(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

This application is related to commonly owned, concurrently filed applications Ser. No. 29/116,725 and Ser. No. 29/116,727.

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the seat of my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an isometric view of a first embodiment of the seat of my design;

FIG. 8 is an isometric view of a second embodiment of the seat of my design;

FIG. 9 is a back elevational view of the second embodiment; and,

FIG. 10 is an isometric view of a fourth embodiment of the seat of my new design.

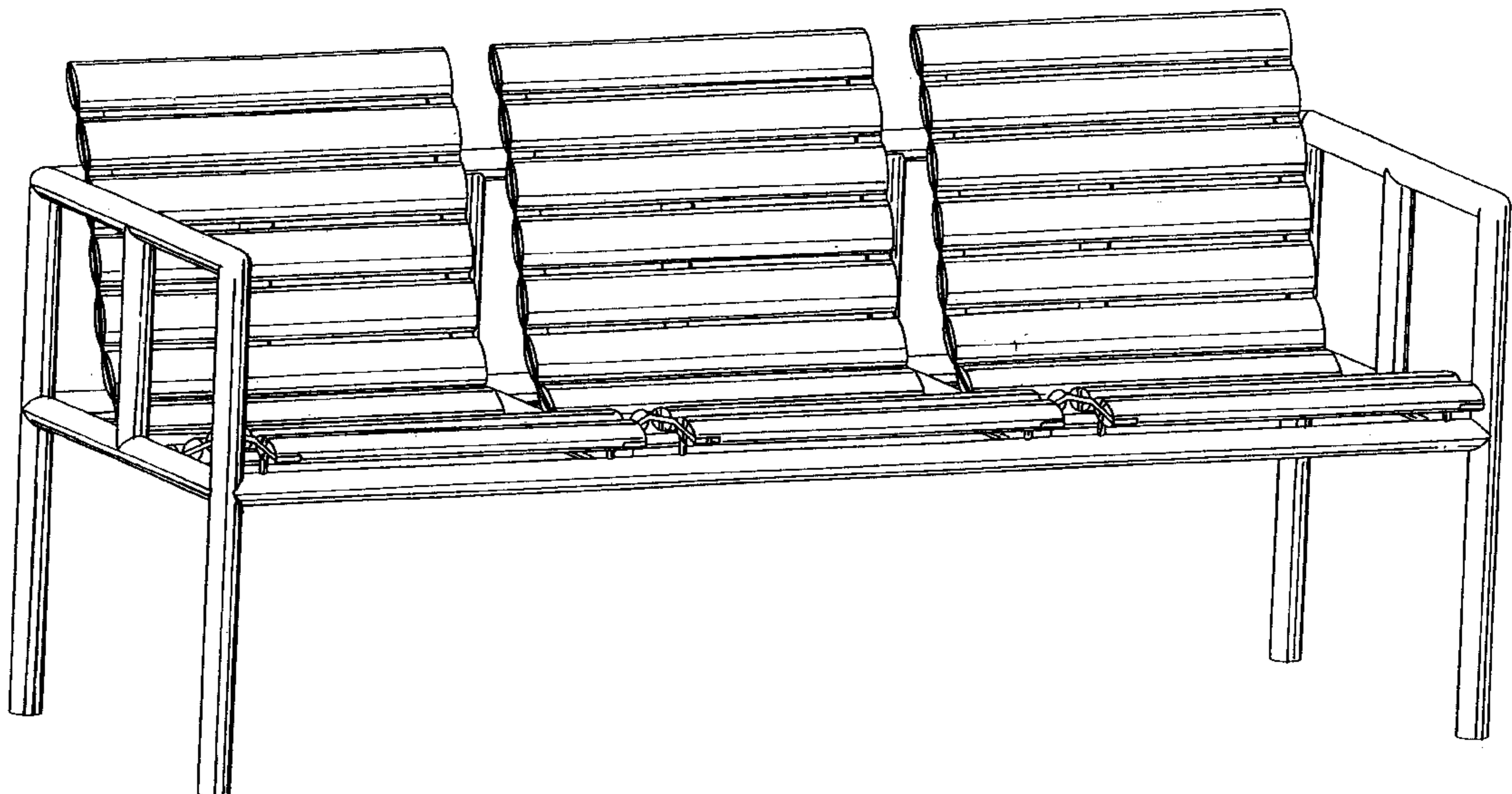

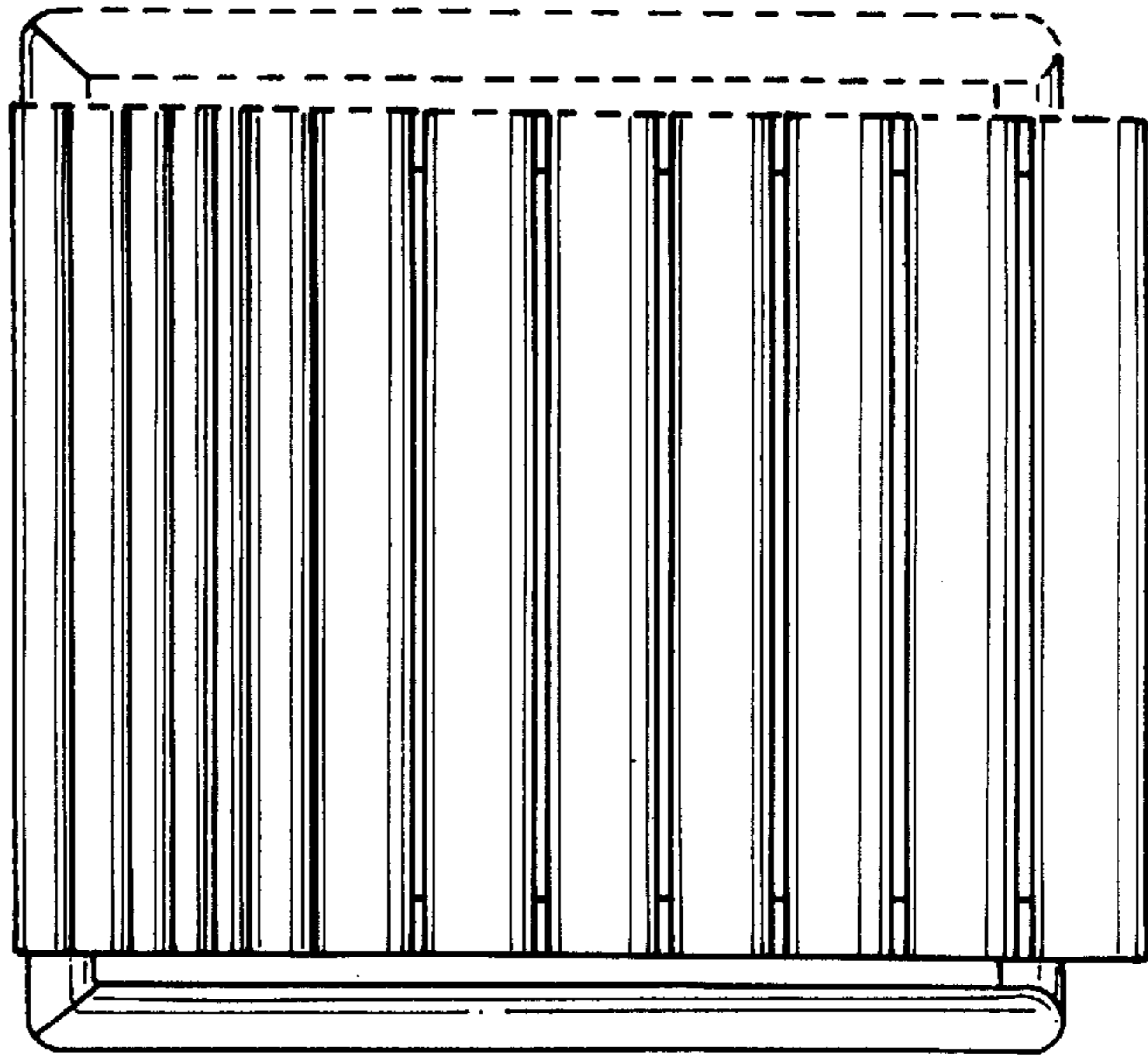

