FIG. 6 shows a front end view thereof.

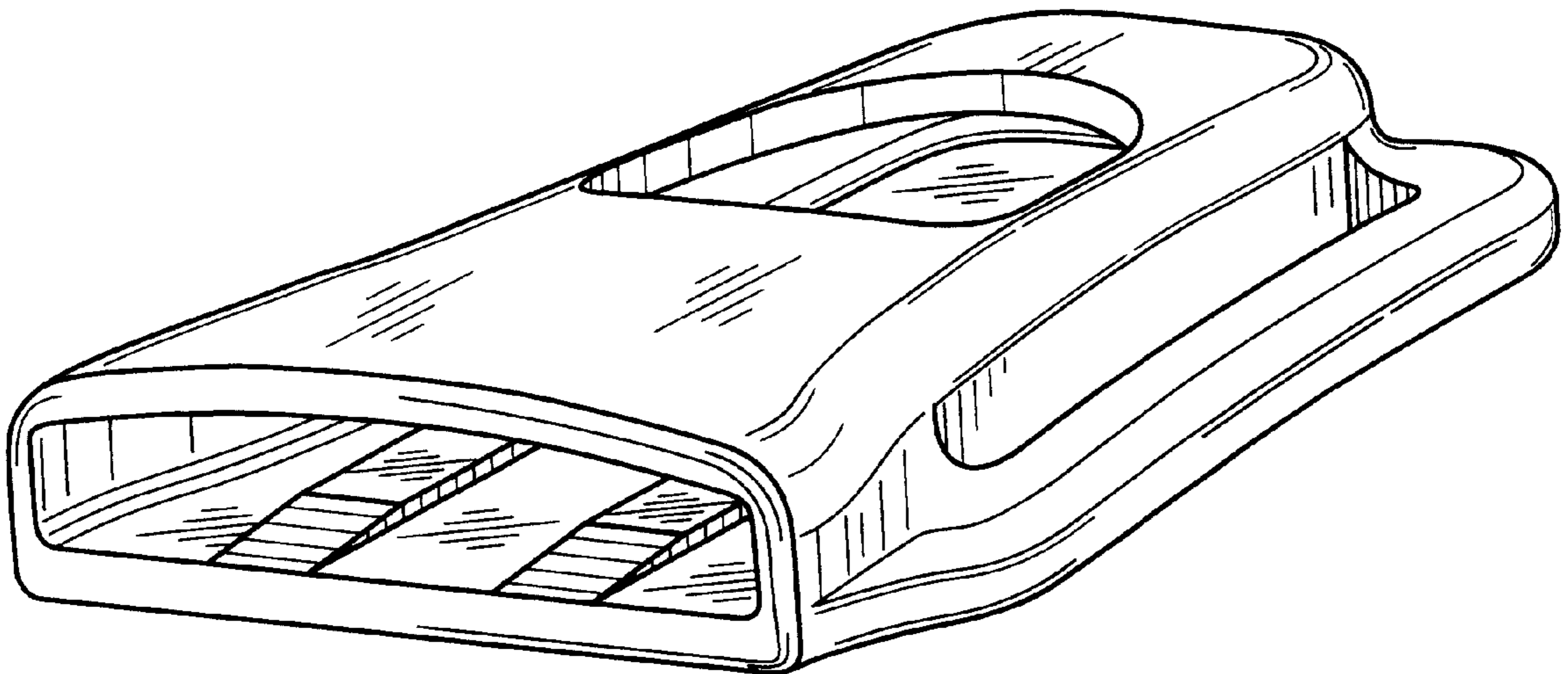

