FIG. 4 is a front end elevation view of FIG. 1; and,

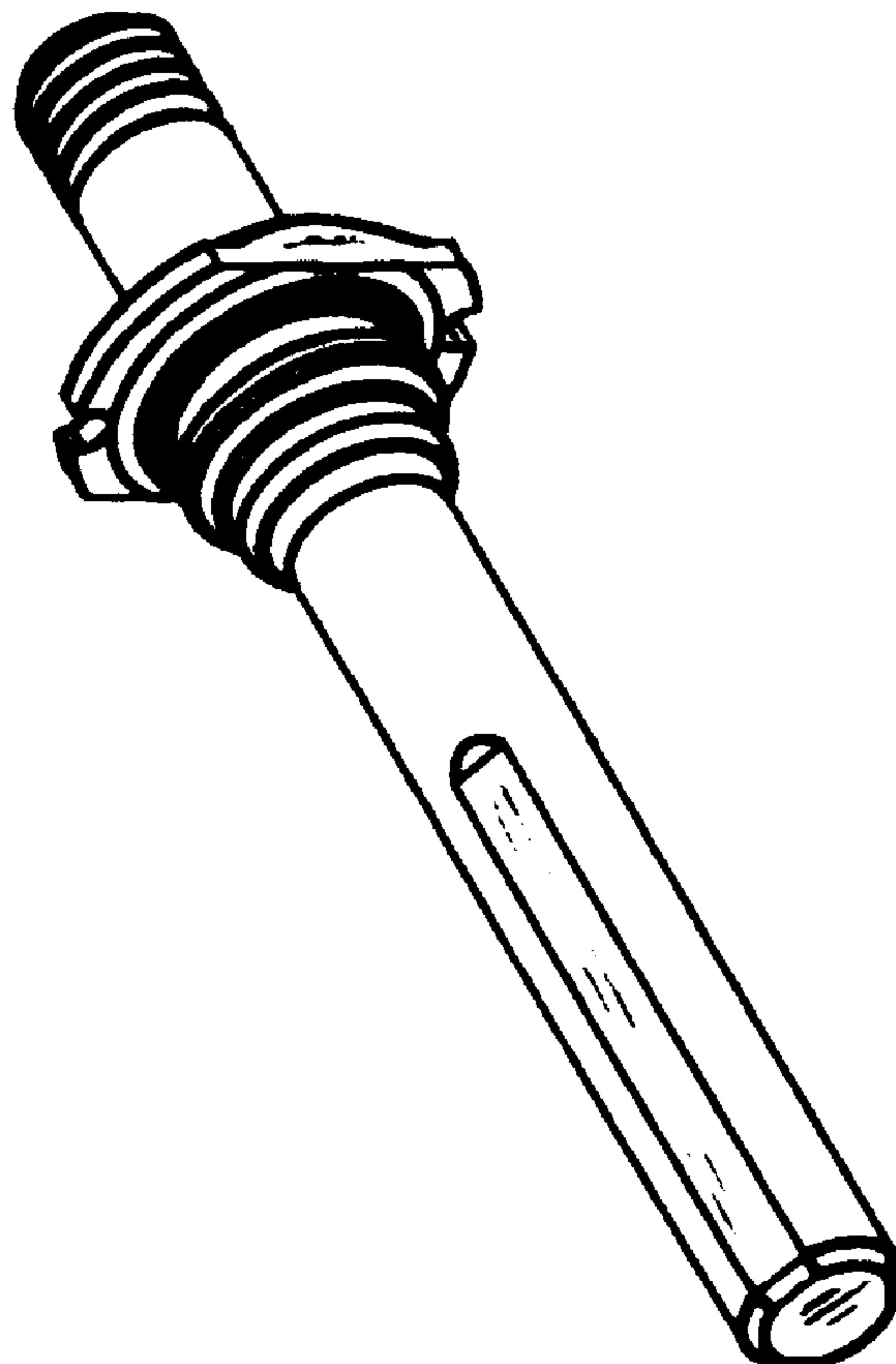
FIG. 5 is a top view of FIG. 1.

