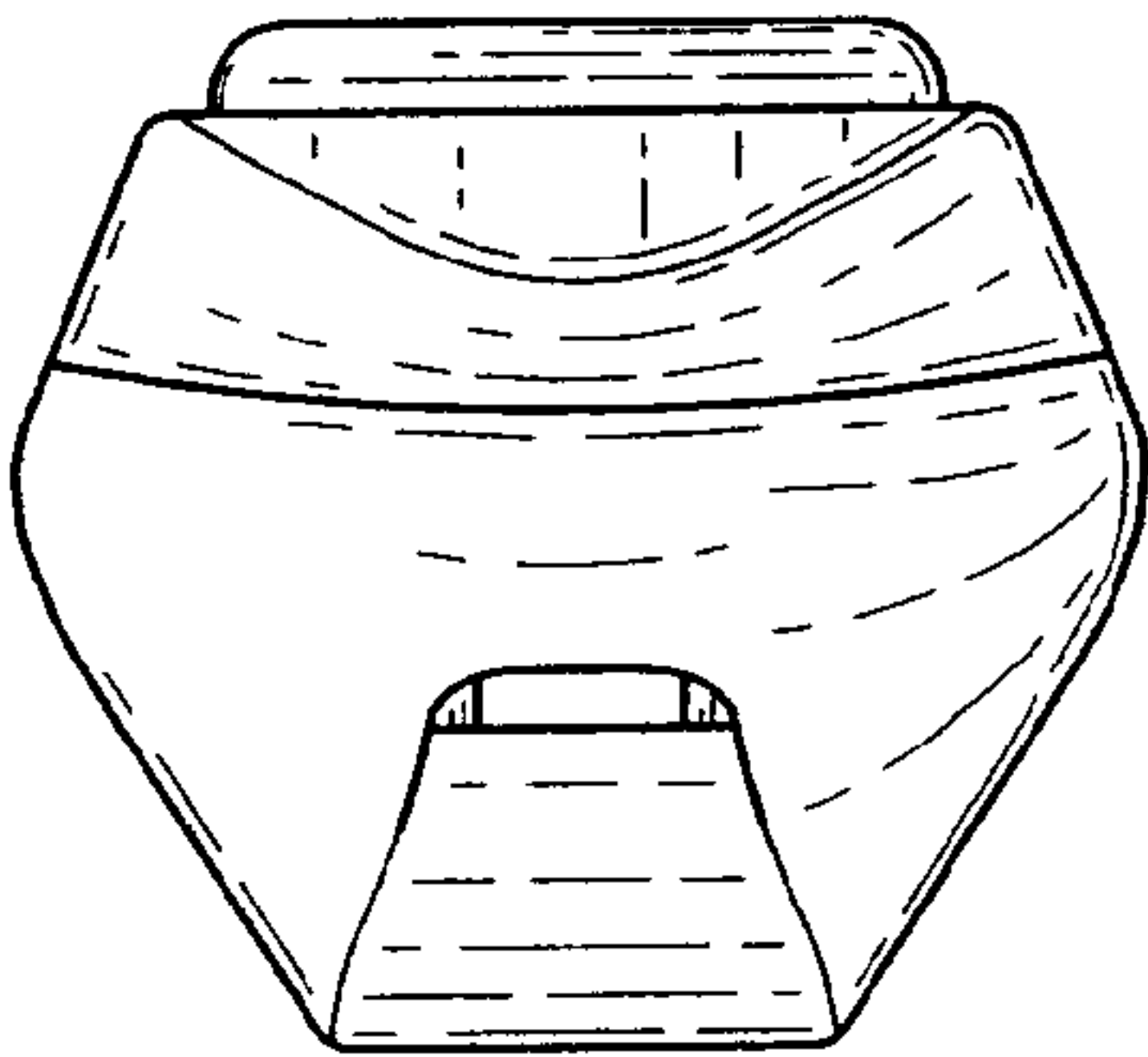
