(57) **CLAIM**

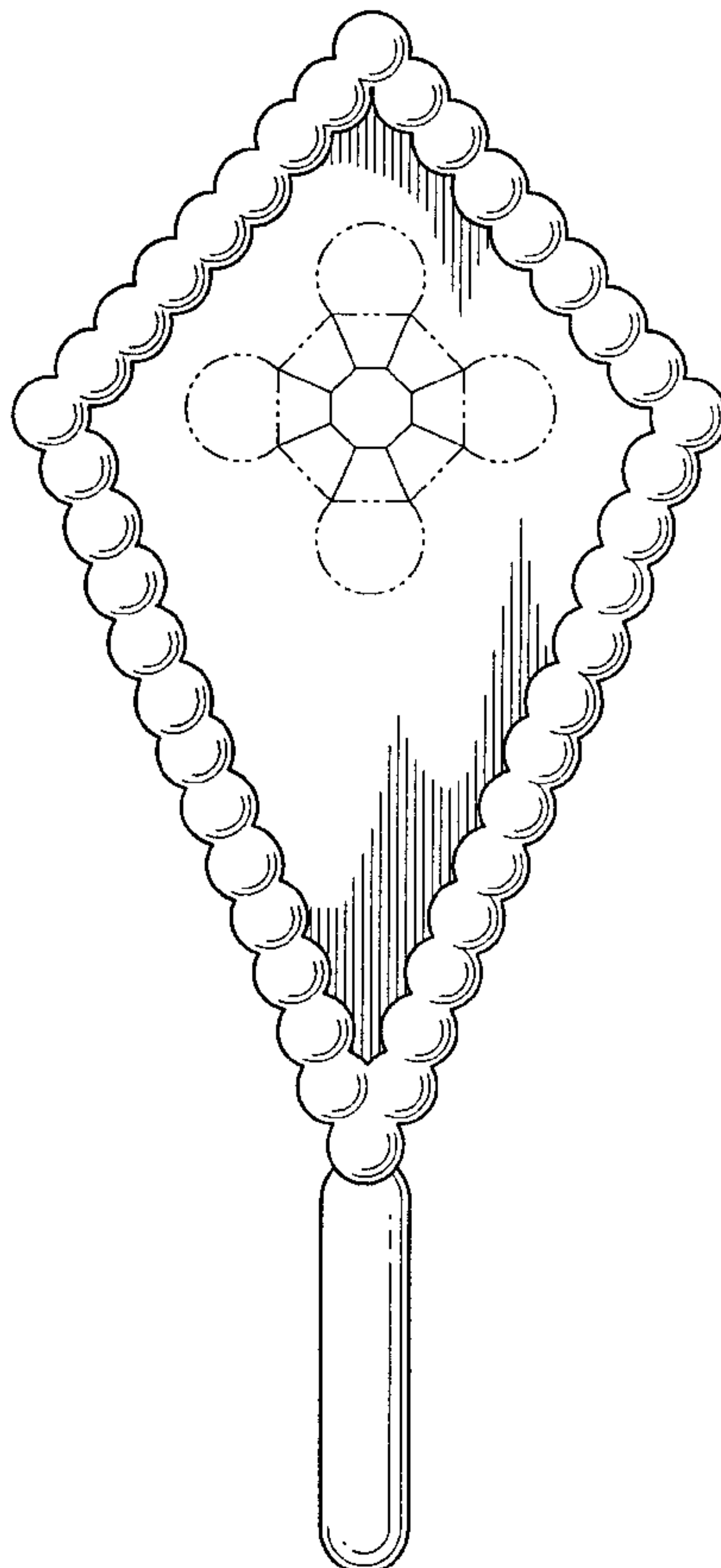
The ornamental design for double-sided jewelry