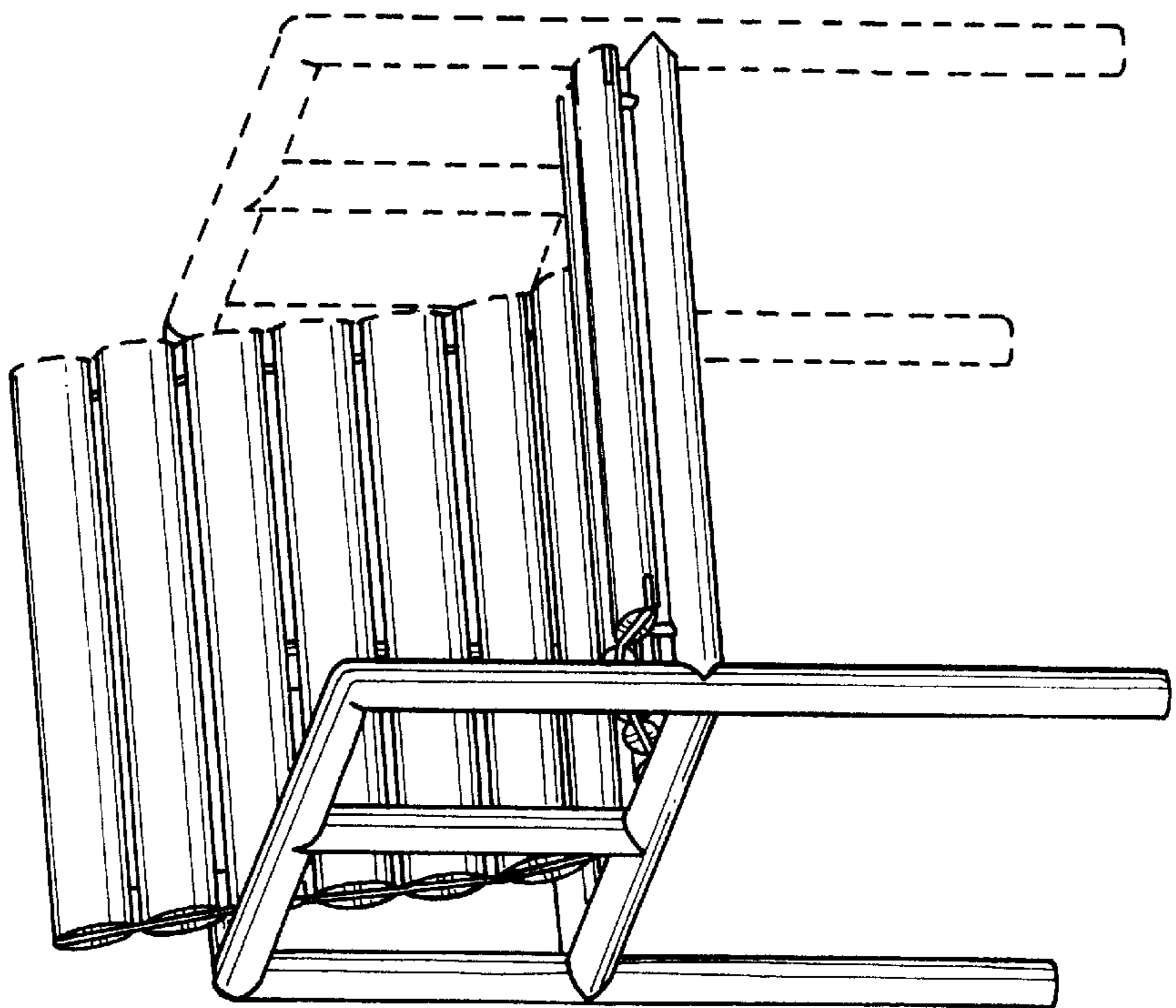

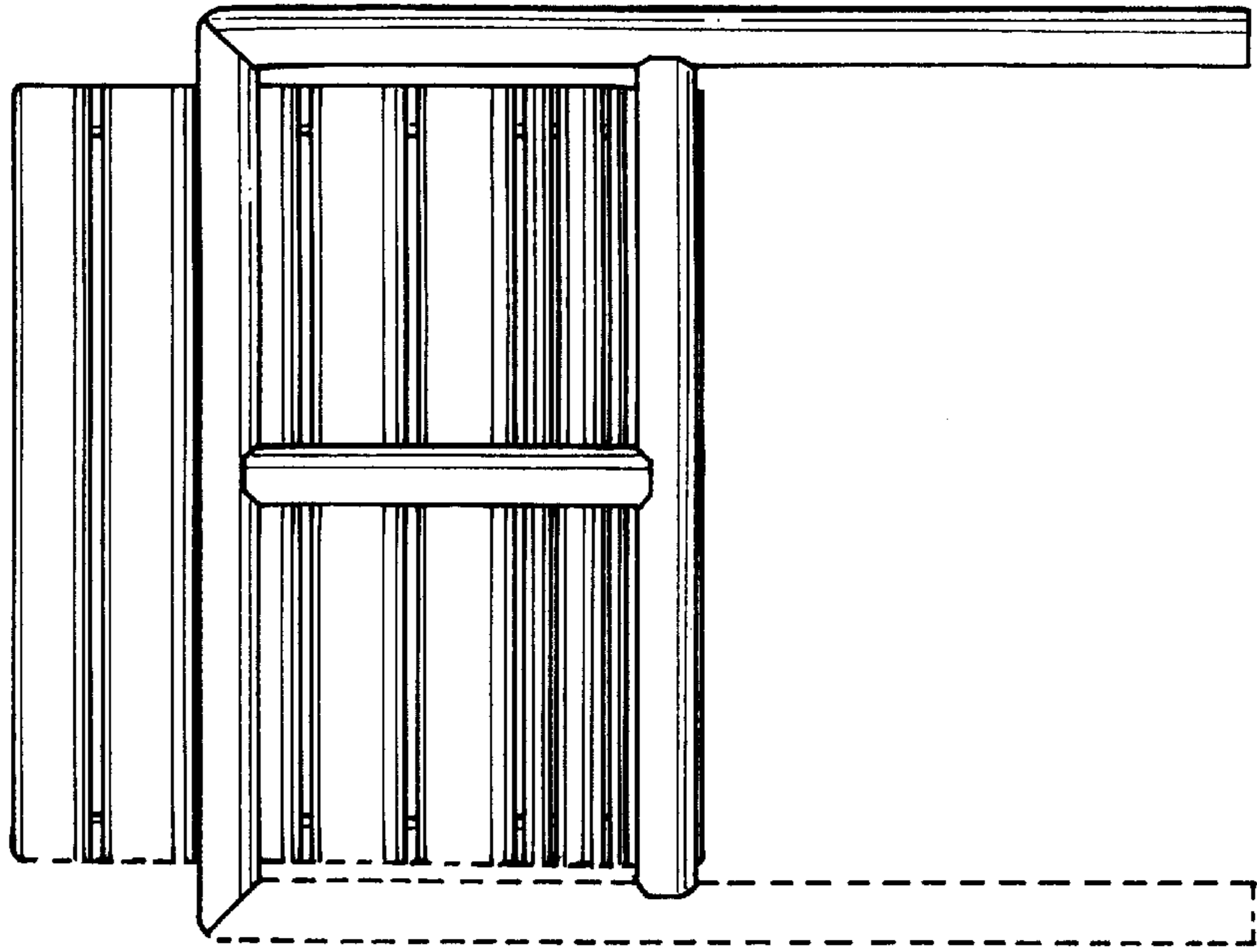
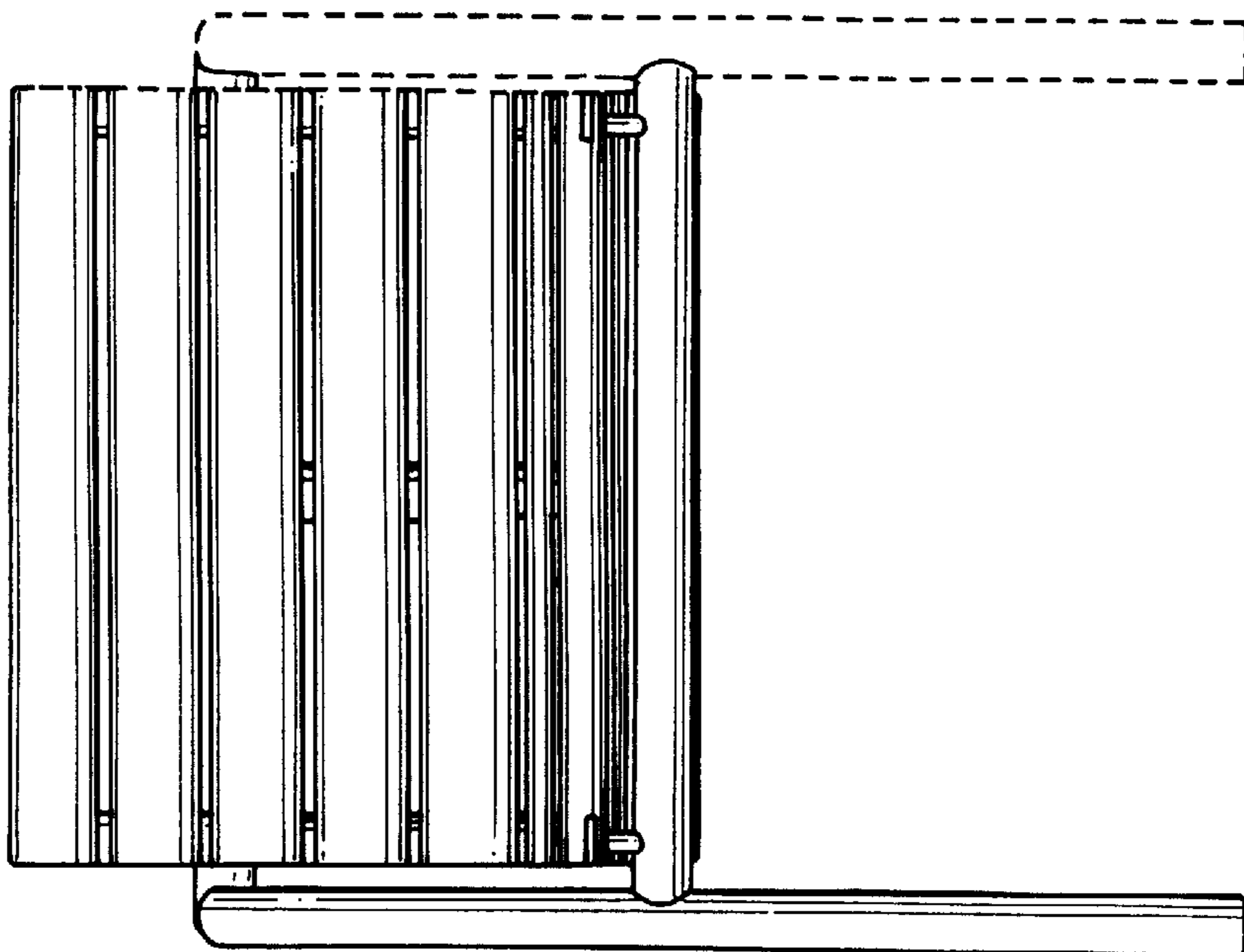