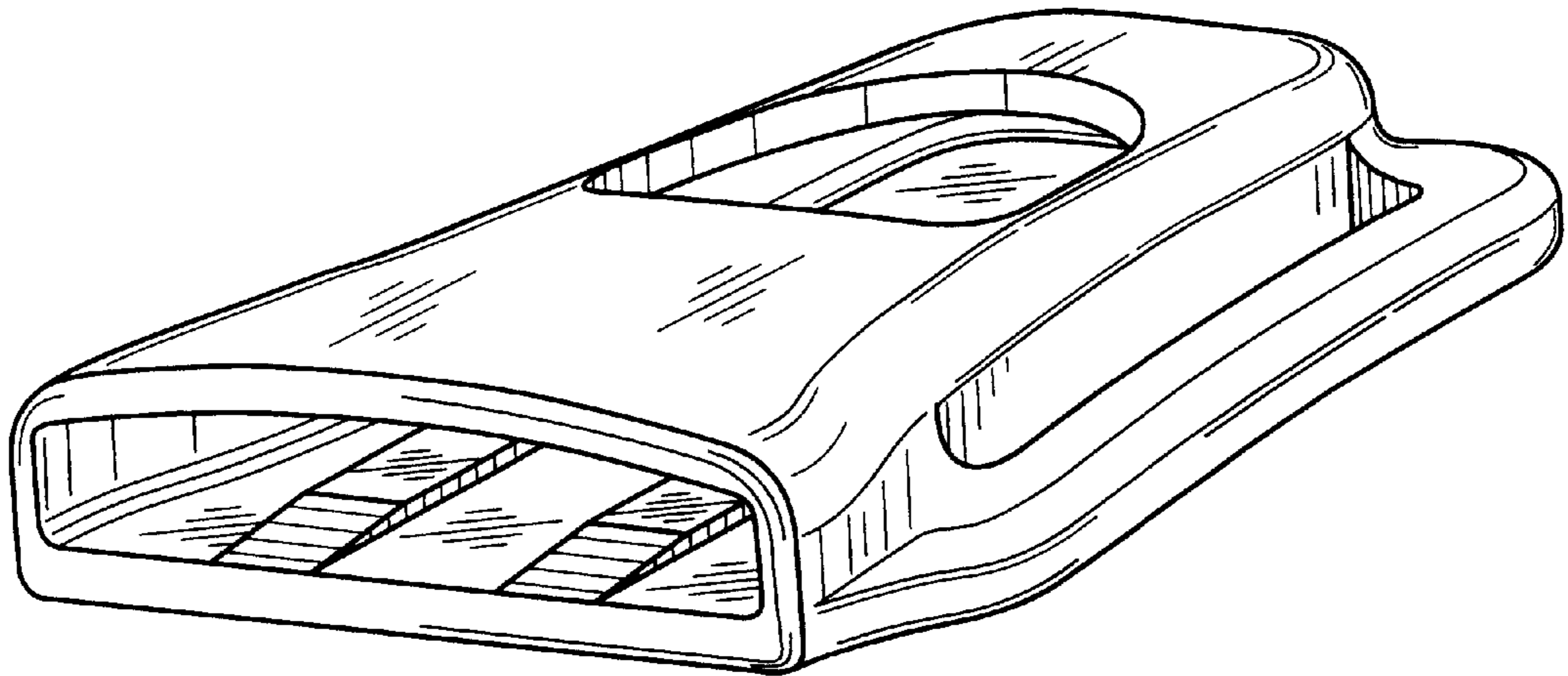

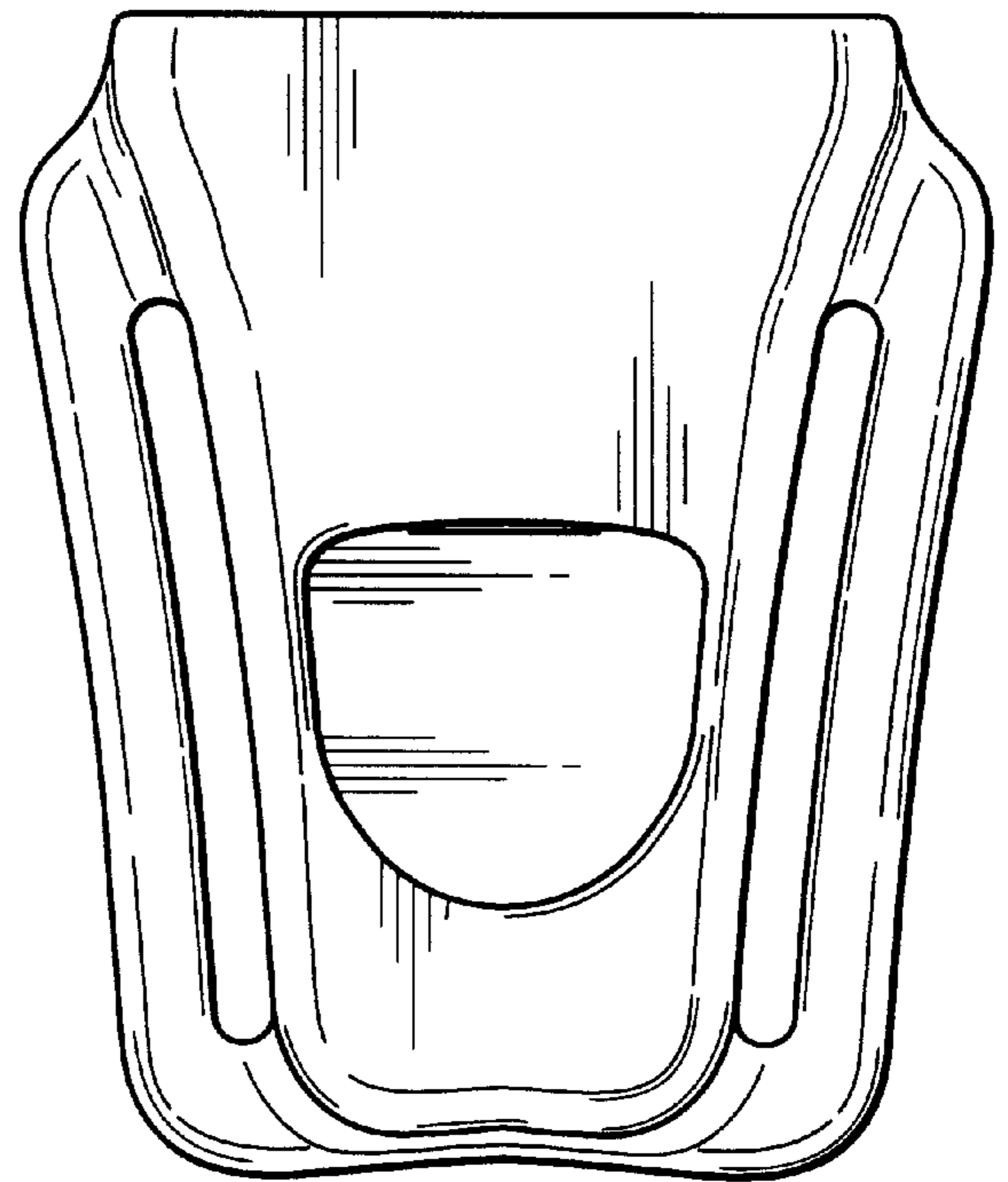

