FIG. 3 is a top view thereof.

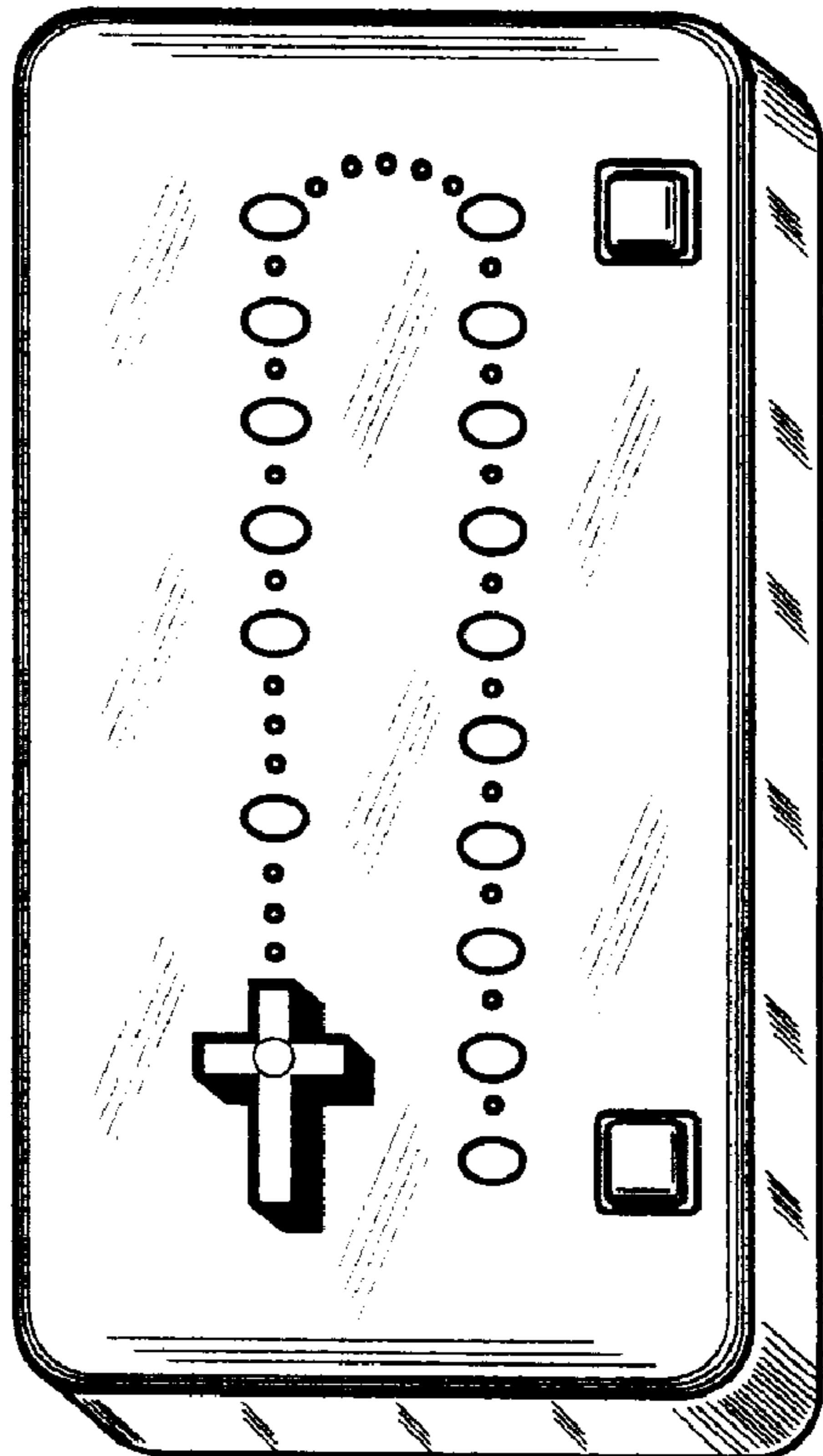