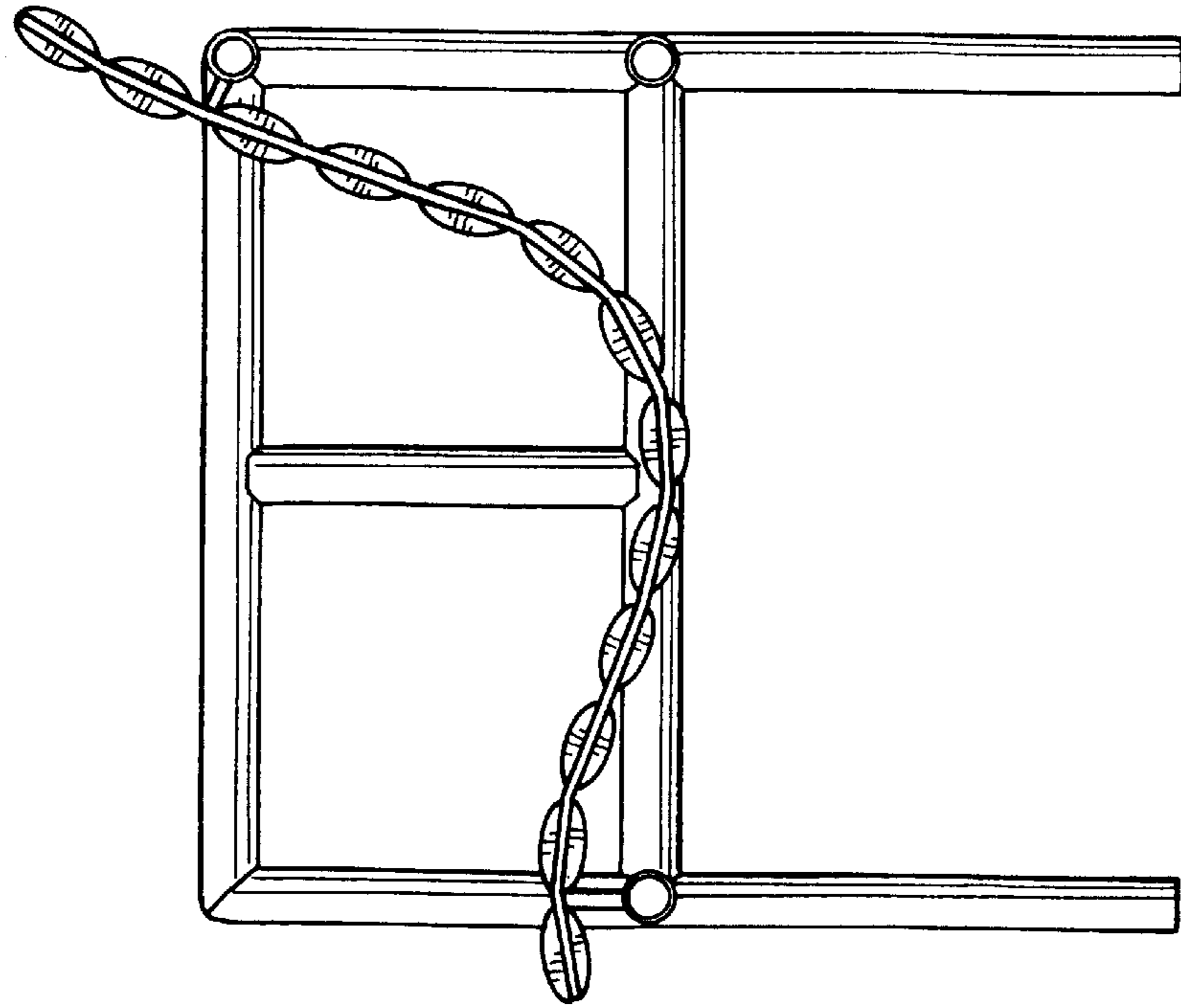

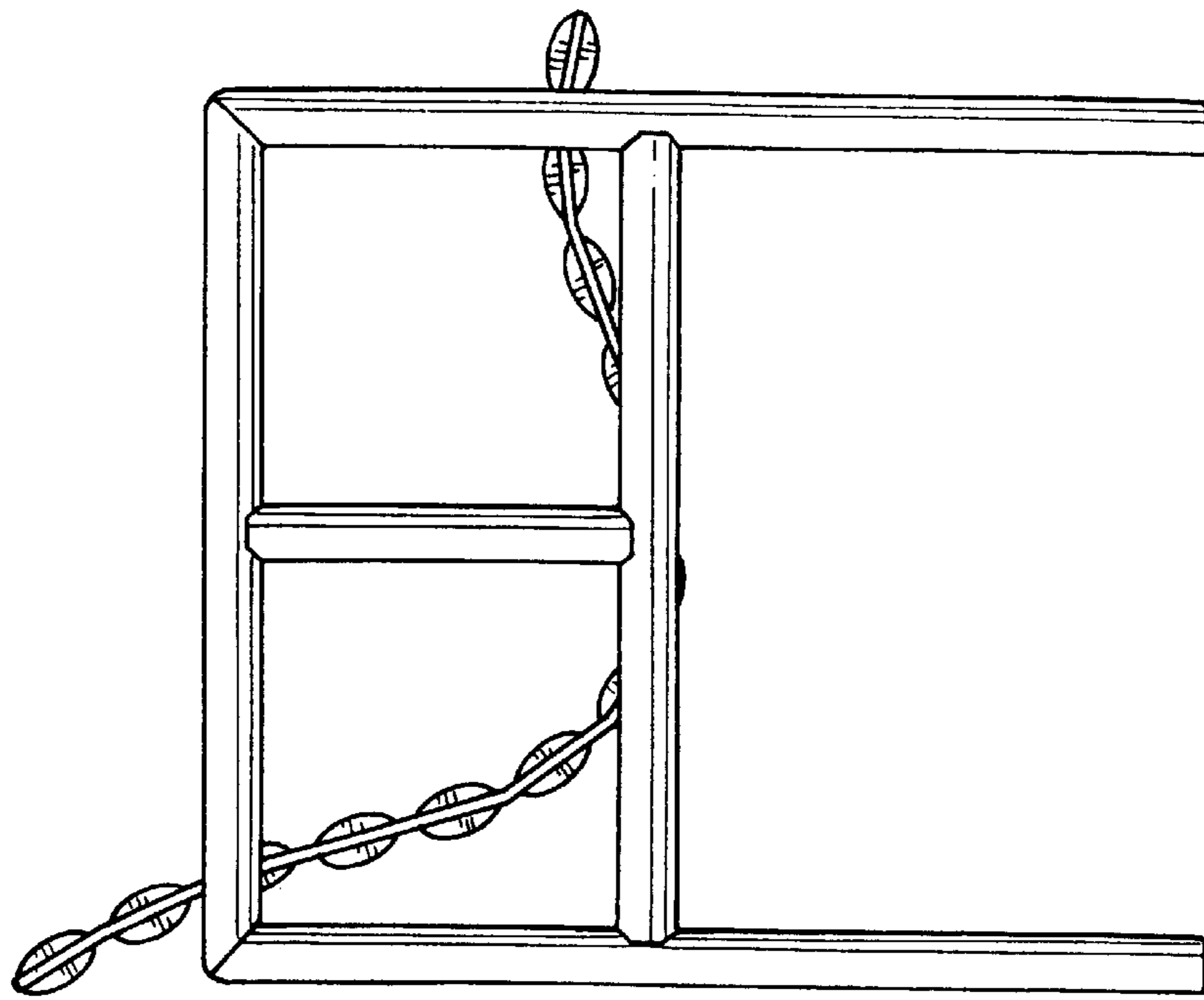

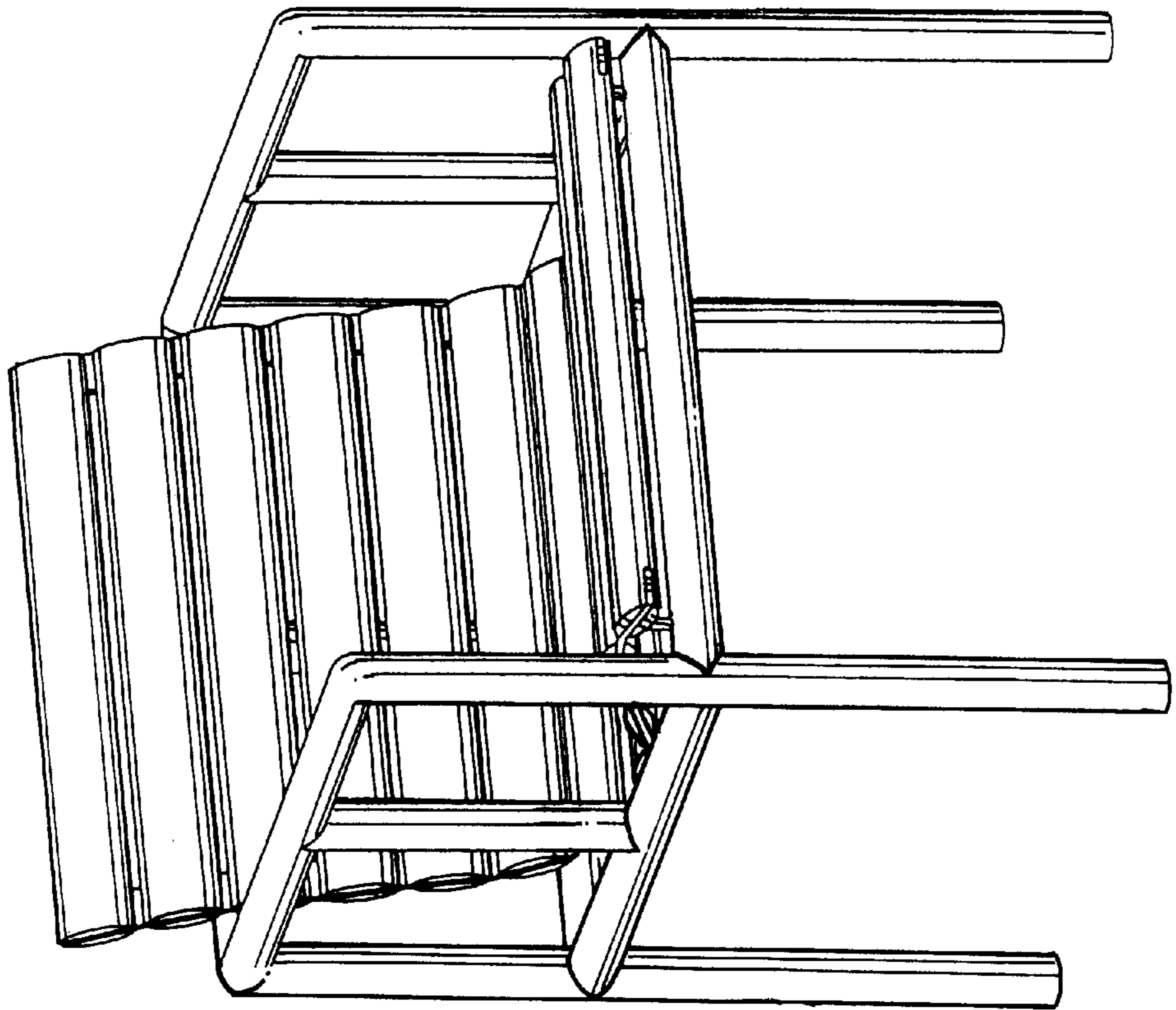