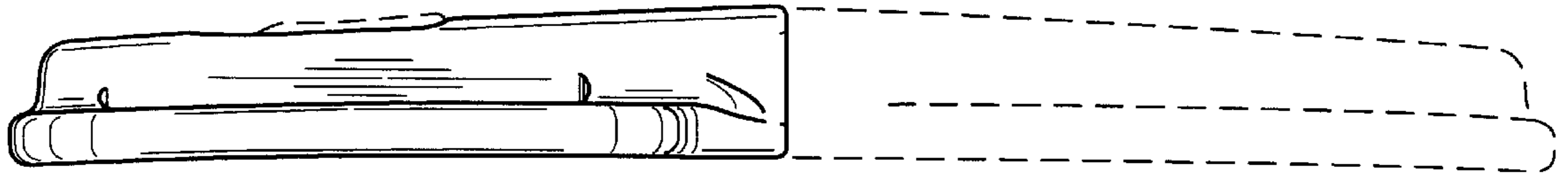

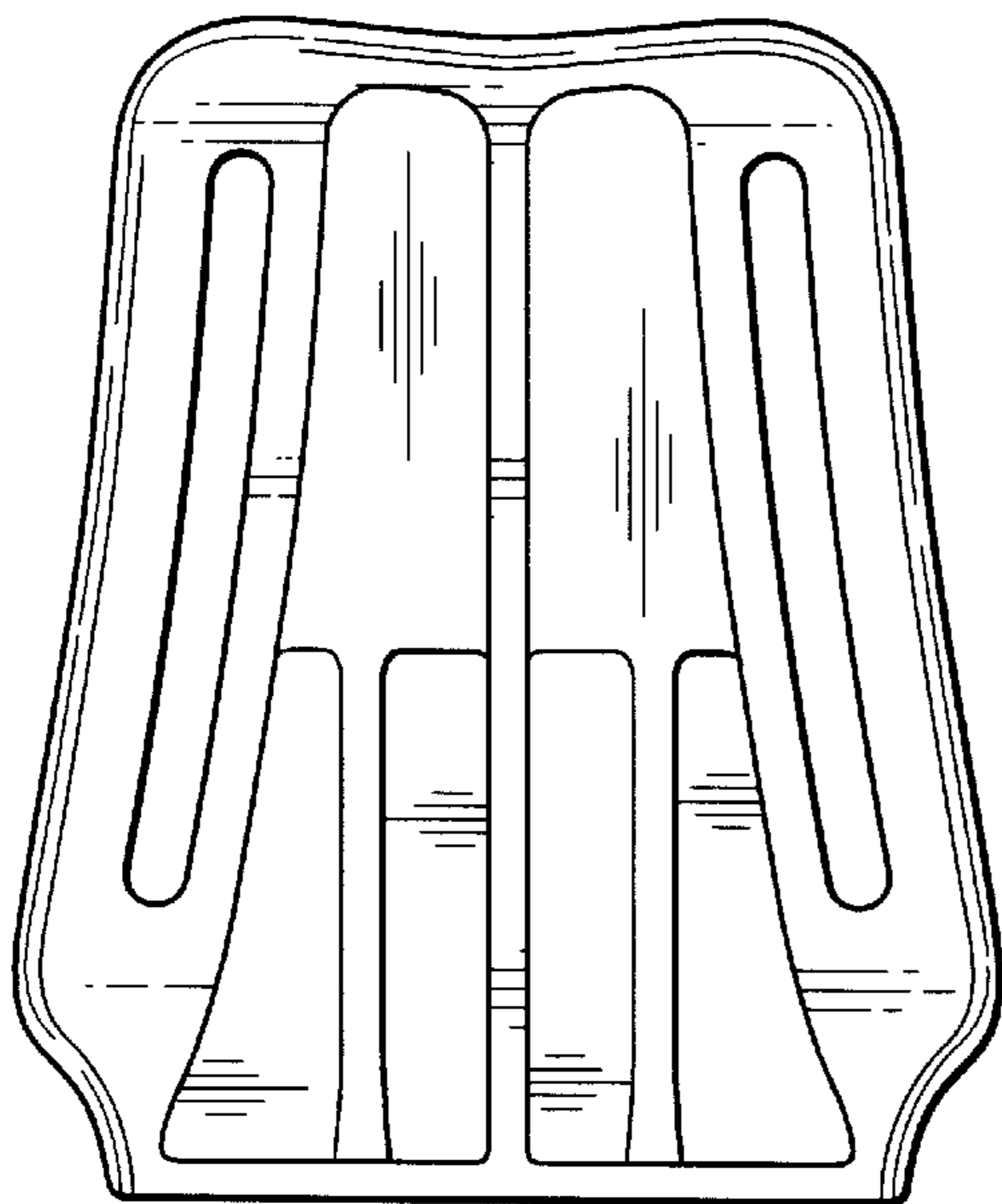

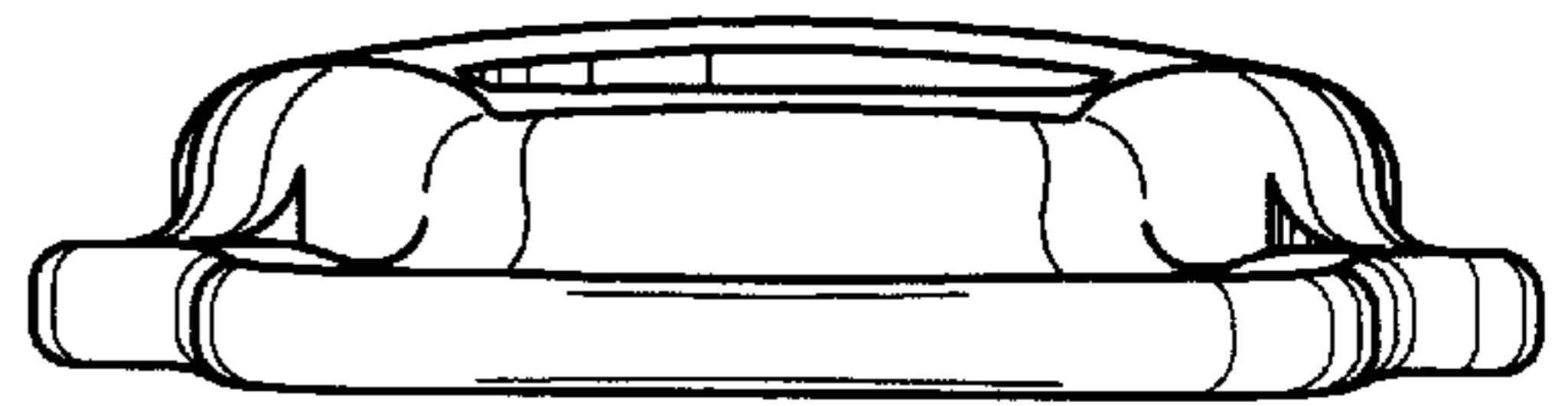
