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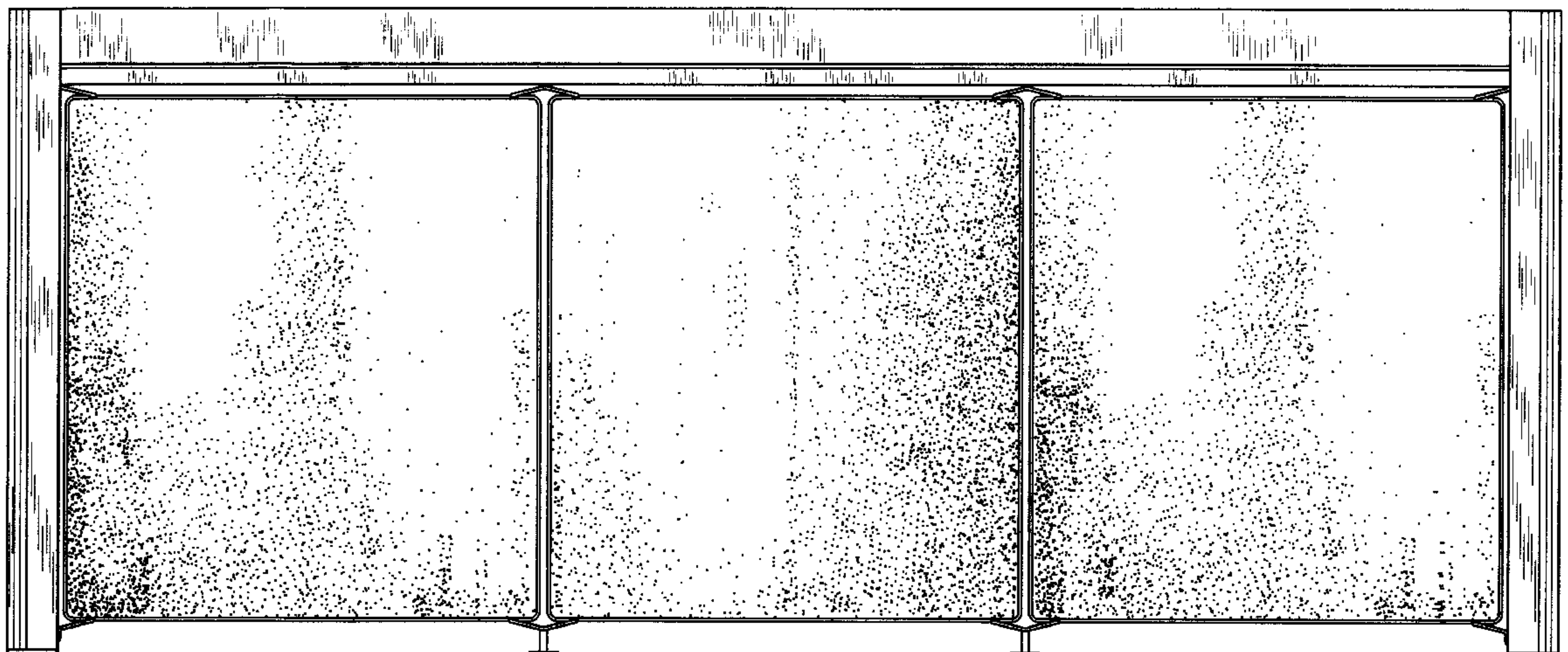