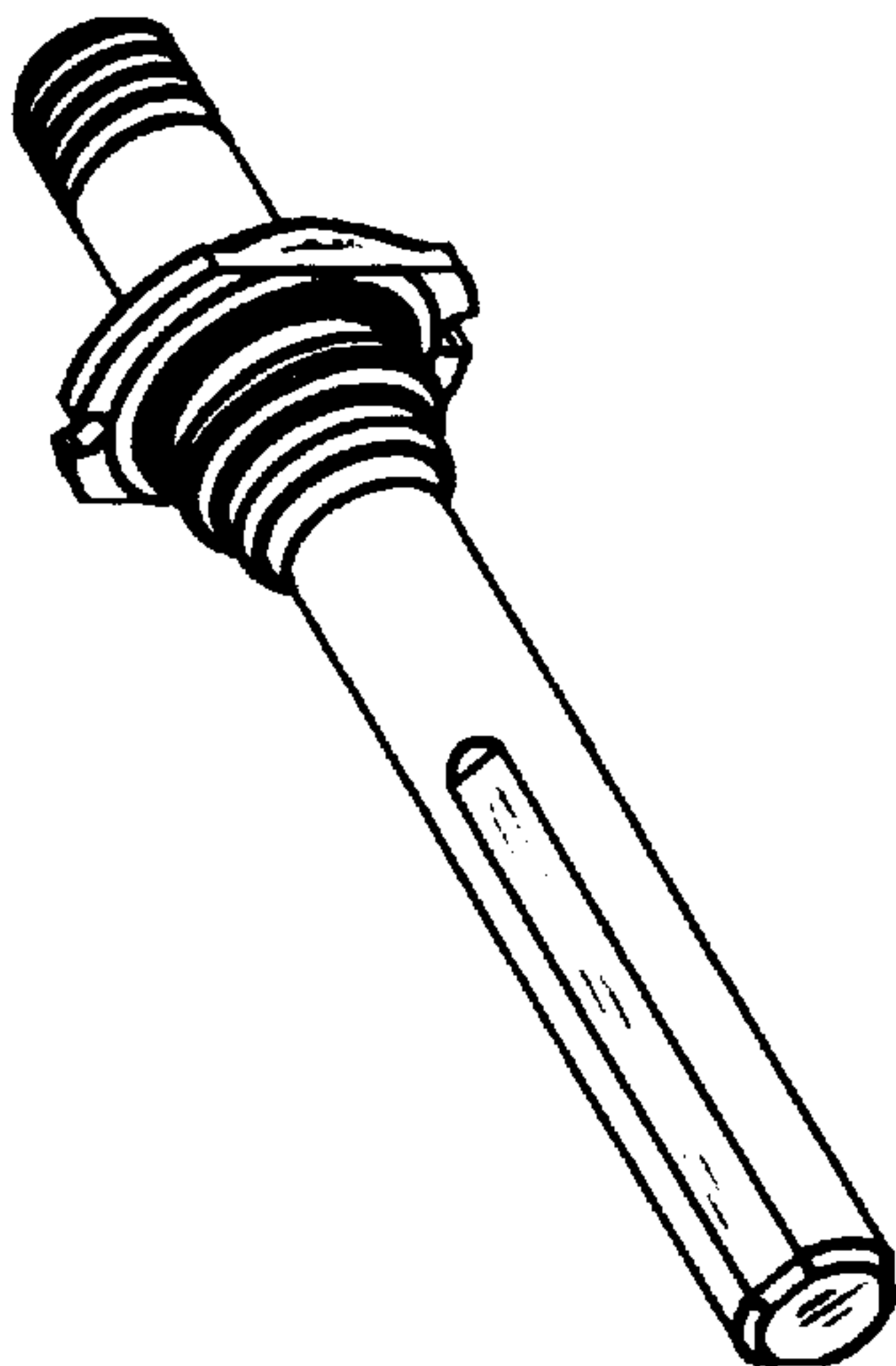

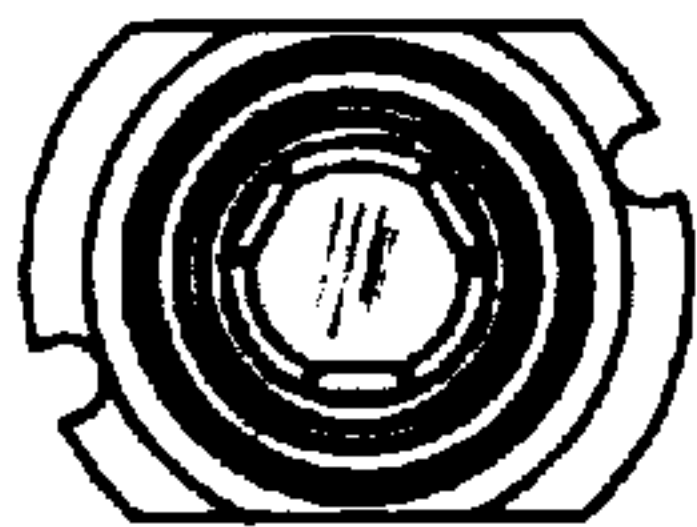

