(57)**CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a motorcycle air cleaner cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a motorcycle air cleaner cover showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment of the design shown in FIGS. 1—5;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the second embodiment;


FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the second embodiment;


FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view of the second emodiment; and,