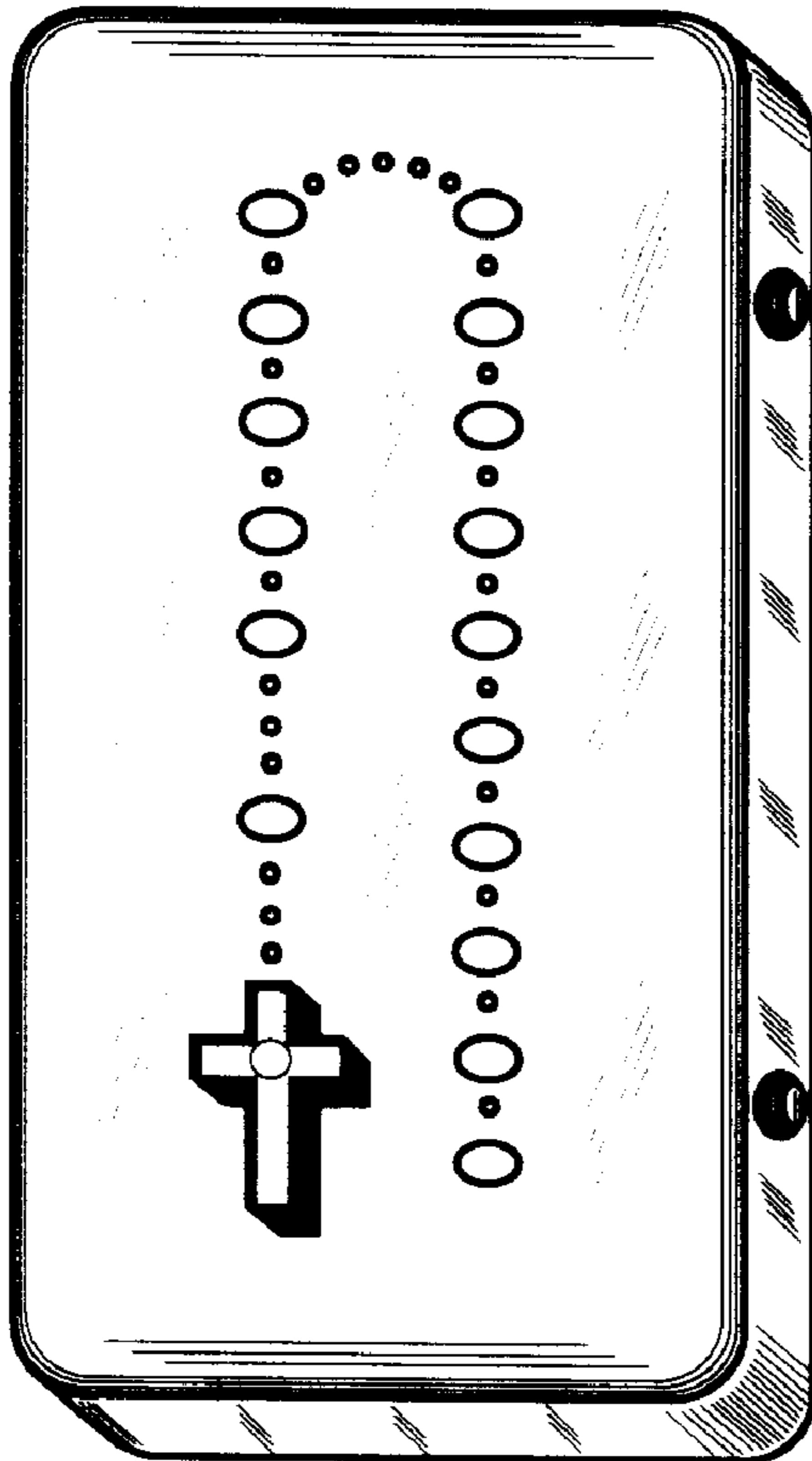
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a