(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vehicle body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front and left side of a vehicle body showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the rear and right side thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, it being understood that the opposite side not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof;


FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,


FIG. 6 is a left side view of a vehicle body showing a second embodiment of our new design, the sole difference from the first embodiment being the incorporation of an alternative body side molding, it being understood that the opposite side to that shown is a substantial mirror image thereof.