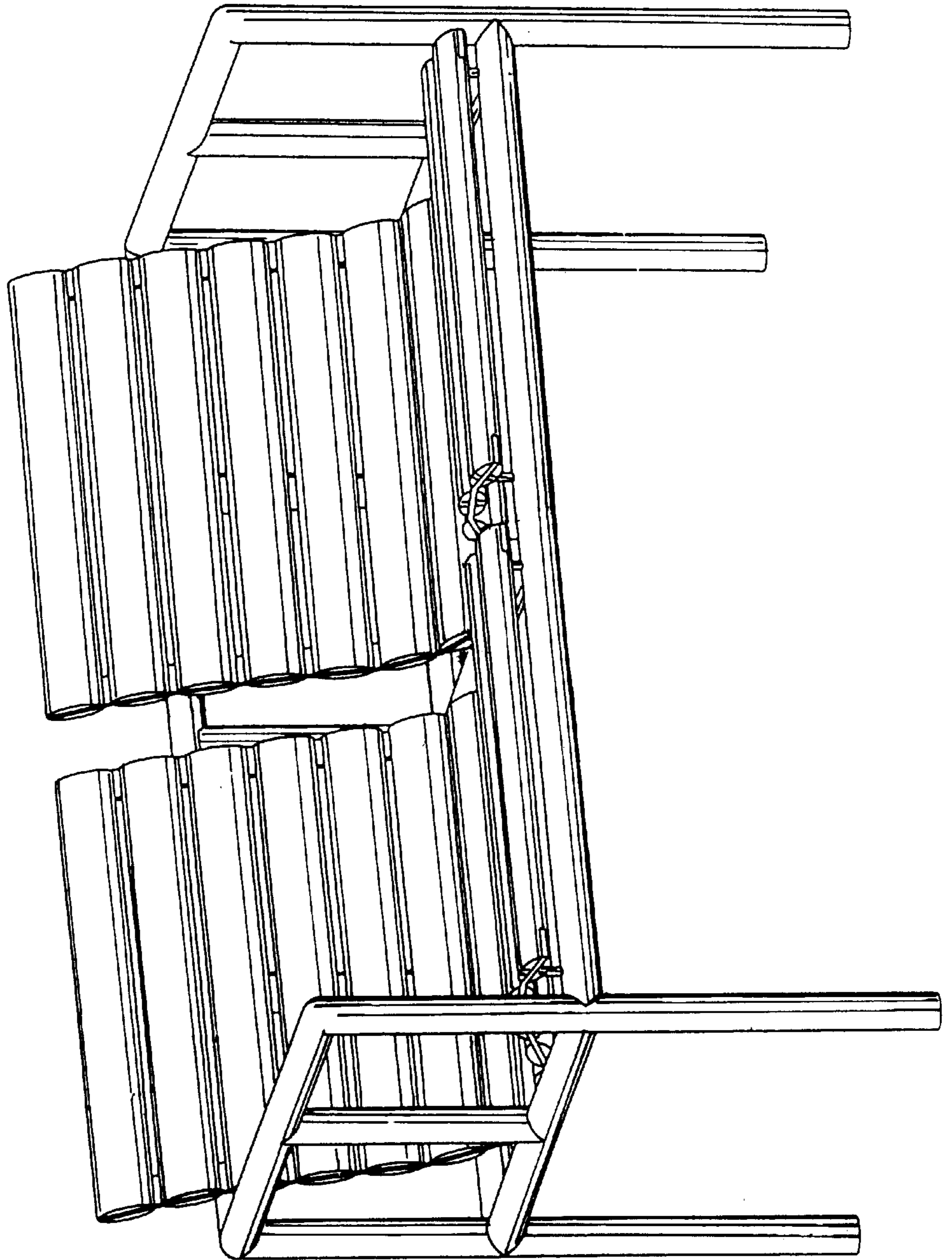
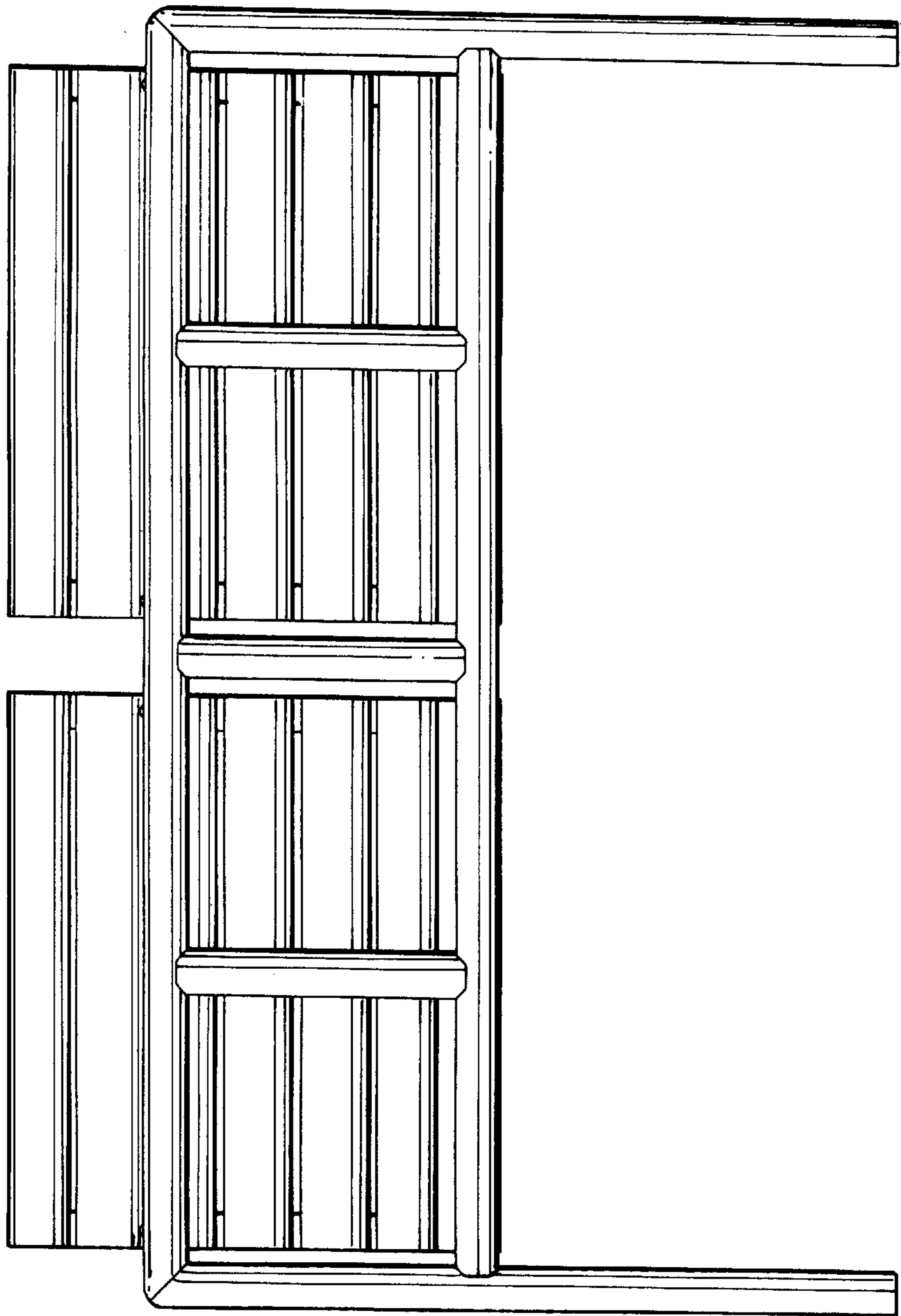

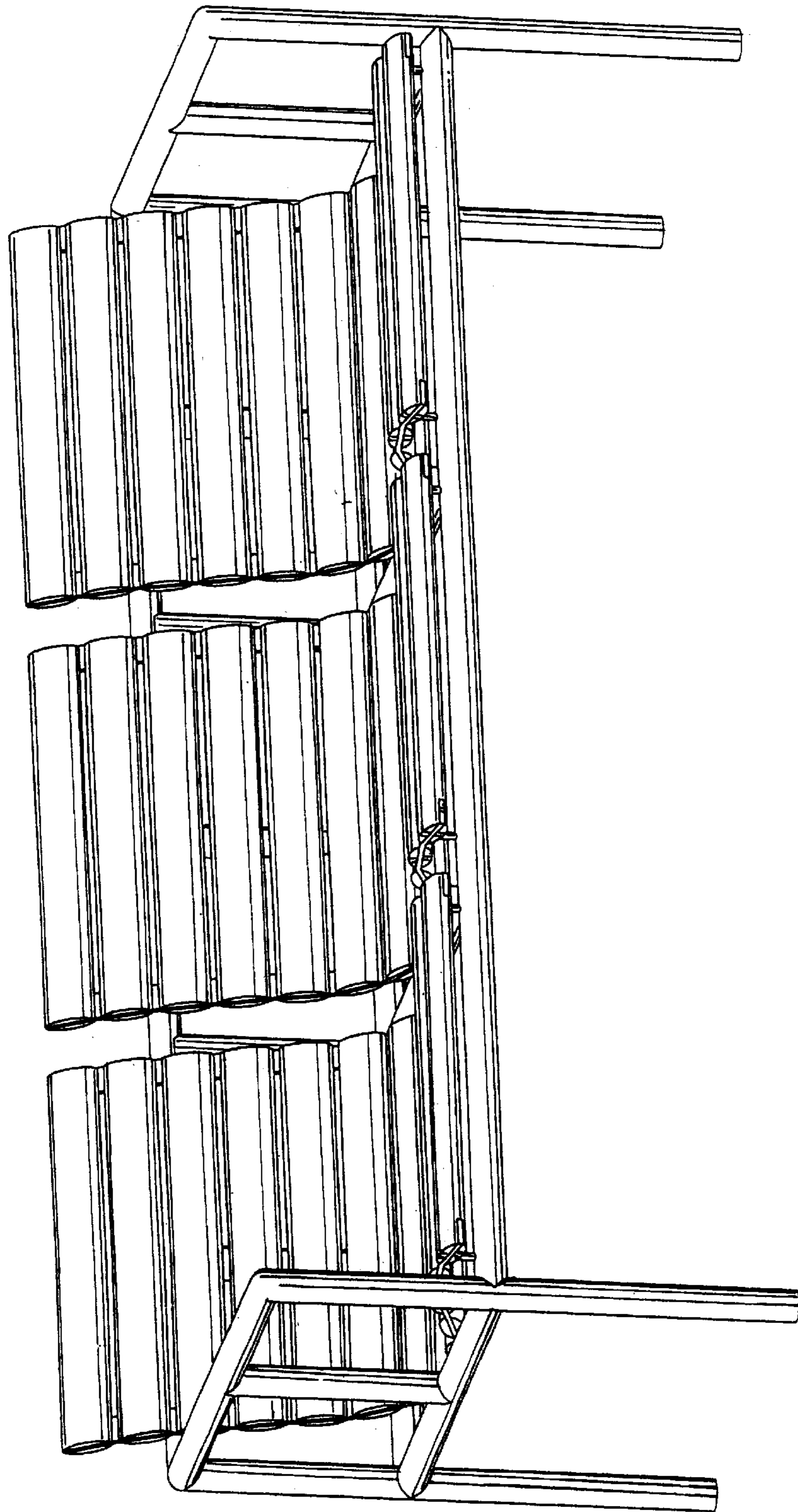