rosary showing my new design;

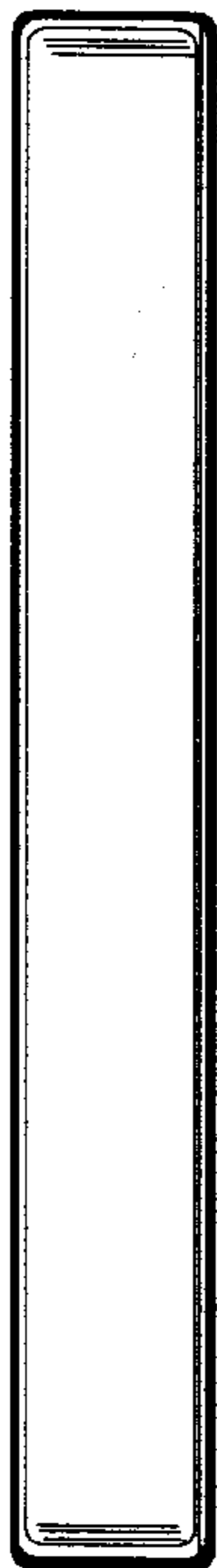

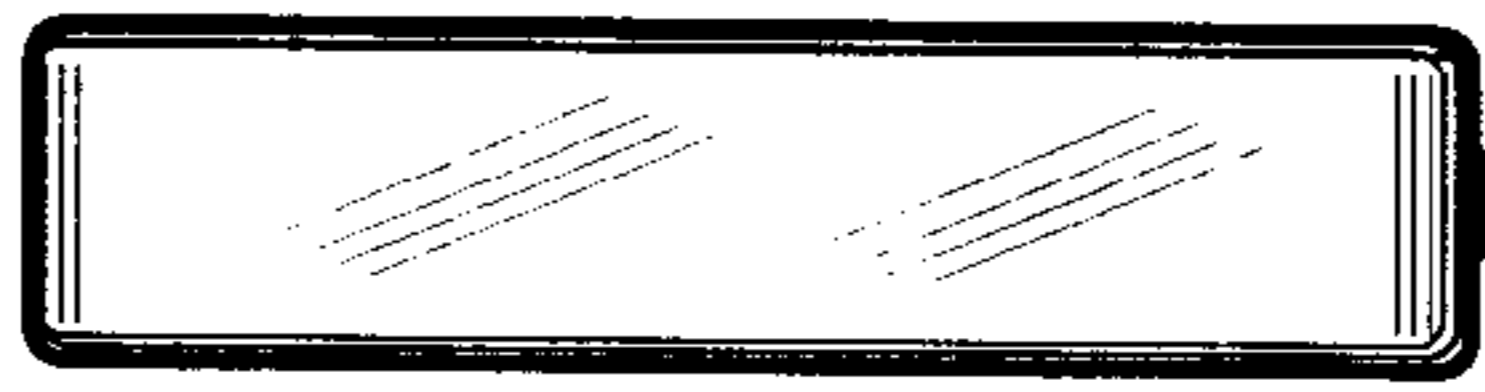

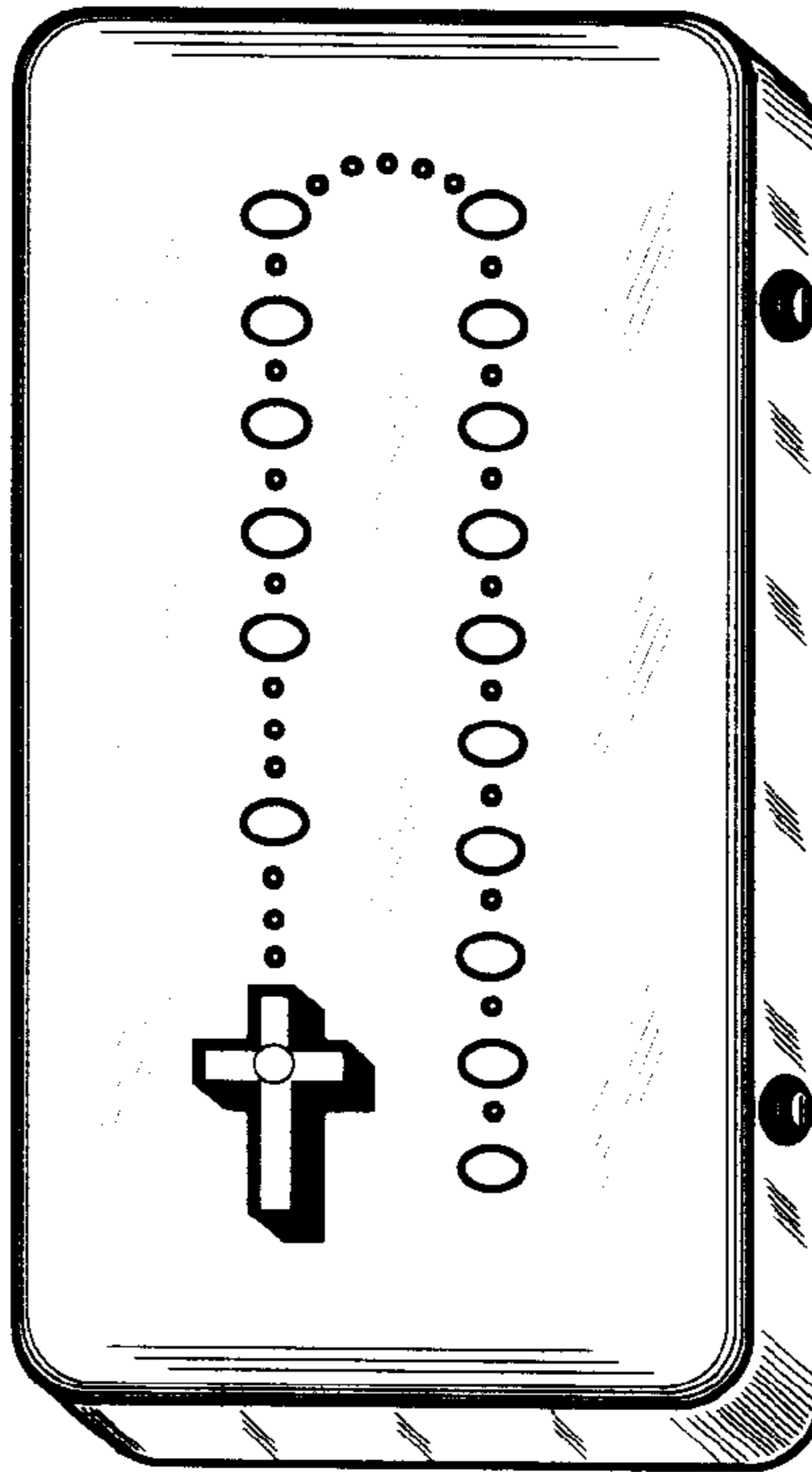

