FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lamp showing my new design;

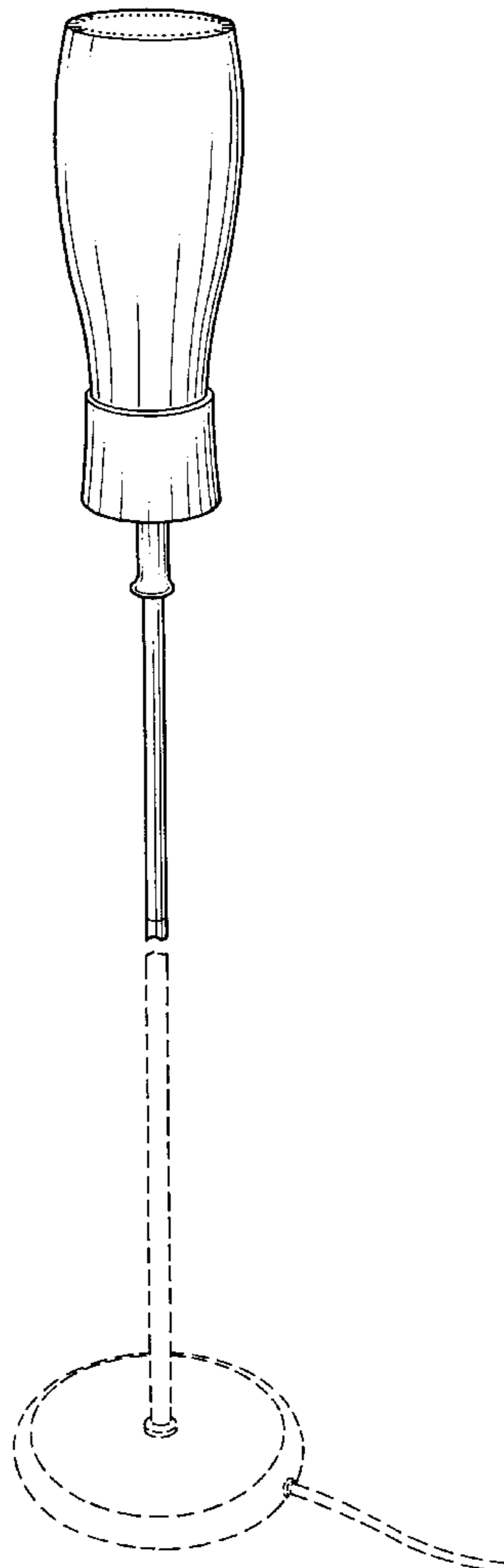
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; and,

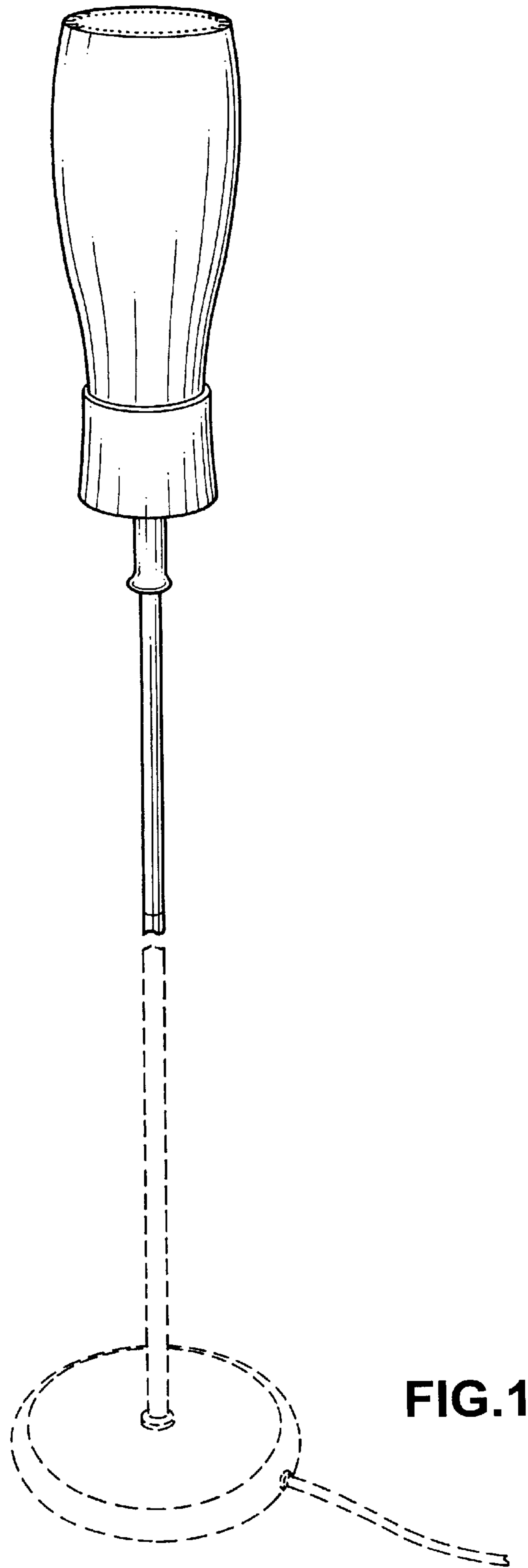
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof.