setting, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a double-sided jewelry setting showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a top end elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a bottom end elevational view; and,

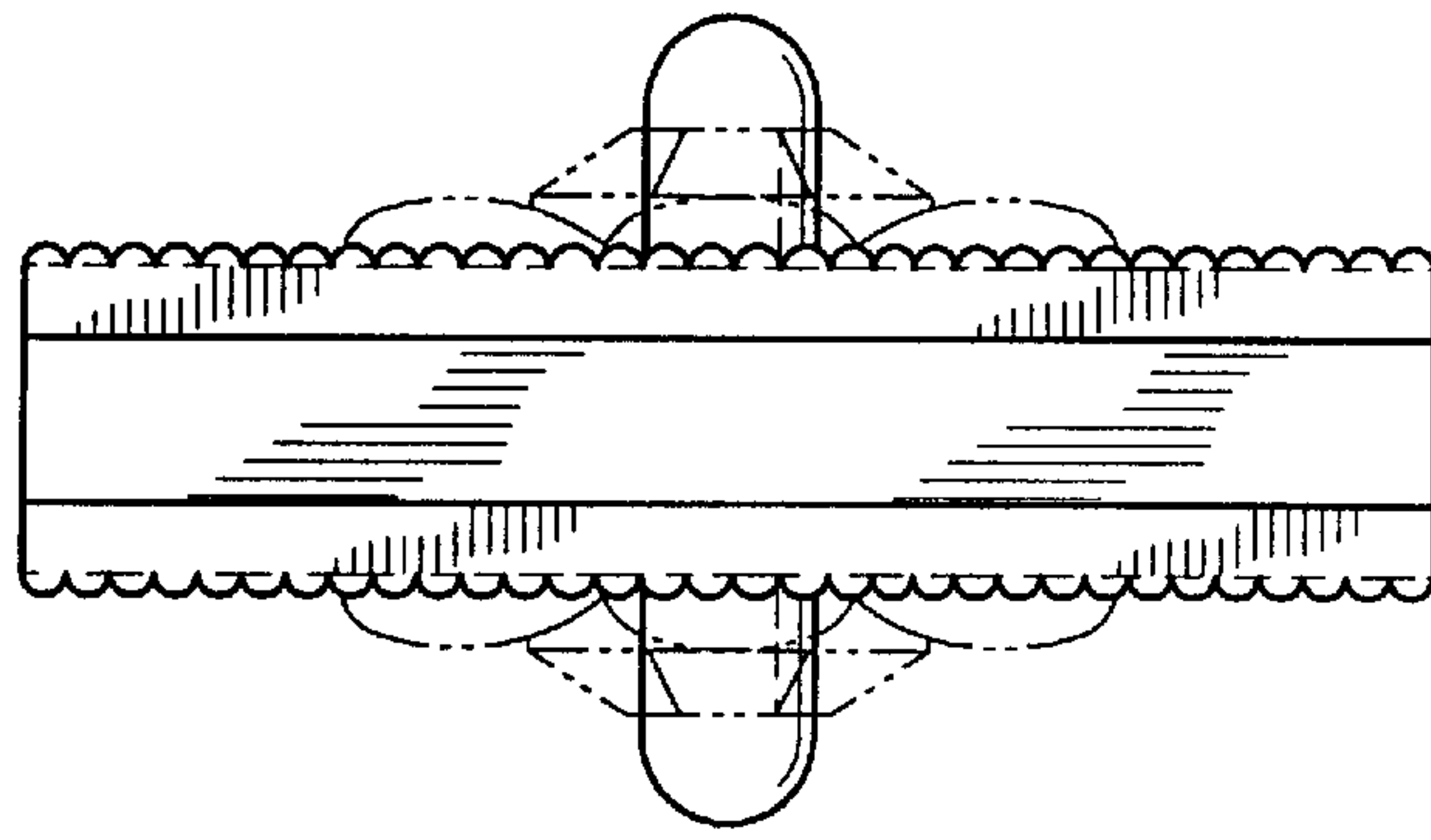

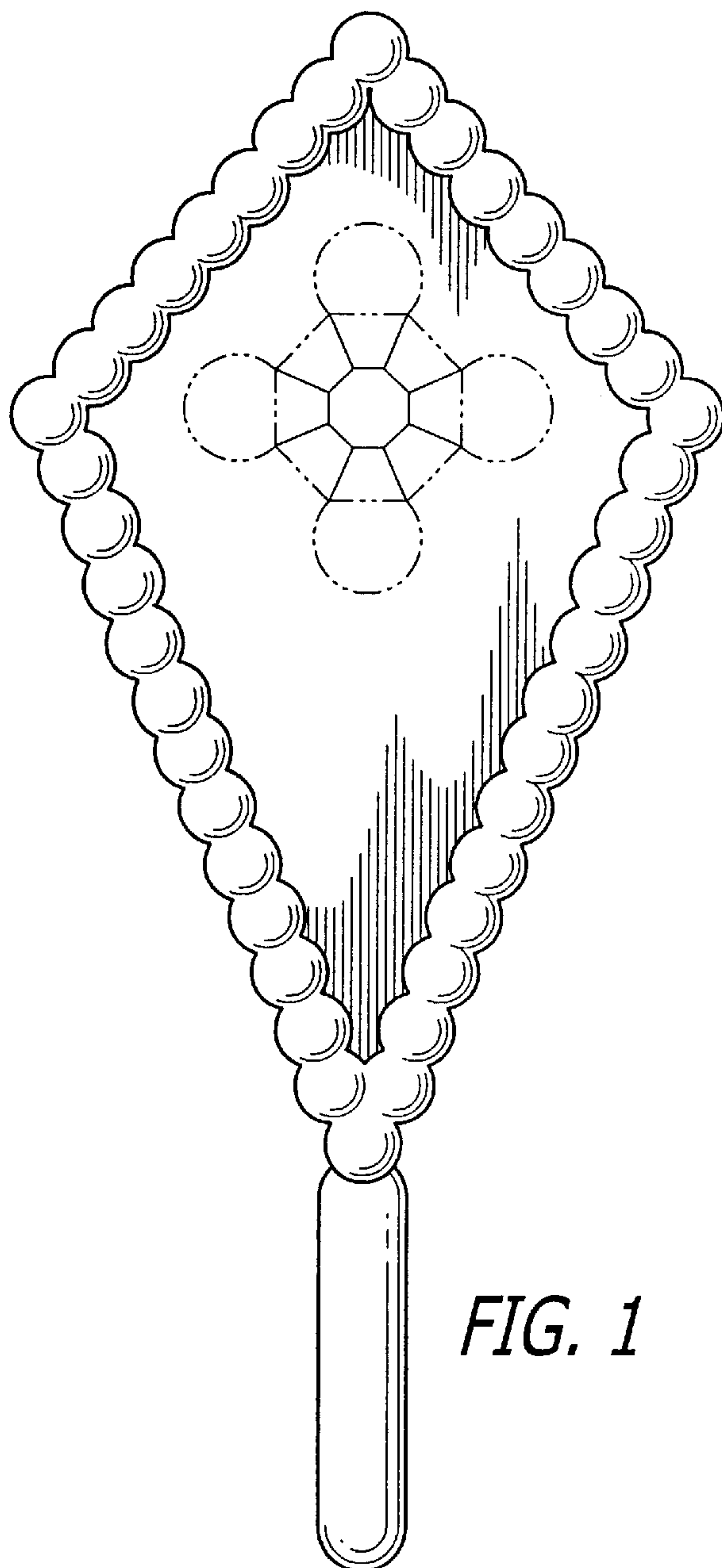