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is front elevational view of a serpentine panel, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged end elevational view;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of an upper left-hand portion of the serpentine panel;

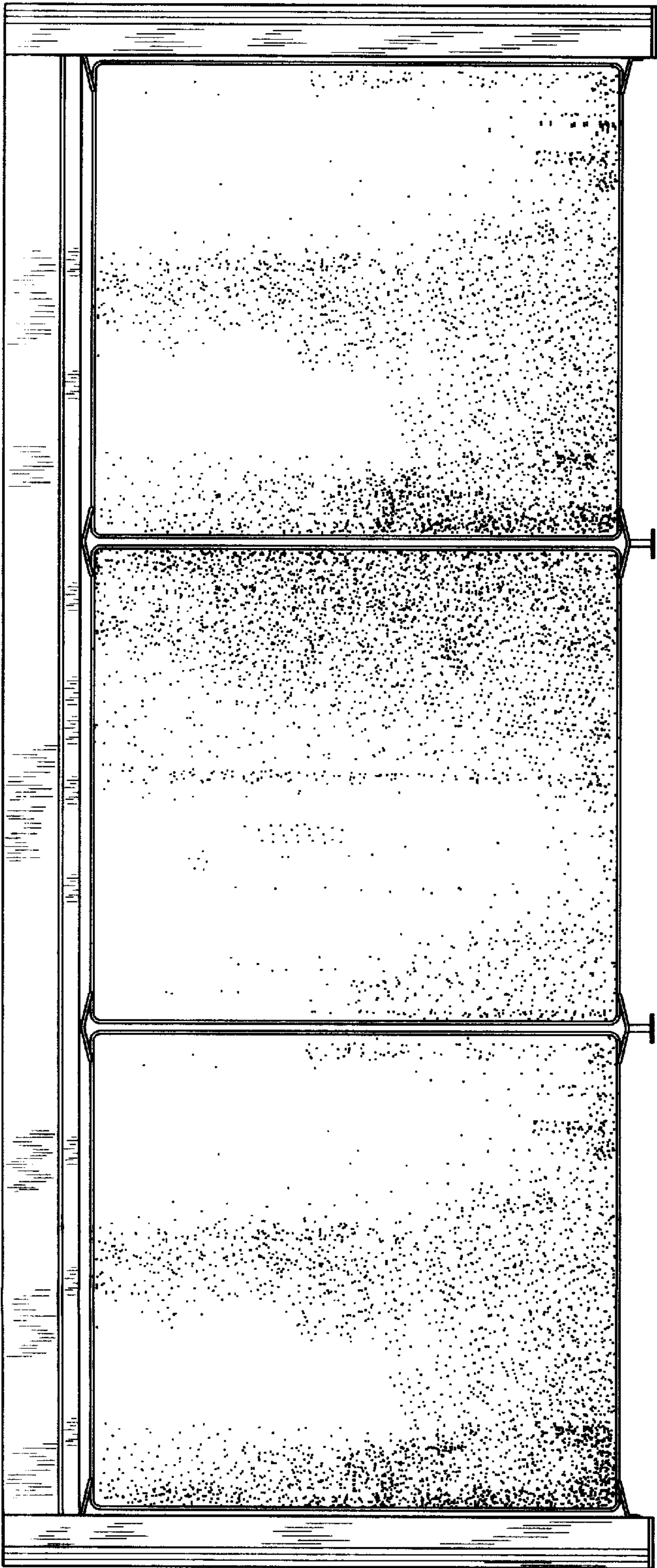

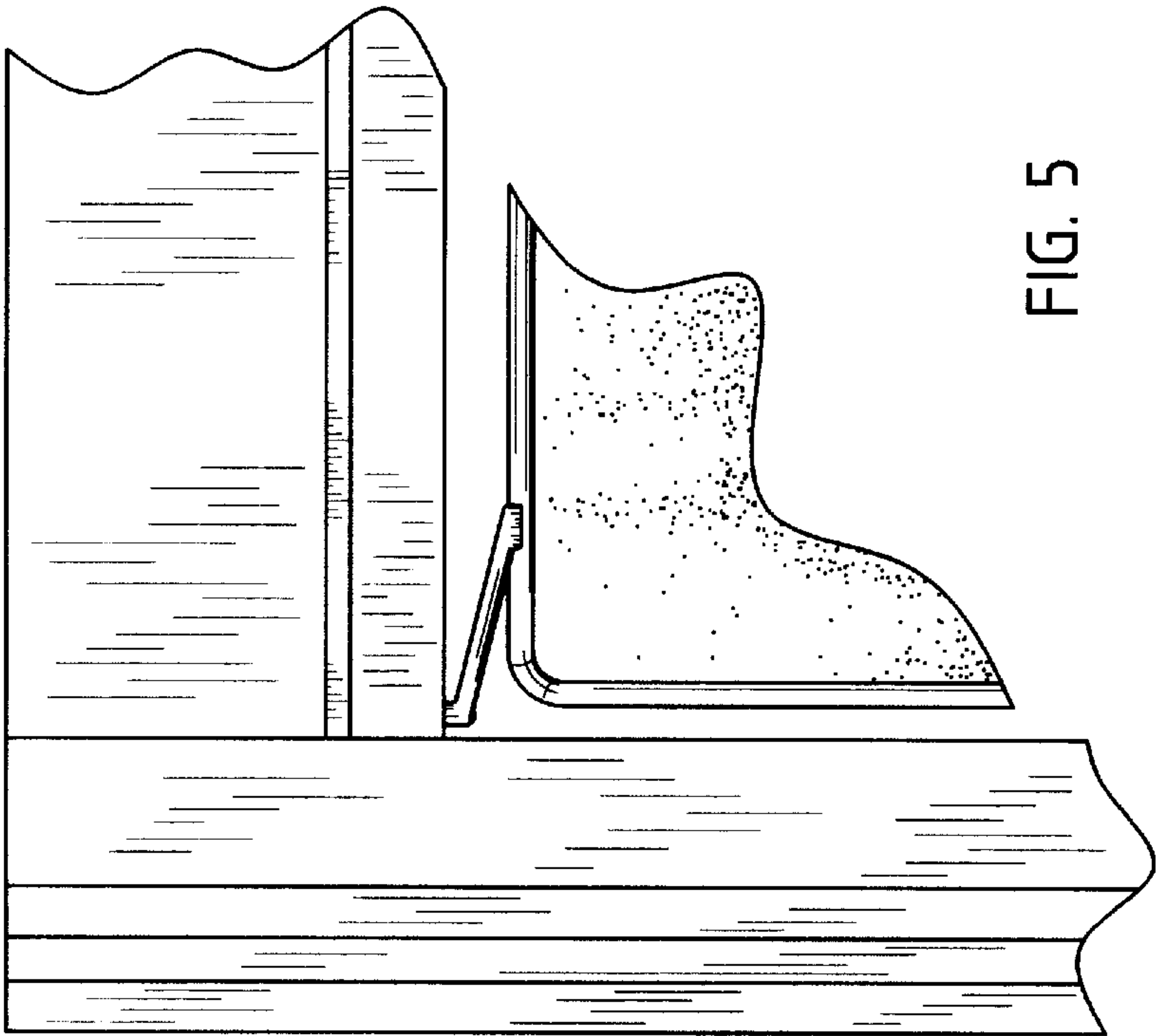