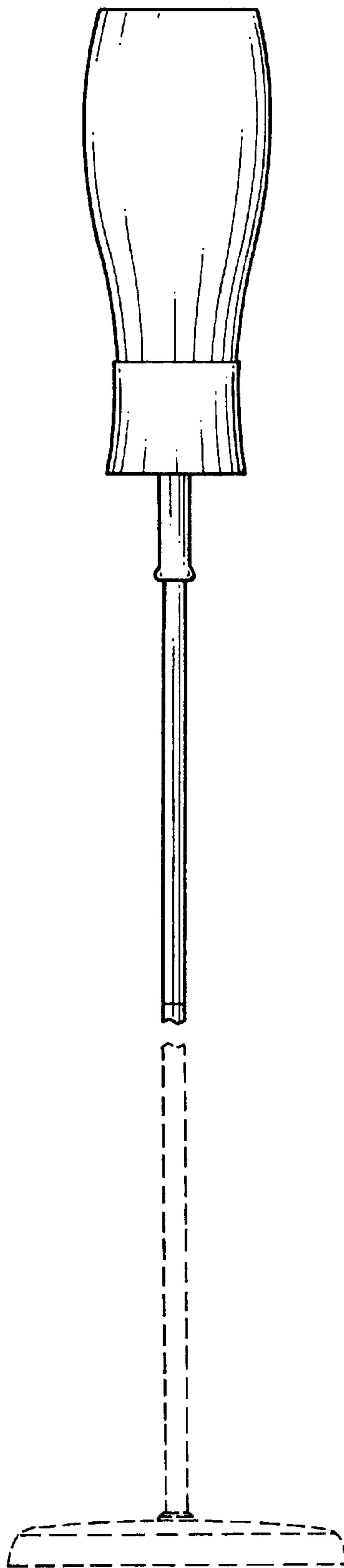

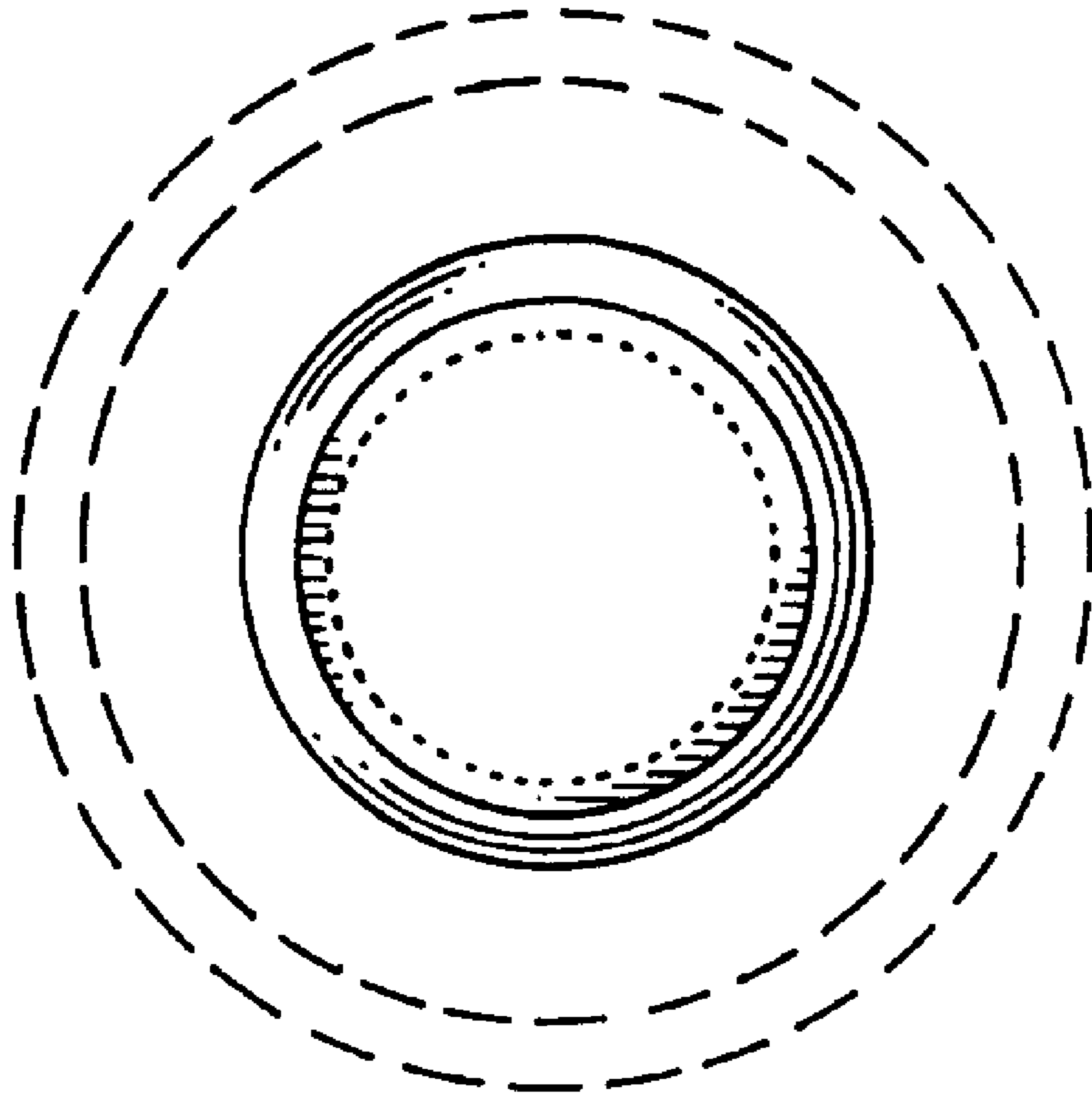