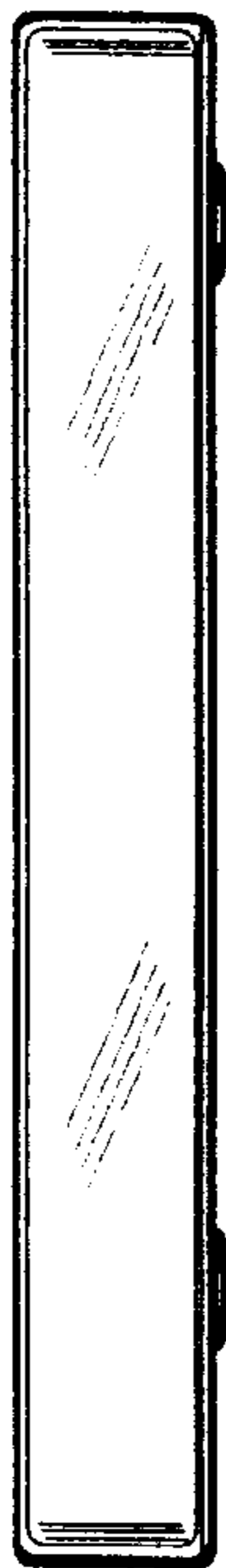

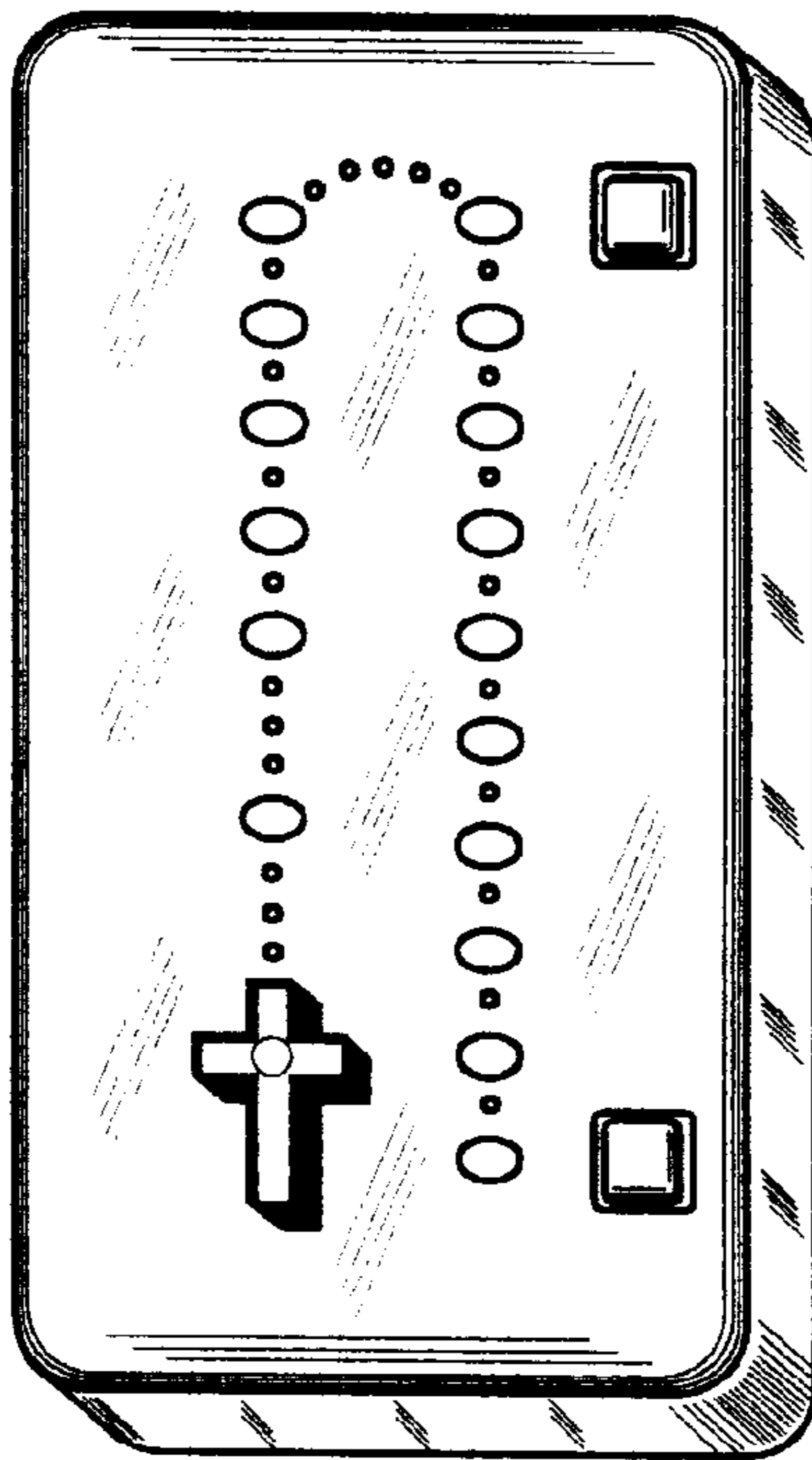