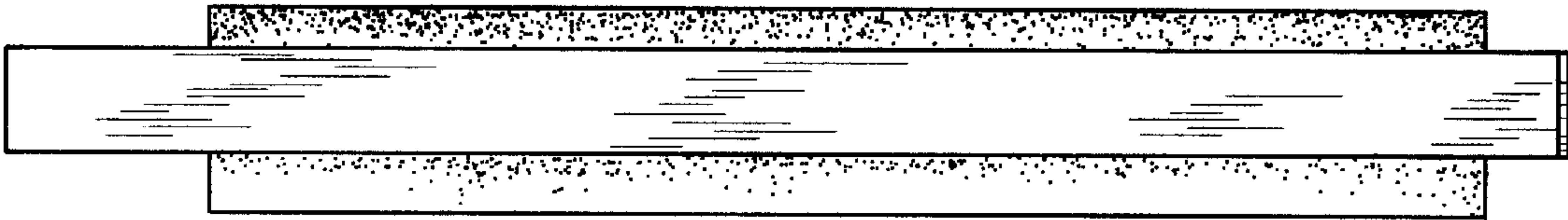

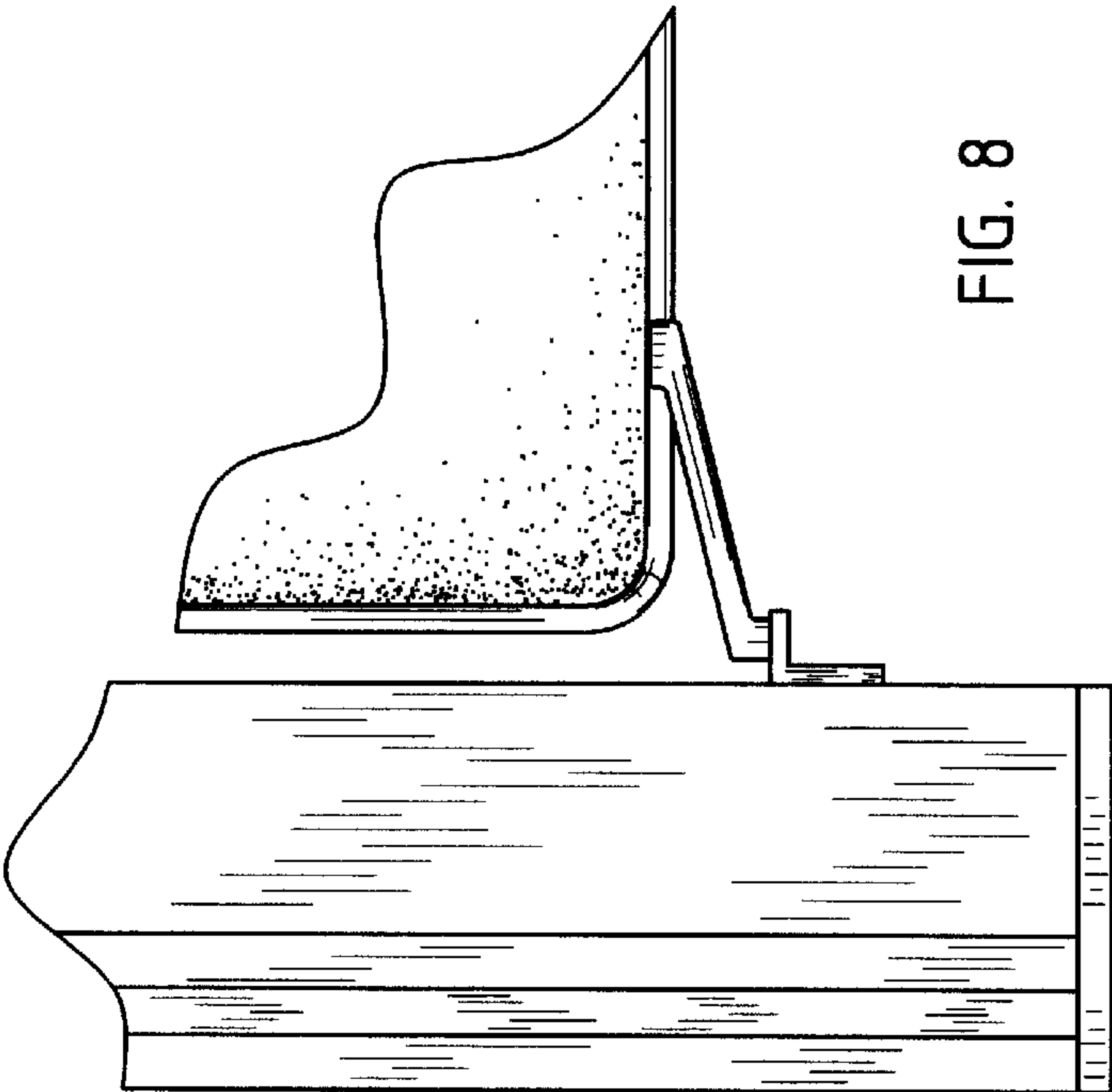