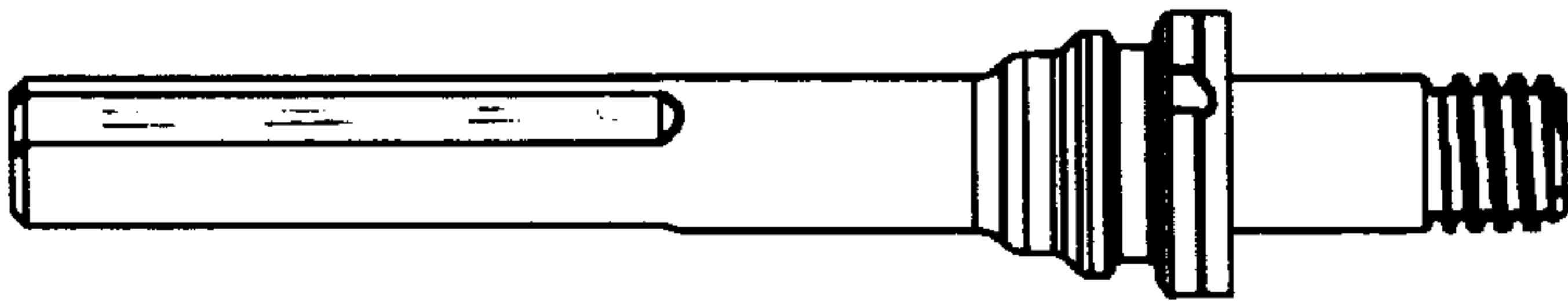

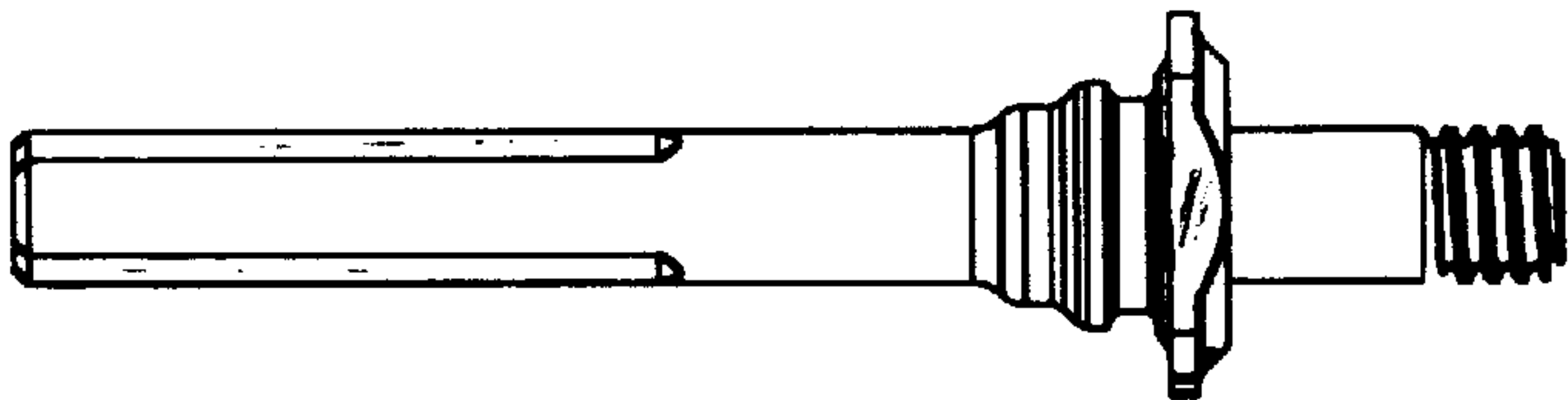

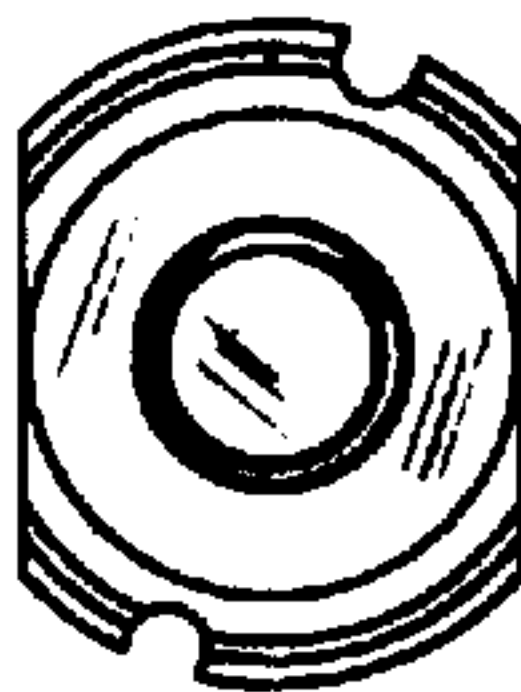