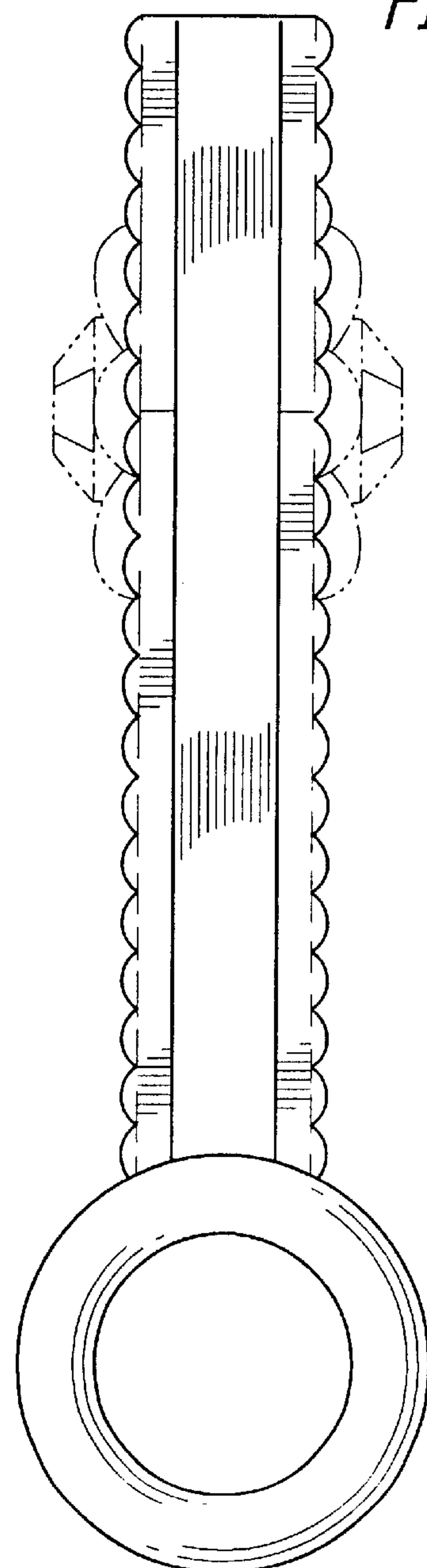

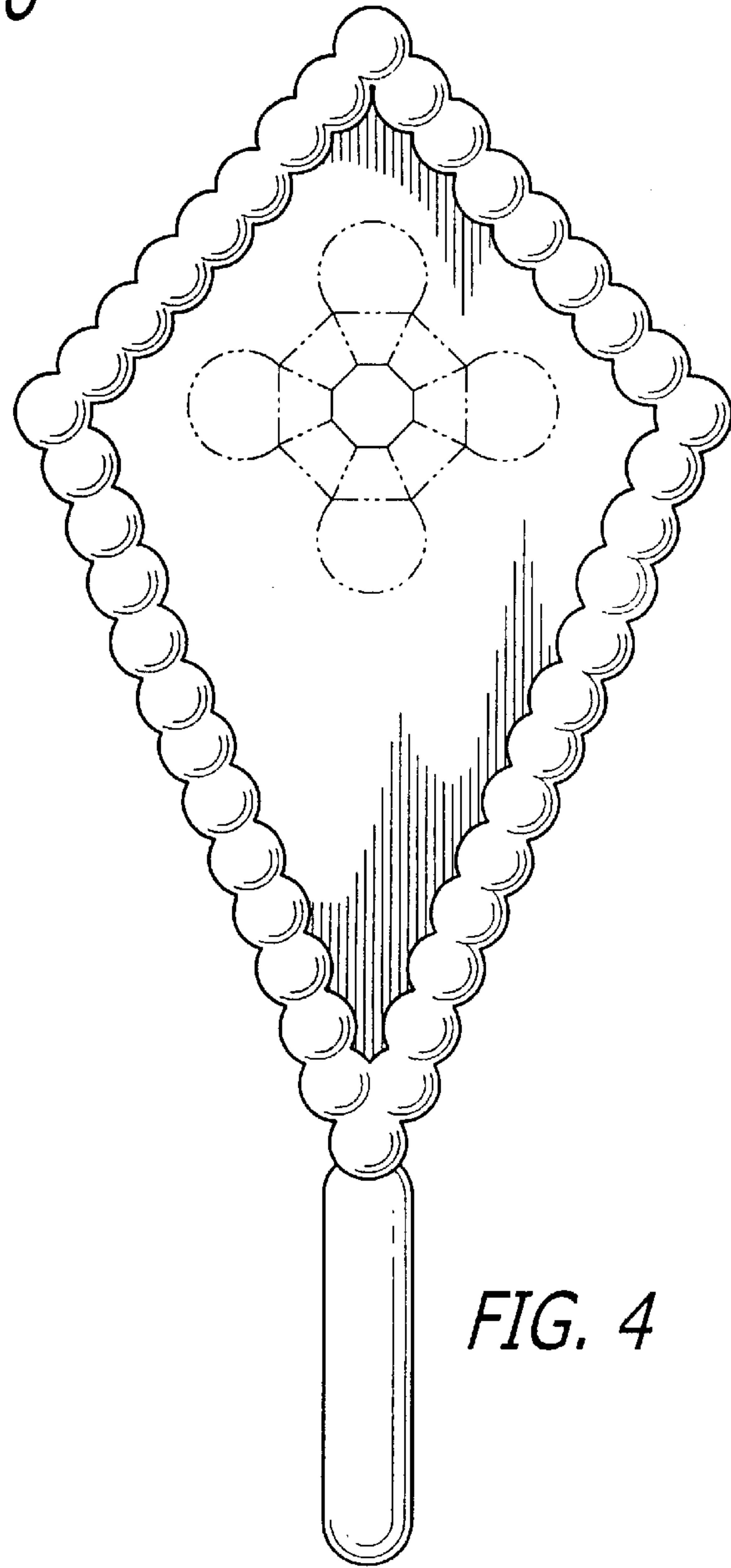
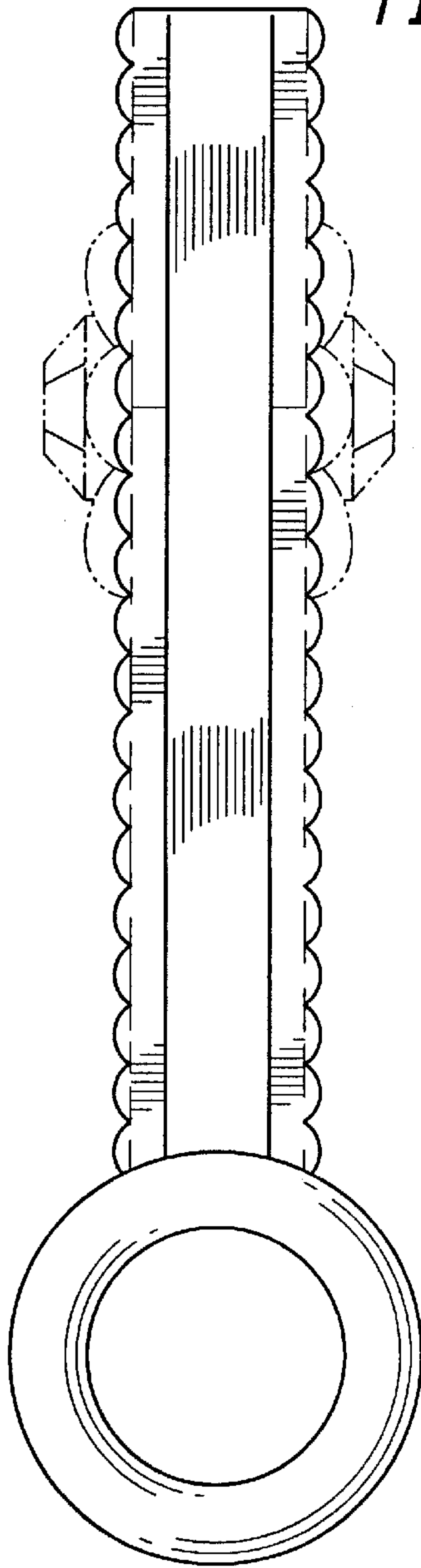