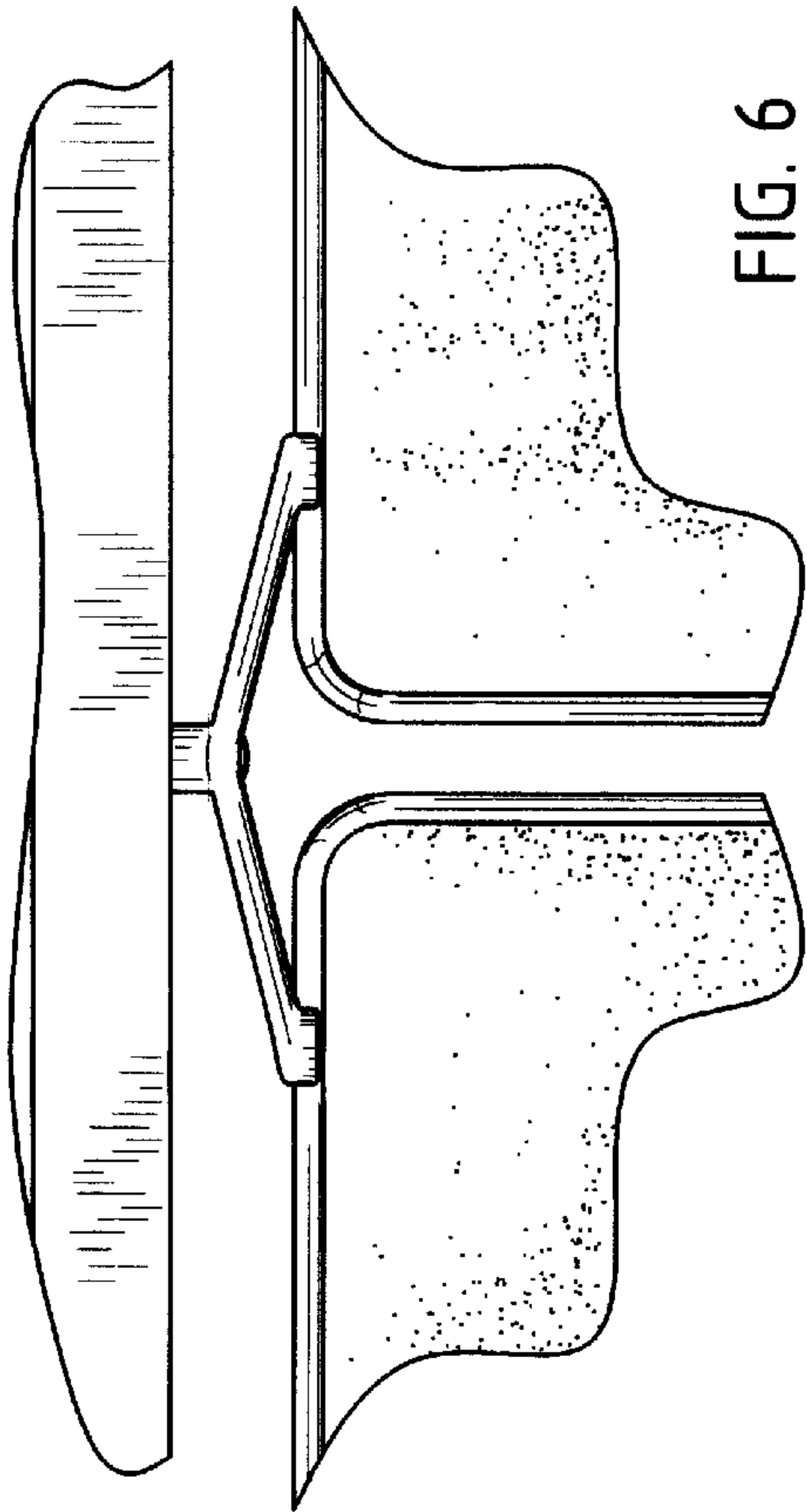

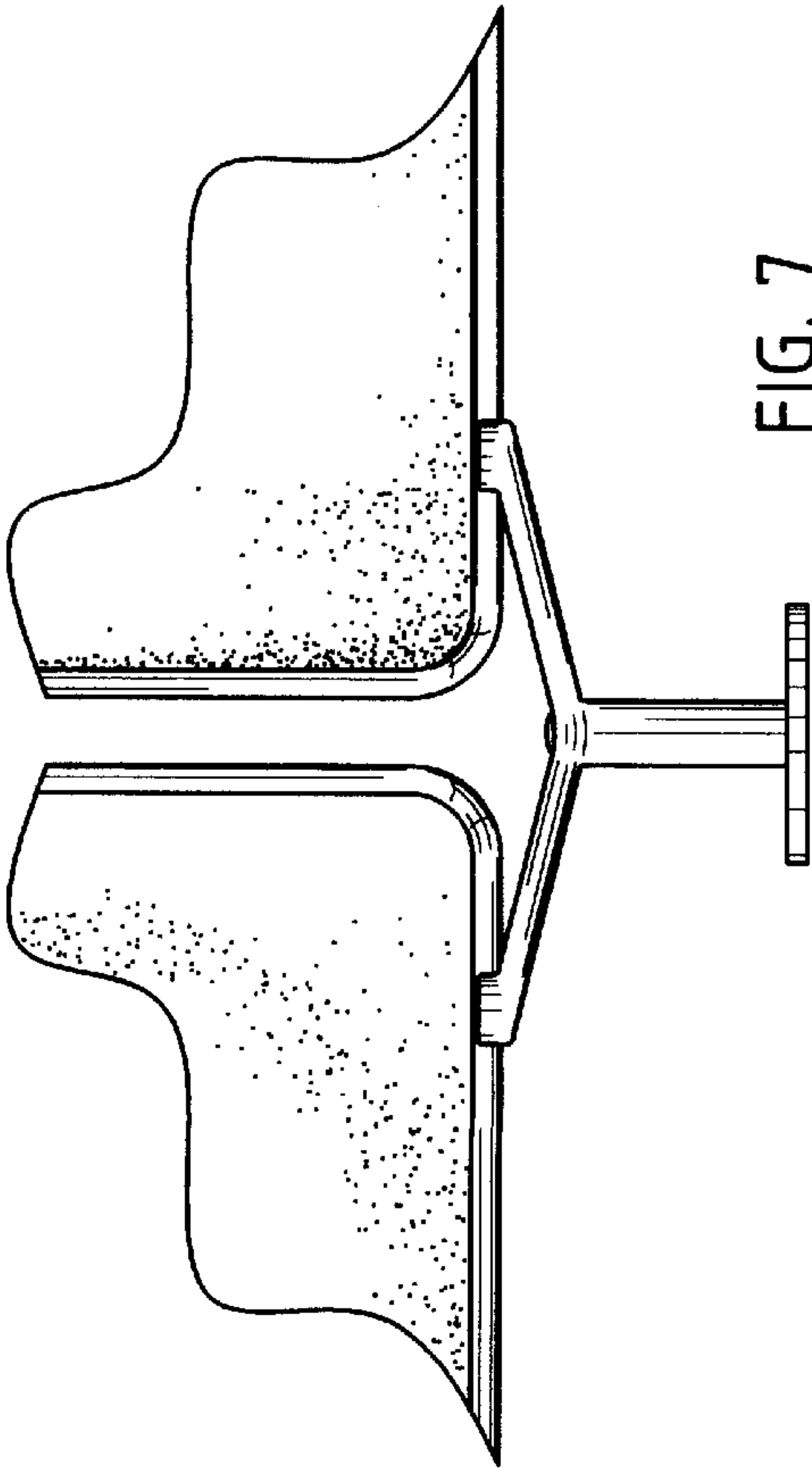

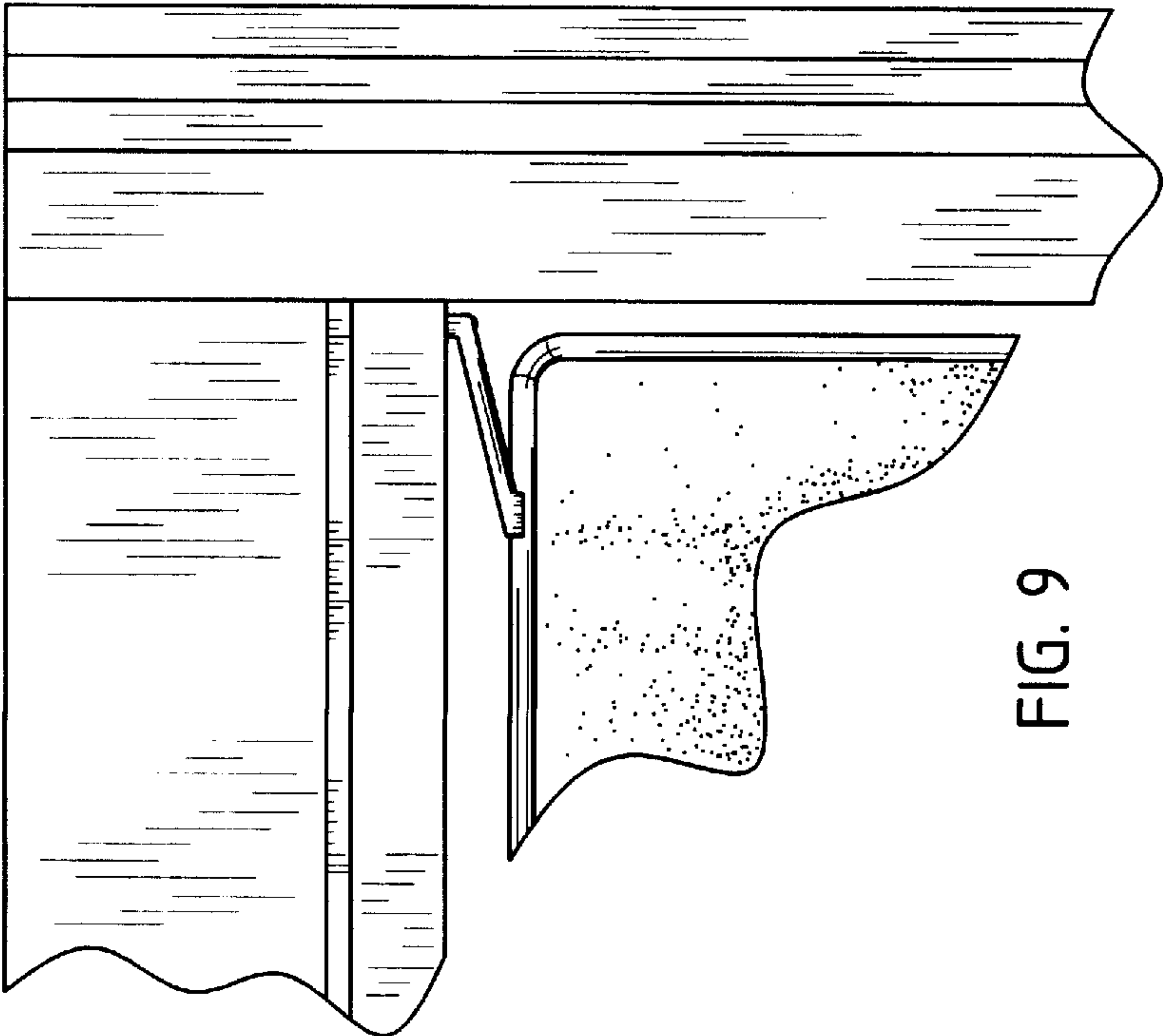

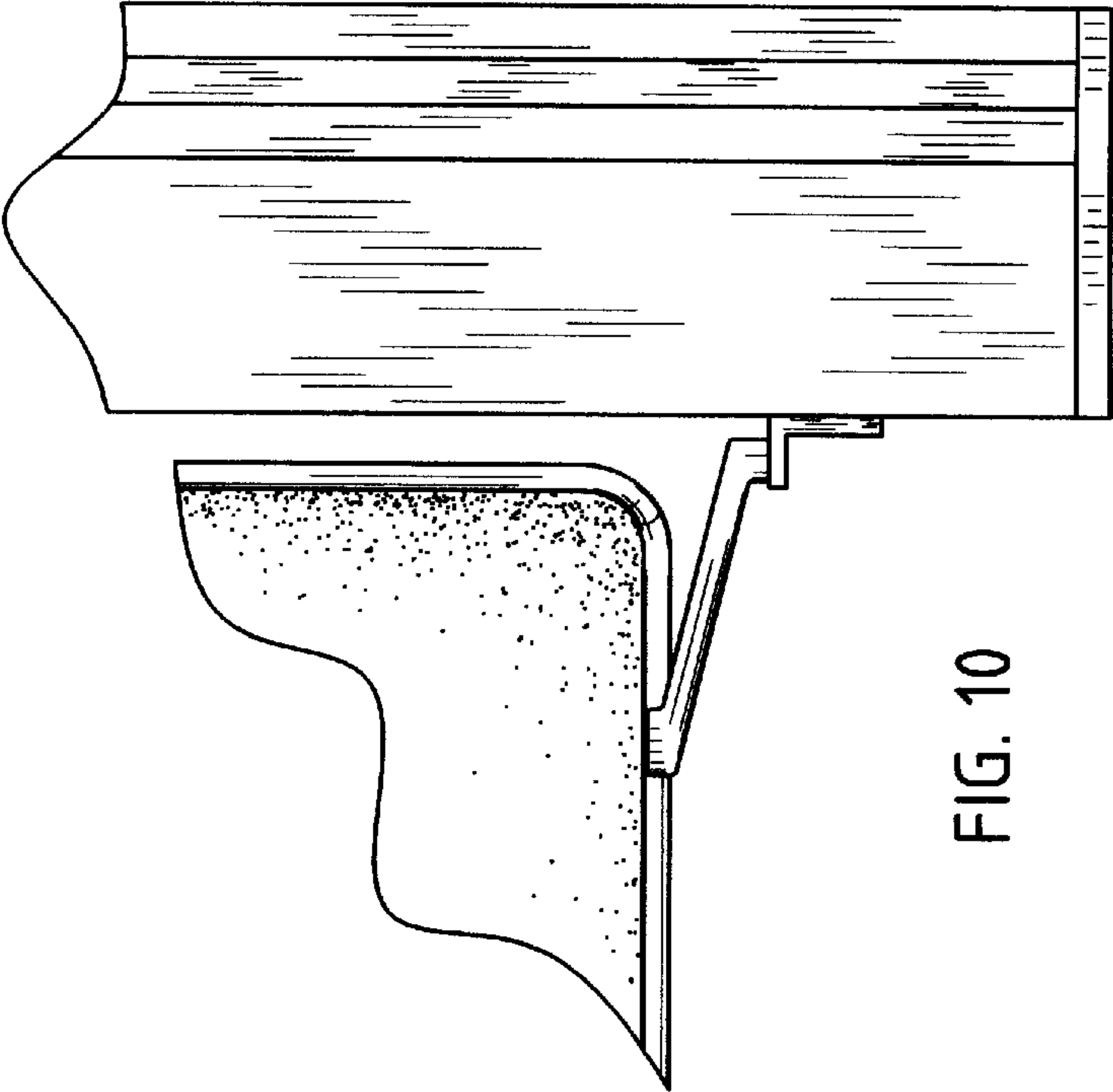
